THE BASICS

The Ohio men's basketball team (3-2) returns to action on Tuesday, Nov. 27 when they play host to Iona (2-3). Tip-off is set for 7 p.m. inside the Convocation Center.

Tuesday's game will be streamed live on WatchESPN and the ESPN app, with Marty Bannister and Toni Roesch on the call. The contest will also be broadcast on the Ohio IMG Sports Network, with 'Voice of the Bobcats' Russ Eisenstein and Rob Cornelius on the call. Radio pregame coverage is set to begin at 6:30 p.m. ET with 'Countdown To Tipoff'.

LAST TIME OUT FOR OHIO

The Bobcats are coming off of an 85-82 overtime victory over Austin Peay on Nov. 24 inside the Convocation Center.

Jason Carter (Johnstown, Ohio) finished the game with 25 points, tying his career high, and 10 rebounds. Carter went 11-of-22 from the field, while also dishing out four assists and two blocks. Teyvion Kirk (Joliet, Ill.) also tied a career high with his 24 points. Kirk went 7-of-16 from the field, 1-of-3 from three-point range and 9-of-12 from the free throw line. Kirk also grabbed 10 rebounds and dished out four assists with one steal. Senior forward/guard Gavin Block (Lincoln, Ill.) and junior guard Antonio Cowart, Jr. (McComb, Miss.) also scored double

figures, with Block scoring 11 and Cowart with 10.

As a team, the Bobcats finished the game shooting 43.7 percent (31-of-71) from the field, 23.1 (6-of-26) from three-point range and 63 percent (17-of-27) from the free throw line. Austin Peay finished shooting 43.1 percent (31-of-72) from the field, 36.8 (7-of-19) from the field, and 65 percent (13-of-20) from the free throw line. The Bobcats also outrebounded the Governors 50-41, while also dishing out 17 assists and recording six blocks, compared to Austin Peay's 12 assists and zero blocks. Ohio forced 16 turnovers and scored 17 points off of them, while also scoring 46 points in the paint and 16 second chance points, compared to APSU's 42 points in the paint and nine second chance points.

Austin Peay had five score in double figures and were led by Porter-Bunton who scored 16 points and grabbed five rebounds. Zach Glotta and Dayton Gumm both scored 15 points, while Terry Taylor and Steve Harris both scored 13 points. Taylor led the Governors with eight rebounds, while Harris added five assists for Austin Peay.

SCOUTING OHIO

The Bobcats enter the matchup with Iona with an overall record of 3-2.

Four games into the season, Ohio is averaging 73.0 points per game. They are shooting 41.6 percent from the field, 21.4 percent from three-point range and 67.8 from the free throw line. The Bobcats are also averaging 42.4 rebounds a contest to go along

ATHENS, Ohio —Led by double-doubles from both redshirt sophomore forward Jason Carter and sophomore guard Teyvion Kirk, the Ohio men's basketball team outlasted Austin Peay, 85-82, in overtime on Saturday (Nov. 24) inside the Convocation Center.

Carter (Johnstown, Ohio) finished the game with 25 points, tying his career high, and 10 rebounds. Carter went 11-of-22 from the field, while also dishing out four assists and two blocks. Kirk (Joliet, Ill.) also tied a career high with his 24 points. Kirk went 7-of-16 from the field, 1-of-3 from three-point range and 9-of-12 from the free throw line. Kirk also grabbed 10 rebounds and dished out four assists with one steal. Senior forward/guard Gavin Block (Lincoln, Ill.) and junior guard Antonio Cowart, Jr. (McComb, Miss.) also scored double figures, with Block scoring 11 and Cowart with 10.

As a team, the Bobcats finished the game shooting 43.7 percent (31-of-71) from the field, 23.1 (6-of-26) from three-point range and 63 percent (17-of-27) from the free throw line. TUESDAY'S MATCHUP

SCOUTING IONA

Iona enters the matchup with Ohio with an overall record of 2-3 and are coming off of a 91-79 loss at Providence on Nov. 24.

Iona is averaging 79.8 points per game and is shooting .446 for the field, .328 from three-point range and .725 from the charity stripe. The Gaels are averaging 30.2 rebounds per game, to go along with 14.6, 10.0 and 1.6 blocks per game. Iona also turns the ball over an average of 14.8 times a game, while forcing opponents to turn the ball over 18.4 times a game.

The Gaels allow opponents to score on average, 82.0 points per game, while allowing them to shoot about .478 from the field, .420 from three-point range and .757 from the free throw line. Opponents are also grabbing an average of 36.2 rebounds per games.

