SERIES HISTORY WITH IONA

Iona leads the all-time series 35-27, including the first meeting this season when four Gaels scored in double figures, led by 14 each from Zoey Ward, Ella Fajardo, and Judith Gomez. Gabby Turco led the Broncs with 13 points in the setback.

SCOUTING THE GAELS

The Gaels are currently sixth in the MAAC at 7-6 on the season. Iona is led on the defensive end by Erin Leary, who is second in the conference at 1.9 blocks per game. She had two in the first meeting this year.

COACHES PREDICTIONS

The Broncs were picked to finish ninth by the league's coaches in the pre-season poll. Rider has won at least one game in the MAAC Tournament in seven of the last eight seasons. The Broncs will have to deal with the loss of three starters from last year's team, including the loss of 62.8% of the team's scoring from a season ago.

DO I KNOW YOU?

The Broncs roster has been completely overhauled in the last two seasons. Despite having four seniors and two juniors on the roster, the Broncs do not have a single player on the team who was a part of the program for the 2022-23 season.

LA SALLE TO LAWRENCEVILLE

The Broncs feature a pair of incoming transfers, both from La Salle in Gabby Turco and Emilee Tahata. Tahata, a junior forward, averaged 5.2 points and 3.1 rebounds for the Explorers in 2023-24. Turco, a senior guard, was two-time All-NE10 honoree and NE10 Rookie of the Year in two seasons at Saint Anselm before playing last year at La Salle. She averaged 5.4 points and 2.8 rebounds for the Explorers a season ago.

CHAMPIONSHIP EXPERIENCE

Rider added three domestic freshmen this season, in guards Camryn Collins, Amany Lopez, and Jocelyn Chavez. Collins was a two-time state champion in Massachusetts playing for Foxboro High School. Lopez scored 16 points in a 43-40 Massachusetts State Championship Game victory. Chavez was a two-time state champion and three-time region champion in Arizona.

A LONG WAY FROM HOME

Rider's two international freshmen have taken journeys to Rider with Emmy Roach coming to Rider from Australia and Winner Bartholomew joining the Broncs from Nigeria via Italy. Bartholomew's first day on campus was also her first day in the United States when she showed up for the first day of classes. She was a member of the 3x3 Italian Championship Team in 2023-24. Roach was team captain of the 2024 South Australian State Team that won a national silver medal.

A LITTLE HELP FOR MY FRIENDS

Sanaa Redmond led the Broncs last season at 2.5 assists per game and led the Broncs in dimes in 12 of their contests. Redmond also valued ball security, with a 1.2 assist to turnover ratio. Redmond scored a season-high 13 points in the opening round of the MAAC Tournament last season against Iona. This Season, Aliya McIver has been doing the most dishing, sitting 10th in the MAAC at 3.5 assists per game and is also ninth in the MAAC with a 1.3 assist to turnover ratio.



'O' NO

Originally nicknamed the Rough Riders by the father of Rider Athletics and Naismith Hall of Famer, Clair Bee, Rider's nickname later changed to the Broncos. What is a Bronc? It's a Bronco. But you can keep the second o. Why do we call ourselves the Broncos, then? The quick answer is a newspaper writer at least 70 years ago either made a typo or wanted a shorter word to fit their headline and called us the Broncos. Enough people actually liked it, so it stuck. Bee was not one who enjoyed the change, later saying he "damn near went through the ceiling" when he first read of the change. Still to this day, broadcasters and public address announcers routinely call us the Broncos in error, setting off a firestorm of tweets to our social media and much more work for our SID (Please don't make me do more work).

OVERTIME ELITE

Rider is 5-1 in overtime games over the last two seasons, including a 2-0 mark last season, defeating Lehigh and Marist. The Broncos had four different players combine for an 11-0 run to begin the extra session against the Mountain Hawks and the Broncos never looked back to secure the 67-57 win. Against Marist, Makayla Firebaugh hit a pair of free throws with one second remaining and the Broncos held on for a 62-61 win.

MERRY-MACK

The Broncos got their second-straight win at Merrimack, getting a game-winning layup from Emilee Tahata with 3.8 seconds remaining. Gabby Turco drew the double team in the tie game with under ten seconds to play before finding the open Tahata under the basket for the open layup.

