The Holy Cross men's basketball team returns to action on Sunday, Dec. 30, when it travels to Iona for a 1:00 p.m. game. The contest between the Crusaders and the Gaels will be shown live on ESPN+, and can be heard on WEEI 1440 AM in Worcester.

Holy Cross is off to an 8-4 start this season and has won seven of its last nine games. The Crusaders are coming off a 60-57 victory over Siena on Dec. 22. Holy Cross currently leads the Patriot League in scoring defense (65.5 points per game), assists (17.8 assists per game), turnover margin (+3.8 turnovers per game) and assist-to-turnover ratio (1.7-to-1).

Sophomore guard **Jacob Grandison** has led the team by averaging 15.0 points, 5.1 rebounds and 3.5 assists per game, while sophomore guard **Austin Butler** has added 12.0 points and 4.5 boards per contest. Four other Crusaders are averaging at least six points, led by sophomore guard **Caleb Green** (11.5 points per game).

Iona stands 2-8 overall this year and has lost its last six games. The Gaels are coming off a 99-84 loss to Yale on Dec. 22. Junior guard E.J. Crawford has led the team by averaging 16.6 points and 5.0 rebounds per game, while hitting 80.4 percent of his free throws. Senior guard Rickey McGill (13.0 points per game), junior forward Tajuan Agee (11.4 points per game) and junior guard Asante Gist (10.4 points per game) are also scoring in double figures. Iona is led by head coach Tim Cluess, who stands 184-100 in his ninth season with the Gaels.

After the contest at Iona, the Crusaders will open Patriot League play with a 7:00 p.m. game at Loyola (Md.) on Thursday, Jan. 3.

**THE SERIES WITH IONA:** This will be the 32nd meeting between the Crusaders and the Gaels on the hardwood, with Iona leading the all-time series tied 16-15. The teams have played only four times since Holy Cross left the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference following the 1989-1990 season, splitting those games. From 1984-1990, Iona went 10-8 against Holy Cross when the schools were MAAC foes. For games played in New Rochelle, the Gaels hold an 8-2 advantage. The schools first met on Dec. 20, 1974, with Holy Cross posting an 87-46 victory at the Worcester Auditorium.

**BUTLER COMING OFF ALL-ROOKIE SEASON:** Sophomore guard **Austin Butler** is once again among the Crusaders' top players on the perimeter this season, after being selected to the Patriot League All-Rookie team in 2017-2018. On the year, he is averaging 12.0 points, 4.5 rebounds and 1.3 steals per game, while making 40.0 percent of his shots from three-point range. During the victory over Siena, Butler led the team with 18 points and five rebounds. Previously against Rhode Island, he totaled 14 points and two steals. Butler also had a big game against Fairleigh Dickinson, posting 14 points, seven rebounds and three steals. A few of his other top games this year have come against Sacred Heart (26 points), Stony Brook (21 points, three assists) and Siena (12 points, career-high 11 rebounds, five assists). In 29 games played last year, Butler averaged 9.8 points and 3.7 rebounds. He was even more impressive in Patriot League regular season play, averaging 11.5 points and 4.6 boards against conference foes. Over the course of his collegiate career, Butler has now totaled 439 points, 164 rebounds, 54 assists and 39 steals, while hitting 34.9 percent of his shots from three-point range (59 of 169).

#### GRANDISON PLAYS KEY MINUTES ON THE PERIMETER:

Sophomore guard **Jacob Grandison** is once again a key part of the Holy Cross rotation this season. In 12 games played, he has averaged a team-best 15.0 points, 5.1 rebounds and 3.5 assists, while hitting 78.6 percent of his foul shots. During the victory over Siena, Grandison posted 14 points, seven rebounds and three assists. Previously against Canisius, he totaled 15 points, seven rebounds and six assists. Grandison also played well at Massachusetts, leading the team with 20 points, four rebounds, three assists and two steals. A few of his other top performances this year have come against Siena (career-high 24 points, four assists, three rebounds), against Stony Brook (21 points, a career-high 10 assists, eight rebounds), at Harvard (21 points, four rebounds, three assists), at Providence (17 points, seven rebounds, three steals), at Albany (17 points, three rebounds, three assists), against Fairleigh Dickinson (13 points, seven rebounds) and at No. 19 Michigan (12 points, five boards, three assists). In 31 games played last year, Grandison averaged 9.0 points and 4.5 rebounds, while hitting 74.1 percent of his free throws. During his career with the Crusaders, he has now totaled 458 points, 202 rebounds, 103 assists and 36 steals.

