What You Need To Know

- Rider continues MAAC play with its home openers against Iona. The Broncs began league play with a road split at Manhattan.
- Dwight Murray, Jr. has been an all-around bright spot so far this season, averaging 18.0 points, 7.8 rebounds, 6.0 assists and 1.5 steals per game, including a near triple-double of 20 points, a career-high 15 rebounds and seven assists in a win at Manhattan on Dec. 11.
- Christian Ings returned from a one-game absence due to injury at St. John's to score 14 and 15 points, respectively, in two games at Manhattan on Dec. 11-12.
- Iona owns a 41-26 lead in the all-time series with Rider, including wins in each of the last four meetings. The Broncs are 4-13 against the Gaels under Head Coach Kevin Baggett.
- Rider is 0-3 all-time against new Iona Head Coach Rick Pitino, having fallen to Providence on Dec. 20, 1986 and Kentucky twice, including the 1993 NCAA Tournament First Round.
- The Gaels are led by Isaiah Ross, who's averaging 21.4 points per game. Nelly Joseph has contributed 9.2 points and 6.4 rebounds per game, while Dylan Van Eyck (8.6 ppg., 6.0 rpg.), Ryan Myers (8.2 ppg.) and Berrick JeanLouis (7.4 ppg., 6.8 rpg.) have also made strong contributions.
- Rodney Henderson, Jr. had 20 points, five rebounds and two steals in the near upset at St. John's. Allen Powell also added a career-high 17 points.
- Rider returned just four letterwinners from last year's team that finished 18-12 and was the No. 3 seed in the MAAC Tournament before it was cancelled.
- The Broncs are tasked with replacing 87.6% of its scoring from a year ago, second most in the nation behind only Kentucky (94.0%).
- Ninth-year Head Coach Kevin Baggett's teams have posted a 142-119 record. Baggett won MAAC Coach of the Year in 2015 and 2018.
- Only John Carpenter (292) and Thomas Leyden (187) have more wins at Rider than Baggett.

SCOUTING THE IONA GAELS

The Gaels are led by Isaiah Ross, who's averaging 21.4 points per game. Nelly Joseph has contributed 9.2 points and 6.4 rebounds per game, while Dylan Van Eyck (8.6 ppg., 6.0 rpg.), Ryan Myers (8.2 ppg.) and Berrick JeanLouis (7.4 ppg., 6.8 rpg.) have also made strong contributions.

ALL-TIME SERIES VS. IONA

Iona owns a 41-26 lead in the all-time series with Rider, including wins in each of the last four meetings. The Broncs are 4-13 against the Gaels under Head Coach Kevin Baggett. Rider is 0-3 all-time against new Iona Head Coach Rick Pitino, having fallen to Providence on Dec. 20, 1986 and Kentucky twice, including the 1993 NCAA Tournament First Round.

MORE MURRAY AT MANHATTAN

Dwight Murray, Jr. nearly went for a triple-double in his MAAC debut at Manhattan, going for 20 points, a career-high 15 rebounds and seven assists in the Broncs' 82-64 win over the Jaspers on Dec. 11. The 15 rebounds nearly doubled his previous career high of eight rebounds. The double-double was the first of his career.

BLADEN FLIRTS WITH FIRST DOUBLE-DOUBLE

Redshirt sophomore forward Tyrel Bladen spent the first two years of his Rider career redshirting as a true freshman in 2018-19 before playing limited minutes as a redshirt freshman in 2019-20. Given significant minutes this season, he's come on, averaging 7.0 points and 5.8 rebounds per game, including outputs of 10 points and eight rebounds on Dec. 8 at St. John's and 11 points and nine rebounds at Manhattan on Dec. 11. He's shot 71.4 percent (10-14) from the floor.

D.J.'S DYNAMIC DEBUT

Dwight Murray, Jr. was been a bright spot in the Broncs' first two games at Syracuse and St. John's, averaging 19.5 points, 6.5 assists and 6.0 rebounds per game. He went for 20 points, six rebounds, six assists and three steals - all team highs - at Syracuse. He made 3-of-6 three-point attempts and played 38 minutes. The 20 points are three off his career high, established last Feb. 23 for Incarnate Word at Lamar. His three steals matched his career high. Three days later, he scored 19 points on 7-of-15 shooting and added seven assists and six rebounds in 38 minutes at St. John's.

STEPPING UP AT ST. JOHN'S

In addition to Murray's contributions, several Broncs stepped up into new roles in a near-upset at St. John's on Dec. 8. Rodney Henderson, Jr. scored 20 points to pace the Broncs' offense, including 6-of-9 shooting from long range, while also grabbing five rebounds. Allen Powell scored a career-high 17 points in his first career start, while Tyrel Bladen posted career highs of 10 points, eight rebounds, two blocks and two steals.

