IONA TAKES ON UCONN IN STORRS

The Iona College men's basketball team's (2-2) looks to extend a two-game winning streak when it faces the American Athletic Conference's UConn (5-2) at Gampel Pavilion. The Gaels evened their season record at 2-2 after wins in back-to-back days at the MAAC-ASUN Challenge at ESPN's Wide World of Sports in Lake Buena Vista, FL.

IONA VS. UCONN - SERIES HISTORY

- The two teams square off for the fifth time in history with the Huskies holding a 3-1 series lead.
- It is the first time the two teams square off in the Tim Cluess era.
- The two teams last faced off on Dec. 27, 2009.

GAELS VS. THE AMERICAN ATHLETIC CONFERENCE

- Iona is 5-11 all-time against current American Athletic Conference having last faced Tulsa on Dec. 8, 2015.
- It is just the second time the Gaels have faced an American opponent while they were a member of the conference.

AT THE HELM

- Associate head coach **Tra Arnold** - in his second year at Iona - continues to serve as acting head coach for tonight's contest as **Tim Cluess** continues to monitor a health matter.
- Before coming to Iona, Arnold spent six successful seasons head coach at Odessa College in Northwest Texas. He served three years prior as head coach at Blinn College.
- Arnold mentored more than 30 future NCAA Division I players including: LJ Figueroa (St. John's), Jermaine Haley (West Virginia), Keandre Cook (Missouri State), Josh Gray (NBA Pelicans, LSU), and Devin Davis (G-League Magic, Houston).
- Director of Operations **John Mateyko** is serving as an assistant coach of the program in Cluess' absence and the elevation of Arnold's responsibilities.

AGEE, CRAWFORD, GIST NAMED PRESEASON ALL-MAAC

Seniors **Tajuan Agee** and **E.J. Crawford** and junior **Asante Gist** were selected to the Preseason All-MAAC team by the league's 11 head coaches.

Agee and Crawford were selected to the first team and Gist the second team.

Crawford was the lone unanimous selection to the first team and although not picked by the coaches, Lindy's Sports selected him as the MAAC's Preseason Player of the Year.

WHO'S BACK?

Iona returns six performers from the 2018-19 MAAC Championship campaign including senior starters **Tajuan Agee**, **E.J. Crawford** and **Ben Perez** and junior **Asante Gist**.

Senior **Niksa Nikolic** and sophomore **Andrija Ristanovic** also contributed to the Maroon & Gold's success last season.

WHAT'S NEW?

Eight new faces highlight the 2018-19 Iona men's basketball roster.

Junior **Isaiah Ross** transferred from UMKC and practiced with the team in his sit out year last season.

NCAA Division I transfers, junior **Isaiah Washington** (Minnesota) and senior **Mo Thiam** (New Mexico State) received legislative relief waivers from the NCAA and will be eligible to play right away.

Junior college transfer juniors **Colton Cashaw**, **A.J. McNeil** and **Dylan van Eyck** look to contribute in their first seasons in New Rochelle.

Freshman walk-ons **Michael Ortale Jr.** and **Parker Weiss** round out the new Gaels.

PRESEASON SUCCESS

Iona won both of its preseason contests prior to the start of the 2019-20 campaign.

The Gaels defeated St. Francis Brooklyn on the road on Oct. 26 in a closed door scrimmage before hosting its first non-Division I exhibition match up in 13 seasons vs. DIII Mount Saint Vincent on Nov. 2.

Tajuan Agee, **E.J. Crawford** and **Asante Gist** combined for 55 of the Gaels 99 points scored vs. the Terriers.

The Gaels handled the Dolphins 112-79 at the newly renovated Hynes Center led by double-doubles from Agee and **Isaiah Washington** and a 23-point effort by Crawford.

LOU HENSON AWARD WATCH LIST

Senior **E.J. Crawford** was one of 50 players named to the Lou Henson Award preseason watch list by CollegeInsider.com.

The award is presented annually to the nation's top Division I mid-major player.

He is the fifth Gael to be recognized on the list since the awards inception in 2010, joining **A.J. English**, **Mike Glover**, **Lamont Jones** and **Scott Machado**.

