### QU DOWNS MANHATTAN, ADVANCES TO MAAC SEMIFINALS

- The Quinnipiac Bobcats advanced to the 2026 Air Force Reserve MAAC Women's Basketball Championship Semifinal with a 59-43 win over the Manhattan Jaspers on Friday afternoon from Jim Whelan Boardwalk Hall.
- First-year Ella Ryan made a solid first impression on the Atlantic City crowd, dropping 15 points and grabbing nine rebounds in her first taste of postseason action with the Bobcats. Ryan went 3-for-8 from three-point range, the most threes on the team in the win over Manhattan.
- Ella O'Donnell scored 14 points, including QU's first six points of the contest. O'Donnell shot 58.3% (7-for-12) from the floor in 23 minutes of action.
- Five Bobcats recorded points in the win.

## NEWS & NOTES

### SCOUTING THE GAELS

- The Iona Gaels are led by head coach Angelika Szumilo, who has led the Gaels to a 20-11 record in her third season at Iona. Coach Szumilo holds a 114-96 overall record in her seven seasons as a head coach (4 at FDU, 3 at Iona).
- The Gaels hold a 20-11 overall record and finished conference play with a 12-8 record. The Jaspers earned the number four seed for the 2026 MAAC Air Force Reserve Women's Basketball Championships in Atlantic City, New Jersey.
- The last time out, the Gaels defeated the Siena Saints in the MAAC Quarterfinal round. Mya Zaccagnini led the way for the Gaels, scoring 14 points on 55.6% (5-for-9) shooting from the field. Naomi Barnwell and Ella Fajardo were the other Gaels to reach double figures in the win. As a team, Iona shot 36.8% (21-for-57) from the field.
- The Gaels average 60.3 points per game, while holding their opponents to an average of 59.5 points per game this year.
- Iona is outscoring their opponents 1869-1845 (+24) this season and has a scoring margin of 0.8.
- As a team, Iona is averaging 60.3 points per game, while shooting 36.4% (686-1885) from the field, 27.2% (168-617) from three-point range, and 73.4% (329-448) from the free-throw line.
- The Gaels are allowing their opponents to score just 59.5 points per game, which ranks 3rd in the conference.
- Iona averages 37.8 rebounds per game and allows their opponents to average 37.5 rebounds per game.
- The Gaels average 13.9 turnovers per game and force 16.3 turnovers per game from their opponents.
- Isabellah Middleton is the leading scorer for the Gaels, averaging 13.8 points per game in 30 starts this season.
- Middleton is shooting 41.6% from the field, 32.1% from three-point range, and 71.9% from the charity stripe this season.
- Zoey Ward is right behind Middleton, averaging 13.5 points per game in 31 starts this year.
- Iona is 1-0 in the 2026 MAAC Tournament and averages 59 points per game in Atlantic City this year.
- Iona averaged 61.8 points per game in MAAC play, which ranked 5th in the conference.
- Iona is currently ranked 276th in the most recent NCAA NET Rankings (Mar. 7).

### HISTORY VS. IONA

- Sunday's matchup marks the 28th time the Bobcats and Gaels are facing off.
- Quinnipiac is 18-9 against Iona, dating back to March 19th, 2008.
- The Bobcats took the only meeting against the Gaels, defeating Iona 80-54, on New Year's Day in Hamden.
- Five Bobcats recorded double figures, led by Karson Martin who scored 19 points on 6-for-8 shooting from the field.
- Anna Foley scored 16 points, Sydney Ryan recorded 14, while both Jackie Grisdale and Ella O'Donnell picked up 12.
- The Bobcats are 241-80 (.751) all-time against current MAAC members.

### BOBCATS BY THE NUMBERS (As of Mar. 7<sup>th</sup>)

- 1 (First): The Bobcats currently rank first in the conference by allowing just 50.9 points per game.
- 1 (First): The Bobcats rank 1st in the nation with 14 road wins this year.
- 1 (First): Paige Girardi ranks first in the nation with a 4.40 assist/

turnover ratio, which also ranks 1st in the MAAC.

