FASTBREAK POINTS

- Canisius closes out its first weekend of MAAC play this afternoon when the Golden Griffins host Iona in the Koessler Athletic Center.
- Canisius is 7-7 overall and 1-0 in league play after the Blue and Gold defeated Rider 77-76 Friday afternoon. The Griffins have now won their MAAC-opener in six-straight seasons.
- The Griffins are 4-1 at home this year, winning those four games by an average of 12.5 points per game.
- Canisius freshman **Takal Molson** recorded his first career double-double in the win over Rider on Friday. He is the first Canisius freshman to record a double-double in his first career MAAC game.
- Senior **Jermaine Crumpton** scored a game-high 20 points in the win over Rider, his 10-straight game with double-figures in the scoring column.
- Sophomore **Isaiah Reese** was credited with two steals in the win over Rider, extending his streak of multiple steals in a game to six.
- Junior **Jonathan Sanks** matched a career-high with 12 points against Rider, including the game-winning free-throw with 39 seconds left to play.

WITHERSPOON AVAILABILITY

All interview requests for head coach Reggie Witherspoon should be directed to Matt Reitnour in the Canisius Athletic Communications office. Coach Witherspoon will be available to the media every Wednesday prior to the start of practice. Postgame press conferences will be held after each game, home and away.

PLAYER INTERVIEWS

All player interview must be arranged through Matt Reitnour in the Canisius Athletic Communications office at least two days in advance. Along with coach Witherspoon, players will be available to the media every Wednesday prior to the start of practice. There is NO player availability on game day prior to tipoff. The Canisius locker room is closed.

CREDENTIALS

Single-game press credentials are issued to accredited members of the working media. Requests for credentials should be submitted to Matt Reitnour at least five days in advance. Credentials can be picked up 90 minutes ahead of tipoff on game days. Parking is provided as available (see PARKING NOTE, please).

MEDIA WORK ROOM

The Canisius media work room is located on the second floor of the Koessler Athletic Center, across from the weight room. The work room opens 90 minutes before tip and is open for two hours after the game.

PRESS ROW SEATING

All credentialed media is permitted to sit on press row in the Koessler Athletic Center. Because of limited space, working media is given first priority for seating on game day. To reserve working space on press row, media is asked to contact Matt Reitnour in the Canisius Athletic Communications office at least 24 hours in advance of tipoff.

Parking space for credentialed media is limited, and all parking requests must be submitted to Matt Reitnour in the Canisius Athletic Communications office 24 hours in advance of game time.

CANISIUS - IONA SERIES HISTORY

- This is the 72nd meeting between these two schools and Iona leads the series 40-31.
- Iona has won four of the last five and seven of the last 10 meetings between these two squads. Canisius' 89-83 win over the Gaels Feb. 14, 2017 snapped Iona's four-game winning streak in the series.
- The last four wins by Iona in this series have come by an average of 16.8 points per game.
- Canisius is 21-12 against Iona at home, with 14 of those victories coming in the Koessler Athletic Center.

ABOUT THE GAELS

- Iona comes into this afternoon's game with a record of 7-6 overall and 1-0 in MAAC play.
- The Gaels have won six of their last eight games, dating back to their Nov. 28 win over Ohio at home. Iona opened MAAC play Friday night with a 98-93 overtime victory at Niagara.
- As a team, Iona is averaging 77.7 points per game, which ranks third-best in the MAAC. Defensively, the Gaels are giving up 76.6 points per contest, which ranks fifth in the league.
- Rider leads the MAAC and ranks 24th in the nation with 10.5 3-point field goals per game. Coming into today's game, 40.4 percent of Iona's points come from 3-point makes, which ranks 27th in the country.
- Junior **Rickey McGill** leads the team and ranks 17th in the MAAC in scoring at 13.5 points per game. Iona has four players averaging better than 10.0 points per game, including graduate student **Zach Lewis**, who is good for 10.7 points per contest. Lewis started his college career at Canisius before transferring to UMass.
- Grad transfer **TK Edogi** leads Iona and ranks third in the MAAC with his 7.7 rebounds per game. Before joining Iona, Edogi played 77 career games at Tulsa.

