11 MILES DOWN THE ROAD, WE GO!

Manhattan looks to get back to its winning ways after a pair of losses to Fairfield and Mount St. Mary's respectively. The Jaspers were without junior guard Nitzan Amar, who sustained a lower-body injury on Thursday, January 23 at Fairfield. She did not play against Mount on Saturday. Stepping up for Manhattan against the Mountaineers, was sophomore Tegan Young, who logged a career high 23 points in her absence. Additionally, Young made her fourth start this season in Amar's stead. This season, the Jaspers have been very selfless with the basketball, but when trailing its opponents in assists, it has fallen to 0-5 on the season. Against Iona, the Jaspers have taken the last two meetings by a combined 18 points both in New Rochelle and Riverdale. Last January, then-senior forward Ines Gimenez-Monserrat set a career-high in shots attempted in a game with 17.

NEWS & NOTES

JASPERS AT A GLANCE:

Hana Muhl - Guard - Junior

- Against Merrimack, Muhl logged a career-high seven assists on Sat. 1/11.
- Muhl grabbed 10 rebounds at Marist on Sat, Dec. 21. Muhl has now grabbed double-digit boards for the second time this year (11/24 @ UMBC with 13)
- Registered a career-high 28 points in the season opener at Rutgers on Mon. November 4 inside Jersey Mikes Arena. Muhl converted 9-of-14 from the field.
- Muhl, arrived in Riverdale after a two-year stint with Ball State from '22-24.

Leyla Ozturk - forward - Graduate Student

- Ozturk logged a career-high 22 points in victory over Niagara on Sat. 1/18.
- Against UMBC on Sunday, November 24, Ozturk tied a career-high with five blocks throughout the 60-50 victory in Baltimore. Ozturk logged five blocks twice before vs. Wagner to open the '22-23 season, and in '23-24 v. Niagara.
- Prior to arriving in Riverdale, Ozturk began her career in the CAA with the Northeastern Huskies during the 2020-21 and 2021-22 campaigns.

Nitzan Amar - Guard - Senior

- Amar sits third in the MAAC with 64 assists and 5.3 assists-per-game.
- Throughout the team's six victories, Amar has led the team with 44 assists. Additionally, Amar sits second on the team averaging 11.7 PPG in the six wins.
- Prior to Manhattan University, Amar began her NCAA career in North Carolina at UNC Greensboro from 2021-22 and 2022-23, respectively.

Ines Gimenez Monserrat - Guard/forward - Graduate Student

- In seven of 12 games this season, Monserrat has recorded double-digit points with a season high 19 at Rutgers. The team went 3-4 in those seven.
- Monserrat was tabbed to the All-MAAC Preseason Third Team in 2024-25.
- Prior to Monserrat's stint at Manhattan University, the Mallorca native started her career on the D2 circuit at NEIO's Franklin Pierce University.

Petra Juric - Senior - forward

- As of Wednesday, 1/29, Juric sits third in the MAAC in field-goal percentage averaging 54.5. Behind Fairfield's Coe, and SHU's Kirby.
- The senior was named Hercules Tires MAAC Women's Basketball Player of the Week on 11/18, alongside Quinnipiac's Gal Raviv.
- Juric was tabbed to the All-MAAC Preseason Second Team in 2024-25.

Brianna Davis - Junior - Guard

- Davis notched a Division I high 22 points against Siena on Thursd. 1/2.
- Transferred from nearby Queens College in Division II's East Coast Conference. Davis earned All-ECC Second Team honors last season.
- In 2022-23, Davis was named the ECC Rookie of the Year after recording five-double-doubles, and a career-high 24 pts v. Roberts Wesleyan.

BROADCASTER TIPS

- Senior forward Petra Juric sits sixth in the MAAC in rebounds-per-game averaging 6.5 per game. One slot higher than her teammate Leyla Ozturk, who's averaging 6.4 RPG.
- Graduate forward Leyla Ozturk sank home a career-high 10 field goals at Niagara.
- Junior guard Hana Muhl made her triumphant return to the lineup in Emmitsburg, MD after suffering a lower-body injury at Marist. She logged five boards and three steals.
- Senior guard Nitzan Amar ranks fourth in the MAAC, and atop the team in minutes played per-game averaging 35.0 minutes.
- Amar tied a career high with seven rebounds against Saint Peter's on Thursday 12/19. The other times, were at ETSU in '22 with UNCG and 2023 v. UMBC with Manhattan.
- The Jaspers' 29% field goal percentage against the Peacocks on Dec. 21, was the lowest recorded since 22-23 season, when Manhattan recorded 29% or lower six times.