REPLACING THOUSANDS

Rider had four 1,000-point scorers move on from last year's roster - graduating seniors Stevie Jordan and Tyere Marshall and grad transfers Frederick Scott (Boston College) and Dimencio Vaughn (Ole Miss). Vaughn was a two-time All-MAAC First Team selection, while Scott was a three-time All-MAAC Third Team honoree. Jordan twice earned All-MAAC Second Team honors, while Marshall took Third Team honors as a senior. Jordan tied for the program record in steals (188) and was an assist shy (597) of becoming the program leader when the 2019-20 season was halted. Marshall ranks ninth in program history with 764 rebounds.





SCORING UP FOR GRABS

Rider lost 87.6 percent of its scoring from a year ago, second-most in the nation behind only Kentucky (94.0 percent). Included in the losses are seven of the Broncs' top eight scorers, with only Christian Ings (4.9 ppg.) returning from the group.

MEET THE BRONCS, D-I TRANSFER EDITION

Rider features a pair of NCAA Division I transfer guards in graduate student Rodney "Rocket" Henderson, Jr. (CSUN) and fellow Division I transfer Dwight Murray, Jr. (Incarnate Word). Both are immediately eligible. The Broncs became acquainted with Henderson when he scored 16 points on 7-of-11 shooting against Rider in the Continental Tire Las Vegas Classic Mid-Major Championship Game on Dec. 23, 2018. Over his 31 games with the Matadors, Henderson averaged 10.0 points per game. Murray averaged 8.1 ppg. over two years at Incarnate Word, including 9.6 ppg. last season. His 87.6 percent (85-97) career connection rate from the free-throw line will be a welcome addition. Albany transfer Malachi de Sousa also joined the Broncs, but will sit out this season. de Sousa started 26 of 58 games played for the Great Danes over the last two years.

MEET THE BRONCS, JUCO TRANSFER EDITION

Rider added another pair of transfers from the junior college ranks in Dontrell McQuarter and Jeremiah Pope. McQuarter, a 6-foot-7 guard, was a two-time NJCAA All-State and All-Conference selection at Hinds C.C. He averaged 15.0 points, 6.0 rebounds and 4.0 assists per game. Pope, a 6-foot-4 guard, averaged 19.3 ppg. and shot 48.6 percent from the floor and 40.7 percent from long range last year, helping Brunswick C.C. to a 22-9 record. He eclipsed 20 points 17 times in 2019-20, including a season-high 37 points on 15-of-25 shooting against Denmark Tech on Jan. 12. Pope began his collegiate career at Division II Fayetteville State University, averaging 4.7 ppg. as a freshman.

MEET THE BRONCS, FRESHMAN EDITION

The Broncs also added seven freshmen to this year's roster in guards Jaelen Mc-Glone, Corey McKeithan, Jordan Smalls, Elijah Perry and R.J. Weise and forwards Nehemiah Benson and Lawrence Foreman. McGlone was a First Team All-State and All-Area selection as a senior at Cheltenham (PA) High School, while McKeithan was a four-time All-Conference and three-time All-State selection at Windsor (CT) High School, finishing with 1,965 career points. A First Team All-Region selection for the Georgia State Runners Up and two-time Region Champs, Smalls averaged 14.2 points and 5.2 rebounds as a senior at Eagle's Landing Christian Academy, shooting 41 percent from long range. Benson averaged 21.5 points and 10.0 rebounds in his senior year at Lutheran East High School, earning First Team All-State and First Team All-District. Foreman joined McKeithan at Windsor (CT) High School as a senior, averaging 10.0 points, 12.0 rebounds and 3.0 blocks per game. He went on to average 7.0 points and 4.0 rebounds in a prep year at Woodstock Academy. Perry and Weise join the Broncs as walk-ons this year. Perry played his final scholastic season at St. Thomas More in Connecticut, while Weise, whose father Rich was a four-year letterwinner at Rider from 1978-82, starred at Allentown (NJ) High School.

HEAD COACH 9TH SEASON SAINT JOSEPH'S '89

2015, 2018 MAAC Coach of the Year 2013, 2018 Ben Jobe Award Finalist 2018 Hugh Durham Award Finalist 2013 Joe B. Hall Award Finalist

Two-time MAAC Coach of the Year Kevin Baggett returns for his ninth season as the Rider University head basketball coach in 2020-21.

In his first year as head coach, 'Baggs' was a finalist for two different National Coach of the Year Awards, the Ben Jobe Award and the Joe B. Hall Award.

Baggett took a team with just two returning starters and six total letterwinners that was picked to finish seventh in the 10-team Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference in 2013 and finished in second place.

He guided the 2012-13 Broncs to a 19-win season, the most by a Rider rookie head coach since Bob Greenwood led Rider to a 20-win season in 1962-63. The only other Rider basketball coach to compile 19 wins in his rookie campaign was the legendary Clair Bee. Included in the 19 wins was Rider's first-ever Division I national postseason tournament victory, a road win at Hartford in the CollegeInsider.com Postseason Tournament (CIT). The last time Rider had won a game in a national postseason tournament came in 1957, when the Roughriders won a pair of games in the NCAA College Division Championships (now NCAA Division II).

