QUICK HITS



Siena opens a tough stretch tonight where they play four of their next five games away from home. The stretch includes games at MAAC Preseason No. 1 (Iona), No. 2 (Manhattan) and defending regular season champ Monmouth. The Saints are just 1-7 on the road so far this season.

Siena has featured a much improved defense over the past seven games. The Saints have allowed an average of just 69.0 points on 43% shooting including 31% from three over their last seven contests. Siena has held its opponents under 70 points four times during that stretch, including a season-low 62 vs. Canisius Sunday. The Saints had allowed an average of 82.6 points on 46% shooting including 36% from three over their first 10 games this year.

Siena leads the MAAC with a +2.2 rebound margin. The Saints are 5-3 when they out-rebound their opponent and winless at 0-9 when they do not. Siena has featured a +9.6 average rebound margin in wins and a -1.7 margin in defeats. The Saints have achieved a +3.8 rebound margin in conference play highlighted by a +19 advantage in Sunday's win over the Griffs.

Siena is just 1-11 in night games. The Saints are averaging 67.2 points on 40% shooting including 34% from three-point range. Conversely, Siena is 4-1 in day games while averaging 76.6 points on 51% shooting including 49% from three. The Saints next three games - and 10 of their next 11 overall - feature nighttime tip-offs.

Siena ranks 74th nationally (351 teams) shooting 37.6% from three-point range. The Saints have shot 40% or better from distance eight times, and made 10 or more threes four times so far this season. Siena is shooting 39.9% from three-point range while averaging 8.1 makes over the past seven games. The Saints made 26 threes while shooting 47.3% over back-to-back road games at Bryant (Dec. 17) and Memphis (Dec. 20). Siena's 12 threes against the Bulldogs tied for the program's most in 12 years. The Saints then hit 14 threes against the Tigers to mark the program's most since making 15 at Fordham on Nov. 24, 2001.

Siena's bench is averaging 28.4 points per game. The Saints are outscoring their opponents' reserves by an average of 8.9 points. Siena's bench amassed a whopping 147 points - an average of 49.0 points - over a three-game span from Dec. 17-22. The Saints' bench outscored the team's starters by 70 points and its opponents' reserves by 90 points over that stretch.

Conversely, Siena's starters are averaging just 41.6 points per game. The Saints' starters have been outscored on average by 15.9 points by its opponents' Starting Five.

Siena has used 10 different starting lineup combinations over the team's first 17 games which is sixth most nationally. Only Florida Gulf Coast (12), Bryant (11), Pitt (11), UTEP (11), and UT Martin (11) have used more combinations. Eleven players on the Saints' 14-player roster have made starts, and no player has started every game. Siena used 11 different starting lineup combinations last season.

The Saints wrapped up their challenging 13-game non-conference schedule with a 4-9 record. Siena's nine losses were vs. teams who are a combined 93-53 (.637). College of Charleston, Vermont, and UAlbany are all ranked in the top-25 of the College Insider Mid-Major Top-25 Poll.

The Saints' 13 non-conference opponents combined to post a 267-166 (.617) overall record and average 20.5 wins last season. Eight of Siena's non-conference opponents won 20 games last year, with six qualifying for postseason tournaments, highlighted by four NCAA Tournament teams. The Saints averaged 89.0 points over three consecutive games from Nov. 17-25. Siena scored 267 points, marking the program's most over a three-game stretch since Jan. 15-21, 2001 (269).

The Saints shot 48.8% from the field and 41.3% from three-point range. Siena eclipsed the 90-point mark in back-to-back games at Lehigh (Nov. 17) and Bucknell (Nov. 20). It marked the first time that the Saints had scored 90 or more points in consecutive games since Feb. 23-29, 2008.

Ten different players have scored in double figures at least once already this season through the team's first 17 games. Sixteen of Siena's 31 regular season contests are vs. teams which played in national postseason tournaments last season. 14 games are vs. programs which won 20+ games last year.

The Saints navigated the 82nd hardest schedule nationally last season, including the 32nd toughest non-conference schedule. Siena played nine games vs. programs which finished in the top-85 of the RPI the previous season in 2015-16.

The Saints were projected to finish sixth (11 teams) according to the MAAC Preseason Coaches' Poll. Two-time defending MAAC Tournament Champion Iona was the preseason favorite after receiving nine of 11 first-place votes. Former Saint **Nico Clareth** was named a Preseason Second Team All-MAAC selection. Clareth officially parted ways with the program on Jan. 10.

