- The game will be streamed on ESPN+ and broadcast on WFUV (90.7 FM) and WFUV's YouTube page.
- Fordham enters the game with a 2-1 record after a 63-61 win over Wagner College in the Rose Hill Gym on Tuesday night while Iona is 2-0 on the season following a 105-91 win at the University of Missouri-Kansas City on Tuesday night.

THE IONA SERIES

- Tuesday night's game will be the 64th meeting between Fordham and Iona on the hardwood, the first since 2006.
- The Rams lead the all-time series, 32-31.
- Fordham won the last matchup, 70-54, on December 3, 2006 in the Rose Hill Gym.
- The two teams were members of the MAAC from 1981-1990.
- Fordham is 197-145 all-time against schools currently in the MAAC.

LAST TIME OUT

- Fordham head coach Mike Magpayo celebrated his birthday on Monday. **Dejour Reaves** waited a few days to give Magpayo his present as the grad student guard hit a jumper with six seconds remaining to lead Fordham to a 63-61 win over Wagner College in the Rose Hill Gym.
- Junior forward **Rikus Schulte** led the Rams with 14 points and seven rebounds while Reaves finished with eleven points, three rebounds and two assists and senior guard **Christian Henry** chipped in with nine points and six assists.
- After falling behind 22-14, Fordham went on a 5-0 run with 8:56 left in the first half to narrow its deficit to 22-19.
- Wagner answered back and added to its lead, leaving the Rams down 31-26 entering halftime.
- Fordham narrowed its deficit to 33-29 before going on a 10-0 run to seize a 39-33 lead on a Schulte three-point play with 16:49 to go in the contest.

Asian American descent. For his efforts, Magpayo was named the 2021 Joe B. Hall Award recipient, given annually to the top first-year head coach in Division I college basketball.

Magpayo arrived at UC Riverside in 2017, serving as an assistant coach with the program from 2017-20 and being promoted to associate head coach in 2019-20.

Prior to arriving in Riverside, Magpayo spent a year as the men's basketball director of operations at the University of San Francisco on the staff of his coaching mentor, Kyle Smith. The Dons finished the season with 22 wins, a fourth-place finish in the West Coast Conference and an appearance in the CBI Championship.

Magpayo also spent three years at Campbell University in the Big South Conference, where he served as the defensive coordinator and recruiting coordinator. In 2016-17, he helped put together one of the best seasons in school history, as the Camels advanced to the conference championship game and made their first postseason appearance since 1992.

A Hacienda Heights, Calif. native, Magpayo served as director of operations, assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Columbia University during the most successful four-year run in school history from 2010-14. He was a member of head coach Kyle Smith's (currently the head coach at Stanford) staff, along with Todd Golden (currently head coach at Florida) and Kevin Hovde, who was just named head coach at Columbia.

A 2001 graduate of UC Santa Barbara where he earned a degree in business economics, Magpayo was a Southern California High School basketball coach from 2001-2010 before starting his college coaching career.



Mike Magpayo was named head men's basketball coach at Fordham University in March of 2025. Magpayo, the 2023 Big West Coach of the Year, served as the head coach at the University of California, Riverside for the past five years.

Over the past five years at UC Riverside, Magpayo set a new standard for Highlander men's basketball. He led the teams to two 20-win seasons, including a 21-13 slate this year, 14-6 in the Big West, as UC Riverside finished in a tie for third in the league standings and received a bid to the 2025 NIT.

Over his five years at UCR, Magpayo led the Highlanders to a record of 89-63 (.586). In the 20 years prior to his taking over, UCR had gone 205-386 (.347) as a Division I program.

Magpayo was named the first Big West Coach of the Year in UC Riverside program history in 2022-23 after leading UCR to a program-record 22 wins - including 10 in Big West play. For his efforts, Magpayo was named a finalist for the 2023 Hugh Durham Award, presented by CollegeInsider to the top mid-major head coach in Division I men's college basketball.

A 2021-22 recipient of the Rising Coaches Trailblazer Award, an award presented to individuals who have blazed the way for diversity, equity and inclusion through the coaching and sports industry, Magpayo led the 2021-22 squad to 16-12 season with wins over previously-unbeaten Hawaii and Cal State Fullerton as well as a buzzer-beating victory at Arizona State during the season's opening weekend.

Following his first year at the helm, Magpayo led the program to new heights in 2020-21 with its highest Big West Tournament seed in program history (three) and the first Big West Tournament win in 10 years.

In his first season as head coach, Magpayo led UCR to a win over Washington which marked a number of firsts for Magpayo, including his first over a signature Power-5 opponent. It was his first win as a head coach, his first game coached on the sideline, and further, the first win for a team coached by a Division I head coach of

• The game would be tied six times over the next 16 minutes, the final time at 61 on a Wagner three-pointer with 34 seconds remaining before Reaves' shot gave the Rams the win.

MAGPAYO BACK WHERE IT ALL STARTED

- In 2009, Fordham head coach **Mike Magpayo** was living in Southern California, running a multi-million dollar real estate firm that he helped start after graduating from UC Santa Barbara.
- But he felt the pull of basketball in his life so he became a prominent JV high school basketball coach within the region during his spare time.
- With the real estate market plunge in 2007-08, he realized maybe it was time to pivot so he decided to pursue a master's degree at NYU.
- To maintain a foot in the basketball world, Magpayo reached out by letter to every Division-I head coach in the New York City area in hopes of volunteering.
- He received one response, from then Columbia head coach Kyle Smith, current head coach at Stanford.
- After thinking he had no chance at a position with the Lions when Smith didn't show up at the diner for a meeting, Magpayo landed a position on the staff as the director of operations in 2010-11.
- He spent three years at Columbia before becoming an assistant coach at Campbell.
- Magpayo returned back to his native California, joining Smith as he took over at San Francisco in 2017.
- He later moved to UC Riverside under David Patrick from 2018-20 and succeeded him as head coach for the next five years, leading the Highlanders to an 89-63 record.

