

FASTBREAK POINTS

- ▶ The Canisius men's basketball team closes out its three-game homestand today when against three-time defending MAAC champion Iona.
- ▶ The Griffs are 5-10 overall and 2-1 in MAAC play after losing to Rider 82-73 Friday night in the Koessler Athletic Center.
- Canisius is 2-1 in MAAC play for the fifth time since the 2012-13 season, and for the second time under third-year head coach Reggie Witherspoon.
- ▶ The Griffs made 11 3-point field goals in the loss to Rider Friday. In its last two games, Canisius has connected on a total of 24 shots from behind the
- Junior Isaiah Reese posted a season-high 21 points in the loss to Rider, his 14th career game with 20-or more points scored.
- ▶ Reese also had four steals against Rider. He starts today's game with 145 career steals, which ranks him eighth in program history.
- Junior Malik Johnson had five assists against Rider, his 37th career game with five-ore more assists to his credit. He ranks 10th all-time in program history with 345 assists in 82 career contests.

WITHERSPOON AVAILABILITY

All interview requests for head coach Reggie Witherspoon should be directed to Matt Reitnour in the Canisius Athletic Communications office. Coach Witherspoon will be available to the media every Wednesday prior to the start of practice. Postgame media availabilty will be held after each game, home and away.

PLAYER INTERVIEWS

All player interview must be arranged through Matt Reitnour in the Canisius Athletic Communications office at least two days in advance. Along with coach Witherspoon, players will be available to the media every Wednesday prior to the start of practice. There is NO player availability on game day prior to tipoff. The Canisius locker room is closed.

CREDENTIALS

Single-game press credentials are issued to accredited members of the working media. Requests for credentials should be submitted to Matt Reitnour at least five days in advance. Credentials can be picked up 90 minutes ahead of tipoff on game days. Parking is provided as available (see PARKING NOTE, please).

MEDIA WORK ROOM

The Canisius media work room is located on the second floor of the Koessler Athletic Center, across from the weight room. The work room opens 90 minutes before tip and is open for two hours after the game.

PRESS ROW SEATING

CANISIUS - IONA SERIES HISTORY

- ▶ This is the 74th meeting between these two schools and Iona leads the series 40-33.
- ▶ Canisius swept Iona in the regular-season series in 2017-18, and the Griffs come into today's game riding a three-game win streak in the series. The sweep by the Blue and Gold last year was the program's first since the 2006-07 campaign.
- ▶ Canisius is 22-12 against Iona at home, with 15 of those victories coming in the Koessler Athletic Center.
- ▶ lona's last four victories in this series have come by an average of 16.8 points per game.

ABOUT THE GAELS

- ▶ lona comes into this afternoon's game with an overall record of 4-10 to go with a 2-1 mark in MAAC action.
- ▶ The Gaels are coming off a 95-90 loss at Niagara Friday night. That loss snapped Iona's two-game win streak.
- ▶ Prior to starting league play with two wins, Iona had dropped seven straight, including a 78-71 loss to Holy Cross Dec. 30. The Griffs also lost to Holy Cross earlier this season in non-league play.
- ▶ The Gaels lead the league and rank 59th nationally in scoring average at 79.8 points per game, but the team allows 84.9 points per game, which ranks 11th in the MAAC and 348th in the country.
- ▶ Iona ranks fourth in the MAAC and 87th in the nation with its 8.7 3-point makes per game. The Gaels allow opponents to make 10.5 3-pointers per game, and the team's 40.2 3-point percentage defense ranks is 10th in the league and 346th in the nation.
- ▶ Junior E.J. Crawford leads the team and ranks fourth in the MAAC with his 17.3 points per game scoring average. He scored 23 points on 10-of-15 shooting to go with six rebounds and two assists.
- ▶ Senior Rickey McGill is good for 15.1 points per game, which ranks second on the team, and his 5.4 assists per game ranks second-best in the MAAC.
- Junior Tajuan Agee chips in 12.9 points and a team-high 7.2 rebounds per game. Those 7.2 boards per game average is fourth-best in the MAAC.