- 2 (Second): Quinnipiac is second in the MAAC with a 17.0 scoring margin.
- 2 (Second): Quinnipiac is currently 2nd in the country, allowing just 50.9 points per game, only behind UConn.
- 2 (Two): The Bobcats have two of the top three-point shooters in the MAAC in Jackie Grisdale and Ella Ryan. Both rank in the top eight in the MAAC in three-pointers per game.
- 3 (Third): Jackie Grisdale is third in the MAAC in minutes played this season with an average of 34.35 minutes per game.
- 3 (Third): Ella Ryan ranks third among first-years in the conference in scoring with an average of 10.2 points per game.
- 3 (Third): Jackie Grisdale ranks third in the MAAC in three pointers (72).
- 5 (Five): Five Bobcats were named to All-MAAC teams, with two on the first-team, two on the third team, and one on the rookie team.
- 8 (Eighth): Paige Girardi ranks eighth in the conference with an average of 3.1 assists per game.
- 9 (Ninth): Ella O'Donnell is 9th in the MAAC with a 1.1 assist/turnover ratio.
- 9 (Nine): Coach Fabbri is one of nine Active Division I women's basketball head coaches to have recorded at least 500 wins at a single program.
- 10 (Tenth): The Bobcats rank 10th in the country with an average of 11.7 turnovers per game, which also leads the MAAC.
- 10 (Tenth): Jackie Grisdale ranks 10th in the conference, averaging 12.7 points per game.
- 11 (Twelfth): Quinnipiac is currently 11th in the nation with a 1.38 assist/turnover ratio, which also ranks first in the conference.
- 12 (Twelfth): The Bobcats rank 12th in the country in three-point percentage (36.7), which ranks second in the MAAC.
- 15 (Fifteenth): Sydney Ryan ranks 15th in the MAAC with an average of 5.6 rebounds per game.
- 18 (Eighteenth): Jackie Grisdale became the 18th Bobcat in their Division I history to join the 1,000-point Club.
- 19 (Nineteenth): Sydney Ryan became the 19th Bobcat in their Division I history to join the 1,000-point Club.
- 20 (Twentieth): Anna Foley became the 20th Bobcat in their Division I history to join the 1,000-point Club.
- 20 (Twenty): The Bobcats have won twelve games by 20+ points (Yale, Colgate, Boston College, Cornell, Manhattan, Saint Peter's, Iona, Mount St. Mary's, Merrimack, Niagara, Siena, and Canisius).
- 27 (Twenty-Seven): The Bobcats held the Peacocks to just 27 points, setting a new Division I team record for fewest points allowed in a single game.
- 28 (Twenty-Eighth): Grisdale was the 28th Bobcat in program history to reach the 1,000-Point mark.
- 29 (Twenty-Nine): Sydney Ryan was the 29th Bobcat in program history to reach the 1,000-Point mark.
- 30 (Thirty): Anna Foley became the 30th Bobcat in program history to reach the 1,000-Point mark.
- 42 (Forty-Second): Coach Fabbri is 42nd in Division I wins as a head coach with 554.
- 229 (Two Hundred Twenty-Nine): Jackie Grisdale broke Sam Guastella's '15 record for career three-pointers made with 229 career threes.

### ALL-MAAC AWARDS & MORE

- Junior guard Karson Martin was named the MAAC's Sixth Player of the Year, as announced by the league office on Wednesday, March 4th.
- Jackie Grisdale and Ella O'Donnell earned All-MAAC First Team honors.
- Anna Foley and Karson Martin were named to the All-MAAC Third Team, and Ella Ryan earned All-Rookie honors.

**QU CLOSES OUT REGULAR SEASON WITH SENIOR DAY WIN**

- The Quinnipiac Bobcats closed out the regular season in style, defeating the Canisius Golden Griffins, 75-37, on Senior Day to clinch a share of the 2025-2026 MAAC Regular Season Championship.
- Along with the Bobcats clinching at least a share of the regular-season title, the Bobcats have clinched the number one seed for the 2026 Air Force Reserve MAAC Women's Basketball Championships in Atlantic City, New Jersey, at Jim Whelan Boardwalk Hall.
- Jackie Grisdale led the Bobcats to their 24th win of the season, scoring 19 points on 6-for-13 shooting from the floor, while knocking down five threes in the win. Grisdale set a new program record for made threes in a career (227).

**QU'S DEFENSE SHINES IN WIN OVER NIAGARA**

- The Quinnipiac Bobcats had their defense on full display in their 54-38 win over the Niagara Purple Eagles in Hamden on Thursday evening. With the win, the Bobcats improved to 23-5 overall and 18-1 in MAAC play, moving back in a tie for first place with the Fairfield Stags.
- Jackie Grisdale and Ella Ryan each scored 12 points to lead the way for the Bobcats.
- Grisdale recorded her first collegiate double-double, grabbing ten rebounds in the win. Grisdale shot 30.8% (4-for-13) from the floor and knocked down two threes.
- Ella Ryan shot 44.4% (4-for-9) from the field and knocked down one of her two three-point attempts.
- Eight Bobcats recorded points in the win.

**BOBCATS GET BACK ON TRACK IN WIN OVER SHU**

- The Quinnipiac Bobcats got back in the win column, defeating the Sacred Heart Pioneers, 55-39, on Saturday afternoon in Fairfield, Connecticut. With the win, the Bobcats improved to 22-5 overall and 17-1 in MAAC play.
- Ella Ryan had a big day for the Bobcats, scoring a team-high 18 points on 63.6% shooting (7-for-11) from the floor and knocking down 50% (3-for-6) of her three-point attempts. Ryan's 18 points are the second highest of her first season in Hamden.
- Anna Foley reached double digits, scoring ten points in the win. Foley grabbed a team-high seven rebounds and dished out a team-high five assists.
- Eight Bobcats recorded points in the 16-point win over the Sacred Heart Pioneers.

