NOTABLE NOTES

BATTLE OF THE BRIDGE SERIES SWEEP

Canisius notched their second conference win of the season against rival Niagara on Tuesday, securing the season sweep in the historic Battle of the Bridge rivalry. Senior Franka Wittenberg and sophomore Irene Rey Pineda led the way, tallying 10 points each in the victory.

2025 WRAPPED

Canisius played in 31 games over the course of the 2025 calendar year, posting a 11-19 record. Nine of those victories came in the second half of the 2024-25 season, including a three-game win streak to end the MAAC slate which secured a berth into the 2025 MAAC Championship.

COMEBACK CANISIUS

The Blue and Gold scored a late comeback over Wright State (Dec. 12) to earn their second win of the season. Trailing 60-55 with under three minutes to go, the Griffins' scored 10 unanswered points to steal the victory. The come from behind effort marked the first time this season that Canisius won a game when trailing at any point in the fourth quarter.

SCORING UP AND DOWN THE LINEUP

Eleven of Canisius' 12 active players found their way onto the scoresheet in Tuesday's 74-58 victory over Niagara. Senior Franka Wittenberg and sophomore Irene Rey Pineda each tallied a team-high 10 points. Juniors Mary Copple and Shariah Gailes and sophomore Yasmine Djibril all added eight points each. Junior Saige Randolph was the lone player to not score in the contest.

JUNIOR SHARIAH GAILES

Junior **Shariah Gailes** was named to the 2025-26 Preseason All-MAAC Third Team. Gailes led the Golden Griffins and ranked third among the conference last season in rebounds per game (8.1) and free throw percentage (77.2).

WHAT IS A GRIFFIN?

The Griffin is a mythical creature of supposed gigantic size that has the head, forelegs and wings of an eagle and the hindquarters, tail and ears of a lion. They are well known for their speed, ability to fly and having eyes like an eagle as well as the strength and courage of a lion.

Griphins have been known for centuries as symbols of strength and vigilance, have been called "The Hounds of Zeus" in Greek mythology and are said to have mastery of both the land and sky.

They are thought to be from India, where the natives of the land made their talons and claws into drinking cups because the talon of a Griffin was said to detect poison in a liquid. Griffins would find gold in the mountains and line their nests with it and as a result, were forced to become great guardians of the nests to keep the hunters away.

LIMITING TURNOVERS

Turnovers have plagued Canisius throughout the season. The Griffins' have committed 20-or-more turnovers in 17 of their 23 games. Canisius turned over the ball a season-low 15 times in Thursday's game against Quinnipiac (Feb. 5).

BUILDING OFF LAST YEAR

Head coach **Tiffany Swofford** won 10 games in her first year at Canisius, including a 9-11 mark in MAAC play and a berth into the 2025 MAAC Championship, despite inheriting a roster that returned only 1% of its scoring from the previous season and being picked last in the MAAC Preseason Poll. The 2024-25 campaign was highlighted by a three-game win streak to end the regular season, solidifying a postseason opportunity.

RECORD BREAKING NIGHT

The Golden Griffins achieved multiple milestones in their first conference victory against Niagara (Jan. 14). **Shariah Gailes'** 16 rebounds was the highest single-game total from a Canisius player since Sisi Elko grabbed 17 boards on Jan. 25, 2024. The Blue and Gold also held the Purple Eagles to three points in the final quarter of play, marking the lowest quarter point total from an opponent in program history.

DEFENDING THREES

The Blue and Gold have become one of the best teams in the nation at defending the three ball, holding their opponents to a combined 27.5% from deep. That figure leads the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference and ranks 46th in the nation. The Griffins' have held their opponents 20%-or-less from three point range on four occasions this season.

CORNIYA THE CLAY-MAKER

Sophomore **Corniya Clay** is seeing more time than ever before in her collegiate career, largely due to the early season injuries that Canisius has had to endure. Clay is averaging 25.1 minutes per game this season, a change from her 4.6 minutes averaged in the 2024-25 season. In her expanded role, Clay has turned in three games with double digit scoring figures.

YASMINE'S CAREER NIGHTS KEEP COMING

Sophomore **Yasmine Djibril** recorded a career-high 16 points against Marist (Jan. 29). A week later, Djibril tallied 20 points against Quinnipiac (Feb. 5) to break that career-high mark set at Marist. The Montreal, Quebec native has scored in double digits on ten occasions throughout her career with six of those coming in the 2025-26 season.

ALL ABOUT GROWTH

Player development remained a pillar of Coach Swoffard's coaching philosophy going into her second season. Senior **Franka Wittenberg** played the best season of her career, notching a 41.5% field goal percentage, 31.0% three-point field goal percentage (33.3% in conference play), and averaging 8.4 points per game and 2.5 assists per game. Wittenberg earned MAAC Player of the Week honors on December 29th. Junior **Mary Copple** saw significant increases as well, with double-digit increases in field goal and three-point percentage from her freshman year. Last season, Copple ranked 11th in MAAC play in three-point field goal percentage (36.6%). Additionally, the 2024-25 season was impacted by forward and post player development under the direction of Swoffard. **Shariah Gailes** led the team in rebounding, ranking third in the MAAC in rebounds per game (8.1) and second in offensive rebounds per game (2.7). Gailes also ranked 15th in field goal percentage for the MAAC (44.1%), averaging 9.1 points per game for the Griffins. Gailes scored double-digit point totals 13 times and posted a team-high eight double-double performances in the 2024-25 season.

