ON THE AIR: Dean Darling (play-by-play), Steve Eggink (color), and Ed Weir (sideline) have the call on the Red Fox Network.

LAST TIME OUT: Marist suffered a 73-67 home loss to Canisius on Friday, Feb. 2. The Red Foxes led by 11 in the second half, but the Golden Griffins went on to outscore the Red Foxes 43-33 over the final 20 minutes. **Brian Parker** led Marist with 19 points and 11 rebounds. The Red Foxes committed 24 turnovers, allowed 19 offensive rebounds, and shot 7-for-14 from the free-throw line.

THE OPPONENT: Iona is coming off an 87-82 home victory over Quinnipiac in double overtime on Friday, Feb. 2. **Rickey McGill** leads the Gaels in scoring (14.5 ppg). Iona leads the MAAC in three-pointers per game, three-point percentage, free-throw percentage, and assist-to-turnover ratio. Head coach **Tim Cluess** has led Iona to postseason play in all of his first seven seasons.

WHAT'S NEXT: Marist begins a stretch of four out of six on the road to close the regular season on Thursday, Feb. 8 at Saint Peter's. Tip-off is scheduled for 7 p.m..

Today's Top Tidbits

In 13 of the last 14 Marist-Iona games, the winning team has scored at least 80 points. ... **Brian Parker** now has 1,245 career points, which ranks 14th in program history. Next in 13th place is **Joe Scott** (1,283 points). ... Parker ranks fourth in the MAAC in scoring (18.0 ppg) and eighth in the MAAC in field-goal percentage (.485). He and Rider's **Dimencio Vaughn** are the only two players in the MAAC who rank in the conference's top 10 in scoring and field-goal percentage. ... Marist and Iona are the MAAC's only two teams to have a second-half lead in all of their conference games this season.

Head Coach Mike Maker
Fourth Season
California Baptist/1988
Career Record: 174-122
Record at Marist: 27-90

Mike Maker was hired as the 11th head coach in Marist men's basketball history on June 17, 2014. The 2017-18 season will be his fourth at Marist.

In the 2016-17 season, Khallid Hart earned Second Team All-MAAC honors as he finished his career as the fourth-leading scorer in program history. Ryan Funk established himself as one of the MAAC's top shooters as he averaged over 12 points per game, more than double the previous season. Marist finished 8-24 overall and 5-15 in the MAAC.

In the 2015-16 season, Maker's first recruiting class took shape as freshmen accounted for over 50 percent of the team's points, minutes played, and starts. Freshman guard Brian Parker set the program's Division I record for freshman points, and his .514 field-goal percentage was the highest of any freshman in the country. Parker was named to the MAAC All-Rookie Team. Khallid Hart was named Second Team All-MAAC and ranked 25th in the nation in scoring. Marist went 7-23 overall, and 4-16 in MAAC play.

In Maker's first season at Marist, the Red Foxes went 7-25 overall and 5-15 in MAAC play while having to overcome numerous injuries. Marist went 6-7 from Jan. 25 until the end of the season, swept the Niagara-Canisius trip for the first time in the program's 18 years in the conference, had a four-game winning streak, and defeated Quinnipiac in the opening round of the MAAC Championships. Under Maker's guidance, Chavaughn Lewis became the school's all-time leading scorer with 2,119 career points, and earned an invitation to the Philadelphia 76ers' Summer League team. Lewis was a Second Team All-MAAC selection.

In his previous position, Maker posted an impressive record of 147-32 (.821) in six years as head coach of Williams College. During his tenure at Williams, the Ephs reached the Final Four on three occasions, including two berths in the Division III national championship game. His 16 NCAA Tournament victories at Williams are a school record.

Maker led Williams to a berth in the 2014 Division III national championship game for the second time in five seasons. The Ephs posted an overall record of 28-5, and ranked in the nation's top 10 in seven statistical categories.