**BOBCATS FALL TO FAIRFIELD IN HAMDEN**

- The Quinnipiac Bobcats dropped their first MAAC game of the season to the Fairfield Stags, 75-63, on Saturday evening in Hamden. With the loss, the Bobcats fell to 21-5 overall and 16-1 in conference play.
- Ella O'Donnell led the Bobcats in scoring with 14 points on 6-for-8 (75%) shooting from the floor. O'Donnell finished the day with four rebounds and two assists.

- Anna Foley reached double figures with eleven points on 62.5% shooting from the field. Foley finished the evening with two rebounds, two steals, one assist, and one block.
- Eight Bobcats recorded points in the loss to the Stags.
- QU's win streak was snapped at sixteen games.

**BOBCATS DEFEAT SIENA, WIN 16th STRAIGHT**

- The Quinnipiac Bobcats defeated the Siena Saints, 62-40, on Thursday evening in Hamden. With the win, the Bobcats improved to 21-4 overall and 16-0 in conference play. Quinnipiac also extended their win streak to sixteen straight games.
- Ella O'Donnell had a big day for the Bobcats as she led the team in scoring with 14 points on 45.5% (5-for-11) shooting from the floor and 4-for-4 from the free-throw line. O'Donnell tied for the team-high with nine rebounds and two steals.
- Anna Foley scored eleven points in the contest on 55.6% (5-for-9) shooting from the field. Anna Foley became the 30th member of Quinnipiac's 1,000 Point Club and the 20th player to reach that feat in QU's Division I history.

**BOBCATS DEFEAT NIAGARA, SWEEP WESTERN NEW YORK TRIP**

- The Quinnipiac Bobcats dominated the Niagara Purple Eagles, 89-45, on Saturday afternoon to sweep the Western New York trip. With the win, the Bobcats secured their 14th 20-win season in the Division I era. Quinnipiac has won 20+ games in back-to-back seasons and four of the last five years.
- Sydney Ryan had a big day for the Bobcats, leading them with 17 points on 63% (5-for-8) shooting from the floor. Ryan was one of three Bobcats who knocked down multiple three-point attempts in the win.
- Jackie Grisdale reached double figures in the win, scoring 14 points on 56% shooting.
- Eleven total Bobcats recorded points in the 44-point win.

**BOBCATS DOWN CANISIUS FOR 14th STRAIGHT WIN**

- The Quinnipiac Bobcats started their Western New York trip the right way, defeating the Canisius Golden Griffins, 73-55, on Thursday night in Buffalo. With the win, the Bobcats cemented their spot in the 2026 MAAC Women's Basketball Championships in Atlantic City, New Jersey.
- Anna Foley had a big day, leading the Bobcats in scoring with 16 points on 62% (8-for-13) shooting from the floor. Foley added eight rebounds, three assists, and three steals to her stat line in the win over Canisius.
- Karson Martin had another solid game for the Bobcats, finishing the night with 14 points, five rebounds, and five assists.

**BOBCATS EXTEND WIN STREAK TO 13**

- The Quinnipiac Bobcats continued their winning ways, defeating the Merrimack Warriors, 80-53, on Saturday afternoon in Hamden.
- Karson Martin led the Bobcats in scoring for the second straight game, dropping 21 points on 8-for-12 (67%) shooting from the field. Martin shot 4-for-6 (67%) from beyond the arc, leading the team in made threes in the game.
- Ella O'Donnell had another big day, scoring 17 points on 73% shooting (8-for-11). O'Donnell stuffed the stat sheet as she finished with five rebounds, six assists, and four steals in the

27-point win over the Warriors.

- Paige Girardi set a new season-high with 13 points in the win.
- Nine Bobcats recorded points in the twenty-seven-point win.

**SHOWED OUT ON THE NATIONAL STAGE**

- Quinnipiac's effort was on full display on Thursday as they defeated the Fairfield Stags on ESPNU, 72-58.
- Karson Martin led the Bobcats in scoring, dropping 19 points on 7-for-10 (70%) shooting from the field. Martin shot 3-for-4 (75%) from beyond the arc, tying the team lead for made threes in the game.
- Ella O'Donnell had a big day, scoring 18 points on 67% (6-for-9) shooting from the floor.
- Ella Ryan reached double figures once again, scoring eleven points in the win.
- The Bobcats are the only remaining unbeaten team in the MAAC.
- The Bobcats ended Fairfield's win streak on their home floor, which was at 21 games.
- Quinnipiac also improved their win streak to twelve, while they ended the Stags' win streak at 13.
- The Bobcats shut down Fairfield's two leading scorers in L'Amoreux (10 points) and Andersen (8 points).
- Quinnipiac outshot the Stags from beyond the arc, knocking down nine of 21 attempts, while Fairfield went 5-for-22.

