GRIFFS RIDE THREE-GAME WIN STREAK ON THE ROAD TO IONA

- ▶ The Canisius men's basketball team returns to the road this weekend for a pair of MAAC games, starting at Iona in New Rochelle, N.Y., tonight.
- ▶ The Griff's moved to 8-10 overall and 3-4 in MAAC play with a 95-86 win over Rider last Sunday. The 95 points scored by the Blue and Gold are the most for the team this season.
- ▶ The 95 points scored last Sunday also stand as the most for Canisius in a MAAC regular season game since Feb. 25, 2018, when the Griff's hung 98 points on Marist.
- ▶ The win over Rider extended Canisius' win streak to three. This marks the Griff's' second win streak of three-or-more games this season.

FASTBREAK POINTS

- ▶ Canisius' win over Rider last Sunday improved the team to 30-9 under fourth year head coach **Reggie Witherspoon** when scoring 80-or-more points in a game.
- ▶ In the last two games, Canisius has shot a 55.6 percent (65-for-117) from the field. The team's 60.7 percent effort from the floor in the win over Rider last Sunday was the program's best team field goal percentage effort since Feb. 25, 2018 when the Griff's shot 60.9 percent in a home victory over Marist.
- ▶ Canisius' reserves posted 26 points off the bench last Sunday against Rider, the 12th time this season the Griff's' bench players have scored 25-or-more points in a game.
- ▶ Senior **Malik Johnson** will start his 118th career game here tonight, which ties him with former Griff forward and Canisius Hall of Famer **Micheal Meeks** as the program's all-time leader in career games started.
- ▶ Johnson is coming off his second double-double of the season, as he scored 18 points to go with 11 assists in the win over Rider. Three of his four career double-double efforts have come with points and assists.
- ▶ Johnson is the reigning MAAC Player of the Week after he averaged 21.0 points, 8.5 assists and 5.5 rebounds per game last week. This is the second time this season he's been honored as the MAAC's Player of the Week.
- ▶ Freshman **Jacco Fritz** scored a career-high 17 points in the win over Rider, his sixth game this season with 10-or-more points in the scoring column.

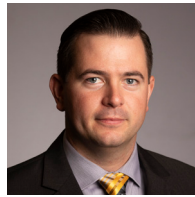

ON THIS DATE

JANUARY 24

- ▶ This marks the 19th time in program history where the Griffs have played on Jan. 24. The team is 7-11 in the previous 18 games played on this date.
- ▶ Canisius has played more games against St. Bonaventure on this date than any other opponent, as the Griffs have played the Bonnies four times on Jan. 24. That includes a 62-49 win by the No. 4 ranked Bonnies on Jan. 24, 1970.

LAST TIME OUT

CANISIUS 95, RIDER 86 • Jan. 19 | Koessler Athletic Center | Buffalo, N.Y.

- ▶ Canisius posted its third-straight win with a 95-86 victory over Siena Jan. 19 in the Koessler Athletic Center.
- ▶ The Griffs a season-high 60.7 percent from the field and drained nine 3-point field goals in the victory. The 95-point effort stands as the most points for the Blue and Gold this year.
- ▶ Senior **Malik Johnson** was one of five Griffs with 10-plus points in the scoring column. He was also good for a game-high 11 assists in that game for his second double-double effort of the season (fourth of his career).
- ▶ Freshman **Jacco Fritz** scored a career-high 17 points after going 7-for-10 from the floor, while sophomore **Jordan Henderson** added 16 points and a career-high five rebounds. All 10 Canisius players that were in uniform for Canisius last Sunday scored at least two points.
- ▶ The 95 points for Canisius are the most for the Blue and Gold in a MAAC regular season game Since Feb. 25, 2018, when the Griffs beat Marist 98-74 at the Koessler Athletic Center.

ABOUT THE GAELS

- ▶ Iona comes into tonight's game with an overall record of 4-9 overall and 2-4 in MAAC play.
- ▶ The Gaels are coming off an 83-73 loss at Marist last Sunday. Iona earned its first home win Jan. 17, when the team beat Fairfield, 64-57.
- ▶ As a team, Iona is averaging 68.3 points per game, which ranks sixth in the MAAC. Defensively, the Gaels allow 70.1 points per contest, which is ninth in the league.
- ▶ Senior guard **E.J. Crawford** leads Iona and ranks second in the MAAC in scoring average at 16.9 points per game. He has scored in double-figures in all 13 games this season.
- ▶ Fellow senior **Tajuan Agee** chips in 13.3 points per game, which ranks 11th in the conference, and his 7.8 rebounds per contest place him fourth in the MAAC.

