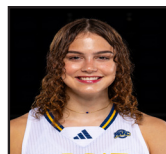

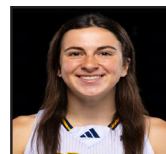

BOBCATS DOMINATE PEACOCKS, 67-27

- The Quinnipiac Bobcats closed out 2025 with a 67-27 win over the Saint Peter's Peacocks on Monday evening in Jersey City, improving to 3-0 in MAAC Play.
- The Bobcats set a new school record for the fewest points allowed in the Division I era, allowing just 27 in the win.
- Ella O'Donnell led the way with 12 points on 5-for-6 (83.8%) shooting from the floor.
- O'Donnell grabbed four rebounds on the defensive end and three on the offensive end for seven total rebounds.
- Karson Martin scored 10 points in the win. Eight Bobcats recorded 5 or more points as they stay unbeaten in MAAC play.
- Nine different Bobcats recorded points in the forty-point win over the Peacocks.

NEWS & NOTES

SCOUTING THE GAELS

- The Iona Gaels are led by head coach Angelika Szumilo, who holds a 30-45 record in her third season as the head coach at Iona. Szumilo holds a 102-90 overall record in her seven seasons as a head coach (4 at FDU, 3 at Iona).
- The Gaels hold an 8-5 record, defeating Mercy, New Haven, Wagner, Saint Francis, UIC, UMass Lowell, Navy, and Rider, while falling to Charleston, Davidson, Dartmouth, Sacred Heart (OT), and Mount St. Mary's.
- The last time out, Iona earned their first MAAC win of the season, defeating the Rider Broncs (Dec. 29), 72-53, on their home floor. Isabellah Middleton led the Gaels in scoring, dropping 14 points on 6-for-9 (66.7%) shooting from the field. Mya Zaccagnini and Zoey Ward each scored ten points in the win over Rider. Iona shot 42.2% (27-64) from the field, 45.8% (11-24) from three-point range, and 70% (7-10) at the free-throw line to earn their first conference win of the season.
- The Gaels average 58.4 points per game, while holding their opponents to average just 58.0 points per game this year.
- Iona is outscoring their opponents 759-754 (+5) this season and has a scoring margin of 0.4.
- As a team, Iona is averaging 58.4 points per game, while shooting 34.2% (280-818) from the field, 27.0% (71-263) from three-point range, and 69.6% (128-184) from the free-throw line.
- The Gaels are allowing their opponents to an average of just 58.0 points per game so far this season, which ranks second in the MAAC and 67th in the nation.
- Iona averages 38.8 rebounds per game and allows their opponents to average 39.7 rebounds per game.
- Iona averages 12.8 turnovers per game and forces 16.1 turnovers per game from its opponents.
- Isabellah Middleton leads Iona in scoring with an average of 13.5 points per game in 13 games so far this season.
- Middleton has started all 13 games this season and shoots 40.7% (68-167) from the field, 33.3% (10-for-30) from three-point range, and 61.2% (30-for-49) from the charity stripe.
- Iona is 3-3 on the road this season and average 56.3 points per game in those contests.
- Iona (100 points) was picked to finish sixth in the Preseason MAAC Coaches' Poll.
- Iona's current NET Ranking is 267 (as of Wed, Dec. 31).

DIV. I HISTORY VS. IONA

- Thursday's matchup marks the 27th time the Bobcats and Gaels are facing off.
- Quinnipiac is 17-9 against Iona, dating back to March 19th, 2008.
- Last time the two teams faced off, the Bobcats defeated the Gaels, 79-51 in the MAAC Quarterfinals, back on March 12th, 2025.
- Quinnipiac was led by Gal Raviv, who scored 23 points on 11-for-16 (69%) shooting from the floor. Ella O'Donnell and Karson Martin reached double figures, scoring 12 and 11, respectively. Martin led the Bobcats with 7 rebounds in 35 minutes of action.
- The Bobcats are 224-79 (.739) all-time against current MAAC members.

BOBCATS BY THE NUMBERS (As of Dec. 31st)

- 1 (First): Quinnipiac is first in the MAAC with a 14.4 scoring margin.
- 1 (First): Jackie Grisdale ranks first in the MAAC in three pointers (36) and three pointers per game (3.00).
- 1 (First): The Bobcats currently rank first in the conference by

allowing just 52.9 points per game.

