The Iona University men's basketball team (11-6, 3-3 MAAC) continues league play at home Sunday afternoon at the Hynes Center, welcoming Canisius (8-8, 3-2 MAAC) for a 1 p.m. tip on ESPN+. The Gaels seek a second straight win for the first time since Dec. 10.

IONA VS. CANISIUS - SERIES HISTORY

- The Gaels and Griffins meet for the 87th time in history with Iona holding a 52-34 advantage.
- Canisius snapped a 10-game losing streak to Iona in Buffalo in 2023-24 but has dropped 12 of the last 13.
- The Maroon & Gold is 19-5 in the last 25 meetings.
- Iona is 29-7 on its home floor.

SCOUTING CANISIUS (8-8, 3-2 MAAC)

- Canisius has won three straight MAAC games since the turn of the calendar with a home sweep last weekend and a road win at Manhattan Friday.
- Junior **Kahlil Singleton** is the Griffins' top scorer at 13.6 ppg and deep threat with 48 3FG. He is No. 3 in the MAAC in 3FG/g and has made nearly 45% of the team's total.
- Junior **Bryan Ndjonga** is second in scoring (12.5 ppg), assists (1.8/g) and 3FG (16).
- Junior **Mike Evbagharu** (8.1 ppg) leads with 6.3 rpg, 2.9 apg and 1.3 spg.
- The Golden Griffins were selected to finish 13th in the MAAC this season.

GAELS IN MAAC REGULAR SEASON PLAY

- Since the inception of the MAAC in the 1981-82 season, Iona has compiled a **462-279 (.623)** record in regular season play.
- The Gaels' **462** wins and **.623** win percentage are the highest of any current MAAC member.
- The Gaels became the first team to reach 450 wins with its win vs. Canisius on Jan. 16, 2025.
- Iona is **105** wins ahead of Siena, No. 2 on the list.

GAELS IN MAAC PLAY AT HOME

- Iona was **6-4** in its MAAC home regular season contests in each of the last two seasons and are **35-10 (.778)** in its last **45** MAAC games at the Hynes Center.
- Iona is **113-32 (.779)** in MAAC contests at the Hynes Center in its last **145** games.
- The Gaels overall record in home conference games is an outstanding **260-104 (.714)**.

POSSESSION IS NINE-TENTHS OF THE LAW

- Despite a MAAC leading 72.1 tempo (No. 29 in the country), the Gaels have posted a 7-2 record in games with 72 possessions or less and are 4-4 in games greater than 72.
- When scoring a point or more per possession the Gaels are 11-1. The mark is 4-0 in games greater than 72 possessions.
- With less than a point per possession, Iona is 0-5 overall and 0-4 with more than 72 turns.
- Defensively when holding teams to less than 1.0 PPG, Iona is 7-1 and 4-0 in 72 possessions or less. With a 1.0 opponent PPP or greater, Iona is 4-5 overall and 1-3 with > 72 possessions.
- The Gaels beat Niagara Friday in a season-low 61 possession game, posting a 1.16 offensive efficiency and 0.87 on the defensive end.
- The 0.87 number was a season-best for Iona as it improved to 69-1 in the last 16 seasons when holding a team under 0.88 PPP.

THE FIRST TEN

- With the Gaels' 10th win of the season vs. Siena, head coach **Dan Geriot** matched former skipper **Rick Pitino** for the second fastest coach to double-digit victories in program history.
- Geriot matched the Gaels 10-5 start in 2020-21.
- Tim Welsh** reached the mark the fastest in 1995-96 winning 10 of the teams first 12 and 15 of the first 17.
- Other Iona coaches to reach 10 wins before a 10th loss include: **Pete Caruso** (10-6), **Tim Cluess** (10-6), **Jim McDermott** (10-7), **Jeff Ruland** (10-7), **Jerry Welsh** (10-8), and **Jim Valvano** (10-9).
- Gene Roberti, Pat Kennedy and Tobin Anderson** each started at 10-10.

NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS

- Iona closed its 2025-26 non-conference schedule with an 8-3 record.
- The .727 winning percentage ranks as the fourth best since the turn of the century, trailing a 7-2 (.778) mark in 2005-06 and 9-3 (.750) finishes in both 2009-10 and 2011-12.
- Since the MAAC expanded to 10 teams in 1997-98 and adopted an 18-game league schedule, only the 1997-98, 2009-10, and 2011-12 seasons produced more than eight non-conference wins.
- Iona's all-time non-conference high since the MAAC's inception in 1981-82 is 14 wins, achieved in the league's inaugural season with a 14-5 record, while the program's best winning percentage came in 1984-85 at 12-1 (.923).

DOUBLE DOUBLE DOUBLES

- For the second time this season junior **Kosy Akametu** and senior **Lamin Sabally** each recorded double-doubles in an Iona's win.
- At Kansas City, Akametu posted 22 points and 10 boards while Sabally had 15 and 10.
- Vs. Niagara, Sabally led with 14 points and 10 rebounds and Akametu recorded 12 points and a career-best 12 rebounds.
- Last season, **Dejour Reaves** and **Yaphet Moundi** accomplished the feat vs. Manhattan.

TOP NEWCOMERS

- C.J. Anthony** appears on a MAAC-high nine of the 11 statistical leaderboards tracked on MAACSports.com, ranking in assists (1st), assist/turnover ratio (2nd), scoring (7th), steals (8th), 3-point fg pct (10th), 3-point fg made (14th), free throw pct (16th), field goal pct (19th), and minutes played (23rd).

- Anthony also ranks No. 4 on MAAC All-KenPom.com team.
- Lamin Sabally** ranks in six categories: rebounding (3rd), field goal pct (4th), steals (5th), assists (13th), blocked shots (21st), and minutes played (23rd).

- Quinnipiac's Amarri Monroe, Sacred Heart's Dashon Gittens, Manhattan's Jaden Winston, and Mount St. Mary's Xavier Lipscomb appear on eight leaderboards, while Manhattan's Devin Dinkins, Siena's Gavin Doty, and Merrimack's Kevar Kennedy are listed in seven. Sabally is joined by five other performers with six.

KING OF THE HILL, TOP OF THE LIST

- No team among the 13 NYC Metropolitan Area Division I basketball programs within 30 miles of the center of NY College basketball, Madison Square Garden has won more games than Iona University in the 31 seasons (573; Hofstra #2, 557).
- Over the last decade-plus, Iona's 319 wins and .630 win percentage are also the best in both categories. (Seton Hall, 288 wins; .593 win pct.)
- Since 1995-96, the Maroon & Gold hold the lead in wins (573), 16 more than Hofstra, 46 more than No. 3 Seton Hall and the top win percentage (.593).
- Iona's 12 postseason appearances (eight NCAA, three NIT, one CIT) since 2010-11 are the most during the time frame, four more than Seton Hall (five NCAA, three NIT) and six more than St. John's (four NCAA, two NIT).

LOU HENSON AWARD WATCH LIST

• Graduate **CJ Anthony** was named to the Lou Henson Award Early Season Watch List, as announced by CollegeInsider.com.

• Anthony is one of just two MAAC players selected among the 50 student-athletes on the early season list, joining Quinnipiac's Amari Monroe.

• The Lou Henson Award is presented annually to the top player in Division I men's basketball from a mid-major program.

MAAC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

• Iona has collected three MAAC Player of the Week honors this season, with graduate **CJ Anthony** earning two in the first four weeks and classmate **Toby Harris** claiming the award on Dec. 22 following a 26-point performance at Vermont.

• Anthony opened the season by winning the first weekly honor for his play against Hofstra, then added a second in week three with standout efforts versus Princeton, Akron, and Oregon State.

• With his first award of the 2025-26 campaign, Anthony became the third Gael to earn MAAC Player of the Week honors in the opening week, joining **Nakiea Miller** (2000) and **Idan Tretout** (2023). He is also the first Iona player to win the award multiple times in a season since **Walter Clayton Jr. and Nelly Junior Joseph** in 2022-23.

• Iona has had multiple Player of the Week recipients in a season for the first time since 2023-24, when Idan Tretout and Greg Gordon earned the distinction.