SCOUTING THE OPPOSITION:

- The Iona Gaels currently sit sixth in the MAAC, one game over .500 in conference play through nine total games.
- Iona is led by second-year head coach Angelika Szumilo. The LIU graduate began her coaching career at the now-defunct LIU Brooklyn campus, and was most recently the head coach of the Northeast Conferences' FDU Knights women's basketball program.
- In the 2024-25 MAAC Preseason Coaches Poll released this past October, the Gaels were selected to finish eighth out of 13 total teams in the league.
- Sophomore forward Zoey Ward leads the Gaels in scoring averaging 9.6 PPG.
- Senior guard Ella Fajardo is the second leading scorer for the Gaels. Fajardo was a transfer from FDU, and played for Szumilo in Teaneck.
- The Gaels are coming off an 11-point loss against the Siena Saints on Saturday, January 25 inside the UHY Center in Loudonville. It was Fajardo and Ward who led the team with a combined 24 points.
- Senior guard Judith Gomez sits third in the MAAC averaging 41.3 percent from three-point range. Gomez sits behind Mount's LeMaster and Quinnipiac's Grisdale, respectively.
- Senior forward Erin Leary leads the MAAC in blocked shots with 39, and averages 2.1 per-game, just .3 higher than Manhattan's Leyla Ozturk, who sits with 33 on the year.

PAIR OF COACHES SHINING BRIGHT

Manhattan women's basketball associate head coach Callan Stores and assistant coach Sara Mitchell have been selected to the 2025 WBCA Next Generation Institute, per a WBCA release. Both Stores and Mitchell are part of a 32-person class consisting of Division I assistant coaches who aspire to become head coaches someday. Since its founding three years ago, the mission of the Next Generation Institute is to reinforce the CEO attributes of being a DI head coach. By gaining membership, Stores and Mitchell will join their peers at the WBCA Convention from April 3-6 in Tampa. Stores is in her ninth season at Manhattan after starting as the director of basketball operations during the 2016-17 season under head coach Heather Vulin. A member of Vulin's first staff at Manhattan, Stores eventually rose up the ranks to associate head coach, a title she has held for the past two seasons. Stores was a star player at Sacred Heart, leading the women's basketball program in career rebounds (1,123) while sitting second on the Pioneers' all-time points list (1,822). Mitchell is in her second season at Manhattan after previously serving as an assistant at Yale in 2023. Prior to Yale, Mitchell was instrumental in helping NJIT to its most successful season in program history in 2021-22, when the Highlanders won 15 games and advanced to the semifinals of the America East Tournament. Mitchell held an assistant role at NJIT from 2018 to 2022. She is a graduate of King's College, where she played college basketball. Stores and Mitchell are the only members of the Class of 2025 who coach at the same institution.

THIS IS MANHATTAN UNIVERSITY

Why is Manhattan University in the Bronx? Our campus was originally located in Manhattan at the intersection of 131st Street and Broadway. In 1923, Manhattan College moved to its present Riverdale location in order to accommodate a growing student body. But with more than 60 years of history established as Manhattan College, the institution decided to retain the name despite the geographic misnomer. 17 alumni are members of the prestigious National Academy of Engineering — an impressive number for an institution the size of Manhattan University. Alumni include Rudy Giuliani '65, former mayor of New York City; James Patterson '69, best-selling author; and Raymond Kelly '63, former commissioner of the NYPD. Manhattan is one of only 182 remaining colleges founded in the United States before the Civil War.

