IONA HOSTS NIAGARA AT THE HYNES CENTER

The Iona College men's basketball team (7-15, 5-6 MAAC) looks to snap a four-game slide when they host Niagara (11-13, 4-7 MAAC) at the Hynes Center Sunday. The two teams complete the season series in the contest this afternoon.

IONA VS. NIAGARA - SERIES HISTORY

- Tonight's game is the 84th meeting between the two squads.
- Iona holds a 47-36 series advantage taking 14 of the 17 meetings under head coach Tim Cluess.
- Following four straight losses in 2006-07 and 2007-08, Iona is 17-5 in the last 22 meetings.
- The Purple Eagles are 18-19 on their home floor.
- The Gaels are winners of five straight and nine of last 10 meetings at the Gallagher Center.

SCOUTING NIAGARA (11-13, 4-7 MAAC)

- Senior forward Marvin Prochet (17.5 ppg), junior guard James Towns (11.8 ppg) and senior forward Dominic Robb (10.1 ppg) each average 10+ points.
- Prochet leads with 7.3 rpg and 61 3FG, Towns averages a team-best 3.9 apg while Robb leads the MAAC with 2.3 blocks per game.
- Sophomore guard Keleaf Tate is #4 in scoring (8.5 rpg) and #3 with 34 3FG.
- Niagara was picked to finish ninth in the MAAC preseason poll.

GAELS IN MAAC REGULAR SEASON PLAY

Since the inception of the MAAC in the 1981-82 season, Iona has compiled a **381-238 (.616)** record in regular season conference play. The Gaels' **381** wins and **.616** winning percentage are the highest of any current MAAC member. The Gaels became the first MAAC team to reach 375 wins with its win at Saint Peter's on Feb. 10, 2018, five seasons after reaching 300. Iona is currently **83** ahead of Manhattan, the No. 2 team on the list.

GAELS IN MAAC PLAY AT HOME

The Gaels finished 2017-18 with a 6-3 mark at home. Iona has won **36 of its last 47** MAAC regular season contests at the Hynes Center. Iona is **65-15 (.813)** in New Rochelle under head coach Tim Cluess. The Gaels overall record in home conference games is an outstanding **216-88 (.711)**.

20+ POINT EFFORTS

- Four Iona players (Crawford, Gist, Agee, McGill) have combined for 24 20+ point efforts this season, the most in the MAAC.
- Quinnipiac ranks No. 2 with 19 (Young, Kelly, Rigoni). Niagara (16), Saint Peter's (12) and Siena (11) round out the top 5.
- Quinnipiac's Cameron Young's 13 games with 20 or more points leads the MAAC individual list.
- Iona's **E.J. Crawford** is one ahead of Niagara's Marvin Prochet in second with 11.

TOUGH STRETCH

- For just the second time in nine seasons under head coach Tim Cluess Iona has dropped four straight MAAC regular season contests.
- In 2011, the Gaels followed four straight losses by four points or less with a nine-game winning streak, and a MAAC final appearance.
- Iona's last three losses have been by a combined total of seven points.

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

- Iona is a 5-3 at home following a 51-day stretch away from the Hynes Center, a span of nine contests in the non-conference season.
- The Gaels played four neutral site games and five true road games.

ROAD WOES

Iona has dropped 11 of its last 12 road contests, its lone win coming at Canisius in early January. The win snapped an eight-game road losing streak dating back to the final two MAAC regular season road contests last season. It was the longest since a seven-game slide spanning the 2012-13 and 2013-14 campaigns.

GAELS PICKED THIRD IN PRESEASON POLL

- Iona was selected to finish third in the MAAC Coaches Poll coming off a fourth-place finish in the regular season, a MAAC tournament title and the loss of 10 performers from the 2017-18 season.
- The Gaels have won MAAC Regular Season Championships in three of head coach Tim Cluess' eight seasons (2011-12, 2013-14 and 2014-15).

WHO'S BACK?

- Iona returns just two performers from the 2017-18 MAAC Championship campaign: senior **Rickey McGill** and junior **E.J. Crawford**.
- The Maroon & Gold also return red shirt freshman **Andrija Ristanovic** who sat out the 2017-18 campaign with an injury.

WHAT'S NEW?

