NEWS AND NOTES

- G'mrice Davis, the nation's returning leading rebounder, sits atop Division I's rebounding statistics. Davis finished second last season behind just Washington's outgoing senior Chantel Osahor with 436 total boards, 12.8 rebounds per game, and 10.0 defensive rebounds per contest, and finished third with 24 double-doubles. After six games this season, Davis leads all Division I players with 14.5 rebounds per game and 11.3 defensive boards per game, while tallying double-doubles in all six games, ranked eighth.

- Davis became just the second Ram to ever average a double-double across a full season last year, next to Fordham Hall of Famer Anne Gregory O'Connell. She was voted First Team All-Conference, the second Ram to ever earn the honor alongside Erin Rooney ('14), and to the All-Defensive team, and she has been picked to repeat both feats this year by the Atlantic 10's head coaches. Davis was also named to the inaugural Katrina McClain Award watch list this preseason, to be given out annually to the nation's top power forward.

- Davis scored her 1,000th career point at Albany on November 19, converting a trademark midrange jumper early in the first quarter. The 20th Ram to reach the 1,000-point mark, she now sits on 1,060 career points, passing Carol Elser ('85) and Stacey Paukovitz ('93) at Manhattan, and is now two points behind former teammate Erin Rooney ('14). She also recently surpassed Sharon Nast ('86) for fourth on the all-time rebounding list, currently with 857 career boards, while her 8.7 rebounding average has just passed Terri Vaccarino ('85) for second all-time.

- Stephanie Gaitley became Fordham women's basketball's all-time winningest head coach with a 74-43 win over Massachusetts on February 11, 2017, her 116th victory in the Bronx. The 32-year veteran passed Kathy Mosolino ('74-'80), and has 124 career victories over her seven seasons, averaging 20 per campaign.

- Redshirt freshman Bre Cavanaugh was named the Atlantic 10's Rookie of the Week on Monday afternoon. Cavanaugh, who has scored in double figures in all six contests this season to start her Fordham career and is 11th in the country with 38.3 minutes played per game, set new career-highs in back-to-back wins this past week, scoring 16 points at Manhattan and a team-high 21 points against Pittsburgh, the latter coming on her most efficient shooting performance to-date (7-13).

Setting the Scene

The Fordham women's basketball team (4-3) held a 10-point lead with seven minutes left in regulation at Penn State on Wednesday night but let its lead slip to All-Conference guard Teniya Page, who, along with Amari Carter, outscored the Rams, 14-3, over those final minutes to snatch victory away. The loss snapped a three-game winning streak for Fordham, who now returns home to the Bronx to host Iona (0-7) on Saturday afternoon at 1 p.m., the first game of a doubleheader with the men's program.

Last Time Out at Penn State

The Rams started out hot, with back-to-back threes by Bre Cavanaugh and Lauren Holden, and continued to hold off the Lady Lions throughout much of Wednesday's contest, all the way until the 1:31 mark of the final period. After the two long-range makes, Mary Goulding converted two layups to give Fordham an early 10-4 lead. The Rams held as much as a nine-point lead in those opening 10 minutes, 20-11, but the hosts scored five unanswered points to cut the deficit to four at the break. The Rams had seven points off turnover and nine second-chance points in the quarter. As the two schools traded baskets over the next 10 minutes, it was Kendell Heremaia's three with 1:40 left to go followed by a trey from Holden to help take a six-point lead into halftime, 34-28. Fordham kept its foot on the gas and carried a seven-point lead into the fourth quarter, 49-42, and, after an early Heremaia three and a Cavanaugh jumper, Fordham had its largest lead of the night, 54-44, with 7:48 to play. Penn State took a timeout with exactly six minutes to play and its comeback began thereafter, with the backcourt duo of Page and Carter combining for a 14-3 run over Fordham. Page scored five quick unanswered points before Holden canned a three to push the lead back to eight, but the Lady Lions missed just one of their next six shots while blowing past the Rams with 11 unanswered points to take a 60-57 lead with 48 seconds remaining. That number crept up to 14 eventually until Goulding's last-second three cemented the final score of 65-60.

Both G'mrice Davis and Goulding tallied double-doubles, while Cavanaugh, Heremaia, and Holden each finished with double-digit scoring. The game was the first all season with more assists (15) than turnovers (14), and the Rams crushed the Lady Lions on the glass, 39-23, including a 23-3 margin on the offensive side. In fact, of Goulding's 10 rebounds, nine came on the offensive glass. Fordham shot 20-of-46 through the first three quarters (43.5%) but just 4-of-22 in the final period.

