GAME INFORMATION

ATLANTIC CITY, NJ - Quinnipiac men's basketball is set for the semifinal round of the MAAC Tournament on Friday night at Jim Whelan Boardwalk Hall, as the top-seeded Bobcats will take on Iona at 6 PM.

2ND STRAIGHT REGULAR SEASON TITLE

• QU won its second consecutive MAAC regular season title this year.
• The Bobcats are 30-10 in MAAC regular season contests over the last two seasons under Head Coach Tom Pecora. Quinnipiac went 15-5 in league play during 2023-24 to earn the program's first-ever regular season championship, then the Bobcats posted another 15-5 league mark this year.

QUARTERFINALS: WIN OVER RIDER

• QU cruised past Rider on Wednesday evening in the quarterfinal round of the MAAC Championships, earning a 78-64 victory at Jim Whelan Boardwalk Hall.
• The top-seeded Bobcats will now advance to the MAAC Tournament semifinals for the second straight year.
• Amarri Monroe led the Bobcats with 23 points. Savion Lewis added 14 points and 4 assists, while Khaden Bennett scored 13 points to go along with 6 rebounds.
• QU advances to the semifinal round of the MAAC Tournament for the fifth time since joining the league in 2013-14.

MONROE NAMED MAAC POTY

• Junior forward Amarri Monroe has been selected the 2024-25 MAAC Player of the Year, as revealed by the league office on Monday, March 10. Monroe paced Quinnipiac in 2024-25, averaging 17.7 points, 9.2 rebounds, and 2.3 steals per game - all of which led the team.
• The Newburgh, New York-native impressed in conference play, averaging a double-double (19.8 PPG & 10.5 RPG) over 19 MAAC regular season contests.
• He finished the regular season leading the MAAC in rebounds per game (9.2), offensive rebounds per game (7.00), and double-doubles (14).

PECORA NAMED COACH OF THE YEAR

• Tom Pecora has earned back-to-back MAAC Coach of the Year honors after leading QU to a regular season championship in both 2023-24 & 2024-25 (15 MAAC wins each season).
• Pecora has more wins (30) over his first two seasons than any men's basketball head coach in the history of the MAAC.
• He adds to his coach of the year honors over the course of his career. In 2006 and 2009, Pecora was named Coach of the Year by the Metropolitan Basketball Writers Association (MBWA) and also received regional Coach of the Year honors from the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) and the Basketball Coaches Association of NY (BCANY).

TOM PECORA | 2ND SEASON AS HEAD COACH | 8TH SEASON AT QU

Tom Pecora – a veteran with 16 years of experience as a head coach at the Division I level – is currently in his second season as Head Coach at Quinnipiac University in 2024-25. Pecora is in his eighth season in total with the Bobcats (previously served as Associate HC from 2017-2023). He was announced as Quinnipiac's next Head Coach on Thursday, April 13, 2023.

The Bobcats' leader has won MAAC Coach of the Year honors in back-to-back seasons (both 2023-24 and 2024-25). Pecora has more wins (30) over his first two seasons than any men's basketball head coach in the history of the MAAC.

Pecora led the Bobcats to a record-breaking 2023-24 campaign during his first year at the helm, eventually earning MAAC Coach of the Year honors after guiding the Bobcats to the top seed in the conference. Quinnipiac set a new program record for wins (24) during the benchmark season, as the Bobcats went 15-5 in league play to capture the program's first-ever MAAC Regular Season Championship. The Bobcats set a new program record for total points (2,630) under Pecora. Quinnipiac defeated each MAAC opponent at least once.

Pecora served as the head coach at Hofstra for nine years (2001-2010) and at Fordham for five seasons (2010-15). Prior to taking over the head coaching position at Hofstra, Pecora served as the associate head coach under Jay Wright for seven seasons, the last two of which resulted in America East Conference titles and NCAA Tournament berths.

As a head coach at Hofstra, he compiled a 155-126 mark in nine seasons, leading the Pride to four postseason appearances (three NIT and one CBI), more than any team in New York City over that nine-year span. In 16 years at Hofstra with Pecora on the staff (nine years as a head coach, seven as an assistant), the Pride averaged 19 wins a season (246-161).