MILLENNIA MEN

Senior **E.J. Crawford** became the 41st player in Iona men's basketball history to record 1,000 career points in a 20-point effort at Canisius.

He was the 11th player under Tim Cluess to reach the mark.

Crawford ranks No. 23 on Iona's all-time scoring list passed Naismith Hall of Famer **Richie Guerin** with his 12-point effort vs. Stetson. He is 13 points from 1,400.

In nine seasons, Cluess has mentored more than 1/4 of Iona's all-time 1,000 point scorers.

Junior Asante Gist is just eight points shy of 1,000 points for his career that includes two seasons at Eastern Kentucky.

KING OF THE HILL, TOP OF THE LIST

No team among the 14 NYC Metropolitan Area Division I basketball programs within 30 miles of the center of NY College basketball, Madison Square Garden has won more games than Iona College in the last 24+ seasons (455; Hofstra #2, 431).

Since head coach **Tim Cluess** took the reins in 2010-11, Iona's 201 wins and .646 win percentage are also the best in both categories. (Seton Hall, 176 wins; .575 win pct.)

Since 1995-96, the Maroon & Gold hold the lead in wins (455), 24 more than Hofstra, 40 more than No. 3 Seton Hall and the top win percentage (.590).

Iona's nine postseason appearances (six NCAA, two NIT, one CIT) since 2010-11 are the most during the time frame, **almost twice as many** Seton Hall (4 NCAA, 1 NIT) and St. John's (three NCAA, two NIT).

In the Cluess era, Iona has also recorded one more win than UConn, while holding a .042 higher winning percentage.

CLUESS RANKS SECOND ALL-TIME IN WINS

Head coach **Tim Cluess** became No. 2 on Iona's all-time coaching wins list at the end of the 2015-16 campaign, surpassing Goal Club Hall of Famer **Jeff Ruland's** mark of 139 over nine seasons.

Cluess has led Iona to **124 MAAC regular season wins** through nine seasons, **the third most in conference history** behind former Siena/Loyola head coach Jimmy Patsos (132 in 14 seasons) and former Niagara skipper Joe Mihalich (166 in 15 seasons).

#GAELNATION AND SNY

- Three Gaels with Iona connections serve as a part of tonight's broadcast on SportsNet New York.
- Analyst **Tim Welsh** served as head coach of the Gaels from 1995-98, leading the Maroon & Gold to two MAAC regular season titles and one tournament championship and NCAA appearance in his final season.
- **Gerard Guilfoyle '00** was a broadcasting major at Iona and is the producer of tonight's contest.
- Vin Parise '00 was also a broadcasting major and is a studio analyst during pre- and postgame shows as well as halftime. Parise was a team manager for Welsh and **Jeff Ruland** during his undergraduate days and then served as an assistant coach under Ruland and Kevin Willard before embarking on his current career in front of the camera.

20/20 VISION

- Iona's 20+ win season streak snapped at nine following the 2018-19 campaign.
- Iona recorded its ninth straight and 22nd all-time 20+ win seasons in the 76-year history of the program in 2017-18.
- It set a program record for consecutive 20+ win seasons, surpassing the previous high of four straight from 1981-85.
- Tim Cluess is the only (of 12 all-time) head coach in program history to earn 20 wins in each of his first eight seasons in New Rochelle. He is also the Iona coach to boast more than four 20+ win seasons as the leader of the Maroon & Gold (Pat Kennedy, 4).

NINE STRAIGHT 20-WIN SEASONS

- The Gaels had an unprecedented run of 20-win seasons in MAAC history. The nine-year stretch more than doubled the previous MAAC mark of four set by the Maroon & Gold from 1981-85 and matched by La Salle (1986-90) and Siena (2006-10).
- In MAAC history, consecutive 20+ win streaks have happened only 17 times.
- Iona has recorded 19 of its 22 20+ win seasons as a member of the MAAC, the most of any league member. Siena has posted 12, Manhattan nine and Saint Peter's eight.