Individually, E.J. Crawford is averaging a team-leading 17.0 points per game and 4.0 rebounds per game. Crawford is shooting .492 from the field, .313 from three-point range and .851 from the free throw line. Asante Gist is next, averaging 13.6 points per game while shooting 43.8 percent from the field, 33.3 percent from beyond the arc and 73.9 percent from the free throw line.

Rickey McGill is averaging 12.8 points per game and has a team-high 34 assists and 10 steals, while Tajuan Agee is averaging a team-high 5.4 rebounds per game.

IN IONA'S LAST GAME

Iona is coming off of a 91-79 loss at the hands of Providence on Nov. 24. In that game, E.J. Crawford led the Gaels with 21 points, going 8-of-18 from the field, 3-of-7 from three and 2-of-2 from the free throw line, while also grabbing five rebounds. Asante Gist scored 21 points, going 6-of-12 from the field and 7-of-8 from the free throw line and had five boards. Rickey McGill and Niksa Nikolic both scored 14 points, while McGill dished out a team-high eight assists and Nikolic led the team in rebounding, with eight boards.

As a team, Iona shot 50.9 percent from the field, 30.0 percent from three-point range and 83.3 percent from the free throw line. The Gaels also grabbed 30 rebounds, had 15 assists and six steals.

For Providence, Alpha Diallo led all scorers with 23 points on 8-of-12 shooting. Nate Watson had 13 points, including eight straight for Providence in the second half. A.J. Reeves also dropped 20 and Isaiah Jackson finished with 13.

SERIES HISTORY

This is the third all-time meeting between the Bobcats and Gaels, with Iona leading the all-time series, 2-0.

LAST TIME AGAINST IONA

Ohio and Iona last met on Nov. 28, 2017, with the Gaels defeating the Bobcats, 93-88 in Athens.

In that game, Senior guard Mike Laster had a game-high 23 points, making 10 of his 19 shots while totaling four rebounds, a block and a steal in 36 minutes of action. He posted his third-straight contest with at least 20 points. Gavin Block scored 18 points in his 34 minutes of play. He also added four assists, three rebounds, and a steal. Junior guard Jordan Dartis totaled 15 points, knocking down four triples and sinking all three of his free throw attempts. He also logged five assists to tie for the team lead in addition to three rebounds over 38 minutes. Teyvion Kirk finished the contest with 14 points, five assists to tie for the team lead, four rebounds, a block and a steal in 29 minutes of action. Doug Taylor totaled double-digit rebounds for the third game in a row, piling up a game-high 13. He also notched four points, four assists and a game-high three blocks over 32 minutes.

Sophomore guard/forward E.J. Crawford and graduate forward TK Edogi each tallied 20 points to lead the way for the Gaels. Edogi achieved a double-double with a team-high 12 rebounds. Lewis and junior guard Rickey McGill also finished in double figures in points with 16 and 15, respectively.

with 15.4 assists, 8.2 steals and 4.8 blocks per game.

Individually, Jason Carter is averaging 18.4 points and 7.6 rebounds per game. He is shooting 50.8 percent from the field and 71.0 percent from the free throw line. Meanwhile, Teyvion Kirk is adding 15.8 points per game 5.6 rebounds and 2.8 assists per game.

Vander Plas is averaging 10.2 points and 5.6 rebounds while shooting 45.0 from the field.

Doug Taylor is leading the Bobcats with 8-0 rebounds and 2.2 blocks per game.

CARTER'S RETURN ALREADY FELT

Five games into the season and the return of Jason Carter has already been felt. The redshirt sophomore, who missed all but three games in 2017-18, has been a force for the Bobcats.

Carter has led the Bobcats in scoring in four of the first five games for Ohio, recording a double-double against Wilberforce, and scoring 24 points against Campbell.

Carter also added a double-double against Austin Peay on Nov. 24, while trying a career-high with 25 points in that matchups.

So far this season, Carter is averaging 18.4 points and 7.6 rebounds per game. He is shooting 50.8 percent from the field and 71.8 percent from the free throw line.

BIG BEN ALERT

Ben Vander Plas' addition to the lineup as also been notability. The redshirt freshman, who missed all of last season due to injury, has been the Bobcats' biggest source off the bench, scoring 16 against Wilberforce, 15 against Campbell and 10 points against LMU.

Vander Plas is averaging 10.2 points and 5.6 rebounds while shooting .450 from the field.

