## Tonight's Game

### What's Trending At Fairfield

✓ The Stags advanced to the 2021 MAAC Basketball Championship championship game after edging third-seeded Saint Peter's University by a 52-47 score on Friday night. Fairfield now turns its attention ninth-seeded Iona College. These two teams faced each other in the 2018 MAAC Championship game with the Gaels prevailing by an 83-71 margin. Fairfield and Iona also met in the 1987 MAAC title game with the Stags winning in overtime by a 73-70 margin as Fairfield overcame an 18-point deficit with 12 minutes left in the second half. Fairfield won MAAC titles in 1986 (played Illinois in the NAAs), 1987 (played Indiana in the NAAs), and 1997 (played North Carolina in the NAAs).

### What's Trending at Iona

✓ The Gaels built a double-digit second half lead against Niagara and held on to advance with a 70-64 victory. Iona won the last four MAAC tournaments including its victory over Fairfield in 2018. The Gaels have won five straight games dating back to the regular season, one game better than its mid-season four-game winning streak which included a non-conference win over Coppin State. The team brings an 11-5 record into the tournament final. Iona enters the game ranked second in scoring offense with 73.0 points per game, a number aided by five games in which Iona has netted 80 or more points.

## MAAC Tournament Notes

**Setting The Record:** The Stags own a 31-36 overall record in MAAC Basketball Championship play through the 2020 edition. Fairfield posted a 14-24 overall record against the top four seeds and a 17-12 overall mark against seeds five and lower. The team will try and get a second win in as many tries against a 10 seed in its MAAC history, defeating Saint Peter's 54-47 in the 2013 tournament.

**Seed Selection:** Fairfield will enter this tournament as the 7th seed, the fifth time that the Stags earned that ranking in MAAC tournament history. The Stags have five wins (5-3) as the seventh seed, more victories than all their other seedings with the exception of the two seed (six victories). Fairfield has a winning record in the MAAC tournament from three different seeds - as the top-seed (4-1), the second-seed (6-3), and the seven seed.

**Against Manhattan:** The Stags will meet up with Manhattan College for the 12th time in MAAC tournament history and for the third straight season, owning a 6-5 mark against the Jaspers in previous tournament settings. Saint Peter's is the only team that the Stags have played more times in the MAAC tournament, taking on the Peacocks 12 times. Last year, the Jaspers eliminated the Stags with a 61-43 victory in Atlantic City as Taj Benning was the only Stag to reach double figures with 10 points. The two teams were tied 19-19 at halftime before Manhattan opened the second half with a 13-6 run and did not trail the rest of the game. In the 2019 tournament, the Stags and the Jaspers met in a first-round game with Manhattan coming away with a 57-53 decision.

**Call It The Streak:** Fairfield will play Manhattan for the third straight time in MAAC tournament play when it faces the Jaspers on Tuesday night, surpassed only by the four consecutive tournaments Saint Peter's (2-2 record from 2013-2016). This run marks the third time that the team will play a team in three straight tournaments, also accomplishing the task against Siena (1-2 record from 2002-2004).

**First Time:** The Stags are in the same bracket with second-seeded Monmouth University, the only team that Fairfield did not face during the 2020-21 regular season. Should Fairfield defeat Manhattan, it would face the Hawks on Thursday for a quarterfinal match up. The rest of the bracket includes third-seeded Saint Peter's as well as sixth-seeded Canisius College and 11th-seeded Rider University. Fairfield earned a split with everyone on its side of the bracket with the exception of Monmouth which it did not play at all.

**Away From Albany:** The Stags have played in six different facilities outside of Albany since the beginning of the MAAC tournament. Fairfield owns a .500 or better in record in four of the six arenas with lone exceptions coming in Bridgeport at Webster Bank Arena/Arena at Harbor Yard. (1-2 record) and Jim Whelan Boardwalk Hall (0-1). The Stags own a 4-3 slate in Springfield as well as in Buffalo. The team advanced to the championship game and posted a 2-1 record in Trenton and owned a 7-7 mark at the Meadowlands Arena.

**Three Championships:** Fairfield has won three MAAC championships in its 39 years of conference competition. The Stags won the 1986 title as the number one seed; won the 1987 championship as the number seven seed; and won the 1997 crown as the number eight seed. Fairfield lost five times in the title game - 1996 vs. Canisius (52-46); 2003 vs. Manhattan (69-54); 2010 vs. Siena (72-65 in overtime); 2012 vs. Loyola (48-44), and 2018 vs. Iona (83-71).

**Most Valuable Player:** Greg Francis is the only Fairfield University player to earn the tournament most valuable player. He secured the award after leading the team to the 1997 tournament title. The Stags placed three players on the All-Tournament team that season. In Fairfield's other two tournament titles, Jim McCaffrey of Holy Cross won the MVP in 1986 and Kevin Houston of Army won the award in 1987.

**Don't Get Them Started:** Getting a win in its quarterfinal game usually is a significant event for the Stags. The Red and White have won 14 quarterfinal games in their history. Of those 14 tournaments, the Stags went on to the championship game eight times. In those seven title games, the Stags have earned the crown three times (1986, 1987, and 1997). The Stags lost the Championship game to Canisius in 1996, Manhattan in 2003, Siena in 2010, Loyola in 2012, and Iona in 2018.

**OT Is OK:** The Stags have played six overtime games in their MAAC tournament history, and won three of those outings. Fairfield defeated Iona College by a 73-70 count in the 1987 MAAC championship game, the Red and White's first-ever MAAC overtime game. The Stags followed up with five more overtime games - 1990 first round win over Niagara (66-63); 1995 quarterfinal win over Iona (81-79); 1998 play-in round loss to Marist (74-73) the 2010 championship game loss against Siena (72-65), and the 2014 first-round loss with Saint Peter's (65-62).