COS AND EFFECT

Mariona Cos-Morales set a career-high with 14 points last season against Marist. The then-junior scored nine of her 14 in the third quarter, which saw Rider turn a six-point deficit into a three-point lead. The now senior showed off her defense in the MAAC Tournament, with three blocks in the first-round win over Iona, then with a career-high five steals in the MAAC Quarterfinal against Iona. Cos-Morales tied her career high with 14 points at LIU, including scoring nine of her 14 in the fourth quarter.

STAT SHEET STUFFER

Aliya McIver did a little bit of everything against FDU, setting career-highs in points (9), rebounds (11), and assists (8). The sophomore had five points, six rebounds, and five assists in the second half that saw both teams score 31 points.

GABBY'S GOT IT

Gabby Turco has provided instant offense for the Broncos after joining the team for her senior season. The Wildwood, NJ product led the team in scoring with 21 points against Navy and has scored in double figures in a team-high 16 games this season. In the win over Niagara, she scored a season-high 24 points and is now eighth in the MAAC at 13.9 points per game.

DOWN BUT NOT OUT

The Broncos trailed by as many as 11 points in the fourth quarter against Stonehill before storming back with a 12-0 run, eventually winning 65-53. The comeback win was just the sixth Division I contest that saw double-digit point comeback in the fourth quarter this season.

WINNING STREAK

The Broncos won their third-straight game against Sacred Heart. It was the first three-game streak for the Broncos since Rider won four-straight in February of 2024.

BLOCK PARTY

Emilee Tahata set a new career high with five blocks at LIU and the Broncos combined for eight blocks on the night. The Broncos are currently fifth in the MAAC at 3.2 blocks per game. Individually, Mariona Cos-Morales is ninth in the MAAC at 0.8 blocks per contest.

FEATURED FRESHMAN

Camryn Collins has scored in double figures in nine games this season, including each of the last three contests. The Freshman ranks in the top 20 among all players in the MAAC three-point percentage and steals. At Merrimack, Collins led the team with a career-high 15 points, then she tied that mark against Sacred Heart.

DEVENEY VIDI VICI

Kaylan Deveney made the start in her Rider debut at Saint Joseph's last season, scoring seven points and grabbing a board in 21 minutes of action. Deveney was the first true freshman to start in her Rider debut since Stella Johnson earned the start to begin her career in 2016. She set a career-high with 15 points against Boston University this year.

EVERYONE LOVES A WINNER

Winner Bartholomew enjoyed playing Quinnipiac this season. In two games, the freshman averaged 16.0 points in the pair of games against the Bobcats with two of her four double-digit scoring games this season coming in those contests. The freshman has led Rider in scoring three times this season, including tying a career high with 17 points against Sacred Heart.

EMILEE IN LAWRENCEVILLE

Emilee Tahata had a career game when the Broncos faced Bryant in Alumni Gym. The junior scored 12 of Rider's first 15 points in the opening six minutes of the game on her way to a career-high 16 along with tying a career-high with seven rebounds. She finished the game 7-for-9 from the field, including 2-for-3 from distance.

NEW BEGINNINGS

The Broncos began the game at BU with a new starting lineup for the first time this season, with Aliya McIver and Emmy Roach entering the starting five for the first time in their career's. McIver responded with a then career-high six rebounds in the contest. Rider continued to switch the starting lineup with Jamia Blake earning her first start as Bronc at Monmouth and Winner Bartholomew starting against FDU. Rider has used seven different starting lineups this season.

\$FREE.99

Gabby Turco has been nearly automatic at the free throw line, currently second in the MAAC and ranking 13th nationally at 91.2% from the charity stripe. This season is not an anomaly for the senior, who has knocked down 88.1% of her attempts at the line in her career.

COLLINS FAMILY REUNION

When the Broncos took on Bryant, the Bulldogs jersey was a familiar sight for the Collins family. Rider freshman Camryn Collins' sister Jordyn is a member of the Bryant women's soccer team, leading the Bulldogs in scoring this season with four goals and two assists.

UNITED NATIONS

The Broncos' roster features players from four different countries. In addition to the ten domestic products on the team, Rider has two from Australia, one from Spain, and one from Nigeria. The Broncos have featured players from multiple foreign countries in every season since 2011-12.

