<> **Knights of Late:** The Knights began their seven-game road trip with a 77-53 loss at Saint Peter's. The team enters Saturday's tilt with an 0-3 road record this season. After missing the first two games and playing limited minutes over the next four, senior guard Darian Anderson appeared to be back to his old self on Wednesday, scoring 21 points to go along with five steals. The Knights entered the game with the 22nd-highest field goal percentage in the country (51.4%) but were limited to 26.8 percent in the loss. This is the second straight-game for the Knights against a team playing its home opener.

<> **Scouting Iona:** Saturday marks the 2017-18 home opener for the Gaels who enter the contest with a 2-4 record with victories over Weber State (80-72) and Ohio (93-88). In the win at Ohio on Tuesday night, E.J. Crawford and TK Edogi paced the team with 20 points apiece, while Edogi added 12 rebounds to his ledger. The Gaels made all 13 of their free throw attempts and hit 14-of-35 (40 percent) from three-point range. The Gaels are headed by 12th year head coach Tim Cluess (262-105) and have appeared in back-to-back NCAA Tournaments, last year earning the No. 14 seed and falling to Oregon. This year's squad was picked to win the MAAC for the third straight season, while senior Deyshonee Much and junior Rickey McGill earned All-MAAC Preseason Second Team honors.

Last Year's Game: The Gaels came to the Rothman Center and posted 54 first-half points in a 19-point victory over the Knights. Sophomore forward Mike Holloway paced the Knights with 17 points and six rebounds on 5-of-8 shooting in the loss, while the Gaels were led by Jordan Washington, who finished with a game-high 18 points.

Bishop's Strong Outing: In last season's game against the Gaels, sophomore forward Kaleb Bishop totaled 13 first-half points. Bishop's 13 tallies set a new career-high for the freshman and he added seven rebounds on the night.

Record Book Update: Darian Anderson scored 21 points and tallied five steals in the Knights' loss at Saint Peter's on Wednesday. He now ranks 10th all-time in FDU history with 1,398 points and second in steals with 180.

Give Us That: Featuring one of the program's most adept stealsman in Anderson, the Knights added a slew of speedy defenders this season including freshman guard Jahlil Jenkins. Jenkins nabbed five steals last game, which has helped the Knights to a 10.7 steals per game average this season -- 8th best in the NCAA.

Turn it Over: The Knights nabbed a program-record 19 steals in the win against Kean and forced 31 turnovers. Junior guard Darnell Edge was at the forefront of the effort with seven steals of his own (most by a Knight since Sean Baptiste totaled seven on 1/10/09 against CCSU.)

Dish it Out: In the lopsided win over FDU-Florham on 11/15, the Knights totaled 27 assists. That total is the most in a game since the team dished out 28 helpers in a 122-115 overtime loss to LIU Brooklyn back on February 23, 2002.

Darnell's Delight: In a career-high 39 minutes against Holy Cross, Edge poured in a career-best 23 points as the Knights topped the Patriot League's Crusaders. Now in his first season as a regular starter, Edge is averaging 13.6 ppg.

Herenda History: Herenda's win over Holy Cross on Wednesday was his 50th with the Knights and 175th as a head coach. Across his time with the Knights, Herenda has logged five wins over Final Four programs Holy Cross Princeton, Rutgers, Seton Hall and St. Joseph's. He's the fourth FDU head coach to reach 50 wins with the program.

Road Warriors: After playing four of their first six games at home, the Knights close out 2017 with seven straight road games. Entering the long stretch the team had an 0-2 record away from the Rothman Center.

Holloway Holds His Own: Facing some of the country's toughest big men this season, including preseason All-American Angel Delgado of Seton Hall, Mike Holloway Jr. is averaging a team-high 14.6 ppg. He has also scored in double figures in all but one game this season. The junior forward, who was 0-2 from three-point range in his career, knocked down the Knights' first basket of the season with a 3-pointer at Seton Hall. He also made a trey against PSU and is 2-for-4 on the season. Holloway has started 66 of a possible 68 games since arriving in Hackensack and currently ranks 19th in the nation in career field goal percentage.