**Scouting Fairfield:** The Stags advanced to the MAAC Basketball Championship final with their fourth straight win, a 52-47 win over Saint Peter's. The team advanced to the championship final for the first time since the 2018 MAAC Tournament when they defeated Marist, Niagara, and Quinnipiac before falling to Iona in the championship game. On Friday night, four Fairfield student-athletes reached double figures in the semifinal victory led by Caleb Green's 14 points. Jesus Cruz came off the bench to tally 12 points while Jake Wojcik and Supreme Cook added 11 and 10 points, respectively. The Stags overcame an early double-digit lead, trailing by a 20-9 score, before rallying with 11 straight points to tie the score on Jesus Cruz's three-point field goal. Cruz would give Fairfield the lead on the team's first possession of the second half with a three-point field goal that made the score 25-24 in Fairfield's favor. Wojcik remains the team's top scorer with 13.5 points per game, followed by Taj Benning's 12.0 scoring average. Benning also ranks second on the team with 5.0 rebounds per game, just of Chris Maidoh's mark of 5.3 per contest.

**Scouting Iona:** The Gaels come into today's match up with five straight wins, the longest win streak of the season after defeating Niagara University by a 70-64 score in semifinal action. Asante Gist led all Iona student-athletes with 19 points, one of three Gaels in double figures. Dylan van Evck and Nelly Joseph Jr. also made double digits with 14 and 13 points respectively. Joseph just missed a double-double as he led his teammates with nine rebounds. Isaiah Ross leads the team in scoring with 18.8 points per game, which also places first among the MAAC scoring leaders. He also represents the team's top long-range threat with 42 three-pointers more than double the total of Gist and Ryan Myers who place second with 19 three-point field goals. Joseph paces the team's rebounders with his 7.4 caroms per contest, a number which also rates second in the MAAC statistics.

**Defensive Stand:** The Stags have allowed an average of 55 points per game through their first three games in the MAAC Championship, holding Saint Peter's to 47 points, Monmouth to a season-low 60 points, and Manhattan to 58 points in overtime. The performances were the fifth, sixth, and seventh times that Fairfield held the opponent to under 60 points, winning all of those contests.

**Career Oriented:** Taj Benning set career highs for points and rebounds in a game with his 24 points and 12 caroms against Monmouth. Supreme Cook also established a personal best with his 14 rebounds. Benning collected his second career double double after going for 10 points and 10 rebounds at Marist. Cook finished off his first career double-double with 11 points. The duo combined for 44 percent of the team's offense (35 of 79 points) and 59 percent of the team's rebounds (26 of 44 rebounds).

**Four Score:** Four Fairfield student-athletes reached double figures in the Monmouth game, namely Taj Benning (24), Jake Wojcik (12 points), Caleb Green (12 points), and Supreme Court (11 points). The foursome helped Fairfield score 1 19-point win as a team, the highest winning margin for the Stags since they defeated Marist by 24 points (55-31) as the top seed.

**Foursome:** Fairfield brings a four-game winning streak into tonight's game, the first time that the Stags have won four straight since the 2017-18 Fairfield team won seven consecutive games from mid-February through March, the last three victories coming in the MAAC tournament. Iona ended that seven-game streak in the MAAC Championship game.

**Up To The Minute:** Senior Taj Benning has played all but nine minutes through the first three games of the MAAC Championship. He was in the game for the full 45 minutes of the Stags' overtime win against Manhattan added 37 minutes in the victory over Monmouth, and posted 33 minutes versus Saint Peter's. He leads the team with 33.7 minutes played per game. Jake Wojcki also played all 45 minutes against Manhattan before adding 36 more minutes to his log versus Monmouth and 37 versus Saint Peter's.

**Perfection:** Allan Jeanne-Rose set a season high for scoring with his eight points against Monmouth, surpassing his previous best of six points set against both Quinnipiac and Providence. He reached his point total on Wednesday by making all three field goal tries including a three-pointer along with his only free throw attempt. His first six points started a 10-0 run in the first half that erased Monmouth's six-point lead and sent the Stags in front for good.

**First Time:** The Stags won for the first two times when they trailed at halftime as well as the second time this season when they were outrebounded in a game with its victories over Manhattan and Saint Peter's in the MAAC Championship. Fairfield owns a 2-11 record when it trails at halftime and a 2-9 record when it is outrebounded by the opposition. The team is 8-5 when it is tied or leads at intermission and a 8-7 mark when they have more rebounds in a game.

**Close Out:** Fairfield improved to 6-3 in the second games of its nine MAAC series played this year. It's a reversal of the team's 1-8 mark in MAAC series openers. The numbers certainly back up the team's performance from the first night to the second night as illustrated by the chart below:

**By The Numbers:** Fairfield scored a season-high 85 points in the team's win over Manhattan on March 5. The Stags netted 79 points in the Monmouth game which marked the fourth time that the Stags surpassed 70 points this season and improved the team's record this year to 4-0 when it reaches that total. The 85-point effort was also the most scored by the Stags under Head Coach Jay Young, eclipsing the 77 points netted in a win over Quinnipiac earlier this season.

**Carom Catching:** Fairfield owned a +5 advantage in the rebounding column over Manhattan on March 5. It marked the

seventh time in the last nine regular season games that the Stags outrebounded the opposition, and the 15th time in the team's 23 games. For the year, Fairfield owns a +1.2 rebounding margin. Chris Maidoh leads the team in rebounding with 5.5 per game followed by freshman Supreme Cook's 5.0 rebounding average.