500 W'S IN THE CONVO

Not only is this the 50th anniversary of the opening of the Convocation Center, but another milestone was set on Nov. 12.

With Ohio's win over Campbell, the Bobcats reached 500

victories inside the Convo.

OHIO IN THE MAC -TEAM

In the Mid-American Conference, the Bobcats currently rank second in rebounding offense (42.4), fourth in rebounding defense (33.6), second in rebounding margin (+8.8), third in offensive rebounds (13.8), second in defensive rebounds (28.6) and first in defensive rebounding percentage (.808).

Ohio is also third in steals (8.2) and fourth in blocked shots (4.8).

OHIO IN THE MAC -INDIVIDUAL

Individually, Carter is seventh in the MAC in scoring (18.4), while Taylor is eighth in rebounding (8.0), while Carter is 10th in the same category (7.6).

Kirk is tied for fifth in steals (1.8), while Taylor is third in blocked shots (2.2). Taylor and Carter are also tied for seventh in offensive rebounds per game with 3.2 each.

90-POINT MARK

The Bobcats have already reached the 90-point mark in 2018-19. Ohio is 15-2 when scoring at least 90 points under Phillips.

In 2017-18 Ohio scored at least 90 points six times.

JAMAICA CLASSIC ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM

Redshirt sophomore Jason Carter was named to the Jersey Mike's Jamaica Classic All-Tournament Team for his performance in Montego Bay.

Carter averaged 13.0 points, 5.5 rebounds and .833 from the free throw line in the Bobcats' two games.

TK GOING FOR ROUND TWO

Sophomore guard Teyvion Kirk looks to pick up where he left off last season. Currently, Kirk is second on the team with 15.8 points per game. He also added 5.6 rebounds, while shooting 45 percent from the field. He has also recorded 14 total assists and nine steals for the Bobcats.

BLOCK PARTY

Doug Taylor, who currently registers 101 blocks in his career, needs four more to tie Gary Trent for 10th all-time in program history.

BOBCATS PREVAIL OVER AUSTIN PEAY IN OT

It would take an extra five minutes for the Bobcats to outlast Austin Peay in the Convocation Center on Nov. 24.

With the Bobcats trailing by five with three minutes remaining in the extra period, Ohio would go on to force five stops to go on an 8-0 run the remaining minutes, ultimately defeating the Governors, 85-82.

OHIO IN OVERTIME GAMES

Ohio 85-82 overtime victory on Nov. 24 was the first OT win of the season. Ohio is now 66-47 all-time in overtime game and is 32-18 all-time in OT games inside the Convo.

On the road, the Bobcats are 26-24 in OT and 7-6 in neutral site games.

Ohio is 8-8 all-time in 2OT games, 0-2 in 3OT games and 1-2

in 4 OT games.

The Bobcats are 4-2 all-time in overtime games in Phillips.

OHIO COMES FROM BEHIND TO DEFEAT CAMPBELL

Ohio had to come from behind to pick up a victory against Campbell on Nov. 12 inside the Convocation Center, defeating the Camels, 81-73.

In that matchup, Jason Carter led the Bobcats again with 24 points, going 8-of-10 from the field and 8-of-10 from the free throw line. Next was Doug Taylor who wrapped up the game with his first double-double of the season, scoring 14 points and grabbing 10 rebounds. Teyvion Kirk and Ben Vander Plas both finished with 14 points, while Jason Preston finished with 12 points.

As a team, Ohio shot .491 from the field, .389 from three-point range and .667 from the free throw line. The Bobcats also grabbed 40 boards, dished out 17 assists and had five steals and six blocks. The Bobcats also scored 15 points off of turnovers and 36 points in the paint.

RETURNING FOR OHIO IN 2018-19

The Bobcats return seven from last season, including guard Teyvion Kirk who garnered MAC All-Freshman Team honors in 2017-18, as well as led the Bobcats in points per game (15.3) and steals (42).

Senior forward Doug Taylor and guard/forward Gavin Block (Lincoln, Ill.) will also be back for the Bobcats. Taylor led the squad last season with 61 blocks and 7.1 rebounds per game, while Block added 8.5 points and a team-leading 106 assists.

Dartis averaged 13.1 points for Ohio during the 2017-18 season, while leading the Bobcats with 78 three-pointers made, while Gollon led the Bobcats at the charity stripe, shooting 87 percent from the free throw line.