- Nine new faces highlight the 2017-18 Iona men's basketball roster.
- Junior transfers **Asante Gist** (Eastern Kentucky) and **Isaiah Still** (Robert Morris) came to New Rochelle last season and sat out due to NCAA transfer regulations.
- Additional junior transfers **Tajuan Agee**, **Jahnathan Maxwell**, **Niksa Nikolic** and **Ben Perez** join the squad with two years of eligibility.
- True freshman and local product **Payton Hudson** joins **Ristanovic** making their collegiate debut.
- Junior **Isaiah Ross** transferred from UMKC and will sit out the 2018-19 campaign.

20/20 VISION

- With its win over Fairfield in the 2018 MAAC championship game, Iona recorded its ninth straight and 22nd all-time 20+ win seasons in the 76-year history of the program.
- It extended a program record for consecutive 20+ win seasons, surpassing the previous high of four straight from 1981-85.
- Tim Cluess is the only (of 12 all-time) head coach in program history to earn 20 wins in each of his first eight seasons in New Rochelle. He is also the Iona coach to boast more than four 20+ win seasons as the leader of the Maroon & Gold (Pat Kennedy, 4).

NINE STRAIGHT 20-WIN SEASONS

- The Gaels continued their unprecedented run of 20-win seasons in MAAC history. The nine-year stretch more than doubles the previous MAAC mark of four set by the Maroon & Gold from 1981-85 and matched by La Salle (1986-90) and Siena (2006-10).
- In MAAC history, consecutive 20+ win streaks have happened only 17 times.
- Iona has recorded 19 of its 22 20+ win seasons as a member of the MAAC, the most of any league member. Siena has posted 12, Manhattan nine and Saint Peter's eight.

MILLENNIA MEN

- Junior **E.J. Crawford** became the 41st player in Iona men's basketball history to record 1,000 career points in a 20-point effort at Canisius
- Senior **Rickey McGill** was the 40th with 16 points at VCU on Dec. 1 earlier this season.
- They are the 10th and 11th players under Tim Cluess to reach the mark.
- In eight-plus seasons, Cluess has mentored more than 1/4 of Iona's all-time 1,000 point scorers.

KING OF THE HILL, TOP OF THE LIST

• No team among the 14 NYC Metropolitan Area Division I basketball programs within 30 miles of the center of NY College basketball, Madison Square Garden has won more games than Iona College in the last 23+ seasons (443; Hofstra #2, 418).

• Iona's 20 wins were the third most and .606 winning percentage was the fourth highest in 2017-18 in the Metro Area.

• Since head coach **Tim Cluess** took the reins in 2010-11, Iona's 189 wins and .641 win percentage are also the best in both categories. (Seton Hall, 163 wins; Wagner, .581 win pct.)

• Since 1995-96, the Maroon & Gold hold the lead in wins (443), 25 more than Hofstra, 41 more than No. 3 Seton Hall and the top win percentage (.587).

• Iona's eight postseason appearances (five NCAA, two NIT, one CIT) since 2010-11 are the most during the time frame, twice as many as LIU Brooklyn (4 NCAA), Seton Hall (3 NCAA, 1 NIT) and St. John's (two NCAA, two NIT).

ABOUT CONFERENCE TOURNAMENT TITLES

• Iona is one of four NCAA Division I programs to capture its last three straight conference tournament championships, joining Gonzaga (six straight), Kentucky (four straight) and South Dakota State (three straight).

• Only eight programs have won at least four tournament titles in the last seven seasons. Iona's four during the time frame is only eclipsed by Gonzaga (7), New Mexico State (6) and San Diego State (5) while matching the mark of Harvard, Kentucky, Stephen F. Austin, and Texas Southern.

ABOUT NCAA TOURNAMENT APPEARANCES

• 37 of the 351 NCAA Division I programs have appeared in at least five of the last seven NCAA Tournaments. Only four of the 37 have come from mid-major conferences (Gonzaga [7], Iona [5], New Mexico State [6] and South Dakota State [5]).

• 21 teams in the 2018 NCAA Tournament have also appeared in the 2016 and 2017 brackets, the last three-in-a-row. Only Gonzaga, Iona and South Dakota State can stake the claim among members of mid-major conferences.