**Finish Strong:** Caleb Green put together his best four-game run as a Stag over the final four regular-season games, averaging 12.5 points per game as the Stags went 2-2 during the stretch. He reached double figures three times including a season-high 21 points at Manhattan (March 4). In addition to scoring, he dished off 14 assists (3.5 per game) over the four game stretch.

**Long Distance:** Jake Wojcik set a personal best with 33 points in the win over Manhattan in the season finale. The junior netted nine field goals of which five were from behind the arc and made all 10 free throw attempts to secure the point total. Wojcik had not scored more than 18 points in any game as a Stag until last week's performance, hitting that mark against Siena.

**Free Throw Frenzy:** Supreme Cook has netted 19 of 27 free throws for 70 percent over the last eight games including 11 of 17 in the MAAC Tournament (65 percent). Before his current run, Cook was connecting on 55 percent of his charity toss attempts (31 of 56). Cook's 50 free throw made ranks third on the team behind Taj Benning (74) and Jake Wojcik (68).

**On The Board:** John Kelly scored his first points as a Stag with a corner jumper at Manhattan on March 5. He also collected a personal-best eight minutes on the floor and added his first collegiate rebound and steal against the Jaspers.

**Sizzling Shooter:** Over the last 13 regular-season games, Chris Maidoh netted 30 of 47 shots for a .638 field goal percentage. His success in the last 10 contests is even better, connecting on 24 of 35 attempts for a .686 field goal percentage. Before this current run, Maidoh netted 15 of 47 shots from the floor (.319) through the first nine games of the year. He currently owns a .479 field goal percentage for the season (45 of 94).

**Off The Bench:** Jesus Cruz came off the bench 12 times during the MAAC portion of the regular season schedule. He averaged 8.8 points per game coming off the bench in MAAC games (104 points) with six games of 10 or more points. In six starts against conference foes, Cruz posted 5.0 points per game (30 points).

**Start Up:** Jason Edokpayi earned his first collegiate start in the regular-season finale against Manhattan. The freshman made four of five shots and ended the game with eight points and three rebounds along with his first collegiate assist and block. Edokpayi netted five total points in his previous four appearances, registering two points at Niagara and three points against Quinnipiac.

**In The 50s:** The Stags posted a 59-58 win over Manhattan on March 9. The result was Fairfield's second victory when it scored less than 60 points this year, owning an 0-5 mark when netting 59 or less prior to that result. However, Fairfield owns a 6-0 record when it holds the opponent under 60 points this season and an 14-1 record under Head Coach Jay Young.

**Long Range:** The Stags posted 11 three pointers in the win at Manhattan on March 5, tying the team high for the season and reaching double figures in that category for the third time this year. Fairfield also connected on 11 three pointers at Niagara and registered 10 three pointers against Rider. After averaging 4.7 three pointers through the first six games, Fairfield averaged 6.6 three pointers over the final 17 games of the regular season (112 made). The addition of Jake Wojcik has certainly been a major factor as the guard has netted a team-high 32 three pointers since joining the team. Taj Benning ranks second during the 17-game stretch with 26 made.

**Transfer Clause:** Sophomore Zach Crisler and junior Jake Wojcik were declared eligible for the 2020-21 basketball season after the NCAA Division I Council approved a blanket waiver request providing relief for four-year college transfer student-athletes currently serving a transfer year of residence during the 2020-21 academic year. Crisler played a year at Rice University where he started seven of his 23

appearances. While there, he averaged 2.4 points and 1.7 rebounds per game, posting a season-high 11 points against North Texas. Wojcik was on the University of Richmond roster for two seasons, earning minutes in 64 games. He played in all 31 games as a sophomore and finished with a 3.1 scoring average. He started all 33 games as a rookie, the second most by a freshman in Richmond history, and tallied 7.7 points and 3.5 rebounds per game in 2018-19.

**Defense:** Fairfield led the MAAC for overall scoring defense in 2019-20, allowing 62.9 points per game. The Stags were also first in the conference for scoring defense in MAAC games, allowing 62.1 points per game. Saint Peter's was second in both categories with its 64.1 overall average and 62.5 average in MAAC games.

**Teammates:** Caleb Green and Tshiefu Ngalakulondi are reunited once again as the duo played together at Proctor Academy before going to Holy Cross and St. Bonaventure respectfully. Green was a three-year captain and an All-New England player at Proctor, while Ngalakulondi was a two-time All-New England player and scored 1,000 points during his stay.

**Don't I Know You:** While at Mount St. Joseph, Jason Edokpayi was a teammate of Jalen Smith, the former University of Maryland standout who was selected in the 10th round of the NBA Draft by the Phoenix Suns. Smith's final year at the school was Edokpayi's sophomore season.

**Continuation:** Two former Fairfield student-athletes continued their basketball careers after graduating last spring. Landon Taliaferro joins Amicale Steinsel in Luxembourg Total League, the top division in Luxembourg. Wassef Methnani joins US Monastir, the defending champion in the Tunisia Pro A League, the top division in Tunisia. Taliaferro ended his Fairfield career with 742 points in 61 games after transferring as a junior for a career scoring average of 12.2 points per game. He netted 153 three pointers over his two-year stay at Fairfield, including a school record 10 against Texas A&M last year. Methnani averaged 4.3 points per game and placed 14th in the MAAC with 0.7 blocks per game as his 20 blocks in 30 games was second among his teammates.

**Back To Back:** Chris Maidoh posted career highs for scoring in back-to-back games on February 8-13. He started the week with 12 points against Quinnipiac on February 8 and followed up with 13 points in the first game of the Saint Peter's series. Maidoh has reached double figures three times this season and the team went on to win all three of those decisions. He also reached double digits with 11 point in the victory over Iona in December.

