What You Need To Know

- Rider and Iona are meeting for the 62nd time, with IC owning a 36-25 lead in the all-time series. Iona won 2-of-3 last season, including the MAAC Quarters.
- Anthony Durham has stepped up of late, hitting 20 of his last 23 attempts from inside the three-point arc. He also dished out a career-high seven assists vs. QU.
- The Rider defense came up big in a 99-76 win at Niagara on Dec. 31, holding the league's top two scorers (Matt Scott - 23.6 ppg., Kahlil Dukes - 21.8 ppg. entering the game) to a combined 18 points.
- Frederick Scott was named to the Lou Henson mid-season Watch List. The Lou Henson Award is presented to the nation's top Division I mid-major player.
- Rider shot 50 percent or better in three-straight 52.0 percent (39-75) on Dec. 31 at Niagara, 50.0 percent (32-64) Jan. 5 vs. Fairfield and a season-high 53.0 percent (35-66) Jan. 7 at Manhattan, before shooting 48.5 percent (33-68) against Ouinnipiac on Jan. 12.
- Frederick Scott hit the game-winning three-pointer at the buzzer to cap a comeback from down 10 in the second half at Penn State.
- Stevie Jordan has been solid all-around (14.1 ppg, 6.8 apg, 4.3 rpg and 2.2 spg).
- RU and IC each lost to Canisius consecutive for their lone MAAC setbacks.
- The Gaels are led by Rickey McGill, whose 14.0 points and 4.8 assists per game are both team highs. Deyshonee Much has added 12.2 points per game, while E.J. Crawford also averages in double figures at 11.6 points per game.
- Sixth-year Head Coach Kevin Baggett's teams have posted a 96-85 record and reached the MAAC Quarterfinals in each of his first five seasons. Baggett was the 2015 MAAC Coach of the Year.

SCOUTING THE IONA GAELS

The Gaels are led by Rickey McGill, whose 14.0 points and 4.8 assists per game are both team highs. Deyshonee Much (12.2 ppg.) and E.J. Crawford (11.6 ppg.) have also averaged in double figures, while Zach Lewis (9.1 ppg.), TK Edogi (9.0 ppg.), Roland Griffin (8.6 ppg.) and Schadrac Casimir (8.1 ppg.) aren't far off. Edogi has also grabbed a team-best 7.6 rebounds per game, while shooting 55.8 percent.

ALL-TIME SERIES VS. IONA

Rider and Iona are meeting for the 62nd time, with the Gaels owning a 36-25 lead in the all-time series. The two teams have split the last two regular season series. However, the Gaels won last season's rubber match in the MAAC Quarterfinals en route to their second-straight NCAA Tournament berth.

FREDDY OFF THE BENCH

Since being utilized off the bench in the last seven games, Frederick Scott is averaging 18.4 points and 8.9 rebounds, shooting 65.7 percent (46-70) from the floor and 47.8 percent (11-23) from long range in 24.3 minutes per game. He was named MAAC Player of the Week on Jan. 8, hit the game-winning three-pointer at the buzzer to beat Penn State on Dec. 22 and has two double-doubles in the span. He scored a career-high 25 points on Jan. 5 against Fairfield.

DEPENDABLE DURHAM

Over an eight-game stretch from Dec. 9-Jan. 12, Anthony Durham has made 20 of his last 23 field-goal attempts (87.0%) from inside the three-point arc, including the last 12. Overall, he's hit 25-of-40 attempts (5-17 3ptFG) in the span.

PAINT PRODUCTION

Rider outscored Manhattan, 58-20, in the paint on Jan. 7, including a 16-0 edge in fast-break points. The paint production came within the flow of the offense, as Manhattan held a 19-16 edge in second-chance points.

FINISHING STRONG

Rider trailed by 11 points on five occasions in the second half against Manhattan on Jan. 7, including the last with 12:15 remaining. But the Broncs whittled away at the deficit and outscored Manhattan, 15-5, in the final four minutes to take an 82-76 victory. Rider shot 64.9 percent (24-37) in the second half, its second-highest percentage in a single period this season (11/24 vs. Hampton - .680 [17-25]). For the game, Rider shot a season-best 53.0 percent (35-66).

Free. Ready. Easy. Determined.

