### GAME INFORMATION

**NEW ROCHELLE, NY** - Quinnipiac will hit the road on Sunday afternoon, as the Bobcats are set to square off with MAAC foe Iona at 1:00 PM on ESPN+.

#### LAST TIME OUT: BOBCATS DOWN IONA

- Quinnipiac cruised past Siena on Friday night (1/10) at M&T Bank Arena, as the Bobcats won their fourth MAAC game of the season by the final score of 72-53.
- Quinnipiac led 39-8 through the first 14-plus minutes of action. The Bobcats went up 43-15 after the first 20 minutes of the contest, shooting 17-of-29 from the field in the first stanza.
- Amarri Monroe registered 16 points, 10 rebounds and four steals to lead the way for Quinnipiac. Paul Otieno recorded another double-double with 12 points and 10 rebounds.
- Khaden Bennett added 14 points and five rebounds, and Jaden Zimmerman chipped in with 13 points and six rebounds.
- QU outrebounded Siena 42-25, and held a 38-14 advantage in the paint.
- The Bobcats move to 8-8 with the win, and QU has won four of its first five MAAC games of the year.

#### TOP OF THE MAAC

- The Bobcats currently rank best in the MAAC in rebounds per game (38.25 RPG).
- Big man Paul Otieno currently leads the league on the individual front in rebounds per game (8.4 RPG), and in blocked shots (34). Otieno ranks fourth nationally in offensive rebounds per game (4.13).
- MAAC Preseason Player of the Year Amarri Monroe ranks atop the league in total steals (45), and he's currently 5th nationally in that category.

#### SCOUTING IONA

- The Gaels enter at 5-11 overall (2-3 MAAC). Iona lost its most recent contest at Fairfield, 68-64, on Friday night.
- Iona ranks second nationally in offensive rebounds per game (16.38), sixth nationally in turnovers forced per contest (17.44), and eighth nationally in steals per game (8.4).
- Dejour Reaves has paced Iona offensively (15.7 PPG, 4.8 RPG). Adam Nije Jr. (11.4 PPG) has also averaged double-digit point totals.
- Quinnipiac is 8-13 against Iona since joining the MAAC in 2013-14. The Bobcats have won three of the last four meetings.

## TOM PECORA | 2ND SEASON AS HEAD COACH | 8TH SEASON AT QU

Tom Pecora – a veteran with 15 years of experience as a head coach at the Division I level – enters his second season at the helm of the Quinnipiac program in 2024-25. Pecora just completed his seventh season in total with the Bobcats (previously served as Associate HC from 2017-2023). He was announced as Quinnipiac's next Head Coach on Thursday, April 13, 2023.

Pecora led the Bobcats to a record-breaking 2023-24 campaign during his first year at the helm, eventually earning MAAC Coach of the Year honors after guiding the Bobcats to the top seed in the conference. Quinnipiac set a new program record for wins (24) during the benchmark season, as the Bobcats went 15-5 in league play to capture the program's first-ever MAAC Regular Season Championship. The Bobcats set a new program record for total points (2,630) under Pecora. Quinnipiac defeated each MAAC opponent at least once.

QU's 19-4 start over their first 23 games marked the program's best start to a year since the 1965-66 campaign. Quinnipiac won 10 consecutive games from Jan. 5 – Feb. 8. The Bobcats finished the month of January with a 7-0 record, marking the first perfect month in the University's Division I history.

Pecora served as the head coach at Hofstra for nine years (2001-2010) and at Fordham for five seasons (2010-15). Prior to taking over the head coaching position at Hofstra, Pecora served as the associate head coach under Jay Wright for seven seasons, the last two of which resulted in America East Conference titles and NCAA Tournament berths.

As a head coach at Hofstra, he compiled a 155–126 mark in nine seasons, leading the Pride to four postseason appearances (three NIT and one CBI), more than any team in New York City over that nine-year span. In 16 years at Hofstra with Pecora on the staff (nine years as a head coach, seven as an assistant), the Pride averaged 19 wins a season (246-161).