- 2 (Two): The Bobcats have two of the top three-point shooters in the MAAC in Jackie Grisdale and Ella Ryan. Both rank in the top six in the MAAC in three-pointers and three-pointers per game.
- 3 (Third): Jackie Grisdale is third in the MAAC in minutes played this season with an average of 34.74 minutes per game.
- 3 (Third): Ella Ryan ranks third among first-years in the conference in scoring with an average of 11.7 points per game and 140 total points.
- 3 (Third): Paige Girardi ranks 3rd in the nation with a 4.63 assist/turnover ratio, which also ranks 1st in the MAAC.
- 4 (Fourth): Paige Girardi ranks fourth in the conference with an average of 3.1 assists per game.
- 5 (Fifth): Jackie Grisdale ranks 5th in the conference, averaging 14.7 points per game.
- 9 (Ninth): The Bobcats rank 9th in the country with an average of 10.8 turnovers per game, which also leads the MAAC.
- 9 (Ninth): Sydney Ryan ranks 9th in the MAAC with 6.8 rebounds per game.
- 13 (Thirteenth): Quinnipiac is currently 13th in the nation with a 1.53 assist/turnover ratio, which also ranks first in the conference.
- 13 (Thirteenth): Quinnipiac is currently 13th in the country, allowing just 52.9 points per game.
- 15 (Fifteenth): The Bobcats rank 15th in the country in three-point percentage (38.2), which ranks second in the MAAC.
- 15 (Fifteen): Sydney Ryan sits 15 points away from reaching the 1,000-point mark in her collegiate career.
- 18 (Eighteenth): Jackie Grisdale became the 18th Bobcat in their Division I history to join the 1,000-point Club on Wednesday at Boston College.
- 20 (Twenty): The Bobcats have won six games by 20+ points (Yale, Colgate, Boston College, Cornell, Manhattan, and Saint Peter's).
- 27 (Twenty-Seven): The Bobcats held the Peacocks to just 27 points, setting a new Division I team record for fewest points allowed in a single game.
- 28 (Twenty-Eighth): Grisdale is the 28th Bobcat in program history to reach the 1,000-Point mark.

BOBCATS IMPROVE TO 2-0 IN MAAC PLAY

- The Quinnipiac women's basketball team improved to 2-0 in conference play with a 76-67 win over the Marist Red Foxes on Sunday evening in Poughkeepsie, New York.
- Sydney Ryan led the Bobcats in scoring with 19 points on 55.6% (5-9) shooting from the field and knocked down four threes in seven attempts.
- Ella O'Donnell added 16 points on 66.7% shooting from the floor. O'Donnell grabbed 5 rebounds and dished out 5 assists.
- Jackie Grisdale scored 14 points in the win and went 6-6 from the free-throw line.
- The Bobcats started on a 25-3 scoring run and never looked back, leading for 99.2% of the game.

FOLEY LEADS QU TO BIG WIN IN MAAC OPENER

- The Quinnipiac women's basketball team opened conference play with a 78-39 win over the Manhattan Jaspers on Friday morning in Hamden on Kids Day.
- Anna Foley led the Bobcats with 18 points on 70% (7-for-10) shooting from the floor in the MAAC opener against Manhattan. Foley also grabbed a team-high eight rebounds,

dished out four assists, recorded three blocks, and one steal in the win.

- Jackie Grisdale also reached double figures, scoring 12 points in the effort.
- Quinnipiac recorded 25 assists as a team on 28 made field goals.
- The Bobcats forced 22 turnovers and scored 27 points off those turnovers.

BOBCATS FALL TO MAINE AT HOME

- The Quinnipiac women's basketball team was defeated by the Maine Black Bears, 63-55, on Sunday, December 14th, in Hamden.
- Ella Ryan led the way in scoring for the Bobcats, scoring 17 points on 70% (7-for-10) shooting from the floor and 3-for-4 (75%) from three-point range.
- Ella O'Donnell reached double figures, scoring eleven points in the loss.
- Sydney Ryan and Anna Foley led the team with eight rebounds each.
- Ella O'Donnell and Paige Girardi dished out a team-high four assists.
- Quinnipiac led the Black Bears at the half, 30-23, but was outscored 40-25 in the second half to drop their final non-conference game of the regular season.

