UNDER THE HAT

•**Rob Perry** scored 34 points against Western Illinois on Nov. 9, the most by a Stetson freshman since 1983

•Perry earned ASUN Newcomer of the Week for that performance, Stetson's first conference weekly award by a freshman since the 2017-18 season

•Perry enters the weekend leading the ASUN in 3FG percentage (.550, 11-20) and ranks second in scoring (17.0 ppg), while fellow freshman **Mahamadou Diawara** is second in overall field-goal percentage (.621)

•Stetson produced some eye-popping numbers in its 84-26 win over Trinity Baptist on Nov. 5:

-The Hatters limited the Eagles to 14.5 percent shooting from the field, the lowest for a Stetson opponent since Flagler shot 25.8 percent on Nov. 19, 2004. That mark is believed to be the lowest in the program's modern history (post-World War II). For context, the NCAA record for lowest single-game field-goal percentage is 13.3 percent by Dayton against Miami (Ohio), on Dec. 29, 2001.

-The 58-point margin of victory was the largest for the Hatters during the program's modern (post-World War II) era. Stetson has sponsored basketball since 1900.

-Trinity's 26 points were the fewest by a Stetson opponent since Tampa also scored 26 points against the Hatters on Feb. 8, 1946 (W, 47-26)

•The Hatters tied a school record with 11 blocked shots vs. Trinity Baptist. Four different players blocked at least 2 shots.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

- Stetson embarks on the most challenging portion of its schedule this weekend, as the Hatters begin a stretch of four games in five days at the ASUN/MAAC Challenge at ESPN's Wide World of Sports. The Hatters will face Iona (Friday) and Monmouth (Saturday) in Orlando, before returning home to host Western Carolina (Sunday) and Florida College (Tuesday).
- The Hatters are 0-2 all-time against Iona, 0-2 against Monmouth, and 4-1 against Western Carolina
- Stetson last faced Iona and Monmouth in DeLand in December of 1991. The Hatters and Catamounts last met in 2001.
- This weekend will mark Stetson's first games at the HP Field House since the Wide World of Sports Complex first opened in 1997

LAST TIME OUT

Stetson's **Rob Perry** led all scorers with 17 points but No. 10 Ohio State proved to be too much for the Hatters as the Buckeyes raced to an 86-51 victory, Monday at Schottenheim Center in Columbus, Ohio.

Perry was 5 of 14 from the field and 4 of 7 from 3-point range, adding a team-high 8 rebounds to his line. Ohio State was led by Kyle Young, who recorded a double-double with 25 points and 10 boards.

The Buckeyes (4-0) limited Stetson to 14 percent shooting in the first half (4-28). Ohio State countered with 48 percent shooting in the opening 20 minutes and led 42-14 at half-time.

Stetson (2-2) regrouped somewhat in the second half, shooting 41 percent from the field, but by then it was too late.

Mahamadou Diawara scored all 9 of his points in the second half. Christiaan Jones also finished with 9 points for Stetson.

Kaleb Wesson (13) and D.J. Carton (10) joined Young in double figures for the Buckeyes.

PERRY NAMED ASUN NEWCOMER OF THE WEEK

Rob Perry was named ASUN Conference Newcomer of the Week on Nov. 11.

Perry earned the weekly honor on the strength of his exceptional performance in Stetson's 77-75 win at Western Illinois last Saturday. The Orlando, Fla., native scored 34 points – the most by a Hatter freshman since 1983 – as Stetson earned its first road win since the end of the 2017-18 season.

Perry scored 25 of his points against the Leathernecks in the second half. His play in the final minutes was instrumental in Stetson's success as he scored seven straight points during one late-game stretch, turning a 65-64 Stetson lead into a 72-64 advantage with 1:38 to play.

Overall, Perry was 12 of 18 from the field with 6 three-pointers. He also added 7 rebounds and a pair of assists.

In two games last week, Perry averaged 20.0 points, 6.0 rebounds and 2.0 assists.

