# IONA VS. CANISIUS - SERIES HISTORY

- The Gaels and Griffs meet for the 86th time in history with Iona holding a 51-34 advantage.
- · Canisius snapped a 10-game losing streak to Iona in Bufallo last season but has dropped 11 of the last 12.
- The Maroon & Gold has won 18 of the last 23 meetings.
- Iona is 16-23 on Canisius' home floor.

# SCOUTING CANISIUS (3-25, 3-14 MAAC)

- Three Griffs average 9+ points led by Paul McMillan's MAAC leading 20.3 ppg. He is also No. 2 on the team in with 3.5 rpg and 2.8 apg.
- Tana Kopa averages 13.1 ppg with a team-best 85 3FG.
- Jasman Sangha's 9.3 ppg is No. 2.
- Cam Palesse leads with 5.0 rpg and Anthony Benard with
- · The Griffs were selected to finish 12th in the MAAC this season.

## GAELS IN MAAC REGULAR SEASON PLAY

• Since the inception of the MAAC in the 1981-82 season, Iona has compiled a 457-276 (.623) record in regular season play.

- The Gaels' 457 wins and .623 win percentage are the highest of any current MAAC member.
- The Gaels became the first team to reach 450 wins with its win vs. Canisius on Jan. 16, 2025.
- Iona is 104 wins ahead of Siena, No. 2 on the list.

# **GAELS IN MAAC PLAY AWAY FROM HOME**

- The Gaels improved to 20games over .500 in MAAC road contests all-time following its win at Niagara Friday night.
- The team is 5-4 in 2024-25.
- Iona holds a 191-171 (.528) in its 44th season in the MAAC.

#### THE ELUSIVE WESTERN NEW YORK SWEEP

- With a win today, Iona seeks just the ninth 2-0 trip to Western New York in 34 years of traveling to play Niagara and Canisius.
- The 33 prior trips the Gaels have swept the games eight time, earned 19 splits and have come up empty six times.
- Iona has won the first game on the trip 21 times and has posted an 8-13 record in the second game after doing so (4-8 vs. Canisius).
- The Maroon & Gold's series sweeps have come in 2022-23, 2015-16, 2013-14, 2011-12, 2008-09, 2005-06, 1997-98, and 1990-91.

#### SEE YOU IN ATLANTIC CITY

- With its win over Niagara Friday night, lona clinched a berth into the 2025 MAAC Championship in Atlantic City, taking place March 11-15 at Boardwalk Hall.
- Only 10 of the 13 teams will participate in the tournament. It is the first time in MAAC history all of its schools will not compete.
- With two games left for the Gaels, Iona can finish as high as third and as low as ninth.

# DON'T MISS THE (MA)ACTION

- The MAAC is No. 1 the NCAA this season in Close Game Percentage according to a metric maintained by KenPom.com and defined as games separated by three or less points or overtime.
- 32 of the 112 MAAC games have been "close" thus far (28.6%) including Iona's game Friday.
- Iona has been involved in six such games (3-3) in conference while Canisius has played one (0-1). Rider (4-4) and Niagara (3-5) lead the MAAC with eight followed by Manhattan (3-4).
- The percentage of games decided by two or less possessions (six points) balloons to 48.2%.
- Iona (7-5), Rider (6-6), Niagara (3-8), and Marist (8-2) and lead with 10 or more.

# **GET HOT (STAY HOT?)**

- Despite dropping three of its last five, Iona still holds one of the top records over the last six weeks of the season.
- The Gaels have won eight of its 12 (8-4) games, playing only behind Quinnipiac (9-2) and tied with Marist (8-4) in win percentage in the MAAC over the time frame.
- Manhattan (7-4) is tied in the loss column with the Gaels and Red Foxes since January 16's contests.
- Iona stands alone in fifth place in the MAAC standings, tied in the loss column with Jaspers and Sacred Heart and one games back of Mount St. Mary's.

#### TOP 5 IN THE NATION

- Iona ranks No. 3 in among all NCAA Div. I programs Steals Rate and No. 4 in Defensive Turnover Rate according to KenPom.com.
- The Gaels force an opponent turnover on 23.1% of its possessions, behind Abeline Christian (24.1%), Tarleton State (23.6%) and UCSD (23.4%).
- The steals rate of 14.4% is just behind ACU (14.6%) and UCSD (14.6%) and ahead of Missouri (14.3%).