CANISIUS - IONA SERIES HISTORY

- ▶ This is the 76th meeting between these two schools and Iona leads the series 42-33.
- ▶ Iona swept the regular-season series from Canisius in 2018-19. Prior to the two wins last year, the Griffs had won three-straight meetings.
- ▶ Iona's last five victories in this series have come by an average of 14.8 points per game.
- ▶ Canisius is 8-24 all-time in the Hynes Athletic Center. The Griffs' last win in New Rochelle, N.Y., came Jan. 21, 2018 when the Griffs scored an 84-82 victory.

MAAC MASTERS

- ▶ Since the start of the 2012-13 season, Canisius ranks third among the current MAAC schools with its 83 regular-season league wins.
- ▶ Only Iona (98 wins) and Rider (84 wins) have more victories during regular-season play in league than the Blue and Gold in that time.
- ▶ In the seven years prior to the 2012-13 season, Canisius won a total of 36 MAAC regular-season contests.

TOUGH LUCK MAAC START

- ▶ Canisius started league play this season with a 73-72 loss at Siena Dec. 23. That loss ended the Griffs' seven-year string of opening MAAC play with a victory.
- ▶ This year's one-point loss to the Saints to open league play marks just the fifth time in program history where Canisius' first MAAC game of the year was decided by one point. The Griffs are 3-2 in those games all-time, which have all come since the 1997-98 conference opener.

CLOSE, BUT NO CIGARS

- ▶ Last season, Canisius played in 14 games decided by five-points or less, and the Griffs led the nation with 11 wins in those 14 contests.
- ▶ The 2019-20 season has resulted in different outcome for the Blue and Gold in close games, as Canisius enters today's game with a 3-4 record in games decided by five or less, with three of those losses coming in MAAC play.

UP NEXT FOR THE GRIFFS

- ▶ Canisius closes out its weekend road swing on Sunday with a game at Fairfield. Tip-off in Alumni Hall is set for 2 p.m.
- ▶ Sunday's game at Fairfield will close out the regular-season series between the two Jesuit schools, as the Stags posted a 46-42 win over the Griffs in Buffalo back on Jan. 5.
- ▶ Canisius defeated Fairfield 73-68 in Alumni Hall last season on Jan. 19, 2019. That win in the Stags' on-campus home was the Blue and Gold's first since Jan. 10, 1998.

CANISIUS BASKETBALL

A NOTE FROM THE BOTTOM OF THE PAGE

- ▶ As fans of college basketball analytics website kenpom.com know, there are plenty of numbers available to help tell the tale of a team's season.
- ▶ According to kenpom.com, nine of the league's first 36 MAAC games this season have been classified as "close games" - meaning the final score was decided by four points or less. Canisius has played in four of those games.
- ▶ On the flip side, only two of the first 36 MAAC games to date have been deemed "blowouts", with one team winning by 19 points-or-more. Canisius has played in one of those two games.

OLD-SCHOOL SUCCESS

- ▶ In Canisius' win over Friday last Sunday, 56 of the Griffs' 95 total points came from 2-point field goals.
- ▶ Coming into tonight's game, 55.3 percent of Canisius' total points this season have come from the traditional 2-point area, which ranks 54th in the nation, according to kenpom.com.
- ▶ As a team, Canisius is averaging 70.7 points per game, which ranks third in the MAAC and 195th in the nation, despite the team ranking 297th nationally with 106 total makes from 3-point land.

THE GRIFFS NOT AFRAID TO SHOOT FROM DEEP

- ▶ Despite ranking 288th in the nation with 5.9 makes per game from 3-point land this season, the Griffs have proven they can get hot from behind the arc.
- ▶ With the season-high 15 makes from 3-point range at UIC Nov. 26, Canisius has made 10-or more treys 79 times since the start of the 2012-13 season.
- ▶ Canisius ended the 2018-19 season play by hitting 8.0 3-point makes per game, which ranked sixth in the MAAC and 145th in the country.

DROPPING DIMES

- ▶ The Griffs average 14.6 assists per game this season after the team had 23 assists in the win over Rider Jan. 19. The Blue and Gold starts tonight's game leading the MAAC in assists per game average, while also ranking 84th nationally.
- ▶ In the three previous seasons under head coach **Reggie Witherspoon**, Canisius has ranked in the top-100 nationally in assists per game three times, highlighted by the team's sixth-place finish following the 2016-17 campaign.

