Propelled Siena to the program's first-ever Division I national postseason tournament championship in winning the College Basketball Invitational in 2013-14

Guided the Saints to the program's first MAAC Championship Game since 2010 last winter

Over the previous seven seasons has steered his teams to four national postseason tournament appearances, an average of 19.3 victories, and .500 or better records six times

Began head coaching career at former MAAC rival Loyola which he led to 145 wins, and national postseason tournament appearances in his final two seasons

Siena returns to the Capital Region tonight to host rival Iona in a MAAC Championship rematch
The Saints will play three of their final five regular season games at home, and then host the MAAC Tournament Mar. 1-5
Six of Siena's seven wins have come at home, and the Saints have won three of their last four at the Times Union Center
Seven of Siena's games this season have been decided by one possession

The Saints are 4-3 in games decided by three points or less

Five of Siena's nine games decided by three points or less
Five of Siena's nine games in January were decided by a single possession
The Saints have also had nine games decided by four points or less (4–5 record), and 11 decided by five points or fewer (4–7)
Siena is allowing an average of 69.3 points over the past 16 games
The Saints rank third in the MAAC in scoring defense in league contests, allowing 69.7 points per game
Siena had allowed an average of 82.6 points over their first 10 games this season
Siena ranks 95th nationally in three-point field goal percentage at 36.9%
The Saints have shot 37.8% from three-point range over their first 12 games of the 2018 calendar year
Fleven of the 15 players who have have seen game action this season for Siena have scored in double figures at least once

Siena has used 16 different starting lineups this season, which is tied with Florida Gulf Coast for the second most nationally
Only Bryant (17) has used more starting lineup combinations this season
Twelve of the 15 players who have seen games action for the Saints have made starts, although nobody has started every game
Siena used 11 different starting lineup combinations last season
The Saints are 7-5 when they win the rebounding battle, and 0-14 when they do not
Siena boasts a +11.5 rebound margin in victories, and holds a -1.6 margin in defeats
The Saints have been led by a balanced scoring attack in conference play, with six players averaging between 8.5 - 10.5 points
Freshman Jordan Horn (10.5) has paced Siena in scoring during MAAC competition
Following the departure of junior Nico Clareth Jan. 10, the Saints now feature the sixth least experienced DI roster per kenpom.com
Siena's average experience is 0.89 years
Only Kentucky (0.2), Duke (0.62), Robert Morris (0.76), Alabama (0.78), and Maryland

Siena is one of just seven Division I teams along with American, Chattanooga, The
Citadel, Holy Cross, Kentucky, and Robert Morris without a true senior on its 2017–18 roster The Saints' returnees combined for just 46 career starts entering this season

The Saints are 4-2 in day games this season

Siena is averaging 75.3 points on 50% shooting including 52% from three in day games

Both afternoon losses have come at the hands of Quinnipiac

Conversely, Siena is just 3-17 in night games while averaging just 64.8 points on only 40% shooting including 33% from three

The Saints are in the midst of a stretch where 10 of 11 games feature nighttime tips

Siena's bench bench amassed a whopping 147 points - an average of 49.0 points - over a three-game span from Dec. 17-22

The Saints' bench outscored the team's starters by 70 points and its opponents' reserves by 90 points over that stretch

Siena's reserves have scored 30 or more points eight times, and are averaging 25.2 points overall this season

The Saints played what is currently ranked as the 41st toughest non-conference schedule nationally

Siena posted a 4-0 non-conference mark with their nine losses coming vs. teams who hold a collective 150-77 (674) record

Siena posted a 4-9 non-conference mark, with their nine losses coming vs. teams who hold a collective 159-77 (.674) record Eight of nine possess .500 or better records, and four currently sit atop their respective conference standings

The Saints' 13 non-conference opponents combined to post a 267-166 (.617) overall record and average 20.5 wins last season Eight of Siena's non-conference opponents won 20 games last year, with six qualifying for postseason tournaments, highlighed by four NCAA Tournament teams

The Saints made 26 threes while shooting 47.3% over back-to-back road games at Bryant (Dec. 17) and Memphis (Dec. 20)
Siena's 12 threes against the Bulldogs tied for the program's most in 12 years
The Saints then hit 14 threes against the Tigers to mark the program's most since making 15 at Fordham on Nov. 24, 2001

Siena averaged 89.0 points over three consecutive games from Nov. 17-25
The Saints scored 267 points, marking the program's most over a three-game stretch since Jan. 15-21, 2001 (269)
Siena shot 48.8% from the field and 41.3% from three-point range
The Saints eclipsed the 90-point mark in back-to-back games at Lehigh (Nov. 17) and Bucknell (Nov. 20)
It marked the first time that Siena had scored 90 or more points in consecutive games since Feb. 23-29, 2008

Sixteen of the Saints' 31 regular season contests are vs. teams which played in national postseason tournaments last season
14 games are vs. programs which won 20+ games last year
Siena navigated the 82nd hardest schedule nationally last season, including the 32nd toughest non-conference schedule
The Saints played nine games vs. programs which finished in the top-85 of the RPI the previous season in 2015-16