# I NEED A HERO

- Two of Iona's last three MAAC road wins have come in the final second of the ball game.
- At Niagara on Friday, rookie Adam Njie Jr. drained a 16-foot pull up jumper from the elbow with 0.9 seconds on the clock to propel Iona to a 65-63 win.
- At Mount St. Mary's, for the first time in 28 seasons - a span of 863 games - Iona recorded a game-winning field goal with time expiring in its 60-57 win on Feb. 6.
- Senior Dejour Reaves connected on a threepointer from the left win following an offensive rebound by Yaphet Moundi and a hand off from Luke Jungers. Replay review saw the shot just off his fingertips with 0.1 seconds on the clock.
- The last Iona "buzzer beater" came on January 13, 1998 when senior Mount Vernon, NY native John McDonald's shot from the top of the key sent the Gaels' home with a 75-72 win over Manhattan at the Hynes Center, then named the Mulcahy Center.

# **FGA DIFFERENTIAL**

- Iona ranks No. 2 in the country in field goal attempt differential, having attempted 217 more shots than their opponents.
- The disparity is based on the Gaels' proclivity to force opponent turnovers and grab offensive rebounds, two areas it ranks in the Top 5 in the NCAA.
- Houston (+251) is the only team ahead of Iona.
   St. John's (+215), Marquette (+214) and Hampton (+207) round out the top five.

# MOUNDI EARNS MAAC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- On Feb. 3, junior Yaphet Moundi became the first lona player to earn MAAC Player the Week honors after averaging 18.0 points and 10 rebounds in two games vs Manhattan and Fairfield.
- Moundi posted an incredible 25 points and 20 rebounds vs. the Stags in the win.

# **CHAIRMEN OF THE BOARDS**

- <u>Iona ranks No. 5 in the NCAA in offensive rebounds (14.7/g).</u>
- The Gaels are 23-6 in battles of the offensive glass winning the first 16 of the season. Overall

the Gaels hold a +5. per game advantage. (+6.5 | home, +3.8 away/neutral).

- Overall the Maroon & Gold has out rebounded its opponent in 17 of the 29 games, posting a 11-6 record (2-9 when opponents have more boards, 0-1 equal rebounds).
- At home, Iona holds a +6.7 overall rebound margin advantage and +1.8 away from home.

# THE GAELS GIVETH & THE GAELS TAKETH AWAY

- <u>lona ranks No. 9 in the NCAA and first in the MAAC in turnovers forced (16.1/g).</u>
- At Siena on Jan. 5, the Maroon & Gold forced 25 turnovers, the most since 25 vs. Long Beach State in Las Vegas on Nov. 19, 2018, a span of 193 games.
- On the flip side, Iona's 14.8 turnovers per game is 345th in the nation.

# **DOUBLE TROUBLE**

- Junior **Yaphet Moundi** leads the Gaels with four double-doubles following his 12 point, 14 rebound effort last Friday night vs. Manhattan. He posted 11/11 at Mount St. Mary's on Feb. 6, 25/20 vs. Fairfield on Feb. 2 and 16/18 vs. Delaware on Nov. 12.
- Senior **Dejour Reaves** recorded his second double-double of the year with 18 points and 11 boards vs. Manhattan. His Div. I effort was 16/11 vs. Quinnipiac on Jan. 12.
- Moundi and Reeves both had a double-double vs. the Jaspers, the first time lona had teammates hit the mark since **Daniss Jenkins** and **Nelly Junior Joseph** at Marist on Jan. 6, 2023.
- Rookie **Adam Njie Jr.** posted his first collegiate double-double with 10 points and 12 rebounds vs. Rider on Friday.

