The No. 9 seed Iona College men's basketball team (9-5, 6-3 MAAC) takes on No. 1 Siena (12-4, 12-4 MAAC) in the quarterfinal round of the 2021 Hercules Tires MAAC Championship at Jim Whalen Boardwalk Hall Wednesday night on ESPN+.

## WHY NINE? DRIVE FOR FIVE?

- Despite owning the second-best winning percentage in the conference, due to this season's tiebreaker, the Gaels will serve as the No. 9 seed.
- With the 2020 Championship canceled before completion last year due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Iona still remains the four-time defending MAAC Tournament Champion.
- The Maroon & Gold look to climb a steep hill in its Drive for Five straight titles, needing to win four games in five days to accomplish the feat.

## THE GAELS IN MAAC TOURNAMENT PLAY

In 40 years as a member of the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference, Iona has compiled an all-time record of 58-27 (.682) record in the league's postseason tournament - including a league-record 12 titles. The .682 winning percentage is highest in MAAC history (Siena, 40-25, .615).

## INSIDE THE MAAC TOURNAMENT FORMAT

Eleven teams vie for the MAAC Championship for the eighth straight year, with the current bracket introduced in 2014. The tournament continues its single-bye format for the 13th straight season. For the sixth straight season, the top two seeds earn a day off before the semifinal round with a quarterfinal win. Iona appears in the first round of the MAAC Championship for in back-to-back seasons for the first time since 2008 and 2009.

## GAELS IN MAAC REGULAR SEASON PLAY

Since the inception of the MAAC in the 1981-82 season, Iona has compiled a 403-252 (.615) record in regular season conference play. The Gaels' 403 wins and .615 winning percentage are the highest of any current MAAC member. The Gaels became the first MAAC team to reach 400 wins with its win at Rider on Dec. 19. Iona is currently 88 wins ahead of Manhattan, the No. 2 team on the list.

## BUSTING THE (MAAC) BRACKET

- The No. 9 seed has never reached the MAAC Championship game in the event's history
- The lowest seed to reach the MAAC final was Fairfield, a No. 8 seed, in 1997.
- Iona is the No. 9 seed for the first time in history.
- **The Gaels are 6-2 all time vs. the No. 1 seed, 0-0 in the 1/9 game.**

## ROSS, JUNIOR JOSEPH NAMED ALL-MAAC

- Seniors **Isaiah Ross** and freshman **Nelly Junior Joseph** added their names to the long list of Iona College men's basketball All-MAAC performers.
- Ross, a preseason All-MAAC Second Team selection was named to the postseason first team after leading the league in scoring during the regular season.
- By virtue of his first team selections, Ross is a candidate for the MAAC's Player of the Year award, announced Wednesday morning.
- In his first season with the Maroon & Gold, Junior Joseph was named to the All-Rookie Team and is a candidate for Rookie of the Year, also announced Wednesday.
- Junior **Berrick JeanLouis** is Iona's candidate for Defensive Player of the Year while freshman **Ryan Myers** is the team's candidate for MAAC Sixth Player of the Year.

## MAJOR AWARDS HISTORY

- **Isaiah Ross** looks to become the eighth MAAC Player of the Year in program history and first since David Laury in 2015.
- **Nelly Junior Joseph** looks to become the fourth MAAC Rookie of the Year in program history and first since Schadrac Casimir in 2015.

## ALL-MAAC FIRST TEAM SELECTION OVER THE LAST DECADE-PLUS

- For the 10th time in 11 seasons, Iona enters the MAAC Championship at least one All-MAAC First Team selection.
- **Isaiah Ross** joins Gael greats **Mike Glover** (2011, 2012), **Scott Machado** (2011, 2012), **Lamont Jones** (2013), **Sean Armand** (2014), **David Laury** (2015), **A.J. English** (2014, 2015, 2016), **Jordan Washington** (2017), **Rickey McGill** (2019), and **E.J. Crawford** (2019, 2020) as First Team honorees since the 2010-11 campaign.
- Three years ago, Iona snapped a MAAC record for consecutive seasons with a player on the All-MAAC First Team, spanning seven years.
- Siena had seven straight from 2006-2012, Manhattan (2000-2005) and La Salle (1987-1992) recorded six straight and the Gaels (1997-2001) had five.

