QU POWERS PAST PIONEERS

- The Ouinnipiac women's basketball team returned home for the first time since Feb. 1 in a big way as they defeated the Sacred Heart Pioneers 71-47 on Thursday evening.
- · With the win, the Bobcats clinched a 20win season, the 13th in Tricia Fabbri's career.
- · Gal Raviv led the scoring for the Bobcats, scoring 22 points on 60% (9-for-15) shooting from the floor. Raviv stuffed the stat sheet, earning eight rebounds, six

assists, and four steals.

- Anna Folev had another solid game. scoring 11 points while grabbing nine rebounds, which led the team.
- Grace LaBarge made an impact for the Bobcats off the bench as she scored 11 points on 56% shooting from the field.
- Sacred Heart started out hot with a 12-4 run at the halfway point of the opening quarter. Quinnipiac would respond with a 12-0 run to close out the first ten minutes. and take a 16-12 lead into the second quarter.
- With the Bobcats leading by twenty to open the fourth quarter, QU looked to improve on their lead.
- · Quinnipiac would not allow SHU to make a comeback, defeating them 71-47.

GAME NOTES

LAST TIME OUT

- The Quinnipiac women's basketball team returned home for the first time since Feb. 1 in a big way as they defeated the Sacred Heart Pioneers 71-47 on Thursday evening.
- With the win, the Bobcats clinched a 20-win season, the 13th in Tricia Fabbri's career.
- Gal Raviv led the scoring for the Bobcats, scoring 22 points on 60% (9-for-15) shooting from the floor. Raviv stuffed the stat sheet, earning eight rebounds, six assists, and four steals.
- The Bobcats would dominate the Pioneers, defeating them by a final score of 71-47.

SCOUTING THE GAELS

- Iona is led by head coach Angelika Szumilo, who holds a 21-33 record in her second season in New Rochelle.
- The Gaels will enter Saturday's matchup with a 10-14 overall record and an 8-6 mark in conference play, sitting in fifth in the MAAC.
- Iona is coming off a 65-60 win over the Rider Broncs on the road on Thursday, Feb. 13th. Ella Fajardo led the way for the Gaels, dropping 20 points in the win.
- The Gaels are being outscored by their opponents, 1485-1359 (-126) this season.
- As a team, the Gaels are averaging 56.6 points per game on 37.6% shooting from the floor and 31.2% from beyond the arc.
- Iona is holding teams to an average of 61.9 points per game and allowing their opponents to shoot 42.4% from the field.
- The Gaels average 31.9 rebounds per game with their opponents averaging 36.7 rebounds per game this season.
- Ella Fajardo is the leading scorer for lona this season, averaging 10.3 points per game in 24 games played.
- Fajardo is shooting 41.9% from the floor, 37.9% from three-point range, and 78.6% from the charity stripe.
- Iona currently sits in fifth in the conference with a 8-6 record in the MAAC.

DIV. I HISTORY VS. IONA

- Saturday's contest marks the 25th matchup between the two programs in their Division-I history.
- Quinnipiac is 15-9 against the Gaels and are 6-4 away from their home floor.
- The Bobcats have won three straight contests against Iona, dating back to Jan. 13, 2024.
- \bullet QU defeated the Gaels in their previous matchup this season, 66-58, on Jan. 11, 2025.
- Anna Foley dropped 21 points and grabbed 12 rebounds for a double-double in the win.

BOBCATS BY THE NUMBERS

- THREE (3) The Bobcats sit in third in the most recent World Exposure Report Mid-Major Poll.
- THREE (3) Gal Raviv is the third highest scoring first year in the NCAA with 17.3 points per game.
- TWELVE (12) Gal Raviv ranks 12th in the NCAA in minutes per game with 36.58.
- THIRTEEN (13) Jackie Grisdale ranks 13th in the NCAA in minutes per game with 36.42.
- NINETEEN (19) Quinnipiac is 19th in the NCAA with a winning percentage of 87.0.