# HISTORICAL PERFORMANCE

- Junior **Yaphet Moundi's** 25-point, 20-rebound effort vs. Fairfield was one of the standout performances in the NCAA this season and in the MAAC over the last three decades.
- Moundi shot 8-of-12 overall and 9-of-13 from the line in just 25 minutes. He grabbed 11 of his 20 rebounds on the offensive glass.
- The last lona player to record 20 or more rebounds in a game was **Jonathan Duck**, who pulled down 20 boards against Seton Hall on Nov. 24, 1990.
- The most recent MAAC player to achieve a 20/20 game was Rider's Tyere Marshall, who tallied 28 points and 20 rebounds against UMass on November 20, 2019.
- According to ESPN Stats & Info and Stats, Inc., Moundi's performance was one of 13 recorded 20/20 games by nine different MAAC players since the 1996-97 season, spanning 29 seasons. He becomes just the sixth MAAC player in that span to record at least 25 points and 20 rebounds.
- Moundi is the only player among the 13 recorded 20/20 performances to accomplish the feat in under 30 minutes of playing time.

#### SUBTLE KEYS TO VICTORY

- When Iona holds a higher Effective Field Goal Percentage (field goal percentage weighted for three-pointers made) and hits more free throws than its opponent, the Gaels have played to a 7-0 record. They are 16-7 when holding an advatage in one of the two and 6-26 when on the long side of both.
- Since 2010, the record splits are 129-13 when winning both, 158-73 when winning one and 17-94 when dropping both.

# COMEH CI COMEH ÇA

- In Iona's two-game homestand vs. Manhattan and Merrimack, sophomore **Comeh Emoubor** had breakout efforts with his top two career point totals with 12 vs. the Jaspers and 20 vs. the Warriors.
- Emoubor earned the start in both contests and has now started four contests this season.
- He has averaged 12.7 points, 5.3 rebounds and 1.0 assists in his last three contests after 2.8 ppg, 2.0 rpg and 0.6 apg in the 26 prior.

#### SOMEWHERE IN MIDDLE AMERICA

- Junior **Luke Jungers** has averaged 9.6 points per game over his last 13 appearances with nine double-digit point efforts including his top five highest of the season with 14 vs. Canisius, Rider and Mount St. Mary's, 15 vs. Merrimack, and 16 vs. Siena.
- Jungers has shot 33-for-82 (40.2%) from long distance and averaged 1.8 rebounds and dished out 17 of his 22 assists on the season including the game winner in lona's buzzer beating with against Mount St. Mary's.
- Prior to the stretch the Omaha, NE native averaged 2.8 points, 1.0 rebounds and 0.4 assists per game.

#### TWO AND TWO

- Among the 5,504 NCAA Division I players to log minutes in 2024-25, junior **Yaphet Moundi** and Luke Jungers are two of 297 to record two or more blocks and two or more steals in a game on multiple occasions.
- Moundi posted three blocks and three steals vs. Delaware on Nov. 12 and two blocks and three steals at Sacred Heart on Dec. 6.
- Jungers accomplished the feat in Iona's last two games at Quinnipiac and vs. Manhattan.
- Moundi is tied for third in the MAAC with six others including: Tana Kopa (Canisius), Jaden Daughtry (Marist), Devon Savage (Merrimack), Paul Otieno (Quinnipiac), Amiri Stewart (Sacred Heart), and Myles Wilmoth (Siena).

Bryan Etumnu (Merrimack) leads with five and Amarri Tice (Quinnipiac) and Dola Adebayo (Mount Saint Mary's) have three efforts.

 Thirteen other MAAC players have recorded one this season.

# KING OF THE HILL, TOP OF THE LIST

- No team among the 13 NYC Metropolitan Area Division I basketball programs within 30 miles of the center of NY College basketball, Madison Square Garden has won more games than Iona University in the 27 seasons (558; Hofstra #2, 543).
- Over the last decade-plus, Iona's 304 wins and .628 win percentage are also the best in both categories. (Seton Hall, 275 wins; .567 win pct.)
- Since 1995-96, the Maroon & Gold hold the lead in wins (558), 15 more than Hofstra, 44 more than No. 3 Seton Hall and the top win percentage (.591)
- Iona's 12 postseason appearances (eight NCAA, three NIT, one CIT) since 2010-11 are the most during the time frame, **four more** than Seton Hall (six NCAA, two NIT) and **seven more** than St. John's (three NCAA, two NIT).

