What You Need To Know

- Rider closes out a two-game road trip in the Empire State on Thursday, January 25, traveling to New Rochelle to face Iona. Outside of Lawrenceville the Broncs are 4-7 in 2017-18 and the team is looking to put an end to a two-game skid on the road.
- Rider has won back-to-back games against the Gaels after sweeping the regular-season series last year. Iona is still in search of their first win of the season.
- Last time out, Marist scored the final five points of regulation to upend the Broncs, 68-67, in Poughkeepsie. Rider held the Red Foxes to 37 percent shooting, but Marist was able to get to the free-throw line 32 times (converting 25 attempts). Junior point guard Lexi Posset was one of four Rider players in double figures with a team-high 19 points.
- Rider was 15-of-16 at the free-throw line versus Niagara for a season-best 93.8%. Last time out, they hit 8-of-11 attempts. This season the team is second in the MAAC in free-throw percentage at 73.7%.

SCOUTING IONA

Iona enters the mid-week clash with an 0-19 overall record and an 0-8 mark in conference play after suffering a 68-56 setback on the road versus Monmouth on Monday evening. The Gaels are in search of their first win of the campaign and the team is 0-9 at home in 2017-18. It is a three-headed attack for Iona with Alexis Lewis, Toyosi Abiola and Treyanna Clay accounting for nearly 70 percent of the team's points. All three average in double figures led by Lewis with over 14 points per game. Lewis is hitting 38 percent of her shots from the field and pulling down a team-high 8.2 rebounds per contest. Abiola, who has been named the MAAC Rookie of the Week seven times this season, is scoring over 12 points per tilt and is second on the team with 21 steals. Clay has played well in the post, scoring more than 10 points per game and shooting over 42 percent from the field. Clay also leads the team in blocked shots with 10. As a team, Iona ranks last in the conference in both points per game (53.7) and field-goal percentage defense with opponents hitting over 44 percent of their shots on the year.

ALL-TIME SERIES VS. THE GAELS

Iona leads the all-time series, 27-17. Rider swept the season series a year ago and Iona won both meeting between the two during the 2015-16 season. The last time the two teams split was in 2014-15 after Rider won an 85-81 thriller in overtime.

LAST YEAR AGAINST IONA

Rider snapped a two-game losing streak versus Iona in early January of 2017 thanks to scoring an 85-65 victory at home. In the second meeting between the two, the Broncs secured a season sweep thanks to holding the Gaels to a season-low 36 points. In both meetings a year ago, Kamila Hoskova averaged over 15 points, while Stella Johnson averaged 15 points, three assists, three steals and seven rebounds in the victories.

LAST TIME OUT

Last time out, Marist scored the final five points of regulation to upend the Broncs, 68-67, in Poughkeepsie. Rider held the Red Foxes to 37 percent shooting, but Marist was able to get to the free-throw line 32 times (converting 25 attempts). Junior point guard Lexi Posset was one of four Rider players in double figures with a team-high 19 points.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN

Rider ends a two-game road trip in the Empire State on Thursday, January 25. This season, the Broncs are 4-6 in true road games. Rider has won four of their last seven contests outside of Lawrenceville with the lone MAAC setbacks coming against defending conference champion Quinnipiac on January 15 and Marist last time out.

DEFENSE WINS

This season, Rider is 6-0 when holding opponents to under 60 points. The Broncs are also 7-2 (4-1 in MAAC play) in 2017-18 when they shoot a higher percentage than their opponents. Rider has forced 18 or more turnovers in three of its last seven games. The Broncs have forced at least 17 turnovers in a game 11 times this season. Rider has a +1.1 turnover ratio this year which ranks third in the MAAC.

CLOSE CALLS

Rider is 1-5 this year in games decided by five points or fewer. The Broncs had dropped their first four such games of the season, including an overtime setback at home versus Siena, before topping the Peacocks on January 2. Last time out, Marist rallied to hand Rider their fifth loss on the year in a game decided by five points or fewer.

HOLDING IT DOWN

This season, Rider is 7-3 and 4-1 in conference play when leading at halftime. Their first loss when leading at the break in MAAC play came at Marist on Sunday. The Broncs have won their five of their last six games when holding a halftime lead.