During his time in Hempstead, Hofstra was the winningest program in the Metropolitan New York area. Over his last six years, Hofstra won 121 games, including four 20-win seasons. In 2006 and 2009, he was named Coach of the Year by the Metropolitan Basketball Writers Association (MBWA) and he also received regional Coach of the Year honors from the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) and the Basketball Coaches Association of New York (BCANY). Pecora also had tremendous success in developing guards while at Hofstra. As an assistant, he recruited NBA guards Speedy Claxton and Norman Richardson, while as a head coach, he recruited three guards who scored over 2,000 career points -- Loren Stokes, Antoine Agudio and Charles Jenkins. Claxton, Richardson, Stokes and Jenkins all won their conference Player of the Year Awards, while Jenkins also played in the NBA for the Golden State Warriors and Philadelphia 76ers.

Prior to joining the staff at Hofstra, Pecora also had previous experience in running a program, serving as head basketball coach at the State University of New York at Farmingdale from 1989-92. In three seasons at Farmingdale, the Rams posted a 62-24 record, captured the Region 15 championship in 1992 (when they finished 20-9), advanced to the National Junior College Athletic Association Tournament and were ranked as one of the nation's top 20 junior college programs.

A native of Queens Village, New York, Pecora attended Martin Van Buren High School before moving on to Adelphi University, where he graduated in 1983 with a bachelor's degree in physical education and health. He was inducted into Adelphi's Hall of Fame in 2002. Pecora entered the coaching profession as an assistant to former Davidson head coach Bob McKillop at Long Island Lutheran High School from 1984 through 1987. Pecora then served as an assistant coach to Stu Klein at Nassau Community College in Garden City from 1987 through 1989. During his tenure at Nassau Community College, the Lions posted back-to-back 25-win seasons and in 1989 played in the National Junior College Athletic Association Tournament for the only time in school history.

GAME NOTES

TWO STRAIGHT REGULAR SEASON TITLES

- Quinnipiac won its second consecutive MAAC regular season title last week in Hamden, as the Bobcats outlasted Mount St. Mary's, 79-70, on March 6 at M&T Bank Arena in Hamden.
- The Bobcats are 30-10 in MAAC regular season contests over the last two seasons under Head Coach Tom Pecora. Quinnipiac went 15-5 in league play during 2023-24 to earn the program's first-ever regular season championship, then the Bobcats posted another 15-5 league mark this year.

LEADING THE PACK

- The Bobcats currently lead the MAAC in rebounds per game (38.56) and in scoring margin (+2.8).
- Amarri Monroe (9.2 RPG) and Paul Otieno (8.6 RPG) rank first and second in the league in rebounding, respectively. Amarri Monroe also leads the league in defensive rebounds per game (6.94).
- Paul Otieno leads the MAAC in field goal percentage (59.4%), and in offensive rebounds per contest (3.9 ORPG).

PECORA NAMED MAAC COACH OF THE YEAR ONCE AGAIN

- Tom Pecora has been named MAAC Coach of the Year once again after leading the Bobcats to another regular season title.
- He's earned back-to-back MAAC Coach of the Year honors after leading Quinnipiac to two consecutive regular season titles (2023-24 & 2024-25).
- Under Pecora's guidance, Quinnipiac has posted an impressive 15-5 MAAC record in both 2023-24, and in 2024-25.
- Pecora has more wins (30) over his first two seasons than any men's basketball head coach in the history of the MAAC.
- He adds to his coach of the year honors over the course of his career. MONROE, OTIENO, ZIMMERMAN EARN ALL-MAAC AWARDS

- Three Quinnipiac men's basketball student-athletes earned All-MAAC recognition, as announced by the league office on Monday, March 10.
- Forwards Amarri Monroe and Paul Otieno both earned a spot on the All-MAAC First Team, and first-year guard Jaden Zimmerman was selected for the MAAC All-Rookie Team.

DOUBLE TROUBLE

- QU forwards Amarri Monroe and Paul Otieno are currently first and second in the MAAC in double-doubles, respectively.
- Monroe has 14 double-doubles so far this year (12 in MAAC games), and Otieno has 13 double-doubles (8 in MAAC games).

SCOUTING IONA

- The Gaels went 12-8 in MAAC play this year under Tobin Anderson, and then beat Manhattan 77-65 in the quarterfinals on Thursday.
- Dejour Reaves has paced the Gaels with 17.1 PPG & 5.4 RPG. Adam Njie Jr. has posted 12.2 PPG & 4.3 APG during his freshman season. Yaphet Moundi leads Iona with 7.3 RPG.
- Tobin Anderson is 32-33 over two seasons at Iona. Anderson came to New Rochelle after serving as head coach at Fairleigh Dickinson University where he led the No. 16 seeded Knights to the NCAA Tournament's second round after a stunning upset over No. 1 Purdue in 2023.

