The Black Bears, in the midst of a stretch of four out of five games away home their home court, open the Turkey Tipoff with a first ever meeting against UIC. Following Friday's opener, the Black Bears will take on either St. Francis or Iona on Saturday afternoon.

LAST TIME OUT:

PROVIDENCE, R.I. -- Asta Blauenfeldt led Maine with 10 points in the University of Maine women's basketball team's 70-39 loss at Brown on Sunday afternoon.

The Black Bears dug themselves into a hole early, trailing 21-2 after one quarter, and were unable to battle their way back.

Blauenfeldt finished the day 3-of-5 from the floor and a perfect 3-for-3 from the free throw stripe as she extended her double-figure scoring streak to 10. Sarah Talon and Adrianna Smith each added six points while Lizzy Gruber added five points, four rebounds, and a career-high four blocks.

Maine finished the game 15-of-57 (26.3) from the floor, including a 3-for-23 showing from three-point range, and were outrebounded 51-26.

A LOOK AT THE BLACK BEARS:

The Black Bears enter the weekend in search of their first road win of the season as they prepare for eight of their next 10 away from their home court. Adrianna Smith, who recently moved into 13th on Maine's all-time scoring list with 1,249 points, ranks second in the America East in scoring (18.0), rebounding (9.0), and assists (4.4); each of which are team-highs. who also ranks second in the America East with three double-doubles on the season, has posted double-figure scoring efforts in four of Maine's first five. Asta Blauenfeldt, riding a 10-game double-figure scoring streak, ranks in the top-10 among America East leaders in scoring (9th - 14.6), field goal percentage (8th-52.9), three-point field goal percentage (5th-43.8), and 3-point field goals per game (2nd-2.8). Blauenfeldt has hit four or more triples twice this season. Kaliyah Sain, who transferred to Maine from Kirkwood Community College, is adding 9.2 points while checking in 10th in the league at 6.0 rebounds per game. Sain's 2.0 triples per outing rank fifth best in the America East. As a unit, Maine ranks eighth in the conference in scoring at 60.8 points per game and eighth in scoring defense, allowing 66.6 per outing. Maine checks in second among league leaders in rebounding (36.0) and lead the league at 26.4 triples per game. The Black Bears have won the turnover battle in four of five outings and rank 15th in the country at just 11.8 giveaways per game.

A LOOK AT UIC:

After starting the season 1-3, UIC enters action riding a two-game win streak with recent victories over Loyola Chicago (68-54) and Ball State (66-64). The Flames average 62.0 points per game and rank third in the Missouri Valley Conference in scoring defense, allowing just 66.2 per game. Much like the Black Bears, UIC does a good job protecting the ball and enter play ranked 28th in the country and tops in the MVC with just 12.7 giveaways per game. Jessica Carrothers leads three double-figure scorers for the Flames as she is averaging a team-high 17.2 points to go along with a team-best 4.2 assists. Julia Coleman is adding 13.2 points and team-high 7.2 rebounds while Amelia Strong is chipping in 13.0 points and 6.0 boards.

SERIES HISTORY VS. THE FIELD:

Maine will be competing against UIC for the first time in program history. Should Maine meet Iona on day two, it would also mark the first meeting between the two teams. Maine is 1-0 against Saint Francis in a lone meeting which came in 1999.

SEASON BEAR TRACKS:

LIMITING THE MISTAKES:

Maine opened the season with single-digit turnover totals its first two games and check in 15th in the country with just 11.8 giveaways per game.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE MACHINE:

After setting the America East record for double-doubles in a single season with 22 in 2023-24, Adrianna Smith has began the season with double-doubles in three of Maine's first five outings. Smith has 41 career double-doubles.

BLAUENFELDT SEEING DOUBLE-FIGURES:

After closing the 2024-25 season riding a five-game double-figure scoring streak, Blauenfeldt has picked up right where she left off with double-digits in each of her first five outings. Blauenfeldt's double-digit scoring streak currently sits at 10 straight.

RARE AIR:

After tallying her 300th career assists in Maine's win over Stonehill, Adrianna Smith joined Liz Wood as the only players in program history to record 1,200 points, 700 rebounds, and 300 assists in a career.

PRESEASON ACCOLADES:

For the eighth consecutive season, the Black Bears have been picked to finish in the top-2 in the America East Preseason Coaches Poll. A year after finishing fourth, Maine has been slotted second in the poll. Adrianna Smith was named to the Preseason All-Conference Team.