GRISDALE, O'DONNELL LEAD QU PAST CORNELL

- For the fourth time this season, the Bobcats defeated their opponent by 20+ points as they dominated the Cornell Big Red, 68-47.
- Jackie Grisdale led the Bobcats in scoring with 25 points on 64.3% shooting.
- Jackie Grisdale tied the QU Division I Single Game Record with seven made threes in the win.
- Ella O'Donnell had a big day as she set a new season-high with 19 points.
- Sydney Ryan reached double figures for the fifth time this season, scoring 11.
- Quinnipiac scored the first bucket of the game and never looked back as they extended the win streak to three.

GRISDALE SCORES 1,000TH POINT IN BIG WIN OVER BC

- The Quinnipiac women's basketball team returned from Thanksgiving Break and defeated the Boston College Eagles, 76-49, on Wednesday afternoon.
- Sydney Ryan led the Bobcats in scoring with 18 points on 54.5% shooting.
- Jackie Grisdale added 17 points and became the 28th member of the 1,000-Point Club in program history.
- Ella Ryan reached double figures for the fifth time this season (11 points).
- Anna Foley recorded her second straight double-double, recording 10 points and 13 rebounds in the win.
- As a team, the Bobcats recorded 26 assists on 30 made field goals, the most assists they have recorded in a single game since Feb. 17, 2021, against Siena (26).
- The win was Quinnipiac's first-ever win against Boston College.
- This was the Bobcats' first win over an ACC team since March 17, 2018 (86-72 win over Miami) and fourth-ever win against current ACC teams in program history.
- Quinnipiac defeated Boston College by 27, which gives them back-to-back 27-point wins, which is tied for their largest margin

of victory this season.

QUINNIPIAC HANDS COLGATE FIRST LOSS OF SEASON

- The Quinnipiac women's basketball team handed the Colgate Raiders their first loss of the season, defeating them 77-50 on Sunday, November 23rd.
- Jackie Grisdale led the Bobcats in scoring with 19 points on 58.3% (7-for-12) shooting from the floor.
- Ella Ryan knocked down four threes in the win as she scored 18 points.
- Anna Foley stuffed the stat sheet, recording 15 points, 10 rebounds, and six assists off the bench. Foley recorded 10+ points, 5+ rebounds, and 5+ assists for the ninth time as a Bobcat.
- Quinnipiac controlled play much of the game, leading for 34:38 of the game.

QUINNIPIAC'S COMEBACK FALLS SHORT AGAINST CHARLESTON

- The Quinnipiac women's basketball team fell in a hard-fought battle, 75-71, to the College of Charleston on Friday night in Hamden.
- Ella Ryan had a career night, dropping 22 points and shot 6-for-8 from beyond the three-point arc.
- Sydney Ryan finished with 14 points, recording double-figures for the second straight game.
- Ella O'Donnell and Jackie Grisdale both reached double-digits in points, scoring 13 and 12, respectively.
- Quinnipiac trailed by nine at the halftime break and outscored the Cougars 43-38 in the second half but fell just short.

BOBCATS DEFEAT YALE BY 23

- The Quinnipiac women's basketball team defeated the Yale Bulldogs, 69-46, on Tuesday night in New Haven.
- Ella O'Donnell led the Bobcats with 14 points on 42.9% (6-for-14) shooting from the floor and finished one rebound shy of a double-double.
- Sydney Ryan recorded her first double-double as a Bobcat, recording 13 points and 13 rebounds in the win.
- Ella Ryan (11 points), Jackie Grisdale (11 points), and Paige Girardi (10 points) each reached double figures.
- The Bobcats jumped out to an early lead in the opening quarter and never looked back as they led for 38:58 (97.4%) of the game.

BOBCATS DROP HOME OPENER TO ST. JOHN'S

- The Quinnipiac women's basketball team dropped their home opener to the St. John's Red Storm, 53-51, on Tuesday night in Hamden.
- Ella O'Donnell led the Bobcats in scoring with 16 points on 53.8% (7-for-13) shooting from the floor.
- O'Donnell also grabbed a team-high seven rebounds in the loss.
- Jackie Grisdale scored 15 points in the loss as she recorded 15+ points in all three games so far this season.
- The Bobcats led at the half by two and had their lead get up to nine in the fourth quarter before St. John's closed out the game on a 20-9 run to beat the Bobcats.