ABOUT CONFERENCE TOURNAMENT TITLES

- Iona is the **only** NCAA Division I programs to capture its last four straight conference tournament championships and holds the nation's longest active streak.
- Only four programs have won at least five tournament titles in the last eight seasons. Iona's

five during the time frame is only eclipsed by New Mexico State (7) and Gonzaga (6) while matching the mark of South Dakota State.

ABOUT NCAA TOURNAMENT APPEARANCES

- 27 of the 351 NCAA Division I programs have appeared in at least six of the last eight NCAA Tournaments. **Only three of the 37 have come from mid-major conferences** (Gonzaga [8], New Mexico State [7] and Iona [6]).
- 13 teams in the 2019 NCAA Tournament have also appeared in the 2016, 2017 and 2018 brackets, the last four-in-a-row. Only Gonzaga and Iona can stake the claim among members of mid-major conferences.

EFFICIENT, EFFECTIVE, AND FAST PACED

- Iona has been a perennial Top 80 team on Pomeroy's Adjusted Offensive Efficiency under **Tim Cluess** but have slipped to 169th through the team's first four contests.
- Offensive Efficiency is measured by calculating the amount of points a team would score in 100 possessions. Ken Pomeroy's formula adjusts for the quality of opposing defenses, the site of each game, and when each game was played.
- **On the defensive side, the Gaels 101.5 PPP surrendered is the lowest since the 2009-10 campaign.**
- Iona's shooting woes through four games has seen its Effective FG% rate slip to its lowest since 2019-10 as well.
- EFG% adjusts for the fact that a three-point field goal is worth one more point than a two-point field goal.
- Iona's tempo of 69.2 possessions per game is middle of the pack in the last decade, but the lowest in the 30-second shot clock era.

• Iona finished a 8-3 at home following a 51-day stretch away from the Hynes Center, a span of nine contests in the non-conference season.

ROAD WOES TO ROAD WARRIORS

• Iona snapped a five game wining streak in its season opener and have dropped 12 of its last 18 contests in its opponent's building.

DOUBLE-DIGIT MAAC WINS

- Iona men's basketball has recorded 10 straight seasons with at least 10+ MAAC regular season wins, extending the league's longest streak.
- The program set the record in 2017-18, surpassing the eight in a row recorded by the Gaels from 1995-03 and Niagara from 1997-05.
- Overall, Iona has 22 10+ win seasons in 38 years in the MAAC followed by Siena (17), Rider/Niagara (14) and Manhattan/Saint Peter's/Fairfield (13).
- Iona has also won 11 or more MAAC games in each of the last 10 seasons, doubling the previous standard held by Niagara (2000-05) and La Salle (1987-92)

HECK OF A JOB

- The Gaels earned the MAAC regular season championship, the No. 1 seed in the tournament and a conference tournament championship in the 2018-19 campaign.
- The Maroon & Gold were selected to finish third and overcame the late departure of preseason All-MAAC Second Team selection **Roland Griffin** and an injury to junior transfer and 2017 All-NEC Second Team honoree **Isaiah Still**, who appeared in parts of just two games during the conference season.
- Iona was 9-3 against teams that finished in the top six in the MAAC standings, the best record among the group. Canisius was 7-4, Quinnipiac 5-5, Monmouth 6-7, Rider 3-7 and Siena 2-7.

CURSE REVERSED

- The No. 1 seed won the MAAC tournament championship for the first time in nine seasons in 2019. Siena, Times Union Center, 2010).
- The MAAC's top seed won a championship

that was not on its home floor for the first time in 14 years (Niagara, 2005).

- It is Iona's fourth MAAC regular season championship and No. 1 seed in nine seasons under head coach Tim Cluess. The Gaels were upset in the semifinal round in 2012 but earned an at-large bid into the NCAA Tournament. Iona fell to Manhattan in back-to-back seasons as the No. 1 seed in the MAAC championship game in 2014 and 2015.

CUPID'S ARROW

- Iona won all nine of 10 games it played since Valentine's Day 2019 to end last season.
- In nine seasons under Tim Cluess, Iona has posted a 54-14 (.794) record from February 14 through the completion of the MAAC Championship including 16 of the last 18 contests dating back to the 2017 tournament.