Series History vs. Iona

Fordham currently holds a 24-20 all-time series advantage against its local rival Gaels, dating back to 1973, when the Rams defeated Iona, 25-18, in the Bronx. The Gaels have held serve over the last 10 contests, though, winning eight, including both contests during the Stephanie Gaitley era. In 2014, Iona downed Fordham, 72-51, in the Bronx, and again last year in New Rochelle, 55-46. Last year, Davis went for 12 points and 14 rebounds, while Holden chipped in 11 points and three assists. In 2014, both Davis and Asnate Fomina struggled for a combined seven points.

Davis Scores 1,000th Point

G'mrice Davis entered her senior campaign with 970 career points scored and knowing it wouldn't be long to become the 20th Ram to ever accomplish the feat of scoring 1,000 career points in maroon and white. After scoring 28 combined points in her first two games, she was able to reach 1,000 quickly at Albany. The Philadelphia native has since scored 45 points over her last three contests and now sits on 1,060 career points, having just passed Carol Elser ('86) and Stacey Paukovitz ('93) to reach 18th all-time, and is now two back of former teammate Erin Rooney ('14).

Cavanaugh Named A-10 Rookie of the Week

Redshirt freshman Bre Cavanaugh was named the Atlantic 10 Rookie of the Week on Monday afternoon after two standout performances last week. The Allamuchy, N.J. native set two new career-highs in scoring when she scored 16 points at Manhattan and then a team-high 21 points against Pittsburgh.

Up Next

The Rams travel to Queens next Tuesday night looking for revenge of last year's loss in the Bronx, taking on St. John's at 7 p.m.

Sixth-Ranked Defense

Fordham comes into the weekend allowing the sixth-fewest points per game in the country, allowing just 51.6 points to opponents, after allowing its first 60-point game by an opponent on Wednesday, and now sitting above 50 points per game allowed. The Rams sit atop the Atlantic 10, as they did a year ago, and are behind just Central Arkansas, Green Bay, North Texas, Clemson, and Middle Tennessee State, and ahead of Villanova, as the only programs to allow 52 or fewer points per contest. Last year, the Rams held opponents to 56.2 points per contest, ranked 19th by season's end.

Davis as Division I's Top Rebounder

G'mrice Davis, the nation's returning leading rebounder, hasn't missed a beat, leading all of Division I with 14.5 rebounds per game and 11.0 defensive boards per contest. The senior forward missed Sunday's contest but her six straight double-doubles rank eighth in the country and her 87 total rebounds rank 29th.

National Ranks

It's never too early to cast an eye towards the Division I national statistics. Davis is once again doing her thing on the glass, but the Rams rank highly in several other team and individual categories, as well. Coming into the contest against Northern Colorado, junior guard Lauren Holden led the nation in minutes per game, at an unsustainable clip of 41.3 minutes per game, longer than the actual 40 minutes of regulation. Since, after playing just 33 minutes against Northern Colorado due to foul trouble, she has rattled off three straight 40-minute shifts for the Rams, and ranks third in the country with 39.6 minutes per game. Redshirt freshman Bre Cavanaugh has made a big impact in the Fordham starting lineup and has been asked to log heavy minutes, averaging 38.1 per contest, which ranks 11th overall. Cavanaugh's been deadly from the free throw line thus far, as well, converting on 89.3% of her attempts, which ranks 35th in DI.

As a team, the Gaitley-led Rams continue to be a top-tier defensive squad, currently ranked sixth overall with just 51.6 points allowed per game. Part of that is the team's success guard-

ing the perimeter, with opponents' hitting just 23.8% of their three-point attempts, ranked 19th in the country and first in the A-10. Opposing teams are also hitting just 36.6% of all shots, too, which ranks 83rd and fifth, respectively, which is down from 30th and second, respectively, after Penn State shot 55.8% from the floor on Wednesday.

Fordham's 74.7% team conversion rate at the free throw line has the team ranked 40th in the country and third in the conference, while the squad has really committed to minimizing fouls in the early going, with just 14.1 per game and 99 total, ranked 18th and 10th, respectively, overall and tops the league standings. The Davis and Goulding-inspired attack on the glass has the Rams with a rebounding margin of +8.7, ranked 41st overall.