EFFICIENT, EFFECTIVE, AND FAST PACED

• Iona currently ranks No. 142 in the nation on Ken Pomeroy's Adjusted Offensive Efficiency (105.9) through 22 games, but have been a perennial top 80 team under **Tim Cluess**.

• Offensive Efficiency is measured by calculating the amount of points a team would score in 100 possessions. Ken Pomeroy's formula adjusts for the quality of opposing defenses, the site of each game, and when each game was played.

• Iona ranks No. 91 (52.8%) in Effective FG%.

• EFG% adjusts for the fact that a three-point field goal is worth one more point than a two-point field goal.

• The Gaels are also 24th "fastest pace" team in the country, averaging 72.3 possessions per game.

MCGILL NAMED MAAC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

• Senior **Rickey McGill** was the leader of the Maroon & Gold offense in its 2-0 start to MAAC play.

• McGill averaged 22.0 ppg, 4.0 rpg, 6.0 apg and 4.0 spg. He shot 58.3% from the floor and 57.1% from beyond the arc.

• McGill became the 50th Gael to earn a MAAC weekly honor in eight-plus seasons under head coach but the first since **Jordan Washington** on Jan. 2, 2018, just over two years ago.

CLOSE SHAVES

• After playing 15 games decided by five points or less last season (8-6), 10 of Iona's 22 contests in 2018-19 have been (2-8) closely contested.

• The school record is 16 games, reached in 2012-13 and 2004-05.

• In 2014-15, the Gaels recorded an 11-4 mark in close games, earning the most wins in program history.

• Iona has recorded four seasons with 15 or more games decided by five or less points, three of them under head coach Tim Cluess, with a 27-28 mark.

HIGH SCORING AFFAIRS

• Iona has reached 100 points 17 times in eight-plus seasons under head coach Tim Cluess, including a single-season program record four times in 2011-12.

• Iona is 13-4 under Cluess and 53-6 all-time when scoring 100 or more.

• The Gaels scored 90 or more points 62 times in 290 (21.3%) games under Cluess and are 50-12.

• Iona is 116-34 when reaching at least 80 points under Cluess

CLUESS RANKS SECOND ALL-TIME IN WINS

- With Iona's win in the 2016 MAAC Championship over Monmouth, head coach **Tim Cluess** became No. 2 on Iona's all-time coaching wins list, surpassing Goal Club Hall of Famer **Jeff Ruland's** mark of 139 over nine seasons.
- Cluess has led Iona to **116 MAAC regular season wins** through eight-plus seasons, **the third most in conference history** behind former Siena/Loyola head coach Jimmy Patsos (132 in 14 seasons) and former Niagara skipper Joe Mihalich (166 in 15 seasons).

LET IT RAIN

- Since 2000-01, Iona has produced **135** games with 10 or more three-point field goals. Five came in the seven seasons under head coach **Jeff Ruland** and seven came with **Kevin Willard** at the helm (three years).
- Under **Tim Cluess**, Iona has posted **125** games (22 in 2013-14, 18 in 2014-15, 15 in 2015-16, 20 in 2016-17, 14 in 2017-18) with double-digit trifectas including **nine** this season.
- The Gaels shattered a school record with 24 3FG on Nov. 26 vs. Delaware State, beating the previous mark of 18, reached twice (at Albany, Nov. 23, 2010; vs. Liberty, Dec. 18, 2012).
- The Maroon & Gold set its No. 2 total of 20 3FG made in an 82-68 win at Holy Cross on Dec. 19, 2017. The first 10 field goals made in the contest were from distance as the team set a first half program record with 12 in the win.
- **Iona's top 25 three-point field goal efforts have come with Cluess as head coach.**
- Against Liberty, Iona's 41 three-point attempts set a new standard. No. 2 was 40 vs. Fairfield this season and No. 3 came in a 24-for-39 effort vs. Delaware State.

- Through **22 games** this season, Iona has made a three-pointer in **352** straight and **800** out of its last **802** games. The school record is 385 straight from Jan. 5, 1994 - Dec. 16, 2006.
- The Gaels have failed to hit a three-pointer in just 18 of their **1,028** games played since the line was adopted for the 1986-87 season.