He's Back: After missing back-to-back games for the first-time in his career (three total missed games), senior guard Darian Anderson returned in limited action against Florham on Nov. 15 and scored 12 points in the first half playing just 13 minutes total.

Freshman Tested: Freshman point guard Jahlil Jenkins began his collegiate career with a pair of difficult tests in two big time college basketball arenas. Jenkins held his own against No. 23 Seton Hall at the Prudential Center and at Penn State's Bryce Jordan Center, averaging 9.0 ppg, 6.0 apg, and 4.0 rpg. The first-year point guard seemed undaunted by the big stage, dishing out eight assists against the nationally-ranked Pirates and scoring 13 points at PSU.

Newcomers: Freshmen Jenkins, Elyjah Williams and Noah Morgan and sophomore Pat McNamara are averaging 14 or more minutes per game this season. Coach Herenda has not been afraid to play his new guys and even featured a stint against Saint Peter's where five newcomers were on the court at once (Tyler Jones and the aforementioned four players).

The Schedule: The 2017-18 slate features another difficult non-conference excursion for the Knights as they open on the road with No. 23 Seton Hall before visiting Happy Valley two days later to square off with Penn State. After playing nine of 11 non-conference tilts on the road last season, the team will host four games prior to NEC play this time around including dates with Holy Cross and Princeton. This year's 11-game, non-conference schedule concludes with KenPom's 41st-ranked team Maryland.

Jersey Tour: The Knights will get a good look at their in-state competition this season by playing seven games against New Jersey schools. In addition to the aforementioned games against Seton Hall and Princeton, the Knights will travel to Rutgers, NJIT and Saint Peter's, while playing host to a pair of Division III schools in Kean and FDU-Florham.

Can't Touch This: Just 7.1 percent of the Knights' shots last season were blocked by the opponent. That figure was 26th lowest in the nation and tops amongst NEC teams.

Points Aplenty: The Knights dominated a pair of Division III opponents last week, topping FDU-Florham 111-49 and Kean 94-55. The 206 combined points are the most ever by the Knights in back-to-back games.

First Shots: Newcomers Elyjah Williams, Noah Morgan, Tyler Jones, Pat McNamara and Brian Fabre all knocked down their first shots with the Knights this season. Furthermore, Jones, McNamara and Jones' all buried 3-pointers to begin their FDU careers.

Darian's Dash: Entering his senior season, Anderson is on the precipice of etching his name amongst the program's all-time leaders in several categories. The senior guard entered the season 11th in points with 1,326, needing 577 to become the program's all-time leader. He also ranks 26th in the nation in active scoring leaders. Additionally, Anderson is ninth in 3-pointers made and 10th in assists. He was also picked as Mid-Major Madness' NEC Preseason Player of the Year.

He'll Take That: Anderson has come up with 50 or more steals in each of his three seasons with the Knights. Last season, the senior guard nabbed at least one steal in 28 of his last 31 games and 3.4 percent of FDU opponent's possessions last season ended with an Anderson theft -- 73rd highest rate in the country. His career steal total is third most in the country amongst active players.

More on Darian: Anderson, who was an All-NEC Second Team honoree last season, enters the season as the NEC's active scoring leader, just outside the top 20 all-time.

Darnell's Edge: Edge's efficiency has been his key contribution to the Knights. The 6'1" guard, Edge displayed tremendous accuracy from the field, converting 50.3 percent of his attempts last season. His true shooting percentage was 62.4 percent, which ranked 86th nationally and he also converted 60.7 percent of his two-point tries. In addition to all that efficiency, Edge's best work came at the free throw line where he logged a 90.4 percent shooting clip. He missed just five times from the line and has just six misses, 66-72 (.917), across his two seasons with the Knights.