Defense, Defense, Defense

A staple of the Gaitley-led Rams is defense, and no stat better represents that than Fordham's 52-5 record when holding opponents under 50 points during her tenure. Last January, Saint Joseph's defeated the Rams, 47-44, at Hagan Arena in Philadelphia, ending a streak of 38 consecutive contests with such victories. The last time before that loss, coincidentally, was also against the Hawks, in the 2013 A-10 Championship game at the Barclays Center, 47-46. Fordham was 10-1 last year when holding opponents under 50 points and are 3-0 this season.

Since Gaitley took over before the 2011-12 season, the Rams have ranked within the top-50 in all six seasons, and within the top-20 at the conclusion of half of them, in scoring defense. The highest a Gaitley-coached defense has finished was 12th during the conference championship-winning 2013-14 campaign, holding opponents at 56.3 points per game, while the 2012-13 squad held opponents to just 52.4 points per game, ranked 16th nationally. Last year, Fordham held opponents to 56.2 points per game and was ranked 19th in the country at season's end. This season, the Rams are 3-0 in such games, holding UMBC, Northern Colorado, and Manhattan all to under 48 points, and rank fourth with 48.2 points allowed per contest.

Offensive Glass

Fordham grabbed an astounding 23 offensive rebounds at Penn State on Wednesday night, compared to 16 on the defensive end, which was 20 more than the Lady Lions' three by night's end. Mary Goulding grabbed nine of her 10 rebounds on offensive possessions, while G'mrice Davis split her 14 boards evenly on either side. Both Cavanaugh and Heremaia each grabbed two, and Holden had one. For the season, of the Rams' 274 rebounds, 95 have come on the offensive glass, or more than one third of the time (34.7%). For the season, both Goulding and Holden have more offensive rebounds than defensive, while Goulding ties Davis for the team lead with 19. Johanna Klug also has an even 13 boards on both ends. Seven players have at least five offensive boards this year.

Opponents Scoring <40

The Rams, all-time, since the move from the AIAW to the NCAA in 1983, have held opponents under 40 points 18 times, all coming in 1990 and beyond. Under Stephanie Gaitley, that number is seven, with Northern Colorado's output of 33 points being the latest. The Bears came into that contest averaging 69 points per contest over five game. Their 33 points were the third-lowest by a Fordham opponent all-time.

Got a Minute?

Junior tri-captain Lauren Holden sits third in all of Division I in minutes played, currently at 39.6 per game and has completed the full 40 minutes in three straight contests, four total, and all 45 minutes in an overtime loss at Albany. A starter since midway through her freshman season, Holden passed the 2,000-minute mark against Northern Colorado and is fast approaching the all-time top-20. Bre Cavanaugh's 38.1 minutes per contest ranks 11th overall, while G'mrice Davis' 36.8 minutes rank 34th.

Fourth Quarter Rallies

In Fordham's two losses this season, the Rams have faced double-digit deficits but made furious charges in the final period of action to get close or take the lead. At Boston College, the Eagles led by 12 with 3:23 left in regulation. Fordham responded, however, and rattled off an impressive 10-1 run down to the final 20 seconds where the Eagles were able to hit both of their free throws and solidify the victory. At Albany, the Rams entered the fourth quarter trailing by 11. Fordham had shown flashes in the third quarter, outscoring Albany, 12-11, but was still unable to make up the necessary ground. The Great Danes began the fourth with a short 4-2 run to lead by 13, but after that last basket, it was all Fordham. The Rams rampaged to a one-point lead with 20 seconds to play, capping a 15-1 run, with G'mrice Davis scoring 11 of those points. Unfortunately for Fordham, the Great Danes would tie things up and go on to win in overtime.

Slow Starts, Strong Finishes

Through seven games this season, the Rams are being outscored by their opponents, 165-164, in first halves. Early in the season, the Rams struggled to get going in first halves but have begun to start better. Where Fordham has really come alive is in second halves, particularly third quarters. Thanks to a 19-5 outburst against Northern Colorado and 20-10 at Manhattan, the Rams are now outscoring opponents 103-81 in third periods, and 105-103 in fourth quarters, which had been better until Penn State outscored the Rams, 23-11, over the final 10 minutes on Wednesday. It was the first time this year that Fordham had lost following a late lead.

Davis Racks Up Preseason Honors

As mentioned, Davis' breakout junior season saw her earn First Team All-Conference and All-Defensive honors, and it was announced at A-10 Media Day that the league's coaches have predicted her to do so again as a senior. Davis was also recently selected as one of 20 players in Division I women's basketball for the inaugural Katrina McClain Award watch list, to be given out to the country's top power forward, starting this season.

