Following a 10-day break for final exams, the Holy Cross men's basketball team returns to action when it plays host to Iona at 7:05 p.m. on Tuesday, Dec. 19. The game between the Crusaders and the Gaels will be televised live by Charter TV3 and the Patriot League Network, and can be heard live on WEEI 1440 AM in Worcester.

Holy Cross currently owns an overall record of 3-6 on the season. In their last outing, the Crusaders posted a 62-58 victory over New Hampshire to snap a six-game losing streak.

Freshman guard **Caleb Green** has led the team by averaging 11.3 points, 2.8 rebounds and 2.8 assists per game, while hitting 40.5 percent of his three-point field goal attempts. Junior forward **Karl Charles** is also off to a strong start this year, with averages of 11.0 points, 3.4 assists, 2.3 rebounds and 1.6 steals per contest. Junior forward **Jehyve Floyd** has added 10.7 points, 5.3 boards and 0.8 blocks per game, while junior guard **Patrick Benzan** is chipping in with 8.8 points, 3.4 rebounds, 2.4 assists and 1.4 steals per contest.

Iona has an overall record of 5-5 on the season. The Gaels had won four straight games before falling to St. John's 69-59 on Sunday at Madison Square Garden.

Junior guard Rickey McGill has led the team by averaging 13.2 points, 5.4 assists, 4.1 rebounds and 1.7 steals per game so far this season, while making 36.2 percent of his three-point attempts. Sophomore forward E.J. Crawford (12.5 points per game), senior guard Zach Lewis (11.6 points per game), senior guard Deyshonee Much (11.3 points per game) and senior forward T.K. Edogi (10.3 points per game) are also scoring in double figures for the Gaels.

After the contest with Iona, the Crusaders will travel to Siena for a 7:00 p.m. game on Friday, Dec. 22.

THE SERIES WITH IONA: This will be the 31st meeting between the Crusaders and the Gaels on the hardwood, with the all-time series tied at 15-15. The teams have played only three times since Holy Cross left the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference following the 1989-1990 season. The Crusaders won 68-55 in New Rochelle in 2003-2004 and 78-53 in Worcester in 2004-2005, while the Gaels posted a 71-59 victory at the Rainbow Classic in 2001-2002. From 1984-1990, Iona went 10-8 against Holy Cross when the schools were MAAC foes. For games played in Worcester, Holy Cross holds an 11-2 advantage, with seven straight wins. The schools first met on Dec. 20, 1974, with Holy Cross posting an 87-46 victory at the Worcester Auditorium.

FLOYD MAKES PRESENCE FELT DOWN LOW: Junior forward **Jehyve Floyd** has been the top player for the Crusaders in the post this season. In nine games played, he has averaged 10.7 points, 5.3 rebounds and 0.8 blocks while hitting 70.0 percent of his shots from the floor. In the victory over New Hampshire, Floyd posted nine points and a career-best nine rebounds. Previously at UMass, he led the team with 12 points and five rebounds. Floyd also played well against La Salle, totaling a career-high 15 points and six rebounds. A few of his other top games this year have come at Rhode Island (14 points and eight rebounds, while hitting six of eight field goal attempts), at Fairleigh Dickinson (13 points, seven rebounds, two assists and two blocks), against Harvard (11 points, three rebounds and two steals) and against Albany (10 points, four rebounds, three blocks). Last season, Floyd averaged 2.3 points, 1.6 rebounds and 0.8 blocked shots in 31 games played. Over the course of his collegiate career, he has totaled 250 points, 144 rebounds, 53 blocks, 45 assists and 34 steals, while hitting 63.2 percent of his field goal attempts (110 of 174).

CHARLES ENJOYING ANOTHER STELLAR SEASON: Junior forward **Karl Charles** is once again a key player for the Crusaders this year. In eight games played, he has averaged 11.0 points, 3.4 assists, 2.3 rebounds and 1.6 steals, while making 78.1 percent of his free throw attempts. In the victory over New Hampshire, Charles recorded 10 points, five assists, four rebounds and two steals. Previously against Albany, he posed 16 points and two assists. Earlier in the season, Charles also played well at Fairleigh Dickinson (17 points, four assists, three rebounds and three steals) and at Sacred Heart (23 points, four rebounds, three assists). Last year, he has averaged 9.4 points, 3.7 assists, 3.3 rebounds and 1.6 steals, while hitting 80.5 percent of his free throws and 37.5 percent of his three-pointers. During last season's victory at Army, Charles scored a career-high 24 points on eight of 10 shooting. Earlier last year against Lafayette, he totaled 20 points, five rebounds, four assists and three steals. As a freshmen, Charles was named to the Patriot League All-Rookie team after averaging 10.6 points, 4.2 rebounds, 2.5 assists, 1.1 steals and 0.5 blocks per game, while hitting 79.2 percent of his free throws. Over the course of his collegiate career, Charles has totaled 761 points, 269 rebounds, 230 assists and 101 steals with a .796 free throw percentage (250 of 314).

