



Began his head coaching career at former MAAC rival Loyola which he led to 145 wins, and national postseason tournament appearances in his final two seasons

Siena opens a tough stretch tonight where they play four of their next five games away from home

The stretch includes games at MAAC Preseason No. 1 (Iona), No. 2 (Manhattan) and defending regular season champ Monmouth
The Saints are just 1-7 on the road so far this season

Two-time defending MAAC Tournament Champion Iona was the preseason favorite after receiving nine of 11 first-place votes
Former Saint Nico Clareth was named a Preseason Second Team All-MAAC selection
Clareth officially parted ways with the program on Jan. 10
The Saints posted a 17-17 overall record last season and finished tied for third in the MAAC with a 12-8 league mark
Siena won 13 of its final 19 games, capped by the program's first MAAC Championship appearance in seven years
The Saints returned seven letterwinners, while welcoming seven newcomers including five true freshmen this season
Clareth was the team's leading returning scorer (13.7) and accounted for 43% of Siena's returning scoring output from last year
The Saints are one of just seven Division I programs along with American, Chattanooga, The Citadel, Holy Cross, Kentucky, and
Robert Morris without a true senior on their 2017–18 roster
Siena's returnees combined for just 46 career starts entering this season

Freshman **Prince Oduro** was projected to be the MAAC's top freshman by both College Sports Madness and A Daly Dose of Hoops

The Saints were one of only two Division I teams in 2016–17 (National Champion North Carolina) with four 1,000 point scorers
All four scholarship seniors are currently playing professionally in Europe

Siena and the Times Union Center

Siena is in its 28th season of competition at the Times Union Center, and 21st since making the full-time move to downtown Albany in 1997–98

The Saints have ranked in the top-100 nationally in attendance in each of the past 20 seasons, coinciding with the program's full-time move to the TUC

Siena ranked 91st nationally in attendance last season, and drew an average of 6,077 fans over 16 home dates at the Times Union Center

The Saints' welcomed over 100,000 fans through the turnstiles for the 11th time last year Siena has drawn a grand total of 2,333,489 fans (an average of 6,536) over 357 dates at the Times Union Center

The Saints welcomed their 2-millionth fan on Dec. 23, 2014 against Cornell, and have drawn crowds in excess of 10,000 on 33 occasions

Siena boasts a 237-120 (.664) all-time record at the Times Union Center, including a 212-98 (.684) mark since making the full-time move to the facility in 1997-98

In 2009–10, Siena established a new program record with 133,505 fans (an average of 7,853) for 17 home games, which ranked 66th nationally in tying for its highest national ranking ever (2002–03)

The Saints are scheduled to host the 2017-18 MAAC Basketball Championships at the Times Union Center for the 19th time in 29 seasons, and fourth time during a five-year agreement from 2015-19

San Jose, California native **Jake Wojcik** has signed and returned his National Letter of Intent during the early signing period, and will enroll at Siena College next fall.

"Jake comes from a strong basketball pedigree and joins us from a great Catholic school," said Patsos. "He's a high character individual, and a strong combo guard in the mold of Danny Ainge. Jake had a lot of offers, but we recruited him very hard, and are super excited to have him."

A 6'4" 195-pound guard, Wojcik was named the 2016-17 Alameda Newspaper Group's South Bay/Peninsula Player of the Year, the Prep2Prep Central Coast Section Player of the Year, and the Western Catholic Athletic League's Co-Player of the Year after averaging 15.6 points while leading Bellarmine Prep to a 25-3 record including a perfect 14-0 mark in league action. 
