### What You Need To Know

- Rider returns to action Friday, when it travels to Iona, which has won five of its last six games.
- Tank Byard's buzzer-beating putback gave the Broncs a 61-59 win over Siena on Feb. 8 at Alumni Gym. The play pushed Byard's stat line to 10 points and a season-best nine rebounds in a season-high 24 minutes.
- T.J. Weeks Jr. has been the Broncs' leading scorer, averaging 13.3 points per game. He's scored in double figures 20 times in 23 games played, including a season-high 23 points vs. Siena.
- Rider is 8-1 this season when holding the opposition to fewer than 72 points. The loss to Merrimack was the Broncs' first when allowing fewer than 72.
- The Broncs held off Saint Peter's, 67-64 Jan. 31 for Head Coach Kevin Baggett's 200th career victory, all at Rider. He became the fourth coach to win 200 games with a MAAC program or programs and just the second to accomplish the feat at a single MAAC institution.
- Iona took the first game of this year's series, 73-67, Jan. 25 at Alumni Gym. The Gaels lead the series, 47-29. The Broncs' last win at Hynes Athletic Center came Jan. 25, 2023, when Rider snapped the Gaels' 21-game home winning streak.
- DeJour Reaves leads the Gaels at 15.9 points per game, while Adam Njie also averages in double figures at 11.6 ppg. to go along with a team-best 3.7 assists per game. Yaphet Moundi (8.0 ppg.) has led the Gaels in rebounding (6.7 rpg.), including a 25-point, 20-rebound performance on Feb. 2 vs. Fairfield. Clarence Rupert (6.6 ppg., 4.4 rpg.), part of the 2022 Saint Peter's Elite 8 team, also transferred to Iona after the last two seasons at Southern Illinois.
- The Broncs were picked seventh in the MAAC Preseason Coaches' Poll.
- 13th-year Head Coach Kevin Baggett's teams have posted a 201-198 record. Baggett won MAAC Coach of the Year in 2015 and 2018.
- Only John Carpenter (292) has more wins at Rider.

### SCOUTING THE IONA GAELS

DeJour Reaves leads the Gaels at 15.9 points per game, while Adam Njie also averages in double figures at 11.6 ppg. to go along with a team-best 3.7 assists per game. James Patterson has also chipped in with 9.5 ppg. and 5.9 rpg., though he's missed the Gaels' last seven games. Yaphet Moundi (8.0 ppg.) has led the Gaels in rebounding (6.7 rpg.), including a 25-point, 20-rebound performance on Feb. 2 vs. Fairfield. Clarence Rupert (6.6 ppg., 4.4 rpg.), part of the 2022 Saint Peter's Elite 8 team, also transferred to Iona after the last two seasons at Southern Illinois.

### ALL-TIME SERIES VS. IONA

Iona took the first game of this year's series, 73-67, Jan. 25 at Alumni Gym. The Gaels lead the series, 47-29. The Broncs' last win at Hynes Athletic Center came Jan. 25, 2023, when Rider snapped the Gaels' 21-game home winning streak.

### **ALRIGHT UNDER 72**

Rider is 8-1 this season when holding the opposition to fewer than 72 points. The Broncs had won the first seven times it held an opponent under 72 before falling, 66-64, to Merrimack on Feb. 2. Rider has defeated San Diego (68-67), Coppin State (64-53), Bucknell (57-53), Niagara (68-65), Mount St. Mary's (66-60), Marist (64-57), Saint Peter's (67-64) and Siena (61-59) while allowing 68 points or fewer. The lone win while allowing more than 68 came at Navy (90-79). On four occasions, the Broncs have fallen when allowing 72 points (Villanova, Delaware, Quinnipiac, Stony Brook).

### BYARD BEATS BUZZER

Tank Byard's buzzer-beating putback gave the Broncs a 61-59 win over Siena on Feb. 8 at Alumni Gym. The play pushed Byard's stat line to 10 points and a season-best nine rebounds in a season-high 24 minutes. It was his second-straight double-figures performance and his third of the year, following an 11-point effort on Feb. 6 at Sacred Heart.