HOT START

- Earning its 10th win on Jan. 2 marked the fourth-earliest point on the calendar in program history to reach that milestone, trailing only the 2021-22 and 2011-12 campaigns (Dec. 21) and 2022-23 (Jan. 1).
- Other fast starts to 10 wins include 1984-85 (Jan. 3), 1997-98 and 2000-01 (Jan. 5).
- The Gaels' eighth win on Dec. 10 was the second-earliest in program history, behind only 2021-22 (Dec. 3).
- Iona opened this season 4-0 for the first time since 2021-22, marking the third time this century and the 11th time in the 80-year history of the program.

STUFFING THE STAT SHEET

- Through 17 games, senior **Lamin Sabally** is averaging 11.5 points, 7.8 rebounds, 2.9 assists, 2.0 steals, and 0.6 blocks per contest.
- He ranks third in the MAAC in rebounding, fourth in field goal pct, fifth in steals, 13th in assists, and 21st in blocked shots.
- Sabally also posted the Gaels' first 2+ block, 2+ steal game of the season at Kansas City.

NEW ROC SPLASH BROS

- Iona graduate students **Toby Harris** and **Luke Jungers** have emerged as potent bench weapons, especially from beyond the arc.
- Through 17 games, senior Lamin Sabally is averaging 11.5 points, 7.8 rebounds, 2.9 assists, 2.0 steals, and 0.6 blocks per contest.

#SCTOP10

- Senior **Lamin Sabally** earned his second ESPN SportsCenter Top 10 highlight of the season with back-to-back dunks late in Iona's win over Bryant.
- His first, with 5:34 remaining, sparked the crowd as he drove from the wing and threw down a poster dunk. Less than 30 seconds later, he caught a lob from **CJ Anthony** to swing momentum in Iona's favor, securing No. 8 on the Top 10.
- In the season opener vs. Hofstra, his thunderous transition dunk with 7:38 left in the second half was ranked No. 2.
- An Instagram post from the baseline angle, showing Sabally drawing contact before finishing one-handed, has amassed over 1.5 million views, 123,000 likes, 72,000 shares, and 2,300+ comments.

SUBTLE KEYS TO VICTORY

- Iona is 7-0 this season when holding a higher Effective Field Goal Percentage (weighted for three-pointers) and making more free throws than its opponent. They are 3-2 when leading in one category and 1-4 when behind in both.
- Since 2010, the splits are 151-15 when winning both, 152-78 when winning one and 16-94 when dropping both.

DON'T CALL IT A COMEBACK

- Iona erased a 19-point second-half deficit in a thrilling double-overtime win vs. Oregon State.
- ESPN.com listed the probability of a loss with 10:54 remaining in regulation at 99.3%.
- Luke Jungers** drilled a corner three with 1.5 seconds left to force the first overtime, and **CJ Anthony** sank two clutch free throws with under six seconds remaining to send the game to a second extra period.
- It marked Iona's fourth comeback from 15 or more points in the last four seasons. Previous comebacks include: trailing by 18 vs. Quinnipiac (Jan. 29, 2023), 16 vs. Sacred Heart (Mar. 8, 2025), and 15 vs. Vermont (Nov. 15, 2024).

FIRST WIN

- Head coach **Dan Geriot** picked up his first collegiate head coaching win in his debut vs. Hofstra.
- He is the first Iona head coach to win in his debut since **Jeff Ruland** in 1998. Since then, **Kevin Willard, Tim Cluess, Rick Pitino, and Tobin Anderson** all lost their first contests.
- Pitino and Anderson won in their second games, Cluess started 0-3, and Willard 0-6. Ruland began with back-to-back wins.
- Cluess' first Division I win came in his fourth game against Geriot's Richmond team in 2010.
- Geriot is the first head coach since **Gene Roberti** in 1973 to start 4-0.

- Iona competed in the Paradise Jam for the third time, posting 1-2 results in all three appearances.
- Previous trips came in 2008 under Kevin Willard and 2012 under Tim Cluess.
- In each tournament, the Gaels lost the first and third games but won the middle contest, finishing sixth overall.

BALANCED SCORING

- The Gaels snapped a long stretch without a specific scoring achievement as six players reached double figures in the win over Princeton on Nov. 18.
- It was the first time since Jan. 18, 2019, vs. Marist at the Hynes Center, a span of 203 games.
- Since the 2002-03 season, Iona has had six or more players score in double figures 10 times, including a high of seven vs. Niagara on Jan. 4, 2014.