## TOP DOG

- Senior **Isaiah Ross** finished the truncated 2020-21 regular season averaging 20.5 points per game, leading the MAAC in scoring.
- Ross is the seventh Iona player to lead the MAAC in scoring, with Steve Burt senior owning the honor in the league's first three seasons.
- The Gaels have boasted back-to-back scoring champs following **E.J. Crawford's** 18.8 ppg last year.
- It is the first time a MAAC school has had a back-to-back scoring champs since Saint Peter's **Keydren Clark** led the league for four straight seasons from 2002-2006.
- It is the second time in MAAC history a school has had different players in back-to-back represent the league's scoring champ. (Niagara **Alvin Young, Demond Stewart**, 1998-2000).

## SULTAN OF SWIPE

- Junior **Berrick JeanLouis** led the MAAC in the regular season with 2.31 steals per game.
- It is the third time in the last five years an Iona player has led the league in steals, following **Rickey McGill** in 2016-18 and 2018-19.
- Former Gael great Rickey Soliver also led the league in steals in 2005-06.

## ABOUT CONFERENCE TOURNAMENT TITLES

- Iona is the only NCAA Division I program to capture its last four straight completed conference tournament championships and holds the nation's longest active streak.
- Only four programs have won at least five tournament titles from 2011-2019. Iona's five during the time frame is only eclipsed by New Mexico State (7) and Gonzaga (6) while matching the mark of South Dakota State.

**AT LONG LAST**

- Iona College men's basketball tipped off on Feb. 12 at the Hynes Center after a 51-day layoff due to COVID-19 issues within the program.
- It was the longest layoff in NCAA Division I this season. Four programs have experienced gaps in playing time of more than 40 days including the Gaels' MAAC counterpart Canisius.

**MULTIPLE TIME PLAYER/ROOKIE OF THE WEEK**

- Senior **Isaiah Ross** took home his third MAAC Player of the Week honor this season on Dec. 28 and second straight following a stellar effort vs. Towson.
- Ross became seventh player in program history to win at least three in a single-season. He is the first since **A.J. English** in 2015-16 to accomplish the feat.
- Ross and English are joined by **Mikkel Larsen** (1994-95), **Mindaugas Timinskas** (1996-97), **Tariq Kirksay** (1997-98), **Mike Glover** (2010-11, 2011-12) and **Scott Machado** (2011-12) as three time winners. Timinskas won five during his senior campaign while Glover and Machado won four each.
- Rookie **Nelly Junior Joseph** earned his fourth weekly honor as MAAC Rookie of the Week on Feb. 15. He has earned the award in four of the five weeks Iona has played.
- Junior Joseph is the fourth Gael to win three or more MAAC Rookie of the Week honors, joining Machado (2008-09), English (2012-13) and **Schadrac Casimir** (2014-15). Casimir's eight awards and Machado's six led to MAAC Rookie of the Year accolades.

**THE (OTHER) BIG STORY**

- Iona College enters its first season under Hall of Fame head coach **Rick Pitino** in 2020-21
- Coach Pitino was tabbed to lead the program on March 14, 2020 after **Tim Cluess** stepped down for health reasons following the most successful decade in Iona basketball history.
- Coach Pitino spent the last two seasons Panathinaikos B.C. (PAN-ah-tin-IKE-ohs) in the EuroLeague in Greece.
- The Naismith Hall of Famer begins his 32nd year as a head coach of an NCAA Division I program.
- Coach Pitino has led Hawaii, Boston University, Providence, Kentucky and Louisville to 770 career wins, seven final fours, and two national titles among his numerous career accomplishments.
- The New York native returns home to the Metropolitan area where it all started. Growing up in Manhattan, Pitino starred for the CHSAA's St. Dominic High School on Long Island before his collegiate playing days at UMass and long coaching career.
- He also coached several years with the New York Knicks and Boston Celtics in the NBA.

**LET IT RAIN**

- Through **14** games this year, Iona has made a three-pointer in **406** straight and **853** out of its last **855** games.
- Last season, the Gaels eclipsed their previous program record of 385 straight from Jan. 5, 1994 - Dec. 16, 2006.
- The Gaels have failed to hit a three-pointer in just 18 of their **1,081** games played since the line was adopted for the 1986-87 season.