# **TOBIN ANDERSON YEAR 2**

- **Tobin Anderson** is in his second season as head coach of the long program in 2024-25.
- Anderson served as head coach at FDU where he led the No. 16 seeded Knights to the NCAA Tournament's second round after a stunning upset over No. 1 Purdue. His FDU squad finished 21-16 overall, earning the NEC's automatic bid.
- He led the Knights to two NCAA Tournament wins, over Texas Southern and the Boilermakers.
- The year before Anderson's arrival, the Knights posted a 4-22 record.
- Anderson had a highly successful coaching career at St. Thomas Aquinas, located less than 25 miles from Iona's New Rochelle Campus.
- A perennial Top 25 program in Division II, STAC won 209 games in nine seasons under Anderson, with five ECC regular season and six tournament titles.
- STAC reached the NCAA Division II tournament in each of his final seven seasons with an Elite 8 appearance in 2017 and Sweet 16 appearances in 2019, 2021 and 2022.
- He was a four-time ECC Coach of the Year (2015, 2016, 2021, 2022) and six-time Metropolitan Basketball Writers Association Division II Coach of the Year (2015, 2016, 2017, 2021, 2022, 2023).
- Prior to STAC, Anderson served as an assistant at Iona's MAAC-rival Siena for two seasons.
- Before Siena, he was an established Division III head coach at Hamilton and Clarkson in upstate New York.
- Anderson graduated from Wesleyan in 1995 where he was a four-year starter, two-year captain, and is one of the top 10 leading scorers in school history.

# **HYNES DOMINANCE**

- Iona had a 21-game Hynes Center winning streak snapped vs. Rider on Jan. 15, 2023.
- The 21-game streak tied the second longest home winning streak in program history, behind 2014-16 (26) and matching 1979-80 and 1951-53.
- The Gaels are 39-14 (.736) in the last 3+ seasons.
- Iona is 140-41 (.773) since 2009.
- The Maroon & Gold are <u>22-8 (.733)</u> over the last 10+ seasons in non-conference home games.

#### **GOING DEEP**

- Iona has posted 10 or more 3FG in **15** of its **62** games under head coach Tobin Anderson, posting a 10-5 record.
- Hitting the mark in **36.4**% of its games in 2023-24 was the highest percentage since 2018-19 under former head coach Tim Cluess (42.4%).
- Since 2007, the highest single-season rate was 60.6%, or 22-of-33 games in 2013-14.
- Among the Gaels last five head coaches, Anderson's rate ranks is third highest behind Cluess (41.7%) and Tra Arnold (31.0%) and ahead of Rick Pitino (19.8%) and Kevin Willard (11.7%).

# LET IT RAIN

- After <u>29 games</u>, Iona has made a three-pointer in <u>542</u> straight and <u>987</u> out of its last <u>988</u> games.
- In 2019-20, the Gaels eclipsed their previous program record of 386 straight from Jan. 5, 1994 Dec. 16, 2006.
- The Gaels have failed to hit a three-pointer in just 18 of their <u>1,215</u> games played since the line was adopted for the 1986-87 season.

## JIMMY V TO THE RAFTERS

- Iona Athletics celebrated of recent Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame Inductee Jim Valvano with a recognition ceremony on Sunday, January 7, 2024.
- Valvano served as head coach of the men's basketball program from 1975-1980, as Director of Athletics from 1977-1980, and was inducted into the Iona University Arrigoni Hall of Fame in 1994.
- Valvano led the Gaels to a 95-46 (.674) record in five seasons remains top-five all-time in program history in wins and win percentage.
- Valvano taught lona to "Dare to Dream" while recruiting some of the Maroon & Gold's finest talent ever and the results showed.
- Iona's 1979-80 team finished 29-5, setting a program record for wins that stands to this day.
- The Gaels were ECAC Champions and defeated eventual national champion Louisville, 77-60, in front of sold-out Madison Square Garden in February 1980, while advancing to the second round of the NCAA Tournament before falling to Georgetown.

