- Three Griffs average 9+ points led by Paul McMillan's MAAC leading 19.6 ppg. He is also No. 2 on the team in with 3.6 rpg and 2.9 apg.
- Tana Kopa averages 12.1 ppg with a team-best 47 3FG.
- Jasman Sangha's 9.3 ppg is No. 3.
- Cam Palesse leads with 4.9 rpg and Anthony Benard with 3.7 apg.
- The Griffs were selected to finish 12th in the MAAC this season.

GAELS IN MAAC REGULAR SEASON PLAY

- Since the inception of the MAAC in the 1981-82 season, Iona has compiled a 449-272 (.623) record in regular season play.
- The Gaels' 449 wins and .623 win percentage are the highest of any current MAAC member.
- The Gaels became the first team to reach 400 wins with its win at Rider on Dec. 19, 2020.
- Iona is 102 wins ahead of Siena, No. 2 on the list.

GAELS IN MAAC PLAY AT HOME

• Iona was 6-4 in its MAAC home regular season contests in 2023-24, 1-2 this season and are 28-7 in its last 34 MAAC games at the Hynes Center.

- Iona is 106-29 (.785) in MAAC contests at the Hynes Center in its last 135 games.
- The Gaels overall record in home conference games is an outstanding 253-101 (.715).

CHAIRMEN OF THE BOARDS (PART I)

- <u>lona ranks No. 2 in the NCAA in offensive</u> rebounds (16.4/g).
- The Gaels have dropped the first battle of the offensive glass vs. Quinnipiac last Sunday, after winning the first 16 games thus far. Overall the Gaels hold a 6.9 per game advantage. (+8.6 home, +5.8 away/neutral)
- Overall the Maroon & Gold has outrebounded its opponent in 10 of the 17 games, posting a 5-5 record (0-6 when opponents have more boards, 0-1 equal rebounds).
- At home, Iona holds a +6.9 overall rebound margin advantage and +3.9 away from home.

THE GAELS GIVETH & THE GAELS TAKETH AWAY

- <u>lona ranks No. 6 in the NCAA and first in the MAAC in turnovers forced (17.4/g).</u>
- Over the last 11 games, the Gaels have forced 18.9 giveaways per game.
- At Siena on Jan. 5, the Maroon & Gold forced 25 turnovers, the most since 25 vs. Long Beach State in Las Vegas on Nov. 19, 2018, a span of 193 games.
- On the flip side, Iona's 16.7 turnovers per game is 352nd in the nation.

DOUBLE TROUBLE

- Senior **Dejour Reaves** posted his first Div. I double-double with 16 points and 10 rebounds vs. Quinnipiac on Jan. 12.
- Junior **James Patterson** had his first as a Div. I player vs. Saint Peter's with an 18-point, 11-rebound effort in the Gaels' win on Dec. 8.
- Patterson posted 16 double-doubles in two seasons at Division II St. Thomas Aquinas, including 13 as a sophomore last season.
- Reaves was the third Iona player to complete a double-double this season following Patterson and junior Yaphet Moundi's 16 points and 18 rebounds vs. Delaware on Nov. 12.

TWO AND TWO

- Among the 5,202 NCAA Division I players to log minutes in 2024-25, junior Yaphet Moundi is one of 162 to record two or more blocks and two or more steals in a game on multiple occasions.
- He posted three blocks and three steals vs.
 Delaware on Nov. 12 and two blocks and three steals at Sacred Heart on Dec. 6.
- Moundi is tied for the MAAC lead with six others including: Jaden Daughtry (Marist), Bryan Etumnu (Merrimack), Tana Kopa (Canisius), Amiri Stewart (Sacred Heart), Amarri Tice (Quinnipiac), and Myles Wilmoth (Siena). Seven other MAAC players have recorded one this season.

