TIP-OFF: Marist opens its 20-game Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference schedule against defending champion Iona. Tip-off is set for 7 p.m.

FOLLOW US: Dean Darling (play-by-play) and Steve Eggink (analyst) will have the call on the Red Fox Network. The pre-game show will start at 6:45. In-game updates will be available at @MaristMBB on X. The game will be broadcast on ESPN+ with John Brickley (play-by-play) and Vin Parise (analyst) on the call.

LAST TIME OUT: Marist earned a 73-49 win over Bucknell in its home opener on Nov. 25. Noah Harris scored a game-high 15 and drained five three-pointers. Jaden Daughtry had career highs in points (12) and blocked shots (three). Jackson Price contributed nine points and a game-high eight rebounds. Marist shot .560 from the field, and held Bucknell to a .288 mark.

ABOUT IONA: The Gaels are coming off an 85-68 loss at nationally-ranked Colorado on Sunday. Prior to that, Iona went 1-2 in the Gulf Coast Showcase, and closed out the tournament with a 25-point victory over Buffalo. Idan Tretout (17.0 ppg) is the Gaels' leading scorer. Tobin Anderson is in his first season as head coach.

WHAT'S NEXT: Marist plays its first home MAAC game on Sunday, Dec. 3 against Manhattan. Tip-off is set for 2 p.m.

Top Tidbits

With a win, Marist will finish November with a 4-2 record. Marist has already clinched its first .500 or better November since the 2007-08 season. That was the last time the Red Foxes had a winning record in November (4-3). ... Marist's .560 field goal percentage against Bucknell on Nov. 25 was the Red Foxes' best since a .587 mark at Columbia on Nov. 12, 2021. ... Marist has held an opponent under 30 percent from the field 10 times in the last four seasons after limiting Bucknell to a .288 mark. ... In all three of its wins this year, Marist has held the opposition under 40 percent from the field.

Record at Marist: 61-89

John Dunne was hired as the 12th head coach in Marist men's basketball program history on April 3, 2018. The 2023-24 season is his sixth at Marist.

At Marist (2018-present)

- Led Marist to its first berth in the MAAC Championship final in program history in the 2022-23 season. The Red Foxes won three games in the conference tournament to reach the championship game.
- Coached Patrick Gardner in the 2022-23 season. Gardner ranked in the MAAC top 10 in five statistical categories. He then appeared in NBA Summer League with the Miami Heat and later signed a contract with the Brooklyn Nets.
- Led the Red Foxes to a six-game winning streak in 2021-22, the program's longest streak in 15 years. Road win total was the program's most in 15 years.
- In 2020-21, he led the Red Foxes to their first winning season in 13 years, and best MAAC finish in 14 years.
- In his first season in 2018-19, Dunne led the Red Foxes to their highest win total in five years, their longest winning streak in four years, and their highest total of road wins in 11 years.

Championships

- 2017 CollegeInsider.com postseason tournament (CIT). Came from behind in three road victories, including championship game at Texas A&M Corpus Christi.
- 2011 MAAC Tournament. Won as #4 seed, with victories over #1 Fairfield on its home court in semifinals and #2 Iona in championship game.

Head Coach, Saint Peter's (2006-18)

- 2017-18: Became the first #9 seed to reach MAAC Championship semifinal round with victory over top-seeded Rider.
- 2016-17: Won CIT championship, the program's first national postseason championship. Won 23 games, second-highest total in school history. Set program record with 14 MAAC wins (went 14-6 in conference, finished second). Had program's first MAAC Defensive Player of the Year (Chazz Patterson), two All-MAAC selections (Quadir Welton, First Team; Trevis Wyche, Second Team), and CIT MVP (Welton). Went 18-6 after New Year's Day, including winning 11 out of 12 to close the season.
- Went 26-14 in MAAC play, 2015-16 and 2016-17.

- Won six MAAC Tournament games and had three semifinal appearances from 2015 to 2018.
- 2010-11: Program's first MAAC championship since 1995, went 20-11 (first 20-win season in 20 years).
- Won 11 MAAC games in the 2009-10 and 2010-11, which hadn't happened at Saint Peter's since 1989.
- Increased the program's win total in each of his first five seasons.
- Defensive success: Ranked second in NCAA in defensive field goal percentage in both 2009-10 (.377) and 2010-11 (.376). Finished 18th in NCAA in defensive efficiency in 2016-17, becoming one of just 11 teams since 2001-02 to finish in the nation's top 75 in all four factors of defensive efficiency.
- Won five MAAC Tournament games as the lower-seeded team (two in 2011, one in 2015, two in 2017). Two of these victories occurred in the quarterfinals, one in the semifinals, and one in the championship game.
- Power conference success: Went 3-3 vs. Rutgers (Big Ten), recorded victories against Alabama (SEC) and Seton Hall (Big East).
- Coached nine 1,000-point scorers, 13 All-MAAC selections, three All-Rookie Team selections, four MAAC All-Tournament Team selections (including one MVP), one MAAC Defensive Player of the Year, and six MAAC All-Academic Team selections.
- Graduated 100 percent of his recruits who completed their eligibility at Saint Peter's.
- Players & coaches donated their time to local soup kitchens and elementary schools.