**BOBCATS WIN ELEVENTH STRAIGHT**

- The Quinnipiac Bobcats won their tenth straight game, defeating the Mount St. Mary's Mountaineers, 56-43, on Thursday night in Hamden. With the win, the Bobcats improved to 15-4 and 10-0 in MAAC play.
- Sydney Ryan led the Bobcats in scoring, dropping 15 points on 54.5% (6-for-11) from the field and knocking down one three-pointer. Ryan finished the day with six rebounds and two steals.
- Jackie Grisdale was second on the team in scoring, finishing with 14 points and knocking down three three-pointers.
- Eight Bobcats recorded points in the thirteen-point win over the Mountaineers as the Bobcats remain unbeaten in MAAC play on 6-for-11 shooting from the field.

- The Quinnipiac Bobcats won their tenth straight game, defeating the Mount St. Mary's Mountaineers, 56-43, on Thursday night in Hamden. With the win, the Bobcats improved to 15-4 and 10-0 in MAAC play.
- Sydney Ryan led the Bobcats in scoring, dropping 15 points on 54.5% (6-for-11) from the field and knocking down one three-pointer. Ryan finished the day with six rebounds and two steals.
- Jackie Grisdale was second on the team in scoring, finishing with 14 points and knocking down three three-pointers.
- Eight Bobcats recorded points in the thirteen-point win over the Mountaineers as the Bobcats remain unbeaten in MAAC play.

**BOBCATS TAKE DOWN MERRIMACK FOR 9th STRAIGHT WIN**

- The Quinnipiac Bobcats earned a win on the road at Merrimack, 75-61, on Monday afternoon in North Andover.
- With the win, the Bobcats improved to 14-4 overall and 9-0 in MAAC play.
- Jackie Grisdale and Karson Martin both had big days, scoring 18 points each in the 14-point win over Merrimack.
- Grisdale exploded for 12 points in the final quarter on 5-for-8

shooting from the field. Martin finished the first half with 15 points on 6-for-11 shooting from the field.

- Foley added 16 points off the bench.
- QU made nine threes in the win. The Bobcats are 12-2 when they make at least nine threes in a single game.

**BOBCATS WIN 8th STRAIGHT, DOWN MARIST**

- The Quinnipiac Bobcats extended their win streak to eight as the Bobcats defeated the Marist Red Foxes, 59-47, on Saturday afternoon in Hamden. With the win, the Bobcats improved to 13-4 overall and 8-0 in MAAC play.
- Ella O'Donnell picked up her second double-double of the season, finishing the day with 15 points and 12 rebounds. O'Donnell dished out a team-high seven assists in the win.
- Seven Bobcats picked up points in the win.
- QU improved to 8-0 in conference play, besting their 7-0 start to conference play a season ago. This is the best start to conference play since the 2018-19 season.

**BOBCATS DEFEAT SHU IN HAMDEN**

- The Quinnipiac Bobcats defended their home court on Saturday, January 10th, as they defeated the Sacred Heart Pioneers, 65-49. With the win, the Bobcats improved to 12-4 overall and 7-0 in MAAC play.
- Anna Foley had a big day, recording her third double-double of the season as she finished the day with 13 points and ten rebounds. Foley shot 41% from the field and added two steals and a block to her stat line.
- Ella O'Donnell tied for the team lead with 13 points as she shot 50% from the floor and went 3-for-4 from the free-throw line.
- Karson Martin added 12 points off the bench in 22 minutes of action.
- Six Bobcats recorded points in the win as their win streak stretched to seven games.

**BOBCATS DOWN MOUNT ON THE ROAD**

- The Quinnipiac Bobcats continued their winning ways, defeating the Mount St. Mary's Mountaineers, 70-44, on Thursday morning in Emmitsburg. With the win, the Bobcats have extended their win streak to six games to kick off MAAC play.
- Ella O'Donnell had a big day for the Bobcats, recording her first double-double of the season. O'Donnell led the way with 18 points on 63.6% (7-for-11) shooting from the floor and grabbed a team high 12 rebounds.
- Jackie Grisdale reached double figures once again, scoring 14 points and knocking down four threes in the effort.
- Seven Bobcats recorded points in the 26-point win over the Mountaineers to improve to 11-4 and 6-0 in MAAC play.

**QU IMPROVES TO 5-0 IN MAAC PLAY**

- The Quinnipiac Bobcats improved to 5-0 in MAAC play with a 68-56 win over the Rider Broncs on Saturday afternoon in Lawrenceville, New Jersey. With the win, the Bobcats have extended their win streak to five games.
- Ella Ryan led the Bobcats in scoring with 15 points on 50% (5-for-10) shooting from the field and 4-for-8 (50%) shooting from three-point range.
- Anna Foley scored 14 points and shot 7-for-13 (53.8%) from the floor. Foley stuffed the stat sheet, recording six rebounds,

three assists, two blocks, and two steals.

- QU improved to 5-0 in conference play, marking the second straight season they won their first five MAAC games of the year.