### T.J. STEPS UP VS. SIENA

T.J. Weeks Jr. stepped up his game to the tune of 23 points, his highest scoring output in two years as a Bronc, in Rider's 61-59 win over Siena on Feb. 8. He made 6-of-9 attempts, including his only try from long range, along with 10-of-11 from the free-throw line. He also grabbed seven rebounds, dished out three assists, blocked two shots and made a steal in 38 minutes.

### HOME IS WHERE YOU HOLD YOUR BREATH

All seven of Rider's conference games at home in 2024-25 have been decided by six points or less, including four by three points or less, including each of the last three (Jan. 31 vs. Saint Peter's, Feb. 2 vs. Merrimack and Feb. 8 vs. Siena). The Broncs are 3-4 in MAAC home games in 2024-25.

### 200 WINS FOR BAGGETT

Rider Head Coach Kevin Baggett earned his 200th win as Broncs Head Coach on Jan. 31 vs. Saint Peter's. Only three coaches in the 44-year history of the MAAC have compiled 200 wins as head coach at league institutions - Joe Mihalich (265, all at Niagara), John Dunne (245, 153 at Saint Peter's, 92 at Marist) and Jimmy Patsos (222, 145 at Loyola, 77 at Siena). Baggett's 135 wins in league play rank third all-time behind Mihalich (166) and Dunne (151). Both Baggett's 100th (Jan. 26, 2018) and 200th wins came against Saint Peter's in late January.





### HOT SHOTS PART DEUX

The Broncs matched their season high in field-goal percentage, shooting 52.9 percent (27-51) on Jan. 31 vs. Saint Peter's. Rider also shot 52.9 percent on the same 27-of-51 on Nov. 12 at Navy. T.J. Weeks Jr. (6-11), Zion Cruz (6-12), Ife West-Ingram (5-6), Tariq Ingraham (4-7), Tank Byard (2-3) and Flash Burton (2-4) each made at least half of their attempts in the game.

### DOUBLE-DOUBLES PILING UP FOR RIQ

Tariq Ingraham compiled his team-leading fifth double-double of the year with 15 points and 14 rebounds at Quinnipiac on Jan. 25. The five double-doubles are currently third-most in the MAAC, behind only the Quinnipiac duo of Paul Otieno (9) and Amarri Monroe (6). Combined with two double-doubles in 2023-24, Ingraham now has seven for his collegiate career.

### ALL ALVAREZ VS. IONA

Jay Alvarez matched his previous career high of 28 points on Jan. 23 vs. Iona. Alvarez made 13-of-24 from the floor and both of his free-throw attempts. He also grabbed a team-high seven rebounds and made two steals. He established the career high for Houston Christian last season against Northwestern State (Jan. 15, 2024). The last time a Rider player made 13 field goals came last Jan. 5, when Mervin James made 13-of-19 in a 31-point effort at Quinnipiac. The last time a Rider player made 14 or more field goals was Mario Porter with a 14-of-18 effort to score 31 vs. FDU on Dec. 31, 2000. Only twice has a Bronc had 15 or more field goals made – George Abel with 21 vs. Cathedral in the 1939-40 season and Greg Cisson with 15 vs. Lafayette on Dec. 16, 1967.

### **BURTON PUTS A HURTIN' ON MARIST**

Flash Burton scored a career-high 21 points, including 17 in the second half, as the Broncs defeated Marist, which entered the game leading the league at 13-2 (6-0 MAAC) on Jan. 18. Burton made 7-of-11 from the floor, including both of his three-point attempts, to go along with 5-of-8 shooting from the free-throw line. He also added a pair of steals. The effort came a game after he went for 14 points, five assists and four steals in a win over Mount St. Mary's, which entered the game at 4-1 in league play. For his effort on the week, Burton was named Rider's first MAAC Rookie of the Week since November 2021.

### **ROAD TOUGH**

Rider has played 15 of its first 24 games on the road, posting a 6-9 record. The fourth road win, coming Nov. 23 at Bucknell, stood as the most in NCAA Division I until UC Irvine won its fifth true road game on Dec. 30. Rider's first four road wins came at San Diego, Coppin State, Navy and Bucknell. Rider previously had never in program history won more than two true road games in November.