**Sizzling Shooter:** Over the past 13 games, Chris Maidoh has netted 30 of 47 shots for a .638 field goal percentage. His success in the last 10 contests is even better, connecting on 24 of 35 attempts for a .686 field goal percentage. Before this current run, Maidoh netted 15 of 47 shots from the floor (.319) through the first nine games of the year. He currently owns a .479 field goal percentage for the season (45 of 94).

**February Folly:** Chris Maidoh started February well with his 13 rebounds in the two-game series against Quinnipiac, 10 in the Saint Peter's series, 14 versus Canisius, and two at Manhattan in a limited role for an average of 5.6 per game. He has been consistent through December and January as well. He averaged 5.8 rebounds during the month of December (47 in eight games) and 5.5 rebounds during the month of January (33 in six games).

**Starting Lineup:** Chris Maidoh started nine games this season which includes two blocks of three games and his current six consecutive starts. He opened the year as part of the starting five in the first three games of the season, averaging 3.3 points and 3.0 rebounds per game. He also gained the nod in a three-game run against Rider and Siena, averaging 2.0 points and 4.8 rebounds per game. He started the last six games including the final game of the Quinnipiac series, both Saint Peter's games, the pair of Canisius dates, and his only appearance against Manhattan. He averaged 7.0 points and 5.4 rebounds per game over his last six starts. As a starter, he has scored 58 points (4.8 ppg) and grabbed 55 rebounds (4.7 rpg).

**Off The Bench:** Chris Maidoh came off the bench for the 10th time this season and only the 11th time in his career against Quinnipiac on February 7. Over the 10 games, Maidoh averaged 5.1 points (51 points) and 6.7 rebounds per game (67 rebounds) as a reserve, a difference from his starting numbers of 5.2 points (47 points) and 4.3 rebounds (39 rebounds) per contest. Ten of his 13 assists this season came as a reserve as well.

**Double Double:** Chris Maidoh earned his first career double double with his 11 points and 10 rebounds against Iona on December 12. He

# Maidoh's Biography

## 2019-20:

Chris Maidoh was named to the MAAC All-Rookie team following his successful freshman campaign. He joined the starting lineup for the season opener against Bucknell, starting a run of 23 consecutive starts by the freshman. He scored in 21 of those 23 contests including a career-high 10 points in 19 minutes against Iona. The forward led the team with 26 blocks in his 31 appearances which placed him 10th in the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAAC). Maidoh blocked at least one shot in 13 games and secured three or more rejections five times. His best overall defensive effort came in a win against Saint Peter's, posting eight points, nine rebounds, and a personal best four blocks. Maidoh reached double figures in rebounding twice with his 10 caroms at Quinnipiac and another 10 against Monmouth. He placed third in the MAAC for offensive rebounding (2.5 per game) in MAAC games only. He made two or more field goals in 12 games, shooting 50 percent or better in eight of those contests. He ended the season with a 4.6 rebounding average which placed 19th in the MAAC. Maidoh scored in 27 of his 30 appearances which helped the rookie ended the 2019-20 campaign with a 3.9 scoring average.

## Before Fairfield:

Maidoh spent last season at Scotland Campus (Pa.) after graduating from Parkdale High School in 2018. As a senior at Parkdale, the forward averaged 10.6 points and 7.0 rebounds per game and was also a defensive presence with 2.3 blocks and 1.4 steals per game. He played in 23 games as a senior and tallied 244 points as well as 162 rebounds.

## 2020-21 Notebook

**Double-Double:** Taj Benning recorded his second career double-double with a career-high 24 points and a personal-best 12 rebounds in the MAAC quarterfinal win over Monmouth. The performance was his second double-double of the season.

**Helping Out:** Taj Benning tied his season high for assists with three against Canisius on February 20, the ninth time that he dished off two or more assists in a game. The team owns a 6-3 record when Benning has at least two assists in a game this year. The guard has 33 assists in 23 games which places third among his teammates behind Caleb Green (72 assists) and Jake Wojcik (38 assists).

**Back To Back:** Taj Benning registered back-to-back 20-point games for the first time in his Fairfield career, netting a career-best 23 points against Quinnipiac before adding 20 points at Saint Peter's. With his 24 points against Monmouth, Fairfield has won all four games in which the guard reached 20 points this year.

**Double-Double:** Taj Benning secured his first career double-double with 10 points and a personal-best 10 rebounds at Marist. The senior surpassed his previous best of nine rebounds set three times including Rider on January 1. Benning has collected five or more rebounds per game in 12 of his 21 appearances this year.

**Board Work:** Taj Benning has averaged 5.0 rebounds per game over the last 16 contests, securing 90 caroms during that time. He set his career high as part of this stretch with his 12 rebounds against Monmouth also reached double figures with 10 at Marist on January 16. His 123 rebounds this season are second on the team, trailing only Supreme Cook's 136 caroms.

**Charity Stripe:** Taj Benning missed his final two free throws against Siena on January 9, ending his consecutive free throw streak at 27 dating back to the season opener. He made his first three free throws against the Saints to extend the streak before missing his pair late in the game. Benning made the second of his two final free throws against the Friars which started his streak. He currently owns a .845 free throw percentage (71 of 84) for the season.

**First Half Run:** Taj Benning scored all 10 of his points against Stony Brook in the first half, helping the Stags build a 29-26 halftime lead. The senior currently ranks second on the team with his 12.1 scoring average, a number which also places 16th in the MAAC.