### **QU KICKS OFF 2026 WITH WIN OVER IONA**

- The Quinnipiac Bobcats opened 2026 with an 80-54 win over the Iona Gaels on Thursday afternoon in Hamden. With the win, the Bobcats improved to 9-4 overall and 4-0 in conference play.
- Karson Martin led the way in scoring for the Bobcats, dropping 19 points on 75% (6-for-8) shooting from the floor and knocking down all three three-point attempts.
- Anna Foley scored 16 points on 70% (7-for-10) shooting from the field.
- Sydney Ryan scored 14 points in the win, moving just one point shy of the 1,000-point mark in her collegiate career.
- Ella O'Donnell and Jackie Grisdale each scored 12 points in the win.

### **BOBCATS DOMINATE PEACOCKS, 67-27**

- The Quinnipiac Bobcats closed out 2025 with a 67-27 win over the Saint Peter's Peacocks on Monday evening in Jersey City, improving to 3-0 in MAAC Play.
- The Bobcats set a new school record for the fewest points allowed in the Division I era, allowing just 27 in the win.
- Ella O'Donnell led the way with 12 points on 5-for-6 (83.8%) shooting from the floor. O'Donnell grabbed four rebounds on the defensive end and three on the offensive end for seven total rebounds.
- Karson Martin scored 10 points in the win. Eight Bobcats recorded 5 or more points as they stay unbeaten in MAAC play.
- Nine different Bobcats recorded points in the forty-point win over the Peacocks.

### **BOBCATS IMPROVE TO 2-0 IN MAAC PLAY**

- The Quinnipiac women's basketball team improved to 2-0 in conference play with a 76-67 win over the Marist Red Foxes on Sunday evening in Poughkeepsie, New York.
- Sydney Ryan led the Bobcats in scoring with 19 points on 55.6% (5-9) shooting from the field and knocked down four threes in seven attempts.
- Ella O'Donnell added 16 points on 66.7% shooting from the floor. O'Donnell grabbed 5 rebounds and dished out 5 assists.
- Jackie Grisdale scored 14 points in the win and went 6-6 from the free-throw line.
- The Bobcats started on a 25-3 scoring run and never looked back, leading for 99.2% of the game.

### **FOLEY LEADS QU TO BIG WIN IN MAAC OPENER**

- The Quinnipiac women's basketball team opened conference play with a 78-39 win over the Manhattan Jaspers on Friday morning in Hamden on Kids Day.
- Anna Foley led the Bobcats with 18 points on 70% (7-for-10) shooting from the floor in the MAAC opener against Manhattan. Foley also grabbed a team-high eight rebounds, dished out four assists, recorded three blocks, and one steal in the win.
- Jackie Grisdale also reached double figures, scoring 12 points in the effort.
- Quinnipiac recorded 25 assists as a team on 28 made field goals.
- The Bobcats forced 22 turnovers and scored 27 points off those turnovers.

### **NON-CONFERENCE WRAP UP**

- The Quinnipiac women's basketball team finished non-conference action with a 5-4 record.
- Quinnipiac won its season opener at Boston University, 65-55, led by Jackie Grisdale (17 points).
- After QU dropped their next two, at Rutgers and at home against St. John's, the Bobcats defeated Yale by 23 in New Haven.
- Quinnipiac returned home and lost a hard-fought battle against the College of Charleston, 75-71.
- The Bobcats won their next three contests, defeating Colgate (77-50), Boston College (76-49), and Cornell (68-47), before dropping their non-conference finale against Maine (63-55).

### **PRESEASON NEWS**

- The Quinnipiac women's basketball team was picked to finish 2nd in the MAAC Preseason Coaches' Poll.
- Quinnipiac received 155 total points, finishing behind only Fairfield, which was unanimously selected to finish first in the conference.
- Anna Foley was named to the Preseason All-MAAC First Team after averaging 10.9 PPG and 5.4 RPG last year in Hamden.
- Jackie Grisdale was also named to the Preseason All-MAAC First Team after averaging 10.8 points per game last year.
- Junior guard Karson Martin was selected to the Preseason All-MAAC Second Team after averaging 9.8 points and 3.1 rebounds per game in 33 contests last year.

### **LEADER OF THE PACK**

- Head coach Tricia Fabbri is in her 31st season at the helm of the Bobcats in 2025-26.
- A six-time Coach of the Year and all-time winningest coach in program history, Fabbri has totaled 569 career victories, thus far.
- With the win over Mount St. Mary's on Feb. 16, 2023, Fabbri became the 90th coach in Div. I women's basketball history to reach 500 career wins and the 22nd to accomplish the feat at one institution without coaching at another.
- Of her 569 wins, 554 have come in Quinnipiac's Div. I era.
- Coach Fabbri and the Bobcats secured their second straight 20-win season and fourth in five seasons. Quinnipiac has won 20+ games in 14 of 28 seasons in their Division I era.
- In 2024-25, Fabbri led the Bobcats to 28 wins and their first WBIT Appearance.
- With five NCAA Tournament appearances, along with five WNIT berths, and one WBIT appearance, Fabbri has led QU to 12 postseason national tournaments in her tenure.
- She has led Quinnipiac to five conference titles in the last 12 seasons and earned five consecutive MAAC Regular Season titles from 2015-2019.