LAST TIME vs. THE GAELS

BUFFALO, N.Y. (Feb. 14, 2017) - Canisius tied a Koessler Athletic Center record with 16 3-point field goals, six players recorded double-figures in the scoring column, and the Golden Griffins' defense held Iona without a field goal for the final 5:32 en route to an 89-83 win over the Gaels. The win for Canisius snapped the team's four-game losing streak in the series against Iona. Former Griff **Phil Valenti** scored 18 points in the win for the Blue and Gold, which drained 16 3-pointers at home for the third time in program history. **Jermaine Crumpton** added 17 points and a game-high eight rebounds in the win for Canisius, while Iona's **Jordan Washington** and **Jon Severe** were good for 15 points apiece in the loss.

NEXT UP

- Canisius will travel to Quinnipiac on Friday, Jan. 5, for the team's first road MAAC game of the 2017-18 campaign. Game time in Hamden, Conn., is set for 8 p.m., and the game will be broadcast live on ESPN3.
- Canisius and Quinnipiac split the regular-season series last year, with each team scoring a win on its home court.
- After playing at Quinnipiac on Jan. 5, the Griffis will travel to play at Siena Jan. 7. That game in Times Union Center is scheduled for a 3 p.m., tipoff.

ISAIAH REESE

- One of two players in the MAAC to rank in the top-10 in scoring, rebounding and assists per game average.
- Had a game-high eight assists in the win over Rider Friday.
- Ranks second in the MAAC (48th nationally) with 2.0 steals per game.

CURRENT EVENTS

CANISIUS IN MAAC OPENERS

- ▶ Canisius opened its 29th season of MAAC play Friday afternoon with a 77-76 win over Rider in the Koessler Athletic Center.
- ▶ The win over the Broncs improved Canisius to 15-14 all-time in the first MAAC game of the season and extended the Griff's MAAC-opening win streak to six straight, dating back to the 2012-13 campaign.

DEJA VU ALL OVER AGAIN

- ▶ Canisius' 77-76 win over Rider on Friday marked the second-straight year where the Griff's started league play with a 77-76 victory. Last season, the Griff's defeated Manhattan 77-76 in Riverdale, N.Y., in the conference opener for both teams.
- ▶ In the 487 total MAAC regular-season games played in Canisius' history, only twice has the final score read 77-76, and both of those games have come in the last two seasons. And both stand as Canisius victories.

DECEMBERS TO REMEMBER

- ▶ Since 2012-13, Canisius is 29-12 in games played in the month of December. The Griff's are 3-3 in December this season after beating Rider 77-76 Friday afternoon in the Koessler Athletic Center.
- ▶ Prior to the 2012-13 season, Canisius only had 11 wins in the month of December from 2008-09 through the 2011-12 campaigns.

KEEPING IT LOW

- ▶ The 51 points scored by Elon Dec. 19 are the fewest for a Canisius opponent under second-year head coach **Reggie Witherspoon**.
- ▶ That 51-point defensive effort against Elon is the lowest points allowed for a Canisius opponent since Monmouth scored 44 against the Griff's Feb. 9, 2015.
- ▶ Coming into today's game against Iona, the Griff's have held seven opponents to 65-points or less this year. Last season, Canisius held just four teams to 65-points or less in a game.
- ▶ In the 71 previous meetings between Canisius and Iona, the Griff's have held the Gaels to 65-points or less a total 19 times. The last time the Blue and Gold kept Iona to 65-points or less was Jan. 4, 2010 - a 77-65 home victory for Canisius.

IMPROVING ON THE DEFENSIVE FRONT

- ▶ Canisius comes into today's game giving up 69.4 points per game through the first 14 games of the 2017-18 slate.
- ▶ Canisius ranks third in the MAAC and 120th nationally in scoring defense. This year marks just the third time (including the 2009-10 and 2014-15 seasons) where the Griff's have held their opponents under 70 points per game through the first 14 contests of the year.
- ▶ Canisius has held seven of their last 11 opponents to 65 points or less after the team gave up 62 points to Robert Morris Dec. 22 in Pittsburgh.