All in the Family: On November 12, senior guard Darian Anderson had the chance to see his brother, Dwayne, who is an assistant on the Penn State men's basketball staff. In addition to the Anderson's, FDU junior forward Mike Holloway's brother Rashaan is a junior center for UMass, while his cousin Keith Braxton is an All-NEC honoree for Saint Francis U.

Jolting Jahlil: Jenkins has turned heads with his blazing speed this season. He has started every game at the point guard spot and been a catalyst for the team, averaging a team-high 4.8 assists per game. Entering the season, the West Virginia native drew praise from several media outlets including NYC Buckets predicted him as the NEC Rookie of the Year. Jenkins played at Virginia Academy as well as the Ashburn-based AAU team Uncommon Bulls, which is headed by former NFL wide receiver Antwaan Randle-El. The freshman guard was the first signing of this year's class by Herenda.

KNIGHTS LAST TIME OUT

<> Senior guard Darian Anderson poured in a season-high 21 points but the Fairleigh Dickinson men's basketball team suffered a 77-53 loss to Saint Peter's on Wednesday night at the Yanitelli Center.

<> The Knights (3-4), who entered the game with the 22nd highest field goal percentage in the country (51.4 percent) were limited to just 26.8 percent by the Peacocks (3-3) – their lowest rate of the season.

<> In addition, to the overall field goal percentage, the Knights connected on only 5-of-24 (20.8 percent) from behind the arc, while the home Peacocks knocked down 11-of-26 (42.3 percent) from behind the arc and 46.9 percent overall. The Peacocks also dominated on the glass, out-rebounding the Knights 49-31 in the contest.

<> The Knights did an excellent job of getting to the free throw line, connecting on 18-of-26 (69.2 percent) compared to just eight attempts for the home team. Defensively, FDU came up with nine steals but lost the turnover battle 16-12.

<> Saint Peter's was led by a balanced scoring effort, which saw five players reach double figures. Forward Nick Griffin topped the scoresheet for the Peacocks and filled up the box score with 19 points, six rebounds and five assists. Junior forward Samuel Idowu was a nuisance for the Knights as the big man connected on 6-of-12 shots, including 4-of-7 from three-point range, finishing with 16 points to go along with eight rebounds.

<> **Herenda's postgame quotes** - "Give credit to Saint Peter's -- they distanced themselves from us early in the second half and we just could not dent their lead," said head coach Greg Herenda following the loss. "We just never got into an offensive rhythm tonight in this building. Darian and Jahlil [Jenkins] made a lot of things happen for us but we needed more than just two guys tonight. Also, Elyjah Williams really competed on both backboards -- but we just looked very young out there tonight. We will learn from this, move on and improve."

Staff Update: Herenda and longtime associate head coach Bruce Hamburger are back but they will be joined by two new staff members this season. Last year's Director of Basketball Ops., Pete Lappas has moved down a seat to the assistant coach spot, while former Knight and Iowa Hawkeye, Darius Stokes has been appointed into Lappas' former role. The biggest addition to the staff is experienced assistant coach Pat Sellers. Sellers, who played for the NEC's Central Connecticut St. Blue Devils, joins the Knights after tenures with Creighton, UConn, Hofstra and most recently, DePaul. Sellers brings a wealth of knowledge and has coached several professional players including 2014 National Player of the Year, Doug McDermott.

NEC Play: Greg Herenda has led the Knights to back-to-back .500 or better seasons in NEC action for the first time since 2007.

Charitable Contributions: Last season, led by the aforementioned Edge, the Knights converted their highest team free throw percentage in the program's 68-year history. The 76.5 percent figure also ranked 20th in the country.

Chicago Duo: The Knights welcome two Chicago-area newcomers into the fold this season in transfer Pat McNamara and freshman Elyjah Williams. Both players are expected to play key roles for the Knights. As a freshman at New Hampshire in 2015-16, McNamara shot 45 percent downtown and scored a career-high 18 points against Holy Cross, who the Knights face on Nov. 22. Williams was a two-sport athlete at Evanston High and played defensive end and tight end for the Wildkits football team. The new Knights power forward led his highschool team to a sectional championship by scoring 18 points and hauling in 15 rebounds in the win.