BOBCATS FALL TO RUTGERS

- The Quinnipiac women's basketball team dropped their non-conference game to Rutgers on Thursday, Nov. 6, 64-55.
- Jackie Grisdale led the Bobcats with 19 points on 7-for-13 (53.8%) from the field and knocked down four three-pointers on seven attempts.
- Ella Ryan got the first start of her collegiate career and dropped 14 points in the effort.
- Ella O'Donnell racked up seven points, five rebounds, and five assists. Her five assists are a single-game high.
- Emma Lizotte and Ella O'Donnell tied for the team lead with five rebounds each.
- Quinnipiac shot 9-for-24 (37.5%) from beyond the three-point arc in the loss to Rutgers.

SEASON OPENING WIN OVER BU

- The Quinnipiac women's basketball team won their season opener for the third straight season, defeating Boston University 65-55 on Monday night.
- Jackie Grisdale led the Bobcats with 17 points in the win. Grisdale shot 50% from the floor and 37.5% from three-point range.
- Karson Martin (14 points), Sydney Ryan (12 points), and Anna Foley (10 points) all reached double figures.
- Ella Ryan added eight points off the bench in the first regular-season game of her collegiate career.
- The Bobcats went 10-for-10 from the charity stripe in the win. Quinnipiac iced the game at the line, going 4-for-4 down the stretch.

PRESEASON NEWS

- The Quinnipiac women's basketball team was picked to finish 2nd in the MAAC Preseason Coaches' Poll.
- Quinnipiac received 155 total points, finishing behind only Fairfield, who were unanimously selected to finish first in the conference.
- Anna Foley was named to the Preseason All-MAAC First Team after averaging 10.9 PPG and 5.4 RPG last year in Hamden.
- Jackie Grisdale was also named to the Preseason All-MAAC First Team after averaging 10.8 points per game last year.
- Junior guard Karson Martin was selected to the Preseason All-MAAC Second Team after averaging 9.8 points and 3.1 rebounds per game in 33 contests last year.

LEADER OF THE PACK

- Head coach Tricia Fabbri is in her 31st season at the helm of the Bobcats in 2025-26.
- A six-time Coach of the Year and all-time winningest coach in program history, Fabbri has totaled 552 career victories, thus far.
- With the win over Mount St. Mary's on Feb. 16, 2023, Fabbri became the 90th coach in Div. I women's basketball history to reach 500 career wins and the 22nd to accomplish the feat at one institution without coaching at another.
- Of her 552 wins, 537 have come in Quinnipiac's Div. I era.
- In 2024-25, Fabbri led the Bobcats to 28 wins and their first WBIT Appearance.
- With 20 wins in 2022-23, Fabbri secured the program's 12th straight winning season under her guidance.
- Fabbri's Bobcats have reached the 20-win plateau in 13 seasons, including a run of eight straight seasons from 2011-2019.
- With five NCAA Tournament appearances along with five WNIT berths, Fabbri has led QU to 11 postseason national tournaments in her tenure.

- She has led Quinnipiac to five conference titles in the last 12 seasons and earned five consecutive MAAC Regular Season titles from 2015-2019.

JUST WIN BABY, WIN!!

- M&T Bank Arena, home of the Quinnipiac Bobcats, has long been one of the most difficult arenas to play at in the country.
- Since the 2012-13 season, Quinnipiac owns a record of 147-37 (.799) in games played at home.
- In that same span, the Bobcats own a mark of 107-21 (.836) in conference play (NEC & MAAC) at home.
- Quinnipiac owns a 171-79 (.684) mark since November 22, 2017.
- The Bobcats stand with a mark of 97-21 (.822) at home in league games since joining the MAAC in 2013-14.
- The Bobcats are 90-18 (.833) at M&T Bank Arena in conference games since the start of the 2014-15 campaign.

CLOSING TIME

- Quinnipiac has enjoyed a great deal of success over the past five seasons when building a first-half lead.
- After starting 2016-17 with a mark of 2-0 when owning a halftime lead, the Bobcats saw one of their most impressive streaks in program history come to an end in a 71-68 loss at Temple.
- The undefeated streak, which lasted throughout three seasons, came to an end at 46 straight wins for the Bobcats when holding a halftime lead.
- Quinnipiac went undefeated in both 2014-15 (24-0) and 2015-16 (19-0) and for the first two games of 2016-17 before suffering the defeat.
- Overall, the Bobcats own a mark of 199-21 (.905) since the start of 2014-15 in games in which Quinnipiac leads at the half.
- This season, the Bobcats hold an 8-3 record in games in which they lead at the half and 0-1 in games in which they trail at the half.