In a season of clutch shots, Frederick Scott started early on Jan. 5 against Fairfield, knocking down seven of his first eight attempts, including his first five three-point attempts. He finished the game with a career-high 25 points on 8-of-11 shooting, including 5-of-7 from long range, and grabbed a team-high eight rebounds in 25 minutes off the bench.

FIVE IN DOUBLE FIGURES

Despite having five players averaging in double figures, Rider had five players score in double figures in a single game for the just the third time this season in a 96-77 victory over Fairfield on Jan. 5. Frederick Scott led the way with 25, while Stevie Jordan (18), Dimencio Vaughn (14), Jordan Allen (10) and Anthony Durham (10) also scored in double digits. The prior two instances of five Broncs in double figures came in a pair of victories over Hampton.





NEEDLING NELSON

Though MAAC Preseason Player of the Year Tyler Nelson scored at his season average of 21 on Jan. 5, the Broncs forced him into seven turnovers. Rider utilized a 32-8 edge in points off turnovers to win, 96-77.

BRONCS PUT UP THEIR DUKES, GET AWAY SCOTT FREE

Rider effectively shut down the MAAC's top scoring duo in Matt Scott (23.6 ppg. entering the game) and Kahlil Dukes (21.8 ppg.) in a 99-76 road win on Dec. 31. The duo combined to make just 4-of-22 shots for 18 points. Scott (0-9 FG) was held without a field goal for the first time since Dec. 30, 2015, following 64-straight with a conversion, and scored just five points (5-7 FT).

SHOOTING STARS

The Broncs shot a then-season-high 52.0 percent (39-75) from the floor and outscored Niagara, 56-24, in the paint on Dec. 31. Tyere Marshall (7-12) and Frederick Scott (6-9) led the effort, while Anthony Durham (3-3), Karamoko Cisse (3-3) and Tyrei Randall (2-3) were extremely accurate. Jordan Allen also made 7-of-15 attempts. In the rare event of a miss, the Broncs grabbed 19 offensive rebounds and outscored the Purple Eagles, 23-7, on second chances.

INSIDE FOR TWO

Rider big men Frederick Scott and Tyere Marshall both compiled double-doubles on Dec. 29 at Canisius. Scott had team highs of 19 points and 12 rebounds off the bench, while Marshall went for 13 points and 11 rebounds. It was the second time this season the duo had compiled double-doubles in the same game (Nov. 10 vs. Hampton). Scott and Marshall would post double-doubles for the third time in the same game on Jan. 7 at Manhattan.

BRONCS AT THE BUZZER

Rider took a 71-70 victory on Dec. 22 at Penn State on Frederick Scott's buzzer-beating three-pointer. The Broncs trailed by as many 10 points in the second half and took the lead with 1:23 left on two Scott free throws. Again trailing by four with 22 seconds left, Stevie Jordan made a floater with 14 seconds remaining and, following a pair of missed Penn State free throws, Scott hit a right-wing three as time expired for the win. The play earned the No. 7 spot on the SportsCenter Top 10. The win was Rider's first over a high major since Nov. 17, 2010, at the University of Southern California and the first over a Big 10 squad since Rider defeated the same Nittany Lions on Nov. 23, 2007. Scott has been clutch several times this season, also hitting the game-winner at George Washington and scoring nine of his 21 points in overtime vs. Wagner.

STEVIE AMONG FASTEST TO 500

Stevie Jordan scored his 500th career point in his 40th game, Dec. 22 at Penn State, becoming the third-fastest Bronc to the plateau over the last 25 years (as far back as full game-by-game records are available). Charles Smith achieved the feat in 30 games as a freshman in 1993-94, followed by Jerry Johnson's 32 games covering his freshman and sophomore years of 2001-02 and 2002-03. The next Broncs on the list are Greg Burston, Novar Gadson and Jimmie Taylor, all of whom reached 500 in their 44th games.

OK WITH OT

With the Broncs' 90-84 overtime win over Wagner on Dec. 16, Rider has now won its last eight overtime contests and nine of 10 under Head Coach Kevin Baggett. The eight-game overtime winning streak began Jan. 26, 2014, with a home win over Monmouth.

WAGNER AWAKENING

The Broncs snapped a four-game losing skid, Dec. 16 against Wagner, which entered the game ranked No. 40 in the RPI. A rollercoaster game, the Broncs led by as many as 12 in the first half and nine at halftime, but found themselves trailing by five with just over two minutes left in regulation. Two Frederick Scott free throws tied the game with 5.4 seconds left in regulation, before the redshirt freshman scored nine of his team-high 21 points in overtime to push Rider to a 90-84 victory.

