It marked the most points by a freshman in their Hofstra debut since Eli Pemberton scored 20 points against Coppin State on November 11, 2016.



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Thankful For Thursdays: Hofstra has had an unusual amount of success on Thursdays over the last nine seasons. The Pride is 37-17 in its last 54 Thursday games dating back to February 1, 2018. CAA Players of the Year: The Hofstra men's basketball program has made a habit out of producing the CAA Player of the Year. In 2023-24, Tyler Thomas became the latest member of the program to earn the conference's top prize. Remarkably, Thomas receiving the CAA's top honor marked the third consecutive season at the time that the program had the conference's player of the year. In addition, Hofstra has had the CAA's Player of the Year in three of the last four, five of the last eight, six of the last 10, and eight of the last 16 seasons with Thomas joining Aaron Estrada (2023 and 2022), Justin Wright-Foreman (2019 and 2018), and Juan'ya Green (2016). Other winners from Hofstra since the program joined the CAA include Charles Jenkins (2011 and 2010) and Loren Stokes (2007). The last CAA school to earn three consecutive CAA Player of the Year Awards was George Mason in 1999 (George Evans), 2000 (George Evans), and 2001 (George Evans).

The Pride Of Hofstra; The Pride Of The Area: It has been a tremendous run for the Hofstra men's basketball program as the Pride has captured 147 wins since the start of the 2018-19 campaign. That total leads all the NCAA Division I schools that are part of the Met Basketball Writers Association.

CAA Players of the Week: Hofstra won a pair of conference player of the week awards last season. With those two tallies, a Hofstra player has won at least one Player of the Week award in each of the last 22 seasons dating back to 2003-03, which is easily the longest active streak in the CAA. Another way to put that is that a Hofstra player has earned Player of the Week honors in every single season the school's been in the CAA except 2002-03. In addition, with Davis taking home the honors, Hofstra has now had a whopping 28 players combine to earn 85 Player of the Week awards dating back to the school's first season in the CAA in 2001-02. That's the most players to earn a Player of the Week award and the most Player of the Week awards earned by any CAA school in that span.