New-Body Nadi: Junior forward Nadi Beciri joined the Knights last year after one season at Harcum College. Beciri provided the Knights some valuable minutes as a rotational frontcourt player but is expecting to play a bigger role in 2017-18. The Bergen County, NJ native lost 31 pounds this offseason and is demonstrating much more athleticism.

Two-Sport Standout: Tabbed the team's emotional leader by his high school teammates freshman forward Elyjah Williams joins the Knights this season from Evanston High where he starred in both football and basketball for the Wildkits. With Williams serving as the team's tight end and defensive end, the Wildkits finished his senior football season in the state playoffs as Williams totaled 13 solo tackles, five assisted tackles, six catches for 195 yards and one touchdown, while blocking for a 1,100-yard rusher. In the winter, he proceeded to lead the Wildkits basketball team to a 28-4 record, a sectional championship and a regional championship.

Honors Court: Senior guard Mike Schrockback was named to the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) Honors Court over the summer, which recognizes the talents and gifts of student-athletes off the court and the hard work they exhibit in the classroom. In order to be named to the Honors Court, a student-athlete must be a junior or senior academically and possess a grade-point average of 3.2 or higher.

Who's Missing: The Knights will have plenty of shots to go around this season with the loss of Stephan Jiggetts, Earl Potts Jr. and Ghassan Nehme, who accounted for 34 percent of the team's field goal attempts last season. Jiggetts, who graduate transferred to South Florida logged 35.3 minutes per game last season and earned All-NEC Third Team honors, while Potts Jr. played 33.1 minutes per contest after earning the 2016 NEC Tournament Most Outstanding Player award.

Al LoBalbo Award: At this year's FDU Hall of Fame ceremony, hall of fame coach Bob Hurley was presented with the LoBalbo Award by Greg Herenda. Hurley coached basketball at St. Anthony High School in Jersey City, NJ from 1972-2017, building a local program into a national powerhouse along the way. Under Hurley's tenure, the Friars won 1,184 games and 28 state championships. Last season, the award was given to Jim Calhoun. The award is presented to a person who, like Coach Lo, has through selfless service, tireless dedication and education through sport made significant contributions that transcend competition for the betterment of athletics and all who are involved.

2016-17 SEASON IN REVIEW

<> Coming off of a 2016 NEC Championship, expectations were high last season for the 2016-17 Knights. The team returned four of its five starters and was selected a preseason No. 1 in the Northeast Conference Preseason Coaches' Poll.

<> After a difficult non-conference schedule, which included road tests at No. 22 Cincinnati, defending BIG EAST Champion Seton Hall and Ohio State, the Knights began conference play by winning eight of their first nine and appeared poised to secure a No. 1 seed in the NEC Tournament.

<> The team followed its blistering 8-1 start in NEC play by reversing course in the second half and closing the conference regular-season slate 1-8 and down the stretch resulting in a 9-9 mark and a No. 6 seed in the conference tournament. The 8-1 record to begin NEC play, matched the program's best start, which was achieved in the 1997-98 campaign.

<> In the opening round of the NEC Tournament, the Knights traveled to Staten Island, N.Y. to face third-seeded Wagner, where they had captured the NEC title one year prior. A tightly contested battle saw Darian Anderson nearly connect on a difficult, fadeaway, game-winning 3-pointer, which rimmed out for a 72-70 Wagner victory.

<> Injuries to key contributors resulted in the Knights using nine different starting lineups over the course of their 30 games. The team's season-opening projected starting lineup of Stephan Jiggetts, Darian Anderson, Ghassan Nehme, Earl Potts Jr. and Mike Holloway Jr. posted a 4-1 record but unfortunately for FDU, Potts and Nehme were limited by injuries for most of the season.