DEFENDING MAIN STREET

- ▶ Canisius returns home today with a 4-1 record in four home dates, with the Griff's winning those four games by an average of 12.5 points per game.
- ▶ The Blue and Gold have flexed their defensive muscles at home this year, where opposing teams are averaging 68.8 points per game against the Griff's while shooting a collective 43.4 percent from the field and 34.3 percent from 3-point land.
- ▶ Canisius went 7-7 at home last season, extending the program's string of finishing .500 or better at home to five-straight seasons.

HITTING ON A HIGH PERCENTAGE

- ▶ The Griff's start today's contest shooting 47.6 percent from the field, with the team connecting on 371-of-779 shots from the field.
- ▶ Canisius, which leads the MAAC and ranks 73rd nationally in field goal shooting percentage, has shot better than 45 percent from the field in seven games this season after the team shot 55.4 percent from the field in the road win at Robert Morris Dec. 22.
- ▶ The Griff's rank sixth nationally in traditional two-point field goal percentage, hitting on 60.0 percent of their shots from inside the 3-point arc.
- ▶ Through 14 games, 49.9 percent of the Griff's offense has come from inside the 3-point line, the highest percentage in that category for the team since the 2014-15 campaign.

CURRENT EVENTS

THE GRIFFS NOT AFRAID TO SHOOT FROM DEEP

- ▶ Canisius comes into today's game with 122 makes from 3-point land, good for an average of 8.7 per contest. Canisius ranks 66th nationally in total 3-point field goals made and 93rd in 3-point field goals per game average.
- ▶ The Griff's drained 11 3-pointers in the team's win over Elon Dec. 19. The team has made 10-or more treys 57 times since the start of the 2012-13 season.
- ▶ Canisius hit a total of 309 3-point field goals last season, the second-makes from long range in school history.

DROPPING DIMES

- ▶ Canisius comes into this afternoon's game ranked first in the MAAC and 53rd in the nation in assists per game with 16.5 per contest.
- ▶ The Blue and Gold dished out 20 assists on 28 makes in the team's win over Rider Friday. According to kenpom.com, the Griff's rank 15th in the nation in assists-to-field goal percentage, with 62.3 percent (231-of-371) of the team's baskets this season coming off assists.
- ▶ Kenpom.com ranked Canisius sixth in the nation in assists-to-field goal percentage last season, with 64.0 percent (601-of-943) of the team's buckets coming off assists.
- ▶ The Griff's ended the 2016-17 season with a school-record 601 total assists as a team, and the squad's 17.7 assists per game average ranked sixth-best in the nation.

TROUBLE AT THE LINE

- ▶ As a team, Canisius is shooting 67.0 percent (134-for-200) from the free-throw line this season. That ranks ninth in the MAAC and 273rd in the nation.
- ▶ The Griff's went to the line just seven times in the team's loss at Albany Dec. 16. That game marked the fourth time this season where the Blue and Gold went to the line fewer than 10 times for a game. All four of those games (at Tennessee State, at Pacific, at Evansville and at Albany) were road games.
- ▶ Canisius is shooting just 59.6 percent (34-for-59) from the free-throw line in the team's last five games. In that span, only sophomore **Isaiah Reese** (100 percent; 7-for-7) and senior **Jermaine Crumpton** (72.7 percent; 8-for-11) are shooting better than 60 percent from the stripe (among players with more than 10 free-throw attempts).

BLOCK PARTY

- ▶ As a team, Canisius ranks third in the MAAC and 168th nationally with 3.4 blocked shots per game. Canisius was credited with seven blocks in the win at Robert Morris Dec. 22, the third time this season the team was credited with seven blocks in a game.
- ▶ The Griff's have a combined 48 blocked shots through 14 games this season. Last year, Canisius was credited with a total of 64 blocked shots as a team in 34 games.
- ▶ Canisius is one of three teams in the MAAC to have multiple players rank among the conference's top-15 in blocked shots. Senior **Selvedin Planincic** leads the team is ranked third in the MAAC with his 1.2 blocks per game, while freshman **Jalanni White** is tied for 15th in the league with his 0.8 blocked shots per contest.