HIGH SCORING AFFAIRS

- Iona has reached 100 points 17 times in eight-plus seasons under head coach Tim Cluess, including a single-season program record four times in 2011-12.
- Iona is 13-4 under Cluess and 53-6 all-time when scoring 100 or more.
- The Gaels scored 90 or more points 62 times in 290 (21.3%) games under Cluess and are 50-12.
- Iona is 120-34 when reaching at least 80 points under Cluess.

THIRD TO 100

- Iona head coach Tim Cluess became the third head coach in MAAC history to record 100 regular season wins.
- Cluess joined Joe Mihalich (Niagara) seasons and Jimmy Patsos (Loyola/Siena) in the century club.
- Cluess was also the fastest of the trio to reach the mark (131 games) with Mihalich becoming the first in 159 games and Patsos the second in 188 games.

LET IT RAIN

- Since 2000-01, Iona has produced **141** games with 10 or more three-point field goals. Five came in the seven seasons under head coach **Jeff Ruland** and seven came with **Kevin Willard** at the helm (three years).
- Under **Tim Cluess**, Iona has posted **129** games (22 in 2013-14, 18 in 2014-15, 15 in 2015-16, 20 in 2016-17, 14 in 2017-18 & 2018-19) with double-digit trifectas.
- The Gaels shattered a school record with 24 3FG on Nov. 26 vs. Delaware State, beating the previous mark of 18, reached twice (at Albany, Nov. 23, 2010; vs. Liberty, Dec. 18, 2012).
- The Maroon & Gold set its No. 2 total of 20 3FG made in an 82-68 win at Holy Cross on Dec. 19, 2017. The first 10 field goals made in the contest were from distance as the team set a first half program record with 12 in the win.
- Iona's top 25 three-point field goal efforts have come with Cluess as head coach.
- Against Liberty, Iona's 41 three-point attempts set a new standard. No. 2 was 40 vs. Fairfield this season and No. 3 came in a 24-for-39 effort vs. Delaware State.
- Through **four games** this season, Iona has made a three-pointer in **367** straight and **815** out of its last **817** games. The school record is 385 straight from Jan. 5, 1994 - Dec. 16, 2006.
- The Gaels have failed to hit a three-pointer in just 18 of their **1,042** games played since the line was adopted for the 1986-87 season.

WIDE MARGINS

- The Gaels are **113-34** in games decided by 10 or more points since head coach **Tim Cluess** took the reins in 2010-11.
- After winning 81 of the first 99 double-digit decisions in his first six seasons (81-18, .818), Iona is 32-16 (.667) since 2016-17.
- During the MAAC regular season, the program is **72-6 (.923)** in MAAC regular season games decided by 10 or more points under Cluess.
- In 14 seasons as an NCAA head coach, Cluess has lost just 15 games by 15 or more points.
- Iona's 126-76 win over Delaware State was the second 50+ point victory in program history and first since the 1967-68 (46 years) campaign.
- In his 13 seasons as an NCAA coach, Cluess has mentored his team to a **173-36** mark in 10+ point contests.

RICHIE GUERIN'S #14 HANGS IN THE RAFTERS

- Iona honored the legacy of **Richie Guerin '54** by retiring his number 14 on Jan. 31, 2014 the first ever in school history.
- Guerin is an Iona College Goal Club (1983), Marine Corps Sports (2004), and Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame (2013) inductee who starred for the Maroon & Gold from 1951-1954.
- He rewrote the basketball record books at Iona, scoring 1,375 points and graduated as the leading scorer in school history.
- A two-time All-Metropolitan selection with the Gaels, he scored a then school-record 40 points against John Carroll in 1954 and was the first Gael to score 40 or more points in a game.

- Following his playing days at Iona, Guerin played with the National Basketball Association's New York Knicks from 1956-1963 and was a player-coach of the St. Louis/Atlanta Hawks franchise for nine years.

- In 13 years as a professional player, Guerin accumulated 14,676 points (17.3 per game), 4,278 rebounds (5.1 per game), and 4,211 assists (5.0 per game) over 848 games.