ADI TRACKER

Redshirt Senior Adrianna Smith, who missed the 2024-25 season due to a knee injury suffered in the preseason, is on track to move up Maine's all-time leaderboard in multiple categories:

- 46 points away from moving into 13th on Maine's all-time scoring list (1,248)
- 33 rebounds from moving into 10th on Maine's all-time rebounding list (781)
- 25 total rebounds from 800 in her career
- 251 points from 1,500 in her career
- 244 rebounds from 1,000 in her career
- 98 assists away from 400 in her career
- 1 game from 100 played

POINTS PRODUCTION LOST:

Maine lost eight players to either graduation or transfer from last year's 2024-25 squad. With the departures, the Black Bears lost 73.9% of its point production from a year ago.

HOME/AWAY

Maine went 10-4 at home last year and 4-12 on the road.

BALL SECURITY:

Maine ranked first in the conference in distributing the ball and third in protecting it a year ago. The Black Bears led the America East with 14.8 assists per game and ranked second with a 1.05 assist/turnover ratio. On the flip-side, Maine was third in the conference with just 14.2 turnovers per game, including four, single digit turnover performances (8 at Rhode Island; 6 at Stonehill; 7 vs. Bates; 5 vs. NJIT). Maine posted a season-high 28 assists in a win over Bates.

HEAVY ON THE THREE:

Maine's offense was run heavily through the three-point shot last year. Maine's 8.2 triples per game ranked first among America East leaders, 32nd in the country, while it ranked tops in the conference with 24.7 shots from beyond the arc per game, 33rd nationally.

DEFENSE:

Maine has held 26 of its last 76 opponents to 50 points or fewer and 46 of the last 77 under 60 points. Maine held 11 of its 31 opponents to 55 or fewer points last season.

VACHON - WINNINGEST HEAD COACH IN PROGRAM HISTORY:

In her ninth full year as the helm of the Black Bears, head coach Amy Vachon is the longest-tenured coach in the America East. Vachon, a five-time America East Coach of the Year, has guided Maine to the America East title game in five of her first nine seasons. Vachon picked up her 100th career win with a victory over New Hampshire on Jan. 13, 2024, reaching the mark in just her 151st game at the helm of the program. She scored her 100th conference win on Feb. 24, 2024, becoming the sixth coach to reach the mark and second fastest to achieve the win total. Vachon's five Coach of the Year honors are the most in league and program history. On Feb. 27, 2025 with a win over UNH, Vachon surpassed her former head coach, Joanne Palombo-McCallie, with 168 career wins to become the all-time winningest coach in program history. Vachon now has 170 career victories.

LONG TIME NO THREE:

The Black Bears have made at least one three pointer in 417-straight games. The last time Maine did not cash in from 3-point range was Feb. 11, 2012 when it went 0-3 against UAlbany.

HOME SWEET HOME:

Over the past seven seasons, Maine has built a 75-30 overall record at home and a 70-10 record in league play. Maine is 22-1 in its last 23 home conference games.

GRAB THAT BOARD:

Maine has won the rebounding battle in 51 of its last 83 outings. Maine is 31-5 when winning the rebounding battle in league play in the past three seasons.

FACTOR OF 60:

Over the past nine seasons, Maine is 202-35 when holding its opponent to 60 or fewer points. The Black Bears are 144-25 in the Vachon era when limiting teams to 60 or less. Over the past 11 seasons against league competition, Maine is 133-17 when holding America East opponents to 60 points or fewer.

60 OR MORE:

On the flip-side, Maine is 193-37 over the past nine seasons when it scores 60 or more. In league play, Maine has a 127-10 record when scoring 60 or more points.

DECIDED AT THE HALF:

Maine is 112-16 when leading at halftime over the past five seasons and 139-22 when taking a lead into the half under Vachon.

FROM DOWNTOWN:

Over the last six years, Maine is 43-11 when it records double-digit 3-point makes in a single game.

MAINERS:

Over 40% of Maine's roster this season is made up of in-state talent with Streams (Veazie), Allen (Corinth), Gruber (Gardiner), Talon (Windham), Fitzpatrick (Cumberland), and Breen (South Thomaston) all hailing from the state of Maine.

Amy Vachon, currently in her ninth full season at the helm of the Black Bears and her 15th year on staff, has guided Maine to three NCAA Tournament appearances, three America East tournament titles, and five America East regular season championships during her tenure as head coach. Vachon has been named the league's coach of the year five times; more than any other head coach in the history of the America East conference.

On Feb. 27, 2025, with a 62-48 win over New Hampshire, Vachon registered her 168th head coaching victory to surpass her own former head coach Joanne Palombo-McCallie as the all-time winningest coach in UMaine women's basketball history. Vachon reached the record-setting mark in just 260 games.