- M&T Bank Arena, home of the Quinnipiac Bobcats, has long been one of the most difficult arenas to play at in the country.
- Since the 2012-13 season, Quinnipiac owns a record of 155-38 (.803) in games played at home.
- In that same span, the Bobcats own a mark of 115-22 (.839) in conference play (NEC & MAAC) at home.
- Quinnipiac owns a 188-80 (.701) mark since November 22, 2017.
- The Bobcats stand with a mark of 105-22 (.827) at home in

league games since joining the MAAC in 2013-14.  
 • The Bobcats are 98-19 (.838) at M&T Bank Arena in conference games since the start of the 2014-15 campaign.

**CLOSING TIME**

• Quinnipiac has enjoyed a great deal of success over the past five seasons when building a first-half lead.  
 • After starting 2016-17 with a mark of 2-0 when owning a halftime lead, the Bobcats saw one of their most impressive streaks in program history come to an end in a 71-68 loss at Temple.  
 • The undefeated streak, which lasted throughout three seasons, came to an end at 46 straight wins for the Bobcats when holding a halftime lead.  
 • Quinnipiac went undefeated in both 2014-15 (24-0) and 2015-16 (19-0) and for the first two games of 2016-17 before suffering the defeat.

**TRICIA FABBRI | HEAD COACH | 31<sup>ST</sup> SEASON | FAIRFIELD '91**

The first full-time, female coach in school history, Tricia Fabbri, enters her 31st year as the coach at Quinnipiac University. Fabbri was hired in 1995 after a three-year stint as an assistant coach at her alma mater, Fairfield University. As a player under Coach Dianne Nolan, the former Tricia Sacca won two MAAC championships, scored 1,622 points, grabbed 1,037 rebounds, and earned three First-Team All-Conference selections and an All-Team selection. She was twice selected to All-Conference teams, a feat later matched by her daughter, Carly, in 2017 and 2018 at Quinnipiac.

The all-time winningest coach in Quinnipiac women's basketball history, Fabbri enters the 2025-26 campaign with 544 career wins.

Fabbri guided the program's transition from the Northeast 10 Conference in Division II to the Northeast Conference in Division I. In the 1998-99 season, Quinnipiac finished 9-18 and qualified for the conference playoffs. In 2000-2001 the team earned its first winning season in nine years, losing to LIU-Brooklyn in overtime in the conference semifinals; in the process, Fabbri was named the Coach of the Year.

In 2005-06, Fabbri led the Bobcats to its first 20-win season and an appearance in the NEC championship game despite featuring four freshmen, including Erin Kerner, the conference's Rookie of the Year. It lost a thriller to top seed Sacred Heart, 69-65. For her efforts, Fabbri was again named the NEC Coach of the Year. In 2007-08, Fabbri and Quinnipiac shared the regular season championship with Robert Morris. The Bobcats earned a berth in the Women's National Invitational, the first national postseason tournament appearance in Quinnipiac women's basketball Division I history. It lost to Iona, 71-59. Brianna Rooney was tabbed the conference's Defensive Player of the Year. She would win the award the following year as well.

In 2011-12, the Bobcats advanced to the NEC semifinals. Quinnipiac was selected to the WNIT where it fell to Temple, 75-60. Felicia Barron was named the Northeast Conference's Defensive Player of the Year and to the All-NEC First Team after leading the nation in steals throughout the season. At the beginning of the year, Quinnipiac notched its most significant win in program history at the time, beating Minnesota, 64-62, in the opening round of the Saint Mary's (CA) Holiday Tournament, which it won the following night. During the 2012-2013 campaign - its last in the NEC - Quinnipiac defeated St. Francis (Pa.), 72-33, in Hamden for the conference championship, earning the school's inaugural trip to the NCAA Division 1 Tournament. The Bobcats fell to Maryland, 72-52. Fabbri led the Bobcats to the first 30-win season in both program and conference history. They were a perfect 18-0 in conference play. McQuain was named the tournament's Most Outstanding Player.

Throughout the season, the team was recognized in the College Insider Mid-Major Top 25 Poll for 15 consecutive weeks, as the Bobcats climbed as high as seventh in the census. The Bobcats also received votes in the National AP Polls for the first time in program history. Deservingly so, Fabbri was named the 2013 NEC Coach of the Year by her peers and also accepted the Sterling House "Spirit Award" at the annual celebrity breakfast in Stratford, Conn. Under Fabbri's tutelage, Felicia Barron earned her second consecutive NEC Defensive Player of the Year award and a trip to the NEC First Team; Brittany McQuain was named to the NEC Second Team; and Jasmine Martin was selected to the NEC Third Team.