GAEL GREATS

*In addition to Naismith Hall of Famer **Richie Guerin '54**, here are additional significant names in Iona basketball history:*

- **Jim Valvano** - legendary head coach at Iona from 1975-80 who "Dared To Dream" to win a national championship with the Gaels and finally did in 1983, albeit with North Carolina State. Succumbed to cancer in 1993 eight weeks after an impassioned speech at the ESPY Awards that year which in which he announced creation of The V Foundation for Cancer Research and its motto, "Don't Give Up... Don't Ever Give Up."
- **Jeff Ruland '91** - All-American during his time at Iona and, two-time NBA All-Star with the Washington Bullets, Philadelphia 76ers and Detroit Pistons. Following his career, returned to Iona and served as head coach from 1998-2007 where he won three MAAC Championships.
- **Pat Kennedy** - head coach from 1980-86. Went on to coach at Florida State, DePaul, Montana, and Towson following a highly successful tenure in New Rochelle. He was most recently head coach at Div. II Pace University in Pleasantville, NY, located 19 miles North of Iona.
- **Warren Isaac '65** - Iona's only 50-point scorer, Isaac played six seasons in Europe following his tenure at Iona. A New York City school legend, Isaac started for Power Memorial paving the way for NBA Hall of Famer Kareem Abdul-Jabbar a 1965 graduate of the high school.
- **Tim Welsh** - head coach from 1995-98 who went on to coach in the Big East with Providence for 10 seasons. Currently an ESPN college basketball analyst. Holds the highest career winning percentage ever at Iona.
- **Kevin Willard** - Iona coach from 2007-10, now head coach at Big East's Seton Hall. Helped turn around a program which won two games in the season prior to his arrival to 20 wins in his final season in Maroon & Gold.
- **Steve Burtt '84 & Steve Burtt '06** - All-time NCAA father/son scoring leaders, both netting over 2,000 career points. Burtt, the father, had a four-season NBA career and most notably appeared off the bench for the Phoenix Suns in the 1992 NBA Playoffs. He was inducted into the prestigious NYC Basketball Hall of Fame this past fall. Burtt, the son, continues to play professionally in Europe.
- **Sean Green '91** - Played 84 NBA games over three seasons for the Indiana Pacers, Philadelphia 76ers and Utah Jazz from 1991-94. Currently a high school basketball coach in Southern California.

- **Scott Machado '12** - The last Gael to appear in an NBA game. Machado played in regular season NBA contests in 2012-13 with the Houston Rockets and postseason with the Golden State Warriors. Played the majority 2018-19 season in the NBA G-League for the South Bay Lakers and played four games with the Los Angeles Lakers. The MAAC & Iona's all-time assist leader. He currently plays professionally in Australia.

- **Bob Santini '53** - Iona's first NBA player, appeared in four games with the New York Knicks in 1955-56.

NOTABLE ALUMNI (ATHLETICS/POP CULTURE)

- **Brendan Malone '62** - longtime NBA assistant coach, last with the Detroit Pistons from 2014-16.
- **Don McLean** - Singer-songwriter noted most famous for his 1971 single "American Pie".
- **Dennis Leonard** - Kansas City Royals Hall of Famer and 12-year MLB veteran who won 20 games on three occasions from 1977-80. He was inducted in May 2015 into the New York Baseball Hall of Fame.
- **Kyle Flood '93** - Former head football coach at Rutgers, current OL coach at Alabama.
- **Maggie Timoney '89** - The Iona women's basketball Hall of Famer recently became the first female CEO of Heineken USA.
- **Jason Motte** - Major League Baseball relief pitcher recorded the final out of the 2011 World Series with the world champion St. Louis Cardinals. Has also appeared in Major League games with the Chicago Cubs, Colorado Rockies and Atlanta Braves.
- **Leonard Korir '12** - a two time NCAA track and field champion while at Iona, Korir represented Team USA in the 2016 Rio Olympic Games in the 10,000-meter event. He is currently ranked as the top American marathon runner on WorldAthletics.org.
- **Amanda Saccomanno '13** - World Wrestling Entertainment's (WWE) Mandy Rose, competes on the SmackDown brand.
- **Ignacio Maganto** - was selected by the LA Galaxy with the 21st pick in the first round of the 2015 MLS SuperDraft, the first Major League Soccer draft pick in Iona history. Maganto scored his first MLS goal with the Galaxy in the spring of 2015.
- **Mariano Rivera III '15** - Earned his degree in May 2015 and was selected in the fourth round by the Washington Nationals.
- **Jared Finkel** - Drafted by the Minnesota Twins in 2017, was a Midwest League (Class A) All-Star in 2018 for the Cedar Rapids kernels.

