NIAGARA TAKES ON IONA SUNDAY THE PURPLE EAGLES LOOKING FOR SEASON SWEEP

The Niagara Purple Eagles will face the Iona Gaels on Sunday, February 10 at 1 p.m.

Scene Setter

- NU will look to sweep the season series for the first time in 11 seasons after winning the first meeting between the programs in January.
- The Purple Eagles set season-highs in points (95), rebounds (51), and in 3-pointers (13) en route to a 95-90 victory over the Iona Gaels on January 11 for their first home win the series in six seasons.
- Niagara has won the last two meetings, which is its longest streak since winning four straight from 2006-08.
- Niagara is in search of three straight wins at Iona from the first time since winning three straight from December 2006 to February 2009. Niagara spoiled the Gaels' home opener in 2016 with a 74-58 victory and rallied to edge Iona, 85-84, last season.
- In seven career meetings against Iona, Marvin Prochet is averaging 13.6 points and 8.6 rebounds. He has scored in double figures in six games and has two double-doubles.

Tipoff Tidbits

- Marvin Prochet is third in the MAAC in scoring with a career-high 17.5 points per game and is second in rebounding with 7.3 boards per game. He is on pace to setting the program single-season 3-point field goal percent record as his career-high 45.2 three-point FG percent **LEADS** the league. Prochet also **LEADS** the MAAC in 3-pointers per game (2.9) and is shooting a career-high 44.7 percent from the field.
- Dominic Robb is seven blocks away from tying Joe Arlauckas ('87), who finished his career with 220 blocks, for most blocks in program history.
- Dominic Robb **LEADS** the MAAC in total blocks (57) and blocks per game (2.4) while ranking tenth and 16th, respectively, in those categories nationally. Robb's 57 blocks are eighth most in program history.
- James Towns is third in the MAAC in free throw percentage with a career-high 81.8 percent. Towns is also averaging career-high numbers in assists per game (3.9) and in assist/turnover ratio (1.7) which are seventh and third, respectively, in the MAAC.
- Five Purple Eagles netted double figures against Quinnipiac on February 3 for the third time this season.
- Raheem Solomon has scored in double figures in five of the last six games. He is averaging 11 points per game and shooting 46 percent from 3-pointers in the last six games.
- The Purple Eagles **LEAD** the MAAC and ranks the top-40 in the nation in free throw percentage (.748). The program record is 76.5 percent set during the 1987-88 season.
- Niagara is second in the conference in blocks per game (3.7), total blocks (89), fewest turnovers (286), and in turnovers per game (11.9),
- According to KenPom.com, the Purple Eagles rank sixth in the nation in opponent free throw rate (23.9) which captures a team's ability to get to the free-throw line.

On The Court**Iona Gaels (7-15, 5-6 MAAC)**

- After falling to Niagara on January 11, the Gaels are 3-5 in their last eight games including a current four-game losing streak.
- Iona has the top scoring offense in the conference, averaging 77.9 points per game. The Gaels are second in free throw percentage (.733) and third in field goal percentage (.455).
- The Gaels have four players averaging over 12 points per game this season - E. J. Crawford (17.9), Rickey McGill (15.2), Asante Gist (12.2) and Tajuan Agee (12.1).

Against The Gaels (Iona Leads 47-37)

- The Purple Eagles have back-to-back wins over the Gaels for the first time since winning four straight in the series from 2006-08.
- Niagara's 95-90 win over Iona on Jan. 11 marked the team's first home win in the series since beating Iona, 93-90, in overtime on Jan. 31, 2013.
- A win on Saturday would give the Purple Eagles their first sweep over the Gaels in a single season since the 2007-08 campaign.

"The Power of Niagara"

- Niagara defeated a current Power 5 (ACC, Big Ten, Big 12, Pac-12, SEC) opponent for the first time in 37 years when the Purple Eagles upended the ACC's Pitt Panthers, 71-70, on December 5.
- The Purple Eagles previously dropped their last 27 games versus current Power 5 teams and won their first game against a Power 5 school in the current format since the breakup of the old Big East in 2013.
- The last win against a current Power 5 team was against Penn State during the 1981-82 season, which was prior to the Nittany Lions joining the Big Ten.
- It was Niagara's first win against an ACC opponent since topping Syracuse during the 1975-76 season prior to the Orange joining the ACC.
- The Purple Eagles became the first MAAC team to beat an ACC team since Fairfield topped Boston College in December 2016.