TAKING CARE OF THE BALL

- ▶ Canisius enters today's game averaging 15.4 turnovers per game after the Griff's gave the ball away 13 times in the win over Rider Friday afternoon.
- ▶ The Blue and Gold has improved on its turnover rate recently, as the team was charged with a season-low 10 turnovers in the loss at Albany Dec. 16, and then followed that effort with 11 turnovers in the home win over Elon Dec. 19. In their last five games, the Griff's are averaging just 12.8 turnovers per game.
- ▶ The Griff's' 15.4 turnovers per game ranks sixth in the MAAC and 299th in the country.

GRIFFS GO SHARPIE

- ▶ The Griff's are 60-1 since the start of 2013-14 when leading at the 2:00 mark of the second half of a game.
- ▶ The Griff's are 54-6 since 2013-14 when leading at the 5:00 mark in the second half. One of those six losses came this season, as Canisius led Buffalo 69-68 at the 5:00 mark Nov. 11, before the host Bulls stormed back to score an 80-75 victory.

PROTECT THIS HOUSE

- ▶ The Griff's own an all-time record of 226-135 (.626 win percentage) in the Koessler Athletic Center. The team is 105-103 (.505 win percentage) since 2001.
- ▶ Canisius did not use the Koessler Center as its main home venue until 1999-00.

CRUMP 1K

- ▶ Canisius senior **Jermaine Crumpton** started his final season with the Griffs as a member of the program's famed 1,000-career point club. The Niagara Falls, N.Y., native scored his 1,000th career point March 3, 2017 in the team's MAAC Tournament quarterfinal loss to Saint Peter's.
- ▶ Crumpton is the eighth player in school history to reach the 1,000 point plateau in his junior year, and just the second Griff to accomplish that feat since **Frank Turner** did it in 2008-09.
- ▶ Crumpton starts today's game ranked 19th in school history with his 1,237 career points. He is the second Niagara Falls, N.Y., native to reach 1,000 points in a Canisius uniform, joining for Griff guard **DeWitt Doss** (2000-05).

TEN PLUS FOR NO.2

- ▶ Canisius senior **Jermaine Crumpton** improved his stretch of games with 10-or more points in the scoring column to 10 straight after he scored 20 points in the team's win over Rider Friday afternoon. That 20-point game was the fifth of the season for the Niagara Falls, N.Y., native.
- ▶ This season, Crumpton has scored in double-figures 12 times. He's been good for 10-or more points scored 64 times in his 102 career games as a Griff.

CRUMPTON FOCUSES ON DIET FOR MORE PLAYING TIME

- ▶ Canisius senior **Jermaine Crumpton** dropped nearly 30 pounds from the end of the 2016-17 season to the start of this season, his final year in a Griff uniform.
- ▶ The Niagara Falls, N.Y., native worked with Canisius' director of athletic performance **Mike Guzda**, to change his eating habits, remove soft drinks from his diet and focus more time in the weight room working on cardio and with the weights.
- ▶ The Preseason All-MAAC First-Team honoree has seen positive results on the floor and in his playing time as a result of his hard work in the offseason. Crumpton is averaging 32.1 minutes per game this season, which ranks 11th in the MAAC.

CHARGE IT!

- ▶ **Jermaine Crumpton** starts today's game as the team's leader in offensive charges taken with 10 through the Griffs' first 14 games of the 2017-18 season.
- ▶ The Niagara Falls, New York native took two offensive charges in the team's win at Robert Morris Dec. 22. That marked the eighth time in his career where he has taken multiple charges in a game.
- ▶ Crumpton is the program's active leader in career charges taken with 38 to his credit in 102 career contests. He drew a team-high 24 offensive charges in the 2016-17 campaign.