THE DONNIE JONES ERA

The 2019-20 season marks the beginning of the **Donnie Jones** era at Stetson. Named the 22nd head coach in program history on April 1, 2019, Jones is in his 10th season as a collegiate head coach. In previous stops at Marshall (2007-10) and UCF (2010-16), Jones won 155 games overall, capturing 20 or more wins four times. As a longtime assistant coach at Florida, Jones helped the Gators to a pair of

McSPADDEN SUFFERS INJURY

Stetson men's basketball announced on Nov. 4 that graduate transfer guard **Chance McSpadden** recently suffered a season-ending injury.

McSpadden, a 6-4 guard from Winter Haven, Fla., transferred to Stetson at the beginning of the summer after four seasons at UCF, where he originally played for current Stetson head coach **Donnie Jones**.

KEEPING IT IN THE FAMILY

Stetson head coach **Donnie Jones** has built a coaching staff with a lot of familiar faces. His three assistant coaches - **Jonathan Mitchell**, **Brendan Suhr**, and **Adam Williams** -- have all either previously played for Jones, coached with Jones, or both.

Mitchell was originally recruited to Florida by Jones as a student-athlete. Mitchell later transferred to Rutgers before embarking on a professional playing career overseas. He spent last season as a graduate assistant at Georgia.

Suhr, the longtime NBA assistant coach who won a pair of championships as an assistant with the Chuck Daly-coached Detroit Pistons, has known Jones for over 20 years and served as an assistant coach and Director of Program Development for Jones at UCF from 2010-15.

A West Virginia native like Jones, Williams played for Jones at Marshall before coaching under him at both Marshall as a graduate assistant, and for three seasons as the Director of Operations at UCF (2012-15).

PARLEZ-VOUS BASKETBALL?

If you're a member of the 2019-20 Stetson Hatters the answer is probably "yes". The Hatters currently have five players and one assistant coach who are fluent in French. Sophomores **Cyriaque Foucart** and **Alex Ionesco** are French natives, and **Mahamadou Diawara** (Mali), **Ricky Gouety** (Ivory Coast) and **Joel Kabimba** (D.R. Congo) hail from African countries where French is the primary -- if not official -- language. Additionally, assistant coach **Jonathan Mitchell** is fluent in French after spending several years playing professionally in Europe.

DIGGING DEEPER

- Stetson has made at least one 3-point field goal in 459 consecutive games after making 8 on Monday at Ohio State
- Stetson's last game without a trey was vs. Colorado State on Dec. 28, 2004
- Freshman **Rob Perry** has scored in double figures in each Stetson's last three games, including a 17-point effort on Monday at No. 10 Ohio State. Through games of Nov. 20, Perry leads all ASUN newcomers in scoring at 17 points per game.
- Basketball has become an international game and Stetson's 2019-20 roster certainly reflects that as the Hatters boast players from six different countries, including the United States. Stetson has players from Canada (**Wheza Panzo**), France (**Cyriaque Foucart**, **Alex Ionesco**), Democratic Republic of Congo (**Joel Kabimba**), Mali (**Mahamadou Diawara**), Ivory Coast (**Ricky Gouety**) and the U.S. (Aninye, Crutchfield, Griffith, Hollmann, Ivory, Jones, Perry, Rawley).
- Stetson will face eight opponents in 2019-20 who reached the postseason last year. Those opponents are: Iona, Liberty, Ohio State (NCAA); Lipscomb (NIT Finals); FIU, Kent State, NJIT (CIT); and Longwood (CBI).
- The Hatters will be visiting four new cities in 2019-20. Stetson will make its first-ever visits to Macomb, Ill. (Western Illinois), Kent, Ohio (Kent State), Lexington, Va. (VMI), and Asheville, N.C. (UNC Asheville).

JONES, RAWLEY WIN ASUN FAN VOTE

Stetson's **Christiaan Jones** and **Jahlil Raw-**

ley were voted as the preseason ASUN Player and Defensive Player of the Year, respectively, in Facebook fan polling, the league office announced in October.

Jones, a junior, averaged 10.4 points and 3.9 rebounds per game as a sophomore, while Rawley collected 35 steals a season ago.