Mr. Double-Double

- Marvin Prochet has established himself as a double-double force as he ranks amongst the nation's leaders in double-doubles.
- He leads the MAAC in double-doubles.
- Prochet started the season with four straight double-doubles, which was the longest streak by a Purple Eagle since Benson Egemonye had four straight during the 2008-09 season.
- He has seven double-doubles in 21 games.
- Prochet is on pace to average a double-double for the entire season and would be the first Purple Eagle to do so since Juan Mendez (23.5 ppg, 10.6 rpg) in the 2004-05 season.

Dominant Second Half Spurs Big Win

- Niagara scored a season-high 53 second half points en route to their largest margin of victory in 10 seasons in a 75-48 win over the Monmouth Hawks on January 26.
- The 27-point win is the Purple Eagles' largest since beating Marist, 79-50, in the 2009 MAAC Tournament Quarterfinals.
- The 48 points allowed are the fewest since St. John's scored 48 points against the Purple Eagles on December 9, 2015.
- It was the fewest points allowed in a win since beating Albany, 65-47, on December 30, 2014.

Purple Eagles Outlast Gaels In High-Octane Affair

- The Purple Eagles scored a season-high 95 points, including a season-high 13 3-pointers, and grabbed a season-high 51 rebounds as they outlasted the Iona Gaels, 95-90, for their first MAAC win on January 11.
- Niagara's 51 rebounds are also the most in the MAAC this season.
- Niagara had a substantial advantage in bench points, outscoring the Gaels 47-6. NU also outscored Iona in second chance points (26-6).

A December To Remember

- The Purple Eagles had their best December record since 2008 with a 5-2 mark.
- NU started the month with a victory at Pitt which jumpstarted a three-game win streak.
- The Purple Eagles also had a road win at Army and defeated Norfolk State inside the Gallagher Center.

Towns Claims Second MAAC Player Of The Week Award

- For the second time in three weeks, James Towns was named MAAC Player of the Week announced on December 24.
- Towns led the Purple Eagles in points and assists as Niagara split a pair of road games. Towns averaged 18.5 points per game, 4.5 assists per game, and 5.0 rebounds per game. He went a team-best 11-for-13 at the free-throw line. He scored a game-high 18 points and shared game-high marks in assists with four against Cleveland State on December 19.
- Towns helped spur a second half comeback win at Army on December 22 behind a game-high 19 points, including 16 in the second half. He led the team in assists with five and grabbed six boards.

Fast Start Propels NU To Victory Over Canisius

- Niagara never trailed in a 78-70 win against archrival Canisius on a frigid cold night on January 30 for its fourth win in the last five meetings.
- The Purple Eagles led by 15 points at the break, for their largest halftime lead of the season, and led by as much as 17 points in the second half.
- NU tied a season-high in free throws made, going 22-for-27 at the charity stripe.

Prochet Collects Second MAAC Player Of The Week Award.

- Marvin Prochet was named MAAC Player of the Week for the second time this season announced on December 16.
- Prochet notched his MAAC-leading fifth double-double of the season with a game-high 24 points and a team-high 10 rebounds to help Niagara defeat Cornell on December 16 for the Purple Eagles' third straight win. Prochet made five straight 3-pointers in the first half on his way to tying a career-high in 3-pointers with five.
- Prochet also became the 47th member of Niagara's 1,000-Point Club during the game. Prochet scored his 1,000th point on the first of two free throws with two minutes left in the game. He made the second free throw to bring Niagara within one point (70-69).

Prochet Enters The 1,000-Point Club

- Marvin Prochet, who entered his senior campaign 115 points away from 1,000 career points, joined the 1,000-point club on December 16.
- He became the 47th member of the club after a 24-point performance in a last-second win versus Cornell.
- Prochet scored his 1,000th point on the first of two free throws with two minutes left in the game.

Secretary Of Defense

- Dominic Robb, who started his final campaign wearing the Purple & White fifth on the career blocks list, is currently second after passing Mark Henry ('84) on December 3.
- Robb set the program's single-season record in blocks with a MAAC-leading 74 blocks during the 2016-17 season.
- He was second in the MAAC with a team-leading 48 blocks last season.
- This season, Robb is 16th in the NCAA in blocks per game.
- Robb's career-high eight blocks in the season-opening win versus Little 3 rival St. Bonaventure are tied for second most in program history and tied for seventh most in the nation this season.

Second Half Run Powers Purple Eagles Past Army

- The Purple Eagles poured in a season-high 51 second half points on their way to a 78-66 victory against the Army West Point Black Knights on December 22.
- An 18-3 run midway through the second half allowed the Purple Eagles to seize control of a tightly-contested matchup.
- The Purple Eagles had season-highs in steals (7), field goals made (30), and in rebounds (45), while their 78 points, 47.6 field goal percent, and six blocks are the second highest this season.
- There were 15 lead changes and four ties.