At Williams, Maker won at least 17 games in all six seasons, and won at least 26 games four times. In 2010, the Ephs reached the Division III national championship game, finished 30-2, set a school record with 21 straight wins and led the nation in four statistical categories. That season, Maker was named Basketball Times Co-National Coach of the Year, D3hoops.com Northeast Region Coach of the Year and NESCAC Coach of the Year.

Following a second straight trip to the Final Four in 2011, Maker was a finalist for Glenn Robinson Division III Coach

of the Year. In 2013, he was named D3hoops.com Northeast Region Coach of the Year, and was a finalist for Glenn Robinson Division III Coach of the Year after an Elite Eight appearance.

This is Maker's 29th season in the coaching ranks. He arrived at Marist with 26 years of coaching experience, including 17 as an assistant at the Division I level. Prior to becoming head coach at Williams, Maker worked under current Oregon head coach Dana Altman at Creighton in the 2007-08 season, during which the Bluejays reached the second round of the NIT.

Maker served as an assistant at West Virginia under head coach John Beilein from 2005-07. The Mountaineers reached the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament in 2006, and won the Postseason NIT in 2007. West Virginia posted a record of 49-20 in his two seasons there.

Prior to his arrival at West Virginia, Maker had a three-year stint as assistant coach at Samford (2002-05) under head coach Jimmy Tillette. His first Division I coaching position came at Dartmouth, where he spent 11 seasons (1991-2002), where he earned the title of associate head coach, and served as the program's recruiting coordinator and director of scouting.

Maker's first head coaching position came during the 1990-91 season, when he guided the Hartnell College women's basketball program. He started his coaching career as assistant coach and head junior varsity coach at his alma mater, California Baptist, from 1988-90.

A native of Salinas, Calif., Maker is a member of the North Salinas High School Hall of Fame. He began his collegiate playing career at Hartnell College (1984-86), where he was a two-year captain, an honorable mention all-conference selection and earned an associate of arts degree in general education. He then played at California Baptist College (1986-88), where he was also a two-year captain and earned Academic All-America honors. Maker graduated Magna Cum Laude with a Bachelor of Science degree in Physical Education from California Baptist in 1988, and earned a Master of Arts degree in Education from Azusa Pacific University in 1990. Maker and his wife Erica are the parents of a five-year-old son, Jack.

History vs. Iona

- Iona leads the all-time series, 46-16.
- Iona has defeated Marist eight straight times overall, and also eight straight times at McCann Arena.
- In 13 of the last 14 meetings, the winning team has scored at least 80 points.

Parker's Production

- Junior guard **Brian Parker** scored his 1,000th career point in his 69th career game on Dec. 9 vs. Stetson. Parker now has 1,245 career points, which ranks 14th all-time in program history. Next on the list in 13th place is **Joe Scott** (1,283 points).
- Parker became the 31st player to score his 1,000th career point in a Marist uniform. Prior to Parker, the most recent was **Khallid Hart** on Jan. 2, 2016.
- Parker scored a career-high 33 points against Manhattan on Jan. 2 for the second 30-point game of his career. It was the highest single-game total by a Red Fox since **Khallid Hart** scored 36 at Rider on Jan. 14, 2016.
- Parker has led Marist in scoring 14 times this season.
- In Parker's last nine games, he is shooting 13-for-24 (.542) from three-point range.
- Parker leads the Red Foxes in scoring (18.0 ppg) and assists (2.7 apg), and is second in rebounds (5.1 rpg). The last two years, Parker led the team in rebounds and assists, and was second in scoring.
- Parker ranks fourth in the MAAC in scoring, eighth in the MAAC in field-goal percentage (.485), and tied for ninth in the conference in defensive rebounding (4.3 per game).
- Parker and Rider's **Dimencio Vaughn** are the only two players in the MAAC who rank in the conference's top 10 in scoring and field-goal percentage.
- Parker had 19 points and a season-high 11 rebounds against Canisius on Feb. 2 for his first double-double of the season. He has eight career double-doubles.