30-POINT CLUB

- Senior **Dejour Reaves** became the most recent member of Iona's 30-point in a game club, the 49th player in program history to reach it.
- Reaves had his second NCAA 30-point effort, matching his career-best with 30 vs. Indiana State.
- The last five members include: **Greg Gordon** and **Idan Tretout** in 2023-24, **Walter Clayton Jr.** and **Daniss Jenkins** in 2022-23 and **Isaiah Ross** in 2020-21.

2024-25 TEAM CAPTAINS

- Head coach Tobin Anderson named graduate
 Jalen Barr and seniors Dejour Reaves and
 Clarence Rupert as team captains for the 2024-25 season during the Gaels trip to the Baha Mar Hoops Nassau Championship in November.
- The three veteran student athletes have combined to play more than 260 games in their collegiate careers.

KING OF THE HILL, TOP OF THE LIST

- No team among the 13 NYC Metropolitan Area Division I basketball programs within 30 miles of the center of NY College basketball, Madison Square Garden has won more games than Iona University in the 27 seasons (550; Hofstra #2, 540).
- Over the last decade-plus, Iona's 296 wins and .627 win percentage are also the best in both categories. (Seton Hall, 274 wins; .578 win pct.)
- Since 1995-96, the Maroon & Gold hold the lead in wins (550), 10 more than Hofstra, 37 more than No. 3 Seton Hall and the top win percentage (.590).
- Iona's 12 postseason appearances (eight NCAA, three NIT, one CIT) since 2010-11 are the most during the time frame, four more than Seton Hall (six NCAA, two NIT) and seven more than St. John's (three NCAA, two NIT).

BRAND NEW (ROCHELLE)

- Iona's roster features 16 newcomers for the 2024-25 season.
- Tobin Anderson and staff completed their roster with a talented mix of transfers and firstyear players.
- The Gaels' five Division I transfers include sophomore Comeh Emuobor (UCF), junior Luke Jungers, (Omaha), seniors DeJour Reaves (Northern Colorado) and Clarence Rupert (Southern Illinois/Saint Peter's) and junior Christian Winborne (Saint Joseph's).
- Reaves and Rupert are the most accomplished of the five. Reaves was an All-Big Sky performer and conference Sixth Man of the Year in 2023-24.
 Rupert helped lead Saint Peter's to an Elite Eight appearance as a rookie in 2022.
- The newcomer list includes two impact Division II transfers in senior **Jalen Barr** (Flagler) and junior **James "Biggie" Patterson** (STAC).
- Patterson was originally recruited by Anderson at St. Thomas Aquinas and starred for two seasons across the Hudson River for the Spartans.
- Anderson and his staff brought in two junior college transfers in juniors Kernan Bundy (Hutchison CC) and Yaphet Moundi (Panola College)
- The Gaels freshman class includes Jacob Hogarth (Brooklyn, NY), Justin Menard (Higganum, CT), Adam Njie Jr. (Bronx, NY) JoJo Wallace (Milford, CT).
- Njie is the highest rated freshman guard ever recruited by Iona. Wallace is the son of former Syracuse standout John Wallace.
- The final three spots are filled by junior walk-on Tyruse Boock (New York, NY) and freshmen Connor Horan (Fairfax, VA) and Josh Michigan (Brick, NJ).

REAVES, PATTERSON AND RUPERT NAMED PRESEASON ALL-MAAC

- Seniors Dejour Reaves and Clarence Rupert and junior James "Biggie" Patterson were Iona's representatives on the Preseason All-MAAC Teams selected by the league's 13 head coaches.
- Reaves was picked on the first team, Patterson the second team and Rupert on the third.

CHAIRMEN OF THE BOARDS (PART II)

- Junior **Yaphet Moundi** completed his first Division I double-double with 16 points and 18 rebounds vs. Delaware.
- It has been 10 seasons since an Iona player reached a rebounding total that high. Former MAAC Player of the Year **David Laury** also grabbed 18 at Marist on February 20, 2015. The school record remains 20, held by **Jonathan Duck** in the 1990-91 season. Moundi had nine offensive rebounds.
- It is tied for the seventh highest total in the NCAA this season, as of Tuesday's games.