SERIES SUCCESS

- Iona has lost only two MAAC regular season series in eight-plus seasons under head coach Tim Cluess.
- The Gaels have won 35 series and tied 33 since the 2010-11 season.
- Prior to Monmouth snapping the streak in 2016-17, the last time Iona went 0-2 against a MAAC opponent in the regular season was vs. eventual MAAC champion Siena in 2009-10.

WIDE MARGINS

- The Gaels are **109-33** in games decided by 10 or more points since head coach **Tim Cluess** took the reins in 2010-11.
- After winning 81 of the first 99 double-digit decisions in his first six seasons (81-18, .818), Iona is 27-15 (.643) since 2016-17.
- During the MAAC regular season, the program is **70-6 (.921)** in MAAC regular season games decided by 10 or more points under Cluess.
- In 12 seasons as an NCAA head coach, Cluess has lost just 14 games by 15 or more points.
- Iona's 126-76 win over Delaware State was the second 50+ point victory in program history and first since the 1967-68 (46 years) campaign.
- In his 12+ seasons as an NCAA coach, Cluess has mentored his team to a **171-35** mark in 10+ point contests.

RICHIE GUERIN'S #14 HANGS IN THE RAFTERS

- Iona honored the legacy of **Richie Guerin '54** by retiring his number 14 on Jan. 31, 2014 the first ever in school history.
- Guerin is an Iona College Goal Club (1983), Marine Corps Sports (2004), and Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame (2013) inductee who starred for the Maroon & Gold from 1951-1954.
- He rewrote the basketball record books at Iona, scoring 1,375 points and graduated as the leading scorer in school history.
- A two-time All-Metropolitan selection with the Gaels, he scored a then school-record 40 points against John Carroll in 1954 and was the first Gael to score 40 or more points in a game.
- Following his playing days at Iona, Guerin played with the National Basketball Association's New York Knicks from 1956-1963 and was a player-coach of the St. Louis/Atlanta Hawks franchise for nine years.
- In 13 years as a professional player, Guerin accumulated 14,676 points (17.3 per game), 4,278 rebounds (5.1 per game), and 4,211 assists (5.0 per game) over 848 games.

GAEL GREATS

In addition to Naismith Hall of Famer **Richie Guerin '54**, here are additional significant names in Iona basketball history:

- **Jim Valvano** - legendary head coach at Iona from 1975-80 who "Dared To Dream" to win a national championship with the Gaels and finally did in 1983, albeit with North Carolina State. Succumbed to cancer in 1993 eight weeks after an impassioned speech at the ESPY Awards that year which in which he announced creation of The V Foundation for Cancer Research and its motto, "Don't Give Up... Don't Ever Give Up."
- **Jeff Ruland '91** - All-American during his time at Iona and, two-time NBA All-Star with the Washington Bullets, Philadelphia 76ers and Detroit Pistons. Following his career, returned to Iona and served as head coach from 1998-2007 where he won three MAAC Championships.
- **Pat Kennedy** - head coach from 1980-86. Went on to coach at Florida State, DePaul, Montana, and Towson following a highly successful tenure in New Rochelle. He was most recently head coach at Div. II Pace University in Pleasantville, NY, located 19 miles North of Iona.
- **Warren Isaac '65** - Iona's only 50-point scorer, Isaac played six seasons in Europe following his tenure at Iona. A New York City school legend, Isaac started for Power Memorial paving the way for NBA Hall of Famer Kareem Abdul-Jabbar a 1965 graduate of the high school.
- **Tim Welsh** - head coach from 1995-98 who went on to coach in the Big East with Providence for 10 seasons. Currently an ESPN college basketball analyst. Holds the highest career winning percentage ever at Iona.
- **Kevin Willard** - Iona coach from 2007-10, now head coach at Big East's Seton Hall. Helped turn around a program which won two games in the season prior to his arrival to 20 wins in his final season in Maroon & Gold.
- **Steve Burtt '84 & Steve Burtt '06** - All-time NCAA father/son scoring leaders, both netting over 2,000 career points. Burtt, the father, had a four-season NBA career and most notably appeared off the bench for the Phoenix Suns in the 1992 NBA Playoffs. He was inducted into the prestigious NYC Basketball Hall of Fame this past fall. Burtt, the son, continues to play professionally in Europe.
- **Sean Green '91** - Played 84 NBA games over three seasons for the Indiana Pacers, Philadelphia 76ers and Utah Jazz from 1991-94. Currently a high school basketball coach in Southern California.