THE CENTURY MARK

- Iona scored 105 points in its win at Kansas City, ending the longest stretch in program history without a triple-digit game.
- The last time the Gaels reached 100 or more points prior to Kansas City was Jan. 3, 2019, in a 103-84 win over Monmouth at the Hynes Center.
- The last road 100-point effort was a 110-101 loss at Rider on Feb. 25, 2018, and the last road win with 100+ points came at Marist, 101-66, on Dec. 4, 2015.

EMBRACE THE PACE

- Iona's 105-point performance at Kansas City came on 86 possessions, as calculated by KenPom.com.
- It matched the Gaels' sixth-highest single-game possession total in regulation since 2010 and was the highest since an 88-possession effort on Feb. 19, 2021.
- Among the 35 recorded contests with 80 or more possessions in regulation since 2010-11, head coach **Tim Cluess** accounted for 32, **Rick Pitino** two, and **Dan Geriot** one.

20+ TRIO

- Junior Kosy Akametu and graduates Keshawn Williams and Toby Harris each scored 20+ points in the win at Kansas City.
- They are the first trio of Gaels to reach 20+ points in a game since Asante Gist (23), Tajuan Agee (21), and E.J. Crawford (21) vs. Princeton on Dec. 17, 2019.

DAN GERIOT YEAR 1

- Dan Geriota** is in his first season as head coach of the Iona men's basketball program in 2025-26.
- He arrives in New Rochelle after 10 seasons in the NBA, where he earned a reputation for player development, tactical preparation, and building winning cultures at both the NBA and G League levels with the Cleveland Cavaliers and New Orleans Pelicans.
- Geriota worked under several NBA head coaches, including Willie Green, J.B. Bickerstaff, John Beilein, Larry Drew, and Tyronn Lue.
- Before his NBA tenure, Geriota coached at the collegiate level as an assistant at Campbell University (2013-2015) under Kevin McGeehan and at Princeton University (2011-2013) under Mitch Henderson.
- As a player, Geriota had a distinguished career at the University of Richmond (2006-2011), helping the Spiders reach back-to-back NCAA Tournaments in 2010 and 2011, including a Sweet 16 berth in his senior season.

- He finished his Richmond career ranked 17th on the program's all-time scoring list with 1,386 points, earning Atlantic 10 All-Rookie Team honors as a freshman and third-team All-Atlantic 10 recognition as a sophomore.
- Geriota played professionally in Belgium for Verviers during the 2011-12 season.
- A native of Springfield, Pennsylvania, he starred at Springfield High School, where he was named Delaware County Player of the Year, and earned a bachelor's degree in political science and history from Richmond.

20/20 VISION

- Iona has recorded 24 20-win seasons in the 80-year history of the program.
- The Gaels have achieved 11 such campaigns since 2009-10, spanning the last 16 seasons.
- Iona has posted 25+ wins seven times in program history, including back-to-back 25+ win seasons in 2021-22 and 2022-23.

- Through **17** games this season, Iona has made at least one three-pointer in **564** consecutive games and in **1,017** of its last **1,019** contests.
- In 2019-20, the Gaels surpassed their previous program record of 386 consecutive games (Jan. 5, 1994-Dec. 16, 2006).
- Since the three-point line was adopted in 1986-87, Iona has failed to make a three-pointer in just **19** of **1,236** games.

MID-MAJOR ELITE

- Iona has made 11 NCAA Tournament appearances since 1998, tied for the third-most among schools in conferences eligible for the CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Poll.
- Only Gonzaga (26) and Saint Mary's (11) from the West Coast Conference have more appearances.
- The Gaels are tied with Murray State (Missouri Valley) and New Mexico State (Conf. USA), and one ahead of Montana (Big Sky) and Vermont (Amer. East).
- Forty-one schools have made at least five NCAA appearances over the last 27 seasons.
- Iona's 2025-26 schedule features mid-major heavyweights, including Vermont (10 appearances), Princeton (7), Akron (6), and Siena (5).
- Outside the ACC, Big Ten, Big 12, Big East, and SEC, only VCU (14), Utah State (14), Memphis (13), and San Diego State (13) have appeared more, with Temple, Davidson, and New Mexico each reaching 10.