BUFFALO STEALERS

- ▶ As a team, Canisius has recorded five-or-more steals in 17 of the team's first 18 games this season. The team's 8.1 steals per game average ranks third in the MAAC and 50th in the nation.
- ▶ As a team, Canisius was credited with 15 steals in the loss to Manhattan Jan. 3. Those 15 steals are the most for the Griffs in a home game since the team had 13 swipes in a home victory over Siena Jan. 19, 2013.

TO GIVE AND TO TAKE

- ▶ As a team, Canisius is averaging 16.3 turnovers per game, which ranks 10th in the MAAC and 333rd in the nation.
- ▶ However, thanks to forcing a league-best 16.9 opponent turnovers per game (25th best in the nation), the Griffs' rank fourth in the league and 159th in the nation with a +0.6 turnover margin.

OFFENSIVE ON THE GLASS

- ▶ After grabbing a season-low two offensive rebounds at Siena Dec. 23, Canisius has responded by pulling down a total of 77 offensive rebounds in the last seven games, including a season-high 17 in the road loss at Pitt Dec. 30.
- ▶ The Blue and Gold enters tonight's game averaging 10.2 offensive rebounds per game, which ranks fourth in the MAAC and 175th in the nation.

THAT 70s SHOW

- ▶ Under head coach **Reggie Witherspoon**, the Griffs are 52-24 when posting 70 points-or-more on the scoreboard.

GRIFFS GO SHARPIE

- ▶ The Griffs are 94-3 since the start of 2013-14 when leading at the 2:00 mark of the second half of a game.
- ▶ The Griffs are 87-9 since 2013-14 when leading at the 5:00 mark in the second half.

PROTECT THIS HOUSE

- ▶ The Griffs own an all-time record of 242-147 (.622 win percentage) in the Koessler Athletic Center. The team is 121-115 (.513 win percentage) since 2001.
- ▶ Canisius did not use the Koessler Center as its main home venue until 1999-00.

TO GIVE AND TO TAKE

- ▶ Senior **Malik Johnson** was credited with two steals in the win over Siena Jan. 17, the 49th time in his career where he's recorded two-or-more steals in a contest.
- ▶ His career-high seven steals vs. Holy Cross at home Dec. 14 stand the most for a Canisius player since **Craig Wise** had seven swipes against St. Bonaventure in The Aud on Jan. 25, 1994, and it also serves as the most steals for a player at the Koessler Athletic Center since former Griff **Harry Seymour** set the building record with nine steals in a game against Vermont on Jan. 28, 1991.
- ▶ Johnson enters tonight's game leading the MAAC and ranking 14th in the nation with his 2.4 steals per outing this season.

- ▶ Senior **Malik Johnson** not only leads the Griffs in scoring average, assists per game average and steals per game average, but he's also the team's top rebounder with his 5.9 rebounds per outing.
- ▶ Johnson starts tonight's game ranked eighth in the MAAC with his 5.9 boards per outing. He is the only player in the league's top-20 rebounders that is listed under 6-foot tall.

RANKING AMONG THE NATION'S BEST

- ▶ **Malik Johnson** starts tonight's game ranked among the top-20 nationally among all Division I players with his 562 career assists and 182 career steals.
- ▶ As of Jan. 23, Johnson ranks eighth among all Division I players with his 5621 career assists, which also makes him the MAAC's active career leader in assists.
- ▶ Johnson is also the MAAC's active career leader in career steals with 182 to his credit, which ranks 14th nationally among all Division I players.

MANY-MINUTE MAN

- ▶ **Malik Johnson** has played in 511 of a possible 520 minutes in the Griffs' last 12 games.
- ▶ Johnson has played 95.6 percent of Canisius' minutes this season. That ranks fourth nationally among all Division I players.

MAJESTY'S MAGICAL RUN

- ▶ Junior **Majesty Brandon** comes into this game having scored a total of 133 points in the team's last eight games, an average of 16.6 points per game.
- ▶ Brandon, who is averaging 12.7 points per game this season, ranks second on Canisius' roster in scoring average. Through the team's first seven MAAC games, he's good for 14.1 points per outing, which ties him for eighth in the league.

CANISIUS BASKETBALL

MAJESTY BECOMES A VIRAL SENSATION

- ▶ Junior guard **Majesty Brandon** has a unique routine before each free-throw he takes, and on Jan. 19, that routine made him a viral superstar on social media.
- ▶ ESPN's SportsCenter tweeted and posted Brandon's free-throw routine to its Twitter and Instagram channels, showing nearly 15 million followers how Brandon gets ready to shoot from the free-throw stripe.
- ▶ As of Jan. 23, Brandon's free-throw routine before two late charity tosses against Rider have been viewed more than 2.1 million times.