In 2013-14 Coach Baggett took a young team and produced two All-MAAC performers along with a MAAC All-Rookie team selection. His 2013-14 squad was ranked eighth in the nation in three-point field goal percentage and was 51st in Division I in three-point field goals made.

In 2014-15, Baggett took a squad that was picked seventh in the MAAC and guided the team to a 21-win season and a second place finish in the conference, earning MAAC Coach of the Year honors as Rider was selected to play in the College Basketball Invitational tournament. Baggett was a finalist for the Ben Jobe National Coaching Award for the second time in three years and he was named the UPS All-District 1 Coach of the Year.

The Broncs had another very successful campaign in 2016-17, winning 18 games and advancing to the MAAC Championship Quarterfinals. Rider was offered the chance to play in multiple national postseason tournaments, but declined. Seniors Jimmie Taylor and Kahlil Thomas were each named to the All-MAAC Third Team. Rider finished first in the league in rebounds per game (40.3), with three Broncs - Thomas, Norville Carey and Taylor - finishing in the top 20 individually.

2017-18 was a banner year for Baggett and the Broncs. Picked to finish seventh in the MAAC after losing four starters to graduation, the Broncs won 22 games, a share of the MAAC Regular Season Championship and advanced to the NIT for the second time in program history. Baggett was named MAAC Coach of the Year for the second time in six years, took NABC All-District 1 Coach and was also a finalist for the Hugh Durham and Ben Jobe Awards. Baggett guided four players to All-MAAC honors, including First Teamer Dimencio Vaughn, Second Teamer Stevie Jordan and Third Team honorees Jordan Allen and Frederick Scott. Scott was named MAAC 6th Player of the Year, while Allen earned All-Rookie Team honors. Vaughn was also selected to the NABC All-District Second Team and earned Second Team All-Met. As a team, Rider led the MAAC in field-goal percentage (.465), offensive rebounds per game (13.2), rebound margin (+2.6), steals per game (7.5), rebounds per game (39.2), turnover margin (+2.2) and turnovers forced per game (15.4). Jordan led the league in assists (5.9) for the second-straight year and was 26th in the nation. Allen's 2.88 three-point field goals made per game ranked 50th in the country, while Vaughn's 1.83 steals per game were 55th. Baggett earned his 100th career win on Jan. 26, 2018, against Saint Peter's.

Stevie Jordan and Frederick Scott repeated as All-MAAC Second and Third Team selections, respectively, in 2018-19, as the Broncs finished tied for second in the MAAC Regular Season Standings. Jordan recorded his 1,000th career point, becoming the 37th player in Rider history to reach the plateau.

In 2019-20, Tyere Marshall joined the ranks of All-MAAC selections, earning Third Team recognition. Dimencio Vaughn returned to All-MAAC First Team form, while Scott earned his third-straight Third Team honor. Vaughn, Scott and Marshall became the 38th, 39th, and 40th Broncs to score their 1,000th points in the cranberry and white. The Broncs compiled an 18-12 overall record and a 12-8 mark in league play. Baggett's Broncs earned the No. 3 seed in the MAAC Championships and were riding a three-game winning streak when the tournament was halted due to COVID-19.

Baggett was named the Rider men's basketball head coach at a standing room only press conference on May 24, 2012.

"This was a popular decision," Rider Director of Athletics Don Harnum said at that time. "It was also a convenient decision, but let me make it very clear, this was not a hire of convenience. This was a hire because I firmly believe and am very confident that Kevin is the right person to lead this program in the future."

With an emphasis on defense, Baggett's Broncs led the MAAC in three-point field goal percentage defense in 2012-13 and was second in overall field goal percentage defense, third in blocks and fourth in points allowed.

The 2020-21 season is the 15th for Baggett as a member of the Rider staff, serving two as an assistant coach and four as an associate head coach. In the last 14 years, Rider has compiled 252 wins, the second-most in the MAAC behind only Iona (258).

Baggett has coached on the Division I level for 25 years and has been on the Rider staff since the 2006-07 season.

Baggett hails from Burlington, NJ and was a 2006 inductee into the South Jersey Hall of Fame. He was a member of the Saint Joseph's 1985-86 basketball team that compiled a 26-6 record and reached the second round of the NCAA Tournament. He received his bachelor's degree in marketing from Saint Joseph's in June, 1989.

Baggett came to Rider from the University of Maryland Baltimore County, where he served as assistant coach from 2004-06. At UMBC Baggett recruited an America East All-Rookie Team member who went on to earn First Team All-Conference honors three times, as well as a pair of transfers from the Colonial Athletic Association who went on to earn All-America East honors

Baggett has also served as an assistant coach at James Madison, Howard, Western Kentucky and Coastal Carolina.

Since joining the MAAC in 1998, Rider has compiled a record of 231-173 in conference games. Only conference members Iona and Siena have better all-time winning percentages in MAAC games.