Last-Second 3-Pointer Lifts NU Over Cornell

- Keleaf Tate's 3-pointer with 1.1 seconds on the clock lifted the Purple Eagles to their third straight win with a 77-74 victory over the Cornell Big Red on December 16.
- The Purple Eagles erased a nine-point deficit in the final eight minutes and completed the comeback with a last-second 3-pointer.
- Marvin Prochet notched his fifth double-double of the season with a game-high 24 points and a team-high 10 rebounds. Prochet made five straight 3-pointers in the first half on his way to tying a career-high in 3-pointers with five.
- Keleaf Tate scored a career-high 23 points, including tying a career-high in 3-pointers with five.
- The Purple Eagles' four turnovers are their fewest since having three turnovers at Quinnipiac on February 8, 2015.

Winning On The Highest Court In The Land

- Playing their third game in five days, the Purple Eagles handed the Wyoming Cowboys a rare defeat on their home court, which is 7,220 feet above sea level.
- Niagara led for over 36 minutes and made pressure free throws in the final minutes to come away with a 72-67 victory on November 16.
- The Purple Eagles picked up their first-ever win against a Mountain West Conference opponent in their fifth attempt, including their first win in two meetings versus Wyoming.

Towns Earns First Career MAAC Player Of The Week Award

- James Towns was named MAAC Player of the Week on December 10.
- Towns averaged team-highs in points with 17.5 per game and in assists with 7.5 per game while averaging 6.0 rebounds as the Purple Eagles went 2-0 with wins at Pitt and at home versus New Hampshire. Towns shot 61.9 percent from the field for the week, including a season-high 69.2 percent against New Hampshire.
- In the victory at Pitt on December 3, Towns had 12 points, dished out a career-high nine assists and grabbed six rebounds. Towns led all scorers with a season-high 23 points, including the game-winning basket, to lift Niagara over New Hampshire on December 9. Towns also led the game in assists with six and had six rebounds.

- Niagara participated in the Fort Myers Tip-Off MTE from November 14-24.
- The Purple Eagles began play in the Fort Myers Tip-Off with a defeat to 2018 Final Four participant Loyola Chicago on November 14, but bounced back with a solid performance to beat the Wyoming Cowboys, 72-67, on their home court on November 16.
- NU hosted the four-team regional featuring Grambling State, Saint Francis Brooklyn, and IUPUI as part of the MTE from Nov. 23-24
- Niagara opened the regional with a 74-68 setback against the Grambling State Tigers on Nov. 23 and dropped the final game to Saint Francis Brooklyn on Nov. 24.
- Dominic Robb was named to the Fort Myers Tip-Off All-Tournament Team after averaging 16 points, 7.0 rebounds, 3.0 blocks and 2.0 steals in two games.

Prochet Earns First MAAC Player Of The Week Award

- Marvin Prochet's stellar start to the season has earned him MAAC Player of the Week honors for the first time in his career announced on November 19.
- Prochet became the first Purple Eagle to start the season with three consecutive double-doubles in nine seasons.
- Prochet averaged 19.0 points per game and 11.0 rebounds per game to lead Niagara in both categories as the Purple Eagles won two out of three games for their best start to a season since the 2009-10 campaign.

- The Purple Eagles return eight letter winners from last season's team that went 19-14, including earning a No. 3 seed in the MAAC Tournament with a 12-6 conference record, and received a bid to play in the CIT.
- Niagara will be led by the senior captains core of Marvin Prochet, Dominic Robb, Chris Barton, and Greg King.
- Junior guard James Towns will step into the starting point guard role, while sophomores Greg Kuakumensah, Keleaf Tate, and Kierell Green will see added minutes.
- NU welcomes newcomers in Raheem Solomon, Marcus Hammond, Ousmane Diop, Steven Levnaic, and Justin Roberts, who will sit-out this season after transferring from Toledo. Dominik Fragala, who redshirted last season, is eligible this season.
- Marvin Prochet was selected to the Preseason All-MAAC Third Team. Prochet and James Towns were both named to the Preseason All-Big 4 Second Team.
- Niagara was picked ninth in the MAAC Preseason Poll.

Casey, who arrived with 27 years of coaching experience at the Division I, II and III levels, was named the 21st head coach of the Niagara University men's basketball program on April 22, 2013. Casey had successful stints as a Division I assistant coach at St. John's, Central Connecticut State and Saint Peter's, and as a Division II head coach at LIU Post and a Division III head coach at Rutgers-Newark.