NEXT UP

- ▶ Canisius will return to the road next weekend as the team travels to Connecticut to play at Quinnipiac (Jan. 17) and at Fairfield (Jan. 19). Both games will be broadcast live on ESPN3.
- ▶ The game against the Bobcats will be Canisius' first since Quinnipiac eliminated the Griffs from the 2018 MAAC Basketball Championship with a 72-69 win in the tournament's quarterfinal round.
- ▶ The Griffs will close out the road swing in the Nutmeg State at Fairfield Jan. 19 when the two teams play in Fairfield's Alumni Hall. The last time Canisius played Fairfield in its on-campus home was Feb. 12, 2001 a 98-93 victory by the Stags.

- Scored a team-high 21 points in the loss to Rider, his 14th career game with 20-plus points scored.
- Averaging 16.7 points, 7.7 rebounds and 5.5 assists per game in MAAC play.
- ▶ Needs 14 points to become the 38th player in school history to score 1,000 points.

CANISIUS OFF TO A STRONG MAAC START

- ▶ Canisius opened its 30th season in the MAAC at Marist Jan. 3 with a 75-72 victory.
- ▶ The win over the Red Foxes moved the Griffs to 16-14 all-time in MAAC openers and it also extended the team's MAAC-opening win streak to seven straight, dating back to the 2012-13 campaign.
- ▶ The Griffs' 70-66 win at Siena Jan. 5 improved the team to 2-0 in MAAC play for the second-straight season and for just the seventh time since 1989-90.
- ▶ Canisius enters today's game with a 2-1 record in league play after losing to Ruder on Friday. This is the fifth time since 2012-13 where the team has opened conference play with a 2-1 record through the first three games of the league slate.

PICKING UP WHERE THEY LEFT OFF

- Last season, Canisius set a school record with 15 MAAC wins. The Griffs earned a share of the MAAC's regular-season title with Rider after going 15-3 in conference play.
- ▶ The Griffs come into today's MAAC game against Iona with a 17-4 record in its last 21 conference games, dating back to the start of the 2017-18 campaign.
- ▶ The team's 17-4 mark in the last 21 league games matches the program's best 21-game MAAC stretch. The Griffs also went 17-4 over a 21-game span during the 1993-94 and 1994-95 seasons.

GRIFFS AGAINST THE RANKED

- As of Jan. 7, Canisius' schedule features two teams ranked in the Associated Press Top-25 Poll.
- ▶ The Griffs lost to then-No. 14 Florida State 93-61 Nov. 19, and fell to No. 21 Buffalo 87-72 at home Dec. 29.
- ▶ Canisius is the only MAAC school to play two ranked teams this season. This marks the first time since 2003-04 where the Blue and Gold have played multiple ranked opponents in the same season.

CANISIUS' NON-LEAGUE SCHEDULE IS STRONG

- As of Jan. 12, the combined record of the 11 non-conference teams on Canisius' 2018-19 schedule is 112-78. Two of those teams, Florida State and Buffalo, are currently ranked in the AP Top-25 poll.
- ▶ Eight of the Griffs' 11 non-league opponents this season are .500 or better on the year, as of Jan. 12.
- ▶ Canisius faced three teams at the 2018 AdvoCare Invitational that currently have a winning record. The Griffs went 0-3 against those three schools (Villanova, Memphis and UAB).

WITHERSPOON COACHES CAREER GAME NO. 500

- ▶ Canisius head coach **Reggie Witherspoon** coached his 500th career game at the Division I level when the Griffs play at St. Bonaventure Nov. 28.
- ▶ Witherspoon is the only current active coach in the MAAC to reach the 500-career game milestone.