Bobcat fans will also see nine new faces on the court this season, with transfers Connor Murrell (Sioux City, Iowa), Jarrell Reeves (Murfreesboro, Tenn.) and Antonio Cowart, Jr., and freshmen Jason Preston (Orlando, Fla.), Nate Springs (Charlotte, N.C.), Torey James (Hickory, N.C.), John Tenerowicz (Cleveland, Ohio), Chris McGraw (Columbus, Ohio) and Mason McMurray (Stow, Ohio) seeing court time for Ohio in their first season with the Green and White.

CARTER RETURNS

After playing in only three games during the 2017-18 season, Carter returns to pick up where he left off after his freshman campaign.

Redshirt freshman Ben Vander Plas will get his chance in 2018-19 to show Bobcat fans what he is all about. The forward missed all of 2017-18 due to injury.

YEAR FIVE OF PHILLIPS ERA

Ohio enters its fifth season under the direction of Phillips in 2018-19. Phillips has led the Bobcats to 69 wins over the past four-plus seasons. He coached his 100th game on the Ohio bench in the quadruple overtime triumph over Indiana State in the Charleston Classic.

Phillips, who served seven years as the head coach at North Dakota State before coming to Athens, reached the 200-career win mark with the victory over Bowling Green.

PROTECT THIS HOUSE

Ohio has registered an impressive 501-161 (.756) all-time record at the Convocation Center, which opened in 1968.

In three-plus seasons under Phillips, Ohio has gone 49-19 (.708) at home.

A LOOK BACK AT 2017-18

Ohio is coming off a 14-11 (7-11 MAC) season in 2017-18 in a season that was hampered by injuries.

The Bobcats averaged 75.3 points per game and 36.3 boards. As a team, Ohio shot .443 from the field, .369 from three-point range and .712 from the free throw line.

Kirk led Ohio with 15.3 points and 6.1 rebounds per game. Kirk also dished out 95 assists and registered 42 steals.

Block led Ohio with 106 assists and 8.5 points per game, while Taylor registered 61 blocks in 2017-18.

OHIO PICKED TO FINISH FOURTH IN MAC EAST

In a vote, which was determined by the league's 12 head coaches and a 23-member MAC News Media Panel, the Bobcats earned 121 points. Ohio was picked to finish behind Buffalo, which earned a conference-high 210 points and received a unanimous 35-first place votes, Miami, which earned 127 points and Kent State who received 122 points. Akron has been tabbed to finish fifth in the MAC East after earning 97 points, while Bowling Green rounded out the division with 58 points.

Eastern Michigan has been selected to win the MAC West Division after racking up 183 points and receiving 17 first-place votes. Ball State has been picked to finish second in the MAC West after earning 175 points and receiving 11 first-

place votes. Rounding out the West was Toledo (156 points, five first place), Western Michigan (81 points, one first place), Northern Illinois (73 points) and Central Michigan (67 points, one first place).

The Bulls have been selected as the favorite to win the 2019 MAC Basketball Tournament with a conference-high 25 votes. Eastern Michigan (3), Toledo (3), Central Michigan (1), Miami (1), Northern Illinois (1) and Western Michigan (1) also received votes to capture the conference tournament crown. The 2019 MAC Basketball Tournament will once again be held at Quicken Loans Arena in Cleveland. This year's tournament will begin on March 11 with first round games on campus before moving to Cleveland (March 14-16). The tournament quarterfinal games will air on ESPN+, with the semifinals on CBS Sports Network, while the title game will be played on Saturday, March 16 on ESPN2 at 7 p.m. Ohio will be looking to earn its seventh MAC tournament crown in program history and first since 2012.

JAMAICA ME CRAZY

The Ohio men's basketball team announced their participation in the 2018 Jersey Mike's Jamaica Classic in September.

In its second year, the annual pre-season college basketball tournament will be held in Montego Bay, Jamaica from November 16-18, 2018, in one of the most iconic destinations in the Caribbean. With its picturesque beaches, modern resorts, and exciting nightlife, Montego Bay is one of the Caribbean's most popular tourist destinations – and a great setting for the 2018 Jersey Mike's Jamaica Classic.

In addition to Ohio, seven (7) other universities round out the host and travel teams participating, including Austin Peay State University, Campbell University, Central Connecticut State University, Florida A&M University, Georgetown University, Loyola Marymount University, and University of South Florida. Eight (8) tournament games will be held on the four (4) host campus sites and eight (8) games at the Montego Bay Convention Centre in Jamaica.

