Siena has played Iona more times (114) than any other opponent
The Gaels have won 15 of the past 20 meetings
The Saints snapped an eight-game losing streak to Iona in Albany dating back to Jan. 23, 2012 with an 82-78 overtime win over the Gaels last Feb. 12 at the Times Union Center
Last five meetings have all been by four points or less and by a total of 11 points (two OT)
Jamion Christian is 1-0 vs Iona
Tim Cluess is 15-6 vs. Siena

Last Meeting

Siena withstood a four-shot final possession by Iona to win by two
The Saints went on a decisive 15-0 second half run to rally from a seven-point deficit to take an eight point lead with 3:24 to play
Jalen Pickett scored all 17 of his points in the second half, including the first 10 Siena points during the 15-0 run
The Saints held the MAAC's highest scoring offense to its lowest point total in 30 games dating back to last season
E.J. Crawford scored 14 of his 19 points in the second half for Iona

Was introduced as the 17th head coach in Siena Basketball history on May 2

Named one of 30 up-and-coming coaches to keep an eye on by The Athletic

36-year-old piloted Mount St. Mary's to 101 wins and a 67-39 (.632) record in the Northeast Conference in six seasons leading his alma mater

Guided the Mount to a pair of NEC Tournament Championships and NCAA Tournament appearances in 2014 and 2017, highlighted by a First Four victory over New Orleans in 2017

Tabbed both the 2016-17 Jim Phelan Coach of the Year - named after his legendary predecessor whom he played for at the Mount - and CollegeInsider.com's Ben Jobe National Coach of the Year, presented annually to the top Division I minority coach

The Mount achieved a stellar 60-19 (.759) overall home record at Knott Arena during his tenure, and was the only NEC program to post a winning conference record in each of Christian's six seasons in Emmitsburg

Previously served as an assistant coach at VCU (2011-12), William & Mary (2008-11), and Division III Emory & Henry (2004-06), and as director of basketball operations at Bucknell (2006-08)

Three-time team captain at Mount St. Mary's under Phelan and Milan Brown amassed 581 points in 90 career games, including 56 starts

Quinton, Virginia native was married to his wife, Allie, who played softball at Mount St. Mary's, just three days after his hiring at Siena, and is the proud father of a six-year-old son, Jacoy

Siena returns to the Capital Region tonight to open a season long four-game homestand

The Saints have won three straight at the Times Union Center

This is Siena's first four-game regular season homestand since Dec. 23, 2009 - Jan. 2, 2010 (won all four games)

This is tied for the Saints' longest regular season homestand since playing five straight in the Capital Region from Jan. 3-21, 1996

Siena enters tonight's game in a three-way tie for second place in the MAAC Standings with Canisius and Quinnipiac

With a win tonight, the Saints would move into a tie for first place with current frontrunner Monmouth

Siena stands just a half game back of the first-place Hawks with six regular season contests remaining

The Saints are currently tied for the ninth greatest turnaround in the nation (+8.5)

Siena has already achieved a five-win improvement from last season, while also doubling its MAAC win total

The Saints were predicted to finish last according to the MAAC Preseason Coaches' Poll, after finishing tied for last in 2017-18 with an 8-24 overall record including a 4-14 MAAC mark

Siena returns home on a season long four-game winning streak, and has won seven of eight

Matches longest winning streak since winning five straight from Feb. 26 - Mar. 8, 2010

A win tonight would tie the program's longest winning streak since winning a program

Division I record 15 straight from Dec. 23, 2009 - Feb. 8, 2010

The Saints have won four straight to open February to mark the program's best start to

the month since winning seven straight to open Feb. 2007

Siena swept the MAAC's weekly awards for the third time this season on Monday

Evan Fisher was named MAAC Player of the Week for the second time

Freshman **Jalen Pickett** was named MAAC Rookie of the Week for the eighth time

Pickett is now tied with **Kenny Hasbrouck** for the most MAAC Rookie of the Week awards

in program history (2005-06)

Pickett matches Iona's **Schadrac Casimir** (2014-15) for the most MAAC Rookie of the Week awards since Fairfield's **Derek**

Needham won the honor a league record-tying 10 times (**Lionel Simmons**, LaSalle: 1986-87) during the 2009-10 season

Pickett swept the MAAC Weekly Awards on Dec. 3, becoming just the third league freshman in 32 years to be Player of the Week

Siena has won seven true road games this season, which is tied for 15th most nationally

It marks the program's most road wins since winning nine during the 2009-10 season

The Saints have won three straight road games, and five of their last six away from home overall

Siena won just one true road game last season, and had lost 11 straight prior to a Nov. 8 victory at George Washington

The Saints snapped an 11-game MAAC road losing streak spanning exactly 23 months with their win at Marist Jan. 11

Siena is 6-2 in games decided by three points or less

The Saints have won three straight on the road which have all come by two points apiece

Siena has ascended to 26th nationally in scoring defense, allowing just 64.4 points

The Saints have allowed an average of just 57.1 points over the past 14 games,

on only 41.9% shooting including 29.8% from three

Siena had allowed an average of 73.7 points on 52% shooting including 44.1%

from three over their first 11 games this season

The Saints ranked fifth worst nationally in field goal defense and second

worst in three-point defense at that time

Siena has held the opposition to 70 points or less in 14 straight games, marking

the program's longest stretch since a 17-game streak from Dec. 8, 1992 - Feb. 10, 1993