DECEMBERS TO REMEMBER

- ➤ Since 2012-13, Canisius is 32-14 in games played in the month of December. The Griffs finished December 2018 with a 2-2 record after the team lost to No. 21/22 Buffalo 87-72 Dec. 29..
- In the three Decembers under head coach **Reggie Witherspoon**, the Blue and Gold is 13-6, with 11 of those wins coming in non-league play.
- ▶ Prior to the 2012-13 season, Canisius only had 11 wins in the month of December from 2008-09 through the 2011-12 campaigns.

FIRST TIME FOR OVERTIME

- Canisius' 97-90 loss to Brown Jan. 8 marked the Griffs' first overtime game of the season. Canisius has now played at least one overtime contest in eightstraight seasons.
- ▶ All time, Canisius is 88-46 in overtime games, and 32-27 when those overtime games come at home.

GRIFFS' OFFENSE LOOKING TO GET GOING

- ▶ Canisius enters today's game vs. Iona averaging 69.6 points per game, which ranks fifth in the MAAC and 283rd in the nation.
- ▶ The Griffs scored a season-high 92 points in the win over Elon Dec. 16. In the team's last five games, the Blue and Gold has posted 70-plus points five times, good for an average of 76.0 points per game.
- ▶ The Griffs are 40-16 under third-year head coach **Reggie Witherspoon** when posting 70-or more points on the scoreboard in a game after the team fell to Rider 82-73 Friday night.

TROUBLE ON THE GLASS

- ▶ Despite the recent surge on the glass, Canisius comes into tonight's game averaging 33.8 rebounds per game, which ranks fifth in the MAAC and 287th in the country.
- ▶ The Griffs rank ninth in the league and 314th in the nation with a -4.1 rebounding margin.
- Canisius has allowed its opponents to grab an offensive rebound on 32.4 percent of all possessions, which ranks 303rd nationally, according to kenpom. com.
- ▶ Canisius has out rebounded its opponent six times this season, and the team is 4-2 in those three contests. The Griffs' +10 rebounding margin in the win over Marist Jan. 3 is the team's largest of the season.
- ▶ In the 82 games under head coach **Reggie Witherspoon**, the Griffs have out rebounded their opponent 34 times. The team is 25-9 in those 34 contests.

A GAME OF RUNS

- ▶ In 14 of the Griffs' 15 games this season, Canisius has allowed its opponents at least one scoring run of nine points or more during the course of the contest.
- ▶ In the Griffs' loss to Rider Friday night, the visiting Broncs outscored Canisius 14-0 over a span of 3:09 midway through the second half to earn a 53-52 lead. Late in the game, the Broncs used another run, this time a 10-0 spurt, to pull away from the Blue and Gold for good.
- ▶ The largest scoring run against Canisius this season came in the game against UAB Nov. 25. In that game, the Blazers used a 22-7 run midway through the first half to erase a 24-9 lead midway through the opening 20 minutes of play.

CHARGE IT!

- ▶ Canisius comes into tonight's game having drawn multiple offensive charges in six of the team's last 11 games after taking three charge calls win the loss to Brown Jan. 8.
- ▶ Sophomore Takal Molson leads the Griffs with seven offensive charges taken this season. He's also the program's active leader in that category with 13 drawn charges in his first 48 career games as a Griff.

BUFFALO STEALERS

- ▶ Canisius was credited with eight steals in the loss to Rider Friday night, the 13th time this season the team has recorded five or more steals in a game.
- ▶ The Griffs enter today's game averaging 7.2 steals per game, which ranks fourth in the MAAC and 111th in the nation.

- ▶ Canisius is 11-11 all-time when playing on Jan. 13.
- ▶ The Griffs have played lona on this date three times, with the Gaels scoring wins in all three of those contests.
- ▶ On Jan. 13, 1982, Canisius beat Mercyhurst 104-74 in the Koessler Athletic Center. In that game, Canisius Hall of Famer 'Sugar' Ray Hall scored a gamehigh 27 points for the Blue and Gold, one of his seven 20-plus point efforts that season.