CRUSADERS AGAINST THE METRO ATLANTIC ATHLETIC CONFERENCE: Holy Cross has an all-time record of 105-82 against the 11 schools which currently compete in the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference. Since the beginning of the 2004-2005 season, the Crusaders are only 11-13 against MAAC foes. Holy Cross stands 13-6 all-time against Canisius, 22-19 vs. Fairfield, 15-15 against Iona, 21-10 vs. Manhattan, 5-2 against Marist, 0-1 vs. Monmouth, 8-7 against Niagara, 3-1 vs. Quinnipiac, 14-13 against St. Peter's and 4-8 vs. Siena. The Crusaders played in the MAAC for seven seasons from 1983-1990, posting a 52-48 record in conference action. Holy Cross' top season in the league came in 1989-1990, when it recorded a 14-2 mark to win the MAAC North Division title.

NEW HAMPSHIRE RECAP

Austin Butler scored a career-high 16 points to lead the Crusaders to a 62-58 victory over New Hampshire at the Hart Center at the Luth Athletic Complex on Dec. 9, 2017. Holy Cross played outstanding defense, holding the Wildcats to 32.8 percent shooting from the floor while forcing 14 turnovers. The Crusaders made 40.7 percent of their shots from the field on the offensive end, including 40.7 percent from three-point range. Caleb Green finished the day with 12 points and two assists, while Karl Charles added 10 points, five assists, four rebounds and two steals. Tanner Leissner led New Hampshire with 16 points and 15 rebounds. The game was close throughout a first half which featured two ties and six lead changes. Holy Cross was up 15-12 with 8:15 remaining before the break, when the Wildcats went on a 7-0 run to pull in front. The Crusaders responded by closing out the half with a 12-3 spurt to claim a 27-22 advantage heading into the locker room. Both teams struggled to score early in the second half, and Holy Cross led 31-28 with 14 minutes left to play. Butler then hit a three-pointer and converted a three-point play to give the Crusaders their biggest lead of the night (37-28) with 13 minutes to go. Holy Cross held onto a single-digit lead for several minutes, and was up 47-43 with 4:43 remaining. Butler hit three-pointers on each of the Crusaders' next two possessions to make the score 53-45, and a three-point play by Jehyve Floyd later put Holy Cross up 58-50 with 1:19 left. The Crusaders then held on for the win, despite making just four of eight free throws in the final minute.

GREEN STARTS CAREER STRONG: Freshman guard **Caleb Green** has become a key part of the Holy Cross backcourt this year. In nine games played, Green has averaged 11.3 points, 2.8 rebounds and 2.8 assists while hitting 40.5 percent of his three-point attempts. In the victory over New Hampshire, he totaled 12 points and two assists. Previously at Fairleigh Dickinson, Green led the team with a career-high 22 points, two rebounds, two assists and two steals. He also played well at Rhode Island, posting a double-double with 14 points, a career-high 11 assists and five rebounds. A few of Green's other top games this season have come against Sacred Heart (12 points, three rebounds, two assists), Harvard (12 points, two rebounds), Manhattan (11 points, three rebounds, two steals) and UMass (10 points, three rebounds, two assists). His 12 points against Sacred Heart in the season opener were the most by a Crusader in his collegiate debut since Cullen Hamilton scored 15 points at Old Dominion on Nov. 9, 2012. Green came to Holy Cross from Proctor Academy in Andover, N.H., where he was two-time second team Class AA All-New England selection and scored over 1,000 career points.

CARMODY LEADS THE CRUSADERS: Bill Carmody is in his third season as the head men's basketball coach at Holy Cross in 2016-2017, with an overall record of 33-43. He owns a career record of 317-288, after earning his 300th career victory with a 63-52 win at Harvard on Nov. 22, 2016. In 2015-2016, Carmody led the Crusaders to their first Patriot League Tournament title since 2007 and their first NCAA Tournament victory since 1953. The 17th head coach in the history of the program, he has 35 years of Division I coaching experience, including 20 seasons as a head coach (with 13 years at Northwestern and four seasons at Princeton). Carmody has led his teams to nine postseason tournament appearances — three trips to the NCAA Tournament and six trips to the National Invitation Tournament.