JASPERS SIGN FOUR IN NLI PERIOD

Manhattan women's basketball head coach Heather Vulin is pleased to announce the newest recruits for the class of 2025; Tatianna Collins (5-10 F, Jersey City, N.J.), Celeste Harper (5-8 G, Englewood, N.J.), Rotem Kahlon (5-7 G, Jerusalem, Israel) and Johlana Tatum (5-8 G, Brooklyn, N.Y.). Tatianna Collins - Plays her prep ball at Hudson Catholic High School in New Jersey under the auspices of Chris Hernandez. Before that, as a junior, Collins played with current Manhattan forward Alexis Rosenfeld at Morris Catholic where the pair won a Morris County Tournament Title. Why she chose Manhattan: "From the moment I stepped into the school I felt at home. The staff and community made me feel welcome." Tati is going to be someone that is going to be a menace on the defensive side of the ball. Her length and athleticism and ability to guard anybody on the court is gonna be really fun to coach and open up a lot of options for us defensively. Plus, Tati is a strong finisher in transition converting on her steals and deflections." Celeste Harper: Played her high school basketball at Academy of the Holy Angels in New Jersey and is currently playing at Kent School (CT) of the Founders League. At Holy Angels, Harper enjoyed a decorated career where she was named First Team All-League and Honorable Mention All-County her sophomore year; First Team All-League, Third Team All-County and Team MVP her junior year; and was First Team All-League, Second Team All-County and Team MVP as a senior. She was assigned the title of captain her senior season at Holy Angels. On August 8, Harper announced her verbal commitment to Manhattan on X, and officially signed her athletic aid agreement on November 15. Why she chose Manhattan: "The finance program and the feeling of community of the campus, as well as opportunities for growth in athletics and my career field." Celeste is a dynamic combo guard that can run the point and light it up from the outside. She will flourish in our uptempo style." Rotem Kahlon: Hails from Israel where she represented her country on the U-16 national team and the 3x3 U17 national team. She currently competes for H.Petah Tikva of Israel-Division A, the top division of professional basketball in Israel. While playing for Ramat Hashron during the 2023-24 season, Kahlon led her squad to the U18 national cup, defeating her former club, Elitzur Holon. She was named MVP for the championship. Why she chose Manhattan: "The basketball program, location and the coaching staff in addition to the great educational system." Rotem is going to bring us experience and poise as a freshman. She spent the last two years serving her country in the military but also playing a high level of basketball. Her overall floor game is impressive and she has the ability to make plays on both the offensive and defensive end." Johlana Tatum: Plays her high school basketball at Nazareth Regional in Brooklyn. She earned the Clutch Performer Award at the WNBPA Camp held over the summer in Brooklyn. Tatum's skillset belies her 5-9 frame as she pulled down 5.8 rebounds per game as a junior.



JASPER NOTES

WHAT IS A JASPER?

The unique nickname of Manhattan College's athletic teams, the Jaspers, comes from one of the College's most memorable figures, Brother Jasper of Mary, F.S.C., who served as the College's athletic director in the late 19th century. One of the greatest achievements of Brother Jasper was that he brought the then little-known sport of baseball to Manhattan College and became the team's first coach. Since Brother Jasper was also the Prefect of Discipline, he supervised the student fans at Manhattan baseball games while also directing the team itself. During one particularly warm and humid day when the college was playing a semi-pro baseball team called the Metropolitans, Brother Jasper noticed the Manhattan students were becoming restless and edgy with the team coming to bat in the seventh inning of a close game. To relieve the tension, Brother Jasper called timeout and told the students to stand up and stretch for a few minutes until the game resumed. Since the College annually played the New York Giants in the late 1880's and into the 1890's at the old Polo Grounds, the Manhattan College practice of the "seventh inning stretch" spread into the major leagues, where it has now become a time-honored custom practiced by millions of fans annually.

THE WORLDWIDE LEADER

For the sixth-straight season all of Manhattan's MAAC games will air on the ESPN family of networks. Most games will air on ESPN+ with ALL games able to be accessed through a cable subscription, and ESPN+ a standalone subscription to ESPN.

BEST START IN VULIN ERA

These Jaspers have opened up the 2024-25 campaign by storm with six victories in the non-conference slate. The best start under head coach Heather Vulin, came in 2021-22, when the team opened up its season 3-2 with victories over St. Francis Brooklyn, Army West Point, and LIU. Vulin's Jaspers accumulated 21 wins that year, with 11 losses, and a trip to the MAAC Championship Final, where they fell to #1 Fairfield 73-68 inside Boardwalk Hall in Atlantic City, NJ.