PAINT POINTS

- ► Canisius held Rider to just one 3-point field goal Friday night, but still came out on the short end of an 82-73 loss.
- ▶ The Griffs have protected the 3-point line this season, entering today's game ranked second in the MAAC in 3-point field goal percentage defense at 35.5 percent. However, the Blue and Gold has struggled recently defending the paint.
- ▶ Coming into today, 52.5 percent of the points scored against Canisius in the last two games have come from within the paint. Rider's 48 points in the paint on Friday are the most allowed by the team this season.

- ▶ The Griffs ended the 2017-18 campaign by shooting 46.4 percent from the field, with the team connecting on 901-of-1,942 shots from the field.
- ▶ Canisius, which ranked second in the MAAC and ranks 82nd nationally in field goal shooting percentage last year, shot better than 45 percent from the field in 18 games in 2017-18.

- ▶ Canisius starts today's game averaging 12 3-point makes in the last two games after the Blue and Gold drained 11 3-pointers in the loss to Rider Friday night.
- ▶ Canisius starts this game today averaging 7.6 3-point makes per game, which ranks sixth h in the MAAC and 190th in the country. The 13 makes from 3-point land in the overtime loss to Brown Jan. 8 are the most for the team this season.
- ▶ With the 11 makes from 3-point range in the loss to Rider Friday night, Canisius has made 10-or more treys 70 times since the start of the 2012-13 season.

DROPPING DIMES

- ▶ Through 15 games this season, the Griffs are averaging 13.0 assists per game. That ranks fourth in the 11-team conference.
- ▶ Canisius recorded 18 assists on 28 made field goals in the loss to Rider on Friday night. That marked the third time this season Canisius was credited with 18 assists in a game, with the team posting a 2-1 record in those three contests.

WE'LL TAKE THAT

- ▶ Canisius comes into today's game ranked second in the MAAC in turnover margin at +1.0. That ranks the Griffs 142nd nationally.
- ▶ The Griffs are forcing opponents to turn the ball over an average of 15.3 times per game, which is fourth in the league behind Rider (17.5), Manhattan (16.0) and Monmouth (15.4).

TAKE CARE OF THE ROCK

- ▶ Through the first 15 games of the 2018-19 campaign, Canisius is averaging 14.3 turnovers per game, which ranks seventh in the MAAC and 236th in the nation.
- ▶ The Griffs were charged with a season-high 22 turnovers in the loss to Brown Jan. 8, the most for the team in a game under third-year head coach Reggie Witherspoon.

- ▶ Canisius junior Isaiah Reese enters today's game as the program's active leader in career points scored with 986, good for a career average of 12.0 points per game.
- ▶ Reese is averaging 15.6 points per game in the team's last five outings after he scored 21 points in the loss to Rider on Friday. He needs 14 more points to become the 38th player in program history to join the famed 1,000-point club.

REESE THE REBOUNDER

- ▶ Canisius junior Isaiah Reese enters today's game as the Griffs' leading rebounder with his 6.1 rebounds per game average. That ranks the 6-foot-5 guard eighth in the MAAC in rebounding average through 15 contests.
- Of Reese's 91 total rebounds, 79 have come off the defensive glass, which breaks down to 5.3 defensive boards per game. That ranks him fifth in the MAAC and 158th in the country.
- ▶ Reese has been the team's leading rebounder in eight games this year and 24 times in his career. His game-high 12 rebounds in the win over Robert Morris Dec. 5 tied his career-high, previously set Feb. 18, 2018 at Rider.

REESE CLIMBING THE CAREER STEALS LIST

- ▶ Junior Isaiah Reese was credited with a game-high four steals in the Griffs' loss to Rider Friday. Those four steals moved him into eighth-place on the school's career steals list with 145.
- ▶ The four steals Friday marked the seventh time this season where the Miami, Fla., native has recorded multiple steals in a game.
- ▶ Reese starts today's contest leading the team and ranked third in the MAAC with 1.9 steals per contest this year. Those 1.9 steals per game ranks 69th nationally.