CENTURY MARK TIMES TWO

With the Broncos win at Lehigh last season, head coach Lynn Milligan recorded her 200th career victory. Milligan is already the winningest coach in program history in now her 18th season as head coach.

FAMILIAR FACES

In addition to Head Coach Lynn Milligan, who played for the Broncos under legendary head coach Eldon Price, MyNeshia McKenzie was named as Associate Head Coach ahead of the 2024-25 season, her fourth with the Broncos, after two-year stints at both Holy Family and St. Joseph's (PA). McKenzie, a 2014 Rider graduate, left the Broncos as the program's leading rebounder (1,143) and third-leading scorer (1,619). The Broncos also added Alyssa Parsons to the coaching staff as an assistant prior to the season. Parsons also played under Milligan, finishing her career with 173 assists and 52 made three-pointers in 78 career games.



LYNN MILLIGAN

HEAD COACH
18TH SEASON
RIDER '92, '94

Lynn Donovan-Milligan '92, '94 enters her 18th season as the head women's basketball coach at Rider University in 2024-25.

The Broncos won at least one game at the MAAC Tournament for the seventh time in the past eight seasons in 2023-24, defeating Iona in the opening round. Taylor Langan led the Broncos individual honors, being named Second-Team All-MAAC. Langan also garnered national attention during the regular season when her buzzer beater to win at Iona on ESPN was featured at number five in SportsCenter's Top 10. Makayla Firebaugh closed out her Rider career ranked eighth on the program's all-time scoring list with 1,365 career points. She also graduated fifth all-time in program history with 217 made three pointers. Jessika Schiffer closed out her Rider career ranked seventh in Rider history with 179 career triples. During the season Milligan earned her 200th career win.

Rider closed the 2022-23 season strong winning five of its final nine games, including an opening round victory in the MAAC Tournament over Marist. Amanda Mobley moved into second on Rider's career assist list, including a Division-I program record 13 against Manhattan. Mobley finished the season ranked just outside the top ten in the country for assists.

The Broncos were plagued by the injury bug under Milligan in 2021-22 with four players missing the entire season, and fifth suffering a season-ending injury just three games into the year. Lenaëja Evans made the most of her senior season with the Broncos, leading the squad in scoring on her way to Third-Team All-MAAC honors.

In 2020-21, the Broncos advanced to the semifinals of the MAAC Tournament for the fifth-straight season, topping 10th-seeded Monmouth and second-seeded Quinnipiac in Atlantic City. Makayla Firebaugh led the individual awards season for the team, being named MAAC Co-Rookie of the Year and Second-Team All-Met.

2019-20 was arguably the Broncos' finest in program history. Milligan earned her second MAAC and Metropolitan Basketball Writers Association Coach of the Year honors in leading Rider to its first-ever MAAC Regular Season Championship. The top-seeded Broncos advanced past Niagara in the MAAC Quarterfinals before the remainder of the tournament was canceled due to COVID-19. Milligan led Rider to an 18-2 league mark, with 18 wins being the most for the team in league play in program history. Rider went 26-4 overall and the 26 wins are the most since the Broncos joined Division I following the 1981-82 season. The Broncos were consistently ranked in the CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top-25 poll, spending the final two months inside the top-12.

With team success came individual accolades and opportunity. Stella Johnson earned her second consecutive MAAC Player of the Year honor, becoming the sixth player all-time to achieve the feat in back-to-back years. She became Rider's first-ever All-American, earning honorable mention recognition from the Associated Press, Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) and United States Basketball Writers Association (USBWA), while also being picked a Senior CLASS Award Second-Team All-American. Johnson was also a finalist for both the Nancy Lieberman Award and Becky Hammon Mid-Major Player of the Year and finished the year as the leading scorer in NCAA Division I at 24.8 points per game, more than a point ahead of the next-closest player. She was also the only active Division I player with 2,000 career points, 700 career rebounds, 400 career assists and 300 career steals. In addition, Johnson was named the ECAC and Met Division I Women's Basketball Player of the Year. The list of honors continued with Johnson's second-straight Rider Female Athlete of the Year and MAAC Female Student-Athlete of the Year honors, while becoming one of two MAAC nominees for NCAA Woman of the Year. Johnson's resume drew the attention of the WNBA, as she was the 29th overall selection in the WNBA Draft by the Phoenix Mercury, before making her WNBA debut for the Chicago Sky and later making a strong impact with the Washington Mystics in her rookie season.