Quinnipiac joined the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAAC) in 2013-14 and made an immediate impact in their new league as the Bobcats advanced all the way to the MAAC Championship game before finishing runners-up to Marist. Fabbri led the Bobcats to a 21-13 overall record in 2013-14 and 14-6 mark in their first season as a MAAC institution. As the No. 4 seed in the 2014 MAAC Tournament, Quinnipiac upended the No. 1 seed Iona Gaels in the Semifinal found to make it to a second straight conference championship game appearance. The season ended with the Bobcats' first at-large postseason tournament berth as Quinnipiac made it to the WNIT for the second time in three years, eventually falling short against Villanova. Under her tutelage, three players garnered All-Conference honors as Brittany McQuain and Jasmine Martin earned Second Team honors while Gillian Abshire made it on the All-MAAC Third Team. Maria Napolitano was awarded the Sixth Player of the Year.

Fabbri's transformative 2014-15 season redefined the record books at Quinnipiac as her squad went 31-4 (.886 win percentage) overall and 20-0 in conference play on their way to winning the 2015 MAAC Championship and earning a spot into the NCAA Tournament. Fabbri led the Bobcats to their most wins (31) in a single season in program history as well as their second 30-win campaign in the last three seasons. Quinnipiac became the first MAAC school in conference history (est. 1980) to finish 20-0 in conference play and just the sixth squad to go undefeated in league play. As the No. 1 seed in the 2015 MAAC Tournament, Quinnipiac upended Monmouth, Siena and ultimately the nine-time defending MAAC Champ Marist to claim their first MAAC Championship. Her record-breaking season earned Fabbri the MAAC Coach of the Year award on a unanimous vote by her peers. Throughout the season, Quinnipiac received unparalleled recognition in the national polls as Fabbri's squad earned four votes in the Associated Press (AP) Top 25 National Poll, totaled two votes in the USA Today Coaches' Poll, ranked No. 10 in the ESPNW Mid-Major Poll and were ranked No. 6 in the College Insider Mid-Major Poll. All four distinctions in the national voting polls were good enough for program records while the Bobcats' votes in the USA Today Coaches' Poll marked the first time the program had ever received recognition in that selective poll.

In 2014-15, Fabbri guided the tutelage of four All-MAAC performers including Samantha Guastella (First Team), Val Driscoll (Second Team), Gillian Abshire (Third Team) and Nikoline Ostergaard (Third Team). In the history of the MAAC, only two teams prior to the 2014-15 Bobcats had four players earn All-Conference laurels, excluding the inclusion of the All-Rookie Team. During the 2015-16 season, Quinnipiac won 17 straight conference games after an 0-3 conference start to win the MAAC regular season crown, despite losing all five starters from the previous year's team. After losing its top

scorer in the conference semifinals, Quinnipiac fell to Iona, 57-41, in the championship game. Fabbri again earned MAAC Coach of the Year honors. Aryn McClure was named the Rookie of the Year. The Bobcats rebounded in the first round of the WNIT by throttling Maine, 90-44, the program's first national postseason tournament win in Division 1.

In 2016-17, Fabbri led the Bobcats on a thrilling ride to the Sweet 16, establishing one of the greatest single seasons by any program in school history. Behind the play of the Tournament's Most Outstanding Player Adily Martucci, the Bobcats beat Rider, 64-59, in the MAAC championship game.

Quinnipiac then became just the fourth No. 12 seed in NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Tournament history to advance to the Sweet 16. The Bobcats beat No. 25 Marquette, 68-65, in Miami to earn its first-ever NCAA Tournament victory. Two nights later, they upset No. 16 Miami, 85-78. The Cinderella story ended a week later when the Bobcats were done in by eventual NCAA Champion South Carolina 100-58 in Stockton, California. Quinnipiac, which finished 29-7, was voted No. 23 in the USA Today Coaches' Poll, its first-ever national ranking. In addition, Quinnipiac was voted the top mid-major program in the nation in the College Insider Mid-Major Poll, another first.

In the 2017-18 season, Fabbri led the Bobcats to a 28-6 record, an 18-0 mark in the MAAC, and a third MAAC title. They overcame Marist, 67-58, as Jen Fay was named the tournament's Most Outstanding Player. The No. 9 seed in the East Region, Quinnipiac beat Miami, 86-72, for a second consecutive year, before losing to No. 1 Connecticut in the second round. Fabbri was named the Coach of the Year for the third time.

The 2018-19 campaign featured Quinnipiac's eighth consecutive 20-win season. The 26-7 team posted its fourth undefeated season in MAAC play and won its third consecutive MAAC title and fourth overall when it thumped Marist, 81-51. Jen Fay was named the tournament's Most Outstanding Player for the second year. The Bobcats eventually fell to sixth-seeded South Dakota State, 76-65, at the Carrier Dome in Syracuse in the opening round of the NCAA Tournament. Fabbri won her fourth Coach of the Year honor.

During the 2020-21 season, Quinnipiac finished 13-8 and earned the second seed in the conference tournament. Mackenzie Dewees was named Quinnipiac's first MAAC Player of the Year and Mikala Morris was the third to be named Defensive Player of the Year.