# RICHIE GUERIN'S #14 HANGS IN THE RAFTERS

- Iona honored the legacy of **Richie Guerin '54** by retiring his number 14 on Jan. 31, 2014 the first ever in school history.
- Guerin is an Iona University Goal Club (1983),
   Marine Corps Sports (2004), and Naismith
   Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame (2013) inductee
   who starred for the Maroon & Gold from 1951-1954.
- He rewrote the basketball record books at lona, scoring 1,375 points and graduated as the leading scorer in school history.

- A two-time All-Metropolitan selection with the Gaels, he scored a then school-record 40 points against John Carroll in 1954 and was the first Gael to score 40 or more points in a game.
- Following his playing days at Iona, Guerin played with the National Basketball Association's New York Knicks from 1956-1963 and was a player-coach of the St. Louis/Atlanta Hawks franchise for nine years.
- In 13 years as a professional player, Guerin accumulated 14,676 points (17.3 per game), 4,278 rebounds (5.1 per game), and 4,211 assists (5.0 per game) over 848 games.

# **GAEL GREATS**

In addition to Naismith Hall of Famers **Richie Guerin '54** and **Jim Valvano** here are additional significant names in Iona basketball history:

- **Jeff Ruland '91** All-American during his time at Iona and, two-time NBA All-Star with the Washington Bullets, Philadelphia 76ers and Detroit Pistons. Following his career, returned to Iona and served as head coach from 1998-2007 where he won three MAAC Championships.
- Tim Cluess head coach from 2010-2020. At the helm during one the Gaels' most successful decades in program history. Cluess won 199 games in nine seasons on the sideline including six NCAA appearances, five MAAC tournament championships, and four MAAC regular season titles. He is the all-time MAAC leader in MAAC tournament victories.
- Pat Kennedy head coach from 1980-86. Went on to coach at Florida State, DePaul, Montana, and Towson following a highly successful tenure in New Rochelle.
- Warren Isaac '65 Iona's only 50-point scorer, Isaac played six seasons in Europe following his tenure at Iona. A New York City school legend, Isaac started for Power Memorial paving the way for NBA Hall of Famer Kareem Abdul-Jabbar a 1965 graduate of the high school.
- **Tim Welsh** head coach from 1995-98 who went on to coach in the Big East with Providence for 10 seasons. Currently an ESPN college basketball analyst. Holds the highest career winning percentage ever at Iona.
- Kevin Willard Iona coach from 2007-10, now head coach at Big 10's Maryland. Helped turn around a program which won two games in the season prior to his arrival to 20 wins in his final season in Maroon & Gold.
- Steve Burtt '84 & Steve Burtt '06 All-time NCAA father/son scoring leaders, both netting over 2,000 career points. Burtt, the father, had a fourseason NBA career and most notably appeared off the bench for the Phoenix Suns in the 1992 NBA Playoffs. He was inducted into the prestigious NYC Basketball Hall of Fame this past fall. Burtt, the son, continues to play professionally in Europe.
- Sean Green '91 Played 84 NBA games over three seasons for the Indiana Pacers, Philadelphia 76ers and Utah Jazz from 1991-94. Currently a high school basketball coach in Southern California.
- Scott Machado '12 The last Gael to appear

in an NBA game. Machado played in regular season NBA contests in 2012-13 with the Houston Rockets and postseason with the Golden State Warriors. Played the majority 2018-19 season in the NBA G-League for the South Bay Lakers and played four games with the Los Angeles Lakers. The MAAC & Iona's all-time assist leader. He currently plays professionally in Australia.

• **Bob Santini '53** - Iona's first NBA player, appeared in four games with the New York Knicks in 1955-56.

# NOTABLE ALUMNI (ATHLETICS/POP CULTURE)

- Brendan Malone '62 longtime NBA assistant coach, last with the Detroit Pistons from 2014-16. Coach Malone passed away in 2023 at age 88.
- **Don McLean** Singer-songwriter noted most famous for his 1971 single "American Pie".
- **Dennis Leonard** Kansas City Royals Hall of Famer and 12-year MLB veteran who won 20 games on three occasions from 1977-80. He was inducted in May 2015 into the New York Baseball Hall of Fame.
- **Kyle Flood '93** Former head football coach at Rutgers, current offensive coordinator and offensive line coach at Texas.
- Maggie Timoney '89 The Iona women's basketball Hall of Famer recently \_became the first female CEO of Heineken USA.
- Jason Motte Major League Baseball relief pitcher recorded the final out of the 2011 World Series with the world champion St. Louis Cardinals. Has also appeared in Major League games with the Chicago Cubs, Colorado Rockies and Atlanta Braves.