ONE-THREE FOR A TRIPLE-DOUBLE

- ▶ Sophomore guard **Isaiah Reese** became the first Canisius player in the program's 114-year history to record a triple-double Nov. 18, when the Griffs defeated Youngstown State at home by a score of 104-84.
- ▶ Reese scored a career-high 23 points and dished out a career best 11 assists, while matching a career-high with 11 boards. He also had three steals in 34 minutes of action.
- ▶ The Miami, Fla., native is the first Division I player this season to post a triple-double on the final box score, and he's the first MAAC player to record a triple-double in a game since former Iona guard **Scott Machado** had one against Marist Feb. 12, 2012.
- ▶ Reese was the first player to sign an NLI to join the program after head coach **Reggie Witherspoon** took over in May 2016.

REESE HAS A CAREER-NIGHT VS. ST. BONAVENTURE

- ▶ Sophomore **Isaiah Reese** scored a career-high 31 points in the Griffs' loss to St. Bonaventure Dec. 6. The 31-point effort in the Koessler Athletic Center are the most for a Canisius player since former Griff **Malcolm McMillan** had 31 points in a win over Lehigh Nov. 16, 2015.
- ▶ Reese hit a career-high 10 field goals and matched a career-high with five makes from 3-point range against the Bonnies. In two career games against Canisius' long-time rival, the Miami, Fla., native is averaging 26.5 points per contest.

REESE ON THE GLASS

- ▶ Sophomore guard **Isaiah Reese** comes into today's game ranked seventh in the MAAC in rebounding average at 6.4 boards per contest.
- ▶ Reese ranks second in the MAAC and ranks 145th nationally with his 5.4 defensive rebounds per game. After grabbing three defensive boards against Rider on Friday, 85.4 percent of Reese's rebounds this season have come off the defensive glass.
- ▶ The Miami, Fla. native has been credited with seven-or more rebounds in seven of the team's last 12 games. He matched a career-high with 11 rebounds in the win over Youngstown State Nov. 18, which stands as the most boards for a Canisius player this season.

MAN OF STEAL

- Sophomore **Isaiah Reese** recorded two steals in the team's win over Rider Friday - the sixth-straight game where he was credited with multiple steals.
- Reese leads Canisius and ranks second in the MAAC (48th nationally) with his 2.0 steals per game. He has been credited with at least one steal in 26 career games (12 times this season).
- The Miami, Fla., native starts today's game with 74 steals in 48 career games, which breaks out to 1.5 steals per game for his career. Among Canisius players with 40 career games played, Reese's 1.5 steals per contest is tied for eighth-best in program history.

HAPPY TO HELP

- Sophomore guard **Malik Johnson** leads Canisius and ranks fourth in the MAAC with his 5.0 assists per game average this season. He was credited with career-high nine assists at Pacific Nov. 25.
- Johnson has been good for five-or more assists in 24 of his first 48 career games as a Griff.
- The Richmond, Va., native ended the 2016-17 season ranked fifth in the MAAC and 14th among all Division I freshmen with his 4.4 assists per game.

- Senior center **Selvedin Planincic** matched a career-high with 11 points to go along with five rebounds and a career-best five blocked shots in 30 minutes in the team's win over Robert Morris Dec. 22.
- The Sherbrooke, Quebec native is averaging 6.7 points, 4.0 rebounds and 2.3 blocked shots per game since moving to the starting line-up for the Griffs Dec. 19 against Elon. The Griffs are 3-0 in his three career starts.

SANKS STARTING TO SETTLE IN

- Junior guard **Jonathan Sanks** matched a career-high with 12 points in 13 minutes off the bench in the Griffs' win over Rider Friday. In that game, his made free-throw with 39 seconds left ended up putting Canisius ahead for good in the 77-76 victory.