Vachon, who spent the final 18 games of the 2016-17 season at the helm of the Black Bears' staff, was officially named the interim head coach for the 2017-18 season on April 5 of 2017.

A champion as a player and coach with the Black Bears, Vachon has built a culture of winning at the University of Maine. On the court and in the classroom, year after year, the Black Bears have excelled at all they've done under Coach Vachon's guidance.

Vachon guided Maine to its 10th America East title and 10th trip to the NCAA Tournament in 2023-24.

Another season, another trip to the America East title game under the guidance of Vachon in 2021-22 as she led Maine to an appearance in the title game for the seventh consecutive season after the Black Bears captured the America East regular season title. Vachon was crowned the America East Coach of the Year for the second consecutive season, and the fourth time in her first five years, to match former Maine head coach Joanne P. McCallie as the only coaches in league history to win the award four times. After a challenging non-conference slate, Vachon guided Maine to a 14-game win streak in conference action. Academically, the Black Bears shined once again with the third highest team GPA in all of Division-I.

Vachon guided the Black Bears through the challenging 2020-21 season, leading Maine to a 17-3 overall mark in the shortened COVID-19 season while earning her third America East Coach of the Year honor. The Black Bears earned their sixth-straight trip to the America East title game after entering the tournament as the number one seed with a 13-2 league mark. Even more impressive was the dedication and commitment to the classroom shown by the Black Bears as Maine earned the highest team cumulative grade point average (3.90) in all of Division-I.

In 2019-20, Vachon and the Black Bears again challenged themselves with a difficult non-conference slate. After suffering key injuries in the early part of the season, Vachon rallied the Black Bears to a return to the America East title game. Although the Black Bears were unable to compete in the Championship game due to COVID-19, Maine ended the season on a high note. Under Vachon's guidance, Maine ended the season riding the nation's eighth-longest win streak (10). The Black Bears capped the season with 12 league wins, marking the third-straight year under Vachon in which the team tallied 12 or more regular season league wins. After losing two starters to injury, Vachon played a key role in the development of several role players into key starting positions, including the development of All-Conference standouts Maevae Carroll and Dor Saar along with the on-court growth of America East Rookie of the Year, Anne Simon. The Black Bears not only finished strong on the court, but off it as well. Maine earned the No. 17 ranking, its highest ranking in school history, on the WBCA Top 25 Academic Honor Roll after compiling a 3.655 cumulative GPA.

Vachon followed up her first full season at the helm by earning her second-straight America East Coach of the Year honor, becoming just the sixth coach in America East history to win the award in back-to-back seasons. After guiding the Black Bears to their second consecutive America East Regular Season and Tournament Championships, Vachon's team earned the league's automatic bid into the NCAA Tournament for the second time in as many seasons. Maine's 25-8 record marked the fourth time in the last five seasons in which it topped the 20-win plateau and also tied for the third-most victories in a single season in UMaine history. The Black Bears were ranked in every edition of the College Insider Mid-Major Top-25 poll throughout the season, ending at No. 13. Maine, which put together a 14-game win streak under Vachon, led the America East in scoring (66.7) while setting new school and league records for 3-point field goals made in a season (273). The Black Bears challenged themselves early in the season, facing the 56th toughest schedule in the nation through their first 13 games, highlighted by an 85-73 victory on the road at North Carolina. Maine finished the season seeded 54th in the Ratings Performance Index (RPI). The Black Bears were dominant in league play, defeating eight conference opponents by 20 points or more with 13 of its 15 regular season league wins coming by double digits. Individually under Vachon's leadership and guidance, the Black Bears earned seven postseason honors including Blanca Millan who was named the America East Offensive and Defensive Player of the Year. All five starters on the 2018-19 team earned all-conference honors.

In her first full season as head coach of the Black Bears, Vachon earned America East Coach of the Year honors after leading Maine to a 23-10 overall mark. Under her guidance, the Black Bears were crowned with their first America East Tournament Championship since 2004, advancing to the NCAA Tournament for the eighth time in school history. Maine entered the America East Tournament as the No. 1 seed after completing a 16-point, come from behind victory over UAlbany in the regular season finale to clinch the regular season title.

The Black Bears ended the challenging campaign with the No. 70 RPI in the country. Maine continued to impress with its home court advantage, leading the America East in attendance for a fourth-straight season after going 12-2 on its home court. Vachon's offensive strategy guided the Black Bears to numerous shooting records including a Maine and America East single season high of 256 three-point field goals made.