Fordham Picked to Finish Fifth in Preseason Poll

Likewise, the league's coaches also predicted an identical fifth-place finish for Fordham in the preseason poll. Dayton, last year's champions, garnered eight first-place votes for a total of 182 points, just ahead of Saint Louis, who tallied 174 points and three first-place votes, and Saint Joseph's, with 170 points and the final three first-place votes. Duquesne, with 160 points, rounds out the top five in a predicted fourth-place finish. George Washington (116), La Salle (114), George Mason (79), Richmond (78), and Massachusetts (73) filled out spots 6-10, followed by VCU (56), St. Bonaventure (50), Rhode Island (46), and Davidson (22).

Five Fordham Debuts

Five freshmen made their debuts against UMBC, the most since 2011. Three of those freshmen started the contest, the most in the last 15 years. Joey Klug's 13 points were the most by a freshman in her debut since Hannah Missry scored 14 in 2013. Klug became the first freshman to record both a block and a steal in her debut over the last 15 years, as well, and the first to record at least one block since Samantha Clark had two in her 2012 debut. Cavanaugh's 39 minutes were the most by a freshman making her debut since Megan Mahoney played all 40 minutes in 2007.

Gaitley Makes History

Stephanie Gaitley reached 100 wins with the Fordham program against Little Rock on November 19, 2016, and later won her 116th contest at home against Massachusetts, 74-43, in February, passing Kathy Mosolino ('74-'80) for the most wins in program history. Gaitley tied and passed the milestone with two typical Gaitley-inspired performances, with three-pointers and excellent defense, holding both opponents below 50 points. Entering the 2017-18 season, Gaitley had 120 wins across six seasons in the Bronx, an average of over 20 per campaign. Her 124 total wins are the second-most of any of Gaitley's stops in her 32-year career as a head coach, ahead of her 116 wins at Richmond (1985-91) but a ways away from her 10-year stint at Saint Joseph's (1991-2001), in which she racked up 196 wins. Gaitley has a career 588-348 record and has the second-most overall wins among active A-10 coaches, behind Saint Louis' Lisa Stone, and has the second-most wins by any Atlantic 10 coach, with 168 between Fordham and Saint Joseph's, but is 72 behind Joe McKeown's record of 240 that he accumulated during his 17 years with George Washington from 1989 to 2008.

This Is Our House

Fordham finished its 2016-17 campaign with a 16-3 at home, as opposed to a 5-7 record on the road and 1-2 at neutral sites. They were also 7-1 during home conference contests for the second year in a row. Since Gaitley took over before the 2011-12 season, the Rams hold a 74-24 (75.3%) record at home. They are 3-0 thus far this season in the Bronx. On the flip side, including this year's 1-2 start, Gaitley's Rams are 50-54 (48.1%) on the road or on neutral ground.

Fordham on the International Scene

The Rams boast one of the larger international contingents, between players and coaching staff, in the country. Seven different countries are represented: Barbados (Sonia Burke), Fiji (Valerie Nainima, Vilisi Tavui), Germany (Johanna Klug), Latvia (Asnate Fomina), Poland (Angelika Szumilo), and New Zealand (Mary Goulding, Kendell Heremaia, Zara Jillings), and 13 from the USA.

The 66-61 double overtime win at La Salle last February was Fordham's 20th win of the season. It is the fourth time under Stephanie Gaitley that the Rams have amassed 20 or more wins, and it is the 16th season that Gaitley has personally won 20 or more, out of 31 seasons. Previously, there had been just five 20-win seasons in program history -- three with Kathy Mosolino (1977-80), one under Christina Wielgus (1991-92), and one under Kevin Morris (1993-94).

60 is the Magic Number?

The Rams were 15-0 when scoring 60 or more points last season. Fordham was also 11-1 when holding opponents under 50 points (and 13-1 when holding them at 52 or under). Wednesday's loss at Penn State was the first time this year the Rams had scored over 60 points. Prior to that, they had scored between 48-55 points in each game.

Four Sign NLIs in 2017-18 Recruiting Class

Coach Gaitley announced a four-player class earlier this week, made up of two guards and two forwards, locally from New York and Pennsylvania: Chloe Chaffin, Kaitlyn Downey, Megan Jonassen, and Catherine Polisano.