- Ignacio Maganto was selected by the LA Galaxy with the 21st pick in the first round of the 2015 MLS SuperDraft, the first Major League Soccer draft pick in Iona history. Maganto scored his first MLS goal with the Galaxy in the spring of 2015.
- Mariano Rivera III '15 Earned his degree in May 2015 and was selected in the fourth round by the Washington Nationals.
- Emma Hayes Iona's women's soccer coach from 2003-2005, Hayes was named the 10th full-time United States Women's Soccer National Team head coach in November 2023 and won Gold in the 2024 Paris Olympic Games.
- Juana Camilion Two-time MAAC Defensive Player of the Year and 2023 MAAC Player of the Year, Camilion represented Spain the 3x3 women's basketball at the 2024 Paris Olympics, earning a silver medal.

- Building on its proud legacy, Iona officially became a University on July 1, 2022, turning the page to the next chapter ahead.
- With a total enrollment of nearly 4,000 students and an alumni base of over 50,000 around the world, Iona is a diverse community of learners and scholars.
- Iona University is a small Catholic liberal arts school that has emerged as an anomaly in higher education, with new-student enrollment spiking over 40 percent since 2019.
- Iona students can expect small class sizes, engaged professors and a wide range of undergraduate and graduate programs within the School of Arts & Science, LaPenta School of Business NewYork-Presbyterian Iona School of Health Sciences and Hynes Institute for Entrepreneurship & Innovation.
- Iona now has two campuses in Westchester County, N.Y., just north of New York City. Iona's beautiful 45-acre campus in New Rochelle, N.Y., and new 28-acre campus in Bronxville, N.Y., are both just 30 minutes via Metro-North train to Midtown Manhattan.
- With the support of a \$20 million gift from NewYork-Presbyterian, Iona has established the NewYork-Presbyterian Iona School of Health Sciences on its new Bronxville campus, developing a premier new school in collaboration with one of the nation's top hospitals.
- The flagship building of Iona's new Bronxville campus has been named the Kelly Center for Health Sciences thanks to benefactors Al and Peggy Kelly. Both are double alumni and longtime Iona basketball fans; Al Kelly is formerly the CEO of Visa.
- Iona also continues to beautify its New Rochelle campus, where it opened a vibrant new green space called the "Murphy Green" in the heart of campus.

- In May 2024, Iona opened a new campus in County Mayo, Ireland. Located within the historic Westport House Estate along the Atlantic coast, Iona looks forward to returning Summer 2025.
- It pays to go to Iona: 94 percent of Iona graduates are employed full-time or enrolled in graduate school within six months of graduation. Iona is also in the top 5 percent nationwide for its long-term return on investment, according to Georgetown University's Center on Education and the Workforce.
- Iona has also achieved national recognition. Most recently for 2025, Iona has been recognized by The Princeton Review, The Wall Street Journal, Forbes and others as one of the nation's best colleges. Additionally, U.S. News & World Report recognized Iona as one of top for social mobility in the country.
- Iona has added three new Division I Varsity programs in the last two years men's lacrosse, women's acrobatics & tumbling and women's golf.
- Iona also continues to expand its Club Sports program, which is geared toward those with an interest in organized sports outside of Iona's rigorous Division I Athletics program, including a highly popular esports club team that was featured on Yahoo's In the Know.
- Tradition: Iona's world-renowned Pipe Band performs at major campus events, and even leads the University's march up Fifth Avenue in the New York City St. Patrick's Day parade.
- In 2023, Iona hired head coach Tobin Anderson after his historic win leading #16 FDU to beat #1 Purdue; he immediately became a beloved figure on campus inspiring the community on the court and off.
- Members of the Iona community are known as Gaels, who are people with Irish-Gaelic ancestry.
- Notable Iona alumni include Al Kelly Jr., retired CEO of Visa Inc.; Margaret C. Timoney, CEO of HEINEKEN USA; and musician Don McLean, most famous for his song "American Pie."

