The Road Back To The Ivy Championship

2025-26 will see the Tigers aim to win a fourth Ivy title in the past five seasons.

All-Time Series Against Iona

In a series that began in 1988, the Tigers hold an 9-1 lead over the Gaels. In New Rochelle, Princeton is 3-0 against Iona.

Mitch Henderson Against Iona

With Henderson as head coach, the Tigers are 3-1 against the Gaels.

Last Time Against Iona

Princeton held off the Gaels, 81-80, inside Jadwin Gymnasium on Nov. 4, 2024, in the Tigers' 2024-25 season opener. Jacob Huggins scored a career-high 12 points on a perfect 6-for-6 shooting.

The Second-Winningest Coach In School History

With 253 career victories, Mitch Henderson passed Franklin C. "Cappy" Cappon to become the second-winningest head coach all-time at Princeton for wins. Henderson trails only Naismith Hall of Fame member Pete Carril, who ended his career with 514 victories.

The Henderson Era

In addition to being the second-winningest coach in school history, Henderson led Princeton to the Sweet Sixteen in 2023, four Ivy League titles (2017, 2022, 2023, 2024) and two Ivy Tournament championships (2017, 2013). He's coached seven 20-win seasons, 11 wins over high major opponents, four Ivy League Players of the Year, 29 All-Ivy selections, two NBA players (Tosan Evbuomwan '23 and Devin Cannady '20) along with over 20 players to play at the professional level.

Dalen Davis Named Ivy Co-Player Of The Week

On Nov. 17, Dalen Davis was honored as the Ivy League Co-Player of the Week. He shared the award with Cornell's Cooper Noard. On the week, he averaged, 19.7 points-per-game and 4.0 rebounds. Davis also recorded 11 assists and two steals. He also won the award on Jan. 6.

Davis Making An Impact Early

Dalen Davis has led the Tigers in scoring through four games and ranks seventh in the Ivy League, averaging 17.5 points-per-game. Davis also ranks ninth in the conference in assist/turnover ratio (1.4) and tenth in assists (3.3).

Tying His Career-High

Davis scored 25 points for the second time in his career in the Tigers' win over Bucknell on Nov. 11. He went 8-for-16 from the field, 2-for-4 from three and 7-for-8 from the free throw line, both career-highs, while adding three rebounds and three assists. Davis also scored 25 points in a win at Northeastern Nov. 10, 2024.

Closing In On 100 Made Three-Pointers

With 89 career made three-point field goals, Davis is 11 away from 100 makes.

Davis Leading The Backcourt

Dalen Davis, a 2024 Ivy Madness All-Tournament Team selection and a one-time Ivy Player of the Week, is set to lead Princeton's backcourt in 2025-26. Last season he averaged 9.2 points-per-game, 2.0 rebounds along 1.6 assists, and scored in double figures 13 times. During non-conference play last season, he was the Tigers' second-leading scorer and averaged 11.7 points while shooting 38.7% from three.

Strong Start For Jackson Hicke

Through four games, Hicke is averaging 11.0 points-per-game on 44.1% shooting from the field and 4.3 rebounds. He currently ranks fifth in the Ivy League in three-point percentage (56.3%). Against Akron, Hicke scored a career and team-high 15 points on 5-for-10 shooting from the field. He also tallied two rebounds, two assists and one steal. Hicke also connected on a career-high four three-pointers against No. 25 Kansas.

The Development Of Jackson Hicke

Hicke started eight games in 2024-25 and averaged 5.5 points and shot 47.0% from the field. He scored in double-figures six times, including on Feb. 28 when he scored a career-high 14 points on 6-for-8 shooting at Columbia.

Hicke At The World University Games

Hicke represented the USA in 3x3 basketball over the summer at the World University Games, and helped the team win silver.

One Of The Ivy League's Top Rebounders

Malik Abdullahi currently ranks seventh in the Ivy League in rebounds-per-game (5.8).

Year Two For Malik Abdullahi

Abdullahi, who started 18 games a freshman in 2024-25 and was named Ivy Rookie of the Week on Nov. 18, is primed for a breakout season. Last season he averaged 4.3 points on 57.0% shooting and 2.7 rebounds. On Nov. 10, Abdullahi made the game-winning basket in a victory at Northeastern.

Happy Ready To Step Up

CJ Happy started the final 10 games of the 2024-25 season and appeared in 25. On the season he averaged 5.0 points and 2.0 rebounds, and his career-high against a DI opponent came on Nov. 24 in the Tigers' win over Portland at the Myrtle Beach Invitational when he recorded 16 points on 7-for-9 shooting along with four rebounds.

Huggins' Impact Off The Bench

Jacob Huggins gave the Tigers a significant boost off the bench against Bucknell, finishing with 11 points, four rebounds and a game and career-high four assists. In addition to making his first career three-pointer, Huggins set career-highs in free throws made (6) and attempted (10).

Increased Role For Jacob Huggins

Jacob Huggins was a contributor in 2024-25, appearing in 22 games and starting three. Huggins scored a career-high 12 points on 6-for-6 shooting and tallied two rebounds, one block and one steal in Princeton's season-opening victory over Iona on Nov. 4.

Stanton The Starter

Through four games, sophomore Jack Stanton is averaging 9.4 points-per-game and 4.3 rebounds-per-game. He set a new career-high in rebounding in back-to-back games, first pulling down six on Nov. 8 at Akron then seven on Nov. 11 against Bucknell.

Stanton's Career Night

Stanton provided a spark off the bench in 2024-25, appearing in 27 games. Stanton's season-high of 17 points came on 6-for-8 shooting from the field and 3-for-5 from three against Yale on Jan. 31.