HYNES DOMINANCE

- Iona is **46-15 (.754)** at the Hynes Center over the last three-plus seasons.
- The Gaels are **147-42 (.778)** since 2009.
- Their non-conference home record over the last 11+ seasons stands at **26-8 (.765)**.
- Iona's 21-game home winning streak was snapped by Rider on Jan. 15, 2023.
- That streak tied for the second-longest in program history, behind a 26-game streak (2014-16) and matching streaks from 1979-80 and 1951-53.

IN THE RAFTERS

Iona Athletics has honored two legendary figures in the Hynes Center rafters: **Jim Valvano** and **Richie Guerin**.

JIM VALVANO

- Head coach (1975-1980) • Director of Athletics (1977-1980) • Arrigoni Hall of Fame (1994).
- Valvano led Iona to a 95-46 (.674) record, including the 1979-80 team that went 29-5, captured the ECAC Championship, defeated eventual national champion Louisville, 77-60, at Madison Square Garden, and advanced to the NCAA Tournament second round. Known for his "Dare to Dream" philosophy, Valvano recruited some of the program's finest talent.
- He was honored with a recognition ceremony on Jan. 7, 2024.

RICHIE GUERIN

- Played at Iona from 1951-1954 and became the first player in school history to have his number retired (#14) on Jan. 31, 2014.
- Guerin scored 1,375 points, earned two All-Metropolitan selections, and set a then-school record with 40 points in a game against John Carroll in 1954.
- He went on to play professionally for the New York Knicks (1956-1963) and served as player-coach for the St. Louis/Atlanta Hawks for nine years, finishing his career with 14,676 points, 4,278 rebounds, and 4,211 assists in 848 games.

GAEL GREATS

In addition to Naismith Hall of Famers Richie Guerin ('54) and Jim Valvano, Iona men's basketball has produced numerous notable figures:

- Jeff Ruland '91** – All-American at Iona; two-time NBA All-Star with the Washington Bullets, Philadelphia 76ers, and Detroit Pistons. Returned to Iona as head coach (1998-2007), winning three MAAC Championships.
- Tim Cluess** – Head coach (2010-2020), led one of the program's most successful decades with 199 wins in nine seasons, six NCAA appearances, five MAAC tournament titles, and four MAAC regular season championships. All-time MAAC leader in tournament victories.
- Pat Kennedy** – Head coach (1980-1986); later coached at Florida State, DePaul, Montana, and Towson.
- Warren Isaac '65** – Iona's only 50-point scorer; played six seasons in Europe. Starred at NYC Power Memorial before paving the way for NBA

Hall of Famer Kareem Abdul-Jabbar.

- Tim Welsh** – Head coach (1995-1998); later coached Providence for 10 seasons in the Big East. Holds the highest career winning percentage in Iona history; now an ESPN college basketball analyst.
- Kevin Willard** – Head coach (2007-2010); now at Villanova following stints at Seton Hall and Maryland. Turned around a program from two wins prior to his arrival to 20 in his final season.
- Steve Burt '84 & Steve Burt '06** – All-time NCAA father/son scoring leaders with over 2,000 points each. The father played four NBA seasons, including the 1992 playoffs with Phoenix, and was inducted into the NYC Basketball Hall of Fame. The son continues his professional career in Europe.
- Sean Green '91** – Played 84 NBA games from 1991-1994; currently a high school coach in Southern California.
- Scott Machado '12** – Prior to Jenkins and Clayton, he was the last Gael to appear in an NBA game; played for Houston and Golden State, plus time in the NBA G-League and Australia. MAAC and Iona all-time assist leader.
- Daniss Jenkins** – Signed a two-way contract with the Detroit Pistons in 2024-25 and remains on a two-way deal for 2025-26. He has appeared in multiple games this season, averaging 7.5 points, 1.8 rebounds, and 3.0 assists per game, with a career-high 24-point outing.
- Walter Clayton Jr.** – Selected 18th overall in the 2025 NBA Draft by the Utah Jazz. As a rookie, he has contributed off the bench, averaging 6.4 points, 2.0 rebounds, and 3.1 assists per game while gaining experience in both the NBA and G League.
- Bob Santini '53** – Iona's first NBA player; appeared in four games with the New York Knicks in 1955-56.