### **JAY GOES DEEP**

A year after shooting 7-of-48 (.146) from long range at Houston Christian, Jay Alvarez has been a different player at Rider, shooting 32.6 percent (30-of-92) through 24 games. Included in the effort was a 5-for-7 showing from long range and a season-high 19 points at Navy (Nov. 12). He was also 3-for-6 from deep and scored 15 points at San Diego (Nov. 6), while matching the 3-for-6 performance at Villanova (Nov. 27).

### MOUNTING TURNOVERS

The Broncs forced a season-high 25 turnovers on a season-high 16 steals on Jan. 16 vs. Mount St. Mary's. Ruben Rodriguez and Flash Burton had four steals apiece, while Jay Alvarez added three thefts and Zion Cruz and T.J. Weeks Jr. had two apiece. The last time Rider forced 25 turnovers and had 16 steals both came in the 2018-19 season. The Broncs forced 25 turnovers on Jan. 31, 2019, vs. Saint Peter's, while making 16 steals on three occasions on the season, with the most recent coming Feb. 22, 2019, vs. Niagara.

### **PURPLE GAIN**

The Broncs snapped a nine-game losing skid Jan. 12 at Niagara. T.J. Weeks Jr. scored 18 points and Tank Byard registered a new season high with 12 points, including Rider's final seven to secure the victory. Included in Byard's production was a conventional three-point play with 1:10 remaining to put Rider on top for good. The win prevented the Broncs from establishing a new program record with what would've been their 10th-straight setback.

### ALVAREZ GOES HIGHER

A game after scoring a team-high 17 points at NC State (Dec. 22), Jay Alvarez went for a then-season-high 23 points against Manhattan (Jan. 5). He hit on 9-of-20 attempts from the floor, including 2-of-7 from long range. The 23 points were the most by a Rider player to date in 2024-25.

#### ZION'S NEW HIGHS

Zion Cruz scored a new season and career-high 16 points on Dec. 20 at Penn. He made 7-of-14 attempts from teh floor, including 2-of-5 from long range, eclipsing his previous season and career high of 15 on Dec. 6 vs. Quinnipiac. He also grabbed a season and career-high seven rebounds. Cruz then dished out a career-high seven assists on Jan. 5 vs. Manhattan and upped his career-high scoring to 23 points on 10-of-20 shooting at Canisius (Jan. 10).

### T.J. TURNS IT ON

T.J. Weeks Jr. went for a then-season-high 21 points on 7-of-14 shooting, including 4-of-8 from beyond the three-point arc on Dec. 4 at Fairfield. Included in the production was eight points in a 17-2 run late to turn a 14-point deficit into a one-point lead.

### RIQQY GETTIN FREAKY

Tariq Ingraham posted the Broncs' first three double-doubles of the year consecutively vs. Delaware (Nov. 30), at Fairfield (Dec. 4) and vs. Quinnipiac (Dec. 6). He went for 12 points and 11 rebounds vs. Delaware, making 6-of-9 attempts from the floor and grabbed six of his 11 rebounds on the offensive glass. He then erupted for a career-high 21 points to go along with 14 rebounds, including seven on the offensive glass, at Fairfield (Dec. 4). Ingraham then went for 11 points and 10 rebounds, five each on the offensive and defensive glass, vs. Quinnipiac (Dec. 6). The double-doubles were the third, fourth and fifth of his collegiate career.

### FIVE IN DOUBLE FIGURES

Rider had five players in double figures for the first time this season and the first time since Feb. 18, 2024, when Zion Cruz (15), Tariq Ingraham (11), Jay Alvarez (11), Flash Burton (10) and T.J. Weeks Jr. (10) each scored 10 points or more on Dec. 6 vs. Quinnipiac. Cruz and Burton were making their first starts as Broncs.





### BURTON HOLDS IT DOWN IN HOMECOMING

Playing in the suburbs of his hometown of Philadelphia, Flash Burton went for 15 points on 7-of-12 from the floor at Villanova on Nov. 27. The seven field goals made easily eclipsed his previous season high of four at Coppin State (Nov. 9) and his 15 points were one off his season-high of 16 at Navy, when he made 9-of-10 at the free-throw line.

