THE OPENING TIP

Fairfield University Men's Basketball makes another short trip, this time taking the quick jaunt to New Rochelle to challenge Iona on Sunday, Feb. 2. Opening tip-off from Hynes Athletic Center is set for 1 p.m. on ESPN+.

LAST TIME OUT

Deon Perry scored 23 points, including an electric first half showing, to lead Fairfield on Friday night at Quinnipiac. But after seven ties and five lead changes, the host Bobcats made the game's final run to pull away with an 81-69 decision. Jamie Bergens added 15 point and five assists for the Stags.

Perry netted 18 of his 23 points in the first half, shooting 5-for-8 from three-point range in the stanza. He knocked down six triples in total to round out his highest scoring output of the season. Kyle Jenkins stuffed the statsheet with 12 points, five rebounds and three assists.

Quinnipiac was led by double-doubles from the All-MAAC duo of Amarri Monroe (27 pts., 10 rebs.) and Paul Otieno (15 pts., 13 rebs.).

Bergens notched the first five points for the Stags, staking Fairfield to a quick 5-2 lead. But the Bobcats responded with their first run of the evening with a 10-0 stretch to put the hosts in front, 12-5. The Stags responded with an 8-0 run capped by a Perry triple to tie the game at 16. That trey got Perry going as the Fairfield guard scored 15 of Fairfield's last 21 in the frame as the Stags headed to the intermission facing a two-point deficit, down 36-34.

The clubs traded scores for much of the second half, culmintating with a Jenkins triple cutting the Fairfield deficit to 61-59 with 7:11 remaining. But the last run of the evening came from Quinnipiac as the hosts reeled off a 16-3 stretch over the ensuing six minutes and put away the eventual 81-69 final.

COACH CASEY ON THE QUINNIPIAC GAME

"We fought incredibly hard tonight, and this team will never make me question that. But we left too many points at the rim and the free throw line. We need to clean up our execution and make more of the types of plays that decide these hard-fought conference games."

THE MATCHUP

FAIRFIELD VS. IONA

THE IONA UNIVERSITY GAELS

Iona dropped a 76-55 contest at MAAC rival Manhattan on Friday to fall to 8-13 overall and an even 5-5 in conference play. The Gaels are 4-5 at home this season with a 3-2 tally at Hynes against league foes.

The Gaels are among the top offensive rebounding teams in the nation, ranking third in the country with 15.38 offensive boards per game. Clarence Rupert and Yaphet Moundi are both corralling more than two rips from the offensive glass per game. Iona's penchant for second chance points has helped to stem the tide from their league-low .401 field goal percentage.

lona's fast pace on both ends of the floor has seen them commit the most turnovers in the MAAC with 16.86 per contest while forcing the most in the conference and fifth-most in the nation, also at 16.86.

ALL-TIME SERIES

After 125 meetings, Iona leads the all-time series by a count of 77-48. The win at Mahoney Arena on Jan. 10 as well as the Stags' victory in the MAAC Championship Quarterfinals marked Fairfield's first back-to-back wins over the Gaels since 2017.

The Stags have not swept the season series since 2006-07, which also marks their last win over Iona in New Rochelle.

SEE 'U' AT MAHONEY ARENA

Fairfield Men's Basketball and Leo D. Mahoney Arena have been selected to host a "MAAC Wildcard" game live on ESPNU on Thursday, Feb. 6. The nationally-televised game against visiting Marist is set for a 7 p.m. tip-off.

Fairfield will be making its second national television appearance of the season. The Nov. 9 contest at Georgetown aired nationally on FS2, and the Stags also made back-to-back regional TV appearances on SNY in games at Monmouth and Columbia in late December.

The Stags participated in three MAAC Wildcard games in 2023-24 as a part of six total appearances on the ESPN family of linear networks during that campaign.

Next Thursday's game will be the second time that Mahoney Arena has played host to an ESPNU telecast. The Stags welcomed Canisius last March, earning a 74-62 Senior Night win before a national television audience.

STAYING CLOSE TO HOME

Fairfield will play five of its last 10 regular season games at Mahoney Arena, and six of the remaining 10 within the state of Connecticut. Visits to Rider (approx. 115 miles) and Siena (approx. 140 miles) are the only remaining regular season games that will be played more than 100 miles away from campus.

MAYBE IN MARCH?

Last Saturday night's game against Merrimack completed this season's home-and-home series with the Warriors. Fairfield also has Niagara and Canisius in the rearview mirror, as the Stags do not make the trip to Western New York this season.

The Stags are yet to see conference foes Sacred Heart, Saint Peter's or Siena. Fairfield will not go head-to-head with the Saints until March 6 in the penultimate game of the regular season.