All games played in the Montego Bay Convention Centre will be televised live on CBS Sports Network.

MEET THE COACHING STAFF

Assistant coaches Will Ryan, Jason Kemp and Jared Swanson return Phillips' staff in 2018-19.

Ryan served as an assistant coach at North Dakota State for seven seasons under Phillips while Kemp spent eight seasons on the basketball staff at North Dakota State, first as a graduate assistant coach for two seasons (2005-07) under current Nebraska head coach Tim Miles and for six years (2007-13) as an assistant Phillips. He came to Athens after a memorable one-year stint under head coach Tod Kowalczyk at Toledo in 2013-14.

Swanson is in his second season as an assistant after spending the previous three years as director of operations for the Bobcats, a role in which he managed all day-to-day men's basketball operations, handled the program's budget, all aspects of team and recruiting travel, academic development and game scheduling. Swanson also served as director of

Saul Phillips enters his fifth season as head coach of the Ohio men's basketball program in 2018-19.

Under Phillips, the Bobcats have won at least 20 games, placed second in the overall Mid-American Conference standings with 11 conference wins and advanced to the league tournament semifinals in each of the past two seasons. Ohio has won 67 games over four seasons under his watch.

Ohio went 20-11 (11-7 MAC) in 2016-17. The Bobcats locked down the No. 2 seed in the 2017 MAC Tournament presented by VisitMyrtleBeach.com for the second year in a row, earning a bye to the quarterfinals. Ohio topped No. 7-seeded Toledo in the quarters, 67-66, before falling to No. 6-seed and eventual tournament champion Kent State, 68-66, in the league semifinals. Phillips navigated Ohio to another 20-win campaign despite the loss of senior forward Antonio Campbell -- the 2016 MAC Player of the Year -- to a season-ending foot injury 15 games into the season.

Ohio's 2,387 points scored in 2016-17 marked the ninth-most in a single season in program history after the '15-16 squad accounted for the second-most with 2,746. The Bobcats drained 285 three-point field goals in 2016-17, which ranked second only to the 296 the '15-16 squad made. Ohio's 38.4 percent three-point field goal percentage in 2016-17 ranked third-best in program history after the '15-16 team posted the second-best percentage by hitting 38.6 percent of its threes.

Redshirt junior guard Jaaron Simmons was named to the 2016-17 National Association of Basketball Coaches All-District 14 First Team and garnered First Team All-MAC honors for the second year in a row after leading Ohio in scoring (15.9 points per game; 492 points) and assists (6.5 assists per game; 200 assists). His 200 assists ranked as the sixth-most in a single season in program history. Sophomore guard Jordan Dartis earned Second Team All-MAC honors after shooting 44.1 percent (86-of-

195) from three-point range, which ranked as the seventh-best three-point field goal percentage in a single season in program history and ranked as the best in the conference and 11th in the nation. Filling the void left by Campbell's injury, forward Jason Carter earned All-MAC Freshman Team selection after logging 306 points (9.9 per game) to rank fourth on the team, 202 rebounds (6.5 per game) to lead the team and 20 blocks (0.6 per game) to rank second on the team. Carter achieved six double-doubles to tie for the team lead.

Ohio posted 23 victories in 2015-16 -- including an 11-7 mark in MAC play. The 2015-16 Ohio squad matched the 1998-99 team for the biggest turnaround in program history. The Bobcats improved by 13 wins under Phillips after posting just 10 victories in 2014-15. The 2015-16 Bobcats matched the 1982-83 team for the sixth-most wins in a single season in program history. After earning the No. 2 seed in the 2016 MAC Tournament presented by VisitMyrtleBeach.com and a bye to Cleveland, Ohio defeated No. 7-seeded Northern Illinois, 79-62, on March 10 in the quarterfinals before falling to No. 3-seeded Buffalo in the semifinals the following day, 88-74. The Bobcats made their 22nd postseason appearance in program history and advanced to the semifinals of the 2016 College Basketball Invitational after beating Albany in overtime in the first round, 94-90, on March 16 and knocking off UNCG, 72-67, on March 21 in the quarterfinals. Ohio's season ended two days later with a 77-72 defeat at the hands of Morehead State.

Ohio's 937 field goals made in 2015-16 tied for second-most in a single season in program history. The Bobcats surpassed the 90-point mark five times in 2015-16 and eclipsed the 80-point mark 16 times.

