TIP-OFF: Marist continues its three-game road swing with its first meeting of the season at Iona. It's the first of two contests with the Gaels in a 14-day span. Tip-off is set for 7 p.m.

ON THE AIR: Dean Darling (play-by-play) and Steve Eggink (color) will have the call on the Red Fox Network. Vin Parise (play-by-play) and Adam Finkelstein (color) have the call on Iona's ESPN+ production.

LAST TIME OUT: Marist was defeated at Saint Peter's by a score of 72-63 on Sunday, Jan. 13. Brian Parker led the Red Foxes with 17 points. Marist committed just nine turnovers, but Saint Peter's held a 40-20 edge in rebounds. The Red Foxes shot just 5-for-21 (.238) from three-point range.

ABOUT IONA: The Gaels are three-time defending MAAC champions. Iona has started conference play at 3-1 this season, including 2-0 at home. In their last outing on Sunday, Jan. 13, Iona recorded an 88-70 triumph at Canisius. E.J. Crawford leads four Gaels averaging in double digits in scoring at 17.5 points per game. Head coach Tim Cluess is in his ninth season at the helm, and has guided the Gaels to postseason appearances each of the last eight years, including five trips to the NCAA Tournament.

WHAT'S NEXT: Marist concludes its road swing on Monday, Jan. 21 at Manhattan. Tip-off is scheduled for 7 p.m.

Ryan Funk enters the game with 998 career points. Currently, 31 players have scored their 1,000th career point in a Marist uniform. ... With six rebounds, **Brian Parker** will move into Marist's career top 10. He will also join **Chavaughn Lewis** as the only players in program history to rank in the Red Foxes' all-time top 10 in points, rebounds, and assists. ... **Tobias Sjoberg** is 6-for-7 (.857) from the field in his last two games. ... Marist is 6-2 when shooting at least 47 percent from the field, and 0-8 when shooting under that. ... Marist is shooting .408 on three-pointers in wins, and .327 in losses.

First Season
Ithaca College/1992
Record at Marist: 6-10

John Dunne was hired as the 12th head coach in Marist men's basketball program history on April 3, 2018. A well-respected coach for his work at the conference, regional, and national levels, Dunne arrived at Marist after a successful 12-year tenure as head coach at Saint Peter's University.

Championships

- 2017 CollegeInsider.com postseason tournament (CIT). Came from behind in three road victories, including championship game at Texas A&M Corpus Christi.
- 2011 Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference tournament. Won as #4 seed, with victories over #1 Fairfield on its home court in semifinals and #2 Iona in championship game.

- 2011 finalist for Skip Prosser Award (established in 2008 to honor those who achieve success on the basketball court & display moral integrity off of it).

Head Coach, Saint Peter's (2006-18)

- 2017-18: Became the first #9 seed to reach MAAC Championship semifinal round with victory over top-seeded Rider.
- 2016-17: Won CIT championship, the program's first national postseason championship. Won 23 games, second-highest total in school history. Set program record with 14 MAAC wins (went 14-6 in conference, finished second). Had program's first MAAC Defensive Player of the Year (Chazz Patterson), two All-MAAC selections (Quadir Welton, First Team; Trevis Wyche, Second Team), and CIT MVP (Welton). Went 18-6 after New Year's Day, including winning 11 out of 12 to close the season.
- Went 26-14 in MAAC play, 2015-16 and 2016-17 seasons.
- Won six MAAC Tournament games and had three semifinal appearances from 2015 to 2018.
- 2010-11: Won program's first MAAC championship since 1995, went 20-11 (program's first 20-win season in 20 years).
- Won 11 MAAC games in the 2009-10 and 2010-11, which hadn't happened at Saint Peter's since 1989.
- Increased the program's win total in each of his first five seasons.
- Defensive success: Ranked second in NCAA in defensive field goal percentage in both 2009-10 (.377)

and 2010-11 (.376). Finished 18th in NCAA in defensive efficiency in 2016-17, becoming one of just 11 teams since 2001-02 to finish in the nation's top 75 in all four factors of defensive efficiency.

-- Won five MAAC Tournament games as the lower-seeded team (two in 2011, one in 2015, two in 2017). Two of these victories occurred in the quarterfinals, one in the semifinals, and one in the championship game.

-- Power conference success: Went 3-3 vs. Rutgers (Big Ten), recorded victories against Alabama (SEC) and Seton Hall (Big East).

-- Coached nine 1,000-point scorers, 13 All-MAAC selections, three All-Rookie Team selections, four MAAC All-Tournament Team selections (including one MVP), one MAAC Defensive Player of the Year, and six MAAC All-Academic Team selections.

-- Graduated 100 percent of his recruits who completed their eligibility at Saint Peter's.

-- Players & coaches donated their time to local soup kitchens in Elizabeth, NJ, and elementary schools in Jersey City, NJ.