BALANCED ATTACK

Four players scored in double figures for the Broncs versus Marist on January 21. It marked the 12th time this season that three or more Broncs scored in double figures in a game. It was the third game in which four players scored 10 or more points for Rider.

KNOCK DOWN

Rider hit seven three-pointers in their 68-67 loss at Marist on January 21. This season, the Broncs are 2-3 overall and 1-1 in conference play when knocking down seven or more three-pointers in a contest. Entering Thursday, the Broncs are third in the MAAC in three-point shooting, hitting 31.6 percent (100-of-316) of their shots from beyond the arc. Stella Johnson is shooting a team-high 37.5 percent from deep (21-of-56) and Lexi Stover has hit a team-best 29 treys. Stella ranks sixth in the MAAC in three-point field-goal percentage this year.

STUFFING THE STAT SHEET

Stella Johnson had another balanced game for the Broncs against Marist. She scored 13 points on 5-of-13 shooting to go along with six rebounds, four assists, three blocks and one steal. This year, she leads the team in points (279), points per game (14.7), field-goal percentage (46.5%), three-point field-goal percentage (37.5%), steals (46) and steals per game (2.4). She is also second in blocks (14), assists (52), assists per game (2.7), rebounds (102) and rebounds per game (5.4).

CHARITY STRIPE

Versus Niagara, Rider shot a season-best 93.8% (15-of-16) from the free-throw line. It marked the second time this year that the Broncs hit more than 90 percent of their free throws after hitting 20-of-22 (90.9%) at NJIT on December 16. The tilt versus the Highlanders marked the third time this season that the Broncs had hit 20 or more free throws in a game. Against Quinnipiac on January 15, the team shot over 84 percent (11-of-13) at the line. Rider is 4-3 in 2017-18 when hitting better than 77 percent of their free-throw attempts in a game. Last time out, Rider hit 8-of-11 attempts at Marist. In that game however, the Red Foxes had 21 more free-throw attempts than the Broncs. On the year, the team has hit 73.7 percent (255-346) of their free throws, which ranks second in the MAAC.

MAAC STATS

Stella Johnson has been stellar in conference play this season. She is averaging over 16 points, six rebounds and more than two steals per game against MAAC opponents. She is also knocking down better than 48 percent (53-of-110) of her shots from the field over the last eight games. Lexi Posset has also turned it on during league play, averaging over 14 points and three assists per tilt.

RANK AND FILE

A pair of Broncs rank in the top-five in statistical categories in the MAAC this season. Kamila Hoskova is third in free-throw percentage (81.8%) and first in minutes played per game (35.4). Stella Johnson is second in steals (46), second in steals per game (2.4), fourth in points per game (14.7) and fifth in field-goal percentage (46.5%).

TURNOVER BATTLE

This season Rider ranks third in the MAAC with a +1.1 turnover margin. The Broncos are 6-5 overall and 3-2 in the MAAC when committing fewer turnovers than their opponents. Both of their conference losses with fewer turnovers have come against Marist.

GOING THE DISTANCE

Versus Niagara, both senior Kamila Hoskova and junior point guard Lexi Posset played all 40 minutes. Hoskova has played 40 or more minutes in a game seven times this year, including three of her last four games. On December 30 versus Siena, Hoskova played a career-high 42 minutes in an overtime setback. This year, she is playing over 35 minutes per game. Posset has played 40 or more minutes in a game three times, including a career-best 45 minutes against Siena.

RUNNING THE POINT

Junior Lexi Posset scored 24 points to lead Rider past Niagara on January 18. She was 5-of-13 from the field, including an impressive 3-of-6 from three-point range. She played all 40 minutes and grabbed four rebounds to go along with two steals. She scored 20 or more points in a game for the second time this season and the third time in her career. Posset also set a new career-best by going 11-of-12 from the free-throw line. She has scored in double figures in six of their last seven games.

GRAND THEFT AUTO

Sophomore guard Stella Johnson recorded three steals in Rider's win against Niagara on January 18. It was her 10th game this season with three or more steals. She opened the year with six steals versus Bucknell. Her six steals in that November 10 contest were the most by a player in the MAAC this season. Stella leads the team with 46 steals and she's averaging 2.4 per game. As a team, Rider is fourth in the MAAC in steals with nearly eight per game. The Broncos have recorded 10 or more steals in a game twice this year, including a season-best 18 in the opener against Bucknell.