- **Scott Machado '12** - The last Gael to appear in an NBA game. Machado played in regular season NBA contests in 2012-13 with the Houston Rockets and postseason with the Golden State Warriors. The MAAC & Iona's all-time assist leader. He currently plays professionally in the NBA G-League.
- **Bob Santini '53** - Iona's first NBA player, appeared in four games with the New York Knicks in 1955-56.

NOTABLE ALUMNI (ATHLETICS/POP CULTURE)

- **Ignacio Maganto** - was selected by the LA Galaxy with the 21st pick in the first round of the 2015 MLS SuperDraft, the first Major League Soccer draft pick in Iona history. Maganto scored his first MLS goal with the Galaxy in the spring of 2015.
- **Jason Motte** - Major League Baseball relief pitcher recorded the final out of the 2011 World Series with the world champion St. Louis Cardinals. Has also appeared in Major League games with the Chicago Cubs, Colorado Rockies and Atlanta Braves.
- **Dennis Leonard** - Kansas City Royals Hall of Famer and 12-year MLB veteran who won 20 games on three occasions from 1977-80. He was inducted in May 2015 into the New York Baseball Hall of Fame.
- **Mariano Rivera III '15** - Earned his degree in May 2015 and was selected in the fourth round by the Washington Nationals.
- **Jared Finkel** - Drafted by the Minnesota Twins in 2017, was a Midwest League (Class A) All-Star in 2018 for the Cedar Rapids Kernels.
- **Don McLean** - Singer-songwriter noted most famous for his 1971 single "American Pie".
- **Kyle Flood '93** - Former head football coach at Rutgers University.
- **Brendan Malone '62** - Current Detroit Pistons assistant coach.
- **Amanda Saccomanno '13** - World Wrestling Entertainment's (WWE) Mandy Rose, competes on the SmackDown brand.
- **Maggie Timoney '89** - The Iona women's basketball Hall of Famer recently became the first female CEO of Heineken USA.

Here is the weekly review of the top performing Gaels alumni, who are currently playing pro basketball.