#### HOLY CROSS STAYS STRONG ON DEFENSE:

The Crusaders are once again among the top defensive teams in the Patriot League this season. In 12 games played, Holy Cross has allowed a Patriot League-low 65.5 points per contest while holding the opposition to 30.1 percent shooting from three-point range and blocking 3.8 shots per contest. Last season, the Crusaders held their opponents to 67.7 points per game on 43.1 percent shooting from the field, while forcing 12.9 turnovers and blocking 3.4 shots per game. Holy Cross was even more effective on the defensive end during Patriot League play in 2017-2018, allowing just 65.7 points per contest on 42.3 percent shooting against conference foes.

### SIENA RECAP

Austin Butler totaled 18 points and five rebounds to lead Holy Cross to a 60-57 victory over Siena at the Hart Center at the Luth Athletic Complex on Dec. 22, 2018. After trailing 47-37 with 11:48 left to play in the second half, the Crusaders outscored Siena 17-2 over the next 6:09 to take a 54-49 lead. Butler hit a pair of three-pointers to begin that run, while the Saints made just one of seven field goal attempts. The score stayed close the rest of the way, and Siena would pull back in front (57-56) with 2:17 to go on a three-pointer by Kevin Degan. A layup by Butler with 1:15 remaining gave Holy Cross the lead for good, then Caleb Green scored with just 23.4 seconds on the clock to make the score 60-57. The Saints would have one last possession, but Jalen Pickett's three-point attempt was off the mark in the closing seconds as the Crusaders pulled out the win. Holy Cross had opened the game by jumping out to an early 5-0 lead, and was later up 21-17 with 6:57 left before the break. Siena then went on a 14-1 run to pull in front, and would hold a 31-26 advantage heading into the locker room. The Saints then extended their lead to 10 points early in the second half, before the Crusaders rallied for the victory. Jehyve Floyd finished the game with 14 points, eight rebounds and five assists, while hitting seven of 11 field goal attempts. Jacob Grandison posted 14 points, seven rebounds and three assists, and Green finished with 12 points and five assists. Evan Fisher led Siena with 17 points and nine rebounds. Holy Cross made 54.3 percent of its field goal attempts and 53.8 percent of its three-pointers on the day, while committing just eight turnovers. The Saints hit just 42.6 percent of their shots from the floor and 27.3 percent of their attempts from beyond the arc.

**FLOYD DOMINATES DOWN LOW:** Senior forward **Jehyve Floyd** is once again among the top players in the Patriot League this year. In 12 games played, he has averaged 8.6 points, 5.8 rebounds, 3.8 assists and 2.8 blocked shots, while hitting 62.7 percent of his field goal attempts. During the victory over Siena, Floyd recorded 14 points, eight rebounds and five assists. Previously against Canisius, he posted 15 points, seven rebounds, five blocks, three assists and two steals. Floyd also played well at Massachusetts, totaling 14 points, seven rebounds and four assists. A few of his other top games this year have come against Fairleigh Dickinson (12 points, career-high 13 rebounds, six blocks, four assists), at Albany (12 points, six assists, six blocks, five rebounds), against Stony Brook (10 points, eight rebounds, seven blocks, five assists) and against Sacred Heart (nine points, five rebounds, career-best 11 assists). In 2017-2018, Floyd was named the Patriot League Defensive Player of the Year, in addition to being selected to the All-Patriot League third team, the Patriot League All-Defensive team and the All-Patriot League Tournament team. Last season, he averaged 12.2 points, 5.6 rebounds and 2.2 blocks while hitting 66.8 percent of his shots from the floor. Over the course of his collegiate career, Floyd has totaled 634 points, 338 rebounds, 146 blocks, 134 assists and 65 steals, while hitting 64.2 percent of his field goal attempts (280 of 436).

**SHARING THE ROCK:** Holy Cross has been an excellent passing team so far this season. The Crusaders currently lead the Patriot League with an average of 17.8 assists per game and a 1.7-to-1 assist-to-turnover ratio. Overall this year, Holy Cross has recorded an assist on 69.6 percent of its made field goals (213 of 306), a mark that ranks first in all of Division I through games of Dec. 26. Sophomore guard **Caleb Green** currently leads the team with 48 assists, followed by senior forward **Jehyve Floyd** (46 assists), sophomore forward **Jacob Grandison** (42 assists) and senior guard **Patrick Benzan** (36 assists).