## Benning's Biography

### 2019-20

Benning secured the 25th spot for scoring among MAAC student-athletes, netting 9.8 points every forty minutes. His 4.6 rebounds per game also equaled the number of caroms by teammate Chris Maidoh, who rated 19th in the conference statistics. Benning enjoyed a strong finish to the 2019-20 campaign, scoring in double figures during 10 of the final 16 games. He posted a season-best 19 points at Rider on January 31, his fourth game with 10 or more points over a run of five contests. Over the final 16 regular-season games of the season, Benning averaged 11.4 points per game and 2.5 assists per game. Benning was one of the team's top free throw shooter by making 80 percent of his attempts, good enough for eighth in the MAAC overall statistics. His best game at the line came against Saint Peter's when he netted all 10 of his charity tosses. He made six or more free throws seven times during the season, four of which were perfection (8 of 8 at Marist; 10 of 10 vs. Saint Peter's; 6 of 6 vs. Texas A&M; 6 of 6 at Loyola Maryland). Benning garnered a team-high 31 starts and was one of three Stags to play in all 32 games, averaging a team-best 33.5 minutes per game (7th in the MAAC).

### 2018-19

Tajj Benning became part of the starting rotation during the 2018-19 campaign and responded with his best season as a Stag. the guard posted a 4.7 scoring average through his 28 appearances with 19 starts. He averaged nearly two assists per game with 48 assists (1.7 per game) and ranked at the top of the team in free throw percentage (.759). His ball handling skills were especially noticeable with his positive assist-turnover ratio (48 assists, 36 turnovers). Benning posted three double-digit scoring games beginning with a career-high 12 points against LIU Brooklyn, a mark he would later tie against Monmouth at home. He also managed an 11-point effort against Oakland in a home game. He put together a solid all-around contest against Marist on March 1, establishing career best with seven assists (one turnover) and eight rebounds in addition to his five points. He also played 40 minutes in that outing with the Red Foxes.

### 2017-18

Benning appeared in 25 games as a reserve during his freshman campaign, making his debut in the season opener against Penn. He made his first of five three point field goals in that game, finishing his first collegiate game with three points. He scored in 12 of his appearances, highlighted by a season-high eight points in a personal-best 26 minutes played against Rider at Webster Bank Arena. His point total surpassed his previous high of seven points established at Rider a few weeks earlier. Benning rated as one of the team's top free throw shooters at 75 percent, netting 15 of his 20 attempts which included two 4-for-4 performances (at Rider and vs. Siena). He concluded the season with more assists (20) than turnovers (16) and also secured 1.4 rebounds per contest. His best performance around the glass came at Wright State when he posted five caroms in 25 minutes. For the season, Benning averaged 1.6 points, 1.4 rebounds and 0.8 assists per outing.

## 2020-21 Notebook

**Accuracy:** Allan Jeanne-Rose made his only field goal attempt against Saint Peter's in the MAAC semis, giving him four made field goals in his last four attempts. For the series, he has netted five of six tries from the floor (83 percent).

**Perfection:** Allan Jeanne-Rose set a season high for scoring with his eight points against Monmouth, surpassing his previous best of six points set against both Quinnipiac and Providence. He reached his point total on Wednesday by making all three field goal tries including a three-pointer along with his only free throw attempt. His first six points started a 10-0 run in the first half that erased Monmouth's six-point lead and sent the Stags in front for good.

**Minute Man:** Allan Jeanne Rose has enjoyed his best 11-game run of the season following his time on the floor in the Quinnipiac, Saint Peter's, Canisius, the three Manhattan games Monmouth, plus Saint Peter's. Over the last 11 games, the sophomore has scored 25 of his 31 points and grabbed 19 of his 32 rebounds this season. The guard has averaged 12.7 minutes per game over the last eight outings (140 minutes), which surpasses the number of minutes he played through the first 12 games of the season (81 minutes).

**Serious Series:** Allan Jeanne Rose turned in his best two-game run this season during the series with Quinnipiac (February 7-8). He averaged five points, 2.5 rebounds, and 1.5 assists per game against the Bobcats, numbers that raised his season averages to 1.1 points, 1.3 rebounds, and 0.5 assists per contest.

# Jeanne-Roae Biography

## 2019-20:

Allan Jeanne-Rose started just one of his first 15 games as a Stag, averaging 1.4 points per game during that first half of the season. He became a regular in the starting lineup with his nod at Siena on February 7 and tallied a personal-best 10 points and a career-high seven rebounds that night. He would surpass that scoring total with his 11-point effort against Niagara, making five of seven field goal attempts along with one free throw. The guard started 10 of his final 11 appearances and averaged 4.6 points per game during the season-ending run. Jeanne-Rose put together a personal-best nine-game scoring streak from January 26 to February 23 during which he posted a 5.8 scoring average (53 points). He also picked up his performance around the glass, averaging 3.4 rebounds per game over the final 11 games of the season including four games with five or more rebounds (7 at Siena, 5 vs. Niagara, 5 vs. Quinnipiac, and 5 at Manhattan).

## Before Fairfield

Jeanne-Rose joins the Fairfield University basketball program as a graduate of Saint John Paul II High School in Florida where he helped lead the team to a 28-5 record and a Class 3A State championship. His dunk at the buzzer was the difference in the championship game, a shot which earned him a spot on ESPN's SportsCenter Top 10 that night. The guard posted impressive numbers as senior, registering 17.5 points and 7.7 rebounds per game. He capped his final season with the basketball team by earning the 2019 All-Big Bend Player of the Year. With his efforts, Saint John Paul II won 18 straight games to close out the season during which he averaged 21 points per game and recorded eight games with 10 or more rebounds.