ALLEN ALL IN

Jordan Allen scored in double figures in each of his first 10 collegiate games and hit at least two three-point field goals in the first 12 games this year. Included in his production was a season-high 28 points at Providence on Nov. 29. He was named MAAC Rookie of the Week consecutively on Nov. 20, 27 and Dec. 4.

BRONCS BALL SECURITY

The Broncs took great care of the basketball in their first six games, registering more assists than turnovers in all six contests for a total of 90 assists to 63 turnovers (1.43 A/TO ratio) and a 5-1 record. In the following four-game losing streak, Rider totaled more turnovers than assists in three of four games, with 60 turnovers to 54 assists in that time. All told, Rider is 11-3 this season when committing fewer turnovers than the opposition.

SECOND HALF SUPERSTARS

The Broncs have scored 50 or more points in the second half in six games this season. Rider scored 54 points in the second half against Hampton in the season opener before again hanging 53 on the Pirates on Nov. 24. The Broncs also scored another 53 in the second half against Hartford and Providence and 50 against UC Irvine. On Dec. 31, Rider scored a season-high 57 second-half points. Conversely, Rider didn't score 50 in the first half until its 15th game.

DIDN'T MISS A BEAT

Stevie Jordan missed the Dec. 6 contest at Robert Morris due to injury, but showed no signs of rust three days later against Hofstra. Jordan went for 19 points on 7-of-11 shooting with a career-high six steals and five assists.

BUZZER BEATERS

Rider made a field goal in the final seven seconds of the first half in seven of its first nine games and scored on all nine of its final possessions of the first half in that span. On two occasions, the bucket tied the game, while a third cut the Broncs' deficit to one. The streak ended in the 10th game against Hofstra.

MARSHALL MANS UP

Tyere Marshall posted back-to-back career-high scoring performances on Nov. 29 at Providence and Dec. 2 at Drexel. He scored 16 points and grabbed seven rebounds at Providence before fouling out with just under four minutes left. He made 6-of-8 field-goal attempts and all four of his free-throw attempts. Marshall then scored 20 of his 23 points in the second half at Drexel, hitting 11-of-13 attempts for the game and his only free-throw attempt. He also completed a double-double with 12 boards. He's seen marked improvement from the free-throw line, needing 19 fewer attempts to achieve his season total of conversions from last year (16-44 in 2016-17; 16-23 in 2017-18).

AND 1

At 5-1, Rider was off to its best start to a season since 1997-98, when the Broncs began the year at 8-1. Similarly, Rider's lone loss in the span took place in Ohio, with the Broncs falling to the Michael Redd-led Ohio State Buckeyes.





UPPER DIVISION CHAMPS

Rider won a pair of games on Thanksgiving Day and Black Friday against UC Irvine and Hampton, respectively, to earn the Las Vegas Invitational Upper Division Championship. Jordan Allen averaged 20.5 points per game, while shooting 46.7 percent (14-30) from the floor and 43.8 percent (7-of-16) from long range in the two games to be named to the All-Tournament Team.

LEFT COAST, RIGHT RESULTS

Rider has won its last three games in the Pacific Time Zone and five of its last six dating back to 2010-11. Rider defeated Pacific last season in Stockton, CA, before earning a pair of wins over UC Irvine and Hampton in the Las Vegas Invitational this season. Prior to a setback to North Dakota State on Nov. 30, 2013, in Santa Clarita, CA, Rider defeated Rice in the same tournament and earned a 77-57 win at USC on Nov. 17, 2010.

GIMME VAUGHN

Dimencio Vaughn got his feet wet from a year-long absence due to a knee injury at George Washington, before becoming an integral figure in the Broncs' rotation. He averaged 16.0 points and 7.5 rebounds, while shooting 71.4 percent (10-14) from the floor, including 2-2 from long range in his first three games back.

FREDDY THE AGGRESSOR

Frederick Scott scored 16 of his 17 points on 6-of-8 shooting in the second half, including 2-of-3 from long range and the game-winning driving bucket with 36.5 seconds remaining in regulation of the Broncs' 67-65 win at George Washington on Nov. 20. He also grabbed 10 rebounds for his second double-double. He then added 18 of his team-high 22 points against UC Irvine in the second half, while also grabbing nine boards.

