TALKING POINTS

- VCU and Iona meet for the first time in 14 years Saturday at the E.J. Wade Arena at the Stuart C. Siegel Center. The Rams lead the all-time series 4-2, which includes one contest, in 2003, played on this floor.
- The Rams are coming off a 62-52 loss at rival Old Dominion on Nov. 28. VCU led by as many as 17 in the first half Wednesday, but the Monarchs were dominant in the second half. ODU held VCU to just 20 second-half points. Redshirt junior guard Marcus Evans led the Rams with 14 points.
- VCU also won its first four games of the season, marking the program's first 4-0 start since the Rams opened 5-0 in 1993-94.
- VCU opponents are shooting just .243 from beyond the 3-point arc, which ranks eighth nationally. VCU opponents shot .351 from 3-point range last season.
- VCU has shown noticeable defensive improvement over last season. The Rams held their first four opponents to 61 points or less. It was the first time VCU held four straight opponents to 61 or less since the 2011-12 season. VCU held just one opponent under 60 points in 2017-18. The Rams have done so three times already this year. VCU ranks fifth nationally in defensive effective field goal percentage (.397).
- Redshirt junior guard/forward Issac Vann was named Atlantic 10 Conference Player of the Week on Nov. 26 after he averaged 19.0 points, 5.7 rebounds and 3.0 assists in three games last week.
- Sophomore forward Sean Mobley (bone bruise, left knee) is day-to-day. He did not play Wednesday at Old Dominion.

HEAD COACH MIKE RHOADES

SECOND SEASON • 23-17 AT VCU (267-145 OVERALL)



Mike Rhoades was named the 12th head coach in VCU history on March 21, 2017. It's Rhoades' second go-around with the Rams. As an assistant and associate head coach with VCU from 2009-14, he helped the Rams kick off an unprecedented run of seven straight NCAA Tournament appearances. Now he's ready to build on that tradition of success.

Rhoades' debut campaign as VCU head coach in 2017-18 produced 18 wins and the program's 18th consecutive winning season. Under his tutelage, forward Justin Tillman blossomed into

a First Team All-Atlantic 10 Conference performer. Tillman also captured All-District honors, as well as the Richmond Times-Dispatch's State College Player of the Year award.

Prior to returning to Richmond, Rhoades engineered a stunning turnaround at Rice. As head coach of the Owls from 2014-17, Rhoades led Rice to its first 20-win campaign since 2003-04 and the program's first postseason appearance since 2011-12. Rice's 23-12 mark in 2016-17 was an 11-win improvement over the 2015-16 season and the 23 wins were the second-most in Owls history. Rice advanced to the second round of the College Basketball Invitational.

Rhoades assumed the reigns at Rice in 2014-15 and led the school to an immediate five-win improvement. The Owls were a combined 12-49 in the two seasons prior to his arrival.

An astute eye for talent, Rhoades recruited Conference USA Rookie of the Year and 2016-17 First Team selection Marcus Evans, a Chesapeake, Va., native and landed Arizona State transfer Egor Koulechov, who ranked fifth in C-USA in scoring in 2016-17, two players who helped spark Rice's dramatic turnaround.

In 14 seasons as a collegiate head coach, Rhoades has produced a 262-143 record, a winning percentage of .647.

Rhoades' ties to Central Virginia date back 20 years, including his five seasons at VCU. Rhoades was integral in recruiting and developing the players that would lead the Rams to a historic Final Four appearance in 2010-11. During his tenure, VCU reached the NCAA Tournament four times and appeared in the postseason all five years. The Rams were 137-46 during that period and won the 2012 CAA Championship.

As a Ram, Rhoades recruited and molded elite-level talent. He played a pivotal role in the signing and development of future NBA players Briante Weber, Treveon Graham and Troy Daniels during his stint on Broad Street, and numerous others have enjoyed successful professional careers overseas.

In 2012, after VCU toppled Wichita State in the First Round of the NCAA Tournament, Rhoades was named one of the top 10 assistant coaches under 40 in the country by ESPN.com.

Prior to his VCU tenure, Rhoades enjoyed a wildly successful run at Division III Randolph-Macon in Ashland, Va. In 10 seasons as head coach of the Yellow Jackets, Rhoades compiled a 197-76 record (.722 win percentage) and led RMC to four NCAA Tournament appearances, including trips to the Sweet 16 in 2002 and 2003.

Rhoades' teams won six Old Dominion Athletic Conference (ODAC) championships and earned national No. 1 rankings in two seasons. He was named ODAC Coach of the Year in three straight seasons from 2001-03,

coached three ODAC Players of the Year, five ODAC Freshmen of the Year, as well as 17 First and Second Team All-ODAC selections. In 2003, he was named NABC South District Coach of the Year and State Coach of the Year by the Richmond Times-Dispatch. He began his coaching career at age 23 as an assistant at Randolph-Macon in 1996 under long-time head coach Hal Nunnally. The Yellow Jackets posted winning records in all three seasons with Rhoades on staff before he was elevated to head coach in 1999 at age 25.