**PROTECTING THE BALL:** Holy Cross has done an excellent job of protecting the ball so far this year. The Crusaders have averaged a Patriot League-low 10.7 turnovers per game this season while posting single-digit turnovers five times. Holy Cross gave the ball away just five times in the first meeting with Siena, while posting six turnovers against Stony Brook and eight in the second Siena game. This should come as no surprise, as the Crusaders have had the fewest turnovers in the Patriot League during three of the last four seasons. In 2014-2015, Holy Cross set a school single-season record for the fewest turnovers per game (10.9).

Schadrac Casimir totaled 22 points and five assists to lead Iona to an 82-68 victory over the Crusaders at the Hart Center at the Luth Athletic Complex on Dec. 19, 2017. The Gaels made a Hart Center-record 20 three-point field goals on the night, with five different players making at least three treys. Iona hit 54.1 percent of its shots from behind the arc, while making 51.9 percent of its field goal attempts overall. Holy Cross was able to connect on 45.6 percent of its shots from the floor and 40.0 percent from three-point range. Jacob Grandison led the Crusaders with a career-high 14 points and two rebounds on the night. Austin Butler added 12 points, two rebounds and two assists, while Jehyve Floyd pulled down a career-high 10 rebounds to go along with nine points. Holy Cross opened the game by jumping out to an early 7-3 lead, and was still up by three (12-9) with 11 minutes left in the first half.

Iona then went on a 21-8 run to claim a 10-point advantage (30-20), with its first 30 points of the game all coming on three-pointers. The Gaels eventually extended their lead to 15 points (38-23) heading into the locker room at halftime. Iona went up by as many as 19 points early in the second half, and was up 52-34 with 15 minutes left in regulation. The Crusaders then used an 11-2 run to get back into the game, and trailed by just nine (54-45) at the 10-minute mark. But the Gaels scored the next eight points to regain control, and went on to post a 14-point victory. The 32 combined three-pointers made by Holy Cross and Iona set another Hart Center record.

**TRADITION OF EXCELLENCE:** This year marks the 100th season of Holy Cross men's basketball. The Crusaders own an overall record of 1,410-992, while making 26 postseason tournament appearances — 13 trips to the NCAA Tournament, 12 to the National Invitation Tournament and one to the CollegeInsider.com Tournament. In the history of collegiate basketball, Holy Cross is one of only 16 schools to have won the NCAA Tournament (1946-1947) as well as the National Invitational Tournament (1953-1954). Throughout its history, Holy Cross has had six first team All-America selections, sent 11 players to the National Basketball Association, had four players and coaches inducted into the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame, had 23 players drafted by professional teams, had three players go on to coach professionally and had 15 players who have coached in college.

**GREEN LEADS FROM THE POINT:** Sophomore guard **Caleb Green** continues to be a key part of the Holy Cross backcourt this year. In 12 games played, he has averaged 11.2 points, 4.0 assists and 3.1 rebounds per contest, while hitting 93.3 percent of his free throws. During the Siena game, Green totaled 12 points and five assists. Previously against Rhode Island, he led the team with 16 points, eight assists and three steals. Green also played well at Massachusetts, tallying 17 points, six assists and four rebounds. A few of his other top performances this season have come at Providence (13 points, four rebounds, three assists), against Sacred Heart (13 points, five assists), at Albany (12 points, seven rebounds, four assists), at Harvard (12 points, three assists), against Stony Brook (10 points, six rebounds) and against Fairleigh Dickinson (10 points, six assists). In 31 games played last season, Green averaged 8.9 points, 2.9 assists and 2.4 rebounds, while hitting 73.3 percent of his free throws. Over the course of his collegiate career, he has now totaled 409 points, 138 assists, 112 rebounds and 42 steals.

**HOLY CROSS IN THE NCAA STATISTICS:** The Crusaders are currently ranked among the NCAA Division I leaders in eight statistical categories, through games of Dec. 25. In addition, four Holy Cross players stand among the best in the nation in individual categories. The rankings:

**BENZAN PLAYS KEY MINUTES IN BACKCOURT:** Senior guard **Patrick Benzan** is one of the leaders in the Holy Cross backcourt this year. In 12 games played, he has averaged 6.4 points and 3.0 assists per contest. During the victory at Albany, he totaled 10 points, three rebounds, three assists and two steals. Previously against Sacred Heart, Benzan recorded a career-high 19 points and five assists, while hitting nine of 10 field goal attempts. In 28 games played last season, he averaged 6.3 points, 3.3 rebounds, 2.1 assists and 1.1 steals per contest, while hitting 79.5 percent of his free throws. Over the course of his collegiate career, Benzan has now totaled 519 points, 221 rebounds, 184 assists and 91 steals.