GAELS PICKED THIRD IN MAAC PRESEASON POLL

- Iona was selected No. 3 in the preseason poll of the league's 13 head coaches.
- The Maroon & Gold has captured a league best 13 regular season championships in 43 MAAC seasons.

NJIE NAMED MAAC ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

- Freshman Adam Njie Jr. was named MAAC Rookie of the Week on November 11 following his performance in the Gaels opening contests of 2024-25.
- Njie averaged 13.0 points, 2.5 rebounds, 3.5 assists in his first two collegiate games at Princeton and Hofstra.
- Iona earned four MAAC Rookie of the Week and two Player of the Week honors in 2023-24.

ROOKIE DEBUTS

- Freshman Adam Njie's 19-point effort at Princeton in his first collegiate game for the Gaels was the second highest effort for an Iona freshman in his debut this century.
- Njie was one point shy of former MAAC Rookie of the Year Schadrac Casmir's 20 points in his first contest vs. Cleveland State in 2014.
- **Steve Burtt Jr.** holds the third highest effort, with 18 points vs. Lipscomb in 2002.

MID-MAJOR ACCOLADES

- Senior Dejour Reaves was named to Bracketeer.org's 2025 Preseason Non-Power Conference All-America watch list.
- Reaves is one of 68 players to appear on the All-America teams or watch list.
- Iona's 2025 opponents on the list include first teamers Xavian Lee and Caden Pierce of Princeton and watch list members Josh Piscarelli (Marist), Budd Clark (Merrimack), Amarri Monroe (Quinnipiac), and Paul Otieno (Quinnipiac).

IN THE BOOKS

- All 14 new Gaels who have appeared in during 2024-25 campaign have scored their first points for the Maroon & Gold. Nine came at Princeton on opening night.
- Seniors Dejour Reaves and Clarence Rupert, juniors Luke Jungers, James Patterson, Yaphet Moundi and Kernan Bundy, sophomore Comeh Emuobor and freshmen Adam Njie and Jacob Hogarth and scored their first collegiate points vs. the Tigers.
- Rookies JoJo Wallace and Justin Menard got in the scoring column for the first time at Hofstra.
- Graduate Jalen Barr made his Iona debut vs.
 Vermont got in the scoring column vs. Cornell.
- Freshman walk-on Josh Michigan scored eight points in his second appearance of the season at Sacred Heart.
- Junior Christian Winborne returned from injury and scored four points in his Gael debut at Colgate.

REGULAR SEASON CHAMPIONS

- Iona has earned 13 MAAC regular season championship, a league record total.
- Iona has earned six regular season titles in the last 13 seasons.
- The Gaels regular season titles have come in 1982-83, 1983-84, 1984-85, 1995-96, 1996-97, 1997-98, 2000-01, 2011-12, 2013-14, 2014-15, 2018-19, 2021-22, 2022-23.

- Iona has posted 24 20+ win season in the 79year history of the program.
- The Gaels have 11 such campaigns since 2009-10, spanning the last 15 seasons.
- Iona won 25+ games, the seventh and eighth time in history and fifth in the last 12 seasons in 2021-22 and 2022-23.

TOBIN ANDERSON YEAR 2

- **Tobin Anderson** is in his second season as head coach of the Iona program in 2024-25.
- Anderson served as head coach at FDU where he led the No. 16 seeded Knights to the NCAA Tournament's second round after a stunning upset over No. 1 Purdue. His FDU squad finished 21-16 overall, earning the NEC's automatic bid.