BATTLE OF THE BOARDS

Rider outrebounded Quinnipiac, 34-26, on January 15. The Broncos pulled down nine offensive rebounds compared to just five for the Bobcats. This season, Rider is 4-4 when they outrebound their opponents, including 2-1 in conference play. The team has won the battle of the boards in three of their last five games. Versus Niagara, freshman Daija Moses grabbed a career-high six rebounds.

BENCH MOB

The Rider bench outscored the Quinnipiac reserves, 29-8, on January 15. Lea Favre scored on nine points on 4-of-5 shooting off the bench, while freshman Jaiden Morris scored a team-high 18 points on 7-of-10 shooting. Tracey Goodman led the charge for subs against Niagara, scoring six points on 3-of-5 shooting. The team is 5-4 this year when their subs score more than their opponents.

JAIDEN'S BIG GAME

Freshman Jaiden Morris had a career night against Quinnipiac on January 15. She scored career-best 18 points on 7-of-10 shooting off the bench for the Broncos. Morris also tied career-bests in rebounds (6) and steals (3). She went off in the third quarter for Rider, scoring nine points and registering two steals. She was 2-of-4 from beyond the arc versus the Bobcats and she also hit both of her free-throw attempts.

WELCOME TO THE CLUB

Senior Kamila Hoskova became the 22nd player in program history to score 1,000 career points on December 30 against Siena. She became the third Bronc in the last two years to reach the milestone and the second in the past two years to do so on a free throw against the Saints. Currently, Hoskova has 1,074 career points which ranks 19th all-time at Rider.

DOUBLE VISION

Senior Kamila Hoskova registered her second double-double of the season at Fairfield on January 10. She scored 12 points and added 10 rebounds. Her other double-double this year came against East Carolina. Sophomore Stella Johnson is the other Bronc with a double-double this year and she also has two, one of which came at Saint Peter's in conference play on January 2. Versus the Peacocks, Stella set new career-bests in points (29) and made field goals (13). Her 29-point, 11-rebound performance propelled Rider to victory at Saint Peter's. She knocked down 13-of-21 shots from the field and both of her three-point attempts. She also added two steals. It was her second career double-double and first in conference play. She has 10 or more rebounds twice this season and she's scored 20 or more points three times.



LYNN MILLIGAN

HEAD COACH
11TH SEASON
RIDER '92, '94

In 2013-14, Milligan led the Broncos to 15 wins, tying for fifth in the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference and Rider advanced to the MAAC semifinals for the first time and the Broncos won their first playoff game since 2004-05.

During that season, Milligan put a player on the All-MAAC First Team for the second season in a row with MyNeshia McKenzie a finalist for Player of the Year honors in the conference. McKenzie graduated as Rider's all-time leading rebounder and third on the all-time scoring list.

Milligan also had a player on the MAAC All-Rookie team with Julia Duggan earning Rider's fifth All-Rookie honor in Milligan's first seven seasons.

With 15 wins in 2012-13, Rider had its best season since the Broncos went 16-12 in 1994-95.

The 15 wins were the fifth most in the then 74-year history of the program and Rider tied its best MAAC record (10-8), finishing fourth in the conference.

Rider made the MAAC quarterfinals and McKenzie earned First Team All-MAAC and Second Team All-MET honors with senior Caitlin Bopp earning Third Team All-MAAC honors with freshman Mikal Johnson named to the MAAC All-Rookie team.

Rider got off to its best start in almost 30 years when the Broncos opened 2011-12 with eight wins in the first 11

The team had a record-breaking in 2016-17, finishing 24-9 and earning the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAAC) automatic bid to the WNIT thanks to a second-place finish during the regular season. The post-season berth was the first for the Broncos at the Division I level.

Milligan picked up her 100th career win as the Head Coach of the Broncos during the 2016-17 season and she now ranks second all-time in program history in wins.

