Opening Tip

CofC, the preseason Coastal Athletic Association favorites, opened the 2025-26 campaign 2-0 inside TD Arena last week. Charleston began the season in historic fashion, setting a program record with 135 points in a 135-41 route over Covenant College on Monday. Then on Friday, CofC defeated Charleston Southern 80-65 in a cross-town matchup.

Charleston looks to remain perfect on the year, and inside TD Arena, with a matchup against Iona at 4 p.m. on Friday. Charleston and Iona have only met twice, with both teams earning a win on the opponents' home court.

The Cougars return two starters from last years WNIT Super 16 squad, including the reigning CAA Player of the Year in Taryn Barbot.

CofC returns six key contributors from last year's team, while adding seven newcomers, including three key transfers in Tyja Beans (Western Carolina), Grace Ezebilo (Tyler Junior College) and Chynell Mitchell (UTRGV).

The 2024-25 Charleston women's basketball team set a record for the most wins in the program's Division I era with 25. Charleston also earned its first Power 4 win since 2009 with a 68-62 victory over Northwestern at the Hawk Classic on December 20, 2024.

Notables

50TH ANNIVERSAY

The College of Charleston women's basketball team will celebrate the varsity program's 50th anniversary throughout the 2025-26 season. The January 25th home game against NC A&T will serve as the main celebratory night and commemorate the 50 years of the program's existence. The 1974-75 Charleston women's basketball team, which was the first-ever varsity squad, will be honored at the game.

All throughout the entire 2025-26 campaign, feature stories on past Cougar greats and influential players will be shared on the College of Charleston official athletics website at cofcsports.com.

CofC AMONG THE NCAA

The Cougars currently have three players in the top-10 in nation their respective categories. Taylor Barbot is the only player in the country to record a triple-double and is also second in the nation in assists per game (9.5). Grace Ezebilo is tied for 3rd in rebounds per game (14.5) and Taryn Barbot is 4th in points per game (27).

As a team, Charleston is in the top-10 in four categories. The Cougars are 2nd in rebounding margin (31.5), 5th in points per game (107.5), 6th in assist-to-turnover ratio (2.1) and 10th in scoring margin (54.5).

HOMECOMING/MILITARY APPRECIATION DAY

Friday's contest will be homecoming and military appreciation day.

CHARLESTON VS IONA

The Cougars are 1-1 all-time against the Gaels, with both teams earning road wins. Iona's victory came in a six-point game in 1998, while Charleston's win came in dominant fashion last year, winning 77-41.

SCOUTING THE GAELS

Coming off an 11-21 season, Iona is 2-0 this year, having earned wins against Mercy and New Haven. The Gaels are led by transfer and graduate guard Isabellah Middleton. On the young season, Middleton is averaging a double-double with 19 points per game and 10 boards per game. Naomi Barnwell, another graduate transfer, is also averaging double figures, having posted 28 points in her first two games. Iona was picked 6th in the 2025 MAAC Women's Basketball Preseason Coaches' Poll, while graduate guard Ella Fajardo was named to the Preseason All-MAAC Second Team.

LAST TIME OUT

Led by Taylor Barbot's triple double, the College of Charleston women's basketball team earned an 80-65 win over Charleston Southern (0-2) in a crosstown matchup at TD Arena Friday afternoon. Barbot's triple-double (14 points, 10 rebounds, 10 assists) was just the third triple-double in program history, and the first since Jada Logan accomplished the feat in 2022.

- The Cougars dominated the boards, winning the rebounding battle 55-32, including racking up 27 offensive rebounds.
- Charleston forced 14 turnovers and scored 21 points off Charleston Southern mistakes.
- CofC outscored CSU 15-6 on fast break points and 28-24 inside the paint.
- The Cougars got to the line 21 times compared to Charleston Southern's 10, and converted on 17 of their 21 free throws.

PRESEASON FAVS

Charleston was picked as the preseason Coastal Athletic Association favorites, receiving eight of the 13 first place votes. Taryn Barbot - the reigning CAA Player of the Year - was also picked as this year's Preseason CAA Player of the Year, while her twin sister Taylor Barbot was named to the Preseason All-CAA Second Team.

IN THE POLLS

The Cougars are ranked 19th in the most recent College Insider Mid-Major top 25 rankings.

MTE

Charleston will play in two MTEs this season. CofC will first compete at the Big Easy Classic in New Orleans during Feast Week, where Charleston will take on New Mexico State and High Point. The squad will then leave the United States for the first time in program history for the Puerto Rico Clasico in December. The Cougars will face off against Cleveland State and UPR Mayaguez in San Juan, Puerto Rico.

TWINTASTIC

CofC's roster consists of two sets of twins: the Barbots and the Philpotts.

BARBOT'S WORLD

Taryn Barbot returns for her junior year for the Cougars after a historic sophomore season. After earning the program's first CAA Rookie of the Year in 2023-24, Barbot came back and won the program's first CAA Player of the Year after the 2024-25 season. The Floral Park, N.Y. native amassed the 1,000 point mark on March 24, 2025 and became the first sophomore in program history and the fastest Charleston basketball player to do so (64 games).

Prior to the 2025-26 season, Barbot has garnered the CAA Preseason Player of the Year award and was just one of 25 athletes named to the Becky Hammon Mid-Major Player of the Year Watch List.


