OPENING TIP-OFF

• Columbia returns to Madison Square Garden for the first time since 2008 when they face off against Iona, a team they have not faced in 26 years.

• The Lions wrapped up their four-game home stand with a 90-68 victory over Bryant Friday. Columbia outscored the Bulldogs, 47-26, in the second half and shot 58.6 percent from the floor in the win.

• Through games played on Dec. 7, Gabe Stefanini ranks No. 2 in the NCAA in 3-point field goal percentage, converting on 59.5 percent of his attempts from beyond the arc.

• Next up for Columbia is a trip to Chestnut Hill to face Boston College for the second consecutive year. The Lions will then take a 10-day hiatus for final exams.

NEWS/NOTES IONA'S STATUS

The Gaels have dropped three in a row and five of their last six overall, but have played a challenging schedule with games at New Mexico, Providence and VCU. Iona has not played since an 88-59 defeat at VCU on Dec. 1. Four players are averaging double-figures in scoring, led by E.J. Crawford at 15.0 PPG. Rickey McGill is dishing out 6.0 assists per game.

The Ivy League men's and women's basketball tournaments will be held at John J. Lee Amphitheater on the campus of Yale, March 16-17, 2019. The top four teams will earn berths to the tournament, with the semifinals on Saturday and the championships on Sunday. All six games will be broadcast live on ESPN's networks. INSIDE THE SERIES

Iona is 4-0 all-time against Columbia. The teams have not met since Dec. 1, 1992, an 80-68 victory by the Gaels, in a game played in Queens.

COLUMBIA VS. THE MAAC

The Lions hold a 23-26 record against teams currently in the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference. Columbia's most common opponent is Manhattan, who it has faced 24 times (15-9).

COLUMBIA AT MADISON SQUARE GARDEN

The Lions are 13-10 in games played at The World's Most Famous Arena. Columbia's last appearance at MSG came in the 2008-09 campaign, where they fell to Virginia Tech, 64-52, before topping Marist, 63-57, at the Aeropostale Holiday Festival. The Lions captured the 1967 Holiday Festival Championship, defeating West Virginia, Louisville and St. John's on their way to the program's lone Ivy League Championship. Overall, this is the Lions fourth appearance in the Holiday Festival.

AVENUE Q

One of the top 3-point threats in the Ivy League, Quinton Adlesh is coming off three-straight solid performances, averaging 17 points off the bench. Adlesh had a season-high 20 points on 6-11 shooting from downtown in the win over Bryant. He is currently third in the Ivy League in 3-point makes per game (3.1) and fifth in 3-point field goal percentage (45.5). Here are a few notes about the sharpshooter from his breakout 2017-18 campaign.

- He converted on 44.2 percent of his tries from 3-point range, which was tops in the Ivy League and 14th in the NCAA for players averaging at least 2.5 makes per game.

- Adlesh made 72 treys last year, putting him sixth on the Lions' single-season list and is currently third on the career 3-point field goal percentage list (.434).

- Columbia went 6-2 when he knocked down four or more treys (1-2 in 2018-19).

STEFANINI MAGNifico

Gabe Stefanini has been the most consistent 3-point shooter for Columbia thus far, knocking down 22-of-37 (59.5 percent) from long range to rank No. 2 in the country in that category. He has dropped 20 or more points on three occasions and against FIU on Nov. 17, the sophomore scored 33 points (the most by a Columbia player since Maodo Lo had 37 at Princeton in March 2016). In a win over St. Joseph's (Brooklyn) on Nov. 25, Stefanini went off for 23 points in just 15 minutes, going 7-of-9 from 3-point range.

IF I COULD BE LIKE MIKE

After another summer of training with NBA All-Star Jimmy Butler, point guard Mike Smith is having a strong start to his junior campaign.

- He ranks fifth in the Ivy League in scoring (15.8 PPG) and leads the Ancient Eight in assists (5.0) and steals (2.3).

- The 2018 All-Ivy Leaguer dropped a career-high 31 points twice - against Youngstown State on Nov. 17 and Delaware on Dec. 2. He has also tied personal-best with eight assists twice and equaled his career-high with five steals against the Blue Hens.

- Smith now has 963 career points, which puts him on pace to become the 29th Columbia player to reach 1,000 points.