Vachon, who took over head coaching duties after Coach Richard Barron stepped aside due to health complications, guided the Black Bears to an 11-7 mark during her time at the helm in 2016-17. Vachon led the Black Bears back to the America East title game, along the way knocking off No. 1 seeded New Hampshire in the America East semifinals.

Vachon also guided UMaine to key wins, including an 84-71 victory over eventual America East Champions UAlbany. Under her guidance, the Black Bears posted an impressive 7-1 record at home.

In addition to the impressive on court statistics under Vachon, the University of Maine Women's Basketball team has excelled in the classroom as well. The 2018-2019 team was first in the America East in with a 3.5 GPA for the season. This is the fourth out of five years in which UMaine women's basketball has been tops in America East. Also, 11 out of 13 players earned UMaine Scholar Athlete awards, each earning a 3.0+ grade point average.

Vachon was promoted to associate head coach in May of 2016. She spent the first six years of her tenure as an assistant before taking over as interim head coach in the winter of 2017. Following the 2011-12 season, Vachon was also promoted to Recruiting Coordinator; a role she served until being named Interim Head Coach in 2017. Vachon was inducted into the Maine Sports Hall of Fame in the spring of 2016.

Former University of Maine women's basketball head coach Richard Barron named Vachon as an assistant coach on May 16, 2011. Vachon, a 2000 graduate of the University of Maine, had a fantastic four-year career as a student-athlete with the Black Bears.

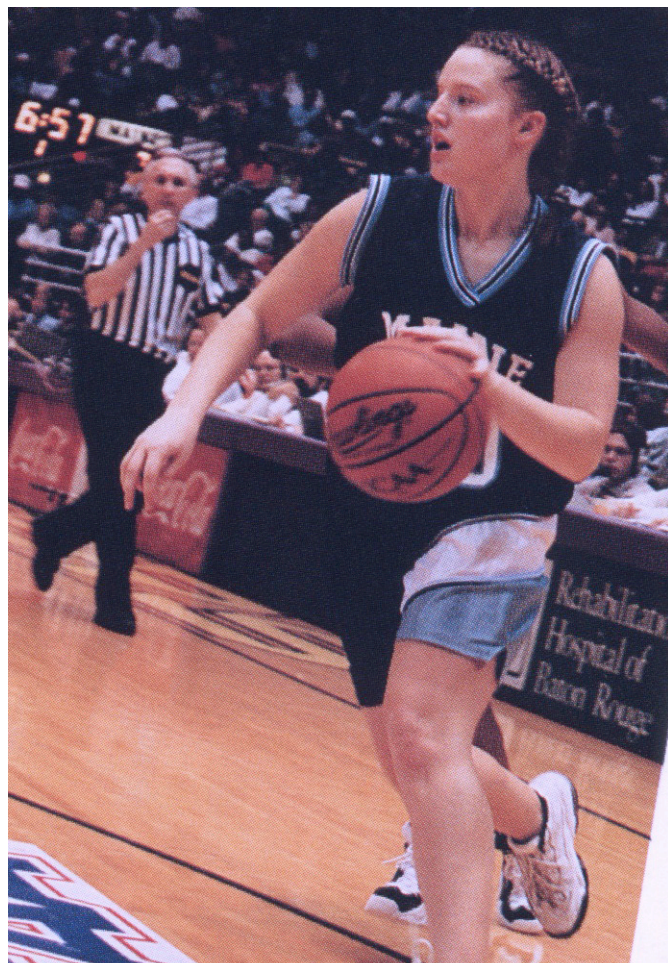
A two-time captain, Vachon led the Black Bears to four-straight NCAA Tournament appearances and was a member of the squad that knocked off Stanford in the first round of the 1999 NCAA Tournament. Maine compiled a four-year record of 87-35 with Vachon on the team, including an impressive record of 61-11 in conference play. She was part of a Maine team that won back-to-back America East Championships in 1996-97 and 1997-98.

Vachon, who was inducted into the UMaine Sports Hall of Fame in 2018, holds Maine records for the most assists in a season (234). She also holds the Maine and America East record for assists in a career with 759. When hired in 2011, she ranked 22nd all-time in NCAA history in career assists. Vachon earned a spot on the America East All-Tournament Team in 1999.

Prior to joining the University of Maine women's basketball staff, Vachon was the head coach at Catherine McAuley High School, located in Portland, Maine. Vachon coached McAuley to the 2011 Maine Class A State Championship. student-athletes, as she also excelled in the classroom. She graduated Magna Cum Laude in 2000 with a degree in elementary education. In 2002, she earned her Master's of Education from the University of North Carolina, Chapel Hill in school counseling. While an undergraduate, she was named: All-Maine Women Honor Society, Dean's List, America East All-Conference Academic Honor Roll, Maine Scholar-Athlete Award winner and also served on the Student-Athlete Advisory Board.