BONUS BASKETBALL

The Jan. 23 win at Manhattan was Fairfield's first overtime game of the season. The Stags did not play an overtime contest in 2023-24, last going to an extra session on Feb. 12, 2023 for a 76-72 win over The Mount.

Fairfield is 3-0 all-time in overtime against Manhattan.

GO FIGURE

Six Stags scored in double figures in the Manhattan victory. The trio of Kyle Jenkins, Prophet Johnson and Braden Sparks shared the team high with 15 points apiece. Deon Perry added 13 points with 10 each coming from Jamie Bergens and Louis Bleechmore.

The last time six Stags scored in double figures was during the 2021-22 campaign when seven players had 10 or more points in a 110-55 victory over Medgar Evers.

The feat had not happened against a Division I opponent since Dec. 13, 2009 when six Stags reached double figures in a win over Sacred Heart.

GOTTA CATCH 'EM ALL

With the Jan. 16 win over Niagara, Chris Casey has now earned at least one win as a head coach against every current MAAC team. Fairfield defeated every MAAC squad except for Niagara, as well as the then-NEC member Sacred Heart, during the 2023-24 season. The remainder of Casey's Division I head coaching tenure came patrolling the Niagara sidelines.

Casey's lone win over Merrimack came in the Division II ranks as head coach of the LIU Post Pioneers during the 2012-13 season. This year's meetings with the Warriors were Casey's first at the Division I level.

GRAND COMPANY

Three Stags scored the 1,000th point of their respective collegiate careers in three consecutive games during the month of January. Prophet Johnson eclipsed 1,000 points at Merrimack on Jan. 3, Deon Perry hit the milestone with 22 points on Jan. 10 against Iona and Louis Bleechmore reached 1,000 points in the Jan. 12 game at Marist.

Kyle Jenkins was already a 1,000 point scorer in his career when he came to Fairfield. He netted 1,042 points in his four previous seasons at Lafayette, culminating with All-Patriot League Third Team honors last season.

CHAIRMAN OF THE (OFFENSIVE BOARDS)

Prophet Johnson ranks third in the MAAC and 40th nationally with 3.20 offensive rebounds per game. Johnson's 6.9 boards per contest overall are good for sixth in the MAAC.

Johnson hauled in 10 offensive rebounds at Monmouth on Dec. 21, the most by a Stag since Anthony "Peanut" Johnson had 10 rips from the offensive glass against Rider in 2010.

Since offensive rebounds were recorded as an official statistic beginning in 1986-87, the Fairfield single-season record is 160 corralled by Darren Phillip in the 1999-2000 campaign for an average of 5.5 per game. Prophet Johnson has 64 offensive boards thus far in the 2024-25 season.

SHARING THE WEALTH

Five Stags average between 20.7 and 30.2 minutes per game this season with a total of 10 players averaging 10 or more minutes per contest. Birima Seck is just seven total minutes short of being the 11th Stag in double figures, taking the court for 183 minutes in his 19 games played to date.

NINE-TENTHS OF THE LAW

Fairfield has made the most of its possessions this season, ranking second in the MAAC and 37th nationally with 10.3 turnovers per game. The Stags are also second in the conference with a turnover margin of +1.6 and lead the league with a 1.27 assist/turnover ratio.

NOTHING IS FREE

The Stags and Blue Devils are two of just 14 teams to have attempted two or fewer free throws in a contest this season, and the only two to do so in the same game.

The last game in which Fairfield attempted two or fewer free throws was a Feb. 4, 2019 loss at Siena. That game differed from this season's affair in that the host Saints went to the line 10 times compared to the Stags' one trip to the stripe, which was converted by Jesus Cruz.

BUT YOU SHOULD STILL WATCH UNTIL THE END

The team leading at the half is 17-2 (with two ties) in 20 Fairfield games this season. The two exceptions came on Dec. 1 with Fairfield rallying past FDU and on Dec. 28 when Columbia came back in the second half to earn a home win. In addition, despite several games going down to the wire, the team holding the lead with an even 5:00 left is 20-1 in Fairfield's 21 games to date.

THE SLIMMEST OF MARGINS

The 67-66 win over Vermont on Nov. 24 was Fairfield's first one-point game since a 73-72 loss to Manhattan on Feb. 19, 2023. Fairfield had not won a one-point game since a 59-58 overtime win over the Jaspers in the First Round of the 2021 MAAC Championship. The Stags added a one-point loss to the ledger on Dec. 18 with a 64-63 setback against CCSU to round out Fairfield's first season with both a one-point win and a one-point loss since the 2018-19 campaign. In program history, Fairfield owns 53 one-point wins and 49 one-point losses.

HIGH SCORING STAGS

The 195 total points scored in the Dec. 8 game at The Mount marked the most in a Fairfield game since the Stags defeated Quinnipiac, 102-98, in double overtime on Feb. 17, 2018. It was also Fairfield's highest scoring 40-minute game since a 109-108 victory over Saint Peter's on Feb. 14, 2006.