NEW YEAR; NEW FACES FOR THE GRIFFS

- ▶ Canisius started the 114th season in program history with six new scholarship players, including four true freshmen, making the Griff's the second-youngest team in the MAAC.
- ▶ The Blue and Gold started the 2017-18 with a total of 270 combined Division I games played among eight players, including junior guard **Jonathan Sanks**, who played 19 games as a redshirt-freshman at Georgia Southern in 2015-16.
- ▶ Senior **Jermaine Crumpton** is the most experienced returning player for Canisius, as he started his final season on Main Street having played in a total of 88 career games.
- ▶ Sophomores **Malik Johnson** and **Isaiah Reese** played in all 34 games last year as freshmen last year. Johnson started all 34 games as well, setting the program record for starts by a true freshman.

FOUR NEW FRESHMEN FOR THE GRIFFS

- ▶ The 2017-18 Canisius basketball roster features four true freshmen, one from Buffalo, one from Connecticut, the program's first Alabama native and a Canadian-born player.
- ▶ Guard **Takal Molson** returns to the Queen City after spending the 2016-17 season at TAAG Academy in Tampa. He signed his NLI to join the program in April 2017.
- ▶ Forward **Jalanni White** comes to Canisius after averaging 12.1 points, 11.0 rebounds and 3.0 blocks per game last year at Notre Dame - West Haven in New Haven, Conn. He helped lead that team to the school's first perfect season (22-0).
- ▶ Guard **D.J. Heath**, a four-star recruit from Anniston, Ala., helped lead his Sacred Heart high school squad to three-straight Alabama Class 1A state crowns.
- ▶ Forward **Scott Hitchon** brings a strong front court game to the Griff's roster after growing up in Whitby, Ontario. He averaged 19 points and 8.0 rebounds per game for Thornlea Secondary last season.

YEAR TWO UNDER WITHERSPOON

- ▶ Canisius head coach **Reggie Witherspoon** is in his second season at the helm of the Golden Griffin program after leading the team to an 18-16 overall mark and an appearance in the CIT last season.
- ▶ The 18 wins last season ties Witherspoon with former head coach **Earl Brown** for the second-most victories in a coach's first year leading the Griff's. Brown led the team to an 18-13 record in 1946-47. Former head coach **Jim Baron** holds the program record for wins in year No. 1 with the program after he guided the team to a 20-14 mark in 2012-13.
- ▶ Witherspoon's first year at Canisius was highlighted by a seven-game win streak that ran from Dec. 7 through Jan. 4. That seven-game winning streak was the program's longest since 1998-99, and featured OT wins over rivals Buffalo and St. Bonaventure.
- ▶ The 2016-17 season was capped by Canisius earning a bid to the 2017 CIT, the program's fourth trip to the CIT in the last five seasons. Witherspoon joins Baron as the only two coaches in program history to lead the Griff's to the national postseason in their first year on Main Street.

O, CANADA

- ▶ The 2017-18 Canisius men's basketball team has three Canadian-born players on its roster, which is tied for the most in the MAAC with rival Siena.
- ▶ Senior center **Selvedin Planincic** claims Sherbrooke, Quebec as his hometown, while sophomore **Dantai St. Louis** is proud to call Brampton, Ontario as his hometown. Freshman **Scott Hitchon** is a native of Whitby, Ontario.
- ▶ The Canadian connection isn't just limited to the team's players, as assistant coach **Larry Blunt** spent time in his coaching career in Canada, most recently at Orangeville Prep in Mono, Ontario. There, Blunt coached both Planincic and St. Louis.

FREQUENT FLYER MILES

- ▶ The 2017-18 non-conference schedule saw the Griff's play a total of nine road/neutral site games this season, where the team posted a 3-6 record. The win at Robert Morris Dec. 22, stands as Canisius' first true road win of the season.
- ▶ In all, Canisius traveled 12,250 miles in the non-conference schedule since starting the season at cross-town rival Buffalo Nov. 11. That game against Buffalo was the shortest trip for the Blue and Gold, as the team went a total of 22 miles round-trip to start the season.

CALIFORNIA LOVE

- ▶ The Griff's' 68-62 win over Texas State Nov. 24 stands as the program's first in the state of California.
- ▶ Prior to that victory, Canisius had not played in California since Dec. 23, 1989 when the team took part in the Met Life Classic in San Francisco. The Blue and Gold went 0-2 in that event in the team's only other trip to nation's most populous state.