In his fifth season leading the Purple Eagles, the program had one of best seasons in recent history. Niagara went 19-14, including 12-6 in conference play, and played in the 10th CollegeInsider.Com Tournament (CIT) for Niagara's first postseason appearance since 2013. Niagara's 19 overall wins, 12 MAAC wins, and nine home wins were the most in five seasons, and the Purple Eagles' 10 road victories led the MAAC and tied a school record in the modern-era set in the 2008-09 season.

The Purple Eagles led the MAAC in points per game (83.3), total blocks (145), blocks per game (4.4), total rebounds (1,286), free throws made (588), fewest turnovers (373) and in fewest turnovers per game (11.3). The 2017-18 Purple Eagles scored a program record 2,748 points and defeated two Big 4 teams (St. Bonaventure, Canisius) in the same season for the first time since 2010-11. Niagara's 9-win improvement from the 2016-17 season was tied for 12th out of 353 NCAA Division I programs.

Niagara had several individual standouts throughout the 2017-18 season. The duo of Kahlil Dukes (AP Honorable Mention, MAAC Co-Player of the Year, All-MAAC First Team, NABC All-District I First Team), and Matt Scott (NABC All-District I First Team, All-MAAC Second Team) received numerous accolades and set program records, and fellow tri-captain Marvin Prochet led the MAAC in double-doubles (nine) and in rebounds per game (7.9).

Casey started his tenure rebuilding the program after being one of the youngest teams in the nation during his first two seasons. The Purple Eagles finished the 2014-15 season winning four of their last five games and had one player named to the MAAC All-Rookie Team. In his first season at the helm, Casey picked up wins against Big 4 rival Buffalo, which was the program's first since 2008, and a victory over two-time defending SoCon champions Davidson. Casey also coached Antoine Mason, who led the nation in scoring for three months and finished second in the nation, behind national player of the year Doug McDermott from Creighton, with 25.6 points per game. At the end of the 2015-16 campaign, one of Casey's first recruits, Matt Scott, was named to the 2015-16 All-MAAC Third Team.

The 2016-17 Purple Eagles finished in double-digit wins, including a win in the MAAC Tournament. Matt Scott was named to the All-MAAC Third Team for the second straight season and Kahlil Dukes set the program's free throw percentage record. Niagara led the MAAC in blocks per game (4.6) with sophomore Dominic Robb setting the program's single-season block record with 74.

Academically, the program earned a 1,000 Academic Progress Rate (APR) for the 2016-17 season.

Since his arrival to Montecagle Ridge, Casey's teams have been very active within the local community. The men's basketball program has been extremely active in community service initiatives during Casey's tenure. The team makes annual visits to the Community Missions of Niagara Frontier and has made numerous trips to the Niagara Falls Boys & Girls Club where it held clinics and have visited patients at the Women & Children's Hospital of Buffalo. The Purple Eagles have also volunteered at the Magdalene Project at St. George's Church in Niagara Falls, New York. During Niagara's tour of Costa Rica in August 2018, the team held a clinic for the Olimpiadas Especial (Special Olympics) San Jose chapter.

Casey is a 1986 graduate of Western Connecticut State University with a Bachelor of Science in business administration. He was a four-year letterwinner at Western Connecticut State, including a two-time captain. He earned his master's in education administration from Central Connecticut State in 1993.

Casey and his wife, Hope, have two daughters, Lauren and Jordan.

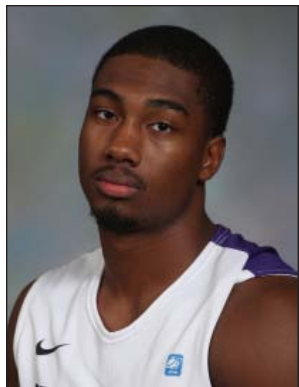

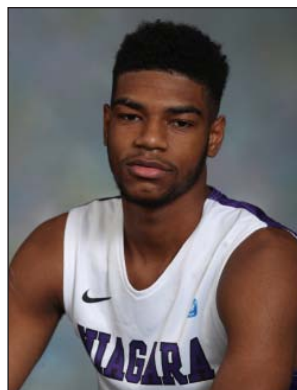

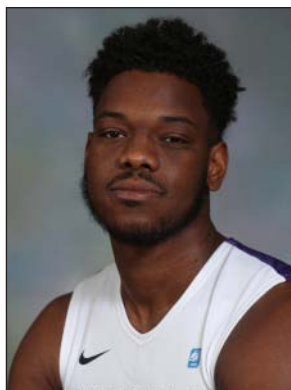