SISTERLY LOVE

Sophomore Kristina Juric and Senior forward Petra Juric having the same last name is NOT coincidence. Kristina is the younger sister of Petra. Both Juric's did not attend the same school pre-college. Kristina attended Kuslanova Gymnasium, while Petra attended Ill Gymnasium. Against FAU, Kristina tallied a career-high 5 rebounds, and one block. Against Niagara, Kristina logged a career-high nine points. Additionally, graduate assistant and former student-athlete Jayla James is the sister of former Women's Basketball Director of Basketball Operations Raven James.

NITZ WITH MAAC RECOGNITION

Amar paces the team in scoring, averaging 11.0 points per game. She leads the team with 44 assists. Second on the team in steals with 13. Amar sits with a 3.81 cumulative grade-point average. On Saturday, December 21, Amar set a season-high with three steals at Marist. Since the list above doesn't populate our student-athlete, please see Amar's season statistics as of 12/23/24 - 326 total minutes, 34-for-100 (34.0 FG%), 16-for-46 (34.8 3ptFG%), 15-for-22 (68.2 FT%), 30 rebounds (4 offensive, 26 defensive, 3.3 rebounds-per-game), 44 assists, 19 turnovers, 6 blocks, 13 steals, 99 points, 11.0 PPG).



WELCOME ABOARD, MEGHAN!

Head Coach Heather Vulin has announced the addition of freshman guard Meghan Thompson for the 2025-26 academic year. "Meghan is going to be a tremendous addition to our team." Said Vulin. "She is a winner! She will help elevate our play on the court and be an incredible ambassador for our program. We are so excited to have Meghan join us, and we love her basketball IQ, ability to spread the floor, and natural leadership ability." Thompson, a 5-8 guard, hails from Colchester, Vermont, where she played Varsity Girls Basketball all four years at Mount Mansfield Union High School under former Manhattan Jasper football player Mark Pfaff '80. Throughout her tenure as a member of the Cougars, Thompson gradually improved as her career went on. She kicked off her varsity career, averaging 6.6 points per game during her freshman campaign. During her sophomore year, Thompson increased her points-per-game output to eight. Her junior campaign saw a massive production increase, as she averaged 15.53 points per game and a three-point percentage of 42.5, which led her to claim Second Team All-Metro accolades. Additionally, she averaged 2.8 rebounds per game, 1.9 assists per game, and 1.7 steals in her junior year. "I chose Manhattan University because of the strong culture of the women's basketball team leading to me quickly connecting with both the players and coaching staff. Along with the environment that feels like home." Said Thompson. "Manhattan University also has a really good teaching program and a small class size, allowing for personal connections with professors." Academically, the Vermont native was named to the Honor Roll for all four high school years. Thompson will major in Early Childhood Education in Riverdale.

Manhattan College Head Coach Heather Vulin enters her ninth season with the Jaspers in 2024-25. Known as a tenacious and tireless recruiter with over 20 years of coaching experience, she was named the eighth head coach in program history on April 25, 2016.

With a talented roster from top to bottom, the 2022-23 squad had multiple threats on offense and were able to use that to their advantage down the stretch. The Jaspers found themselves in the 2023 MAAC Tournament championship game for the second year in a row after a 10-10 MAAC regular season mark and sixth place finish. In the classroom, the Jaspers were named a Top 25 WBCA All-Academic Team for their GPA. Dee Dee Davis earned Second-Team All-MAAC honors and was named Second-Team All-Met for the second straight year.

The 2021-2022 campaign saw Vulin continue to build on the team's successes in the previous two years. She led the Jaspers to a 21-11 record, the most wins in a single season since the 2010-2011 season, and the team's third straight winning season, including a 14-6 record in MAAC play. She guided the team to the finals of the MAAC Tournament while earning the third seed in the tournament. En route to the finals, the team took down Canisius (61-49) and then proceeded to upend the second-seeded Quinnipiac (72-59). Vulin coached four players, Dee Dee Davis, Courtney Warley, Brazil Harvey-Carr, and Petra Juric to All-MAAC honors. Davis and Warley both earned first-team nods, another first for the program, while Harvey-Carr earned third-team honors while Juric earned a spot on the All-Rookie team. Davis and Warley also earned second-team All-Met honors. Vulin guided Warley to be the second player in program history to score 1,000 points and pull down 1,000 rebounds.