LEADERSHIP GROUP

- Head Coach Tricia Fabbri announced the leadership group ahead of the 2025-26 season.
- Graduate student Jackie Grisdale, senior Ella O'Donnell, and junior Anna Foley were named team captains.

BRAND NEW BOBCATS

- Quinnipiac Head Coach Tricia Fabbri built on her returning foundation, bringing in three newcomers, including a class of two first-year students.

SYDNEY RYAN TRANSFERS TO QU

- Sydney Ryan joins the Bobcats after three seasons at Furman University.
- Ryan finished last season with the third-highest three-point percentage on the team, 32.0% (62-for-194).
- The Nashville, TN native played a large portion of minutes for Furman, as she averaged 31.8 minutes per game in her junior season.
- Ryan comes to the Bobcats and brings scoring and rebounding, ranking within the top five on her squad in both categories.
- Sydney Ryan comes to Quinnipiac and reunites with her younger sister, Ella Ryan.

ELLA RYAN COMES TO CT

- Ella Ryan comes to Quinnipiac from Brentwood High School

in Nashville, Tennessee.

- Ryan holds the record at Brentwood for the Most Career Points (2,321), Most Career Rebounds (600), Most Career Three-Pointers Made (309), Most Career Steals (275), Most Points in a Single Season (689), and Most Points in a Single Game (40).
- Ryan is a four-time All-District Team Selection, a two-time All-Region Team Selection, a two-time TSWA 4A All-State Selection, and a one-time Region MVP (2024).
- Ryan averaged 25 PPG, 5 RPG, 3 APG, 3 SPG, and shot 38% from three-point range in her senior season.
- Ryan will play alongside her older sister, Sydney Ryan, for the first time since high school.

NEAL JOINS THE SQUAD

- Anyiah Neal comes to Quinnipiac after attending the Loomis Chaffee School.
- Neal is a two-time Founder League Champion, a two-time NEPSAC Class-A Champion, a 2025 All-NEPSAC Honorable Mention, a 2022-23 NYSPHSAA Section III Class A All-Tournament Selection, a 2022-23 New York State All-CNY First Team Selection, and a 2021-22 NYSPHSAA Section III Class A All-Tournament Team Selection.
- Neal is a native of Syracuse, New York, and comes to Hamden for her first season in 2025-26.

ANOTHER FABBRI ON THE STAFF

- Head Coach Tricia Fabbri announced the addition of her daughter and former player, Carly Fabbri '18, to the staff ahead of the 2025-26 season.
- Fabbri had a four-year career in Hamden and earned multiple MAAC All-Tournament Honors and an All-MAAC Third Team distinction in her senior season.
- In her senior season in Hamden, Fabbri averaged 9.6 points per game and was ranked 11th in the nation with a 2.90 assist-to-turnover ratio, recording 142 assists and 49 turnovers.
- Fabbri was named to the CoSIDA Academic All-District Team and the MAAC All-Academic Team after a stellar senior year.
- In her junior campaign, Fabbri recorded 11 PPG, dished out three assists per game, and grabbed three rebounds per game at the MAAC Tournament to earn All-Tournament honors.
- Fabbri was named to the MAAC All-Academic Team after her sophomore season. Fabbri ranked 12th in the MAAC in assists per game, tied for sixth in three-point percentage, and tied for 12th in three-pointers made per game (1.5).

TRICIA FABBRI | HEAD COACH | 31ST SEASON | FAIRFIELD '91

The first full-time, female coach in school history, Tricia Fabbri, enters her 31st year as the coach at Quinnipiac University. Fabbri was hired in 1995 after a three-year stint as an assistant coach at her alma mater, Fairfield University. As a player under Coach Dianne Nolan, the former Tricia Sacca won two MAAC championships, scored 1,622 points, grabbed 1,037 rebounds, and earned three First-Team All-Conference selections and an All-Team selection. She was twice selected to All-Conference teams, a feat later matched by her daughter, Carly, in 2017 and 2018 at Quinnipiac.