Joining Stella Johnson in earning a MAAC major award was Amari Johnson, the league's Defensive Player of the Year. Amari also earned All-MAAC Second Team honors, along with fellow senior Lea Favre. Milligan also oversaw a strong performance in the classroom, with seven Broncos earning MAAC All-Academic Team recognition.

It was another banner year for the Broncos in 2018-19 as Rider finished the season with

a 19-13 overall record and a 14-4 record in the MAAC. Rider earned the league's automatic bid to the WNIT. It marked the second time in program history and the second time in the last three years that the team appeared in the WNIT. The Broncos won 10 or more MAAC games for the third year in a row (first time in program history 10 or more MAAC wins three straight years). The 14 MAAC wins are the most in program history in an 18-game conference schedule and the second-most in Rider history.

Three Broncos earned All-MAAC honors, highlighted by Stella Johnson being the only player in the league to be a unanimous selection to the First Team. Stella was also tabbed as the MAAC Player of the Year. It was the second time in program history that the team had a student-athlete recognized as the league's best player.

In 2017-18, the Broncos went 14-17 overall and 10-8 MAAC play to earn the No. 5 seed in the MAAC Tournament. Rider won a MAAC Tournament game for the second year in a row after topping fourth-seeded Fairfield in the MAAC Quarterfinals. The Broncos advanced to the MAAC Semifinals for the second year in a row and the third time in program history.

During the year, four Broncos earned weekly awards from either the MAAC or College Sports Madness. At the conclusion of the regular season, three Rider players garnered All-MAAC recognition. Stella Johnson and Kamila Hoskova were named Second Team All-MAAC and freshman Jaiden Morris landed on the MAAC All-Rookie Team.

In 2017-18, Hoskova became the 22nd player in program history to score 1,000 career points. She ended her stellar tenure with the Broncos eighth all-time in scoring with 1,255 points.

The team had a record-breaking in 2016-17, finishing 24-9 and earning the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAAC) automatic bid to the WNIT thanks to a second-place finish during the regular season. The post-season berth was the first for the Broncos at the Division I level. Milligan picked up her 100th career win during the 2016-17 season.

She was named both the MAAC Coach of the Year in a vote of her peers and the Maggie Dixon Division I Coach of the Year by the Metropolitan Basketball Writers Association. Milligan was the first Rider Head Coach to earn both distinctions.

Milligan guided the Broncos to arguably the most successful season in program history in 2016-17, racking up 24 wins and earning the No. 2 seed in the MAAC Tournament. Picked to finish 10th in the preseason poll, Rider posted an 8-2 mark both on the road and at home in conference play. The team swept eight MAAC opponents during the regular season and was ranked for four weeks in the CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top-25 Poll.

The 24 wins are the most victories by the Broncos under Milligan and the most for the program since the team won 26 games during the 1981-82 season. The 24 wins against Division I opponents is the most in a single season in program history as well. The 16 MAAC wins are also the most under Milligan in a season and in program history. The team finished above .500 in conference play for the third time since entering the league and the No. 2 seed is the best for Rider since joining the MAAC as well.

2024-25 Rider Women's Basketball



In 2016-17, the women's basketball team saw four players earn All-MAAC honors as announced in early March by the league office. The four players earning All-MAAC honors is a new program record for Rider as the team saw three players receive league-wide distinction in 2012-13, 2001-02 and 1999-2000. The four players honored by the league were the most by any team in the conference this year.

In 2014-15, Milligan's squad posted double-digit wins for the fourth season in a row before being held to eight wins this past season.

In 2013-14, Milligan led the Broncos to 15 wins, tying for fifth in the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference and Rider advanced to the MAAC semifinals for the first time and the Broncos won their first playoff game since 2004-05.

During that season, Milligan put a player on the All-MAAC First Team for the second season in a row with MyNeshia McKenzie a finalist for Player of the Year honors in the conference. McKenzie graduated as Rider's all-time leading rebounder and third on the all-time scoring list.