REAVES NAMED PRESEASON ALL-A-10



- Fordham grad student guard **Dejour Reaves** was named third team preseason All-Atlantic 10.
- Last year, Reaves earned First Team All-MAAC honors at Iona University.
- He led the Gaels to an appearance in the championship game of the MAAC Tournament, averaging 17.3 points per game, a total that ranked fourth in the MAAC and 98th nationally.
- Reaves shot 44.9% from the field, including a 34.1% clip from beyond the arc on just over five attempts per outing and also converted on 81.9% of his tries from the charity stripe and pulled down 5.5 boards per contest.
- Reaves reached double figures 29 times with 12 outings of 20 or more points, including a season-high 30-point outing against Indiana State in the Bahamas that included a 6-for-9 showing from three-point range.

FORDHAM FIRST IN THREE-POINTERS

Did you know???? Fordham was the first team in the NCAA to use the three-point shot? The first time a three-point shot was used experimentally in a game was on February 7, 1945 when Columbia defeated Fordham, 73-58. The three-point line was set at 21 feet from the basket and Columbia scored 11 “long goals” to Fordham’s nine. Also, free throwers had an option to take their shots from the regular 15-foot distance for one point or from 21 feet for two points. Eight “long fouls” were made during the game.

The game also featured a 12-foot wide free throw lane, a move that would be adopted by the NCAA eleven years later.

- A defensive menace, Reaves averaged 2.1 steals per game in 2024-25, good enough for third in the MAAC and tied for 28th in all of Division I.
- In 2023-24, Reaves was named All-Big Sky Third Team at Northern Colorado as well as Big Sky Top Reserve of the Year.

RAMS RETURN JUST 1% OF SCORING

- The 2025-26 Fordham Rams return just over one percent of their scoring from last year.
- The lone returning players who scored for the Rams last year are sophomore guard **Ryan Pettis**, who scored 23 points in 24 games, and junior guard **Jamison O’Toole**, who accounted for eight points in six games.
- The only other player on the 2025-26 roster who appeared in a game for the Rams last year is sophomore Max Miller, who saw action in five contests.



2025-26 RAMS FEATURE TEN TRANSFER...

- Program sales will be high this year for Fordham as the 2025-26 squad features 12 new players including ten transfers.
- Of the ten transfers, five are grad transfers.
- Leading the grad transfers is guard **Dejour Reaves**, a 2025 All-MAAC selection at Iona last year where he led the Gaels and was fourth in the MAAC in scoring at 17.3 ppg.
- Other grad transfer include forward **Zarique Nutter** (Georgia State) and guards **Marcus Greene** (Hawaii), **Louis Lesmond** (Harvard), and **Jace Howard** (Michigan).



- Nutter was second on the Georgia State team last year in scoring, averaging 14.2 ppg, while Greene averaged 7.3 ppg for the Rainbow Warriors in 2024-25.
- Lesmond was named Harvard’s Defensive Player of the Year while Howard, son of former Michigan head coach Juwan Howard, is back in action after missing last year due to injury.
- Other transfers include senior guard **Christian Henry** (Eastern Michigan), junior forward **Akira Jacobs** (Hawaii) and junior forward **Rikus Schulte**, sophomore center **Jack Whitbourn** and redshirt freshman forward **Abass Bodija**, who all followed head coach Mike Magpayo to Fordham from UC Riverside.
- Henry averaged 14.7 points over 32 games (all starts) for the Eagles, shooting 43.6% from the floor, while Jacobs averaged 6.9 points and 2.6 boards in 30 games for the Rainbow Warriors.

gym opened on January 16, 1925 for a game between Fordham and Boston College. The Rams took the opener 46-16 in a game refereed by one of the University's most prominent alumni, "The Fordham Flash", Baseball Hall of Famer Frankie Frisch.

- The Gym was one of the largest on-campus facilities at the time it was built, earning the nickname "The Prairie" because of its large floor space. The original configuration had no end zone stands and a seating capacity of 2,100 but several standing room crowds of 6,000 were reported in the late 1920s. Since its opening in 1925, the gym has seen numerous renovations, adding new seating, scoreboards and public address systems.
- The arena has been in continuous use by Fordham's basketball teams since its opening with the exception of the World War II years, when it was used for a barracks.
- The Rose Hill Gym has been the site of many legendary college and high school basketball games including Kareem Abdul Jabbar's final high school game and the 1988 Tolentine-Archbishop Molloy Catholic High School Athletic Association (CHSAA) Championship game, billed by the New York Newsday as the "Best High School Game of the 80's".
- The Rose Hill Gym has been named as one of the

Top Ten arenas by USA Today and was featured in the 2011-12 ESPN The Magazine College Basketball issue as one of four Cathedrals of College Basketball.

WHAT'S NEXT?

- The Rams continue the 2025-26 season by returning home to host the Manhattanville College on Sunday, November 16, at 4:00 p.m. in the historic Rose Hill Gym.
- It will be the first meeting between Fordham and Manhattanville on the hardwood.