Here is the weekly review of the top performing Gaels alumni, who are currently playing pro basketball.

- 1. Scott Machado** (6'11"-G-90, graduated '12, plays pro in Australia) could not help Cairns Taipans (4-7) in their last game. Despite his very good performance Cairns Taipans lost 114-106 on the road to the one of league's weakest teams (#8) Illawarra Hawks. Machado had a double-double by scoring 22 points and making 12 passes. He also added 4 rebounds in 38 minutes. Machado has relatively good stats this year 14.8ppg, 3.5rpg, 8.4apg and 1.5spg in 11 games he played so far. He is a naturalized Brazilian.
- 2. Kiril Wachsmann** (6'8"-C-84, graduated '06, plays in Uruguay) was the major contributor in Malvin's victory against the closely-ranked Olimpia (7-4) 73-72 in a derby game in the Uruguayan LUB last Tuesday. He recorded a double-double by scoring 17 points and getting 10 rebounds. It was the game of the round between two top 4 ranked teams. Malvin Montevideo (7-4) is placed third in the LUB. Wachsmann's team will play only one more game in the Regular Season. And that game will be critical. It's Wachsmann's first season with the team. He has relatively good stats this year 12.2ppg, 11.0rpg and 2.4apg. Wachsmann has also Uruguayan citizenship.
- 3. Mike Poole** (6'5"-F-92, graduated '14, currently in Chile) led CD Castro to a victory against the second-ranked Puente Alto (5-3) 71-64 in the Chilean Liga Nacional on Saturday night. He recorded 12 points, 5 rebounds, 4 assists and 4 steals in 37 minutes. It was the game of the round between two top 3 ranked teams in group Conferencia Sur. Club Deportes Castro (1-1) is placed third in Conferencia Sur. But this is still an early stage of the season and everything may happen. It's Poole's first year with the team. Poole has individually a very good season with high stats. He averages 19.5ppg, 6.0rpg, 2.6apg and 1.9spg in eight games.
- 4. Steve Burtt** (6'3"-G-84, graduated '06, plays pro in Greece) was not able to help Ionikos Nikaias in their game against Kolossos HH (4-4) in the Greek A1. He scored 9 points and added 4 passes. But Ionikos Nikaias was defeated 86-79 at home by the lower-ranked Kolossos HH (#8). But the season just started, so everything may happen. It's Burtt's first year with the team. This season Burtt has very high stats. He averages 15.1ppg, 2.3rpg and 2.7apg. Burtt is a naturalized Ukrainian.
- 5. Lamont Jones** (6'0"-PG-90, graduated '13, plays in Germany) was not able to secure a victory for Fraport Skyliners Frankfurt (3-6) in their game against Brose Baskets (7-2) in the German BBL. Jones scored 8 points, made 4 passes and 3 steals in 27 minutes. Fraport Skyliners Frankfurt lost 87-72 in Bamberg to the much higher-ranked (#3) Brose Baskets. But the season is still in its first stage and everything can happen. Jones has very impressive stats this year 18.9ppg, 2.1rpg, 5.4apg and 1.2spg in nine games.
- 6. Jordan Washington** (6'8"-F-93, graduated '17, currently in Mexico) contributed to an Abejas de Leon's victory against the sixth-ranked Astros 94-89 in the Mexican LNBP (second division) on Thursday night. Washington scored 12 points and grabbed 7 rebounds. Washington has relatively good stats this season 10.9ppg and 5.4rpg.
- 7. Rickey McGill** (6'11"-G-97, graduated '19, plays pro in Greece) couldn't help Panionios in their game against Promitheas in the Greek A1. McGill scored 7 points and added 5 passes in 23 minutes. His team lost 76-87. This year McGill averages 5.6ppg, 1.7rpg, 4.1apg and 1.4spg in seven games.
- 8. Jan Svandrlik** (6'6"-F-94, graduated '18, plays in Czech Republic) managed to help BK Opava to win against the sixth-ranked BK Olomoucko 90-85 in the Czech Republic NBL last Friday. Svandrlik scored only 3 points and grabbed 5 rebounds. This season Svandrlik averages 5.8ppg, 3.7rpg and 1.3spg.
- 9. Isaiah Williams** (6'7"-G/F-92, graduated '16, currently in Switzerland) contributed to an easy victory against one of league's weakest teams BBC Nyon 86-69 in the Swiss SBL on Saturday night. He scored 7 points and added 5 assists in 26 minutes. This year Williams averages 6.9ppg, 5.8rpg and 2.4apg in nine games.
- 10. TK Edogi** (6'8"-F-94, graduated '18, plays pro in Israel) couldn't help H. Ramat Gan in their game against Ironi Kiryat Ata in the Israeli National League (second division). Edogi scored 6 points, grabbed 5 rebounds and made 2 blocks. His team was edged 99-98. Edogi has relatively good stats this season 12.8ppg, 10.4rpg, 1.2apg and 2.2bpg. He is a naturalized Nigerian.