HOLY CROSS STAYS STRONG ON DEFENSE: The Crusaders are once again among the top defensive teams in the Patriot League this year. Through nine games played, they have held their opponents to 70.7 points per contest on 45.5 percent shooting from the field, while forcing 13.9 turnovers per game. Holy Cross has been particularly tough over its last three games, allowing just 60.0 points per contest on 35.7 percent shooting during that stretch. Last year, the Crusaders limited their opponents to just 62.1 points per game overall and 61.3 points per contest in Patriot League regular season play.

Kevin Hamilton totaled 24 points, five steals and three assists to lead Holy Cross to a 78-53 victory over Iona at the DCU Center on Jan. 18, 2005. The Crusaders opened the game with a 4-0 lead, and gradually built up the advantage to 15 points with three minutes remaining in the first half. Iona cut the lead to 13 points (35-22) at the break, and scored the on its first shot of the second half to make it an 11-point game. But Holy Cross then went on an 11-2 run to take control, and led by at least 19 points the rest of the way. The Crusaders extended the lead to as many as 32 points, before finally winning by 25. Hamilton made seven of 11 shots on the day, including five of eight from three-point range, in addition to connecting on all five of his free throw attempts. Keith Simmons added 14 points while hitting four of five three-pointers, while Kevin Hyland had 12 points on four of five shooting from

the floor. Pat Doherty, starting for the first time in his collegiate career, added seven points and eight assists. As a team, Holy Cross made 12 of 19 three-point attempts (63.2 percent). The Crusaders also totaled 18 steals, while forcing the Gaels into 24 turnovers. Iona was led by Greg Jenkins with 16 points, while Steve Burt added 11 points.

PROTECTING THE BALL: Holy Cross has done an excellent job of protecting the ball so far this year. The Crusaders have turned the ball over just 110 times in nine games played, for an average of 12.2 turnovers per contest. Holy Cross has posted single-digit turnovers three times this year, with a season-low of seven against New Hampshire. This should come as no surprise, as the Crusaders have had the fewest turnovers per game in the Patriot League in each of the last three seasons (11.0 in 2016-2017; 11.0 in 2015-2016; 10.9 in 2014-2015). In 2014-2015, Holy Cross set a school single-season record for the fewest turnovers per game.

CRUSADERS HEAT UP ON OFFENSE: Holy Cross has shot the ball well so far this season, making 45.4 percent of its field goal attempts overall (212 of 467). The Crusaders have connected on 50 percent of their shots from the floor in a game twice so far this year. Holy Cross hit 28 of 56 field goal attempts in the victory over Harvard, while making 24 of 48 shots in the Albany game. The last time the Crusaders made over 45 percent of their field goal attempts for an entire season came during the 2002-2003 campaign (46.2 percent, 759 of 1643).

HART IS WHERE THE HOME IS: Holy Cross currently owns an all-time record of 375-157 at the Hart Center at the Luth Athletic Complex, including a 2-1 mark so far this season. The Crusaders posted their 300th win in the building against Sacred Heart on Nov. 14, 2008. Holy Cross had a 23-game winning streak at the Hart Center from Feb. 15, 2006-Jan. 2, 2008, which was the longest streak in the history of the building and the sixth-longest home court winning streak in the nation at the time. In 2006-2007 the Crusaders posted a perfect 14-0 mark at the Hart Center, setting a school record for the most home victories since they moved into the building. During the Hart Center's history, Holy Cross has posted a winning record at home in 36 out of 42 seasons, while recording double-figure home victories 18 times. The Crusaders stand 161-65 at home since the beginning of the 2000-2001 season, including a 104-37 record against Patriot League foes.

BENZAN PLAYS KEY MINUTES IN BACKCOURT: Junior guard **Patrick Benzan** is one of the leaders in the Holy Cross backcourt this year. In nine games played, Benzan has averaged 8.8 points, 3.4 rebounds, 2.4 assists and 1.4 steals per contest, while making 47.6 percent of his shots from the floor. During the La Salle game, he totaled 13 points, five rebounds and two assists. Previously against Albany, Benzan recorded 13 points and two rebounds. A few of his other top games this season have come against Harvard (career-high 18 points, seven rebounds, three assists, three steals) and Sacred Heart (14 points, three rebounds, two assists). In 2016-2017, Benzan averaged 7.6 points, 2.5 rebounds, 2.4 assists and 1.4 steals per game, while hitting 51.4 percent of his field goal attempts. During last year's game at Army, Benzan totaled 16 points, eight assists, five rebounds and three steals. He also played well at Bucknell last season, recording 15 points, three rebounds and two steals. Over the course of his collegiate career, Benzan has now totaled 344 points, 134 rebounds, 112 assists and 63 steals.