**KING OF THE HILL, TOP OF THE LIST**

- No team among the 14 NYC Metropolitan Area Division I basketball programs within **30** miles of the center of NY College basketball, Madison Square Garden has won more games than Iona College in the last quarter century (473; Hofstra #2, 464).
- Over the last decade, Iona's **219** wins and **.626** win percentage are also the best in both categories. (Seton Hall, 204 wins; .578 win pct.)
- Since 1995-96, the Maroon & Gold hold the lead in wins (**471**), **nine** more than Hofstra, **30** more than No. 3 Seton Hall and the top win percentage (**.585**).
- Iona's nine postseason appearances (six NCAA, two NIT, one CIT) since 2010-11 are the most during the time frame, **almost twice as many** Seton Hall (4 NCAA, 1 NIT) and St. John's (three NCAA, two NIT).

## SIX DECADE CLUB

- With Iona's win at Hofstra, Naismith Hall of Fame head coach **Rick Pitino** joined an exclusive club, becoming the sixth head coach to win a Division I college basketball game in six different decades.
- Coach Pitino won his first game in the 1970s with the University of Hawaii in 1976. His stint at Boston University wrapped around the turn of the 1980s decade, where he also won games with Providence and Kentucky. He spent eight seasons with the Wildcats, all in the 1990s. His 2000s and 2010s victories all came while at the Louisville. His first win at Iona on Dec. 5, 2020, also his first this decade.
- Coach Pitino joined contemporaries **Cliff Ellis**, **Jim Boeheim** and **Mike Krzyzewski** who joined the list last season.
- Bill Reinhart** (1910s-1960s, Oregon, George Washington) and **Tony Hinkle** (1920s-1970s, Butler) were the lone members prior to the turn of the calendar in January.
- Phog Allen** of Kansas lore, came very close—he coached from the 1900s to the 1950s but in the 1910s, his only year at a Div. I school was at Kansas in 1919-20. The Jayhawks won their first four games that season, but the season opener took place on January 6, 1920. Allen remains one of many "five-decadars".

## MILLENNIUM MAN

- With his 33-point effort at Hofstra on Dec. 5, senior **Isaiah Ross** recorded his 1,000 career point.
- Ross scored his first 636 points as a freshman and sophomore at the University of Missouri Kansas City. He has posted 376 points in a season-plus with the Gaels.

## THE GLOVE

- Junior **Berrick JeanLouis** is tapped to defend the opponent's top offensive player. He leads the MAAC in steals (2.5/g) and is one of 10 players to average at least a block per game (1.0/g).
- Manhattan's Ant Nelson, Coppin State's Anthony Tarke, Rider's Dwight Murray Jr., and Fairfield's Jesus Cruz each averaged under their season's point and field goals made average and field goal percentage when defended by JeanLouis.

- Iona returns **just four** performers from the 2019-20 campaign including senior captains **Asante Gist**, **Isaiah Ross** and **Dylan van Eyck**.
- The Gaels' fourth senior, Colton Cashaw returns for his second season in Maroon & Gold.
- Walk on **Parker Weiss** also returns for year two.
- The Gaels graduated five student-athletes last season including All-MAAC performers **Tajuan Agee** and **E.J. Crawford** who have moved on to professional careers overseas.

## JAMES ENROLLS AT IONA EARLY

- Trey James**, one of Iona's four signees for next season, graduated high school early and elected to enroll at Iona College a semester early.
- James is immediately eligible to play in 2020-21.
- A 6-10 forward and 18-year old should be high school senior, was one of the premier big men in the state of Kentucky. The Inez native broke the state's career blocks record as a junior. After originally committing to Wake Forest before a coaching change, he picked Iona over Iowa.

## GAELS INK FOUR FOR 2021-22

- Rick Pitino** and staff announced the signing of four student-athletes to NLI's this November. In addition to **Trey James**, the three other Gael newcomers next year will be:

• **Walter Clayton Jr.** is a 6-3 point guard from Lake Wales, FL and a top high-school program, Bartow. A top football recruit at multiple positions, he saw interest in Power 5 FBS programs in the sport, but chose basketball, his first love.

• **Joshua Duach** comes from Melbourne, Australia, and is a 6-6 combo guard with national team experience. He chose Iona over Maryland, Portland and Weber State.

• **Jordan Wildy**, a 6-9 pick and pop forward, committed to Iona after a junior campaign with Moravian Prep, one of the top prep programs in the country. The Rock Hill, SC native is currently enrolled at Winston-Salem Christian School.

#### RICHIE GUERIN'S #14 HANGS IN THE RAFTERS

• Iona honored the legacy of **Richie Guerin '54** by retiring his number 14 on Jan. 31, 2014 the first ever in school history.