RECAPPING NON-CON

Canisius concluded their non-conference slate against Wright State on Friday. Canisius faced multiple power-five opponents in its seven-game slate. The Blue and Gold hosted four of its seven non-conference contests against programs such as Eastern Michigan, Cornell, Mercyhurst and Wright State. The early portion of the season was highlighted by former Canisius head coach Sahar Nusseibeh's return to Buffalo when the Griffins hosted Eastern Michigan on Nov. 7. Nusseibeh coached the Griffins for three seasons (2021-2024).

CONFERENCE ACTION

Canisius is scheduled to host ten conference contests inside the Koessler Athletic Center in the 2025-26 season. Canisius opened up MAAC play on Dec. 19, when they hosted Saint Peter's. For the second-straight year, the MAAC schedule will be unbalanced. Each school in the 13-team league will play eight conference opponents twice (one at home, one on the road) and four other conference rivals one time, each. Per MAAC scheduling policy, each school is guaranteed to play its closest geographic opponent, but the rest of the opponents that a school plays only one time were chosen at random. For this season, Canisius will not host Marist or Merrimack, and the Griffins will not play road games at either Rider or Saint Peter's.

TRUSTING THE BENCH

Through 23 games of the season, nine of Canisius' 13 active players are averaging double digit minutes per game. Sophomore **Irene Rey Pineda** has provided the Golden Griffins with a cushion of depth off the bench, averaging 6.3 points per game. Head coach **Tiffany Swoffard** has used all active players in 17 of the Griffins' 23 games.

A WIN WOULD...

A win in Thursday's contest would give Canisius its third conference victory of the season. A Canisius win coupled with a Rider loss to Saint Peter's would give the Griffins 11th place in the MAAC.

HEAD COACH - TIFFANY SWOFFARD



Tiffany Swoffard was named the 11th head coach in women's basketball program history on April 17, 2024.

A long-time assistant coach with 14 years of NCAA Division I coaching experience at both the Power 5 and mid-major levels, Swoffard takes over the Golden Griffin program after spending the 2023-24 campaign as a member of the Penn State women's basketball coaching staff.

In her one season on staff at Penn State, Swoffard helped lead the Nittany Lions to their first 20-win season since 2016-17, which resulted in a WBIT berth and an appearance in the tournament's semifinal round. Swoffard oversaw the development of the Penn State post players and served as the team's rebounding coordinator, as the Nittany Lions finished the year in the top half of the Big Ten in both rebounds per game and rebounding margin.

Before joining the staff at Penn State, Swoffard spent four seasons as an assistant coach at Miami (Ohio) in the Mid-American Conference (MAC). From 2019-23, six RedHawks earned All-MAC accolades, while 20 student-athletes earned All-MAC Academic honors. In addition to her role as recruiting coordinator, Swoffard was the team's offensive coordinator in 2022-23, where Miami (Ohio) ranked fourth in the MAC in league scoring average, as the RedHawks posted an average of 72.1 points per game against conference rivals.

Swoffard joined the RedHawks' staff after spending four years as an assistant coach at Toledo, where she played an integral role in all aspects of the program, including perimeter-player development, recruiting, academic support and opponent scouting. She served as Toledo's recruiting coordinator and worked with both the guards and post players.

During her time with the Rockets, Swoffard helped lead Toledo to an 81-49 overall record and a 43-29 mark in MAC play, including a pair of 20-win seasons in 2016-17 and 2018-19. Swoffard was in her second year as an assistant coach with the Rockets when the team won the MAC Tournament following the 2016-17 season. During her tenure, Toledo garnered 12 All-MAC selections, made an NCAA Tournament appearance and earned two WNIT berths.

Prior to Toledo, Swoffard spent five seasons at Mercer, where she handled recruiting, on-court development, academic support and in-office administration and worked with both the guards and post players. She mentored five all-conference athletes and 17 academic all-conference recipients. Swoffard helped lead Mercer to its first 20-win season in two decades in 2012-13, and its first appearance in a postseason tournament since 1985.

Before her stint at Mercer, Swoffard spent four seasons (2007-10) as an assistant coach at the University of Arkansas – Fort Smith. There, she was responsible for arranging team travel, updating game statistics, scouting opponents, organizing film exchange, ordering equipment, scheduling community service projects and assisting with scheduling. Swoffard also coordinated recruiting visits, identified possible recruits, facilitated camps and served as the program's recruiting coordinator. While on staff there, Arkansas – Fort Smith finished third at the 2008 NJCAA National Tournament and she also assisted with the program's transition to the NCAA Division II level.

Swoffard started her collegiate coaching career at NCAA Division III Rowan University in Glassboro, N.J., where she was a graduate assistant coach from 2005-07. Before that, she spent two seasons as the junior team head coach of the Georgia Metros Nike Elite AAU Basketball program.

A native of Chattanooga, Tenn., Swoffard was a four-year letterwinner at Austin Peay from 1998-2002, including two consecutive years in which the Lady Governors captured the Ohio Valley Conference Tournament championship and went on to play in the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Tournament (2000-01 and 2001-02).

An active member of the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA), Swoffard earned her bachelor's degree in business administration with an emphasis in marketing from Austin Peay in 2002. She went on to earn her master's degree in business administration from Rowan in 2007.