HATTERS ADD THREE DURING EARLY SIGNING PERIOD

Stetson head coach **Donnie Jones** recently announced the signing of three student-athletes for the 2020-21 season:

Gabriel Wuor, 7-1, F, Wesley (Ky.) Christian HS
Wuor spent last season at Trinity International School in Las Vegas, Nev. Through his first three games at Wesley this season, Wuor is averaging 14 points, 9 rebounds and 5 blocked shots per game. In his most recent outing, Wuor had 18 points, 7 rebounds, 4 blocked shots and a pair of assists against Beckley Prep. Wuor spent last summer participating in the highly regarded DENG Camp, hosted and run by former NBA All-Star Luol Deng. At the July camp in Dallas, Wuor was named as the camp's Most Improved Player.

Keith Lamar, 6-5, G, Eagle's Landing (Ga.) HS
Lamar was a key member of a powerful Eagle's Landing squad which went 23-5 and was undefeated (16-0) on its way to a Region 4AAAAA championship. Lamar averaged 10.2 points per game as a junior, scoring 33 points in a win over rival Henry County. Lamar appears poised for an outstanding senior year. He was recently named pre-season 2nd-team All-State by the Georgia High School Association, and was ranked No. 21 among all seniors in Georgia by HoopSeen.com.

GianCarlo Valdez, 6-3, G, Decatur (Ala.) Heritage Christian
Valdez enjoyed a stellar junior season, averaging 18.9 points, 4.6 rebounds, 2.8 assists and 1.9 steals per game, earning first-team All-State honors along the way. Valdez made a name for himself during the state tournament last season with some spectacular play. In the semifinals against Georgiana, Valdez stole the ball at half court in the final seconds and hit a buzzer-beating layup for a 60-58 win. He followed that effort with a 23-point performance in the title game three days later as the Eagles defeated St. Luke's Episcopal. The Dominican native is also no stranger to international competition. He played for the Dominican U17 team at the 2018 FIBA U17 Basketball World Cup, averaging 6.3 points, 2.5 rebounds, 1.3 assists in 6 games. His best performance was a 15-point effort against Mali. Valdez enters his senior season ranked No. 6 among all seniors in the state by Prep Hoops Alabama.

HATTERS BROADCAST INFO

Stetson men's basketball will make a total of 28 appearances on national streaming platforms and one appearance on national television during the 2019-20 season.

For the sixth straight season, the Hatters and the ASUN Conference will partner with ESPN to stream all home and away conference games on ESPN+. Veteran broadcasters Evan Weston and Greg Turner will handle play-by-play and color commentary duties, respectively.

Production of all home broadcasts is coordinated by Stetson Broadcast Productions.

Additionally, the Hatters are scheduled to have at least three games carried on ESPN3 and one on SEC Network+, with one game yet-to-be-determined.

The Hatters will make their lone national television appearance on Nov. 18 when Stetson's game at Ohio State is carried on the Big Ten Network.

In addition, the Hatters return to radio this year as all home games will be broadcast on WSBB AM 1230 & 1490 in New Smyrna Beach. Newcomer Kenny Schierlinger will handle play-by-play duties.

ABOUT STETSON UNIVERSITY

Stetson is located in DeLand, Fla., with a second campus in Gulfport, Fla. and two satellite centers. Founded in 1883 by Henry A. DeLand as the DeLand Academy and later renamed Stetson University to honor its benefactor, Philadelphia hat maker John B. Stetson, the university has a storied history of leadership, values and significance. The university is home to many Florida firsts, including the first collegiate newspaper, the oldest schools of business administration and music, the first college of law and the state's first private university to integrate.

Notable athletic alums include 2014 & 2017 American League Cy Young Award winner Corey Kluber; 2014 National League Rookie of the Year & two-time (2018, 2019) NL Cy Young Award winner Jacob deGrom; former NBA forward Lorenzo Williams; Ray Finkle, former Miami Dolphins kicker, later a police chief in Miami and one helluva model American; Atlanta Falcons President & CEO Rich McKay; college basketball Hall of Fame inductee Dr. Glenn Wilkes; Jacksonville Jaguars linebacker Donald Payne; and PGA Tour member Sam Ryder.