13 FOR THREE

- ▶ Junior Isaiah Reese hit four 3-point field goals in the loss to Rider Friday. He starts today's game with 134 career makes from behind the arc, which ranks 12th in school history, three shy of passing former Griffs guard Craig Wise for 11th all-time in career 3-point field goals.
- ▶ Reese made a team-high 83 3-pointers last season, which ranks sixth-best all-time in program history for a single season. His 2.0 treys per game this year tied him for 11th in the conference.

DYNAMIC DUO

- ▶ Canisius sophomore **Takal Molson and** junior **Isaiah Reese** combine to make a powerful 1-2 punch for the Griffs' offense.
- ▶ Through the team's first 15 games this year, the backcourt tandem have combined to score 42.9 percent of Canisius' total points. Molson leads the way with his 17.3 points per game scoring average, while Reese is good for 12.6 points per contest this season.
- ▶ Entering today's contest, the two guards have combined to take 44.3 percent of the team's field goal attempts this season. Of the combined 389 shots by Molson and Reese, 191 have come from behind the 3-point arc (49.1 percent).

THE MOLSON 500

- ▶ Canisius guard **Takal Molson** comes into today's game averaging a team-high 17.3 points per game, which ranks fifth-best the MAAC.
- The Buffalo, N.Y., starts this game this afternoon with 676 total points in his career through 48 career games, good for an average of 14.1 points per outing.
- ▶ Earlier this season, Molson moved past the 500-career point mark in 37 career games, making him the fastest Canisius sophomore to reach the 500-career point milestone since 'Sugar' Ray Hall passed the 500-point plateau in 31 games as a Griff during the 1982-83 season.

MOLSON GOOD FOR 10-PLUS

- Canisius guard Takal Molson leads Canisius and ranks fifth in the MAAC with his 17.3 points per game scoring average.
- ▶ The Buffalo, N.Y., has scored in double-figures in all 15 games to date this season. Dating back to last year, Molson has scored 10-plus points in 19 consecutive contests.
- ▶ Molson scored a game-high 23 points in the road win at Siena Jan. 5, his fourth 20-point performance of the season. He matched a career-high Nov. 13 with 25 points in the win at Bucknell.
- ▶ In his first college game Nov. 11, 2017, Molson scored 25 points in the Griffs' road loss at Buffalo. Those 25 points set the program record for points scored in a Canisius debut by a true freshman.

- ▶ Junior guard Malik Johnson had five assists in the loss to Rider on Friday to give him 345 for his career, which ranks 10th all-time in program history.
- ▶ Through 15 games this season, he is averaging 3.0 assists per game, which ranks him second on the team and ninth in the MAAC.
- ▶ In the team's last five games, Johnson is averaging 3.8 assists per contest and he's averaging 4.0 assists per game in the team's first three league games of the season.
- ▶ Johnson's five assists on Friday vs. Rider marked the fourth time this season and the 37th time in his career where he recorded five or more assists in a game.
- ▶ The Richmond, Va., native is the first Canisius sophomore to dish out more than 145 assists in each of his first two seasons in Blue and Gold.

TO GIVE AND TO TAKE

- ▶ Junior Malik Johnson is one of the team's leaders in assists per game, and he also among this year's leaders in steals per game as well with 1.6 steals per game to his credit.

- ▶ Johnson, who is ranks eighth in the MAAC with 1.6 steals per game this season, became just the 19th player in school history to record 100 career steals when he was credited with two in the road loss at Holy Cross Dec. 20.

What is a Griffin?

The Griffin is a mythical creature of supposed gigantic size that has the head, forelegs and wings of an eagle and the hindquarters, tail and ears of a lion. They are well known

for their speed, ability to fly and having eyes like an eagle as well as the strength and courage of a lion

Griffins have been known for centuries as symbols of strength and vigilance, have been called

"The Hounds of Zeus" in Greek mythology and are said to have mastery of both the land and sky.