Chaffin, a 5'10 wing, hails from Kingston, N.Y., where she was a three-sport athlete and four-year member of the Tigers basketball team under head coach Stephen Garner. Chaffin was

named a Daily Freeman First Team All Star and BCANY Section 9 All Star after her sophomore and junior campaigns, as well as an All State honorable mention as a sophomore. Chaffin, a two-time team captain entering her senior season, averaged 13.6 points, 8.0 rebounds, 2.8 steals, 2.3 assists, and 0.8 blocks per game last year. Chaffin plays her club ball with NY Havoc 17U, helping them to the Gym Rat Challenge 16U Gold Bracket Championship, and was named a NEG Top 2018 New York state recruit this year. Away from the court, Chaffin also competed in track & field and field hockey, and is a member of the National Honors Society.

Gaitley on Chaffin: "Chloe committed to us as an eighth grader. She is a big guard who reminds me a lot of Danielle Burns ('16). She has the ability to attach the basket and will create matchup problems."

Downey, a 6'1 forward from Hastings on Hudson, N.Y., plays her high school ball at Maria Regina in Hartsdale under head coach Michael Kiers. Downey, a member of the 1,000-point club during her three seasons thus far with the Tigers, is a two-time MVP and team-captain during her sophomore and junior campaigns. After earning the Coaches Award as a freshman and averaging 14.7 points and 8.0 rebounds per game as a sophomore, Downey broke out as a junior, averaging 19.9 points, 11.3 rebounds, 3.5 blocks, 3.2 steals, and 3.1 assists, and earning several honors and accolades at season's end. Those honors include Class B All-State Third Team, First Team All-Hudson Valley, First Team All-CHSAA, Lohud Girls Second Team,

8.0 points per contest, and was named team captain entering her junior season. However, she unfortunately had to sit out the year with injury. She has also played volleyball with the Patriots and holds the school records for assists and service aces. Rams' Summer Trip to Italy, Spain

Fordham gets to travel somewhere in the world every four years and this August the Rams went to Italy and Spain for two weeks of sight-seeing and competition. The Rams faced three squads in Italy, one an hour outside Venice, one just outside of Milan, and one in Rome, plus against two professional squads in Barcelona, Spain. Fordham went 5-0 and was able to get valuable experience for 13 of the 14 players on the roster, minus Tavui who was unable to travel with the program.

2016-17 Season Review

Last year's Rams finished the season with a 22-12 overall record and 11-5 in conference play, good for a fifth-place final standing. Their efforts were rewarded with a WNIT bid, the program's third in the past five years under head coach Stephanie Gaitley, and Fordham, like its other two trips to the postseason tournament, made it past the first round, this time by rallying to defeat Georgetown on the road, before falling at Penn State a couple days later. Senior forward G'mrice Davis led the way, becoming just the second Ram to ever average a double-double over the course of the season, and was chosen as an Atlantic 10 First Team All-Conference and All-Defensive honoree. Davis was the second player to ever earn First Team honors (Erin Rooney in both 2013 and 2014), and third to garner All-Defensive recognition (Arielle Collins in 2013 and Samantha Clark in 2016). Davis finished the campaign second in total rebounding (436), rebounding per game (12.8), defensive boards per game (10.0), and third in double-doubles (24), but is the returning leader in those categories after graduations. Davis was recently predicted to repeat both of her accomplishments for her senior campaign, and was chosen as one of 20 players in Division I to the inaugural Katrina McClain Award watch list, to be given annually to the nation's top power forward.

The class of 2017, Danielle Burns, Hannah Missry, and Danielle Padovano, made up some of the most durable players in Fordham history, all three rankings in the top-seven in career games played and, in Missry's case, second all-time in career starts. The trio made up 32.1% of the Fordham offense a season ago. Missry, who broke the school's all-time three-pointers made record as a junior, continued to add to her tally, finishing her career with 310, which ranks third all-time in Atlantic 10 history.

When Stephanie Gaitley inherited the Fordham women's basketball program, the Rams had gone nearly two decades without a winning record and were just three years removed from a 0-29 campaign.

In just five seasons at the helm of the Rams, Stephanie Gaitley has transformed Fordham from a perennial doormat into a national power, compiling three consecutive 20-win seasons and bringing home the school's first-ever Atlantic 10 Women's Basketball Championship in 2013-14.