SUMMER TRIP TO CANADA

- ▶ The Canisius men's basketball team took a five-day foreign tour north of the boarder to Canada Aug. 18-23, where the team played five games and posted a 3-2 record.
- ▶ The foreign tour was the program's first since Canisius traveled to Italy in the summer of 2008.
- ▶ The Griff's spent time in Montreal and Ottawa, spending down time to tour such sites as Old Montreal, Olympic Stadium and Saint Joseph's Oratory of Mount Royal before heading to Ottawa, Canada's capital city.
- ▶ On the basketball court, Canisius went 3-2 on its foreign tour, scoring wins over Queen's University, Bishop's University and Concordia.
- ▶ Sophomore guard **Isaiah Reese** led the team in scoring average with 21.0 points per game, and he was the Griff's top scorer in four of the five exhibition games played.

GRIFFS PICKED NINTH IN MAAC POLL

- ▶ Canisius was picked to finish ninth in the annual MAAC Preseason Coaches Poll. This marks the second-straight year where the Blue and Gold were picked to place ninth by the conference's 11 head coaches.
- ▶ Iona, the defending MAAC champion, is the league's preseason favorite to win the conference's title.
- ▶ Senior **Jermaine Crumpton** was the only Canisius player named to a preseason all-star unit by the

MAAC's 11 head coaches. The Niagara Falls, N.Y., native was named Preseason All-MAAC First-Team, the first Griff to earn that honor since **Billy Baron** was named the MAAC Preseason Player of the Year before the start of the 2013-14 campaign.

RETURNING AWARD WINNERS

- ▶ Canisius started the 2017-18 season with the second-youngest roster in the MAAC, with eight players ranking as freshmen or sophomores. However, the Griff's are the only team in the conference to return multiple MAAC honorees from a season ago.
- ▶ Senior **Jermaine Crumpton** and sophomore **Malik Johnson** both earned all-league honors for the Blue and Gold at the end of the 2016-17 season. Crumpton was an All-MAAC Third Team honoree, while Johnson was named to the MAAC All-Rookie Team.
- ▶ The third-team acknowledgment for Crumpton was his first all-conference award, and Johnson's appointment to the MAAC All-Rookie Team makes him just the ninth player in program history to garner that honor.

114TH SEASON OF CANISIUS HOOPS

- ▶ Canisius embarks on the 114th season of basketball this year. Canisius has sponsored varsity basketball longer than any other team in the MAAC.
- ▶ The 2017-18 campaign also marks the 29th season of MAAC membership for the program.
- ▶ The Griff's played their first basketball game Dec. 7, 1903, a 14-6 win over Gordon's of Buffalo.
- ▶ The program has made a total of 13 postseason appearances (5 NCAA, 4 NIT, 4 CIT), with the last postseason berth coming in 2016-17, where the team earned an invite to the 2017 CIT.

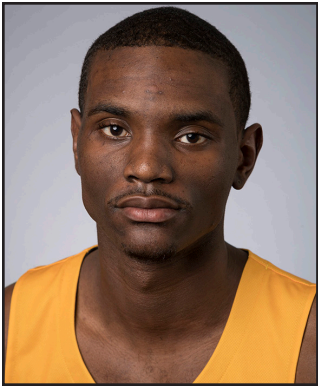

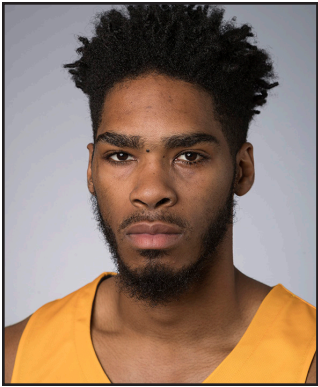

- As a player, Witherspoon played for two seasons at Erie Community College, where his head coach was **John Beilein**. Beilein later went on to be the Canisius head coach from 1992-97, and he now leads the Michigan basketball program.