Vachon, a 2021 Maine Basketball Hall of Fame inductee, knows the demands of a Division I student-athletes, as she also excelled in the classroom. She graduated Magna Cum Laude in 2000 with a degree in elementary education. In 2002, she earned her Master's of Education from the University of North

Carolina, Chapel Hill in school counseling. While an undergraduate, she was named: All-Maine Women Honor Society, Dean's List, America East All-Conference Academic Honor Roll, Maine Scholar-Athlete Award winner and also served on the Student-Athlete Advisory Board.

Courtney (Anderson) England, who began her appointment as an assistant coach at UMaine on July 1, 2017, is in her sixth year on staff with the Black Bears. England was promoted to Associate Head Coach on July 1, 2021.

England, who spent four years as a student-athlete on the University of Maine women's basketball team, returned to her alma mater following a year stint (2016-17) as an assistant coach at Presbyterian University.

Prior to her time at Presbyterian, England spent the 2015-16 season as the Director of Basketball Operations at the University of New Hampshire before stepping into an acting assistant coaching role with the Wildcats.

During her playing time at UMaine, England devoted numerous hours to working camps where she helped develop and mentor local camp attendees. In 2015, England was selected to take part in the Women's Basketball Coaches Association' "So You Want to be a Coach" program.

As a student-athlete with the Black Bears, England appeared in 114 games with 60 starts while scoring 315 points and adding 266 rebounds and 226 assists.

Prior to joining the UMaine staff, Biskup spent five seasons as an assistant coach at Roanoke College and Southern Maine Community College. Biskup spent the 2014-17 seasons at Division III Roanoke where he assisted in multiple duties including coaching, recruiting, practice planning, film breakdown, monitoring of academic progress and the overall coordination of the program's day-to-day events.

In his two seasons at Southern Maine Community College, Biskup was involved in the recruiting process in Maine and New Hampshire as well for the overall skill development of the perimeter players.

In addition to his coaching roles, Biskup has participated and run numerous camps during his time at UMaine, Roanoke and served as co-director of the Hoop Magic Basketball Clinic in South Portland, Maine.

Biskup earned his Bachelor of Science in Elementary Education from UMaine in 2012.

Tanesha Sutton ('18) joined the Maine coaching staff as an assistant coach in July of 2024.

Sutton returned to UMaine where she played guard for the Black Bears for three seasons after sitting out the 2015-16 following transferring to Orono from Duquesne.

While at UMaine, Sutton, a two-time America East all-conference honoree, averaged 11.2 points, 6.3 rebounds and 2.7 assists in 98 games for the Black Bears. During her senior season, Sutton became the 21st Black Bear in history to record 1,000 career points. Sutton, a multi-year captain of the Black Bears, currently ranks 21st on Maine's all-time scoring list (1,124) and 20th in all-time assists (268). Sutton guided Maine to America East titles and NCAA appearances in back-to-back seasons (2017-18, 2018-19).

Following her playing time at UMaine, Sutton played three seasons professionally overseas. Sutton began her professional career with the Norrköping Dolphins (2019-20) of the Swedish Basketball League. In 2022-23, Sutton was named to the All-Romanian Second Team as she led Napoca Cluj in scoring. Sutton closed out her professional career by playing one season (2023-24) with Barcelos (Portugal).

Sutton started her coaching career as an assistant coach at the Community College of Philadelphia in 2020 and served four seasons as a coach with Hunting Park AAU. In 2019, Sutton co-founded the Different Mindset Annual Youth Basketball Camp and also spent parts of the 2022 and 2023 seasons as a youth coach at the Elite Sports Factory.

Matt Peyton was hired as assistant strength and conditioning coach and director of operations for the women's basketball team in August of 2018.

Peyton spent a portion of the 2017-18 season at UMaine where he served as an assistant sports performance coach, assisting specifically with the women's basketball, baseball and track & field programs.

After his time with UMaine wrapped up, Peyton honed his craft by joining the Rome Braves, a minor league affiliate of the Atlanta Braves, in April of 2017. While with the Braves, Peyton oversaw the implementation of the strength and conditioning program along with oversight of team nutrition.

Peyton began his strength and conditioning career by serving two years as the head strength and conditioning intern at the University of Nebraska Omaha. Following his time with Nebraska Omaha, Peyton joined Creighton University for a five-month internship before accepting a position as an assistant sports performance coach at UMaine.

Peyton was the strength and conditioning coach for the 2017-18 America East champion Black Bears' women's basketball team.