TIE AFTER 20, WIN AFTER 40

In each of Rider's first three wins this season, the Broncs were tied with the opposition after the first 20 minutes. Rider was tied at 36-36 against both Hampton and Hartford before cruising to double-digit victories. The Broncs then headed to the locker room tied at 32-32 at George Washington before pulling out a 67-65 victory.

FIRST A-10 WIN SINCE 2010

Rider had lost its last six vs. Atlantic 10 foes prior to its 67-65 victory on Nov. 20. The Broncs had last defeated an A-10 team Dec. 22, 2010, at La Salle.

WELL, ISN'T THAT SPECIAL?

Rider dominated the specialty stats against Hartford. The Broncs outscored the Hawks, 34-16 in the paint, 17-4 off turn-overs, 15-5 on second chances, 24-4 in fast-break points and 30-7 on bench scoring. Rider also enjoyed a 56-32 advantage in rebounding, limiting Hartford to just four offensive boards.

TRIPLE-DOUBLE WILL HAVE TO WAIT

Stevie Jordan was staring down a potential triple-double with 19 points, nine rebounds and eight assists with eight minutes left against Hartford before being given the rest of the night off with Rider holding a 24-point lead. Jordan posted three double-doubles in his freshman year of 2016-17. He again flirted with a triple-double with 14 points, 12 assists and seven rebounds against Hampton on Nov. 24.

EXAMINING XAVIER

The Broncs pushed nationally-ranked No. 17 Xavier, trailing by just five early in the second half before the Musketeers pulled away. Jordan Allen hit a three to end the half for the second-straight game and opened the second half scoring with another trifecta. He then made a steal that led to two Anthony Durham free throws to cut the deficit to five before Xavier went on a 24-4 run to pull away.

PAIR OF FIRST-TIME DOUBLE-DOUBLES

Tyere Marshall and Frederick Scott both posted their first-career double-doubles in the Broncs' 90-75 season-opening win over Hampton. Scott had 15 points and 14 rebounds, while Marshall added 10 points and 12 rebounds. Marshall added a second double-double with 11 points and 11 rebounds against Hartford. Marshall came a point away from a double-double as a freshman last Jan. 21 against Marist with nine points and 13 rebounds, while Scott played sparingly in four games as a true freshman at DePaul before redshirting.





ALLEN IMPRESSES

Redshirt freshman Jordan Allen impressed in his collegiate debut, scoring a game-high 21 points, including 5-of-12 shooting from long range. The 21 points eclipsed Stevie Jordan's 14 in last year's season-opener as the most by a Rider freshman making his collegiate debut in the 22 years that full box scores are available. The next closest Bronc on record was Bob Fisicaro, who scored 13 points in his Rider debut, Nov. 16, 1995 against Temple. Allen's 21 are the most in a Rider debut since St. John's transfer Nurideen Lindsey scored 26 in the 2012-13 season opener against Robert Morris.

NOT SHY FROM LONG RANGE

Led by Allen's 5-of-12 shooting from long range, the Broncs made 14-of-31 attempts from beyond the arc against Hampton on Nov. 10. The 14 three-point field goals made tied the most in Head Coach Kevin Baggett's six seasons at the helm (Dec. 23, 2015 at Morgan State), while the 31 eclipsed the previous high of 30 (Dec. 4, 2015 at Fairfield).

JORDAN HONORED BY LEAGUE'S COACHES

A year after averaging 11.7 points and a league-best 5.6 assists per game in being voted to the MAAC All-Rookie Team, sophomore point guard Stevie Jordan was selected to the 2017-18 Preseason All-MAAC Third Team.

FAMILIAR PROJECTION

The Broncs have been picked to finish seventh in the MAAC Preseason Coaches' Poll, the same projection as in 2016-17, when Rider took the sixth seed in the MAAC Championships. Back-to-back champion Iona has been tabbed to win the league, followed by Manhattan, Monmouth, Fairfield, Niagara and Siena. Following the Broncs in the poll are Saint Peter's, Canisius, Marist and Quinnipiac.