During his time in Hempstead, Hofstra was the winningest program in the Metropolitan New York area. Over his last six years, Hofstra won 121 games, including four 20-win seasons. In 2006 and 2009, he was named Coach of the Year by the Metropolitan Basketball Writers Association (MBWA) and he also received regional Coach of the Year honors from the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) and the Basketball Coaches Association of New York (BCANY). Pecora also had tremendous success in developing guards while at Hofstra. As an assistant, he recruited NBA guards Speedy Claxton and Norman Richardson, while as a head coach, he recruited three guards who scored over 2,000 career points -- Loren Stokes, Antoine Agudio and Charles Jenkins. Claxton, Richardson, Stokes and Jenkins all won their conference Player of the Year Awards, while Jenkins also played in the NBA for the Golden State Warriors and Philadelphia 76ers.

Prior to joining the staff at Hofstra, Pecora also had previous experience in running a program, serving as head basketball coach at the State University of New York at Farmingdale from 1989-92. In three seasons at Farmingdale, the Rams posted a 62-24 record, captured the Region 15 championship in 1992 (when they finished 20-9), advanced to the National Junior College Athletic Association Tournament and were ranked as one of the nation's top 20 junior college programs.

A native of Queens Village, New York, Pecora attended Martin Van Buren High School before moving on to Adelphi University, where he graduated in 1983 with a bachelor's degree in physical education and health. He was inducted into Adelphi's Hall of Fame in 2002. Pecora entered the coaching profession as an assistant to former Davidson head coach Bob McKillop at Long Island Lutheran High School from 1984 through 1987. Pecora then served as an assistant coach to Stu Klein at Nassau Community College in Garden City from 1987 through 1989. During his tenure at Nassau Community College, the Lions posted back-to-back 25-win seasons and in 1989 played in the National Junior College Athletic Association Tournament for the only time in school history.

### TOP OF THE MAAC

- MAAC Preseason Player of the Year Amarri Monroe ranks atop the league in total steals (45), and he's currently 5th nationally in that category.

### NEWS AND NOTES

- Preseason MAAC Player of the Year Amarri Monroe leads QU in scoring (14.8 PPG) so far this season, and has also recorded 7.4 RPG. Monroe has tallied double-digit scoring totals in 13 of 16 contests.
- Big man Paul Otieno leads the MAAC with seven double-doubles already this season. Otieno has posted 12.5 PPG and 8.4 RPG so far this year, shooting 59.0% from the field.
- Point guard Savion Lewis is averaging 5.2 assists per game. Last year, Lewis finished fourth nationally with 7.3 APG.
- Khaden Bennett has posted 11.3 PPG & 4.1 RPG to date. He's got 10+ points in 10 of his last 11 contests.
- First-year guard Jaden Zimmerman has come on strong as of late, averaging 9.7 PPG so far during 2024-25. The Bronx, New York-native has scored 10+ in five of his last six outings. He poured in a career-high 16 points at Saint Peter's (1/3).

- Quinnipiac won its first-ever MAAC regular season title under first-year Head Coach Tom Pecora.
- QU also set a new program mark for total points in a single season (2,630).
- The Bobcats' 19-4 start over their first 23 games marked the program's best start to a year since the 1965-66 campaign.
- Quinnipiac won 10 consecutive games from Jan. 5 - Feb. 8.
- The Bobcats finished the month of January with a 7-0 record, marking the first perfect month in the university's Division I history.

### QU SELECTED AS PRESEASON LEAGUE FAVORITE

- Quinnipiac Men's Basketball has been selected as the preseason favorite in the 2024-25 MAAC Preseason Coaches' Poll, as revealed by the league office on Oct. 8, 2024.
- Quinnipiac earned 166 points in total in the preseason coaches' poll (11 first-place votes). It marks the first time that QU has ever been selected as the preseason MAAC favorite. The defending MAAC regular season champs went 15-5 in league play (24-10 overall) last season under Head Coach Tom Pecora. The Bobcats earned a berth to the 2024 Ro College Basketball Invitational (CBI) after setting a program record for total wins.