The all-time winningest coach in Quinnipiac women's basketball history, Fabbri enters the 2025-26 campaign with 544 career wins.

Fabbri guided the program's transition from the Northeast 10 Conference in Division II to the Northeast Conference in Division I. In the 1998-99 season, Quinnipiac finished 9-18 and qualified for the conference playoffs. In 2000-2001 the team earned its first winning season in nine years, losing to LIU-Brooklyn in overtime in the conference semifinals; in the process, Fabbri was named the Coach of the Year.

In 2005-06, Fabbri led the Bobcats to its first 20-win season and an appearance in the NEC championship game despite featuring four freshmen, including Erin Kerner, the conference's Rookie of the Year. It lost a thriller to top seed Sacred Heart, 69-65. For her efforts, Fabbri was again named the NEC Coach of the Year. In 2007-08, Fabbri and Quinnipiac shared the regular season championship with Robert Morris. The Bobcats earned a berth in the Women's National Invitational, the first national postseason tournament appearance in Quinnipiac women's basketball Division I history. It lost to Iona, 71-59. Brianna Rooney was tabbed the conference's Defensive Player of the Year. She would win the award the following year as well.

In 2011-12, the Bobcats advanced to the NEC semifinals. Quinnipiac was selected to the WNIT where it fell to Temple, 75-60. Felicia Barron was named the Northeast Conference's Defensive Player of the Year and to the All-NEC First Team after leading the nation in steals throughout the season. At the beginning of the year, Quinnipiac notched its most significant win in program history at the time, beating Minnesota, 64-62, in the opening round of the Saint Mary's (CA) Holiday Tournament, which it won the following night. During the 2012-2013 campaign - its last in the NEC - Quinnipiac defeated St. Francis (Pa.), 72-33, in Hamden for the conference championship, earning the school's inaugural trip to the NCAA Division 1 Tournament. The Bobcats fell to Maryland, 72-52. Fabbri led the Bobcats to the first 30-win season in both program and conference history. They were a perfect 18-0 in conference play. McQuain was named the tournament's Most Outstanding Player.

Throughout the season, the team was recognized in the College Insider Mid-Major Top 25 Poll for 15 consecutive weeks, as the Bobcats climbed as high as seventh in the census. The Bobcats also received votes in the National AP Polls for the first time in program history. Deservingly so, Fabbri was named the 2013 NEC Coach of the Year by her peers and also accepted the Sterling House "Spirit Award" at the annual celebrity breakfast in Stratford, Conn. Under Fabbri's tutelage, Felicia Barron earned her second consecutive NEC Defensive Player of the Year award and a trip to the NEC First Team; Brittany McQuain was named to the NEC Second Team; and Jasmine Martin was selected to the NEC Third Team.

Quinnipiac joined the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAAC) in 2013-14 and made an immediate impact in their new league as the Bobcats advanced all the way to the MAAC Championship game before finishing runners-up to Marist. Fabbri led the Bobcats to a 21-13 overall record in 2013-14 and 14-6 mark in their first season as a MAAC institution. As the No. 4 seed in the 2014 MAAC Tournament, Quinnipiac upended the No. 1 seed Iona Gaels in the Semifinal round to make it to a second straight conference championship game appearance. The season ended with the Bobcats' first at-large postseason tournament berth as Quinnipiac made it to the WNIT for the second time in three years, eventually falling short against Villanova. Under her tutelage, three players garnered All-Conference honors as Brittany McQuain and Jasmine Martin earned Second Team honors while Gillian Abshire made it on the All-MAAC Third Team. Maria Napolitano was awarded the Sixth Player of the Year.

Fabbri's transformative 2014-15 season redefined the record books at Quinnipiac as her squad went 31-4 (.886 win percentage) overall and 20-0 in conference play on their way to winning the 2015 MAAC Championship and earning a spot into the NCAA Tournament. Fabbri led the Bobcats to their most wins (31) in a single season in program history as well as their second 30-win campaign in the last three seasons. Quinnipiac became the first MAAC school in conference history (est. 1980) to finish 20-0 in conference play and just the sixth squad to go undefeated in league play. As the No. 1 seed in the 2015 MAAC Tournament, Quinnipiac upended Monmouth, Siena and ultimately the nine-time defending MAAC Champ Marist to claim their first MAAC Championship. Her record-breaking season earned Fabbri the MAAC Coach of the Year award on a unanimous vote by her peers. Throughout the season, Quinnipiac received unparalleled recognition in the national polls as Fabbri's squad earned four votes in the Associated Press (AP) Top 25 National Poll, totaled two votes in the USA Today Coaches' Poll, ranked No. 10 in the ESPNW Mid-Major Poll and were ranked No. 6 in the College Insider Mid-Major Poll. All four distinctions in the national voting polls were good enough for program records while the Bobcats' votes in the USA Today Coaches' Poll marked the first time the program had ever received recognition in that selective poll.