- 1. Sean Armand** (6'5"-SG-91, graduated '14, plays pro in Russia) was the major contributor in a Zenit Sankt Petersburg's victory against the closely-ranked Khimki (12-3) 86-82 in the VTB United League last Sunday. He scored 15 points and added 3 assists in 27 minutes. Zenit Sankt Petersburg (9-5) is placed fifth in the VTB United League. It was his team's fourth consecutive victory in a row. Armand has relatively good stats this year 13.5ppg, 2.5rpg and 3.5apg in two games he played so far.
- 2. Lamont Jones** (6'0"-PG-90, graduated '13, plays in Germany) could not help MHP RIESEN Ludwigsburg (3-9) in their last game on Saturday. Despite Jones' very good performance MHP RIESEN Ludwigsburg was defeated 83-78 on the road by the lower-ranked Telekom Baskets (#11). He was the second best scorer with 16 points. Jones has relatively good stats this season 13.7ppg, 2.5rpg and 3.1apg.
- 3. TK Edogi** (6'8"-F-94, graduated '18, currently in Turkey) led Sakarya Buyuksehir Basketbol to a victory against the closely-ranked Buyukcekmece (6-10) 73-69 in the Turkish BSL in Sunday night's game. Edogi scored 12 points and grabbed 5 rebounds in a mere 16 minutes. Sakarya Buyuksehir Basketbol (5-11) is placed 13th in the BSL. It was his team's first victory after nine consecutive losses. This year Edogi averages 10.0ppg and 5.2rpg in six games. He is a naturalized Nigerian.
- 4. Steven Burt** (6'3"-G-84, graduated '06, plays pro in Greece) was not able to help Cretan Kings (3-13) in their last game on Saturday. Despite his very good performance Cretan Kings was badly defeated 82-62 in Athens by the much higher-ranked AEK (#4). Burt was the top scorer with 15 points. He also added 3 steals. It's Burt's first season with the team. Burt has individually a very good year with high stats. He averages 18.1ppg, 2.3rpg and 3.4apg. Burt is a naturalized Ukrainian.
- 5. Jan Svandrlik** (6'6"-F-94, graduated '18, currently in Czech Republic) contributed to a BK Opava's victory against the third-ranked NH Ostrava 120-108 in the Czech Republic NBL in Saturday night's game. He recorded 16 points, 9 rebounds and 3 assists. This season Svandrlik averages 7.8ppg, 3.5rpg and 1.2apg.
- 6. Kiril Wachsmann** (6'8"-C-84, graduated '06, plays pro in Uruguay) couldn't help Olimpia (15-8) in their last game. Despite his good performance Olimpia lost 82-92 in a derby game to the leading Nacional. Wachsmann had a double-double by scoring 10 points and getting 14 rebounds in 36 minutes. Wachsmann has relatively good stats this year 12.1ppg, 10.0rpg and 1.8apg in 23 games. He has also Uruguayan citizenship.
- 7. Scott Machado** (6'1"-G-90, graduated '12, plays in the NBA G League) helped South Bay Lakers win their game against the Texas Legends crushing them 148-114 in the NBA G League on Saturday night. Machado recorded 14 points, 6 assists and 3 steals (made all of his five free throws). Machado has relatively good stats this season 14.0ppg, 3.4rpg and 7.0apg. He is a naturalized Brazilian.
- 8. Aaron Rountree III** (6'8"-F-93, graduated '16, currently in Qatar) led Qatar Sports Club Doha to a victory over one of league's weakest teams Al Rayyan 76-66 in a derby game in the Qatari D1 in Wednesday night's game. He was MVP of the game. Rountree III had a double-double by scoring 18 points and getting the same number of rebounds. He also added 6 assists, 2 blocks and 3 steals in 40 minutes. Rountree III has relatively good stats this year 13.8ppg, 10.7rpg, 6.3apg, 2.2bpg and 2.6spg in 15 games.
- 9. Tariq Kirksay** (6'7"-F-79, graduated '00, plays pro in France) helped FOS Provence Basket win their game against the sixth-ranked Limoges CSP Elite 87-72 in the French Jeep ELITE last Saturday. Kirksay recorded 10 points and grabbed 4 rebounds. This season Kirksay averages 6.7ppg, 2.7rpg and 1.7apg. He is a naturalized French.

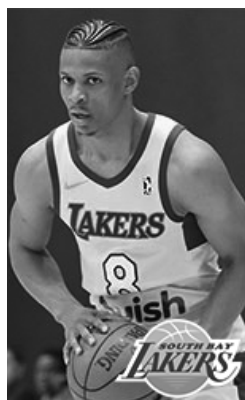

- Tim Cluess was named 12th head coach of the Iona College men's basketball program on April 8, 2010 and returns for his ninth season with the Gaels.

- Came to New Rochelle with an impressive 20-year coaching resume after spending four seasons as head coach at LIU Post in Brookville, NY.

- One thing can be said, he is a winner. After spending 14 years as head coach at St. Mary's High School in Manhasset, NY, he spent the five years prior to arriving at Iona in the college ranks at Suffolk Community College and LIU Post.

- He amassed a 120-33 record and had unprecedented success at both schools.

- When combining his high school record, Cluess has won nearly 75 percent of his games coached.

- Has led the Gaels to 20+ wins in each of his first eight seasons in New Rochelle, the only coach in school history to accomplish the feat. The Gaels won 25 games in three of them.

- Iona has appeared in eight straight postseason tournaments including a Collegelnsider.com Postseason Tournament championship game appearance in 2011, the NCAA First Round in 2012 with the MAAC's second ever at-large bid into the NCAA Tournament, the 2013 NCAA Second Round, the 2014 and 2015 National Invitation Tournaments before returning to the 2016, 2017 and 2018 NCAA Tournaments.

- The Gaels were crowned MAAC Tournament Champions in 2013, 2016, 2017 and 2018 and MAAC Regular Season Champions in 2012, 2014 and 15. The Cluess-led program set a school record with 17 conference wins in 2013-14 and 2014-15.

- Cluess was named MAAC Coach of the Year following the 2013-14 campaign.

- Under Cluess, Iona has consistently been among the top scoring teams in the nation. The Gaels finished 13th in 2010-11, first in both 2011-12 and 2012-13, fourth in 2013-14, fifth in 2014-15 and 27th in 2015-16 and Top 50 in 2016-17 and 2017-18.