They are thought to be from India, where the natives of the land made their talons and claws into drinking cups because the talon of a Griffin was said to detect poison in a liquid. Griffins would find gold in the mountains and line their nests with it and as a result, were forced to become great guardians of the nests to keep the hunters away.

GRIFFS COMING OFF A BANNER SEASON

- ▶ Canisius finished the 2017-18 regular season with a 15-3 record in conference play, which earned the Griffs a share of the MAAC regular-season championship.
- The 15 conference victories last season set a new program record for the Blue and Gold, and the regular-season title was the first for Canisius since 1993-94.

2017-18 GRIFFS TIE PROGRAM WINS RECORD

- ▶ Canisius ended the 2017-18 season with an overall record of 21-12, the ninth 20-win campaign in school history, and the first since 2013-14.
- ▶ The team's 98-74 win over Marist Feb. 25, 2018 allowed last year's team to tie the school record for wins in a regular season. The 1993-94 edition of the Griffs also won 21 regular-season games.
- ▶ The Canisius program record for wins in a season is 22, set by the 1993-94 team. That team won a game in the 1994 MAAC Basketball Championship before eventually losing to Villanova in the first round of the 1994 NIT.

2018-19 SCHEDULE FEATURES PLENTY OF MADNESS

- ▶ Canisius' 2018-19 schedule features five non-conference opponents that played in the 2018 NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Tournament last March.
- ▶ The Griffs are one of seven teams in the country to play five or more non-league games against NCAA Tournament teams from a season ago.
- ▶ One of Canisius' five non-league games against NCAA Tournament teams from last year came Nov. 22 when the Griffs played Villanova in the AdvoCare Invitational. This season marks the first time the Blue and Gold have played the defending national champion since the team met Syracuse in 2003-04.

CANISIUS PICKED SECOND IN MAAC POLL

- ▶ Canisius was picked to finish second in the annual MAAC Preseason Coaches Poll. The second-place projection for this year's team is the highest for the Griffs in the history of the preseason poll.
- ▶ The Griffs received 105 votes in the poll, leaving the Blue and Gold 16 points behind the league's preseason favorite, Rider. Canisius and Rider both went 15-3 in league play last season, and the two schools shared the MAAC's regular-season championship title.

REESE NAMED PRESEASON MAAC PLAYER OF THE YEAR

- ▶ Canisius junior Isaiah Reese was named the 2018-19 MAAC Preseason Player of the Year, as voted on by the league's 11 head coaches.
- ▶ Reese, who was one of two unanimous Preseason All-MAAC First Team honorees, is just the second player in school history to be named the MAAC's Preseason Player of the Year. Former Griff Billy Baron also received the award prior to the start of the 2013-14 season.
- ▶ The Miami, Fla., native ended 2017-18 as an All-MAAC First-Team choice, making him the first Canisius sophomore since **Micheal Meeks** in 1994 to be honored to the league's top postseason all-star unit.

MOLSON EARNS MAAC HONORS AS WELL

- ▶ Canisius sophomore guard **Takal Molson** was named to the 2018-19 Preseason All-MAAC Second Team Oct. 23, when the conference officially released its preseason awards live on ESPN3.
- ▶ Molson, the reigning MAAC Rookie of the Year, was one of two Canisius guards honored in the preseason, joining teammate Isaiah Reese.
- ▶ The Buffalo, N.Y., native ranked third on last year's team and second among all MAAC freshmen with his 12.6 points per game scoring average. He is the fourth player in school history to be named the MAAC's Rookie of the Year, and the first since Frank Turner in 2006-07.

MANHERTZ ... TOUCHDOWN!