In 2014-15, Fabbri guided the tutelage of four All-MAAC performers including Samantha Guastella (First Team), Val Driscoll (Second Team), Gillian Abshire (Third Team) and Nikoline Ostergaard (Third Team). In the history of the MAAC, only two teams prior to the 2014-15 Bobcats had four players earn All-Conference laurels, excluding the inclusion of the All-Rookie Team. During the 2015-16 season, Quinnipiac won 17 straight conference games after an 0-3 conference start to win the MAAC regular season crown, despite losing all five starters from the previous year's team. After losing its top

scorer in the conference semifinals, Quinnipiac fell to Iona, 57-41, in the championship game. Fabbri again earned MAAC Coach of the Year honors. Aryn McClure was named the Rookie of the Year. The Bobcats rebounded in the first round of the WNIT by throttling Maine, 90-44, the program's first national postseason tournament win in Division I.

In 2016-17, Fabbri led the Bobcats on a thrilling ride to the Sweet 16, establishing one of the greatest single seasons by any program in school history. Behind the play of the Tournament's Most Outstanding Player Adily Martucci, the Bobcats beat Rider, 64-59, in the MAAC championship game.

Quinnipiac then became just the fourth No. 12 seed in NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Tournament history to advance to the Sweet 16. The Bobcats beat No. 25 Marquette, 68-65, in Miami to earn its first-ever NCAA Tournament victory. Two nights later, they upset No. 16 Miami, 85-78. The Cinderella story ended a week later when the Bobcats were done in by eventual NCAA Champion South Carolina 100-58 in Stockton, California. Quinnipiac, which finished 29-7, was voted No. 23 in the USA Today Coaches' Poll, its first-ever national ranking. In addition, Quinnipiac was voted the top mid-major program in the nation in the College Insider Mid-Major Poll, another first.

In the 2017-18 season, Fabbri led the Bobcats to a 28-6 record, an 18-0 mark in the MAAC, and a third MAAC title. They overcame Marist, 67-58, as Jen Fay was named the tournament's Most Outstanding Player. The No. 9 seed in the East Region, Quinnipiac beat Miami, 86-72, for a second consecutive year, before losing to No. 1 Connecticut in the second round. Fabbri was named the Coach of the Year for the third time.

The 2018-19 campaign featured Quinnipiac's eighth consecutive 20-win season. The 26-7 team posted its fourth undefeated season in MAAC play and won its third consecutive MAAC title and fourth overall when it thumped Marist, 81-51. Jen Fay was named the tournament's Most Outstanding Player for the second year. The Bobcats eventually fell to sixth-seeded South Dakota State, 76-65, at the Carrier Dome in Syracuse in the opening round of the NCAA Tournament. Fabbri won her fourth Coach of the Year honor.

During the 2020-21 season, Quinnipiac finished 13-8 and earned the second seed in the conference tournament. Mackenzie Dewees was named Quinnipiac's first MAAC Player of the Year and Mikala Morris was the third to be named Defensive Player of the Year.

In 2021-22, the Bobcats returned to the national postseason stage, advancing to the WNIT for the fifth time in program history. Quinnipiac finished with a 21-12 record - the program's 11th straight winning season - and defeated Rhode Island, to earn the program's fifth-ever win in a national postseason tournament and first since the 2018 season. The program earned WBCA Division I Academic Team honors, recording a 3.405 team GPA to rank 53rd of all Division I women's basketball programs.