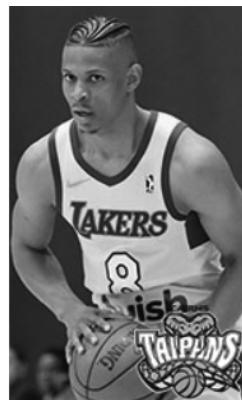

- Tim Cluess was named 12th head coach of the Iona College men's basketball program on April 8, 2010 and is in his 10th season with the Gaels.

- Came to New Rochelle with an impressive 20-year coaching resume after spending four seasons as head coach at LIU Post in Brookville, NY.

- One thing can be said, he is a winner. After spending 14 years as head coach at St. Mary's High School in Manhasset, NY, he spent the five years prior to arriving at Iona in the college ranks at Suffolk Community College and LIU Post.

- He amassed a 120-33 record and had unprecedented success at both schools.

- When combining his high school record, Cluess has won nearly 75 percent of his games coached.

- Led the Gaels to 20+ wins in each of his first eight seasons in New Rochelle, the only coach in school history to accomplish the feat. The Gaels won 25 games in three of them.

- Iona appeared in its ninth straight postseason tournament in 2019 including a CIT championship game appearance in 2011, the NCAA First Four in 2012 with the MAAC's second ever at-large bid, the 2013 NCAA tournament and the 2014 and 2015 NIT before returning to the 2016, 2017, 2018 and 2019 NCAA Tournaments.

- The Gaels were crowned MAAC Tournament Champions in 2013, 2016, 2017, 2018 and 2019 and MAAC Regular Season Champions in 2012, 2014, 2015 and 2019. The Cluess-led program set a school record with 17 conference wins in 2013-14 and 2014-15.

- Cluess was named MAAC Coach of the Year following the 2013-14 and 2018-19 campaigns.

- Under Cluess, Iona has consistently been among the top scoring teams in the nation. The Gaels finished 13th in 2010-11, first in both 2011-12 and 2012-13, fourth in 2013-14, fifth in 2014-15 and 27th in 2015-16 and Top 50 in 2016-17 and 2017-18.

- In each of his eight seasons at Iona, the team's scoring averages rank in the Top 12 in school history including a school record 83.6 points per game during the 2013-14 season.

- In addition to being the 2011-12 and 2012-13 NCAA scoring champions, the Gaels were NCAA statistical champs in total three-point field goals made in 2014-15 (344), three-point field goals per game (10.2/g) in 2013-14 and assists per game (19.3/g) in 2011-12.