- ▶ On Dec. 17, former Griffs forward and current Carolina Panthers tight end Chris Manhertz scored his first career touchdown on a 50-yard pass from teammate Christian McCaffery on Monday Night Football.
- ▶ That play against the New Orleans Saints makes Manhertz the first former Griff to score a touchdown in a professional football game since Tom Colella scored for the Cleveland Browns in a game in 1947.
- A former three-time team captain, Manhertz played 116 career games as a Griff during his career on Main Street from 2010-14. His 789 career rebounds ranks fourth all-time in program history.

BINKY GETS THE CALL TO THE HALL

- ▶ Former Canisius guard Dana 'Binky' Johnson (Class of 1994) was recently named as one of six new inductees into the Canisius Sports Hall of Fame.
- ▶ Johnson played in 99 career games for the Griffs from 1990-94, where he averaged 6.7 points, 2.9 rebounds and 4.4 assists per contest.
- ▶ He graduated from Canisius as just the sixth player in school history to distribute more than 300 assists in his time in Blue and Gold.
- ▶ The Norristown, Pa., native ranks fifth in school history with his 183 career steals, and he still holds the program record for steals in a single season with 79 swipes in 1992-93.
- ▶ Johnson, who was a two-time team captain for the Griffs, is the 54th former men's basketball player to be inducted into the school's Hall of Fame.

115TH SEASON OF CANISIUS HOOPS

- ▶ Canisius embarks on the 115th season of basketball this year. Canisius has sponsored varsity basketball longer than any other team in the MAAC.
- ▶ The 2018-19 campaign also marks the 30th season of MAAC membership for the program.
- ▶ The Griffs played their first basketball game Dec. 7, 1903, a 14-6 win over Gordon's of Buffalo.
- ▶ The program has made a total of 14 postseason appearances (5 NCAA, 4 NIT, 4 CIT, 1 CBI). Canisius' appearance in the 2018 CBI marked the fifth time in the last six years where the Blue and Gold have earned a postseason berth.



- ▶ Canisius named **Reggie Witherspoon** the program's 24th head coach in program history May 28, 2016.
- ▶ In his first two seasons at Canisius, Witherspoon has compiled 39 overall wins, with 25 of those victories coming in MAAC play.
- ▶ His 2017-18 team tied the school record for wins in the regular season with 21, and the Griffs' 15 MAAC victories last year set a new program standard for league wins in a single season.
- ▶ Those 15 MAAC wins allowed Canisius to earn a share of the 2017-18 MAAC regular-season championship, the program's first since 1993-94.
- ▶ Witherspoon joins with former Canisius head coach **Jim Baron** as the only two coaches in program history to lead Canisius to back-to-back national tournaments in their first two years on Main Street.
- A Buffalo native, Witherspoon returned to his hometown to take over the Golden Griffin program after spending the 2015-16 season on the bench at Chattanooga.
- ▶ Witherspoon led the University at Buffalo program for 14 seasons from 1999-13, where he earned 198 career wins against 228 career losses.
- ▶ A two-time Mid-American Conference Coach of the Year (2004, 2012), he boasted a record of 174-143 in his last 10 years with the Buffalo program.
- ▶ Witherspoon has a MAC regular-season crown, two trips to the MAC Tournament title game, an NIT berth, two bids to the College Basketball Invitational (CBI) and a pair of trips to the CollegeInsider.com Postseason Tournament (CIT) on his head coaching resume.
- ▶ Witherspoon has also coached at the international level, as he has assisted with USA Basketball and the national under-18 team program two times. In 2006, he worked with the USA U-18 tryout team that featured Blake Griffin, Michael Beasley, Jared Bayless and Kyle Singler. In 2010, he was an assistant coach under Jeff Capel and worked with Kyrie Irving, Austin Rivers and Patric Young.
- ▶ Witherspoon began his coaching career at his high school alma mater Sweet Home High School in the north suburbs of Buffalo.
- ▶ As a player, Witherspoon played for two seasons at Erie Community College, where his head coach was **John Beilein**. Beilein later went on to be the Canisius head coach from 1992-97, and he now leads the Michigan basketball program.