Pickett ranks amongst the national leaders in assists (6.2 - 18th), steals (2.0 - 51st), and assist-to-turnover ratio (2.35 - 56th)

Pickett is third amongst all Division I freshmen in assists, seventh in steals, and ninth in assist-to-turnover ratio

Pickett leads the MAAC in both assists and assist-to-turnover ratio

Pickett also ranks second in the MAAC in steals, eighth in scoring (14.5), and tied for eighth in threes (49)

Pickett needs 85 points (minimum seven games left) to break Siena's freshman scoring record of 447 by **Nico Clareth** (2015-16)

Fisher has enjoyed a breakout season, and combined with Pickett to provide the Saints with a formidable one-two punch

The duo has combined to account for 63% of the Saints' assists, 47% of the scoring, and 34% of the rebounding

Fisher ranks fifth in the MAAC in rebounding (6.2), and sixth in both scoring (15.9) and field goal percentage (.508)

Fisher has tallied 365 points in 23 games this season, after totaling just 348 over 97 games spanning his first three seasons

Siena boasts two of the MAAC's top-three freshmen scorers in Pickett and **Sloan Seymour** (8.8)

Seymour ranks second overall in the MAAC and tied for eighth nationally amongst all Division I freshman with 69 threes

Seymour needs eight threes (minimum seven games left) to break Siena's freshman record of 76 set by **Scott Knapp** in 1997-98

The Saints rank amongst the national leaders in both fewest fouls and turnovers

Siena has committed the fourth fewest fouls nationally (14.0), after ranking

304th last year averaging 20.0

The Saints stands 12th nationally averaging just 10.3 turnovers per game, after

ranking 325th nationally last season (15.1)

Siena has committed 15 turnovers or fewer in every game this season

The Saints also lead the MAAC in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.19 - 77th nationally)

after ranking 12th worst nationally in the statistic last season (0.73)

Siena possesses three of the top-12 players in the MAAC in three-point makes

Seymour ranks second, Pickett is tied for eighth and **Kevin Degnan** is 12th

With 637 three-point attempts and 217 makes, the Saints are on pace to break

the program's single-season record for attempts (722 in 2001-02) and challenge for the school record in makes (283 in 1998-99)

Head coach **Jamion Christian** has amassed a 75-43 (.636) conference record over his seven seasons as a head coach

Including postseason play, he has led his programs to an 84-47 (.641) record and won NEC Tournaments titles in 2014 and 2017

Christian has posted a winning conference record in each of his first six full seasons as a head coach

Christian has guided his programs to a 28-10 (.737) mark following Jan. 15 the past three seasons

Christian has tallied a 19-6 (.760) record in his first seasons at both Siena and Mount St. Mary's following Jan. 15

The Saints wrapped up the non-conference portion of their schedule with a 5-8 record

Most non-conference victories since going 7-4 in 2015-16

Seven non-conference opponents Siena lost to are a combined 109-64 (.630)

Non-conference wins over league leaders Harvard, Norfolk State and Robert Morris

Siena and Holy Cross met twice (first time played same team twice in non-conference in same season since Purdue in 2013-14)

Siena is in the program's milestone 30th season of Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference competition

The Saints have won at least a share of seven MAAC Regular Season Championships, and captured five tournament titles

Siena was predicted to finish 11th (last) according to the MAAC Preseason Coaches' Poll

The Saints are without their top-six scorers from last year's team which was 8-24 overall and tied for 10th in the MAAC at 4-14

Three of the top-six scorers transferred, two more left the program, and rising junior guard **Khalil Richard** suffered a

season-ending significant partial tear of the quadriceps tendon in his right knee during a preseason scrimmage at UMass Oct. 20

Richard was to be the team's top returning scorer after averaging 9.2 points last season

Siena returned just 28% of its total points, 30% of its assists, 35% of its minutes, and 38% of its rebounding from last season

Fisher is the Saints' top returnee after averaging 7.8 points and 4.9 rebounds in a team-high 28 starts in 2017-18

Siena welcomes nine newcomers to its 18-man roster

Siena and the Times Union Center

Siena is in its 29th season of competition at the Times Union Center, and 22nd since making the full-time move to downtown Albany in 1997-98

The Saints have ranked in the top-100 nationally in attendance in each of the past 21 seasons, coinciding with the program's full-time move to the TUC

Siena ranked 94th nationally out of 351 Division I programs in attendance last season, drawing an average of 5,968 fans over 16 home dates at the Times Union Center

The Saints' average attendance last season out-drew power five conference schools such as Boston College, Oregon State, Pittsburgh, Rutgers, Stanford, USC, and Washington State, and exceeded the overall Division I national average of 4,807 by more than 1,100 fans

Siena has drawn a grand total of 2,431,125 fans (an average of 6,500) over 374 dates at the Times Union Center

The Saints welcomed their 2-millionth fan on Dec. 23, 2014 against Cornell, and have drawn crowds in excess of 10,000 on 33 occasions

Siena boasts a 245-129 (.655) all-time record at the Times Union Center, including a 230-107 (.682) mark since making the full-time move to the facility in 1997-98

In 2009-10, Siena established a new program record with 133,505 fans (an average of 7,853) for 17 home games, which ranked 66th nationally in tying for its highest national ranking ever (2002-03)

The Saints are scheduled to host the 2018-19 MAAC Basketball Championships at the Times Union Center for the 19th time in 29 seasons, and final time during a five-year agreement from 2015-19