NOTABLE ALUMNI (ATHLETICS/POP CULTURE)

- Brendan Malone '62** – Longtime NBA assistant coach, last with Detroit (2014-16); passed away in 2023. His grandson, Thomas, is a graduate manager for Iona this season.
- Don McLean** – Singer-songwriter, most famous for "American Pie" (1971).
- Dennis Leonard** – Kansas City Royals Hall of Famer, 12-year MLB career, three 20-win seasons (1977-1980); inducted into NY Baseball Hall of Fame, 2015.
- Kyle Flood '93** – Former Rutgers head football coach; current offensive coordinator and OL coach at Texas.
- Maggie Timoney '89** – Iona women's basketball Hall of Famer; first female CEO of Heineken USA.
- Jason Motte** – MLB relief pitcher; recorded final out of 2011 World Series with St. Louis; also played for Chicago, Colorado, and Atlanta.
- Leonard Korir '12** – Two-time NCAA track champion; represented Team USA in 2016 Rio Olympics (10,000m) and 2024 Paris Games (Marathon).

- Ignacio Maganto** – First Iona MLS draft pick; selected by LA Galaxy in 2015, scored first MLS goal that spring.
- Mariano Rivera III '15** – Selected in the fourth round by Washington Nationals in 2014.
- Emma Hayes** – Iona women's soccer coach (2003-2005); named U.S. Women's National Team head coach in 2023; won Gold at 2024 Paris Olympics.
- Juana Camilion** – Two-time MAAC Defensive Player of the Year, 2023 MAAC Player of the Year; silver medalist for Spain in 3x3 women's basketball at 2024 Paris Olympics.

- Iona now has two campuses in Westchester County, N.Y., just north of New York City. Iona's beautiful 45-acre campus in New Rochelle, N.Y., and new 28-acre campus in Bronxville, N.Y., are both just 30 minutes via Metro-North train to Midtown Manhattan.
- With the support of a \$20 million gift from NewYork-Presbyterian, Iona has established the NewYork-Presbyterian Iona School of Health Sciences on its new Bronxville campus, developing a premier new school in collaboration with one of the nation's top hospitals.
- The flagship building of Iona's new Bronxville campus has been named the Kelly Center for Health Sciences thanks to benefactors Al and Peggy Kelly. Both are double alumni and longtime Iona basketball fans; Al Kelly is formerly the CEO of Visa.
- This fall, Iona opened its first residence hall in Bronxville, Bohm Hall.
- Iona also continues to beautify its New Rochelle campus,

where it just opened a modern new dining hall and renovated LaPenta Student Union located adjacent to the new Murphy Green in the heart of campus. Construction is also underway on another green space in New Rochelle, the Upper Green.

- Iona has emerged as a leader in teaching and learning in the age of AI, opening the Gabelli Center for Teaching and Learning and leading the way in innovative instruction. Iona faculty are even working with local K-12 school districts through its AI@Iona Outreach program to 'teach the teachers' on how to engage with AI in the classroom. Through the Gabelli Center, Iona has also brought some of the world's foremost AI thinkers and experts to campus for engaging discussions. In May 2024, Iona opened a new campus in County Mayo, Ireland. Located within the historic Westport House Estate along the Atlantic coast, Iona looks forward to returning this May.
- It pays to go to Iona: 94 percent of Iona graduates are employed full-time or enrolled in graduate school within six months of graduation. Iona is also in the top 6 percent nationwide for its long-term return on investment, according to Georgetown University's Center on Education and the Workforce.
- Iona has also achieved national recognition. Most recently for 2026, Iona has been recognized by The Princeton Review, The Wall Street Journal, Forbes and others as one of the nation's best colleges. Additionally, U.S. News & World Report recognized Iona as one of top for social mobility in the country.
- The Wall Street Journal's new ranking of the 2026 Best Colleges in America places Iona University at #5 in Catholic Colleges nationwide for student experience.
- Iona has added five new Division I Varsity programs in the last few years – men's lacrosse, women's acrobatics & tumbling, women's golf and men's and women's tennis launching next year.
- Iona also continues to expand its Club Sports program, which is geared toward those with an interest in organized sports outside of Iona's rigorous Division I Athletics program, including a championship esports club team that was featured on Yahoo's In the Know.