Campbell was named a 2015-16 Associated Press Honorable Mention All-America selection, the 2016 MAC Player of the Year, a 2015-16 National Association of Basketball Coaches Division I First Team All-

District 14 honoree and a 2016 First Team All-MAC pick. Simmons earned 2015-16 NABC Division I Second Team All-District 14 honors. The Second Team All-MAC selection's 275 assists went down as the most in both program and MAC history. Dartis garnered All-MAC Freshman Team selection for his efforts last season after setting the program's single-season record with a 47.9 percent three-point field goal percentage.

The Phillips era began with a 73-47 victory over Appalachian State on Nov. 15, 2014, at the Convocation Center. The Bobcats posted a record-setting 99-78 win over Big East Conference foe DePaul on Dec. 23, 2014, in the 2014 Hawaiian Airlines Diamond Head Classic to highlight non-conference play in 2014-15. Ohio set a Hawaiian Airlines Diamond Head Classic record with 99 points -- the most since Indiana State edged Ole Miss, 87-85, in overtime in 2012.

Ohio's 2015 Mid-American Conference slate featured home victories over East Division rivals Miami, Akron and eventual league tournament champion Buffalo. Phillips picked up his first MAC win on Jan. 21 -- an 82-73 triumph over Ball State in Muncie, Ind. Ohio closed the regular season by storming past Miami, 95-65, in a 'Battle of the Bricks' Senior Day clash on March 6 at the Convo. The Bobcats' 30-point win over the RedHawks marked Ohio's largest margin of victory in the 'Battle of the Bricks' since beating Miami by a 61-20 count in 1940-41 in Oxford. The Bobcats were scorching from behind the arc, converting a season-high 17-of-31 three-point attempts. Ohio's 17 three pointers made marked the program's most since knocking down 17 on Jan. 20, 2000 at Central Michigan, which ranks as the second-most in school history.

Senior forward Maurice Ndour garnered Second Team All-MAC honors for a second straight season while redshirt senior guard Javarez Willis earned Honorable Mention All-MAC recognition for the first time.

Ohio Director of Athletics Jim Schaus

named Phillips the 18th head coach in men's basketball-program history on April 6, 2014. He begins the 2017-18 campaign with a career head coaching record of 187-127 (.595).

Phillips came to Athens following seven seasons at North Dakota State, where he guided the Bison to a 134-84 record (.615) -- including a 75-45 mark in The Summit League -- and NCAA Championship appearances in 2009 and '14. He departed Fargo with the fourth-most wins by a head coach in program history. Under Phillips' watch, the Bison produced 14 All-Summit League selections.

During the 2013-14 campaign, Phillips led North Dakota State to a 26-7 overall record -- including a 12-2 mark in league play -- and a Summit League title en route to earning a 2014 NCAA Championship berth. The No. 12-seeded Bison knocked off No. 5-seeded Oklahoma in overtime, 80-75 in the Second Round. Phillips garnered Summit League Coach of the Year laurels for the second time while senior guard Taylor Braun earned Summit League Player of the Year honors.

Phillips directed North Dakota State to its first Summit League crown and NCAA Division I Championship appearance in 2009 as the Bison went 26-7 overall and 16-2 in league play. The 2009 Summit League Coach of the Year was one of 10 finalists for the Hugh Durham Mid-Major Coach of the Year award. Senior guard Ben Woodside received Summit League Player of the Year under Phillips -- the first Bison to ever earn such honors.

NDSU had been on the rise since graduating four starters from that NCAA team. The Bison won 11, 14 and 17 games before a 24-win season and Summit League title game appearance in 2013. NDSU played in the College Basketball Invitational for the second straight year.

Phillips was an assistant coach at North Dakota State for three seasons before being elevated to the head job when Tim Miles was hired by Colorado State.

Before coming to North Dakota State in 2004, Phillips was the director of basketball operations for three years at Wisconsin, where he handled the day-to-day scheduling, coordinated travel, budgeting and on-campus recruiting for Bo Ryan's staff.

Phillips spent two years as an assistant coach under Ryan at Milwaukee (1999-01) and two years as an assistant at Lake Superior State (1997-99) under Marty McDermott.

A native of Reedsburg, Wis., Phillips graduated from Wisconsin-Platteville with a degree in business and psychology in 1996. He played basketball for four seasons at UWP under Ryan and was captain of the Pioneers' undefeated national championship team in 1995.

He went on to become a graduate assistant at Wayne (Neb.) State for one season under Greg McDermott.

Phillips and his wife, Nicole, have one daughter, Jordan, and two sons, Charlie and Benjamin.
