LAST TIME OUT: Marist fell on the road at MAAC-leading Rider, 86-85, on Sunday, Jan. 27. The Red Foxes held a 16-point lead in the second half, but Rider erased its deficit with a 16-0 run over a span of 4:18. **Ryan Funk** scored a career-high 32 points and drained seven three-pointers to lead the Red Foxes, followed by **Brian Parker** with 19 points, five rebounds, and four assists. Marist shot .500 from the field and .556 from three-point range. The Red Foxes tied a season high with 15 three-pointers.

ABOUT IONA: In their last outing on Sunday, Jan. 27, the Gaels were defeated at Fairfield by a score of 80-68. **E.J. Crawford** leads four Gaels averaging in double figures at 17.4 points per game. Iona leads the MAAC in points per game (80.1) and field goal percentage (.465). Head coach **Tim Cluess** is in his ninth season, and has led the Gaels to postseason play each of the last eight years, including five NCAA Tournament appearances.

WHAT'S NEXT: Marist opens February play at home against Fairfield on Saturday at 7 p.m. The game will be broadcast live on ESPN+.

Marist is 46-for-102 (.451) from three-point range in their last four games. ... Marist has shot at least .500 from the field seven times this season, including each of its last two games. ... In his last three games, **Ryan Funk** is averaging 22.0 points and shooting .533 (16-for-30) from three-point range. Funk is in third place in program history in three-pointers made (236). He is three three-pointers away from second-place **Danny Basile**, who had 239 in his career. ... **Brian Parker** has scored in double figures in nine straight games. His longest career streak of scoring in double figures is 11.

First Season
Ithaca College/1992
Record at Marist: 7-13

John Dunne was hired as the 12th head coach in Marist men's basketball program history on April 3, 2018. A well-respected coach for his work at the conference, regional, and national levels, Dunne arrived at Marist after a successful 12-year tenure as head coach at Saint Peter's University.

Championships

- 2017 CollegeInsider.com postseason tournament (CIT). Came from behind in three road victories, including championship game at Texas A&M Corpus Christi.
- 2011 Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference tournament. Won as #4 seed, with victories over #1 Fairfield on its home court in semifinals and #2 Iona in championship game.

- 2011 finalist for Skip Prosser Award (established in 2008 to honor those who achieve success on the basketball court & display moral integrity off of it).
- NCAA Men's Basketball Rules Committee (2010-13; chair, 2012-13).

- MAAC Men's Basketball Committee (2011-present).
- NABC (1996-present).
- Active in Coaches vs. Cancer.

Head Coach, Saint Peter's (2006-18)

- 2017-18: Became the first #9 seed to reach MAAC Championship semifinal round with victory over top-seeded Rider.
- 2016-17: Won CIT championship, the program's first national postseason championship. Won 23 games, second-highest total in school history. Set program record with 14 MAAC wins (went 14-6 in conference, finished second). Had program's first MAAC Defensive Player of the Year (Chazz Patterson), two All-MAAC selections (Quadir Welton, First Team; Trevis Wyche, Second Team), and CIT MVP (Welton). Went 18-6 after New Year's Day, including winning 11 out of 12 to close the season.
- Went 26-14 in MAAC play, 2015-16 and 2016-17 seasons.
- Won six MAAC Tournament games and had three semifinal appearances from 2015 to 2018.
- 2010-11: Won program's first MAAC championship since 1995, went 20-11 (program's first 20-win season in 20 years).
- Won 11 MAAC games in the 2009-10 and 2010-11, which hadn't happened at Saint Peter's since 1989.
- Increased the program's win total in each of his first five seasons.
- Defensive success: Ranked second in NCAA in defensive field goal percentage in both 2009-10 (.377)

and 2010-11 (.376). Finished 18th in NCAA in defensive efficiency in 2016-17, becoming one of just 11 teams since 2001-02 to finish in the nation's top 75 in all four factors of defensive efficiency.

-- Won five MAAC Tournament games as the lower-seeded team (two in 2011, one in 2015, two in 2017). Two of these victories occurred in the quarterfinals, one in the semifinals, and one in the championship game.

-- Power conference success: Went 3-3 vs. Rutgers (Big Ten), recorded victories against Alabama (SEC) and Seton Hall (Big East).

-- Coached nine 1,000-point scorers, 13 All-MAAC selections, three All-Rookie Team selections, four MAAC All-Tournament Team selections (including one MVP), one MAAC Defensive Player of the Year, and six MAAC All-Academic Team selections.

-- Graduated 100 percent of his recruits who completed their eligibility at Saint Peter's.

-- Players & coaches donated their time to local soup kitchens in Elizabeth, NJ, and elementary schools in Jersey City, NJ.

-- Core philosophy: "Our philosophy is to develop our student-athletes not only as basketball players, but as active leaders in the community. We are committed to developing the character of each individual in our program to prepare them for life after basketball."

- Western Michigan University (1994-95). First Division I job, worked under head coach Bob Donewald.

Education/Playing Experience

- Earned Master's degree in Sport Management from East Stroudsburg University (1996).
- Earned Bachelor's degree in Psychology from Ithaca College (1992). Was a four-year men's basketball letterwinner. Graduated as the program's all-time leader in steals and third in assists (currently sits fourth in steals, fifth in assists). His 60 steals as a senior rank second in a single season.
- Graduated from Archbishop Molloy High School (1988). Played for legendary head coach Jack Curran.