• Guerin is an Iona College Goal Club (1983), Marine Corps Sports (2004), and Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame (2013) inductee who starred for the Maroon & Gold from 1951-1954.

• He rewrote the basketball record books at Iona, scoring 1,375 points and graduated as the leading scorer in school history.

• A two-time All-Metropolitan selection with the Gaels, he scored a then school-record 40 points against John Carroll in 1954 and was the first Gael to score 40 or more points in a game.

• Following his playing days at Iona, Guerin played with the National Basketball Association's New York Knicks from 1956-1963 and was a player-coach of the St. Louis/Atlanta Hawks franchise for nine years.

• In 13 years as a professional player, Guerin accumulated 14,676 points (17.3 per game), 4,278 rebounds (5.1 per game), and 4,211 assists (5.0 per game) over 848 games.

#### GAEL GREATS

In addition to Naismith Hall of Famer **Richie Guerin '54**, here are additional significant names in Iona basketball history:

• **Jim Valvano** - legendary head coach at Iona from 1975-80 who "Dared To Dream" to win a national championship with the Gaels and finally did in 1983, albeit with North Carolina State. Succumbed to cancer in 1993 eight weeks after an impassioned speech at the ESPY Awards that year which in which he announced creation of The V Foundation for Cancer Research and its motto, "Don't Give Up... Don't Ever Give Up."

• **Jeff Ruland '91** - All-American during his time at Iona and, two-time NBA All-Star with the Washington Bullets, Philadelphia 76ers and Detroit Pistons. Following his career, returned to Iona and served as head coach from 1998-2007 where he won three MAAC Championships.

• **Tim Cluess** - head coach from 2010-2020. At the helm during one the Gaels' most successful decades in program history. Cluess won 199 games

in nine seasons on the sideline including six NCAA appearances, five MAAC tournament championships, and four MAAC regular season titles. He is the all-time MAAC leader in MAAC tournament victories.

• **Pat Kennedy** - head coach from 1980-86. Went on to coach at Florida State, DePaul, Montana, and Towson following a highly successful tenure in New Rochelle.

• **Warren Isaac '65** - Iona's only 50-point scorer, Isaac played six seasons in Europe following his tenure at Iona. A New York City school legend, Isaac started for Power Memorial paving the way for NBA Hall of Famer Kareem Abdul-Jabbar a 1965 graduate of the high school.

• **Tim Welsh** - head coach from 1995-98 who went on to coach in the Big East with Providence for 10 seasons. Currently an ESPN college basketball analyst. Holds the highest career winning percentage ever at Iona.

• **Kevin Willard** - Iona coach from 2007-10, now head coach at Big East's Seton Hall. Helped turn around a program which won two games in the season prior to his arrival to 20 wins in his final season in Maroon & Gold.

• **Steve Burt '84 & Steve Burt '06** - All-time NCAA father/son scoring leaders, both netting over 2,000 career points. Burt, the father, had a four-season NBA career and most notably appeared off the bench for the Phoenix Suns in the 1992 NBA Playoffs. He was inducted into the prestigious NYC Basketball Hall of Fame this past fall. Burt, the son, continues to play professionally in Europe.

• **Sean Green '91** - Played 84 NBA games over three seasons for the Indiana Pacers, Philadelphia 76ers and Utah Jazz from 1991-94. Currently a high school basketball coach in Southern California.

• **Scott Machado '12** - The last Gael to appear in an NBA game. Machado played in regular season NBA contests in 2012-13 with the Houston Rockets and postseason with the Golden State Warriors. Played the majority 2018-19 season in the NBA G-League for the South Bay Lakers and played four games with the Los Angeles Lakers. The MAAC & Iona's all-time assist leader. He currently plays professionally in Australia.

• **Bob Santini '53** - Iona's first NBA player, appeared in four games with the New York Knicks in 1955-56.

#### NOTABLE ALUMNI (ATHLETICS/POP CULTURE)

• **Brendan Malone '62** - longtime NBA assistant coach, last with the Detroit Pistons from 2014-16.

• **Don McLean** - Singer-songwriter noted most famous for his 1971 single "American Pie".

• **Dennis Leonard** - Kansas City Royals Hall of Famer and 12-year MLB veteran who won 20 games on three occasions from 1977-80. He was inducted in May 2015 into the New York Baseball Hall of Fame.