The winner of 562 career games and the third winningest coach in Atlantic 10 history, two shy of Theresa Greutz's 156, and most among active coaches, Gaitley has led a team to the NCAA Tournament on eight occasions, compiling 15 20-win seasons and five conference titles over her 30 years as a head coach.

After compiling a 12-18 record in her first season at Fordham, Gaitley entered her second campaign with a few key additions. With Marah Strickland and Erin Rooney finally ready to play and star recruit Samantha Clark in maroon and white, Gaitley had all the pieces that the 27th year head coach would need to put together an historic campaign.

Gaitley's Fordham squad put up the best record the program had seen in over 30 years, finishing the season 26-9 and falling in the Atlantic 10 title game by just one point to Saint Joe's. Earning a berth in the WNIT, Fordham advanced to the Round of 16, picking up the school's first postseason victories since 1980.

Playing her signature style of smart, yet aggressive defense, Gaitley's team finished the season ranked first in the Atlantic 10 and 16th in the nation in scoring defense. The 2012-2013 Rams also finished the year ranked 15th in the country in free throw percentage.

For her efforts, Gaitley was named the 2013 Maggie Dixon Metropolitan Coach of the Year by the Met Basketball Writers Association.

With the success of the previous year still fresh in her team's mind,

the 2013-14 Rams put together the most memorable season of Fordham women's basketball in over three decades, winning the program's first-ever Atlantic 10 Championship and securing an NCAA Tournament berth for the first time since 1994. In claiming the title, Gaitley guided the Rams to wins over three teams against whom they had gone 0-4 during the regular season.

In addition to advancing to the NCAA Tournament, Gaitley's squad also accomplished a number of feats during the regular season, including a school-record 12-game winning streak, a school-record 11 nonconference wins and the program's first-ever Thanksgiving tournament victory at the Lady Rebel Round-Up played at UNLV.

The 2014-15 season saw the Rams win at least 21 games for the third straight season (the first time since 1977-1980 that a Ram team has won 20 or more games three years in a row) earn their third consecutive postseason appearance (as they made the second round of the WNIT before falling at St. John's), and finish fourth in the Atlantic 10 standings to earn the #4 seed in the conference tournament (where they lost to top seed and nationally-ranked George Washington in the semifinals). Gaitley also became the second-winningest coach in program history with 84 wins. The Rams led the conference in scoring defense (55.5), which was good enough for 18th nationally, and three-point field goal percentage defense (.274), which ranked 15th in the nation.

Gaitley, who led Monmouth University to 23 wins and a WNIT appearance in 2011, was named head coach at Fordham University on April 1, 2011 and set out to begin a new chapter in the Rams' women's basketball program, a chapter marked by hard work, an international flavor, a stifling defense and an emphasis on family values.



Gaitley, the winningest active coach in the A-10, arrived at Rose Hill with extensive experience as a head coach, guiding teams at Monmouth, Long Island University, Saint Joseph's University and the University of Richmond over a 25-year span. She compiled a 464-270 career record (.630 winning percentage) over that time, including 12 20-win seasons.

Gaitley coached three players who earned conference Player of the Year accolades including Long Island's Valerie Nainima (now part of the staff at Fordham), who was the first player in Northeast Conference history to win the league's Rookie and Player of the Year honors in the same season when she accomplished the feat in 2007. The other two are Jana Lichnerova and Susan Moran, the 2000 and 2002 Atlantic 10 Player of the Year at Saint Joseph's, respectively. Both Lichnerova and Moran were also named Atlantic 10 Student-Athletes of the Year for women's basketball.

Nainima, a member of the Fiji women's national basketball team, Lichnerova, who played for the Slovakia Olympic Team at the 2000 Games, and Moran, one of the top women's basketball players from Ireland, are a good example of Gaitley's international roots that have served her so well in her career. Gaitley has had three of her former international players either drafted or in camp with WNBA teams, and has conducted SVG camps all over the world for the past 20 years.

Gaitley also has experience with the United States national team, serving as an assistant in 2000 at the Jones Cup and helping the team to the gold medal. She also served as head coach of the West Team at the 1995 U.S. Olympic Festival, winning a silver medal.

An underlying theme for Gaitley-coached teams has been an unyielding defense, as evidenced by her Blackbirds squad that led the Northeast Conference in scoring defense from 2006-08, including holding the opposition to 54.8 points per game in 2007-08. In fact, from 1989-2000, Coach Gaitley's teams ranked in the top-10 in the nation in scoring defense nine times. In 2012-13 and 2013-14, her Rams finished 16th and 12th, respectively in the nation in that category.