# Whipple's Biography

## 2019-20

Calvin Whipple continued his role as a key reserve, something that he carried over from his rookie season. The sophomore played in all but two games during the 2019-20 campaign, earning a pair of starts at Marist and Saint Peter's in successive games. Whipple averaged 22 minutes as a starter highlighted by a personal-best 31 minutes at Marist. When he came off the bench, Whipple played 11.5 minutes per outing with his season high as a reserve coming against UMass, a 29-minute stint during which he netted six points from behind the three-point line. Over the first nine games of the season, Whipple averaged 4.0 points per game which was highlighted by an eight-point effort against Davidson. He would surpass that total with nine points in a home win against Saint Peter's, netting all three of his three-point attempts. For the season, he averaged 2.0 points and 1.4 rebounds per game with 14 of his 21 field goals coming from behind the three-point line. He scored in 14 of his 30 appearances.

## 2018-19

Whipple quickly earned a reputation for his marksmanship behind the three-point line, placing fourth on the team with 21 shots from behind the arc and second among Fairfield newcomers. He showed his prowess from long distance in the Boston College game when he made seven of 14 three-point attempts en route to his personal-best 21 points on the road. The performance was his only double-digit games over his 24 appearances as a reserve. His nearly hit double figures against Niagara at home, posting eight points which was enhanced by his two three-point field goals. He was also adept at handling the basketball, averaging one turnover every 33 minutes of play in addition to dishing off 10 assists. Whipple made at least one three-point field goal in 12 games, highlighted by four contests with two or more long-range baskets. After missing his first four shots as a collegiate, Whipple found his touch by shooting 55 percent from the floor over the next four games (11 of 20). He registered a field goal percentage of 50 percent or better 10 times as a rookie.

## Before Fairfield

Whipple joined the Fairfield University men's basketball program after spending the last four seasons at Northfield Mount Hermon. He developed into one of the program's top three-point shooters over his four years, capping his career with 84 three pointers for Northfield Mount Hermon. He was a regular in the starting lineup with 34 starts in 35 appearances as a senior, averaging just under 10 points per game. He was part of Northfield Mount Hermon's 2016 and 2018 New England (NEPSAC) Regular Season and Postseason Championship teams. He garnered a nomination for the McDonald's All-America team as well. He was also selected as an ESMARK All-American, given to student-athletes in recognition for outstanding athletic, educational and community service achievements by high school student-athletes across the United States in 16 major sports programs.

## 2020-21 Notebook

**Long Range:** Jesus Cruz made five three point field goals through the first 21 games (45 attempts) but has found his range over the last three contests. Cruz netted two three pointers in back to back games (nine attempts) for the first time this year which he accomplished in the two Manhattan games. He made his only attempt from behind the arc against Monmouth as well. He now has eight three pointers in eight career MAAC Tournament games.

**Three In A Row:** For the third time this season, Jesus Cruz scored in double figures in three straight games when he netted 10 points at Saint Peter's, 10 and 17 points in the two-game series with Canisius. The most recent run of three games was the only one that did not include at least one start. Cruz started all three games in his first stretch (44 points for 14.7 ppg) and began one game in the second run (37 points for 12.3 ppg).

**Off The Bench:** Jesus Cruz came off the bench 12 times during the MAAC portion of the schedule. He averaged 8.8 points per game coming off the bench in MAAC games (104 points) with six games of 10 or more points. In six starts against conference foes, Cruz posted 5.0 points per game (30 points).

**Multiplicity:** Jesus Cruz tacked on three more steals to his season with a trio at Manhattan on March 5. The senior has eight games with two or more steals, the most among his teammates. Taj Benning is next in line with five multiple-steal games.

**Non-Conference Success:** Jesus Cruz enjoyed success against non-conference foes this year, averaging 12.0 points and 4.0 rebounds per game in those games. In MAAC play, Cruz averaged 7.4 points and 3.3 rebounds per game.

**Prestigious Point:** Jesus Cruz scored his 1000th career point on his first basket of the game against Iona on December 12. He finished the game with seven points. The guard netted the prestigious point in his 102nd career game which gave him a 9.8 career scoring average.

**Double-Double:** Jesus Cruz secured the Stags' first double-double of the season with his 10 points and 11 rebounds against Stony Brook. The performance was his third career double-double, also achieving the feat against Quinnipiac with 21 points and 10 rebounds (2017-18) and at Iona with 13 points and 10 rebounds. His career high for rebounding stands at 13 against Marist in 2017-18 but his three points did not yield a double-double.

## Cruz's Biography

### 2019-20

Jesus Cruz split his time between the starting lineup and coming off the bench in 2019-20, opening the year with 12 straight starts. He opened the run with a season-high 24 points against Bucknell, one of his six 20-point efforts during the year. He scored in double figures in the first seven games of the season and nine of the first 10 dates. As a starter, Cruz averaged 13.2 points per game, but tallied 9.1 points per game off the bench. His best performance as a reserve came against Quinnipiac when he tallied 22 points, just one point better than his 21 points off the bench against Canisius and at Manhattan. Cruz ended the season with an 11.0 scoring average which placed second on the team. His scoring total also strong enough to place 21st in the MAAC. Cruz led the team with 26 steals in his 32 appearances, averaging 0.8 per game. He posted seven games with two or more steals including two with five steals (UMass and at Oakland).

### 2018-19

Jesus Cruz averaged 9.4 points per game over his 31 outings, 24 of which were as a starter, leading all guards on the team with his .454 field goal percentage. He netted 10 or more points 15 times which included three 20-point performances (20 points at Quinnipiac, 21 vs. Canisius, and career-high 24 vs. Iona). Earlier in the year, Cruz secured a double-double at Iona with 13 points and 10 rebounds, the second of his career and first since a 21-point, 10-carom event against Quinnipiac in 2017-18. He nearly earned another double-double by fell a rebound shy with his 17 points and nine caroms against LIU Brooklyn. He was one of the best on the team at the free throw line with his .787 mark (48 of 61), making his first 15 free throws of the season and starting the year by netting 23 of his first 24 tries. He ended the regular-season by averaging 10.1 points per game over his final 14 games which included three games of 18 or more points.