- He led the Knights to two NCAA Tournament wins, over Texas Southern and the Boilermakers.
- The year before Anderson's arrival, the Knights posted a 4-22 record.
- Anderson had a highly successful coaching career at St. Thomas Aquinas, located less than 25 miles from Iona's New Rochelle Campus.
- A perennial Top 25 program in Division II, STAC won 209 games in nine seasons under Anderson, with five ECC regular season and six tournament titles.
- STAC reached the NCAA Division II tournament in each of his final seven seasons with an Elite 8 appearance in 2017 and Sweet 16 appearances in 2019, 2021 and 2022.
- He was a four-time ECC Coach of the Year (2015, 2016, 2021, 2022) and six-time Metropolitan Basketball Writers Association Division II Coach of the Year (2015, 2016, 2017, 2021, 2022, 2023).
- Prior to STAC, Anderson served as an assistant at Iona's MAAC-rival Siena for two seasons.
- Before his Siena, he was an established Division III head coach at Hamilton and Clarkson in upstate New York.
- Anderson graduated from Wesleyan in 1995 where he was a four-year starter, two-year captain, and is one of the top 10 leading scorers in school history.

IONA IN SEASON OPENERS

- The Gaels are 52-26 record in their first game of the season since 1945.
- Iona opened the season on the road for second straight year.
- The Maroon & Gold is just 16-22 in season openers away from home and have lost 22 straight since the 2006-07 campaign.

HYNES DOMINANCE

- Iona had a 21-game Hynes Center winning streak snapped vs. Rider on Jan. 15, 2023.
- The 21-game streak tied the second longest home winning streak in program history, behind 2014-16 (26) and matching 1979-80 and 1951-53.
- The Gaels are **35-11** (.**761**) in the last 3+ seasons.
- Iona is <u>136-38 (.782)</u> since 2009.
- The Maroon & Gold are <u>22-8 (.733)</u> over the last 10+ seasons in non-conference home games.

LET IT RAIN

- After 17 games, Iona has made a three-pointer in 530 straight and 975 out of its last 977 games.
- In 2019-20, the Gaels eclipsed their previous program record of 386 straight from Jan. 5, 1994
 Dec. 16, 2006.
- The Gaels have failed to hit a three-pointer in just 18 of their <u>1,203</u> games played since the line was adopted for the 1986-87 season.

GOING DEEP

- Iona has posted 10 or more 3FG in 12 of its 50 games under head coach Tobin Anderson, posting a 9-3 record.

- · Iona Athletics celebrated of recent Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame Inductee Jim Valvano with a recognition ceremony on Sunday, January 7, 2024.
- Valvano served as head coach of the men's basketball program from 1975-1980, as Director of Athletics from 1977-1980, and was inducted into the Iona University Arrigoni Hall of Fame in 1994.
- Valvano led the Gaels to a 95-46 (.674) record in five seasons remains top-five all-time in program

history in wins and win percentage.

- · Valvano taught Iona to "Dare to Dream" while recruiting some of the Maroon & Gold's finest talent ever and the results showed.
- · Iona's 1979-80 team finished 29-5, setting a program record for wins that stands to this day.
- · The Gaels were ECAC Champions and defeated eventual national champion Louisville, 77-60, in front of sold-out Madison Square Garden in February 1980, while advancing to the second round of the NCAA Tournament before falling to Georgetown.

RICHIE GUERIN'S #14 HANGS IN THE RAFTERS

- · Iona honored the legacy of Richie Guerin '54 by retiring his number 14 on Jan. 31, 2014 the first ever in school history.
- Guerin is an Iona University Goal Club (1983), Marine Corps Sports (2004), and Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame (2013) inductee who starred for the Maroon & Gold from 1951-1954.
- · He rewrote the basketball record books at Iona, scoring 1,375 points and graduated as the leading scorer in school history.
- · A two-time All-Metropolitan selection with the Gaels, he scored a then school-record 40 points against John Carroll in 1954 and was the first Gael to score 40 or more points in a game.
- Following his playing days at Iona, Guerin played with the National Basketball Association's New York Knicks from 1956-1963 and was a player-coach of the St. Louis/Atlanta Hawks franchise for nine years.
- In 13 years as a professional player, Guerin accumulated 14,676 points (17.3 per game), 4,278 rebounds (5.1 per game), and 4,211 assists (5.0 per game) over 848 games.