- Tradition: Iona's world-renowned Pipe Band performs at major campus events and even leads the University's march up Fifth Avenue in the New York City St. Patrick's Day parade.
- Members of the Iona community are known as Gaels, who are people with Irish-Gaelic ancestry.
- Notable Iona alumni include Al Kelly Jr., retired CEO of Visa Inc.; Margaret C. Timoney, CEO of HEINEKEN USA; and musician Don McLean, most famous for his song "American Pie."



PRESIDENT SEAMUS CAREY, PH.D.

- Seamus Carey, Ph.D., serves as the ninth president of Iona University.
- A Bronx native and first-generation college student, Carey began his Iona presidency in July 2019.
- Propelling the University on a path of innovation, President Carey has since overseen the school's growth and expansion to include the acquisition of a new second campus in Bronxville, the launch of the NewYork-Presbyterian Iona School of Health Sciences and new programs inside and outside the classroom.

- President Carey also successfully led the transition to become Iona University, reflecting both the strength and diversity of its academic programs.
- New student enrollment is up over 40% under President Carey's leadership since 2019.



WHAT IS A GAEL?

- The symbol of Iona University's athletic teams is the popular Gael. A Gael is anyone of Irish-Gaelic ancestry, consistent with the Irish tradition of Iona.
- The University was founded in 1940 by the Congregation of Christian Brothers, commonly known as the Irish Christian Brothers.
- The Gael, which is depicted as a spunky character, provides Iona with a nickname consistent with the school motto, *cetera bonum certamen* ("fight the good fight") and personifies strength.

Dan Geriot is in his first season as head coach of the Iona University men's basketball program in 2025-26. He arrives in New Rochelle after spending the past 10 seasons in the National Basketball Association (NBA), where he developed a reputation for player development, tactical preparation, and building winning cultures at both the NBA and G League levels.

Geriot completed his 10th NBA season and first with the New Orleans Pelicans in 2024-25, serving as an assistant coach on Willie Green's staff. He joined the Pelicans after two seasons with the Cleveland Cavaliers, where he held the dual role of assistant coach and director of player development. In that position, he was responsible for supporting head coach J.B. Bickerstaff in all facets of game preparation, opponent scouting, and individual development—particularly among the team's frontcourt players.

Over the course of nine seasons with the Cavaliers organization, Geriot steadily rose through the coaching ranks. His roles included assistant coach (2019-21), head coach of the G League's Canton Charge (2021-22), assistant/player development coach (2018-19), assistant video coordinator/coaching assistant (2016-18), and seasonal video coordinator during Cleveland's 2015-16 NBA Championship season. Across his time with the Cavs, Geriot was part of multiple playoff runs and contributed to 99 wins in his final two seasons with the club.

Before joining the NBA, Geriot began his coaching career at the collegiate level. He was an assistant coach at Campbell University from 2013 to 2015 under Kevin McGeehan, and at Princeton University from 2011 to 2013 under head coach Mitch Henderson. During his time in college basketball, he contributed to recruiting, scouting, and player development, with a focus on frontcourt skill work.

As a player, Geriot enjoyed a decorated career at the University of Richmond from 2006 to 2011. He helped lead the Spiders to back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances in 2010 and 2011, including a Sweet 16 berth in his senior season. Geriot finished his career ranked 17th on Richmond's all-time scoring list with 1,386 points, and also tallied 266 assists and 4.1 rebounds per game while shooting 37.3 percent from three-point range. He earned Atlantic 10 All-Rookie Team honors as a freshman and third-team All-Atlantic 10 recognition as a sophomore. He went on to play professionally for one season in Belgium with Verviers during the 2011-12 campaign.

A native of Springfield, Pennsylvania, Geriot starred at Springfield High School, where he was named Delaware County Player of the Year after averaging 24.8 points and 10.8 rebounds as a senior. He earned a bachelor's degree in political science and history from Richmond.