Rhoades played collegiately under coach Pat Flannery at Lebanon Valley College in his home state of Pennsylvania and led the squad a 66-59 overtime win over NYU in the 1994 NCAA Division III National Championship Game. The entire team was inducted into the school's Athletic Hall of Fame in October 2014, the 20th anniversary of the title.

The guard was named USA Today D-III National Player of the Year in 1995 and twice earned All-America honors. He graduated with a degree in history in 1995. He left as the school's all-time scoring leader and still holds Lebanon Valley records in free-throw percentage (.845), assists (668) and steals (212). His No. 5 jersey was later retired.

Rhoades also earned his masters from VCU's Center for Sport Leadership in 2002.

The Mahanoy City, Pa. native and his wife Jodie have two sons, Logan, and Chase, and one daughter, Porter.

#VANNIMAL

A healthy Issac Vann is a good thing for VCU. The 6-6 swingman was named Atlantic 10 Conference Player of the Week on Nov. 26 following a three-game stretch in which he led the Rams to wins over Temple and Hofstra while averaging 19.0 points, 5.7 rebounds and 3.0 assists per game. Vann poured in a career-best 30 points and 11 rebounds in an 87-86 overtime loss to St. John's on Nov. 20.

Hampered by a injuries last season, Vann is back to full strength this year following offseason ankle surgery. He leads the team in scoring at 14.0 points per game.

HAVOC BACK?

For years, VCU was known for its high-intensity full-court press that yielded scores of turnovers. VCU Coach Mike Rhoades has made it known his desire to see the Rams return to their old, chaos-producing ways.

VCU looks to be headed in that direction early in the 2018-19 season. Through seven games, has forced its opponents into an average of 15.1 turnovers per game. Opponents have shot .357 from the field, including just .243 from 3-point range.

The Rams have held six of their seven opponents this season under a point per possession: Gardner-Webb (0.80), Hampton (0.72), Bowling Green (0.80), Temple (0.77), Hofstra (0.89) and Old Dominion (0.95).

The 26 turnovers VCU generated in its win over Bowling Green were the program's most since the Rams turned Buffalo over 31 times on Dec. 22, 2015.

The Rams held each of their first four opponents to 61 points or less. The last time

VCU held four straight foes to 61 or less occurred during the 2011-12 season.

Redshirt junior guard Marcus Evans, meanwhile, currently ranks 23rd nationally in steal percentage (4.9).

ARC ACHES

VCU has been particularly stingy guarding the 3-point line. VCU opponents are shooting just .243 from the arc, which ranks eighth nationally. No VCU opponent has shot better than .333 from long range in six games this season. VCU opponents shot .351 from three last season, which ranked 176th nationally.

TEACH ME HOW TO DOUGLAS

Redshirt sophomore forward Corey Douglas, who played for VCU Coach Mike Rhoades at Rice in 2016-17, has enjoyed some impressive moments early in his VCU career, especially on the defensive side of the ball. While he is averaging just 19.9 minutes per game, Douglas is third on the Rams in rebounding (5.1 rpg) and first in blocks (2.1 bpg).

A dynamic 6-foot-2 combo guard, Evans followed VCU Head Coach Mike Rhoades from Rice last year. He sat out last season in accordance with NCAA transfer regulations.

During that time, has worked to overcome surgeries on both Achilles' tendons.

When healthy, Evans is an explosive scorer. The Chesapeake, Va. native scored more than 1,300 points in two seasons at Rice and was named All-Conference USA First Team both years, as well as C-USA Rookie of the Year in 2016.

Evans is averaging 23.0 minutes through six games, but is the team's second-leading scorer (13.4 ppg). Evans also leads the team in steals and his five steals against Bowling Green were the most by a Ram since the 2016-17 season.

THE OTHER MARCUS IS ALSO GOOD AT BASKETBALL

Sophomore forward Marcus Santos-Silva showed real promise as a freshman and could be primed to blossom in 2018-19.

A consensus three-star recruit, McAllister is known for his high-motor and his athleticism, skills that will blend well with VCU's up-tempo, full-court press system.

McAllister led Heritage High School in Wake Forest, N.C. to a 25-5 record and a 4A State Championship Game appearance in 2017-18, while averaging 17.5 points, 5.7 rebounds, 3.5 assists and 1.2 steals per game. McAllister also starred for the Garner Road AAU program in North Carolina.

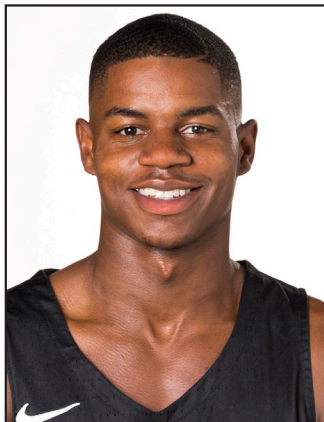

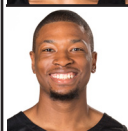