GAEL GREATS

In addition to Naismith Hall of Famers **Richie Guerin '54** and **Jim Valvano** here are additional significant names in Iona basketball history:

- Jeff Ruland '91 All-American during his time at Iona and, two-time NBA All-Star with the Washington Bullets, Philadelphia 76ers and Detroit Pistons. Following his career, returned to Iona and served as head coach from 1998-2007 where he won three MAAC Championships.
- Tim Cluess head coach from 2010-2020. At the helm during one the Gaels' most successful decades in program history. Cluess won 199 games in nine seasons on the sideline including six NCAA appearances, five MAAC tournament championships, and four MAAC regular season titles. He is the all-time MAAC leader in MAAC tournament victories.
- Pat Kennedy head coach from 1980-86. Went on to coach at Florida State, DePaul, Montana, and Towson following a highly successful tenure in New Rochelle.
- Warren Isaac '65 Iona's only 50-point scorer, Isaac played six seasons in Europe following his tenure at Iona. A New York City school legend, Isaac started for Power Memorial paving the way for NBA Hall of Famer Kareem Abdul-Jabbar a 1965 graduate of the high school.
- Tim Welsh head coach from 1995-98 who went on to coach in the Big East with Providence for 10 seasons. Currently an ESPN college basketball analyst. Holds the highest career winning percentage ever at Iona.
- Kevin Willard Iona coach from 2007-10, now head coach at Big 10's Maryland. Helped turn around a program which won two games in the season prior to his arrival to 20 wins in his final season in Maroon & Gold.
- Steve Burtt '84 & Steve Burtt '06 All-time NCAA father/son scoring leaders, both netting over 2,000 career points. Burtt, the father, had a four-season NBA career and most notably appeared off the bench for the Phoenix Suns in the 1992 NBA Playoffs. He was inducted into the prestigious NYC Basketball Hall of Fame this past fall. Burtt, the son, continues to play professionally in Europe.
- Sean Green '91 Played 84 NBA games over three seasons for the Indiana Pacers, Philadelphia 76ers and Utah Jazz from 1991-94. Currently a high school basketball coach in Southern California.
- Scott Machado '12 The last Gael to appear in an NBA game. Machado played in regular season NBA contests in 2012-13 with the Houston Rockets and postseason with the Golden State Warriors. Played the majority 2018-19 season in the NBA G-League for the South Bay Lakers and played four games with the Los Angeles Lakers. The MAAC & Iona's all-time assist leader. He currently plays professionally in Australia.

• **Bob Santini '53** - Iona's first NBA player, appeared in four games with the New York Knicks in 1955-56.

- **Brendan Malone '62** longtime NBA assistant coach, last with the Detroit Pistons from 2014-16. Coach Malone passed away in 2023 at age 88.
- **Don McLean** Singer-songwriter noted most famous for his 1971 single "American Pie".
- Dennis Leonard Kansas City Royals Hall of Famer and 12-year MLB veteran who won 20 games on three occasions from 1977-80. He was inducted in May 2015 into the New York Baseball Hall of Fame.
- **Kyle Flood '93** Former head football coach at Rutgers, current offensive coordinator and offensive line coach at Texas.
- Maggie Timoney '89 The Iona women's basketball Hall of Famer recently _became the first female CEO of Heineken USA.
- Jason Motte Major League Baseball relief pitcher recorded the final out of the 2011 World Series with the world champion St. Louis Cardinals. Has also appeared in Major League games with the Chicago Cubs, Colorado Rockies and Atlanta Braves.
- Leonard Korir '12 a two time NCAA track and field champion while at Iona, Korir represented Team USA in the 2016 Rio Olympic Games in the 10,000-meters and 2024 Paris Games in the Marathon.
- Ignacio Maganto was selected by the LA Galaxy with the 21st pick in the first round of the 2015 MLS SuperDraft, the first Major League Soccer draft pick in Iona history. Maganto scored his first MLS goal with the Galaxy in the spring of 2015.
- Mariano Rivera III '15 Earned his degree in May 2015 and was selected in the fourth round by the Washington Nationals.
- Emma Hayes Iona's women's soccer coach from 2003-2005, Hayes was named the 10th full-time United States Women's Soccer National Team head coach in November 2023 and won Gold in the 2024 Paris Olympic Games.
- Juana Camilion Two-time MAAC Defensive Player of the Year and 2023 MAAC Player of the Year, Camilion represented Spain the 3x3 women's basketball at the 2024 Paris Olympics, earning a silver medal.