Siena was projected to finish sixth according to the MAAC Preseason Coaches' Poll
Two-time defending MAAC Tournament Champion Iona was the preseason favorite after receiving nine of 11 first-place votes
The Saints posted a 17-17 overall record last season and finished tied for third in the MAAC with a 12-8 league mark

The Saints posted a 17-17 overall record last season and finished tied for third in the MAAC with a 12-8 league mark

Siena won 13 of its final 19 games, capped by the program's first MAAC Championship appearance in seven years

The Saints returned seven letterwinners, while welcoming seven newcomers including five true freshmen this season

Prince Oduro was projected to be the MAAC's top freshman by both College Sports Madness and A Daly Dose of Hoops

Siena graduated five seniors and lost 72% of their scoring and 68% of their rebounding from last year's team

The Saints' four scholarship seniors combined to score 5,780 career points

Siena was one of only two Division I teams in 2016–17 (National Champion North Carolina) with four 1,000 point scorers

All four scholarship seniors are currently playing professionally in Europe

The Saints are scheduled to play 15 regular season home games at the Times Union Center this season

That matches the 2010-11 squad for the program's most regular season home games since playing 17 during the 1985-86 season

Siena will also host the MAAC Championships for the fourth consecutive season during a five-year run come March

The Saints boast a 239-121 (.664) all-time record at the Times Union Center

Siena went 2-1 on their international trip to Montreal in late August

The Saints posted double digit completely in victories over McGill and Concordia

The Saints posted double digit comebacks in victories over McGill and Concordia

Horn had a breakout performance in leading the team averaging 15.0 points on the trip

Canisius shot 59% in the second half in scoring 51 points in the stanza Oduro led Siena with both 12 points and eight rebounds

The Saints shot 21-28 from the free throw line and scored 17 points off of 11 Golden Griffin turnovers

Posted a 17–17 overall record and finished tied for third in the MAAC with a 12–8 mark Bounced back from 4–11 start to win 13 of final 19 games

Advanced to the MAAC Championship Game for the first time in seven years

Overcame 17-point second half deficit vs. top-seed Monmouth in semifinals

Brett Bisping and **Marquis Wright** were named Second Team All-MAAC selections Four Saints were named to the MAAC All-Tournament Team

Played the 82nd hardest schedule, including the 32nd toughest non-conference slate Played 14 games vs. teams which finished in the top-100 of the RPI Recorded four top-100 RPI victories

One of only two teams (National Champion North Carolina) with four 1,000 point scorers Four scholarship seniors combined to score 5,780 career points

Lavon Long became just the third player in program history to eclipse 1,200 points, 600 rebounds and 250 assists

Led the MAAC with a +6.7 rebound margin in conference play Used 11 different starting lineup combinations

Siena and the Times Union Center

Siena is in its 28th season of competition at the Times Union Center, and 21st since making the full-time move to downtown Albany in 1997–98

The Saints have ranked in the top-100 nationally in attendance in each of the past 20 seasons, coinciding with the program's full-time move to the TUC

Siena ranked 91st nationally in attendance last season, and drew an average of 6,077 fans over 16 home dates at the Times Union Center

The Saints' welcomed over 100,000 fans through the turnstiles for the 11th time last year Siena has drawn a grand total of 2,351,588 fans (an average of 6,532) over 360 dates at the Times Union Center

The Saints welcomed their 2-millionth fan on Dec. 23, 2014 against Cornell, and have drawn crowds in excess of 10,000 on 33 occasions

Siena boasts a 239-121 (.664) all-time record at the Times Union Center, including a 214-99 (.684) mark since making the full-time move to the facility in 1997-98

In 2009–10, Siena established a new program record with 133,505 fans (an average of 7,853) for 17 home games, which ranked 66th nationally in tying for its highest national ranking ever (2002–03)

The Saints are scheduled to host the 2017–18 MAAC Basketball Championships at the Times Union Center for the 19th time in 29 seasons, and fourth time during a five-year agreement from 2015–19

Averaged 13 points and 11 rebounds while leading First Love to a 24–3 record and Slam National Post-Grad Championship appearance during his final season where he was also teammates with current Siena freshman **Christian Bentley**

Scored 10 points and added nine rebounds (21 minutes) while sparking come-from-behind win over Concordia in final game of team's international trip to Montreal in August

Appeared in 11 games as a freshman last season, logging 46 minutes and totaling eight points

Father, Thomas Sr. '91, was member of Siena's 1988-89 team which upset Stanford in the NCAA Tournament

Younger brother, Kevin, is a sophomore starter on the University of Maryland basketball team

Matriculated to Siena after spending a postgraduate year at Cheshire Academy (CT)

Led Shenendehowa to 25-0 record and first-ever NYSPHSAA Class AA State Championship in 28 years as high school senior

Scored in double figures a team-high 13 times, and recorded first two collegiate double-doubles this season Recorded first career double-double with 12 points and 12 rebounds in MAAC opener at Marist (Dec. 29)

Tallied career-high 19 points and tied season-high with seven rebounds vs. St. Bonaventure (Nov. 29)