<> By earning the sixth seed in last year's NEC Tournament, the Knights qualified for back-to-back NEC Tournaments for the first time since the 2005-07. It's also the first time that the team has totaled double-digit victories in consecutive seasons since the 2007 campaign.

<> The Knights shot a robust 76.5 percent from the free throw line, which is a program-record and was the 20th-best rate in the nation last season. Sophomore guard Darnell Edge spearheaded the effort by converting 90.4 percent of his chances.

<> Anderson led the Knights with another banner year, which culminated in All-NEC Second Team 2017 NABC Division I All-District Second Team honors for the junior guard. The team's leading scorer at 17.0 points per game, Anderson also notched his 1,000th career point and enters the 2017-18 season 11th on the school's all-time scoring list (1,326 points) and third in steals (169).

<> Jiggetts broke out with career-highs across the board and garnered All-NEC Third Team honors. The junior point guard, who graduate transferred to University of South Florida in the offseason, started all 30 games, ranked second on the team with 13.5 points per game and dished out a team-high 4.2 assists per game. Jiggetts made his mark in the team's 90-72 victory over Lipscomb when he tallied the NEC's first triple-double (16p, 10r, 10a) since 2010.

<> Mike Holloway Jr. had himself another extremely efficient season as he shot 56.6 percent from the field, averaged 11.4 points and 6.3 rebounds. The Knights' big man increased his points and rebounds during his sophomore campaign and is a 57.4 percent shooter from the field across his first two seasons in Hackensack.

At FDU

Greg Herenda is in his fifth season at the helm of the Fairleigh Dickinson men's basketball program.

Last season, the Knights enjoyed their second consecutive .500 or better season in NEC play as Herenda led the team to a 9-9 conference mark and 11-19 overall. The team played a difficult non-conference slate facing off against Big Ten teams Ohio State and Rutgers along with other perennial powerhouses Cincinnati and Seton Hall.

The 2016-17 Knights featured two All-NEC selections in Darian Anderson (second team) and Stephan Jiggetts (third team). Additionally, Anderson garnered NABC District 18 Second Team honors.

In 2015-16, featuring the third-youngest roster in the nation, Herenda guided one of the biggest turnarounds in the NCAA. The Knights finished with an 18-15 overall record, captured the NEC Tournament title and earned a berth in the 2016 NCAA Tournament. The 18 victories marked a 10-win improvement from the previous season.

Furthermore, the 18 wins and 11 NEC victories are the most by an FDU squad since the 2005-06 season, while the NEC Tournament title and NCAA Tournament berths were the first for FDU since the 2005 season. Additionally, the team posted its first winning road record in 19 seasons.

Sophomores Darian Anderson and Earl Potts Jr. garnered Second Team All-NEC honors following the season, while freshman Mike Holloway earned a place on the NEC All-Rookie Team. Potts also became the second FDU player in Herenda's tenure to garner NEC Most Improved Player honors.

Under Herenda's guidance, the Knights have achieved tremendous success in the classroom. After earning the NEC Team GPA Award for the first time in program history in 2014-15, the Knights captured the award again last season. Additionally, the team's work in the classroom last season also resulted in the program's first National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) Team Academic Excellence Award.

Herenda was introduced as the seventh head coach in program history on Friday, April 26, 2013. He came to FDU after serving as the head coach at UMass Lowell from 2008-2013, where he posted a record of 95-56 (.629) en route to becoming the program's all-time winningest coach.

During his first year in Hackensack, Herenda returned the Knights to the Northeast Conference Tournament for the first time since 2010. He tripled FDU's conference win total during his first season and became the first head coach in the Garden State since December 1987 to defeat both Rutgers and Seton Hall in the same season. The only other coach to accomplish the feat was Pete Carril at Princeton.