TRADITION OF EXCELLENCE: This year marks the 98th season of Holy Cross men's basketball. The Crusaders own an overall record of 1,393-975, while making 26 postseason tournament appearances — 13 trips to the NCAA Tournament, 12 to the National Invitation Tournament and one to the CollegeInsider.com Tournament. In the history of collegiate basketball, Holy Cross is one of only 16 schools to have won the NCAA Tournament (1946-1947) as well as the National Invitational Tournament (1953-1954). Throughout its history, Holy Cross has had six first team All-America selections, sent 10 players to the National Basketball Association, had four players and coaches inducted into the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame, had 23 players drafted by professional teams, had three players go on to coach professionally and had 15 players who have coached in college.

CRUSADERS KEEP FORCING TURNOVERS: In nine games played so far this year, Holy Cross has forced its opponents to commit an average of 13.9 turnovers per contest. During the victory over Harvard, the Crusaders forced 23 turnovers. Previously at Sacred Heart, Holy Cross caused the Pioneers to give the ball away 20 times. That marked the first time the Crusaders forced at least 20 turnovers in back-to-back games since they accomplished the feat against Harvard (24 turnovers) and Brown (23 turnovers) in the first two games of the 2014-2015 season. Last year, Holy Cross led the Patriot League and ranked 20th in the nation by forcing 15.9 turnovers per game.

IN THE RECORD BOOKS: Junior forward **Karl Charles** is presently ranked among Holy Cross' all-time leaders in two statistical categories. Charles currently stands eighth in career average minutes played (29.8) and eighth in career free throw percentage (.796, 250 of 314).

CRUSADERS LOOKING FOR SIXTH PATRIOT LEAGUE REGULAR SEASON TITLE:

During the 2017-2018 campaign, Holy Cross will attempt to win the Patriot League regular season title for the sixth time in school history. The last championship for the Crusaders came in 2006-2007, when they tied for first place in the conference with Bucknell, as both teams posted 13-1 records in league play. Prior to that, Holy Cross won outright Patriot League regular season titles in 2001, 2003 and 2005, while sharing the regular season championship in 1994. The Crusaders' five total championships are tied for the second-most in conference history with Navy (one outright, four shared), behind only Bucknell (eight outright, three shared).

HOLY CROSS IN THE NCAA STATISTICS: The Crusaders are currently ranked among the NCAA Division I leaders in fewest turnovers and turnover margin, through games of Dec. 16. In addition, junior forward **Karl Charles** stand among the best in the nation in steals. The rankings:

CRUSADERS PICKED EIGHTH IN PRESEASON POLL: In the 2017-2018 Patriot League preseason poll, Holy Cross was picked to finish in eighth place in voting by the conference's head coaches and sports information directors. The Crusaders received 48 total points in the conference preseason poll. Bucknell placed first in the poll, with 162 total points and 18 first-place votes, followed by Boston University in second with 141 points and two first-place votes, and Navy in third with 120 points. Lehigh placed fourth with 108 points, while Colgate was fifth (104 points), Loyola (Md.) was sixth (78 points) and Army West Point was seventh (66 points). The preseason rankings were rounded out by American (ninth, 39 points) and Lafayette (10th, 27 points).

DRIBBLES: Freshman guard **Austin Butler** led the team with a career-high 16 points during the victory over New Hampshire. He previously posted 10 points, two rebounds and two assists in the win over Harvard, and is now averaging 5.3 points and 1.4 rebounds per game ... Junior guard **Matt Zignorski** scored 10 points on three-of-four shooting from three-point range during the Rhode Island game, then made his first career start against New Hampshire. On the season, he is currently averaging 3.4 points per game ... Freshman forward **Connor Niego** tallied nine points and two rebounds at Rhode Island in the first appearance of his collegiate career. On the year, he has averaged 4.3 points and 3.3 boards ... Freshman forward **Matt Faw** scored a career-high 12 points during the victory over Harvard, while hitting five of seven field goal attempts. He is averaging 4.8 points and 1.4 rebounds on the season ... Freshman forward **Jacob Grandison** had nine points and three assists against Albany, then posted nine points, two rebounds and two assists at UMass. He is averaging 5.3 points and 2.4 boards per game this year ... With the 69-64 victory at Sacred Heart, Holy Cross improved to 69-30 all-time in season openers ... In the latest NCAA Graduation Success Rate Report, for the four-class aggregate of entering classes from 2007 through 2010, the Crusader men's basketball team posted a perfect 100 percent graduation rate. Holy Cross' overall Graduation Success Rate for all student-athletes was 97 percent, tied for the 14th-best mark among all Division I schools ... Holy Cross has received an NCAA Academic Progress Rate Public Recognition Award in each of the last 12 seasons, for having a multi-year APR in the top 10 percent of all Division I men's basketball teams in the nation.