- In each of his eight seasons at Iona, the team's scoring averages rank in the Top 12 in school history including a school record 83.6 points per game during the 2013-14 season.

• Machado is one of several Iona Gaels to have played for Cluess to continue their playing careers in the professional ranks including: **Sean Armand**, **Vangelis Bebis**, **Taylor Bessick**, **Tre Bowman**, **Sam Cassell Jr.**, **Randy Dezouvre**, **TK Edogi**, **A.J. English**, **Mike Glover**, **Jayon James**, **Ra'Shad James**, **Lamont Jones**, **David Laury**, **Zach Lewis**, **Deyshonee Much**, **Ibn Muhammad**, **Chris Pelcher**, **Taaj Ridley**, **Alejo Rodriguez**, **Aaron Rountree**, **Jon Severe**, **Jan Svandrlík**, **Jordan Washington**, and **Isaiah Williams**.

• Prior to Iona, Cluess' LIU Post Pioneers earned a 23-6 overall record in his last season, earning victories in 19 of their last 21 contests. The squad earned its fourth straight berth in the East Coast Conference championship game. Cluess was named the ECC Co-Coach of the Year for the third straight time.

• In 2008-09, LIU Post had its finest season in history, setting a school record with 30 victories. Standing among the top 10 teams in the nation from January through March in 2009, the Pioneers were ranked as high as No. 2 that year.

• The squad posted an undefeated regular season, winning all 24 games for the first time in school history. LIU Post won its second straight ECC regular season and tournament championship titles and defeated Bentley in overtime in front of thousands on their home court to win the NCAA East Region Championship title and advance to the Elite Eight Tournament in Springfield, Mass.

• For his outstanding efforts, Cluess was named the Basketball Times Division II Co-Coach of the Year as well as Metropolitan Basketball Writers Association Division II Coach of the Year for the second straight season.

• The 2007-08 season saw Cluess' squad post a 26-5 overall record, including an 18-2 clip in the conference. LIU Post claimed its first regular season and conference titles since the 2003-04 season with a 60-57 win to advance to the NCAA Northeast Regional at Bentley College. He was voted the ECC Coach of the Year by his peers, and was named the MWBA Division II Coach of the Year.

• In 2006-07, his first year at the helm, Cluess guided the Pioneers to a 19-11 record and an

appearance in the ECC Championship game. He improved the team's win total by six from the season before he took over the program.

• Cluess was named the eighth head men's basketball coach in the 50-year history of the Pioneers' program in April of 2006, after spending the 2005-06 campaign as the head men's basketball coach at Suffolk Community College in Brentwood, NY. He led a team of eight players to a 22-10 record overall, as well as a Region XV championship and a fourth-place finish in the NJCAA Division III Tournament. The trip to the national tournament was the first in the Longhorns' history, and Cluess was tabbed the District 5 Coach of the Year.

• Prior to his ascent to the college ranks, Cluess was a standout head coach at St. Mary's High School in Manhasset, NY from 1991-05, where the Gaels went a remarkable 264-78 (.772) during his tenure.

• St. Mary's won a record eight consecutive Nassau-Suffolk CHSAA league championships from 1997-98 to 2004-05. In that final season with Cluess as their mentor, the Gaels went 25-1 and finished the season ranked in the Top 20 nationally after holding the No. 1 ranking for eight weeks of the campaign.

• Cluess helped develop more than 50 players who moved on to the collegiate and professional ranks at St. Mary's including former North Carolina standout and current San Antonio Spur Danny Green.

• He won four state titles and two Federation championships at the Manhasset school. Cluess was a seven-time coach of the year in the high school ranks and earned tournament wins in national tournaments such as the Beach Ball Classic and the Las Vegas Prep Classic.

• Cluess played professional basketball in Europe and Australia after a collegiate career at both St. John's and Hofstra.

• He attended St. John's from 1978-81, before completing his coursework at Hofstra from 1982-83.

• Cluess holds a bachelor's degree in Accounting from Hofstra and currently resides in Floral Park, N.Y. with his wife, Karen, and their two children – Kevin, 22 and T.J., 20.