QU SELECTED AS PRESEASON LEAGUE FAVORITE

- Quinnipiac Men's Basketball has been selected as the preseason favorite in the 2024-25 MAAC Preseason Coaches' Poll, as revealed by the league office on Oct. 8, 2024.
- Quinnipiac earned 166 points in total in the preseason coaches' poll (11 first-place votes). It marks the first time that QU has ever been selected as the preseason MAAC favorite. The defending MAAC regular season champs went 15-5 in league play (24-10 overall) last season under Head Coach Tom Pecora. The Bobcats earned a berth to the 2024 Ro College Basketball Invitational (CBI) after setting a program record for total wins.

BOBCATS RETURN PRESEASON ALL-MAAC TRIO

- Three Bobcats in total (Amarri Monroe, Savion Lewis, Paul Otieno) received preseason recognition. Monroe and Lewis are Preseason All-MAAC First Team selections, while big man Paul Otieno earned a spot on the Preseason All-MAAC Second Team.
- Preseason MAAC Player of the Year Amarri Monroe (formerly Amarri Tice) played in all 34 games for Quinnipiac a season ago, stuffing the stat sheet with 12.9 PPG, 6.9 RPG, 1.8 APG, 1.8 SPG, 1.0 BPG. He posted 14.4 PPG & 7.2 RPG in MAAC play. Monroe was the only player that finished inside the league's Top 5 in rebounds, blocks, and steals. He scored 10+ points 25 different times, and registered five separate double-doubles.
- Savion Lewis wrapped up the 2023-24 campaign averaging 8.1 PPG, 7.3 APG & 3.2 RPG for the Bobcats. He finished second nationally in total assists (248). Lewis recorded 5+ helpers in 28 of Quinnipiac's 34 contests, including an impressive 17-assist night against Rider in Hamden (1/5/23).
- Graduate forward Paul Otieno returns for another year after leading the MAAC in field goal percentage (63.8%) in 2023-24. He averaged 11.0 PPG & 6.9 RPG, starting in all 34 contests for the Bobcats. He registered four double-doubles a season ago.

VETERAN GROUP

- The Bobcats return six of nine players that logged 200+ minutes last season (2023-24).
- Amarri Monroe (12.9 PPG in '23-24), Paul Otieno (11.0 PPG), Savion Lewis (8.1 PPG), Alexis Reyes (7.8 PPG), Doug Young (6.3 PPG), Richie Springs (3.8 PPG) are all back for Quinnipiac.

THE 6 NEWCOMERS

- The Bobcats added six newcomers in total.
- Ryan Mabrey transferred in from Miami University, where the former All-MAC Freshman Team selection played in 58 games with the RedHawks over the last two seasons.
- Quinnipiac also brought in five true first-year athletes: Grant Randall (Queens, NY), Samson Reilly (Manchester, CT), Spence Wewe (Bristol, England), Braylan Ritvo (Harlem, NY), Jaden Zimmerman (Bronx, NY).

LAST YEAR: BENCHMARK 2023-24 SEASON

- The Bobcats finished off the record-breaking 2023-24 campaign with 24 total wins (new program best).
- Quinnipiac won its first-ever MAAC regular season title under first-year Head Coach Tom Pecora.
- QU also set a new program mark for total points in a single season (2,630).
- The Bobcats' 19-4 start over their first 23 games marked the program's best start to a year since the 1965-66 campaign.
- Quinnipiac won 10 consecutive games from Jan. 5 – Feb. 8.
- The Bobcats finished the month of January with a 7-0 record, marking the first perfect month in the university's Division I history.

GAME NOTES

MONROE, OTIENO, ZIMMERMAN EARN ALL-MAAC AWARDS

- Three Quinnipiac men's basketball student-athletes earned All-MAAC recognition, as announced by the league office on Monday, March 10, 2025.
- Forwards Amarri Monroe and Paul Otieno both earned a spot on the All-MAAC First Team, and first-year guard Jaden Zimmerman was selected for the MAAC All-Rookie Team.