### ADD 'STRONG CHIN' TO HIS SCOUTING REPORT

T.J. Weeks Jr. left the Bucknell game following a second-half collision that left a gash over his right eye. Weeks Jr. exited the game for 4:35 of game time to get five stitches, during which time the Broncs did not make a field goal. Bucknell closed to within as few as two points in the span, but four free throws and Weeks Jr.'s pull-up jumper with 2:42 remaining ended the drought and pushed the lead back to eight as the Broncs held on for the win.

### **RIQ REPEATS**

Tariq Ingraham posted consecutive 14-point efforts at Iowa (Nov. 19) and Bucknell (Nov. 23). He went 6-of-11 from the floor and 2-for-2 from the free-throw line at Iowa, before hitting 4-of-9 from the floor and 6-of-7 from the free-throw line at Bucknell. He also grabbed a then-season-high nine rebounds in the win over the Bison.

### **COMING OUT PARTY FOR WEST-INGRAM**

Making his first-career start, sophomore forward Ife West-Ingram went for 14 points on 6-for-6 shooting to go along with seven rebounds and six assists on Nov. 12 at Navy. West-Ingram's contributions through four games were altogether positive, posting a neutral +/- in the opener at #22 UCLA before going +10 at San Diego, +12 at Coppin State and +6 at Navy.

Freshman Flash Burton posted double-figures scoring outputs in his third and fourth career games at Coppin State (Nov. 9) and Navy (Nov. 12). He scored 11 points at Coppin State and followed with 16 at Navy, making 3-of-5 attempts, including a conversion on his only three-point try. He also made 9-of-10 from the free-throw line, all in the final 2:25 of the second half to ice the win.

### STAYING CLASSY IN SAN DIEGO

T.J. Weeks Jr. scored a team-high 19 points and Jay Alvarez added 15 points as the Broncs scored a 68-67 victory at San Diego on Nov. 6. Five other scored at least five points, including Ruben Rodriguez (6 points), who hit the game-winning floater in the paint with 1:15 remaining.

### 75 PERCENT OF THE TIME, WE'VE WON EVERY TIME

Rider has won its last two and three of its last four match-ups with West Coast Conference opponents since 2010. Prior to the Nov. 6 win at San Diego, the Broncs defeated Pacific on Dec. 10, 2016, in Stockton, CA, and Loyola Marymount in a neutral-site game in Springfield, MA, on Nov. 21, 2010. The lone setback came to Santa Clara in Orlando, FL, on Nov. 30, 2014.

T.J. Weeks Jr. made 4-of-7 three-point attempts at UCLA on Nov. 4 en route to a team-high 15 points. He made four of his first five attempts from long range, including 3-for-3 in the first half.

### T.J.'S GOT A TRACK RECORD

T.J. Weeks Jr. is the Broncs top returning scorer at 10.0 points per game a year ago. It was Weeks Jr.'s first year with the Broncs following four years at UMass. Weeks Jr. entered 2024-25 with 1,146 career points, shooting 36.0 percent from long range.

### SECOND SIXTH-YEAR STARTER

Tariq Ingraham gives Rider a second sixth-year starter. After spending parts of three injury-plagued years at Wake Forest, Ingraham transferred to Rider and will enter his third year on the court for the Broncs. Last season, he averaged 9.3 points and led the Broncs at 6.5 rebounds per game, shooting 48.9 percent.

### **ROLLIN' WITH RUBEN**

Ruben Rodriguez entered 2024-25 as the Broncs' starting point guard following 28 appearances off the bench last year. A prolific high-school scorer, his 2,008 scholastic points broke records set by Stu Jackson and Lonnie Walker IV.

### PORTALING... EVERYBODY'S DOING IT

The Broncs will look to get contributions from six transfers with prior Division I affiliations in Jay Alvarez, Alaaed-dine Boutayeb, Tank Byard, Zion Cruz, Zocko Littleton Jr. and Andre Young. Alvarez ranked fifth in the Southland Conference for Houston Christian at 15.6 points per game a season ago. Tank Byard was a solid contributor at Alcorn State, averaging 7.6 points and 4.4 rebounds, and will join Alvarez in the starting lineup. Boutayeb first was rostered at Florida State, before transferring to Arkansas State and Miami Dade College. The 7-foot-2 center will give the Broncs a dynamic option inside. Zocko Littleton Jr. played his freshman year at Appalachian State, before moving on to Chipola College. Andre Young continues the Rider pipeline from Pebblebrook High School, the same Georgia school that produced All-MAAC selections Dwight Murray Jr. and Mervin James. Young missed his true freshman year at Troy due to injury and played last season at Gulf Coast State College. Cruz was a five-star prospect when he committed to DePaul for his freshman year and should be able to help the Broncs after a JUCO year at Pratt (Kansas) Community College.