She was named both the MAAC Coach of the Year in a vote of her peers and the Maggie Dixon Division I Coach of the Year by the Metropolitan Basketball Writers Association. Milligan was the first Rider Head Coach to earn both distinctions.

Milligan guided the Broncos to arguably the most successful season in program history in 2016-17, racking up 24 wins and earning the No. 2 seed in the MAAC Tournament. Picked to finish 10th in the preseason poll, Rider posted an 8-2 mark both on the road and at home in conference play. The team swept eight MAAC opponents during the regular season and was ranked for four weeks in the CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top-25 Poll.

The 24 wins are the most victories by the Broncos under Milligan and the most for the program since the team won 26 games during the 1981-82 season. The 24 wins against Division I opponents is the most in a single season in program history as well. The 16 MAAC wins are also the most under Milligan in a season and in program history. The team finished above .500 in conference play for the third time since entering the league and the No. 2 seed is the best for Rider since joining the MAAC as well.

In 2016-17, the women's basketball team saw four players earn All-MAAC honors as announced in early March by the league office. The four players earning All-MAAC honors is a new program record for Rider as the team saw three players receive league-wide distinction in 2012-13, 2001-02 and 1999-2000. The four players honored by the league were the most by any team in the conference this year.

In 2014-15, Milligan's squad posted double-digit wins for the fourth season in a row before being held to eight wins this past season.

games, matching the 8-3 start by the 1982-83 squad. The Broncos were led by McKenzie who was recognized with Third Team All-MAAC honors.

In 2010-11, Milligan, for the third season in a row, coached a member of the MAAC All-Rookie team (McKenzie) with Ali Heller earning MAAC Sixth Player of the Year honors after being one of the most prolific three-point shooters in the nation.

Caitlin Bopp earned All-Rookie honors in 2009-10 with Sarah Homan earning All-Rookie honors in 2008-09. In her second season at the helm of the Broncos' program, Rider finished with its most victories since the 1999-2000 season and its second highest MAAC win total all-time, earning Milligan consideration for MAAC Coach of the Year.

In Milligan's first season, Rider tripled its win total in the MAAC and the excitement that Milligan brought to the program boosted attendance in Alumni Gym to almost 600 fans per game.

Milligan returned to her alma mater to become the new head coach of the Rider University women's basketball team, on April 24, 2007.

"Returning to Rider has been a dream come true," said Milligan, who was a two-sport stand-out for the Broncos. "I was thrilled to come home to a place that is so special to me and have the opportunity to lead the women's basketball program into the future."

Milligan returned to Rider from Saint Joseph's University in Philadelphia, Pa., where she served as an assistant coach for six years, the last two as the top assistant. Saint Joseph's earned a berth in the WNIT five times during her last six seasons.

At Saint Joseph's, Milligan was directly responsible for recruiting and guard play for a program that compiled 111 wins during her last six seasons with the team. Three of her last five recruiting classes were nationally ranked. She assisted with all aspects of the Hawks' program, including on-court instruction, scouting, game-plan preparation, academic support and fundraising.

Prior to joining Saint Joseph's, Milligan spent six years as the top assistant coach at Drexel University. In her final season, she helped guide Drexel to a 19-10 record overall and a 13-5 mark in the America East Conference, tying for second place and advancing to the semifinal round of the league tournament. Milligan arrived in Philadelphia following a one-year stint as an assistant coach at Central Connecticut State.

At Rider, Milligan earned a bachelor's degree in communication in 1992 and earned a master's degree in counseling in 1994. Also a three-year member of the Bronco softball team, Milligan collected more than 100 career hits in just three seasons and helped lead the team to the 1990 East Coast Conference Championship as the team's leading hitter and to the 1991 Eastern College Athletic Conference Championship.

A native of Voorhees, N.J., Milligan is a member of Eastern High School's Athletic Hall of Fame. Milligan has a twin sister, Aileen, who played basketball at Loyola College in Maryland. Milligan is an active member of the Women's Basketball Coaches Association. She currently resides in Voorhees with her husband, Patrick.

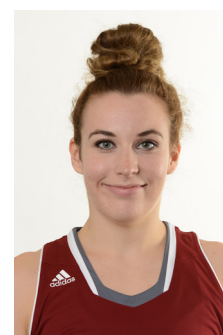