MEN IN THE MIDDLE

Columbia is receiving solid production from all three players that have played the "five spot" this season. The trio has helped the Lions take the Ivy League league in offensive rebounds (10.8) and rank No. 2 in rebound margin (+3.4) and No. 3 in team rebounding (37.8).

- Ike Nweke was named Ivy League Rookie of the Week on Nov. 12 after posting 17 points and seven boards at Marist in his collegiate debut. He is averaging 7.3 points, on 55.3 percent shooting from the floor, and 4.8 rebounds.

- Patrick Tapé is converting on 69.2 percent of his attempts, and is posting 6.4 points and 3.4 rebounds in just 14.0 minutes per contest as he works his way back from a minor knee injury suffered during the preseason.

- After seeing limited action in 2017-18, Randy Brumant is taking advantage of a bigger role. The Houston, Texas, native boasts averages of 6.4 points and 8.4 rebounds, which is currently second in the Ivy League, to go with a 59.0 percent clip from the field. He has reached double-digit rebounds in two of the past four games and his 19 rebounds against St. Joseph's (Brooklyn) on Nov. 25 was the most for a Lion since Mark Cisco pulled down 20 in a game against Cornell in 2012.

SHARING IS CARING

Columbia has averaged 21.0 assists per game over its last four contests and sit atop the Ivy League, averaging 18.4 per contest for the year, which also ranks 15th in the NCAA.

Columbia will be featured on linear television eight times in 2018-19, highlighted by a March 1 matchup at Brown that will be televised on ESPNU at 5 p.m. Columbia's game against Iona at Madison Square Garden Sunday, December 9, will be aired on FS1 at 11 a.m. The Lions will have six games broadcast on SportsNet New York (SNY), with three airing live and three more aired on tape delay.

In July 2018, the Ivy League and ESPN agreed to a long-term relationship to showcase Ivy League events through a variety of ESPN platforms, including at least 24 events annually on ESPN's linear networks and more than 1,100 annually on ESPN+. Launched in April 2018, ESPN+ is available through the ESPN app and ESPN.com for \$4.99/month and \$49.99/year. The subscription includes over 175 Ivy League men's and women's basketball games as well as thousands of other live events from other collegiate conferences and professional sports leagues.

Lance Medow is the men's basketball play-by-play announcer. Since 2006, he's called games in various sports for both Columbia and the Ivy League including baseball, football, soccer and women's basketball. Medow performs a variety of on-air work for several sports and media organizations. He hosts various shows on Sirius XM's numerous sports channels including Mad Dog Sports Radio, NFL Radio, NBA Radio and Bleacher Report Radio and has also called play-by-play of the McDonald's All-American Game High School Boys Basketball Game for SiriusXM. In addition to his work on satellite radio, since 2013, Medow serves as the Pre/Half/Post Game Host on the WFAN Giants Radio Network.

FROM DOWNTOWN

The Lions knocked down a team record 17 3-pointers in its win over St. Joseph's (Brooklyn) on Nov. 25. Columbia is took advantage of the friendly confines of Levien Gym during its four-game home stand, knocking down 53-of-124 (42.8 percent) from beyond the arc and is knocking down 10.6 treys per game (13th in the NCAA) after leading the conference in 2017-18 with an average of 10.0 per contest last season.

KLEPTOMANIACS

Defensively, some the Lions have been much more active during the home stand, registering 10.8 steals per game. On the season, Columbia paces the Ivy League, posting 8.0 per game.

STRANGER THINGS

If the Lions didn't have bad luck, they'd have no luck at all the past two years. More than half (14) of Columbia's losses have come by two possessions or less and the Lions are 1-14 in games decided by that margin. Analytically, Columbia is ranked last out of 353 NCAA Division programs in the category by KenPom (-.318) and TeamRankings.com (-2.8). Last season, the Lions at -.146 according to KenPom and TeamRankings.com had them -4.5, - both were was last in the NCAA.

TRIO OF ALUMNI ENTER COLUMBIA ATHLETICS HALL OF FAME

Heyward Dotson and David Newmark, two key members of Columbia's 1968 Ivy League Championship squad were inducted into the Columbia Athletics Hall of Fame on Oct. 18. Dotson was a three-time All-Ivy League selection before earning a Rhodes Scholarship to Oxford. A 7-foot center, Newmark averaged 19.9 points per game during his tenure with the Lions and went to play in the NBA for the Chicago Bulls and Atlanta Hawks. Additionally, the first-ever head coach of the Lions and Naismith Hall of Famer Harry A. Fisher earned the honor.