The Saints posted a 17-17 overall record last season and finished tied for third in the MAAC with a 12-8 league mark. Siena won 13 of its final 19 games, capped by the program's first MAAC Championship appearance in seven years.

The Saints returned seven letterwinners, while welcoming seven newcomers including five true freshmen this season. Clareth was the team's leading returning scorer (13.7) and accounted for 43% of Siena's returning scoring output from last year. The Saints are one of just seven Division I programs along with American, Chattanooga, The Citadel, Holy Cross, Kentucky, and Robert Morris without a true senior on their 2017-18 roster.

Siena's returnees combined for just 46 career starts entering this season. Freshman **Prince Oduro** was projected to be the MAAC's top freshman by both College Sports Madness and A Daly Dose of Hoops.

The Saints graduated five seniors and lost 72% of their scoring and 68% of their rebounding from last year's team. Siena's four scholarship seniors combined to score 5,780 career points. The Saints were one of only two Division I teams in 2016-17 (National Champion North Carolina) with four 1,000 point scorers. All four scholarship seniors are currently playing professionally in Europe.

Siena is scheduled to play 15 regular season home games at the Times Union Center this season. That matches the 2010-11 squad for the program's most regular season home games since playing 17 during the 1985-86 season. The Saints will also host the MAAC Championships for the fourth consecutive season during a five-year run come March. Siena boasts a 237-120 (.664) all-time record at the Times Union Center.

The Saints went 2-1 on their international trip to Montreal in late August. Siena posted double digit comebacks in victories over McGill and Concordia. Freshman guard **Jordan Horn** had a breakout performance in leading the team averaging 15.0 points on the trip.

Horn hit the game-winning three with 5.3 seconds remaining. Siena's defense posted season-bests in fewest points allowed (62) and fewest points allowed in a half (21 in the first half). The Saints also limited the MAAC's top shooting team to just 38% from the field including only 6-26 (23%) from three. Siena held a decided 43-24 rebounding advantage. Sophomore guard **Ahsante Shivers** led four Saints in double figures with 18 points.

Siena and the Times Union Center

Siena is in its 28th season of competition at the Times Union Center, and 21st since making the full-time move to downtown Albany in 1997-98

The Saints have ranked in the top-100 nationally in attendance in each of the past 20 seasons, coinciding with the program's full-time move to the TUC

Siena ranked 91st nationally in attendance last season, and drew an average of 6,077 fans over 16 home dates at the Times Union Center

The Saints' welcomed over 100,000 fans through the turnstiles for the 11th time last year
Siena has drawn a grand total of 2,333,489 fans (an average of 6,536) over 357 dates at the Times Union Center

The Saints welcomed their 2-millionth fan on Dec. 23, 2014 against Cornell, and have drawn crowds in excess of 10,000 on 33 occasions

Siena boasts a 237-120 (.664) all-time record at the Times Union Center, including a 212-98 (.684) mark since making the full-time move to the facility in 1997-98

In 2009-10, Siena established a new program record with 133,505 fans (an average of 7,853) for 17 home games, which ranked 66th nationally in tying for its highest national ranking ever (2002-03)

The Saints are scheduled to host the 2017-18 MAAC Basketball Championships at the Times Union Center for the 19th time in 29 seasons, and fourth time during a five-year agreement from 2015-19

San Jose, California native **Jake Wojcik** has signed and returned his National Letter of Intent during the early signing period, and will enroll at Siena College next fall.

"Jake comes from a strong basketball pedigree and joins us from a great Catholic school," said Patsos. "He's a high character individual, and a strong combo guard in the mold of Danny Ainge. Jake had a lot of offers, but we recruited him very hard, and are super excited to have him."

A 6'4" 195-pound guard, Wojcik was named the 2016-17 Alameda Newspaper Group's South Bay/Peninsula Player of the Year, the Prep2Prep Central Coast Section Player of the Year, and the Western Catholic Athletic League's Co-Player of the Year after averaging 15.6 points while leading Bellarmine Prep to a 25-3 record including a perfect 14-0 mark in league action. 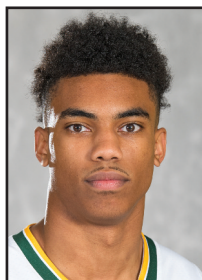