- **TWENTY (20)** The Bobcats are currently ranked number 20 in the College Insider Mid-Major Top 25.
- TWENTY-ONE (21) QU sits 21st nationally in turnovers per game with an average of 12.4.
- TWENTY-FOUR (24) Head Coach Tricia Fabbri currently sits in 24th place among active Division I coaches with 536 career wins
- FIFTY-THREE (53) Quinnipiac is 53rd in Division I in three-point percentage (34.7%).

BOBCATS DOMINATE PURPLE EAGLES

- The Quinnipiac women's basketball team wrapped up their trip to Western New York with a 70-38 win over the Niagara Purple Eagles on Saturday.
- The 32-point victory marks the largest margin of victory over Niagara since the 2019 season.
- Karson Martin led the scoring for the Bobcats, scoring 19 points on 62% (8-13) shooting from the floor and 3-for-3 from three-point range.
- Anna Foley had herself a day on both ends of the floor, scoring ten points, dishing out eight assists, grabbing seven rebounds, and recording three steals and two blocks.
- Quinnipiac's lead stretched to ten early in the second quarter but held just a four-point lead at the media timeout. The Bobcats would finish the half on a 14-4 run and take a 33-19 lead into halftime.
- QU continued their run, closing out the third quarter with the 54-30 advantage.
- The Bobcats dominated the final quarter, doubling Niagara's scoring output in the frame.
- The Bobcats would defeat the Purple Eagles 70-38, their largest margin of victory over Niagara since 2019.

RAVIV, MARTIN LEAD QU PAST CANISIUS

- The Quinnipiac women's basketball team defeated the Canisius Golden Griffins, 56-41, on Thursday evening in Buffalo.
- Gal Raviv scored 19 points on 54% shooting from the floor to lead the team.
- Karson Martin was second on the team with 18 points on 50% shooting and knocked down two three-pointers.
- Both teams had difficulty shooting in the opening quarter, but the Bobcats emerged from the first ten minutes with a 15-11 lead.
- Quinnipiac came out strong in the second quarter, extending their lead to nine points and prompting Canisius to call a timeout.
- The Bobcats and Golden Griffins exchanged baskets for the rest of the quarter, with QU heading into halftime with a 35-26 advantage.
- The Bobcats generated three consecutive turnovers to start the second half and held a six-point lead at the media timeout.
- QU finished the third quarter with a 10-3 run, entering the final quarter with a 49-36 advantage.
- The Bobcats allowed just five points in the final frame to defeat the Canisius Golden Griffins 56-41.

GAME NOTES

QU COMPLETES SEASON SWEEP OF SIENA

- The Quinnipiac women's basketball team returned home on Saturday as they defeated the Siena Saints 77-74 in Hamden.
- Gal Raviv set a new career-high 32 points on 52.9% (9-17) shooting from the floor.
- Raviv stuffed the stat sheet, recording eight assists, seven rebounds, and one steal.
- Anna Foley and Grace LaBarge each reached double-digits, scoring 14 and 12, respectively.
- The Bobcats and Saints traded points early on in this matchup as the two teams were even at 14 points apiece after the opening ten minutes
- After QU took a 40-33 lead with eight seconds left in the half, Siena's Myriam Traore knocked down a half-court buzzer beater to make it a four-point game at the half.
- Siena tied the game up early in the third quarter, but the Bobcats responded as their lead stretched back up to eight at the end of the third quarter.
- Quinnipiac would not allow Siena within five for much of the final quarter, but the Saints made it close at the end.
- QU got a clean inbound to seal the 77-74 victory over the Saints.

RODE HOME WITH A WIN

- The Quinnipiac women's basketball team got back in the win column as they defeated the Rider Broncs 66-53 on Saturday afternoon in New Jersey.
- Gal Raviv had another 20+ point performance, scoring 21 points on 6-for-14 (42.8%) shooting from the floor.
- Anna Foley was second on the team with 13 points and grabbed a team-high seven rebounds.
- Jackie Grisdale reached 12 points in the win. Seven different Bobcats scored points in the 13-point victory over the Broncs.
- The Bobcats started on fire, shooting 50% in the opening quarter to open an 18-8 advantage after the first ten minutes.
- The Bobcats continued to dominate in the second quarter, outscoring the Broncs 18-5 to take a 36-13 lead into halftime.
- Quinnipiac's lead got as high as 23 before Rider cut it to 17 at the end of the third quarter. The Broncs outscored the Bobcats 19-13 in the third frame.
- Rider got within eleven with 1:26 left in the final frame, but Quinnipiac wouldn't let them get any closer. Quinnipiac was able to hit their free-throws down the stretch to defeat Rider by thirteen.