History vs. Iona

- Iona leads the series, 48-16. The Gaels have won 10 straight in the series overall, and nine straight in Poughkeepsie.
- The winning team has scored at least 80 points in 15 of the last 16 meetings.

Parker's Production

- Senior guard **Brian Parker** is in fifth place in program history with 1,659 career points. Next on the list in fourth place is **Khallid Hart** with 1,879 points.
- Parker is also second in free throws attempted (691), third in free throws made (468), sixth in field goals made (564), seventh in field goals attempted (1,177), seventh in assists (350), and 10th in rebounds (567).
- Parker and **Chavaughn Lewis** (Marist's all-time leading scorer) are the only players at Marist to rank in the top 10 all-time in points, rebounds, and assists.
- Parker is in the MAAC's top 10 in assists (6th, 3.6), assist-to-turnover ratio (7th, 1.1), and points per game (9th, 15.0).
- Parker has scored in double figures in nine straight games. His longest career streak of scoring in double figures is 11.

Facts On Funk

- Senior forward **Ryan Funk** scored his 1,000th career point at Iona on Jan. 18. He scored a career-high 32 points at Rider on Jan. 27. In both games, Funk set a career high with seven three-pointers.
- Funk became the 32nd player in program history to score his 1,000th career point at Marist. He now has 1,064 points, which ranks 24th in program history. Next on the all-time list in 23th place is **Rick Smith** (1,075 points).
- Funk is in third place in program history in three-pointers made (236), and is in third place in three-pointers attempted (617). He is three three-pointers away from second-place **Danny Basile**, who had 239 in his career.
- In his last three games, Funk is averaging 22.0 points and shooting .533 (16-for-30) from three-point range.
- Funk is sixth in the MAAC in three-pointers per game this season (2.7).

Knudsen Connects

- Senior guard **David Knudsen** ranks third in the MAAC in three-point percentage (.434).
- In his last three games, Knudsen is averaging 14.0 points and 4.7 rebounds per game while shooting .615 (16-for-26) from the field and .517 (8-for-14) from three-point range. He scored a season-high 21 at Manhattan on Jan. 21.
- Knudsen has made 13 straight free throws.
- Knudsen was named MAAC Student-Athlete of the Week on Jan. 3.

Lamb's Versatility

- Senior forward **Isaiah Lamb** leads Marist in rebounds (5.0 rpg), is tied for the team lead in steals (0.8 spg), and is third in scoring (8.6 ppg).
- Lamb is sixth in the MAAC in three-point percentage (.422).
- Against Canisius on Jan. 3, Lamb scored a season-high 21 points, and tied his career high with nine rebounds (previously set at Lehigh, Nov. 13).

Hines Lends Helping Hand

- Freshman point guard **Darius Hines** has six double-digit scoring games this season. The Red Foxes have won each one.
- Hines averages 10.4 points per game in Marist's wins, and 5.8 in its losses.

Seniors Shall Lead

- Marist's senior class of **Brian Parker** (15.0 ppg), **Ryan Funk** (11.5 ppg), **Isaiah Lamb** (8.6 ppg), and **David Knudsen** (8.1 ppg) has accounted for 62 percent of the Red Foxes' scoring this year.
- A senior has led Marist in scoring in 19 of its 20 games this season.

- Marist has held the opposition under 40 percent from the field five times this season. The Red Foxes have won all five games.
- Marist has shot at least .500 from the field seven times this season, including each of its last two games. The Red Foxes are shooting .517 (59-for-114) from the field in their last two games.
- The Red Foxes are 6-4 when they shoot at least 47 percent from the field, and 1-8 when they don't.
- Marist is 7-4 when having a better shooting percentage than their opponent, and 0-8 when it doesn't.

- Senior guard **Brian Parker** was named the Tournament's Most Valuable Player, and freshman guard **Darius Hines** was named to the All-Tournament Team.

- Marist held both of its opponents in Northern Ireland to under 60 points and under 40 percent shooting while prevailing by at least 17 points. Dartmouth scored 58 points and shot .377 from the field in an 18-point Marist victory. LIU Brooklyn scored 53 and shot .321 in a 17-point Marist triumph.
- It was the first time Marist held back-to-back opponents under 60 points since November 23 & 25, 2012 (Vanderbilt, 33; Clemson, 59).
- It was the first time Marist held back-to-back opponents under 40 percent shooting since February 1 & 6, 2015 (Canisius, .307; Niagara, .365).
- It was the first time Marist has won back-to-back games both by at least 17 points since January 6 & 9, 2001 (defeated Loyola & Saint Peter's both by 17).
- Marist's 46 points allowed at Manhattan on Jan. 21 were its fewest since Nov. 23, 2012, when the Red Foxes gave up a program-record low 33 to Vanderbilt.

- Senior guard **Brian Parker** was named MAAC Player of the Week on Nov. 12 after averaging 23.0 points and 8.0 rebounds while shooting .517 from the field in the Red Foxes' first two games of the season.
- It was the fourth career MAAC weekly honor for Parker, who earned one Player of the Week honor and two Rookie of the Week awards in the 2015-16 season.