The Newcomers

Princeton welcomes six newcomers for the 2025-26 season; Jacob Hammond, Landon Clark, Jake Sussberg, Sebastian Whitfield, Cash McSweeney and Ryan Mandes.

First Career Start For Clark

Clark made his first career start in his first college game, the Tigers' season opener against Akron. He finished with five points, four rebounds, two assists, one steal and one block.

Productive Minutes From The Freshman

In 12 minutes in first college game against Akron, Hammond scored six points on 2-for-2 shooting from the field and 2-for-2 shooting from the free throw line. Whitfield scored six points and knocked down two three-pointers in 13 minutes while McSweeney scored three points and recorded four rebounds and one assist in eight minutes. Sussberg scored five points in eight minutes

A Homecoming For Mike Brennan

Mike Brennan returned to the Tigers' staff as the Ted Athanassiades '61 Association Head Coach ahead of the 2025-26 season. An assistant coach at Cornell during 2024-25, Brennan served as head coach at American from 2013-23 and as an assistant at Princeton from 2000-07. As a player, Brennan was a four-year starter under Pete Carril and helped the Tigers earn NCAA Tournament appearances in 1991 and 1992.

A Different Type Of Homecoming For Mathew Johnson

A native of Columbus, New Jersey, Mathew Johnson returns to his home state as assistant coach of the Tigers for 2025-26. Johnson was on staff at UConn from 2019-2025 and won national championships in 2023 and 2024 with the Huskies.

A New Knick

On Sept. 18, Tosan Evbuomwan '23 signed a two-way deal with the New York Knicks after playing for the Brooklyn Nets in 2024-25. On Jan. 12 against the Utah Jazz, Evbuomwan recorded a career-high 22 point on 7-for-8 shooting from the field and 2-for-3 from three along with five rebounds. On the season with Brooklyn, Evbuomwan averaged 9.4 points, 4.0 rebounds and 1.6 assists.

Top-Five Most Conference Titles Won

Princeton's 33 Ivy titles are the fifth-most regular season championships of any program in NCAA DI men's basketball. The Tigers need five more championships to tie Penn and six earn the No. 4 spot.

SWEET SIXTEEN RUN

Henderson led Princeton to the Sweet Sixteen in 2022-23, becoming just the fourth No. 15 seed in history to do so. The Tigers defeated a pair of nationally ranked opponents (No. 8 Arizona & No. 23 Missouri), became the 11th No. 15 seed to beat a No. 2 seed after taking down Arizona 58-55 in the Round of 64, and earned the largest ever margin of victory for a No. 15 seed thanks to a 78-63 victory over No. 7 seed Mizzou in the Round of 32.

WINNER

The Tigers have won four regular season titles along with two Ivy Tournament titles in the past seven years under Henderson. Princeton has become a mainstay in the postseason throughout Henderson's tenure, making two NCAA Tournament appearances and playing in three NITs. The 2022-23 season saw Henderson earn his 200th career win and become just the eighth men's basketball coach to record 100 Ivy League victories. Currently, he is the second-winningest coach in program history behind Pete Carril (514 wins) with 251 career victories, recently passing Franklin C. "Cappy" Cappon (250 wins).

SUCCESS AGAINST HIGH MAJORS

Princeton have defeated 12 high major opponents during Henderson's tenure which is the most of an Ivy program in that time. The victories include Rutgers (2024-25), Rutgers (2023-24), No. 8 Arizona (2022-2023), No. 25 Missouri (2022-2023), South Carolina (2021-22), Oregon State (2021-22), No. 17 Arizona State (2018-19), USC (2017-18), Penn State (2013-14), Rutgers (2013-14), Florida State (2011-12) and Rutgers (2011-12).

IN THE RECORD BOOK

Henderson's team holds several program records including:

- 2023-2024: Highest free throw percentage in a season (80.6%)
- 2022-2023: Most points scored in a season (2416)
- 2021-2022: Highest scoring average in a season (79.80)
- Most field goals made in a season (910)
- Most three-point field goals made in a season (327)

AS A PLAYER

A four-year starter for the Tigers, Henderson was a three-time Ivy League Champion. He helped the Tigers earn NCAA Tournament wins over UCLA in 1996 and UNLV in 1998, a season that saw Princeton ranked No. 8 in the final AP Poll and end the season with a 27-2 record. Henderson was a two-time All-Ivy honoree, being named Second Team in 1998 and Honorable Mention in 1998. He ranks third all-time in school history for most assists in a season (65, 1997-98), sixth in most assists in a season (131, 1997-98), ninth in in assists (304) and ninth in steals (142). Signed by the Atlanta Hawks in 1999, Henderson played a season of professional basketball in Ireland before moving into the coaching ranks.

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

In his work with Coaches vs. Cancer, Henderson has traveled to New York and Washington advocating for cancer awareness and research. Within the Princeton community, Henderson gives his time as a fellow at the university's Forbes College, one of six residential colleges on campus. His dedication to community involvement extends to the team, which holds clinics in Jadwin for the Princeton Recreation Department.

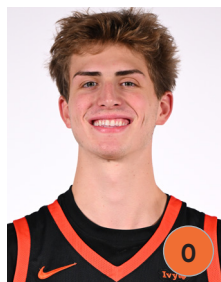

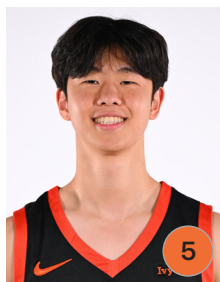
