NOTABLE NOTES

SETTING THE SCENE

The Canisius women's basketball team takes on their last road game of the season with a crucial game at Iona. The Griffis, who won six of their ten games from the beginning of January to Feb. 11, are on a four-game losing skid entering the contest. They enter this game with an overall record of 7-20 to go with a 6-11 ledger in MAAC play. A win for Canisius and a loss by Rider will clinch a playoff birth for the Griffis.

LAST TIME OUT

Canisius stumbled in a loss to Manhattan on Thursday, falling 71-35 to the Jaspers. After keeping the scoring close in the first quarter, the Griffis went cold on offense, putting up 22 points in the final three quarters of play. Manhattan shot 52.3 percent from the floor in the final three quarters while turing the ball over only nine times giving them a 20-3 advantage on points off turnovers.

GRIFFS VS GAELS

Saturday's contest marks the 72nd meeting between Canisius and Iona, with the Gaels holding a 41-30 lead in the all-time series. On January 16, Canisius defeated the Gaels at home 66-63, after sophomore Shariah Gailes turned in a 16 point, five rebound performance to go along with 11 points from graduate student Jaela Johnson and 10 points from junior Mariam Sanogo.

WINNING WAYS

Since the start of the new year, Canisius has rebounded after a 1-10 non-conference record by going 6-10 in MAAC play, putting them in prime position for conference tournament bid. In their six conference wins, Johnson has led the scoring, averaging 15.7 points per game and shooting 50 percent from the floor. Sophomore Shariah Gailes is also averaging double-digits with 11.0 points per game along with 8.2 rebounds per game. Canisius as a team has out-rebounded their opponents by 13.5 rebounds in their conference wins while shooting 78.3 percent from the charity stripe.

SOPHOMORE SHARIAH GAILLES



Sophomore Shariah Gailles has recorded 16 games where her rebounding has match or outpaced her scoring including her game at Manhattan where she had six points and six rebounds.

WHAT IS A GRIFFIN?

The Griffin is a mythical creature of supposed gigantic size that has the head, forelegs and wings of an eagle and the hindquarters, tail and ears of a lion. They are well known for their speed, ability to fly and having eyes like an eagle as well as the strength and courage of a lion.

Griffins have been known for centuries as symbols of strength and vigilance, have been called "The Hounds of Zeus" in Greek mythology and are said to have mastery of both the land and sky.

They are thought to be from India, where the natives of the land made their talons and claws into drinking cups because the talon of a Griffin was said to detect poison in a liquid. Griffins would find gold in the mountains and line their nests with it and as a result, were forced to become great guardians of the nests to keep the hunters away.

VETERAN LEADERSHIP

Graduate student Jaela Johnson comes into this evening's game as the Griff's leading scorer with her 11.4 points per game scoring average. Johnson, who has played 128 career college basketball games, leads Canisius in six different statistical categories this season (scoring average, minutes per game, free-throw percentage, assists per game, steals per game and three-point percentage).

GAILES ON THE GLASS

Sophomore Shariah Gailles has proven to be one of the MAAC's top rebounders, as she enters tonight's game with 8.5 boards per contest, which leads the team and ranks third in the conference. She has been credited with five-or more rebounds in ten-straight games after she had 12 boards against Mount St. Mary's on Saturday. In her past 10 games, she is averaging 10.4 rebounds per outing.

YASMINE IN THE PAINT

In the previous three games freshman **Yasmine Djibril** has entered the starting lineup and has played consistently well in her rookie campaign. In her last 10 gamesm Djibril is averaging 6.5 points per game and 5.7 rebounds per game. Djibril had her two of her highest scoring nights recently, scoring a career-high 10 points at Merrimack and scoring 10 points in their win over Rider. She was awarded MAAC Rookie of the Week for her efforts with an eight point game versus Sacred Heart. Djibril recorded double-digit rebounds in back-to-back games with a 11 against Niagara and 10 at the Mount.

FANTASTIC FRANKA

Junior Franka Wittenberg is averaging 7.7 points per game, 4.0 rebounds and 2.2 assists in wins this season. At Rider, she led all scorers with 14 points and went 4-for-4 at the charity stripe. Wittenberg has also been effective at the free-throw line, shooting 78.4 percent on the season and 83.0 percent in league action. She bounced back from a cold stretch on Thursday against Marist with a 13 point, 7 rebound performance while taking the games to overtime with a clutch three-pointer.

X-FACTOR

The x-factor in Canisius' wins has been junior **Mariam Sanogo** with her rebounding ability and athletic defense. She leads the team with 15 blocks and is second on the team with 23 steals on the season. In Griffs' wins, Sanogo is averaging 6.8 points per game and 5.0 rebounds. She is also 21-for-24 from the free-throw line in conference play.

COPPLE FROM DEEP

Sophomore **Mary Copple** had one of the best shooting performances of her collegiate career against Niagara, going 4-for-8 from three for 12 points. One of the three returning players for the Griffs this season, Copple has worked her way into the starting line-up, shooting 33.3 percent from distance in MAAC play this season, while averaging 5.1 points per game. This season, the Brighton, Mich. native has already quadrupled her minutes played and doubled her scoring output from her freshman season. In her past four games, Copple is averaging 8.0 points per game and shooting 37.5 percent from three.

CHARITY STRIPE

Canisius' scoring has been bolstered by their ability to score at the free-throw line. In MAAC play, the Griffs are shooting third best in the MAAC 75.5 percent (219-for-290) and have six players who are over 75 percent percent from the stripe in conference play. Johnson has gone 57-for-61 from the line and junior Mariam Sanogo is 21-for-24. The Griffs' team shot a season-high 31 free-throw attempts in their most recent game against Siena.