Some of the more notable non-athletic alums include actor Ted Cassidy, who played

Lurch the Butler in TV's The Addams Family; former U.S. Senator Max Cleland (D-Ga.); composer Gerard Marino; country singer Wilma Burgess; Charles E. Merrill, founder of Merrill Lynch; and former Marine Corps General Roy Geiger.

DONNIE JONES

HEAD COACH • FIRST SEASON • PIKEVILLE '88

Donnie Jones was introduced as the 22nd men's basketball head coach in Stetson history at a press conference on April 1, 2019.

Jones comes to Stetson following a one-year stint as assistant coach at Dayton. The former head coach at UCF (2010-16) and Marshall (2007-10), Jones has also served as an assistant at Pikeville, Marshall, Wichita State, and Florida, helping lead the Gators to a pair of national titles.

"I began to follow Donnie Jones when he was an assistant coach at the University of Florida," Altier said. "Donnie was an integral part of creating the highest standard of basketball success ever for a school in the south. I watched closely as Donnie led the programs at Marshall and UCF, elevating their recruiting to the highest level and engaging fans, ticketholders and the community as never before.

"Every program Donnie has touched has been characterized by setting a new standard of performance on the court, classroom and in the community. Donnie is the perfect fit for us, and will help us advance the Stetson basketball program to new heights."

In nine seasons combined at UCF and Marshall, Jones compiled a 155-129 (.546) overall record and led his teams to three post-season tournaments, including the NIT in 2012 with UCF. Nearly half of his teams – four – have produced 20-win seasons.

"I'm so excited and grateful to be a part of the Stetson Hatter family," Jones said. "I appreciate the opportunity to help build a culture and a style of play that will be exciting to play and fun to watch."

Long considered one of the top recruiters in the country, Jones has a history of securing top-shelf talent. During his time as an assistant at Florida, Jones helped the Gators recruit and sign 11 McDonald's All-American and 12 eventual National Basketball Association draft selections, including Matt Bonner, David Lee, Mike Miller and Jason Williams. At Marshall, Jones signed and coached current Miami Heat center Hassan Whiteside.

A native of Point Pleasant, W. Va., Jones has been coaching college basketball for 30 years and has experienced more than 700 wins in his coaching career. His career began as an assistant at his alma mater, Pikeville College in Pikeville, Ky., where he spent two seasons before moving on to Marshall as a graduate assistant (1990-92).

Jones was elevated to a full-time position in 1992 and stayed on staff after Billy Donovan joined the Herd in 1994. After four seasons at Marshall, Jones joined Donovan at Florida in 1996.

At Florida, Jones helped Donovan and the Gators to 261 victories, nine NCAA Tournament appearances, and NCAA National Championships in 2006 and 2007.

After 10 seasons at Florida, Jones returned to Marshall for his first head coaching job. In three seasons with the Thundering Herd, he was 55-41, winning 24 games and reaching the quarterfinals of the CIT in 2010.

On the heels of his success with Marshall, Jones was named head coach at UCF in the spring of 2010 and spent six seasons with the Knights, amassing 100 wins and reaching the postseason twice (CBI Quarterfinals, 2011; NIT First Round, 2012). Jones won 20 games in each of his first three seasons in Orlando before the Knights left Conference USA for the American Athletic Conference.

In 2016 he worked as a scout for the Los Angeles Clippers before joining the staff at Wichita State for the 2017-18 season. This season Jones teamed up with former fellow Florida assistant Anthony Grant at Dayton, joining the Flyers' staff for the recently completed season.

A 1988 graduate of Pikeville, Jones is a member of the Pikeville athletic Hall of Fame. He also earned a Master's degree in Sports Management from Marshall in 1992.

Jones and his wife, Michelle, have three children: daughter Madisyn, a freshman at Stetson; son Isaac, and daughter Sophie.