• **Kyle Flood '93** - Former head football coach at Rutgers, current OL coach at Alabama.

• **Maggie Timoney '89** - The Iona women's basketball Hall of Famer recently became the first female CEO of Heineken USA.

• **Jason Motte** - Major League Baseball relief pitcher recorded the final out of the 2011 World

Series with the world champion St. Louis Cardinals. Has also appeared in Major League games with the Chicago Cubs, Colorado Rockies and Atlanta Braves.

• **Leonard Korir '12** - a two time NCAA track and field champion while at Iona, Korir represented Team USA in the 2016 Rio Olympic Games in the 10,000-meter event. He is currently ranked as the top American marathon runner on WorldAthletics.org.

• **Amanda Saccomanno '13** - World Wrestling Entertainment's (WWE) Mandy Rose, competes on the SmackDown brand.

• **Ignacio Maganto** - was selected by the LA Galaxy with the 21st pick in the first round of the 2015 MLS SuperDraft, the first Major League Soccer draft pick in Iona history. Maganto scored his first MLS goal with the Galaxy in the spring of 2015.

• **Mariano Rivera III '15** - Earned his degree in May 2015 and was selected in the fourth round by the Washington Nationals.

## TIMELINE OF 2020-21 SCHEDULE ADJUSTMENTS: WHAT A LONG STRANGE TRIP IT'S BEEN

### SEPTEMBER 16

- Iona's original 11-game, 2020-21 non-conference schedule included a three-game trip to the Bahamas, two neutral site games at Madison Square Garden and Mohegan Sun and four home games.
- It was entirely scrapped due to NCAA setting the start date for Nov. 25 and the MAAC reorganizing its league season to play four games in December.
- Six new non-conference games were set up initially for the new season start date.

### NOVEMBER 12

- Iona cancels four of the six games a result of the pause in activity due to a positive case among the program's NCAA Tier I group. The games included at Fordham (Nov. 25) and three games in Bubbleville at Mohegan Sun from Nov. 29-Dec. 2 (Vermont, Buffalo and UMass).
- The fifth game on Dec. 5 was canceled as Wagner elected to delay the start of its season.

### NOVEMBER 20

- As a result of the cancellations, the sixth game (at Hofstra), initially intended to be played on Dec. 22, was moved to Dec. 5.
- Along with moving Hofstra, Iona agreed to play Merrimack on Dec. 3.

### NOVEMBER 28

- Iona and Seton Hall agreed to square off a little over 48 hours later, in what turned out to be **Rick Pitino's** Iona debut, in a nationally televised affair in Newark.

### DECEMBER 1

- Iona-Monmouth, MAAC opening weekend rescheduled due to a pause in athletic activity with the Hawks. Gaels slated to travel to Quinnipiac instead.

### DECEMBER 3

- Iona-Merrimack canceled the morning of the game due to COVID-19 issues with the Warriors.

### DECEMBER 4

- Iona agrees to play Morgan State, on Dec. 8.

### DECEMBER 8

- Iona-Quinnipiac weekend returned to Jan. 8-9 due to a Bobcat pause, and brought Fairfield on as Iona's actual opening MAAC foe.

### DECEMBER 10

- Iona agrees to host Coppin State on Dec. 23

### DECEMBER 20

- Iona agrees to host Towson on Dec. 29

### DECEMBER 23

- Iona-Monmouth rescheduled a second time to take place Jan. 29-30. Both teams were not slated to play on those dates due to other adjustments to MAAC schedules.

### DECEMBER 29

- Iona-Towson canceled the morning of the game due to COVID-19 issues with the Tigers.
- That evening, Iona learned of a positive COVID-19 result among one of its Tier I members, necessitating a pause in activity for 14 days.

### WEEK OF JANUARY 10

- Iona resumes activity following New York State/CDC required 10-day quarantine. Iona is allowed to return to practice, however, MAAC regulations require the completion of a 14-day quarantine prior to resumption of completion. All eligible Tier I members received a negative test and practice resumed.

### JANUARY 16

- The night before its scheduled contest vs. Saint Peter's, Iona learns of an additional positive among Tier I individuals requiring another pause.
- During the subsequent pause, several members of the program tested with some exhibiting symptoms of the virus.

### FEBRUARY 12

- Following a 51-day layoff since its last contest Iona tipped off vs. Manhattan at 6 p.m. .