The 2020-2021 campaign was highlighted by Vulin earning her first postseason appearance, while leading the program to its best MAAC winning percentage (9-3; 750) since 2002-03 as well a second-straight winning season (11-9). The Jaspers earned a bid to the 2021 Women's Basketball Invitational (WBI), and after losing a hard-fought battle to eventual champion Cleveland State, defeated Loyola Chicago in securing Manhattan's first postseason win the 2011-12 season. Prior to the year, the Jaspers were also tabbed as the MAAC's Top Team and defeated Saint Peter's on February 6 before a nationally televised audience on ESPNU. Center Courtney Warley averaged a double-double en route to earning All-MAAC Second Team honors, which also marks her third-straight all-league honor. Warley also stood out in the classroom, and was named as one of 30 finalists for the prestigious Senior Class Award. Guard Dee Dee Davis joined Warley on the All-MAAC Second Team and paced the team in scoring, while her backcourt mate Emily LaPointe provided the season's signature moment as her putback at the buzzer was the difference in Manhattan's 71-70 overtime win vs. perennial MAAC power Quinnipiac.

In 2019-20, Vulin led the Jaspers to the program's best finish since 2011 (15-14, 12-8 MAAC), going 6-1 down the stretch and winning five straight to tie for third place in the MAAC and earn a first round bye (#4 seed) in the 2020 conference tournament. The Jaspers' 12-8 MAAC record marked the fourth time in eight years that the program has finished .500 or better in league play, three under Vulin's leadership. Though Manhattan's season came to an abrupt end when the 2020 MAAC tournament was cancelled due to the spread of COVID-19, the Jaspers finished the season ranked 66th in Division I for scoring defense and 74th in turnover margin.

Warley received First Team All-MAAC honors, as well as All-ECAC Second Team and All-Met Second Team accolades. LaPointe became the program's first unanimous MAAC Rookie of the Year, while being named to the MAAC All-Rookie Team and All-Met Third Team. It was the third-straight season that a Vulin player earned MAAC All-Rookie recognition, as well as the third-straight year a Jasper took home one of the conference's major postseason awards.

During the 2018-19 campaign, Vulin led the Jaspers to a fourth-place tie in the MAAC, finishing the year 9-9 in conference (12-19 overall). After knocking-off perennial powerhouse Marist and No. 2 Rider during the regular season, Manhattan reached the quarterfinals of the 2019 MAAC Championship, the second consecutive year the Jaspers advanced to that round. The team also received a significant boost from its freshmen and sophomores, accounting for approximately 70 percent of all minutes played.

In Vulin's second season, the Jaspers finished with a 13-18 overall record (9-9 MAAC), facing a challenging schedule that included seven games against opponents that qualified for postseason play, including California and Virginia. In her first year as head coach (2016-17), Vulin led the Jaspers to an 8-22 overall record, going 4-16 in conference play. Despite an injury-plagued year, her inaugural season brought a renewed commitment to the program's culture (known as #play-GREEN), an intense focus on recruiting, and a tenacity on defense that has set the stage for years to come.

Player development on and off the court is essential to Vulin. As a result, multiple Jaspers have earned individual accolades during her tenure, including LaPointe and Warley (who was also the 2018-19 MAAC Defensive Player of the Year and has earned All-MAAC Third Team and MAAC All-Rookie honors), as well as Kayla Grimme, a 2017-18 All-MAAC Second Team and All-Met Third Team selection who played basketball professionally in Portugal in 2018; Amani Tatum, a 2017-18 All-MAAC Third Team selection; Gabby Cajou, the MAAC's 2017-18 Sixth Player of the Year, the first in program history; and Davis, a unanimous selection to the 2018-19 MAAC All-Rookie Team.

In 2015-16, Vulin served as assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at the ACC's Virginia Tech. Vulin helped the Hokies post a seven-win turnaround from the 2014-15 campaign and earn a berth in the postseason WNIT, their first postseason appearance in nine years, where Virginia Tech advanced to the second round. The Hokies received votes in both the USA Today and AP polls, and finished the season ranked 11th nationally in field goal percentage defense (.346), as well as 15th in scoring defense (52.9 ppg).