Herenda also developed Sidney Sanders Jr. into the most improved player in the nation after the Knights' co-captain saw his scoring average rise from 4.6 points per game as a junior to 19.1 points per game, the second-highest increase in the NCAA. For his efforts, Sanders Jr. was FDU's first All-NEC First Team performer since 2007 and earned All-NABC and All-Met accolades. He was also the first FDU men's basketball player to earn the NEC Most Improved Player Award before Earl Potts Jr. received the honor in 2015-16.

In his second season, Herenda and the Knights opened with an upset victory at Saint Joseph's on a late basket by senior, and Philadelphia native, Mustafaa Jones. The team would follow with notable non-conference victories against intrastate rival Princeton and Colonial Athletic Association members Towson and Delaware.

Throughout Herenda's time at FDU he has maintained a strong relationship with the Boys and Girls Club of Hackensack/Lodi. He has also worked hard to develop relationships with alumni and in association with an alumni commitment he began the Revitalization of the Alumni Basketball Suite in the Rothman Center.

Off the court, Herenda developed and hosts The Greg Herenda Show on WFUDU which features premiere guests and sports personalities such as Hall of Fame Coaches Jim Calhoun and John Calipari, NFL coaches Bill Cowher and Dave Wannstedt, MLB Hall of Famers (Frank Thomas), former NBA players, and numerous other guests. The show, which airs on Saturdays at noon on WFUDU 89.1 FM, celebrated its three-year anniversary on September 7, 2017.

Prior To FDU

Herenda, who is a native of North Bergen, N.J. and played for legendary coach Jerome Halligan at St. Peter's Prep in Jersey City, N.J., has a coaching path that has taken him to the Big East, Conference USA, the Ivy League and the Patriot League though the years, and his teams have won multiple conference championships, as well as appearing in both the NCAA and NIT Tournaments.

In 2008, Herenda took over at UMass Lowell, inheriting a 12-win squad from the year before. In his first season, he was named the Northeast Conference-10 and NABC East Region Coach of the Year after leading the Division II school to a 21-8 record, which started a stretch of three straight 20-win seasons and four straight trips to the NCAA Tournament. During that time, Herenda led UMass Lowell to a NE-10 Tournament title in 2009-10, a semifinal appearance in 2010-11 and another championship game appearance in 2011-12.

Before leading UMass Lowell, Herenda was the head coach at Cabrini College for one season (2007-08), Division III school in Radnor, Pa. While coaching at Cabrini, Herenda doubled as a lead analyst and color commentator for YES Network's Ivy League basketball telecasts. Herenda started his head coaching career at Elgin Community College in Elgin, Ill., in 2006. He turned around a six-win team from the previous year into a squad that finished 18-11, won the Skyway Conference championship and reached the Region IV District B Junior College championship game for the first time in school history during his only season at the helm.

Bruce Hamburger enters his fifth season as the associate head coach for the Fairleigh Dickinson men's basketball program. In 2015-16, Hamburger helped guide the Knights to a 10-win turnaround as the team earned an NEC Championship and returned to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2005.

"Bruce brings an incredible amount of experience and expertise to our program," Herenda said. "I am very lucky to have a coach who has not only been on a Final Four bench, but has head coaching experience and ties to the entire state of New Jersey, which will prove to be a tremendous addition to my staff." Whose Quote?

"I am excited to join the FDU family, I look forward to working with Coach Herenda and the rest of the coaching staff and players, and making the FDU program successful," Hamburger said. "Having worked with Greg (Herenda) at Seton Hall, I know the passion and commitment that he will put into making the FDU program excel both on and off the court. I am eager to contribute any way I can."

Hamburger came to Hackensack via Jersey City after coaching at Saint Peter's from 2010-2013. While at St. Peter's, the team made the NCAA Tournament during his first year (2010-11). Hamburger's leadership resulted in the 10th team to make the NCAA Tournament in his 16 years as an assistant coach.

Prior to working at Saint Peter's, Hamburger was an assistant coach at Caldwell College, after spending two seasons as an assistant coach for the New York Liberty of the WNBA.