**CARMODY LEADS THE CRUSADERS:** Bill Carmody is in his fourth season as the head men's basketball coach at Holy Cross in 2018-2019, with an overall record of 50-60. He owns a career record of 334-295, and earned his 300th career victory with a 63-52 win at Harvard on Nov. 22, 2016. In 2015-2016, Carmody led the Crusaders to their first Patriot League Tournament title since 2007 and their first NCAA Tournament victory since 1953. The 17th head coach in the history of the program, he has 36 years of Division I coaching experience, including 21 seasons as a head coach (with 13 years at Northwestern and four seasons at Princeton). Carmody has led his teams to nine postseason tournament appearances — three trips to the NCAA Tournament and six trips to the National Invitation Tournament.

**CRUSADERS AGAINST THE METRO ATLANTIC ATHLETIC CONFERENCE:** Holy Cross has an all-time record of 108-84 against the 11 schools which currently compete in the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference. Under head coach Bill Carmody, the Crusaders are 6-5 against MAAC foes. Holy Cross stands 14-6 all-time against Canisius, 22-19 vs. Fairfield, 15-16 against Iona, 21-10 vs. Manhattan, 5-2 against Marist, 0-1 vs. Monmouth, 8-7 against Niagara, 3-1 vs. Quinnipiac, 14-13 against St. Peter's and 6-9 vs. Siena. The Crusaders played in the MAAC for seven seasons from 1983-1990, posting a 52-48 record in conference action. Holy Cross' top season in the league came in 1989-1990, when it recorded a 14-2 mark to win the MAAC North Division title.

**HART IS WHERE THE HOME IS:** Holy Cross currently owns an all-time record of 383-163 at the Hart Center at the Luth Athletic Complex, including a 4-0 mark so far this season. The Crusaders posted their 300th win in the building against Sacred Heart on Nov. 14, 2008. Holy Cross had a 23-game winning streak at the Hart Center from Feb. 15, 2006-Jan. 2, 2008, which was the longest streak in the history of the building and the sixth-longest home court winning streak in the nation at the time. In 2006-2007 the Crusaders posted a perfect 14-0 mark at the Hart Center, setting a school record for the most home victories since they moved into the building. During the Hart Center's history, Holy Cross has posted a winning record at home in 36 out of 43 seasons, while recording double-figure home victories 18 times. The Crusaders stand 170-71 at home since the beginning of the 2000-2001 season, including a 108-42 record against Patriot League foes.

**DRIBBLES:** • Holy Cross has come back to win its last two games, after trailing by 10 points in the second half both times ... The Crusaders' eight victories this year are their most prior to the start of Patriot League since going 8-7 against non-conference foes in 2012-2013 ... In the NCAA's new NET rankings (through games of Dec. 21), Holy Cross' schedule ranks as the 137th hardest in the nation, and the toughest in the Patriot League ... Junior guard **Clayton Le Sann** tied his career high with 13 points against

Rhode Island on Dec. 8, while hitting five of seven field goals and three of five shots from three-point range. On the year, he is now averaging 1.8 points per game ... Sophomore forward **Connor Niego** led the team with a career-high 13 points at No. 19 Michigan on Nov. 10, then scored 11 points against Rhode Island on Dec. 8. Over the course of his Holy Cross career, he has now totaled 119 points and 56 rebounds ... Sophomore forward **Matt Faw** scored a career-high 13 points during the victory over Stony Brook on Nov. 16. He has now totaled 219 points, 93 rebounds, 21 blocks and 22 assists during his collegiate career, while making 36 of 87 three-point attempts (41.4 percent) ... Senior forward **Jehyve Floyd** has 146 career blocked shots, to rank third all-time at Holy Cross ... Holy Cross won the Springfield Bracket of this year's Basketball Hall of Fame Tip-Off Tournament for the 15th regular season tournament championship in program history ... In the latest NCAA Graduation Success Rate Report, for the four-class aggregate of entering classes from 2008 through 2011, the Crusader men's basketball team posted a perfect 100 percent graduation rate. Holy Cross' overall Graduation Success Rate for all student-athletes was 98 percent, tied for the eighth-best mark among all Division I schools ... Holy Cross was picked to finish in fifth place in the 2018-2019 Patriot League preseason poll of head coaches and sports information directors, while senior forward **Jehyve Floyd** was selected to the preseason All-Patriot League team.