MAJESTY'S MAAC DEBUT

- ▶ Junior guard **Majesty Brandon** scored a career-high 30 points in the team's road loss to Siena Dec. 23, setting a new program record for most points scored by a Griff in their first career MAAC game.
- ▶ Brandon's 30 points came on the power of seven 3-point field goals, the most 3-point makes in a game for a Griff since the 2017-18 campaign.
- ▶ Despite being in just his first year with the program, the Bronx, N.Y., native is the only active player on Canisius' roster to have scored 30-or-more points in a game.

HITCHON HIGHLIGHTS

- ▶ Canisius junior **Scott Hitchon** scored a career-high 29 points in the team's loss at Buffalo, Dec. 18. That stands as a school record for points scored in a game by a Canisius player in UB's Alumni Arena.
- ▶ Hitchon is just the sixth player in program history to score 29-or-more points in a road game against Buffalo, Niagara and St. Bonaventure.
- ▶ The Whitby, Ontario native has scored in double-figures in six of the team's last nine games. In the team's last five games, he's averaging 10.0 points per game while shooting 56.3 percent from the field.

HITCHON SHOWING HIS SHOOTER'S TOUCH

- ▶ Canisius junior **Scott Hitchon** is shooting 48.1 percent from the floor this season, and in MAAC games, he's hitting 54.9 percent of his shots from the field.
- ▶ In the Griffs' last five games, the Whitby, Ontario native is shooting 56.3 percent from the floor, while knocking down 77.3 percent of his shots from the free-throw line.
- ▶ Hitchon comes into tonight's contest ranked seventh in the league in field goal percentage and eighth in the conference in free-throw shooting percentage at 77.6 percent.

HARRIED GETTING INTO THE FLOW

- ▶ Canisius freshman **Armon Harried** has started all 18 games for the Griffs this season. On Jan. 13, he was named MAAC's Rookie of the Week for the second time in a three-week span.
- ▶ The son of former Syracuse big man **Herman "Tree" Harried**, Armon is averaging 7.6 points and 4.6 rebounds per game in the team's last five outings.
- ▶ Harried joined the Golden Griffin program after leading Lake Clifton High School to back-to-back Maryland Class 1A state championships. Last season, he averaged 29.4 points per game with three double-double efforts in Lake Clifton's title run. To cap his scholastic career, he scored 35 points in the title game.

THREE TIMES A CHARM

- ▶ On Dec. 2, Canisius freshman **Jacco Fritz** was named the MAAC's Rookie of the Week, which marked the third-straight week the Tiel, Netherlands native earned the award.
- ▶ By earning that honor Dec. 2, Fritz became the first player in program history to earn a MAAC weekly honor in three consecutive weeks, and he became the second MAAC freshman to win the award in three-straight weeks in the last two seasons, joining Siena's **Jalen Pickett**, who garnered the league's top-rookie award on multiple occasions last season.
- ▶ Fritz scored a career-high 17 points in the Griffs' win over Rider Jan. 19 after he went 7-for-10 from the field and 2-for-2 from the free-throw line. He also grabbed six rebounds and dished out a career-high five assists.
- ▶ On the year, Fritz is averaging 7.6 points per game, and his 64.5 percent success rate from the field ranks first among Canisius players with at least 75 field goal attempts.

CAREER-DAY ON THE BOARDS FOR WHITE

- ▶ Canisius junior **Jalanni White** came off the bench to score 16 points to go along with a career-high nine rebounds in the team's road loss at Pitt Dec. 30.
- ▶ Of his career-high nine boards against the Panthers, six came off the offensive glass. He also matched career-highs with two assists and two steals in a season best 31 minutes of action.
- ▶ On Jan. 17, the New Haven, Conn., native posted 13 points and seven rebounds off the bench in the win over Siena. Of his seven rebounds, four came off the offensive glass. He is tied for 10th in the MAAC with 1.9 offensive rebounds per game.

WHAT CAN BROWN DO FOR THE GRIFFS?

- ▶ Canisius welcomes senior **Corey Brown** to the 2019-20 roster as a graduate transfer from Northern Arizona. Jan. 19 marked his 100th career collegiate game after starting his career at Northern Arizona.
- ▶ Brown sat out the 2018-19 season, what was to be his senior year at Northern Arizona, with an injury. By joining the Canisius program, he becomes just the third grad transfer in program history and the first under head coach **Reggie Witherspoon**.
- ▶ The Hollywood, Fla., native joins with former Griff **Chris Perez** (2013-14) and **Malcolm McMillan** (2015-16) as the only three graduate transfer in school history.