Prior to her time at Virginia Tech, Vulin was an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Villanova for seven seasons, from 2008-2015, under Harry Perretta, who in 2016 became the 10th active and 14th overall Division I women's basketball coach to win 700 games at one school. The Wildcats won four Big Five titles, made two NCAA Tournament appearances and earned three postseason WNIT appearances during that span, reaching the quarterfinals of the postseason WNIT in 2015. Villanova posted three consecutive 20-win seasons from 2012-13 to 2014-15. In addition, the Wildcats led the nation in fewest turnovers per game four-straight times (2011-15).

During her time at Villanova, Vulin was responsible for the recruitment of three Gatorade Players of the Year, including Caroline Coyer, the 2013 Virginia Player of the Year and a member of the 2015 U.S. Team at the Pan American Games, and the three-time Delaware Player of the Year. Among the players she recruited and developed were three Big East All-Rookie Team selections, four Big East Sixth Men of the Year, and seven All-Big East performers.

After beginning her coaching career as a graduate assistant at North Dakota State under Women's Basketball Hall of Fame member Amy Ruley from 2000-02, Vulin spent two seasons as an assistant coach at Sacred Heart University from 2002-04, before being promoted to recruiting coordinator at Sacred Heart from 2004-08, helping the Pioneers post a 124-55 overall record and win a pair of Northeast Conference (NEC) championships. She recruited the 2008-09 squad that became just the third team in NEC history to go undefeated in the regular season and win the tournament championship. While at Sacred Heart, she mentored two NEC Players of the Year (one of which is the all-time leading scorer in program history) and two NEC Rookies of the Year, as well as seven all-NEC players and five NEC All-Rookie selections.

Prior to leaving Sacred Heart in 2008, Vulin recruited current Jaspers Assistant Coach Callan Taylor to attend Sacred Heart. During Taylor's time with the Pioneers, she earned All-NEC honors each season, including NEC Player of the Year, and became the Pioneers' all-time leading rebounder (1,123), while ranking second on the Pioneers' career scoring list (1,822).

A two-sport athlete at Minnesota-Morris, Vulin was a four-year letterwinner in both basketball and volleyball, receiving academic all-conference honors in each. Vulin earned a bachelor's degree in secondary education – social sciences, psychology and women's studies from Minnesota-Morris in 1999, and a master's degree in education from North Dakota State in 2003.

Vulin is married to Kevin Vulin, who played basketball at Sacred Heart University and professionally overseas. He previously served as assistant men's basketball coach at Sacred Heart, where the couple met in 2002. They have a son, Jack, and a daughter, Ava and reside in Hartsdale, NY.

GAME #19 - Iona @ Siena - 1/25/25

LOUDONVILLE, NY – The Iona University women's basketball team dropped a close matchup on the road Saturday afternoon, falling to Siena 79-68 at the UHY Center. The Gaels reclaimed the lead early in the fourth quarter but were unable to withstand a late charge by the Saints to split the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference regular season series between the two teams. The Gaels had two scorers eclipse 20 points for the game. Senior Ella Fajardo led the way with a career-high 22 points to go with a game-high five assists. Sophomore Zoey Ward also registered 20-plus points with a career-high 21 points for the game and a team-high five rebounds. Senior Erin Leary finished the game with three steals and two blocked shots on the defensive end to pair with nine points. Siena continued its hot shooting in the second quarter with a 15-5 margin to start the frame and build up to its largest lead of the afternoon, 40-25 with 3:35 left in the opening half. Iona picked up baskets from Fajardo and senior Talia DePetrillo to cut into the deficit and bring the score at halftime to 41-29 in favor of the home side. Iona utilized its press out of the intermission causing five Siena turnovers in the first 3:30 of play to force a timeout from the Saints. A 7-3 run out of the timeout with four points from Ward and a knock down three from Leary cut the deficit to seven, 49-42 with 4:49 to go. The Gaels continued the strong third quarter with a 10-6 closing stretch to make it a three-point game 55-52 heading into the final frame. Ward led Iona with 13 points in the frame to pace the comeback bid. Momentum carried over into the fourth quarter as sophomore Mya Zaccagnini began the period with a knockdown triple followed by a steal and then one more three-pointer to give Iona back the lead 58-55 with 9:26 left to go. Siena responded out of its called timeout with a 7-0 run to take back the lead. A triple from Fajardo cut the run briefly before another 7-0 run from the Saints to take firm hold of the game.