Assistant Coach Experience

- Seton Hall University (2001-06). Pirates reached NCAA Tournament twice and Postseason NIT once.
- Siena College (1999-2001). Won MAAC regular-season title both seasons, advanced to Postseason NIT Second Round in 2000, had 44-20 overall record.
- Manhattan College (1998-99). Worked under head coach John Leonard.
- Adelphi University (1996-98). Worked under current Orlando Magic head coach Steve Clifford; team posted record of 43-17 in two seasons.
- Wilkes University (1992-94, 1995-96). Had 28-2 record and trip to Division III Elite Eight in 1995-96.
- Western Michigan University (1994-95). First Division I job, worked under head coach Bob Donewald.

Education/Playing Experience

- Earned Master's degree in Sport Management from East Stroudsburg University (1996).
- Earned Bachelor's degree in Psychology from Ithaca College (1992). Was a four-year men's basketball letterwinner. Graduated as the program's all-time leader in steals and third in assists (currently sits fourth in steals, fifth in assists). His 60 steals as a senior rank second in a season.
- Graduated from Archbishop Molloy High School (1988). Played for legendary head coach Jack Curran.

Series History

- This is the 73rd all-time meeting between the teams. Iona leads the series, 54-18, and has won six straight.
- Marist has lost eight straight at the Hynes Center. The Red Foxes' last victory came on Feb. 7, 2013 by a score of 105-104 in double overtime. In that game, **Chavaughn Lewis** drained a three-quarter court shot at the end of the first overtime.
- **John Dunne** is 2-7 against the Gaels as Marist's head coach, with an 0-4 record at the Hynes Center.

MAAC Openers

- This is Marist's 27th year in the MAAC. The Red Foxes are 14-12 in MAAC openers, which includes a 12-5 mark at home and a 2-7 mark on the road.
- This is the fifth time Marist has opened MAAC play against Iona. The Red Foxes are 1-3 in these games. Marist prevailed at home in 2008, lost on the road in 2013, lost at home in 2015, and lost at home in 2021.

Strong Start

- With a win against Iona, Marist will finish November with a 4-2 record.
- Marist has already clinched its first .500 or better November since the 2007-08 season. That was also the last time the Red Foxes had a winning record in November (4-3).
- Marist began the season 2-0 with road wins against Army and UMBC. It marked the first time in Marist's 43 years in Division I that the Red Foxes have started 2-0 with both wins taking place on the road.
- Marist's 71-55 season-opening win at Army West Point was its largest margin of victory in a season opener since 1999. The Red Foxes led by double digits for the final 24:22 of the game.
- Marist has now won four of its last five season openers.

Offensive Efficiency

- Marist shot a season-best .560 (28-for-50) from the field in its victory over Bucknell on Nov. 25. It was the Red Foxes' best single-game field goal percentage since a .587 mark at Columbia on Nov. 12, 2021.
- Marist has shot at least 50 percent from the field three times in its first five games this season.
- The Red Foxes are shooting .478 from the field this season, which ranks second in the MAAC and 68th nationally.

Doing it with Defense

- Marist held Bucknell to .288 (17-for-59) shooting from the field in its win over the Bison on Nov. 25. It marked the 10th time in the last four seasons that the Red Foxes have held an opponent under 30 percent from the field.
- In all three of its wins this season, Marist has held the opposition under 40 percent from the field.
- Marist is holding the opposition to .411 shooting from the field this season, which ranks second in the MAAC.
- Marist has allowed 63.8 points per game this season, which ranks first in the MAAC and 55th nationally.

Maxing Out

- Sophomore center **Max Allen II** led Marist in scoring in each of its first four games this season, and leads the team with four double-digit scoring games.
- Allen leads the Red Foxes with 15.6 points per game. His .630 field goal percentage ranks first in the MAAC and 34th nationally.
- Allen set a career high with 28 points at New Hampshire on Nov. 21. He shot 12-for-17 from the field and 5-for-5 from the free throw line.
- Allen has converted 11 straight free throws over his last three games.

Brickner Across the Board

- Sophomore guard **Isaiah Brickner** leads the Red Foxes in assists (3.8 apg), rebounds (5.2 rpg), and minutes (26.6 mpg), and is tied for the team lead in steals (1.4 spg).

- Brickner has a 2.11 assist-to-turnover ratio (19-9) this season.

- Brickner had a dunk at New Hampshire on Nov. 21 that ranked #4 on SportsCenter's Top 10 plays.

Jaden Makes the Jump

- Sophomore forward **Jaden Daughtry** set career highs in points (12) and blocked shots (three) in Marist's win over Bucknell on Nov. 25.

- Daughtry had a then-career high 11 points, a season-high eight rebounds, three steals, and two blocked shots in a win at UMBC on Nov. 11.