Milligan also had a player on the MAAC All-Rookie team with Julia Duggan earning Rider's fifth All-Rookie honor in Milligan's first seven seasons.

With 15 wins in 2012-13, Rider had its best season since the Broncos went 16-12 in 1994-95.

The 15 wins were the fifth most in the then 74-year history of the program and Rider tied its best MAAC record (10-8), finishing fourth in the conference.

Rider made the MAAC quarterfinals and McKenzie earned First Team All-MAAC and Second Team All-MET honors with senior Caitlin Bopp earning Third Team All-MAAC honors with freshman Mikal Johnson named to the MAAC All-Rookie team.

Rider got off to its best start in almost 30 years when the Broncos opened 2011-12 with eight wins in the first 11 games, matching the 8-3 start by the 1982-83 squad. The Broncos were led by McKenzie who was recognized with Third Team All-MAAC honors.

In 2010-11, Milligan, for the third season in a row, coached a member of the MAAC All-Rookie team (McKenzie) with Ali Heller earning MAAC Sixth Player of the Year honors after being one of the most prolific three-point shooters in the nation.

Caitlin Bopp earned All-Rookie honors in 2009-10 with Sarah Homan earning All-Rookie honors in 2008-09. In her second season at the helm of the Broncos' program, Rider finished with its most victories since the 1999-2000 season and its second highest MAAC win total all-time, earning Milligan consideration for MAAC Coach of the Year.

In 2008-09, attendance increased again to an average of 900 fans per home game and the Broncos have consistently almost 700 fans per contest since.

"The Rider community and the surrounding community took to the way we play," Milligan said. "I've always told the team that if you play hard, the fans will respect that and will want to see you play. Our alumni support is terrific and once you see a game, you want to come back again and again."

Never one to back down from a challenge, the Broncos posted wins over teams from the MAAC as well as Conference USA (Central Florida), the Northeast Conference (Monmouth), the Patriot League (Army), the Colonial Athletic Association (Hofstra) and the Ivy League (Princeton) during the 2007-08 season and defeated second place Canisius, third place Fairfield and fifth place Iona all on the road.

Milligan returned to her alma mater to become the new head coach of the Rider University women's basketball team, on April 24, 2007.

"Returning to Rider has been a dream come true," said Milligan, who was a two-sport stand-out for the Broncos. "I was thrilled to come home to a place that is so special to me and have the opportunity to lead the women's basketball program into the future."

Milligan returned to Rider from Saint Joseph's University in Philadelphia, Pa., where she served as an assistant coach for six years, the last two as the top assistant. Saint Joseph's earned a berth in the WNIT five times during her last six seasons.

At Saint Joseph's, Milligan was directly responsible for recruiting and guard play for a program that compiled 111 wins during her last six seasons with the team. Three of her last five recruiting classes were nationally ranked. She assisted with all aspects of the Hawks' program, including on-court instruction, scouting, game-plan preparation, academic support and fundraising.

Prior to joining Saint Joseph's, Milligan spent six years as the top assistant coach at Drexel University. In her final season, she helped guide Drexel to a 19-10 record overall and a 13-5 mark in the America East Conference, tying for second place and advancing to the semifinal round of the league tournament. Milligan arrived in Philadelphia following a one-year stint as an assistant coach at Central Connecticut State.

At Rider, Milligan earned a bachelor's degree in communication in 1992 and earned a master's degree in counseling in 1994. Also a three-year member of the Bronco softball team, Milligan collected more than 100 career hits in just three seasons and helped lead the team to the 1990 East Coast Conference Championship as the team's leading hitter and to the 1991 Eastern College Athletic Conference Championship.

The 1992 Rider basketball team was the most successful in 10 years when Milligan was a senior and went 9-3 in the East Coast Conference. In her two seasons as a Rider graduate assistant coach, the Broncos were a combined 35-20, including a 25-11 record in the Northeast Conference.

A native of Voorhees, N.J., Milligan is a member of Eastern High School's Athletic Hall of Fame. Milligan has a twin sister, Aileen, who played basketball at Loyola College in Maryland. Milligan is an active member of the Women's Basketball Coaches Association. She currently resides in Voorhees with her husband, Patrick.