Knudsen's Contributions

- Junior guard **David Knudsen** has raised his scoring average 7.6 points per game from last season. He is averaging 11.9 points per game this season after averaging 4.3 as both a freshman and sophomore.
- Knudsen leads Marist in free-throw percentage (.894) and steals (24). He is second in made three-pointers (46), assists (46), and scoring (11.9 ppg).
- Knudsen scored a career-high 28 points against Manhattan on Jan. 2.
- Knudsen was named MAAC Male Student-Athlete of the Week on Jan. 2, and was named the Marist Center for Student-Athlete Enhancement's Male Student-Athlete of the Month for February. He is a Business Administration major with a concentration in International Business and minor in Communication.

Funk From Downtown

- Junior forward **Ryan Funk** leads Marist in three-point percentage (.410) and three-pointers made (55), and is third in scoring (11.1 ppg).
- In Marist's wins this season, Funk is shooting .513 (20-for-39) from three-point range and averaging 15.6 points per game.
- Funk is shooting .464 (32-for-69) from three at McCann Arena this season.
- Funk hit the game-winning three with 0.8 seconds left at Manhattan on Jan. 30.
- Funk scored a season-high 23 points against Quinnipiac on Jan. 26, which tied a career high (also against Quinnipiac on Dec. 4, 2016).
- Funk scored 10 of the team's 15 overtime points against Fairfield on Jan. 13.
- Funk went on a personal 12-0 run against in the second half against Siena on Dec. 29, breaking open a tie game and giving Marist the lead for good.
- Funk has made 163 career three-pointers, which is tied for eighth place all-time in program history.
- Funk drained a team-high 81 three-pointers last season, which is tied for the fifth-highest single-season total in program history.

Sjoberg Steps Up

- Sophomore center Tobias Sjoberg had 13 rebounds (the highest single-game total by a Red Fox this season) and 11 points at Quinnipiac on Jan. 10.
- Sjoberg has team highs of three double-digit rebounding games and two double-doubles this season.
- Sjoberg is the only Red Fox to start all of the team's games this season.
- Sjoberg is eighth in the MAAC at 1.0 blocks per game.

- Freshman guard **Austin Williams** had the first two double-digit scoring efforts of his career in two recent outings. Williams scored 14 points at Quinnipiac on Jan. 10, and 23 against Fairfield on Jan. 13. He also set career highs in rebounds (six) and assists (five) against the Stags.
- In those two contests, Williams shot 14-for-19 (.737) from the field.
- In his last eight games, Williams is averaging 9.9 points.
- Williams has led Marist in rebounding five times this season, with a season-high seven against Monmouth on Jan. 27.

Lamb Shines Off Bench

- Junior forward **Isaiah Lamb** has given Marist nine double-digit scoring efforts off the bench this season, with a career-high 28 at Brown on Dec. 22.
- In his career, Lamb has averaged 6.5 points in 41 games as a starter with 12 double-digit scoring games, and 8.4 points in 43 games as a reserve with 17 double-digit scoring games.

Do-It-All Dozic

- Red-shirt sophomore forward **Aleksandar Dozic** is averaging 11.0 points in his last four games, and has started Marist's last three contests.
- Dozic has two 11-rebound games, and one double-double this season.

Gummerus Contributes As Freshman

- Freshman forward **Lasse Gummerus** is shooting .350 from deep this season.
- Gummerus scored a career-high 10 points against Army West Point on Dec. 2.

- Senior center **Connor McClenaghan** set a career high with nine points against Fairfield on Jan. 13, shooting 4-for-5 from the field.

- Coach Maker on Nedrow: "Luke is an exceptional student, a natural leader, and mature beyond his years. He combines toughness, and a versatile skill set that will enable him to thrive as a point forward in our hybrid Princeton offense."