LIONS PICKED SEVENTH IN PRESEASON IVY LEAGUE POLL

The Lions were predicted to finish seventh in the preseason Ivy League poll, conducted by selected members of the media. Harvard edged out defending champion Penn as the early favorites, with the Crimson receiving 137 points and 12 first-place votes. Yale was picked third followed by Princeton to make up the top-four. Brown, Cornell, the Lions and Dartmouth completed the prognostications.

JIM ENGLES

HEAD COACH • THIRD SEASON
DICKINSON '90

2015 Metropolitan and Mid-Major Coach of the Year Jim Engles became the 23rd head coach in the 116-year history of the Columbia men's basketball program in April 2016.

The Lions boasted one of the top offenses in the Ivy League in 2017-18, leading the conference with 10.0 made 3-pointers per game. Columbia averaged 76.4 points per game, which was also second in the Ancient Eight. Individually, Mike Smith picked up All-Ivy League Second Team and Third Team All-Met accolades after averaging 17.6 points and 4.6 assists per game.

In his brief tenure, three players have gone on to play professionally. Luke Petrasek '17CC has spent the last two seasons with the Greensboro Swarm, the NBA G League affiliate of the Charlotte Hornets. Jeff Coby '17CC spent 2017-18 in Spain, signed a training camp deal with the New York Knicks in 2018 and is currently with the Westchester Knicks in the G League. Lukas Meisner enters his first season with Medi Bayreuth in his native Germany.

In 2016-17, several players also enjoyed breakout seasons under the direction of Engles. Petrasek garnered second team All-Ivy League and third team All-Met honors after averaging 15.1 points. Smith set a Columbia rookie scoring record with 368 points.

Engles returned to Columbia after spending eight years as head coach for the New Jersey Institute of Technology. Over his final six seasons at NJIT, Engles compiled a 100-88 record, including back-to-back 20-win seasons in 2014-15 and 2016-17. Prior to leading the Highlanders, Engles served as an assistant coach at Columbia under former head coach Joe Jones from 2003 to 2008.

NJIT had competed at the Division I level for only two seasons when Engles arrived in 2008, and in three years he turned them into a 15-win program. In 2014-15, he directed the Highlanders to a 21-12 record, including an upset at No. 16 Michigan and a postseason berth, advancing to the semifinals of the CollegeInsider.com Tournament (CIT).

At the conclusion of the 2014-15 season, Engles was named John McLendon National Coach of the Year honors from CollegeInsider.com, received the Peter A. Carlesimo Division I co-Coach of the Year from the Metropolitan Writers Association and was a finalist for the Skip Prosser Man of the Year and Hugh Durham National Coach of the Year awards.

In 2015-16, Engles once again led the Highlanders to the semifinals of the CIT, where they faced the eventual champions, Columbia, at Levien Gym last week. His team also finished tied for second place in the America Sun Conference in its first year in the league.

In addition to the tremendous success over those two years, Engles won a Great West regular season championship and was selected the Great West Conference Coach of the Year in 2012-13. In 2010-11, he picked up a vote for AP National Coach of the Year after NJIT posted a 15-15 record.

The success of Engles' Highlanders squads culminated with

NJIT committing to build a new \$100 million Wellness and Events Center and receiving an invitation to join the Atlantic Sun Conference after spending two years without any conference affiliation.

In his first stint with the Lions, Engles helped Joe Jones turn around the Columbia program from a last-place finish in The Ivy League, into a consistent competitor in non-conference and league play, including the first .500 finish in league play since 1992-93.

Prior to joining Columbia as an assistant in 2003, Engles spent the previous six seasons at Rider University, where he was the top assistant coach for the Broncs under Don Harnum, as well as their recruiting coordinator. Rider's basketball program enjoyed great success with Engles on staff, including winning the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference regular-season title during the 2001-02 season and making the school's first appearance in the postseason NIT in 1998.

Before joining Rider, Engles spent seven seasons as an assistant coach at Wagner College. He assisted Tim Capstraw in guiding the Seahawks to the best winning-percentage turnaround in Division I basketball, going from four wins in 1991-92 to 16 in 1992-93. Wagner also recorded the most Division I wins in school history during that time, and competed against Rider for the Northeast Conference Championship in 1993 on national TV