In 2021-22, the Bobcats returned to the national postseason stage, advancing to the WNIT for the fifth time in program history. Quinnipiac finished with a 21-12 record - the program's 11th straight winning season - and defeated Rhode Island, to earn the program's fifth-ever win in a national postseason tournament and first since the 2018 season. The program earned WBCA Division I Academic Team honors, recording a 3.405 team GPA to rank 53rd of all Division I women's basketball programs.

Quinnipiac Women's Basketball enjoyed another impressive season in 2022-23, going 21-9 (16-4 MAAC) to earn a first-round bye in the league tournament. The Bobcats went 12-3 in Hamden and went on a 10-game unbeaten streak from Jan. 19 - Feb. 18 during MAAC play. The Bobcats saw three players earn All-MAAC honors, led by Mary Baskerville earning the title of 2022-23 MAAC Women's Basketball Sixth Player of the Year. Baskerville became the third player in program history to garner the distinction, joining former Bobcats Taylor Herd (2018-19) and Maria Napolitano (2014-15) to do so.

Senior Mikala Morris received All-MAAC status for the fourth consecutive season, earning a spot on the All-MAAC Second Team. Morris joined Aryn McClure as just the second player in the program's Div. I history to accomplish the feat of earning All-League status four times. Fellow senior Cur'Tiera Haywood earned Third Team All-MAAC honors, while first-year Ella O'Donnell was named to the MAAC All-Rookie Team after her first season with the Bobcats. Haywood earned All-MAAC Third Team honors after previously earning MAAC All-Rookie Team distinction as a first-year in 2019-20.

In 2023-24, the Bobcats were led by their young squad to the MAAC Postseason. Anna Foley earned All-MAAC Second Team honors, while she and Karson Martin were both named to the All-Rookie Team. Foley earned Rookie of the Week honors four times and was a one-time MAAC Player of the Week honoree.

The Bobcats got off to a flying start in the 2024-25 campaign, winning their first six games of the season before falling to ACC foe, Miami, in overtime. From there, the Bobcats won nine straight games, starting the season 15-1, their best start to a season in program history. Quinnipiac rolled into the MAAC Tournament with a 28-5 overall record and an 18-2 mark in conference play. The 18 MAAC wins were the program's most wins in conference play since the 2018-19 season. The Bobcats defeated the Iona Gaels in the MAAC Quarterfinals and downed the Merrimack Warriors in the MAAC Semifinal to reach the MAAC Title game for the first time since 2019. Despite a loss in the Championship game, the Bobcats earned the program's first invite to the WBIT.

After leading the Bobcats to their most wins (28) in a season since 2017-18 and their most wins in a conference slate (18) in six seasons, Fabbri was named the MAAC Coach of the Year for the fifth time in her coaching career.

First-year star Gal Raviv earned the conference's Rookie of the Year and Player of the Year award, the first time in the league's history a player has won both of those awards in the same season (men's or women's). Raviv's numbers were astonishing, averaging 18.0 points per game and becoming the first player since Jasmine Martin (2013-14) to reach the 500+ point threshold in a single season. Raviv was named MAAC Rookie of the Week eleven times, tying the record for the most Rookie of the Week awards in a single season.

Three Bobcats earned All-MAAC honors after the 2024-25 season. Gal Raviv was named to the All-MAAC First Team and All-Rookie Team, Anna Foley earned All-MAAC Second Team honors for the second straight season, and Jackie Grisdale was named to the All-MAAC Third Team. During her nine-year MAAC tenure, Fabbri and Quinnipiac have won four MAAC championships, three NCAA Tournament games, and two WNIT games. Quinnipiac has had a Player of the Year, a Defensive Player of the Year, a Rookie of the Year, and three Sixth Players of the Year. Quinnipiac has had 32 players selected to All-Conference teams, including seven first-team selections. She has been named conference Coach of the Year four times.

During her 15-year NEC tenure, Fabbri and Quinnipiac won one title. Fabbri coached one Player of the Year, one Rookie of the Year, two Defensive Players of the Year, and 28 All-Conference selections. Fabbri was named conference Coach of the Year three times.

Since joining NCAA Division I, Coach Fabbri has distinguished herself as a premier coach in the region. Fabbri and the Bobcats left the Northeast Conference in 2013 ranking second place all-time in career NEC regular-season wins (177) and overall NEC wins (187).

In 1998, Fabbri was inducted into the Fairfield University Athletic Hall of Fame. In 2002, she was also inducted into the Connecticut Women's Basketball Hall of Fame and the Delran (N.J.) High School Athletic Hall of Fame. In 2006, she was named to the MAAC 25th Anniversary Team. She was inducted into the Albert Carino Basketball Club of South Jersey Hall of Fame. That year, she also received the St. Clare Award at the 22nd Annual Franciscan Sports Banquet.

Fabbri served on the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Competition Committee from 2016-2018.

Fabbri and her husband, Paul, have three children: Carly, Armand, and Paul Henry.