LEADER OF THE PACK

- Head coach Tricia Fabbri is in her 30th season at the helm of the Bobcats in 2024-25.
- A five-time Coach of the Year and all-time winningest coach in program history, Fabbri has totaled 535 career victories, thus far.
- With the win over Mount St. Mary's on Feb. 16, 2023, Fabbri became the 90th coach in Div. I women's basketball history to reach 500 career wins and the 22nd to accomplish the feat at one institution without coaching at another.
- Of her 536 wins, 521 have come in Quinnipiac's Div. I era.
- With 20 wins in 2022-23, Fabbri secured the program's 12th straight winning season under her guidance.
- Fabbri's Bobcats have reached the 20-win plateau in 12 seasons, including a run of eight straight seasons from 2011-2019.
- With five NCAA Tournament appearances along with five WNIT berths, Fabbri has led QU to 10 postseason national tournaments in

her tenure.

• She has led Quinnipiac to five conference titles in the last 11 seasons and earned five consecutive MAAC Regular Season titles from 2015-2019.

JUST WIN BABY, WIN!!

- M&T Bank Arena, home of the Quinnipiac Bobcats, has long been one of the most difficult arenas to play at in the country.
- Since the 2012-13 season, Quinnipiac owns a record of 142-34 (.807) in games played at home.
- In that same span, the Bobcats own a mark of 103-21 (.831) in conference play (NEC & MAAC) at home.
- Quinnipiac owns a 155-74 (.677) mark since November 22, 2017.
- The Bobcats stand with a mark of 93-21 (.816) at home in league games since joining the MAAC in 2013-14.
- The Bobcats are 86-18 (.827) at M&T Bank Arena in conference games since the start of the 2014-15 campaign.

CLOSING TIME

- Quinnipiac has enjoyed a great deal of success over the past five seasons when building a first-half lead.
- After starting 2016-17 with a mark of 2-0 when owning a halftime lead, the Bobcats saw one of their most impressive streaks in program history come to an end in a 71-68 loss at Temple.
- The undefeated streak, which lasted throughout three seasons, came to an end at 46 straight wins for the Bobcats when holding a halftime lead.
- Quinnipiac went undefeated in both 2014-15 (24-0) and 2015-16 (19-0) and for the first two games of 2016-17 before suffering the defeat.
- Overall, the Bobcats own a mark of 184-18 (.911) since the start of 2014-15 in games in which Quinnipiac leads at the half.

FIRST YEAR OF FOLEY

- Anna Foley did not disappoint in her first season in Hamden as she was named to the All-MAAC Second Team and All-MAAC Rookie Team last season.
- Foley was the only member of the team last season to start in all 31 games.
- She averaged 13.1 points, 7.1 rebounds, and 3.1 assists per game as a first-year.
- Foley led the team in total rebounds (220), rebounds per game (7.1), field goals made (160), and total points (406).
- Anna scored a season-high 28 points against Manhattan on 57.9% shooting (2/17).

MORE FROM MARTIN

- Karson Martin closed out her first season in a Bobcat uniform as she earned MAAC All-Rookie honors at the end of the regular season.
- · Martin appeared in 24 games, starting in 21 of those games.
- She averaged 11.9 points and 3.1 rebounds per game over 31.7 minutes per game.
- · Martin ranked third on the team with 25 made three-pointers.
- Martin scored a career-high 23 points against Canisius (1/18).
- The Woodstock, Georgia native recorded her first collegiate double-double with 11 points and 12 rebounds in the win against Marist (3/9).