### BOBCATS RETURN PRESEASON ALL-MAAC TRIO

- Three Bobcats in total (Amarri Monroe, Savion Lewis, Paul Otieno) received preseason recognition. Monroe and Lewis are Preseason All-MAAC First Team selections, while big man Paul Otieno earned a spot on the Preseason All-MAAC Second Team.
- Preseason MAAC Player of the Year Amarri Monroe (formerly Amarri Tice) played in all 34 games for Quinnipiac a season ago, stuffing the stat sheet with 12.9 PPG, 6.9 RPG, 1.8 APG, 1.8 SPG, 1.0 BPG. He posted 14.4 PPG & 7.2 RPG in MAAC play. Monroe was the only player that finished inside the league's Top 5 in rebounds, blocks, and steals. He scored 10+ points 25 different times, and registered five separate double-doubles.
- Savion Lewis wrapped up the 2023-24 campaign averaging 8.1 PPG, 7.3 APG & 3.2 RPG for the Bobcats. He finished second nationally in total assists (248). Lewis recorded 5+ helpers in 28 of Quinnipiac's 34 contests, including an impressive 17-assist night against Rider in Hamden (1/5/23).
- Graduate forward Paul Otieno returns for another year after leading the MAAC in field goal percentage (63.8%) in 2023-24. He averaged 11.0 PPG & 6.9 RPG, starting in all 34 contests for the Bobcats. He registered four double-doubles a season ago.

### VETERAN GROUP

- The Bobcats return six of nine players that logged 200+ minutes last season (2023-24).
- Amarri Monroe (12.9 PPG), Paul Otieno (11.0 PPG), Savion Lewis (8.1 PPG), Alexis Reyes (7.8 PPG), Doug Young (6.3 PPG), Richie Springs (3.8 PPG) are all back for Quinnipiac.

### THE 6 NEWCOMERS

- The Bobcats added six newcomers in total.
- Ryan Mabrey transferred in from Miami University, where the former All-MAC Freshman Team selection played in 58 games with the RedHawks over the last two seasons.
- Quinnipiac also brought in five true first-year athletes: Grant Randall (Queens, NY), Samson Reilly (Manchester, CT), Spence Wewe (Bristol, England), Braylan Ritvo (Harlem, NY), Jaden Zimmerman (Bronx, NY).

### INSTANT IMPACT

- Both Jaden Zimmerman and Grant Randall have made an immediate impact during their first collegiate season.
- Zimmerman is averaging 9.7 PPG during his first year. The guard has registered 10 or more points nine different times already, and scored a career-high 16 points in QU's win at Saint Peter's on Jan. 3.
- Grant Randall has chipped in with 2.3 PPG and 2.8 RPG off the bench. Randall scored a season-high six points during Quinnipiac's trip to Saint Louis.

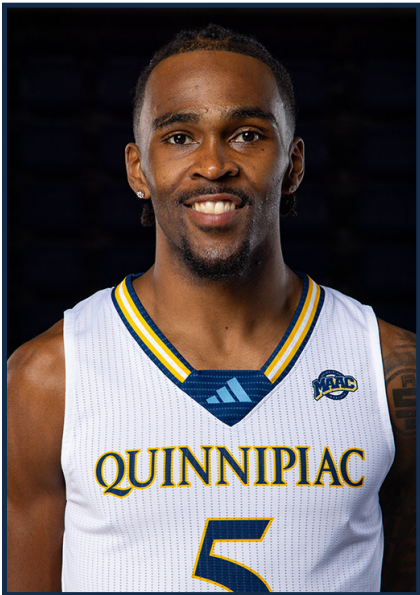
