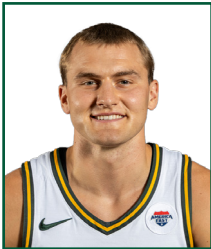

VERMONT NOTES

HISTORY BETWEEN MATCHUP

- This will be the 11th matchup between the Catamounts and the Gaels. Vermont last faced Iona last year, when the Catamounts took a 62-59 loss in New Rochelle, NY
- Iona Leads the Series History 7-3.
- This is third home game of a three game homestand which will feature three MAAC schools (Merrimack, Siena, and Iona).

TJ LONG EARLY DOMINANCE

- Named 1 of 5 USBWA National Players of the Week (only non P-4 player) (11-3-11/9)
- Averaged 25.2 ppg in a 3-0 week with 13 3pt FG (11-3-11/9)
- Had 40 points & 13 rebounds in 89-84 2OT win at Brown - Long was one of five players in the nation to receive USBWA national player of the week honors.
- Long averages 14.5 points per game which ranks 5th in the America East.
- Long ranks 68th in the country and 1st in AE in total three pointers made this season (31)

THE GUS BUS

- Gus Yalden, a redshirt sophomore transfer from Seton Hall, has averaged a team-high 17.1 points per game. Yalden's 17.1 PPG ranks 1st in the America East.
- Had a career-high 29 points shooting 10-15 from the field in a 83-69 win against Siena on Wednesday.
- Won America East Player of the Week (11-24-11-30) averaging 18.5 points and 4.5 rebounds shooting 65% from the field and 43% from three in four games.

SEAN BLAKE SOPHOMORE BREAKOUT

- A sophomore guard from Canada who made the America East All-Rookie team last year.
- Blake recorded a career-high 20 points against Buffalo on 11/18
- Blake leads the team and ranks 4th in the America East in assists per game (4.3).

TJ HURLEY DOMINANCE

- TJ Hurley ranks 6th in the America East in total three-pointers made per game (2)
- Hurley is 5th in the country shooting 95.1%

from the free throw line.

- Became the 41st player at UVM to record 1,000 career points.

THREES FOR DAYS

- Vermont is ranked 82nd in the country and 1st in the AE in three points per game making 9.3 threes a game.
- The Catamounts rank 115th in the country and 1st in the AE in three point percentage (35.4%)

EFFICIENT FROM THE FIELD

- Vermont ranks 52nd in effective field goal % (56.3%)
- The Catamounts rank 70th in field goal percentage (48.1%)

FREE THROWS

- Catamounts rank 67th and 1st in the America East in free throw percentage (75.4%).
- TJ Hurley ranks 5th nationally in free throw percentage (95.1%)

REBOUNDS

- The Catamounts rank 98th in the country and 1st in the America East in rebound margin (+4.9)

NOAH BARNETT ENERGY GUY

- In his second year of play with the Catamounts (redshirted his first year at Vermont), Barnett ranks 4th in the America East in offensive rebounds per game (2.31)

NEWCOMERS

- Vermont returns seven players from last year's team and will welcome nine newcomers for the 2025-26 season.

PATRICK GYM DOMINANCE

- The Catamounts home record over the last five years is 62-6 including going 16-0 in Patrick Gym in 2021-22.

HURLEY COMING UP HUGE IN 24-25

- Junior TJ Hurley has been averaging career-high and team best 16.1 ppg.
- Has eleven 20+ point games this season.
- Hurley has 10+ points in 24/30 games.
- Also has multiple 3's in 24/30 games.
- Hurley ranks 26th in the country in free throw percentage (88.7%).
- Landed on the America East First Team All Conference this year.

DEFENSIVE PROWESS IN 24-25

- The Catamounts have allowed 64 points per game which ranks 15th best in the country.
- UVM ranks 87th in defending the three-point line allowing opponents to shoot 32% from three.
- Vermont average 13.6 fouls per game, ranking 11th lowest in the country.
- Catamounts have allowed 70+ points 5 times out of their last 26 games.
- UVM has allowed 62.9 points in AE play.

BLOCK PARTY IN 24-25

- Catamounts are ranked 43rd in blocks per game (4.5) last year.
- Ileri Ayo-Faleye averaged 2 blocks per game which ranks 25th in the country.
- Had a career-high 7 blocks against Northeastern on 11/30.
- Ileri has a 7.9% block percentage which is #47 in Nation.
- Ileri Ayo-Faleye earned America East All-Defensive team honors this year.

AMERICA EAST CHAMPIONSHIPS

- Vermont has won 11 America East Championships, which is the most in conference history
- The Catamounts have won 7 championships under head coach John Becker's guidance - six in the last eight seasons

20 WINS

- Vermont has had 16 straight seasons with at least 20 wins in which there were at least 20 games played.
- Becker has reached 20 wins in every year of his career besides 2020-21 (15 total games played); Finished 10-5.
- 2007-08 was the last time Vermont did not reach the 20 win marker (16-15).

JOHN BECKER

- 7 America East Titles in 14 seasons
- 8 straight regular season titles - 2nd longest streak in country, behind Gonzaga (11)
- 20 wins in each full season - Vermont is one of three schools with 20 wins in at least 16 straight seasons (Kansas & Gonzaga)
- Had a unique entry into the coaching profession from loading trucks to I.T. work, John Becker took a winding road to coaching