GAME NOTES

LEADERSHIP GROUP

- Head Coach Tricia Fabbri announced seniors Jackie Grisdale and Grace LaBarge as team captains for the 2024-25 season.
- "We are thrilled to have these two young women be the bridge between coaches and players for this season," said head coach Tricia Fabbri.

BRAND NEW BOBCATS

 Quinnipiac Head Coach Tricia Fabbri built on her returning foundation, bringing in five newcomers, including a class of four rookies.

CP IS IN CT

- Caranda Perea comes to Quinnipiac after a season at the University of Tulsa.
- Perea averaged 2.2 points and 1.6 rebounds per game in 34 games last season.
- Prior to her time at the University of Tulsa, Perea spent two seasons at Temple (2021-23) and one season at George Washington (2020-21).
- The Altoona, PA native scored over 1,000 points in her high school career and was named to the First Team All-District and All-Region Teams as a junior and senior.

GOT OUR GAL

- Gal Raviv comes to Hamden after having played at Bella Vista College Prep in Arizona.
- Raviv represented Team Israel at the FIBA U18 Women's EuroBasket and led the team with 17.3 points and 4.7 assists per game.
- Raviv ranked fourth in the entire tournament in PPG (17.3) and ranked sixth in APG (4.7).
- The Kadima, Israel native represented her country at the U16 FIBA Euro Championship while she was only 14 years old.
- Named to the tournament's First 5 in the 2021 Girls U16 FIBA Euro Championship.

SHARPSHOOTING SIPLA

- Reagan Sipla arrived at Quinnipiac after having played four seasons at St. Charles North High School in Illinois.
- Sipla is the all-time leader in scoring for juniors in St. Charles North High School history.
- Sipla also holds the St. Charles North High School record for most three-pointers made in a single season by juniors.
- The St. Charles, Illinois native was a unanimous selection to the All-Conference team as a junior.

GO, GO GRACIE

- After a high school career at Waupun Area High School in Wisconsin, Gracie Gopalan has made her way to Hamden.
- Gopalan is a true guard who broke Waupun's season assists record as a sophomore.
- Gopalan is a two-time First Team All-Conference selection and a one-time Second Team All-Conference selection.
- The Waupun, Wisconsin native brings the championship pedigree to Hamden after being a three-time ECC Conference Champion.

THE MAINE DEFENDER

• The Saco, Maine native Emma Lizotte has made her way to

Quinnipiac after four years at Thornton Academy.

- Lizotte averaged 17.5 points, 10.3 rebounds, 3.0 blocks, 1.0 steals, and 1.0 assists per game in high school.
- Lizotte is a two-time First Team All-Conference selection and a one-time All-Defensive team selection.
- The 2022 Tournament MVP led her team to a 2022 State Championship at Thornton Academy.

CT IS HOME

- Head Coach Tricia Fabbri announced the addition of Cur'Tiera Haywood '23 to the coaching staff as an assistant coach ahead of the 2024-25 season.
- Haywood had a four-year career in Hamden as she earned multiple All-MAAC honors during her time as a Bobcat.
- Haywood was named to the All-MAAC Rookie Team after averaging 4.1 points per game in 18.6 minutes per game in her first season.
- In her senior season in Hamden, Haywood earned All-MAAC Third-Team Honors after averaging career highs of points (10.0 PPG), rebounds (5.2 RPG), and assists (1.2 APG) in 30 starts
- After a four-year stint in Hamden, Haywood transferred to Austin Peay in Clarksville, TN for her graduate season.
- CT started all 33 games for the Governors while averaging 8.2 points per game, 3.6 rebounds per game, and 1.0 assists per game.
- Haywood led the team in free-throw percentage (.794) and three-pointers made (38) while being one of two players to start every game.