MAAC ROUNDUP

The Griffs are holding team's to 30.8 rebounds per game, the second best mark in the league and have won the battle on the boards in 12 of their last 14 MAAC games. Manhattan leads the league in rebound per game with 37.7 while Canisius ranks third with 36.6.

MILESTONE WATCH

After last game at Manhattan, Johnson has accumulated 891 points in her career, leaving her 109 points shy of the 1000 point plateau.

A WIN WOULD....

A win on Saturday would give the Griffs their seventh conference win of the season and mark their eighth win overall. A win would also give head coach **Tiffany Swoffard** her seventh win MAAC win, eighth win overall and fourth home win of the season. A win clinches a playoff birth for the Griffs if Rider loses one of their last two games of the season.

LAST SEASON RESULTS

The 2023-24 women's basketball team had on of their best seasons in recent memory. The Griffis achieved a overall record of 17-14 and conference record of 11-9, granting them the fifth seed in the conference tournament. This was the first time the Griffis went above .500 in there overall and conference records since the 2008-2009 season under head coach Terry Zeh, when they went 24-9 overall and 14-4 in MAAC Play.

RETURNING PLAYERS

After the departure of previous head coach Sahar Nusseibeh, only three players returned to the Canisius roster from the 2023-24 season. Senior gaurd **Xanthippi Karatasious** is the longest tenured member of the Griffis, beginning her time in Buffalo in the 2021-22 season. Last season, Karatasious played in four games and was named to the MAAC All-Academic team. Sophomore gaurd **Mary Copple** also returned for her second season. In her freshman season, Copple appeared in 14 games and amassed a season-high five assists at Manhattan (Feb. 22). Finally, sophomore **Saige Randolph** returned to the Griffis after walking on to the team in her freshman season.

HEAD COACH - TIFFANY SWOFFARD



Tiffany Swoffard was named the 11th head coach in women's basketball program history on April 17, 2024.

A long-time assistant coach with 14 years of NCAA Division I coaching experience at both the Power 5 and mid-major levels, Swoffard takes over the Golden Griffin program after spending the 2023-24 campaign as a member of the Penn State women's basketball coaching staff.

In her one season on staff at Penn State, Swoffard helped lead the Nittany Lions to their first 20-win season since 2016-17, which resulted in a WBIT berth and an appearance in the tournament's semifinal round. Swoffard oversaw the development of the Penn State post players and served as the team's rebounding coordinator, as the Nittany Lions finished the year in the top half of the Big Ten in both rebounds per game and rebounding margin.

Before joining the staff at Penn State, Swoffard spent four seasons as an assistant coach at Miami (Ohio) in the Mid-American Conference (MAC). From 2019-23, six RedHawks earned All-MAC accolades, while 20 student-athletes earned All-MAC Academic honors. In addition to her role as recruiting coordinator, Swoffard was the team's offensive coordinator in 2022-23, where Miami (Ohio) ranked fourth in the MAC in league scoring average, as the RedHawks posted an average of 72.1 points per game against conference rivals.

Swoffard joined the RedHawks' staff after spending four years as an assistant coach at Toledo, where she played an integral role in all aspects of the program, including perimeter-player development, recruiting, academic support and opponent scouting. She served as Toledo's recruiting coordinator and worked with both the guards and post players.

During her time with the Rockets, Swoffard helped lead Toledo to an 81-49 overall record and a 43-29 mark in MAC play, including a pair of 20-win seasons in 2016-17 and 2018-19. Swoffard was in her second year as an assistant coach with the Rockets when the team won the MAC Tournament following the 2016-17 season. During her tenure, Toledo garnered 12 All-MAC selections, made an NCAA Tournament appearance and earned two WNIT berths.

Prior to Toledo, Swoffard spent five seasons at Mercer, where she handled recruiting, on-court development, academic support and in-office administration and worked with both the guards and post players. She mentored five all-conference athletes and 17 academic all-conference recipients. Swoffard helped lead Mercer to its first 20-win season in two decades in 2012-13, and its first appearance in a postseason tournament since 1985.

Before her stint at Mercer, Swoffard spent four seasons (2007-10) as an assistant coach at the University of Arkansas – Fort Smith. There, she was responsible for arranging team travel, updating game statistics, scouting opponents, organizing film exchange, ordering equipment, scheduling community service projects and assisting with scheduling. Swoffard also coordinated recruiting visits, identified possible recruits, facilitated camps and served as the program's recruiting coordinator. While on staff there, Arkansas – Fort Smith finished third at the 2008 NJCAA National Tournament and she also assisted with the program's transition to the NCAA Division II level.

Swoffard started her collegiate coaching career at NCAA Division III Rowan University in Glassboro, N.J., where she was a graduate assistant coach from 2005-07. Before that, she spent two seasons as the junior team head coach of the Georgia Metros Nike Elite AAU Basketball program.

A native of Chattanooga, Tenn., Swoffard was a four-year letterwinner at Austin Peay from 1998-2002, including two consecutive years in which the Lady Governors captured the Ohio Valley Conference Tournament championship and went on to play in the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Tournament (2000-01 and 2001-02).

An active member of the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA), Swoffard earned her bachelor's degree in business administration with an emphasis in marketing from Austin Peay in 2002. She went on to earn her master's degree in business administration from Rowan in 2007.