-- Core philosophy: "Our philosophy is to develop our student-athletes not only as basketball players, but as active leaders in the community. We are committed to developing the character of each individual in our program to prepare them for life after basketball."

- Western Michigan University (1994-95). First Division I job, worked under head coach Bob Donewald.

- Earned Master's degree in Sport Management from East Stroudsburg University (1996).
- Earned Bachelor's degree in Psychology from Ithaca College (1992). Was a four-year men's basketball letterwinner. Graduated as the program's all-time leader in steals and third in assists (currently sits fourth in steals, fifth in assists). His 60 steals as a senior rank second in a single season.
- Graduated from Archbishop Molloy High School (1988). Played for legendary head coach Jack Curran.

History vs. Iona

- Marist is 16-47 against Iona all-time, with the Gaels capturing the last nine.

Parker's Production

- Senior guard **Brian Parker** is in fifth place in program history with 1,601 career points. Next on the list in fourth place is **Khallid Hart** with 1,879 points.
- Parker is also second in free throws attempted (675), third in free throws made (460), seventh in field goals made (541), eighth in field goals attempted (1,127), and eighth in assists (339).
- Parker has 553 career rebounds, just six shy of 10th place in program history. He would join **Chavaughn Lewis** (Marist's all-time leading scorer) as the only players at Marist to rank in the top 10 all-time in points, rebounds, and assists.
- Parker is in the MAAC's top 10 in assists (6th, 3.8), assist-to-turnover ratio (7th, 1.2), and points per game (8th, 15.1).

Facts On Funk

- Senior forward **Ryan Funk** is in fourth place in program history in three-pointers made (220), and is also in fourth place in three-pointers attempted (587).
- Funk has 998 career points. To date, 31 players have scored their 1,000th career point in a Marist uniform.

Lamb's Versatility

- Senior forward **Isaiah Lamb** leads Marist in rebounds (5.1 rpg) and steals (1.0 spg), and is third in scoring (8.6 ppg).
- Against Canisius on Jan. 3, Lamb scored a season-high 21 points, and tied his career high with nine rebounds (previously set at Lehigh, Nov. 13).

Knudsen Connects

- Senior guard **David Knudsen** is seventh in the MAAC in three-point % (.403).
- Knudsen has made 11 straight free throws. He is 11-for-11 from the line in his last four games after going 2-for-4 from the line in his first 12 games this year.
- Knudsen was named MAAC Student-Athlete of the Week on Jan. 3.

Seniors Shall Lead

- Marist's senior class of **Brian Parker** (15.1 ppg), **Ryan Funk** (9.6 ppg), **Isaiah Lamb** (8.6 ppg), and **David Knudsen** (7.3 ppg) has accounted for 61 percent of the Red Foxes' scoring this year.
- A senior has led Marist in scoring in 15 of its 16 games this season.

Strength Of Sjoberg

- Junior center **Tobias Sjoberg** is shooting 6-for-7 (.857) in his last two games.

Team Notes

- Marist leads the MAAC in field goal percentage defense (.438).
- Marist has held the opposition under 40 percent from the field four times in its last 10 games. The Red Foxes have won all four games.
- Marist has shot over .500 from the field five times this season (4-1 record).
- The Red Foxes are 6-2 when they shoot at least 47 percent from the field, and 0-8 when they don't.
- Marist is shooting .408 on three-pointers in wins, and .327 in losses.
- Marist is 4-1 when at least four players score in double digits in a game, and 0-7 when fewer than three players score in double digits.

Long Trip

- Marist set a Division I program record by playing eight straight games away from home from Nov. 13 through Dec. 19. Marist went 4-4 in this stretch.
- The road swing consisted of games in five states (New York, Pennsylvania, New Hampshire, Florida, Texas) as well as a trip to Belfast, Northern Ireland.

Champions In Belfast

- Marist is coming off a championship in the Samson Bracket of the Basketball Hall of Fame Belfast Classic in Northern Ireland. The Red Foxes defeated Dartmouth (76-58, Nov. 29) and LIU Brooklyn (70-53, Nov. 30).
- It marked Marist's first in-season tournament championship since the 2006 Pepsi-Marist Classic, and its first away from campus since the 1984 United First Federal Classic, which was hosted by Florida Southern.
- Senior guard **Brian Parker** was named the Tournament's Most Valuable Player, and freshman guard **Darius Hines** was named to the All-Tournament Team.

- It was the first time Marist held back-to-back opponents under 60 points since November 23 & 25, 2012 (Vanderbilt, 33; Clemson, 59).

- Senior guard **Brian Parker** was named MAAC Player of the Week on Nov. 12 after averaging 23.0 points and 8.0 rebounds while shooting .517 from the field in the Red Foxes' first two games of the season.
- It was the fourth career MAAC weekly honor for Parker, who earned one Player of the Week honor and two Rookie of the Week awards in the 2015-16 season.