- Quinnipiac women's basketball was tabbed tied for 3rd in the MAAC Preseason Coaches' Poll, as announced by the league office as part of the inaugural MAAC Basketball Tip-off held at Ocean Casino Resort in Atlantic City, NJ. on Tuesday, Oct. 8.
- The Bobcats received 132 points in the preseason coaches' poll finishing behind Fairfield (169) and Siena (136) and tying with Niagara.
- Quinnipiac sophomore Anna Foley was named to the All-MAAC Second team after averaging 13.1 PPG, 7.1 RPG, and 3.1 APG last season.
- Jackie Grisdale and Karson Martin were both named to the All-MAAC Third Team.

TRICIA FABBRI | HEAD COACH | 30TH SEASON | FAIRFIELD '91

The first full-time, female coach in school history, Tricia Fabbri enters her 30th year as the coach at Quinnipiac University. Fabbri was hired in 1995 after a three-year stint as an assistant coach at her alma mater, Fairfield University. As a player under Coach Dianne Nolan, the former Tricia Sacca won two MAAC championships, scored 1,622 points, grabbed 1,037 rebounds, and earned three First-Team All-Conference selections and an All-Team selection. She was twice selected to All-Conference teams, a feat later matched by her daughter, Carly, in 2017 and 2018 at Quinnipiac

The all-time winningest coach in Quinnipiac women's basketball history, Fabbri enters the 2024-25 campaign with 516 career wins, ranking 24th among active Division I head coaches.

Fabbri guided the program's transition from the Northeast 10 Conference in Division II to the Northeast Conference in Division I. In the 1998-99 season, Quinnipiac finished 9-18 and qualified for the conference playoffs. In 2000-2001 the team earned its first winning season in nine years, losing to LIU-Brooklyn in overtime in the conference semifinals; in the process, Fabbri was named the Coach of the Year.

In 2005-06, Fabbri led the Bobcats to its first 20-win season and an appearance in the NEC championship game despite featuring four freshmen, including Erin Kerner, the conference's Rookie of the Year. It lost a thriller to top seed Sacred Heart, 69-65. For her efforts, Fabbri was again named the NEC Coach of the Year. In 2007-08, Fabbri and Quinnipiac shared the regular season championship with Robert Morris. The Bobcats earned a berth in the Women's National Invitational, the first national postseason tournament appearance in Quinnipiac women's basketball Division I history. It lost to lona, 71-59. Brianna Rooney was tabbed the conference's Defensive Player of the Year. She would win the award the following year as well.

In 2011-12, the Bobcats advanced to the NEC semifinals. Quinnipiac was selected to the WNIT where it fell to Temple, 75-60. Felicia Barron was named the Northeast Conference's Defensive Player of the Year and to the All-NEC First Team after leading the nation in steals throughout the season. At the beginning of the year, Quinnipiac notched its most significant win in program history at the time, beating Minnesota, 64-62, in the opening round of the Saint Mary's (CA) Holiday Tournament, which it won the following night. During the 2012-2013 campaign - its last in the NEC - Quinnipiac defeated St. Francis (Pa.), 72-33, in Hamden for the conference championship, earning the school's inaugural trip to the NCAA Division 1 Tournament. The Bobcats fell to Maryland, 72-52. Fabbri led the Bobcats to the first 30-win season in both program and conference history. They were a perfect 18-0 in conference play. McQuain was named the tournament's Most Outstanding Player.

Throughout the season, the team was recognized in the College Insider Mid-Major Top 25 Poll for 15 consecutive weeks, as the Bobcats climbed as high as seventh in the census. The Bobcats also received votes in the National AP Polls for the first time in program history. Deservingly so, Fabbri was named the 2013 NEC Coach of the Year by her peers and also accepted the Sterling House "Spirit Award" at the annual celebrity breakfast in Stratford, Conn. Under Fabbri's tutelage, Felicia Barron earned her second consecutive NEC Defensive Player of the Year award and a trip to the NEC First Team; Brittany McQuain was named to the NEC Second Team; and Jasmine Martin was selected to the NEC Third Team.