BUZZER BEATERS

Peyton Smith's tip-in with 1.6 seconds to go in the Dec. 4 win over Rider was the Stags' latest game-winning basket when tied or trailing since Caleb Fields' layup to knock off Sacred Heart, 61-59, with 0.9 seconds left on Dec. 7, 2022 at Mahoney Arena.

THE BENCH MOB

Fairfield scored 55 bench points in the Dec. 1 win over FDU. Five of the Stags' top six scorers were in a reserve role, including Jamie Bergens with a game-best 20 points off the pine. On the season, Fairfield ranks second in the MAAC with 28.05 bench points per game. Fairfield's (verifiable) record for bench points in a game is the 75 scored in the 110-55 victory over Division III Medgar Evers in the 2021-22 season.

ICING IT AT THE STRIPE

After a 9-for-17 start at the free throw line against FDU, the Stags connected on their last 12 charity tosses to help put away the 78-74 win. The span included Jamie Bergens going 4-for-4 in the final 18 seconds as well as Matt Curtis hitting all three tries after drawing a foul while shooting from downtown to put the Stags in front, 66-64, with four minutes remaining.

ROOKIE OF THE RIEK

After leading Fairfield in scoring at the Naismith Hall of Fame Tip-Off, Makuei Riek was selected as the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference Rookie of the Week. Riek averaged 11.5 points per game at Mohegan Sun Arena as the Stags went toe-to-toe with reigning conference champions Yale and Vermont. Riek tallied his 11.5 points per game on 9-for-20 shooting from the floor, including a 4-for-10 showing from three-point range. He also corralled 2.5 rebounds with 2.0 assists per outing.

Against defending Ivy League Champion Yale, Riek netted the first 13 points of his collegiate career along with three boards, two assists and a steal. In the victory over Vermont - the reigning three-time champ of the America East - Riek scored the Stags' first seven points on his way to 10 tallies with two rebounds and two assists in a 67-66 win.

STIFF COMPETITION

The games against Yale and Vermont at Mohegan Sun saw the Stags challenge a pair of 2024 NCAA Tournament teams in back-to-back games. The Stags last played against consecutive teams who competed in the prior season's NCAA Tournament in the 2018-19 campaign when they opened the year against the trio of Purdue, Bucknell and LIU.

NEWS & NOTES FACTS, FIGURES AND MORE

DEFENDING IN DURHAM

The 62-56 win on Nov. 12 at New Hampshire marked the fourth time during Chris Casey's tenure that the Stags held a Division I opponent below 60 points. Fairfield is 3-1 in those games. That effort was Fairfield's second-best defensive showing since the start of 2023-24, topped only by the December 2023 win over Wagner, 67-51, at Mahoney Arena.

AN OFFENSIVE SPARK(S)

Braden Sparks' team-leading 17 points on Nov. 9 at Georgetown marked a new Division I career high for the junior. His previous best was 15 points in a win over VMI as a student-athlete at Mercer two seasons ago. Sparks' overall collegiate career high came last season at Indian Hills Community College when he poured in 27 points in the NJCAA Region XI Championship Game.

STAGS VS. NEW ENGLAND

The Stags are 167-190 all-time against the current Division I basketball programs in New England. Fairfield has never lost to regional foes Dartmouth (4-0) and Sacred Heart (10-0). The only two current Division I teams in New England that the Stags have never defeated both reside in the Ocean State. Fairfield is 0-7 against Rhode Island and has never played Bryant, which joined the Division I ranks in 2008.

IN THE MAAC PRESEASON POLL

Fairfield was picked fourth in the MAAC Preseason Coaches' Poll, garnering one first-place vote from the conference's 13 head coaches. The Stags were one point ahead of fifth-place Saint Peter's, the reigning MAAC Champion. Quinnipiac collected 11 first-place votes to top the preseason ledger,.

PRESEASON ALL-MAAC

Deon Perry was named to the Preseason All-MAAC Second Team, Perry averaged a Patriot League-leading 17.3 points per game last season at Loyola Maryland, knocking down 79 three-pointers on .351 shooting from distance. He bolstered his scoring totals with a .911 free throw percentage, good for 10th in the nation. Perry also ranked in the top-10 in the Patriot League in assists and slotted fourth in the conference with 1.48 steals per game.

2023-24 AT A GLANCE

Fairfield Men's Basketball finished the 2023-24 season at 24-13 - one win short of matching the program's single-season wins record. After a 14-6 showing the MAAC regular season, the second-seeded Stags reached the 2024 MAAC Championship Game and, the following week, advanced to the CBI Semifinals.