Along with his time at Caldwell and in the WNBA, Hamburger brings over 20 years of coaching experience to the Knights' staff. He served as the head coach at Kean University for 11 years, where he is the all-time winningest coach. Hamburger coached his alma mater to four appearances in the ECAC Tournament, winning the ECAC title in 2005, and advanced to the finals again in 2006. He also led Kean to an appearance in the New Jersey Athletic Conference Tournament in 2001.

Prior to coaching at Kean, Hamburger was an assistant coach at Seton Hall under P.J. Carlesimo for nine years, beginning in 1986. The Pirates won two Big East Tournament titles and made six appearances in the NCAA Tournament during his tenure, including the 1989 run to the NCAA championship game. The team was inducted into the Seton Hall Athletic Hall of Fame in June 2014.

Hamburger began his coaching career in 1984 at Trenton State, where he was an assistant coach under Kevin Bannon for two seasons.



PATRICK SELLERS

ASSISTANT COACH

Patrick Sellers joined the Fairleigh Dickinson men's basketball program as an assistant coach in October 2017. Sellers joins the Knights after spending two seasons as an assistant coach at DePaul as a member of head coach Dave Leitao's staff.

Prior to arriving at DePaul, Sellers served in the same capacity at fellow BIG EAST school Creighton. Prior to Creighton, Sellers made collegiate coaching stops at Central Connecticut State (1999-03), Massachusetts (2003-04), Connecticut (2004-10) and Hofstra (2011-13).

In his first season on the DePaul staff, Sellers helped the Blue Demons' development and registered a pair of wins over ranked opponents including No. 11 Providence and No. 20 George Washington. The win over GW was the largest margin of victory in program history by an unranked DePaul team over a ranked opponent. Off the court, the team placed an impressive 11 players on the BIG EAST All-Academic Team and was honored with the NABC's Team Academic Excellence Award. Individually, Eli Cain was named to the BIG EAST's All-Freshman Team.

In his two seasons in Omaha, Sellers helped the Bluejays transition into the BIG EAST Conference while the Bluejays lead the nation in three-pointers made, three-point percentage and assist/turnover ratio in his first season led by National Player of the Year – and current New York Knick – Doug McDermott.

Before his arrival in Omaha, Sellers spent the two seasons as an assistant coach at Hofstra. In his second season with the Pride, Sellers was named the program's interim head coach before accepting the position on the Creighton staff.

Sellers worked at Connecticut from 2004-10, where he was instrumental in recruiting players such as Jeremy Lamb, Tyler Olander, Shabazz Napier and Roscoe Smith who helped form the nucleus of the 2011 and 2014 national champions. His primary on-court responsibility was working with Connecticut's frontcourt, including future NBA players Hasheem Thabeet and Jeff Adrien.

Between his stints at Connecticut and Hofstra, Sellers spent one season in China as an assistant coach with Shanxi Zhongyu.

Prior to his time in Storrs, Sellers was an assistant coach for one season at Massachusetts (2003-04) and for four years at his alma mater, Central Connecticut State (1999-2003). While at CCSU, the Blue Devils made the NCAA Tournament in both 2000 and 2002, earning regular-season and tournament Northeast Conference titles in both years.

Sellers began his coaching career in the high school ranks at St. Thomas Aquinas in New Britain, Conn. He served as an assistant for three seasons before becoming head coach in 1997. His first team won a conference title, and both his teams would advance to the state tournament.

A native of South Carolina, Sellers played collegiately at Central Connecticut State, where he graduated in 1991 with a degree in accounting. Sellers was a team captain and named East Coast Conference Defensive Player of the Year in 1991 after leading the team in rebounding twice and finishing with 581 career rebounds.

Following college, Sellers played professionally in the British Basketball League for three seasons before returning to the U.S. to begin his coaching career.

ASSISTANT COACH

Pete Lappas enters his fourth season at Fairleigh Dickinson and his first as assistant coach for the Knights men's basketball program.