BRONCS HELPING BRONCS

Stevie Jordan dished out double-digit assists on three occasions last season, while Kealen Washington-Ives accomplished the feat twice. Jordan dished out a then-season-high 12 assists in the Broncs' 81-79 victory over Kennesaw State last Dec. 14. The 12 assists were tied with Deon Hames and Kealen Washington-Ives for most dimes by a Bronc in a single game in at least the last 21 seasons, as far back as full game-by-game statistics are available, prior to Jordan's 13-assist effort at Quinnipiac on Feb. 26. Hames compiled 12 assists on three occasions in the 1994-95 and 1995-96 seasons. The Rider record book shows Norm Hobbie as the single-game record holder with 18 assists against Lehigh in the 1975-76 season. The last Bronc to reach double-digit assists prior to Jordan was Jonathan Thompson, who did it twice in 2011-12 (11 vs. Marist 1/6/12; 10 at Canisius - 2/9/12).

HEAD COACH 6TH SEASON SAINT JOSEPH'S '89

2015 MAAC Coach of the Year 2013 Ben Jobe Award Finalist 2013 Joe B. Hall Award Finalist

Kevin Baggett returns for his sixth season as the Rider University head basketball coach in 2017-18.

In his first year as head coach, 'Baggs' was a finalist for two different National Coach of the Year Awards, the Ben Jobe Award and the Joe B. Hall Award.

Baggett took a team with just two returning starters and six total letterwinners that was picked to finish seventh in the 10-team Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference in 2013 and finished in second place.

He guided the 2012-13 Broncs to a 19-win season, the most by a Rider rookie head coach since Bob Greenwood led Rider to a 20-win season in 1962-63. The only other Rider basketball coach to compile 19 wins in his rookie campaign was the legendary Clair Bee.

In 2013-14 Coach Baggett took a young team and produced two All-MAAC performers along with a MAAC All-Rookie team selection. His 2013-14 squad was ranked eighth in the nation in three-point field goal percentage and was 51st in Division I in three-point field goals made.

In 2014-15, Baggett took a squad that was picked seventh in the MAAC and guided the team to a 21-win season and a second place finish in the conference, earning MAAC Coach of the Year honors as Rider was selected to play in the College Basketball Invitational tournament. Baggett was a finalist for the Ben Jobe National Coaching Award for the second time in three years and he was named the UPS All-District 1 Coach of the Year.

The Broncs had another very successful campaign in 2016-17, winning 18 games and advancing to the MAAC Championship Quarterfinals. Rider was offered the chance to play in multiple national postseason tournaments, but declined. Seniors Jimmie Taylor and Kahlil Thomas were each named to the All-MAAC Third Team. Rider finished first in the league in rebounds per game (40.3), with three Broncs - Thomas, Norville Carey and Taylor - finishing in the top 20 individually.

Baggett was named the Rider men's basketball head coach at a standing room only press conference on May 24, 2012.

"This was a popular decision," Rider Director of Athletics Don Harnum said at that time. "It was also a convenient decision, but let me make it very clear, this was not a hire of convenience. This was a hire because I firmly believe and am very confident that Kevin is the right person to lead this program in the future."

With an emphasis on defense, Baggett's Broncs led the MAAC in three-point field goal percentage defense in 2012-13 and was second in overall field goal percentage defense, third in blocks and fourth in points allowed.

The 2017-18 season is the 12th for Baggett as a member of the Rider staff, serving two as an assistant coach and four as an associate head coach. In the last 11 years, Rider has compiled 196 wins, the most in the Metropolitan New York/New Jersey area. Siena is the only MAAC team with more wins in those 11 years.

Baggett has coached on the Division I level for 22 years and has been on the Rider staff since the 2006-07 season.

Baggett hails from Burlington, NJ and was a 2006 inductee into the South Jersey Hall of Fame. He was a member of the Saint Joseph's 1985-86 basketball team that compiled a 26-6 record and reached the second round of the NCAA Tournament. He received his bachelor's degree in marketing from Saint Joseph's in June, 1989.

Baggett came to Rider from the University of Maryland Baltimore County, where he served as assistant coach from 2004-06. At UMBC Baggett recruited an America East All-Rookie Team member who went on to earn First Team All-Conference honors three times, as well as a pair of transfers from the Colonial Athletic Association who went on to earn All-America East honors.

Baggett has also served as an assistant coach at James Madison, Howard, Western Kentucky and Coastal Carolina.