Fairfield's 2,794 points scored last season were a program record and the Stags' 75.5 points per game were their highest scoring average since 2017-18. That total was sparked by a program-best 342 made three-pointers that ranked 11th in the nation. Defensively, the Stags had a program record 314 steals. The average of 8.5 steals per game were the best for a Fairfield club since 1999-2000 and the third-best season average in program history. Jasper Floyd bolstered that mark with an individual single-season record of 87 thefts.

TWO DOZEN DUBS

At 24-13 overall in 2023-24, Fairfield secured its first 20-win season since a 22-15 campaign in 2011-12. The campaign marked the eighth 20-win season in Fairfield history and the fourth time that the Stags have earned 23 or more Division I victories in a season. At 14-6 in the MAAC, the Stags posted their most conference wins since a 15-3 performance en route to the MAAC Regular Season Championship in 2010-11.

NOTABLE NETS

Fairfield finished 2023-24 with the MAAC's best NET ranking at #162. The Stags owned the MAAC's strongest non-conference win of the season with a Quad 2 win at #86 Yale, the Ivy League Tournament Champion. The conference's only other Quad 2 win last season was a Canisius victory at #89 St. Bonaventure.

UP NEXT

Action returns to Leo D. Mahoney Arena on Thursday, Feb. 6, when the Stags host Marist at 7 p.m. The game will be nationally televised on ESPNU.

HEAD COACH CHRIS CASEY

SECOND SEASON • WESTERN CONN. '86

College basketball veteran Chris Casey was named the interim head coach of Fairfield University Men's Basketball prior to the 2023-24 season and was named the 14th head coach in program history on March 12, 2024. Casey most recently served as an assistant with the Stags for the last four campaigns and previously led the programs at Niagara, LIU Post and Rutgers-Newark.

Casey has coached 38 consecutive college basketball seasons (entering 2024-25) as a head coach, assistant coach, and graduate assistant. He has been to seven NCAA postseason tournaments at the Division I, II and III levels and has recruited or coached more than 30 all-conference players and 11 conference major award winners.

In his first season leading the Stags, Casey guided Fairfield to a 24-13 record -- the second-most victories in school history. Fairfield finished second in the MAAC regular season at 14-6 and advanced to the MAAC Championship Game. The Stags also participated in the CBI, winning two games in Daytona Beach to reach the Semifinals of the national tournament. Casey was named a finalist for the Hugh Durham Coach of the Year Award.

The 2023-24 Stags set a program record with 2,794 points scored as well as the highest scoring average (75.7 ppg) since 2017-18. Fairfield also knocked down a program-record 342 three-pointers, ranking 11th in the nation in conversions from beyond the arc, and amassed a program-program record 314 steals.

Individually, the Stags boasted three All-MAAC players (Jalen Leach, Caleb Fields and Brycen Goodine) for the first time since 2010-11 and two NABC All-District honorees (Leach, Fields) for the first time since 2011-12.

Previously as a head coach, Casey was a part of the MAAC for six years at Niagara from 2013-19. His tenure in Western New York included a 19-win campaign in 2017-18 that saw the Purple Eagles finish 12-6 in the MAAC as the third-seeded team in the conference. Casey recruited and coached Khalil Dukes to MAAC co-Player of the Year honors, with Matt Scott getting an All-MAAC Second Team nod in that campaign.

Casey joined Niagara after a three-year stretch at LIU Post highlighted by back-to-back East Coast Conference Championships and NCAA postseason appearances. He was the 2012 ECC Coach of the Year and Met Writers Division II Coach of the Year. Casey coached the ECC Player of the Year in each of his campaigns leading the Pioneers, Stefan Bonneau in 2011 and 2012 and Tobin Carberry in 2013.

Casey's first head-coaching stop was at Division III Rutgers-Newark from 1998-2001. He was the New Jersey Athletic Conference Coach of the Year in 2001 after leading the Scarlet Raiders to the ECAC Tournament.

Casey's assistant coaching career began as a part of the first two Division I seasons in Central Connecticut State history from 1986-88. After a return to his alma mater Western Connecticut State for one season, a year in which the Wolves reached the Sweet Sixteen of the 1989 NCAA Division III Tournament, he reentered the Division I ranks with stops at St. Francis and Saint Peter's. He was apart of two MAAC Championship teams with the Peacocks (1991, 1995).

Following his stint as head coach at Rutgers-Newark, Casey rejoined the staff at CCSU from 2001-06. He was a part of the Blue Devils' 2002 NEC Championship squad and was recognized as an AFLAC National Assistant Coach of the Year in 2003. In 2006, he moved on to Norm Roberts' staff at St. John's for a four-year tenure that included a trip to the 2010 National Invitation Tournament.

Casey graduated from Western Connecticut State in 1986 with a Bachelor of Business

Administration. He earned an M.S. in Education from Central Connecticut State in 1993.

Casey and his wife Hope have two daughters, Lauren and Jordan.