Quinnipiac Women's Basketball enjoyed another impressive season in 2022-23, going 21-9 (16-4 MAAC) to earn a first-round bye in the league tournament. The Bobcats went 12-3 in Hamden and went on a 10-game unbeaten streak from Jan. 19 - Feb. 18 during MAAC play. The Bobcats saw three players earn All-MAAC honors, led by Mary Baskerville earning the title of 2022-23 MAAC Women's Basketball Sixth Player of the Year. Baskerville became the third player in program history to garner the distinction, joining former Bobcats Taylor Herd (2018-19) and Maria Napolitano (2014-15) to do so.

Senior Mikala Morris received All-MAAC status for the fourth consecutive season, earning a spot on the All-MAAC Second Team. Morris joined Aryn McClure as just the second player in the program's Div. I history to accomplish the feat of earning All-League status four times. Fellow senior Cur'Tiera Haywood earned Third Team All-MAAC honors, while first-year Ella O'Donnell was named to the MAAC All-Rookie Team after her first season with the Bobcats. Haywood earned All-MAAC Third Team honors after previously earning MAAC All-Rookie Team distinction as a first-year in 2019-20.

In 2023-24, the Bobcats were led by their young squad to the MAAC Postseason. Anna Foley earned All-MAAC Second Team honors, while she and Karson Martin were both named to the All-Rookie Team. Foley earned Rookie of the Week honors four times and was a one-time MAAC Player of the Week honoree.

The Bobcats got off to a flying start in the 2024-25 campaign, winning their first six games of the season before falling to ACC foe, Miami, in overtime. From there, the Bobcats won nine straight games, starting the season 15-1, their best start to a season in program history. Quinnipiac rolled into the MAAC Tournament with a 28-5 overall record and an 18-2 mark in conference play. The 18 MAAC wins were the program's most wins in conference play since the 2018-19 season. The Bobcats defeated the Iona Gaels in the MAAC Quarterfinals and downed the Merrimack Warriors in the MAAC Semifinal to reach the MAAC Title game for the first time since 2019. Despite a loss in the Championship game, the Bobcats earned the program's first invite to the WBIT.

After leading the Bobcats to their most wins (28) in a season since 2017-18 and their most wins in a conference slate (18) in six seasons, Fabbri was named the MAAC Coach of the Year for the fifth time in her coaching career.

First-year star Gal Raviv earned the conference's Rookie of the Year and Player of the Year award, the first time in the league's history a player has won both of those awards in the same season (men's or women's). Raviv's numbers were astonishing, averaging 18.0 points per game and becoming the first player since Jasmine Martin (2013-14) to reach the 500+ point threshold in a single season. Raviv was named MAAC Rookie of the Week eleven times, tying the record for the most Rookie of the Week awards in a single season.

Three Bobcats earned All-MAAC honors after the 2024-25 season. Gal Raviv was named to the All-MAAC First Team and All-Rookie Team, Anna Foley earned All-MAAC Second Team honors for the second straight season, and Jackie Grisdale was named to the All-MAAC Third Team. During her nine-year MAAC tenure, Fabbri and Quinnipiac have won four MAAC championships, three NCAA Tournament games, and two WNIT games. Quinnipiac has had a Player of the Year, a Defensive Player of the Year, a Rookie of the Year, and three Sixth Players of the Year. Quinnipiac has had 32 players selected to All-Conference teams, including seven first-team selections. She has been named conference Coach of the Year four times.

During her 15-year NEC tenure, Fabbri and Quinnipiac won one title. Fabbri coached one Player of the Year, one Rookie of the Year, two Defensive Players of the Year, and 28 All-Conference selections. Fabbri was named conference Coach of the Year three times.

Since joining NCAA Division I, Coach Fabbri has distinguished herself as a premier coach in the region. Fabbri and the Bobcats left the Northeast Conference in 2013 ranking second place all-time in career NEC regular-season wins (177) and overall NEC wins (187).

In 1998, Fabbri was inducted into the Fairfield University Athletic Hall of Fame. In 2002, she was also inducted into the Connecticut Women's Basketball Hall of Fame and the Delran (N.J.) High School Athletic Hall of Fame. In 2006, she was named to the MAAC 25th Anniversary Team. She was inducted into the Albert Carino Basketball Club of South Jersey Hall of Fame. That year, she also received the St. Clare Award at the 22nd Annual Franciscan Sports Banquet.

Fabbri served on the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Competition Committee from 2016-2018.

Fabbri and her husband, Paul, have three children: Carly, Armand, and Paul Henry.