A FIRST ZERO

- ▶ Canisius freshman **Akrum Ahemed** is wearing jersey No. 0, making him the first player in program history to wear just a single zero on his jersey.
- ▶ Six players in program history have worn "00", with the most recent double-zero on the Canisius roster being former Griff **Ronnie Gombe**, who played for the team from 2015-17.

GRIFFS WITHOUT TWO GUARDS

- ▶ Canisius will be without the services of junior guards **Sam Rautins** (lower body) and freshman guard **Akrum Ahemed** (foot). Both players are currently listed as "out".

CANISIUS IN KEYBANK CENTER

- ▶ Canisius' 61-57 win over St. Bonaventure at KeyBank Center Nov. 23 improved the Griff's to 29-19 all-time in the downtown Buffalo arena.
- ▶ The Griff's are now 4-2 all-time against St. Bonaventure at KeyBank Center, with wins coming in each of the last two meetings (including a 68-66 win on Nov. 29, 2009).

GRIFFS MAKE WAVES IN THE WINDY CITY

- ▶ Canisius' 94-64 win at UIC Nov. 26 stands as the program's largest margin of victory under fourth-year head coach **Reggie Witherspoon**.
- ▶ The 94 points for the Blue and Gold at UIC are the most for the program in a regulation road game since Dec. 9, 2012 when the team beat Marist 94-82 in Poughkeepsie, N.Y.
- ▶ The Griff's victory over UIC stands as the program's largest margin of victory on the road in a non-league game since Dec. 1, 1976 when the Blue and Gold beat St. Michael's 100-70 in Colchester, Vt.
- ▶ The win at UIC also marked the program's first in the city of Chicago since Dec. 15, 1959, when the Griff's defeated Loyola University Chicago 73-68.

DUKE GETS THE CALL TO THE HALL

- ▶ On Dec. 5, Canisius College officially introduced its 2019 Sports Hall of Fame Class, and former Griff's guard **Duane "Duke" Richardson '82** is part of the induction class.
- ▶ Richardson played two seasons at Canisius (1978-79 and 1979-80) after transferring from Niagara County Community College. He played 53 games and set program records for assists in a single-season (215 in 1978-79), assists per game average (8.3 in 1978-79) and career assists per game average (7.0).
- ▶ Richardson will be formally inducted in the Canisius Sports Hall of Fame on Saturday, Feb. 29, when the Griff's play host to Saint Peter's at the Koessler Athletic Center.

ALL-SESQUICENTENNIAL TEAM

- ▶ In honor of Canisius' 150th anniversary, the athletic department formally introduced the men's basketball program's "All-Sesquicentennial Team" on Nov. 23, when the Griff's played host to St. Bonaventure at KeyBank Center.
- ▶ The team, which was voted on by Canisius fans through an on-line poll at GoGriffs.com, represent some of the greatest players to ever wear the Blue and Gold.

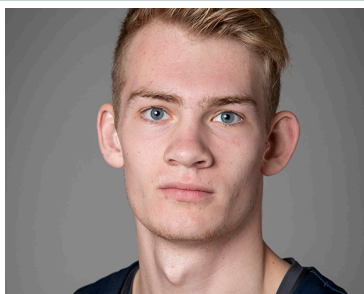

- ▶ A two-time Mid-American Conference Coach of the Year (2004, 2012), he boasted a record of 174-143 in his last 10 years with the Buffalo program.
- ▶ Witherspoon has a MAC regular-season crown, two trips to the MAC Tournament title game, an NIT berth, two bids to the College Basketball Invitational (CBI) and a pair of trips to the CollegenInsider.com Postseason Tournament (CIT) on his head coaching resume.
- ▶ Witherspoon has also coached at the international level, as he has assisted with USA Basketball and the national under-18 team program two times. In 2006, he worked with the USA U-18 tryout team that featured **Blake Griffin**, **Michael Beasley**, **Jared Bayless** and **Kyle Singler**. In 2010, he was an assistant coach under **Jeff Capel** and worked with **Kyrie Irving**, **Austin Rivers** and **Patric Young**.
- ▶ Witherspoon began his coaching career at his high school alma mater - Sweet Home High School in the north suburbs of Buffalo.
- ▶ As a player, Witherspoon played for two seasons at Erie Community College, where his head coach was **John Beilein**. Beilein later went on to be the Canisius head coach from 1992-97, and he now he serves as the head coach of the Cleveland Cavaliers.