### FRESH FACES

Rider also welcomed two scholarship freshmen and a walk-on. Flash Burton, a 6-foot-3 guard out of Philadelphia averaged 21.6 points per game in his senior season at Cardinal O'Hara. Cole McCabe comes to Rider from the prestigious IMG Academy, while walk-on Maurizio D'Alessandro also joins the Broncs this year out of Fork Union Military Academy and New Hampton Prep.

### **BAGGETT SECOND ALL-TIME AT RIDER**

12th-year Rider Head Coach Kevin Baggett tied Thomas Leyden (1940-42, 1946-60) for second all-time at Rider with his 187th win on Feb. 18, 2024, at Manhattan and passed him with his 188th win on Feb. 23, 2024, vs. Iona. Entering the season with 192 wins, only John Carpenter's program-record 292 wins outpace him.

HEAD COACH 13TH SEASON SAINT JOSEPH'S '89

Two-time MAAC Coach of the Year Kevin Baggett returns for his 13th season as the Rider University head basketball coach in 2024-25. The 2024-25 season is the 19th for Baggett as a member of the Rider staff, serving two as an assistant coach and four as an associate head coach. In the last 18 years, Rider has compiled 303 wins, second-most in the MAAC behind only Iona (338). Baggett has coached on the Division I level for 28 years and has been on the Rider staff since the 2006-07 season.

'Baggs' is a two-time MAAC Coach of the Year (2015 and 2018) and has been a finalist for three different National Coach of the Year Awards - the Ben Jobe Award, the Joe B. Hall Award and the Hugh Durham Award.

As Head Coach at Rider, Baggett has led his players to 26 All-MAAC honors and two MAAC Sixth Player of the Year awards. The total increases to 36 including six seasons as an assistant coach, with mentorship of 2008 NBA Lottery Pick Jason Thompson, the 2008 MAAC Player of the Year and two-time MAAC Defensive Player of the Year, to his credit. In addition, he's coached six MAAC All-Rookie Team honorees.

In his first season at Rider, Baggett took a team with just two returning starters and six total letterwinners that was picked to finish seventh in the 10-team Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference in 2013 and finished in second place. With an emphasis on defense, Baggett's Broncs led the MAAC in three-point field goal percentage defense in 2012-13 and was second in overall field goal percentage defense, third in blocks and fourth in points allowed.

He guided the 2012-13 Broncs to a 19-win season, the most by a Rider rookie head coach since Bob Greenwood led Rider to a 20-win season in 1962-63. The only other Rider basketball coach to compile 19 wins in his rookie campaign was the legendary Clair Bee. Included in the 19 wins was Rider's first-ever Division I national postseason tournament victory, a road win at Hartford in the CollegeInsider.com Postseason Tournament (CIT). The last time Rider had won a game in a national postseason tournament came in 1957, when the Roughriders won a pair of games in the NCAA College Division Championships (now NCAA Division II).

In 2013-14, Coach Baggett took a young team and produced two All-MAAC performers along with a MAAC All-Rookie team selection. His 2013-14 squad was ranked eighth in the nation in three-point field goal percentage and was 51st in Division I in three-point field goals made.

In 2014-15, Baggett took a squad that was picked seventh in the MAAC and guided the team to a 21-win season and a second place finish in the conference, earning MAAC Coach of the Year honors as Rider was selected to play in the College Basketball Invitational tournament. Baggett was a finalist for the Ben Jobe National Coaching Award for the second time in three years and he was named the UPS All-District 1 Coach of the Year.

The Broncs had another very successful campaign in 2016-17, winning 18 games and advancing to the MAAC Championship Quarterfinals. Rider was offered the chance to play in multiple national postseason tournaments, but declined. Seniors Jimmie Taylor and Kahlil Thomas were each named to the All-MAAC Third Team. Rider finished first in the league in rebounds per game (40.3), with three Broncs - Thomas, Norville Carey and Taylor - finishing in the top 20 individually.