- Other Top 10 NCAA statistical marks include fourth in assists in 2010-11 (17.4/g), second in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.54:1) and third in field goal percentage (50.8%) in 2011-12, second in free throw percentage (78.1%) in 2012-13 and

• Machado is one of several Iona Gaels to have played for Cluess to continue their playing careers in the professional ranks including: **Sean Armand**, **Vangelis Bebis**, **Taylor Bessick**, **Tre Bowman**, **Sam Cassell Jr.**, **Randy Dezouvre**, **TK Edogi**, **A.J. English**, **Mike Glover**, **Jayon James**, **Ra'Shad James**, **Lamont Jones**, **David Laury**, **Zach Lewis**, **Deyshonee Much**, **Ibn Muhammad**, **Chris Pelcher**, **Taaj Ridley**, **Alejo Rodriguez**, **Aaron Rountree**, **Jon Severe**, **Jan Svandrik**, **Jordan Washington**, and **Isaiah Williams**.

• Prior to Iona, Cluess' LIU Post Pioneers earned a 23-6 overall record in his last season, earning victories in 19 of their last 21 contests. The squad earned its fourth straight berth in the East Coast Conference championship game. Cluess was named the ECC Co-Coach of the Year for the third straight time.

• In 2008-09, LIU Post had its finest season in history, setting a school record with 30 victories. Standing among the top 10 teams in the nation from January through March in 2009, the Pioneers were ranked as high as No. 2 that year.

• The squad posted an undefeated regular season, winning all 24 games for the first time in school history. LIU Post won its second straight ECC regular season and tournament championship titles and defeated Bentley in overtime in front of thousands on their home court to win the NCAA East Region Championship title and advance to the Elite Eight Tournament in Springfield, Mass.

• For his outstanding efforts, Cluess was named the Basketball Times Division II Co-Coach of the Year as well as Metropolitan Basketball Writers Association Division II Coach of the Year for the second straight season.

• The 2007-08 season saw Cluess' squad post a 26-5 overall record, including an 18-2 clip in the conference. LIU Post claimed its first regular season and conference titles since the 2003-04 season with a 60-57 win to advance to the NCAA Northeast Regional at Bentley College. He was voted the ECC Coach of the Year by his peers, and was named the MWBA Division II Coach of the Year.

• In 2006-07, his first year at the helm, Cluess guided the Pioneers to a 19-11 record and an

appearance in the ECC Championship game. He improved the team's win total by six from the season before he took over the program.

• Cluess was named the eighth head men's basketball coach in the 50-year history of the Pioneers' program in April of 2006, after spending the 2005-06 campaign as the head men's basketball coach at Suffolk Community College in Brentwood, NY. He led a team of eight players to a 22-10 record overall, as well as a Region XV championship and a fourth-place finish in the NJCAA Division III Tournament. The trip to the national tournament was the first in the Longhorns' history, and Cluess was tabbed the District 5 Coach of the Year.

• Prior to his ascent to the college ranks, Cluess was a standout head coach at St. Mary's High School in Manhasset, NY from 1991-05, where the Gaels went a remarkable 264-78 (.772) during his tenure.

• St. Mary's won a record eight consecutive Nassau-Suffolk CHSAA league championships from 1997-98 to 2004-05. In that final season with Cluess as their mentor, the Gaels went 25-1 and finished the season ranked in the Top 20 nationally after holding the No. 1 ranking for eight weeks of the campaign.

• Cluess helped develop more than 50 players who moved on to the collegiate and professional ranks at St. Mary's including former North Carolina standout and current San Antonio Spur Danny Green.

• He won four state titles and two Federation championships at the Manhasset school. Cluess was a seven-time coach of the year in the high school ranks and earned tournament wins in national tournaments such as the Beach Ball Classic and the Las Vegas Prep Classic.

• Cluess played professional basketball in Europe and Australia after a collegiate career at both St. John's and Hofstra.

• He attended St. John's from 1978-81, before completing his coursework at Hofstra from 1982-83.

• Cluess holds a bachelor's degree in Accounting from Hofstra and currently resides in Floral Park, N.Y. with his wife, Karen, and their two children - Kevin and T.J.