Quinnipiac joined the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAAC) in 2013-14 and made an immediate impact in their new league as the Bobcats advanced all the way to the MAAC Championship game before finishing runners-up to Marist. Fabbri led the Bobcats to a 21-13 overall record in 2013-14 and 14-6 mark in their first season as a MAAC institution. As the No. 4 seed in the 2014 MAAC Tournament, Quinnipiac upended the No. 1 seed Iona Gaels in the Semifinal found to make it to a second straight conference championship game appearance. The season ended with the Bobcats' first at-large postseason tournament berth as Quinnipiac made it to the WNIT for the second time in three years, eventually falling short against Villanova. Under her tutelage, three players garnered All-Conference honors as Brittany McQuain and Jasmine Martin earned Second Team honors while Gillian Abshire made it on the All-MAAC Third Team. Maria Napolitano was awarded the Sixth Player of the Year.

Fabbri's transformative 2014-15 season redefined the record books at Quinnipiac as her squad went 31-4 (.886 win percentage) overall and 20-0 in conference play on their way to winning the 2015 MAAC Championship and earning a spot into the NCAA Tournament. Fabbri led the Bobcats to their most wins (31) in a single season in program history as well as their second 30-win campaign in the last three seasons. Quinnipiac became the first MAAC school in conference history (est. 1980) to finish 20-0 in conference play and just the sixth squad to go undefeated in league play. As the No. 1 seed in the 2015 MAAC Tournament, Quinnipiac upended Monmouth, Siena and ultimately the nine-time defending MAAC Champ Marist to claim their first MAAC Championship.Her record-breaking season earned Fabbri the MAAC Coach of the Year award on a unanimous vote by her peers. Throughout the season, Quinnipiac received unparalleled recognition in the national polls as Fabbri's squad earned four votes in the Associated Press (AP) Top 25 National Poll, totaled two votes in the USA Today Coaches' Poll, ranked No. 10 in the ESPNW Mid-Major Poll and were ranked No. 6 in the College Insider Mid-Major Poll. All four distinctions in the national voting polls were good enough for program records while the Bobcats' votes in the USA Today Coaches' Poll marked the first time the program had ever received recognition in that selective poll.

In 2014-15, Fabbri guided the tutelage of four All-MAAC performers including Samantha Guastella (First Team), Val Driscoll (Second Team), Gillian Abshire (Third Team) and Nikoline Ostergaard (Third Team). In the history of the MAAC, only two teams prior to the 2014-15 Bobcats had four players earn All-Conference laurels, excluding the inclusion of the All-Rookie Team. During the 2015-16 season, Quinnipiac won 17 straight conference games after an 0-3 conference start to win the MAAC regular season crown, despite losing all five starters from the previous year's team. After losing its top scorer in the conference semifinals, Quinnipiac fell to lona, 57-41, in the championship game. Fabbri again earned MAAC Coach of the Year honors. Aryn McClure was named the Rookie of the Year. The Bobcats rebounded in the first round of the WNIT by throttling Maine, 90-44, the program's first national postseason tournament win in Division 1.





TRICIA FABBRI | HEAD COACH | 30TH SEASON | FAIRFIELD '91

In 2016-17, Fabbri led the Bobcats on a thrilling ride to the Sweet 16, establishing one of the greatest single seasons by any program in school history. Behind the play of the Tournament's Most Outstanding Player Adily Martucci, the Bobcats beat Rider, 64-59, in the MAAC championship game.

Quinnipiac then became just the fourth No. 12 seed in NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Tournament history to advance to the Sweet 16. The Bobcats beat No. 25 Marquette, 68-65, in Miami to earn its first-ever NCAA Tournament victory. Two nights later, they upset No. 16 Miami, 85-78. The Cinderella story ended a week later when the Bobcats were done in by eventual NCAA Champion South Carolina 100-58 in Stockton, California. Quinnipiac, which finished 29-7, was voted No. 23 in the USA Today Coaches' Poll, its first-ever national ranking. In addition, Quinnipiac was voted the top mid-major program in the nation in the College Insider Mid-Major Poll, another first.

In the 2017-18 season, Fabbri led the Bobcats to a 28-6 record, an 18-0 mark in the MAAC, and a third MAAC title. They overcame Marist, 67-58, as Jen Fay was named the tournament's Most Outstanding Player. The No. 9 seed in the East Region, Quinnipiac beat Miami, 86-72, for a second consecutive year, before losing to No. 1 Connecticut in the second round. Fabbri was named the Coach of the Year for the third time.