### 2017-18

Jesus Cruz played in all 33 games as a freshman which included 24 starts. After coming off the bench in his first four collegiate games, Cruz started the next nine games from the guard position. He averaged 9.3 points per game during that stretch of starts (84 points), a run which included a 16-point effort at Houston. He would surpass that game scoring total just once when he registered a double-double with 21 points and 10 rebounds against Quinnipiac at the Nassau Coliseum. Cruz posted 10 or more points in 14 games including three in the MAAC tournament. The guard averaged 10 points per game in his four MAAC tournament appearances, highlighted by a 14-point night against Iona in the conference championship game. He also averaged 6.5 rebounds per game, setting a personal-best with 13 rebounds against Marist in the Stags' first game of the event. Cruz was especially effective defensively, placing among the MAAC leaders with 1.6 per game. He grabbed four or more steals in four games which included a five-steal effort at Manhattan in December. For the season, Cruz averaged 9.1 points, 4.4 rebounds, 1.4 assists, and 1.6 steals per game.

For the season, he has 59 assists against 34 turnovers which is best among his teammates and places 13th in the MAAC with his 2.7 assists per game.

**Home Front:** Caleb Green posted his first double-digit point total on the road when he netted 12 points at Niagara (December 18). Before that game, all three of his other games with 10 or more points came at Alumni Hall, including his personal-best 15 points in his home debut against Hartford. **Back To Back:** Jalen Leach posted more than 10 points in back-to-back games for the first time as a Stag when he netted 16 points at Niagara and 11 points vs. Fairleigh Dickinson.

**Under Control:** Jalen Leach committed one turnover at Marist on January 16, the seventh eighth contest in which he has not committed more than one miscue in an appearance. He has played 204 minutes translating into just one turnover (12 turnovers total) every 17 minutes he was on the court.

**Personal Best:** Jalen Leach came off the bench and established a career high with 16 points as a reserve against Niagara on December 18. He made five of his six shots from the floor including four of five from three-point range and dished off a personal best four assists.

**Starting Lineup:** Jalen Leach earned his first career start when he received the nod against Iona on December 12. The freshman responded with 10 points, one of three starters and four Fairfield student-athletes overall to reach double figures in the game.

**Off The Bench:** Freshman Jalen Leach was the team's top scorer off the bench in the first five games this year including 13 points at Stony Brook. He reached double figures in five of his 15 appearances starting with a team co-leading total of 10 points at Providence, four of which came off the bench. For the season, the guard is averaging 5.8 points per game as a reserve (104 points in 15 games).

**Four In A Row:** Jalen Leach netted one three pointer at Hartford to give him at least one long-range jumper in his first four appearances this season. The junior netted nine field goals of which five were from behind the arc and made all 10 free throw attempts to secure the point total. Wojcik had not scored more than 18 points in any game as a Stag until last week's performance, hitting that mark against Siena.

**Arc-eology:** Jake Wojcik places sixth in the conference with his 1.9 three-point field goals per game, netting 36 shots in 18 games. Over his last 12 appearances, Wojcik is shooting .456 from behind the three-point arc (26 of 57) which raised his season three-point field goal percentage to .391. He made two or more three pointers in seven of those 12 contests including five long-range shots at Manhattan on March 5.

**Double Figures:** Jake Wojcik posted 15 points in the last game of the Saint Peter's series which was his 11th straight game with 10 or more points. The run tied Taj Benning's early season run of 11 straight games in double figures. Wojcik's streak ended with eight points in the opening game against Canisius. Wojcik doubled that total in the next game against the Griffs with 16 points.

**First Half Romp:** Jake Wojcik scored all 12 of his points in the first half against Fairleigh Dickinson, a point total that ended up leading the team that game. He netted three of five field goal attempts, including one of three three-point tries, and all five free throws in the first 20 minutes of the game. The 12 first-half points ties the best performance by a Stag this year, equalling Caleb Green's total against Iona (November 12).

**Memorable Moment:** Jake Wojcik made his Fairfield debut at Niagara on December 18 and started by making his first shot as a Stag. The forward netted a three-point field goal that tied the game at 3-3 and went on to score 11 points against the Purple Eagles. He also grabbed three rebounds and dished one assist.

**Back In The Game:** Junior Jake Wojcik was declared eligible for the 2020-21 basketball season after the NCAA Division I Council approved a blanket waiver request providing relief for four-year college transfer student-athletes currently serving a transfer year of residence during the 2020-21 academic year.

**Before Fairfield:** Jake Wojcik came to Fairfield after spending his first two seasons at the University of Richmond where he appeared in 64 games. In his first season at Richmond, the guard started 33 games which was the second most by a freshman in school history. He placed fifth on the team in scoring with 7.7 points per game and fourth in rebounding with 3.5 rebounds every forty minutes. **Dependability:** Tshiefu Ngalakulondi did not committed a turnover in three consecutive games from January 10-15, covering 38 minutes as a reserve. He started his career with 10 turnovers in the first six games but has been responsible for eight turnovers over the last 11 games which includes two against Quinnipiac on February 7 which stopped his run of three straight without a turnover.

**Seven In Six:** For the sixth time this season, Tshiefu Ngalakulondi posted seven points in a game when he reached the mark versus Canisius (February 19). He netted that point total in three of his first four games and followed up with a seven-point effort against Rider on January 2nd at Marist on January 16. He connected from beyond the arc in the Canisius game, his sixth game with a three-point field goal.