2017-18 was a banner year for Baggett and the Broncs. Picked to finish seventh in the MAAC after losing four starters to graduation, the Broncs won 22 games, a share of the MAAC Regular Season Championship and advanced to the NIT for the second

time in program history. Baggett was named MAAC Coach of the Year for the second time in six years, took NABC All-District 1 Coach and was also a finalist for the Hugh Durham and Ben Jobe Awards. Baggett guided four players to All-MAAC honors, including First Teamer Dimencio Vaughn, Second Teamer Stevie Jordan and Third Team honorees Jordan Allen and Frederick Scott. Scott was named MAAC 6th Player of the Year, while Allen earned All-Rookie Team honors. Vaughn was also selected to the NABC All-District Second Team and earned Second Team All-Met. As a team, Rider led the MAAC in field-goal percentage (.465), offensive rebounds per game (13.2), rebound margin (+2.6), steals per game (7.5), rebounds per game (39.2), turnover margin (+2.2) and turnovers forced per game (15.4). Jordan led the league in assists (5.9) for the second-straight year and was 26th in the nation. Allen's 2.88 three-point field goals made per game ranked 50th in the country, while Vaughn's 1.83 steals per game were 55th. Baggett earned his 100th career win on Jan. 26, 2018, against Saint Peter's.

Stevie Jordan and Frederick Scott repeated as All-MAAC Second and Third Team selections, respectively, in 2018-19, as the Broncs finished tied for second in the MAAC Regular Season Standings. Jordan recorded his 1,000th career point, becoming the 37th player in Rider history to reach the plateau.

In 2019-20, Tyere Marshall joined the ranks of All-MAAC selections, earning Third Team recognition. Dimencio Vaughn returned to All-MAAC First Team form, while Scott earned his third-straight Third Team honor. Vaughn, Scott and Marshall became the 38th, 39th, and 40th Broncs to score their 1,000th points in the cranberry and white. The Broncs compiled an 18-12 overall record and a 12-8 mark in league play. Baggett's Broncs earned the No. 3 seed in the MAAC Championships and were riding a three-game winning streak when the tournament was halted due to COVID-19.

Rider once again won a MAAC Tournament game in 2020-21 under Baggett, taking an opening-round contest against sixth-seeded Canisius. Dwight Murray, Jr. earned All-MAAC Second Team and NABC All-District 1 Second Team honors.

While 2021-22 had its up's and down's, the year ended on a high note, as Baggett led the Broncs to a pair of MAAC Tournament wins, including an upset of top-seeded Iona in the quarterfinals. Dimencio Vaughn earned All-MAAC Second Team honors and Dwight Murray, Jr. was named to the MAAC All-Championship Team after hitting the game-winning shot against Iona with six seconds remaining in regulation.

Baggett led the Broncs to a second-place finish in the MAAC regular season standings in 2022-23, including a win at eventual champion Iona, snapping the Gaels' 21-game home winning streak. Rider ranked among the best rebounding teams in the nation with a +4.6 rebounding margin, good for 37th in Division I. Murray earned his second All-MAAC honor, being named to the First Team, while Mervin James was selected to the Second Team.

The Broncs again finished in the upper tier of the MAAC in 2023-24, with Baggett guiding Rider to a 15-17 mark, including a 12-8 record in league play. The Broncs finished the league slate with a seven-game winning streak to clinch a first-round bye in the MAAC Championships. During the win streak, Baggett moved past Thomas Leyden (187 wins) into second place all-time at Rider with his 188th victory at the school. James was a unanimous First Team All-MAAC honoree, while Allen Powell was selected to the Third Team.

Baggett was named the Rider men's basketball head coach at a standing room only press conference on May 24, 2012.

"This was a popular decision," Rider Director of Athletics Don Harnum said at that time. "It was also a convenient decision, but let me make it very clear, this was not a hire of convenience. This was a hire because I firmly believe and am very confident that Kevin is the right person to lead this program in the future."

Baggett hails from Burlington, NJ and was a 2006 inductee into the South Jersey Hall of Fame. He was a member of the Saint Joseph's 1985-86 basketball team that compiled a 26-6 record and reached the second round of the NCAA Tournament.