- Seamus Carey, Ph.D., serves as the ninth president of Iona University.
- A Bronx native and first-generation college student, Carey began his lona presidency in July 2019.
- Propelling the University on a path of innovation, President Carey
  has since overseen the school's growth and expansion to include
  the acquisition of a new second campus in Bronxville, the launch of
  the NewYork-Presbyterian Iona School of Health Sciences and new
  programs inside and outside the classroom.
- President Carey also successfully led the transition to become Iona University, reflecting both the strength and diversity of its academic programs.
- New student enrollment is up over 40% under President Carey's leadership and the University welcomed its largest incoming class in over 20 years this fall.

- The symbol of Iona University's athletic teams is the popular Gael. A Gael is anyone of Irish-Gaelic ancestry, consistent with the Irish tradition of Iona.

# **Tobin ANDERSON**

# Head Coach Wesleyan '95 - Second Season

Tobin Anderson is in his second season as head coach of the Iona University men's basketball program. He was appointed to the position on March 21, 2023. Anderson came to New Rochelle after serving as head coach at FDU where he led the No. 16 seeded Knights to the NCAA Tournament's second round after a stunning upset over No. 1 Purdue.

Anderson led the 2022-23 FDU squad to a 21-16 overall record and 10-6 in Northeast Conference play. The Knights earned the NEC's automatic bid and earned two wins in this year's NCAA Tournament, a First Four win over Texas Southern and the first-round win over the Boilermakers. It was just the second-ever win for a No. 16 seed over a No. 1 seed in tournament history. The year before Anderson's arrival, the Knights posted a 4-22 record.

Prior to FDU, Anderson had a highly successful coaching career at St. Thomas Aguinas, located less than 25 miles from Iona's New Rochelle Campus. In nine seasons, he turned STAC into a perennial Top 25 program in Division II after inheriting a team that won just five games prior to his hire. In total he led the Spartans to a 209-62 (.771) overall mark, earning five East Coast Conference regular season and six tournament titles. Anderson's STAC program reached the NCAA Division II tournament in each of his final seven seasons with an Elite 8 appearance in 2017 and Sweet 16 appearances in 2019, 2021 and 2022. A highlight of Anderson's first NCAA tournament season in 2015-16 was a 90-58, exhibition win over St. John's to open the campaign on November 4, 2015. Under Anderson, the Spartans posted a 128-30 (.810) mark in regular season ECC play. He was a four-time ECC Coach of the Year (2015, 2016, 2021, 2022) and five-time Metropolitan Basketball Writers Association Division II Coach of the Year (2015, 2016, 2017, 2021, 2022). Anderson got his first taste of Division I coaching, serving as an assistant at Iona's MAAC-rival Siena for two seasons from 2011–2013. Before his time at Siena, Anderson was an established head coach at the Division III level at Hamilton College and Clarkson University in upstate New York.

While at Hamilton, Anderson posted a 118-63 (.652) record in seven seasons. The Continentals reached the league tournament five times including a tournament championship and a trip to the NCAA D-III tournament. He guided his team to the second round of the NCAA tournament in 2006 and earned three regular season titles.

Anderson earned his first head coaching position at Clarkson University in Potsdam, NY. In his five years with the Golden Knights, he broke the school record for wins, with a 19-10 season in 2001-02. The team advanced to the ECAC regional championship game and was the third-most improved Division III men's basketball team from the previous season. Anderson's first team finished the 1999-00 season with a 14-12 record, the program's first winning season in 25 years and its first-ever post season bid.

To begin his coaching career, Anderson spent three years as an assistant coach; one year at Clarkson in 1996-97 and two years at Le Moyne College, from 1997-1999.

Anderson graduated from Wesleyan University in 1995 with a bachelor's degree in American Studies. He was a four-year starter, two-year captain, and is one of the top 10 leading scorers in school history. Anderson earned his master's in Athletic Administration from Florida State University in 1996. He is originally a native of Truro, Iowa. He and his wife Jodi have two children, Bryce and Alexa.