One of the most apparent attributes about Coach Gaitley is her likeable demeanor strongly influenced by family values. Gaitley has an outgoing personality that is contagious throughout her program. She has maintained a longstanding, successful career based around her attitude and ability to convey her beliefs as a coach and as a mentor to her players.

In 2010-11, Gaitley led Monmouth to a 23-10 overall record, 13-5 in the Northeast Conference, and helped the Hawks tie the school record for wins in a season and advance to the title game of the NEC Championship. Following the championship game loss, Monmouth received its first ever WNIT bid and its first postseason appearance since making the 1983 NCAA Tournament.

Gaitley spent three seasons at Monmouth, recording a winning slate each year. She accomplished this with her trademark tough defense, allowing fewer than 60 points per game each year, including an NEC-best 55.7 in 2010-11.

Gaitley's Monmouth teams also were successful in the classroom, with the 2009-10 squad honored by the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) as one of the top academic squads in the nation. The Hawks ranked 15th in the country with a 3.4 team GPA in the WBCA's annual Academic Top 25 Team Honor Roll, which is based on the highest grade point averages (GPA) for the entire season.

Prior to her three years at Monmouth, Gaitley served as the head coach at Long Island University for six seasons, accumulating a 95-82 record at the helm of the program. She left the Brooklyn school as the winningest coach in LIU women's basketball history. In her final season at the school, 2007-08, she guided the Blackbirds to a school-record 24 wins and the top seed in the Northeast Conference Tournament. In her time in Brooklyn, she led LIU to a pair of 20-win seasons, the first NEC Regular Season title and first WNIT bid in program history and was named the 2006-07 NEC Coach of the Year.

Prior to her stint with Long Island, Gaitley was the head coach at Saint

Joseph's in Philadelphia, Pa. for ten seasons (1992-01). She led the Hawks to five 20-win seasons and two Atlantic 10 Championships in her time there while earning five NCAA Tournament bids, including three at-large berths. Her teams advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament three times and she earned both a preseason and postseason WNIT bid. She finished her time in Philly with a 196-88 mark and 109-39 in conference play.

In 1992-93, Gaitley's second season with Saint Joseph's, she went 21-8, which kick-started a run of qualifying for the NCAA Tournament in three of the next four years. Gaitley's teams in 1993-94 and 1994-95 went a combined 39-18 at Saint Joseph's. Her teams qualified for the NCAA Tournament in each season, and her 1999-2000 team went 25-6 and won the Atlantic 10 Conference Championship.

Gaitley got her start as a head coach at the University of Richmond from 1985-1991 where she compiled a 116-63 record, the most wins for any Richmond women's basketball coach, while winning 20 or more games in a season four times. During her last two seasons with the Spiders, she went a combined 51-10 and won the Colonial Athletic Association Championship each season while advancing to the NCAA Tournament in both years. Gaitley was named the CAA Coach of the Year in 1989-90 and also led the Spiders to a WNIT bid.

A native of Ocean City, N.J., Gaitley graduated from Villanova in 1982 with a Bachelor of Science degree in education and was an academic All-American that season. She was named to the Eastman Kodak All-America Team in 1981-82 and is currently sixth on the Villanova all-time rebounding list. She also received a Master of Science degree in secondary education at Villanova in 1983. The school inducted her into its Hall of Fame in 1993, three years after she was enshrined into the Philadelphia Big Five Hall of Fame.

Gaitley and her two sisters, Courtney and Coco, hold a piece of NCAA history. During the 1981-82 season, Stephanie and Courtney, while playing for Villanova, played against Coco, who played for FDU, marking the first time in NCAA history that three sisters competed in the same game.

Gaitley learned early on in her basketball career about success, as she was a member of the Ocean City High School girl's basketball team that went 100-0 in league play from 1974-78 under head coach Pat Dougherty. She is a member of the South Jersey and Ocean City High School Halls of Fame.

Gaitley and her husband, Frank, have three sons, Dutch, a video coordinator with the San Antonio Spurs, D.C., who graduated from Fordham in 2015 after playing four years of basketball for the men's program, and Jordan "Coop" Gaitley, a senior at Fordham Prep.



Gaitley reached 500 career wins in the semifinals of the 2013 Atlantic 10 Championship and two years ago became one of seven coaches to bring three different schools to the NCAA Tournament.