**Productive Time:** Tshiefu Ngalakulondi scored six points in seven minutes of work against Iona on December 12, netting three of his first field goal attempts. He has scored six or more points in four of his six games and has shot 50 percent or better from field three times. The seven minutes played is his season low, two minutes under his previous low set against Hartford.

**Starting Lineup:** After coming off the bench for the first three games, Tshiefu Ngalakulondi started at Hartford and against Iona (December 11). He answered with seven rebounds in both games and tallied a career-best two assists at Hartford. He switched places with sophomore Chris Maidoh, who started the first three games before coming off the bench at Hartford.

**Defensive Effort:** Tshiefu Ngalakulondi put on a defensive showcase with a block, three steals, and nine rebounds in the team's match up with Stony Brook. The forward set season-highs with his rebounding and steal numbers. Ngalakulondi ranks third in the MAAC with 7.5 rebounds per game.

**Dynamic Debut:** Tshiefu Ngalakulondi started his Fairfield career by leading the team in rebounding and blocked shots. His eight caroms and two rejections also placed him second among the conference statistical leaders. The redshirt junior came off the bench and played 24 minutes.

**2019-20:** Tshiefu Ngalakulondi did not play during the 2019-20 season, completing his one-year residency requirement following his transfer from St. Bonaventure.

**Before Fairfield:** Ngalakulondi comes to Fairfield University after playing two seasons at St. Bonaventure University, appearing in 37 games over his stay with the Bonnies. Last season, the forward averaged 3.6 points and 3.7 rebounds as he split time as a starter (11 games) and as a reserve (eight games). He scored in double figures twice as a sophomore

which resulted in a pair of double-doubles. His first game was a 14-point, 13-rebound effort at Niagara, both of which turned out to be his season highs. Three appearances later, Ngalakulondi registered 11 points and 12 rebounds against the University of Akron. Defensively, Ngalakulondi secured a steal in nine of his first 11 games of the campaign, and posted two games with three or more blocks (3 vs. Georgia State and 4 vs. Delaware State). As a freshman, the forward played in 18 games and averaged 2.3 points and 1.3 rebounds. He shot 61 percent from the floor (17 of 28) including 5 of 11 from behind the three-point line. He netted career-high 21 points in a win over Maryland Eastern Shore, netting eight of 11 shots from the floor. He attended Proctor Academy before enrolling at Saint Bonaventure, earning two Class AA All-New England honors. He averaged 16 points and eight rebounds per game as a senior, 17 points and 11 rebounds as a junior, 13.5 points and eight rebounds as a sophomore and finished his career with more than 1,000 career points.

### Head Coach Jay Young



A respected veteran within college basketball, Jay Young became the 13th Head Coach of the Fairfield University Men's Basketball program on April 3, 2019. Young came to Fairfield after spending the previous three seasons as an assistant coach in the Big Ten at Rutgers University.

In his first season with the Stags, Fairfield established itself as the top defensive team in the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAAC). The Stags led all 11 conference teams by yielding 62.9 points per game overall and 62.1 points per game in MAAC contests.

While at Rutgers, Young helped lead the Scarlet Knights to their best-ever Big Ten finish in 2018-19, recording wins over nationally-ranked conference foes Ohio State and Iowa with one of the youngest rosters in the nation. Young, who coordinated the Rutgers defense for Head Coach Steve Pikiell, was also integral in bringing the highest-ranked freshman class in program history to Piscataway.

Rutgers set a new standard for Big Ten wins in each of Young's three seasons with the Scarlet Knights. The Scarlet Knights earned their first Big Ten postseason win in 2017 and then reached the Big Ten Tournament Quarterfinals for the first time in 2018. KenPom.com ranked Rutgers as the most improved Power 6 conference program in the nation this year, jumping 71 positions since the beginning of the 2018-19 season.

Prior to patrolling the sidelines at Rutgers, Young rose to the role of Associate Head Coach at Stony Brook University, where he was a member of Coach Pikiell's staff for many of the most successful seasons in Seawolves history. Stony Brook reached the NCAA postseason for the first time in its Division I history in 2016 after winning the America East Tournament and Regular Season Championship. The Seawolves also received bids to the National Invitation Tournament (NIT) three times during Young's tenure as the America East Regular Season Champions.

Young also directed the recruiting efforts that brought Jameel Warney to Long Island. A three-time America East Player of the Year, Warney is Stony Brook's all-time leader in points, rebounds and blocked shots. He is currently a member of the Westchester Knicks of the NBA G League. Young recruited three of the top four all-time leading scorers at Stony Brook during his tenure with the Seawolves.

Previously a Head Coach at the University of New Haven, Young took the reins of a team that had just one winning season in the prior eight years and led them to back-to-back NCAA postseason bids in 2003-04, including the Chargers' first victory on the national stage since 1988. He went 78-66 (.542) in his five seasons at New Haven, wrapping up his tenure with four straight winning campaigns.

Young's first head coaching stop was in the junior college ranks at Newbury College, where he was a two-time NJCAA Regional Coach of the Year and 1995 NJCAA District VI Coach of the Year. Young guided his team to postseason play in three straight seasons, highlighted by a trip to the 1995 NJCAA Division III Final Four

Young has also made assistant coaching stops at Northeastern, Salem State, and Fitchburg State in a collegiate coaching career that spans more than 30 years.

A 1986 graduate of Marist College with a Bachelor's Degree in Political Science, Young played three seasons of lacrosse for the Red Foxes. He earned First Team All-Conference honors in his senior campaign.