AMARRI MONROE (MAAC PLAYER OF THE YEAR)

- Junior forward Amarri Monroe has been selected the 2024-25 MAAC Player of the Year, as revealed by the league office on Monday, March 10. Monroe paced Quinnipiac during the regular season in 2024-25, averaging 17.7 points, 9.2 rebounds, and 2.3 steals per game – all of which led the team.
- The Newburgh, New York-native impressed in conference play, averaging a double-double (19.8 PPG & 10.5 RPG) over 19 MAAC contests. He finished the regular season leading the MAAC in rebounds per game (9.2), offensive rebounds per game (7.00), and double-doubles (14). Monroe has recorded 20+ points in 16 different games this season. He also grabbed 10+ rebounds in eight consecutive contests to wrap up the regular season.
- The junior forward becomes QU's second Player of the Year in as many seasons.
- Monroe is the fourth player in Quinnipiac program history to be named conference player of the year. Justin Rutty was named NEC Player of the Year in 2009-10, Cameron Young earned MAAC Player of the Year status in 2018-19, and Matt Balanc was crowned the league's Player of the Year in 2023-24.
- Monroe has 70 steals already this year for Quinnipiac. He needs just four more to break the Bobcats' single-season record of 73 (Boyd Johnson, 1988-89).

PAUL OTIENO

- QU big man Paul Otieno led the MAAC with a 59.0% shooting percentage during the regular season in 2024-25.
- Otieno finished his regular season campaign with 13.4 points, 8.6 rebounds, and 2.1 blocks per night.
- The Nairobi, Kenya-native averaged 3.9 offensive rebounds per contest – which leads the MAAC and ranks 6th nationally heading into postseason action.
- Otieno grabbed 11 offensive rebounds on 11/23 at UMass Lowell. He recorded 5 or more offensive boards in 10 different contests.

SAVION LEWIS

- Graduate point guard Savion Lewis leads QU with 6.4 assists per game – which ranks 2nd in the MAAC and 13th nationally. He's also averaging 5.7 PPG & 3.5 RPG.
 - Lewis has dished out 584 career helpers – a new Quinnipiac Division I program record. Lewis takes over the top spot from Rob Monroe (2001-05), who recorded 541 assists during his time with the Bobcats.
 - A season ago (2023-24), Lewis finished with 7.3 assists per game – which finished 4th nationally.
- The former Half Hollow Hills East star was voted New York's 2018 Mr. Basketball after recording 34.0 points, 7.0 assists and 5.0 steals per contest as a senior in 2017-18.

OTHER PLAYER NOTES

- Jaden Zimmerman has posted 10.8 points and 2.1 rebounds during his rookie season with the Bobcats en route to an All-Rookie selection. The guard has 10+ points in 20 different games this season. He scored 24 points on 2/14 at Sacred Heart, then poured in 22 points against Merrimack on 3/2.
- Sophomore Khaden Bennett has posted 10.5 PPG & 4.3 RPG in a breakout season. Bennett scored 10+ points in 20 different games for Quinnipiac.
- Alexis Reyes stuffed the stat sheet with 5.7 PPG, 4.5 RPG & 2.1 APG during the 2024-25 regular season. He logged over 26 minutes a night, recorded four games with 10 or more points, and had a pair of games with 10 rebounds during the regular season.
- Doug Young has chipped in with 5.4 PPG off the bench. The guard has recorded 10 or more points seven different times this season, including a season-high 18 points in a win over Sacred Heart on 2/14.
- Ryan Mabrey has added 4.5 PPG. He poured in a season-high 17 points on 11/9 vs. St. John's (5 made 3-pointers), and also scored 14 points in the regular-season finale on 3/8 at Fairfield (also 5 made 3-pointers).

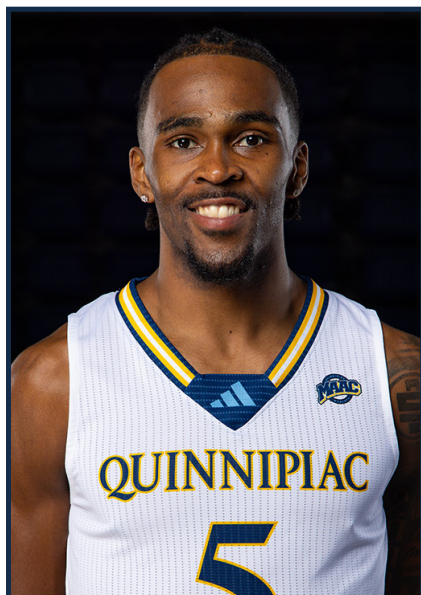