The 2018-19 campaign featured Quinnipiac's eighth consecutive 20-win season. The 26-7 team posted its fourth undefeated season in MAAC play and won its third consecutive MAAC title and fourth overall when it thumped Marist, 81-51. Jen Fay was named the tournament's Most Outstanding Player for the second year. The Bobcats eventually fell to sixth-seeded South Dakota State, 76-65, at the Carrier Dome in Syracuse in the opening round of the NCAA Tournament. Fabbri won her fourth Coach of the Year honor.

During the 2020-21 season, Quinnipiac finished 13-8 and earned the second seed in the conference tournament. Mackenzie Dewees was named Quinnipiac's first MAAC Player of the Year and Mikala Morris was the third to be named Defensive Player of the Year.

In 2021-22, the Bobcats returned to the national postseason stage, advancing to the WNIT for the fifth time in program history. Quinnipiac finished with a 21-12 record - the program's 11th straight winning season - and defeated Rhode Island, to earn the program's fifth-ever win in a national postseason tournament and first since the 2018 season. The program earned WBCA Division I Academic Team honors, recording a 3.405 team GPA to rank 53rd of all Division I women's basketball programs.

Quinnipiac Women's Basketball enjoyed another impressive season in 2022-23, going 21-9 (16-4 MAAC) to earn a first-round bye in the league tournament. The Bobcats went 12-3 in Hamden and went on a 10-game unbeaten streak from Jan. 19 – Feb. 18 during MAAC play. The Bobcats saw three players earn All-MAAC honors, led by Mary Baskerville earning the title of 2022-23 MAAC Women's Basketball Sixth Player of the Year. Baskerville became the third player in program history to garner the distinction, joining former Bobcats Taylor Herd (2018-19) and Maria Napolitano (2014-15) to do so.

Senior Mikala Morris received All-MAAC status for the fourth consecutive season, earning a spot on the All-MAAC Second Team. Morris joined Aryn McClure as just the second player in the program's Div. I history to accomplish the feat of earning All-League status four times. Fellow senior Cur'Tiera Haywood earned Third Team All-MAAC honors, while first-year Ella O'Donnell was named to the MAAC All-Rookie Team after her first season with the Bobcats. Haywood earned All-MAAC Third Team honors after previously earning MAAC All-Rookie Team distinction as a first-year in 2019-20.

During her nine-year MAAC tenure, Fabbri and Quinnipiac have won four MAAC championships, three NCAA Tournament games, and two WNIT games. Quinnipiac has had a Player of the Year, a Defensive Player of the Year, a Rookie of the Year, and three Sixth Players of the Year. Quinnipiac has had 32 players selected to All-Conference teams, including seven first-team selections. She has been named conference Coach of the Year four times.

During her 15-year NEC tenure, Fabbri and Quinnipiac won one title. Fabbri coached one Player of the Year, one Rookie of the Year, two Defensive Players of the Year, and 28 All-Conference selections. Fabbri was named conference Coach of the Year three times.

Since joining NCAA Division I, Coach Fabbri has distinguished herself as a premier coach in the region. Fabbri and the Bobcats left the Northeast Conference in 2013 ranking second place all-time in career NEC regular-season wins (177) and overall NEC wins (187).

In 1998, Fabbri was inducted into the Fairfield University Athletic Hall of Fame. In 2002, she was also inducted into the Connecticut Women's Basketball Hall of Fame and the Delran (N.J.) High School Athletic Hall of Fame. In 2006, she was named to the MAAC 25th Anniversary Team. She was inducted into the Albert Carino Basketball Club of South Jersey Hall of Fame. That year, she also received the St. Clare Award at the 22nd Annual Franciscan Sports Banquet.

Fabbri served on the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Competition Committee from 2016-2018.

Fabbri and her husband, Paul, have three children: Carly, Armand, and Paul Henry.