Prior to his promotion to the assistant role, Lappas served three seasons as the team's Director of Basketball Operations.

"I am extremely proud and happy to be able to promote Pete Lappas to be my next assistant coach here at Fairleigh Dickinson University," said head coach Greg Herenda. "From day one, Pete has put his entire heart and soul into our program and he truly deserves the opportunity to be on the court and out recruiting as much as anyone. This is a great day for Pete -- but an even better day for our basketball program."

Since joining the program prior to the 2014-15 season, Lappas has been a key contributor to the team's recent success, which includes a 2016 NEC Championship and NCAA Tournament appearance.

Lappas came to Fairleigh Dickinson after serving two years as a graduate assistant manager at Temple. During his first year in Philadelphia, the Owls finished 24-10 (11-5 Atlantic 10) and made the NCAA Tournament, where they defeated NC State, before falling to Indiana by four points in the third round. Lappas graduated from Temple last spring with a master's degree in Sport and Recreation Management.

A 2012 graduate of Boston College, with a Bachelor of Arts degree in Communications, Lappas has coached at some prestigious summer camps, including Jim Calhoun's camp at Connecticut, Gary Williams' camp at Maryland, Mike Rice's camp at Rutgers and Jay Wright's camp at Villanova.

An intern with the Philadelphia 76ers during the summer of 2011, Lappas has also worked as an administrative assistant at multiple Hoop Group camps as well as an assistant to camp directors at the Reebok All-American Camp.

Lappas is the son of Steve Lappas, who was the former head coach at Villanova (1992-2001) and Massachusetts (2001-05) and now current college basketball analyst for CBS Sports Network.

Upon his hire as the director of basketball operations in 2014, Herenda said, "Obviously he has been around college basketball his entire life, and I am very excited for Pete to start his career as part of my staff here at Fairleigh Dickinson University."

DIRECTOR OF BASKETBALL OPERATIONS

Head Coach Greg Herenda and the Fairleigh Dickinson men's basketball program formally announced the appointment of Darius Stokes as the team's Director of Basketball Operations in September of 2017.

Stokes, who played four seasons at the University of Iowa before graduate transferring to Fairleigh Dickinson for the 2014-15 season, rejoins the Knights now as a member of Herenda's staff.

"I am so proud and happy to have Darius join our staff," said Herenda. "Darius was an integral part of our rebuilding process as a student-athlete and now he will continue that tradition as a part of my staff. Darius exemplifies everything that our current players should look up to. He has his undergraduate degree and his masters and his coaching career is in front of him."

In addition to his college career, Stokes also played one season of professional basketball in Spain before returning to Iowa as an administrative assistant to the basketball program.

Upon his hire, Stokes' coach at Iowa, Fran McCaffrey said, "Darius is thrilled for the opportunity to join the basketball staff at FDU. He loved his playing experience and has tremendous respect for coach Herenda. He is smart, with an outstanding work ethic and I have no doubt that he will help bring many winning seasons to the FDU program."

In his graduate season with the Knights, the 6'7" forward started 28 of the team's 29 games averaging 3.1 points and 3.3 rebounds on 51.3 percent shooting.

Stokes, who graduated from Iowa with a degree in Health and Human Physiology and earned his Master's of Sports Administration at Fairleigh Dickinson, comes from a tremendous basketball family. His father Greg had a great career at Iowa and was drafted in the second round of the 1985 NBA draft by the Philadelphia 76ers. Stokes' sister Kiah was a three-time National Champion at UConn and is currently a member of the WNBA's New York Liberty.

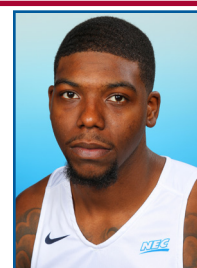

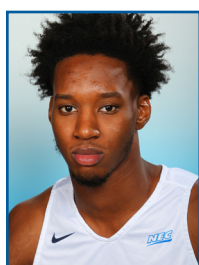