Tobin ANDERSON

Head Coach Wesleyan '95 - Second Season

Tobin Anderson is in his second season as head coach of the Iona University men's basketball program. He was appointed to the position on March 21, 2023. Anderson came to New Rochelle after serving as head coach at FDU where he led the No. 16 seeded Knights to the NCAA Tournament's second round after a stunning upset over No. 1 Purdue.

Anderson led the 2022-23 FDU squad to a 21-16 overall record and 10-6 in Northeast Conference play. The Knights earned the NEC's automatic bid and earned two wins in this year's NCAA Tournament, a First Four win over Texas Southern and the first-round win over the Boilermakers. It was just the second-ever win for a No. 16 seed over a No. 1 seed in tournament history. The year before Anderson's arrival, the Knights posted a 4-22 record.

Prior to FDU, Anderson had a highly successful coaching career at St. Thomas Aguinas, located less than 25 miles from Iona's New Rochelle Campus. In nine seasons, he turned STAC into a perennial Top 25 program in Division II after inheriting a team that won just five games prior to his hire. In total he led the Spartans to a 209-62 (.771) overall mark, earning five East Coast Conference regular season and six tournament titles. Anderson's STAC program reached the NCAA Division II tournament in each of his final seven seasons with an Elite 8 appearance in 2017 and Sweet 16 appearances in 2019, 2021 and 2022. A highlight of Anderson's first NCAA tournament season in 2015-16 was a 90-58, exhibition win over St. John's to open the campaign on November 4, 2015. Under Anderson, the Spartans posted a 128-30 (.810) mark in regular season ECC play. He was a four-time ECC Coach of the Year (2015, 2016, 2021, 2022) and five-time Metropolitan Basketball Writers Association Division II Coach of the Year (2015, 2016, 2017, 2021, 2022). Anderson got his first taste of Division I coaching, serving as an assistant at Iona's MAAC-rival Siena for two seasons from 2011–2013. Before his time at Siena, Anderson was an established head coach at the Division III level at Hamilton College and Clarkson University in upstate New York.

While at Hamilton, Anderson posted a 118-63 (.652) record in seven seasons. The Continentals reached the league tournament five times including a tournament championship and a trip to the NCAA D-III tournament. He guided his team to the second round of the NCAA tournament in 2006 and earned three regular season titles.

Anderson earned his first head coaching position at Clarkson University in Potsdam, NY. In his five years with the Golden Knights, he broke the school record for wins, with a 19-10 season in 2001-02. The team advanced to the ECAC regional championship game and was the third-most improved Division III men's basketball team from the previous season. Anderson's first team finished the 1999-00 season with a 14-12 record, the program's first winning season in 25 years and its first-ever post season bid.

To begin his coaching career, Anderson spent three years as an assistant coach; one year at Clarkson in 1996-97 and two years at Le Moyne College, from 1997-1999.

Anderson graduated from Wesleyan University in 1995 with a bachelor's degree in American Studies. He was a four-year starter, two-year captain, and is one of the top 10 leading scorers in school history. Anderson earned his master's in Athletic Administration from Florida State University in 1996. He is originally a native of Truro, lowa. He and his wife Jodi have two children, Bryce and Alexa.
