Claxton was named the 13th head coach in Hofstra men's basketball history on April 7, 2021. Claxton, who starred at Hofstra from 1996 to 2000, spent eight seasons on the Hofstra basketball staff, including the previous seven as an assistant coach. Claxton led Hofstra to a 21-11 record in his first year, guided the Pride to a 25-10 mark in his second season, and posted a 20-13 record last year.
