MOUNT STORYLINES

♦ Mount St. Mary's topped Penn State Brandywine, 73-42, on December 21. The Mount forced 28 turnovers while holding the Lions to 28 percent shooting in the victory. Abdou Khadre Kebe and Justin Amadi each scored 12 points to pace the offense. The Mount outscored the Lions 23-4 over the first 13:23 of the second half to build a 32-point advantage.

♦ This will be the 11th all-time meeting between the Mount and Iona with the Gaels holding a 7-3 advantage in the series. Iona holds a 2-1 record at Knott Arena, including a 70-67 win in overtime last year on a DeJour Reaves three-pointer at the buzzer.

♦ The last meeting between the two teams was the 2025 MAAC Championship game with the Mount prevailing, 63-49. Dallas Hobbs led the way on offense with 18 points and seven assists. Dola Adebayo was named Tournament MVP, completing his run in Atlantic City with a 15-point, three rebound effort. Arlandus Keyes was superb off the bench, supplying 14 points. DeJour Reaves led Iona with 19 points and seven boards.

♦ Mount St. Mary's is 2-2 at Knott Arena this season, and is 12-6 (.667) at home over the past two seasons.






♦ Mount St. Mary's used its eighth different starting lineup over the first 13 games in the win over Penn State Brandywine on December 21. Mason So has started every game this season, and is the lone Mountaineer to play in all 13 games this year. Injuries have been the main factor for the lineup shuffling as the Mount has lost 56 man-games due to injury this season.

INSIDE THE NUMBERS

♦ Trey Deveaux had 11 points and 11 rebounds against PSU Brandywine for his first double-double as a Mountaineer. It is the second double-double of Deveaux's career at the NCAA Division I level. He had 17 points and 11 rebounds for Western Illinois against Morehead State on Feb. 15, 2025.

♦ Mount St. Mary's dished out a season-high 26 assists on 30 made field goals in the win over Penn State Brandywine. The 26 assists are the most by a Mount team since recording 26 in a 100-75 loss at Tulane on Dec. 30, 1995. It is just the ninth time since the Mount moved to NCAA Division I in 1988-89 that the team has recorded 26 or more assists in a game.

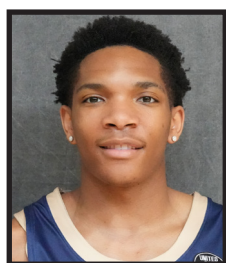

► MOUNT ST. MARY'S UPDATE

◆ Mount St. Mary's is coming off a 73-42 victory over Penn State Brandywine on December 21. Justin Amadi and Abdou Khadre Kebe led the way with 12 points each while Anastasios Rozakeas and Trey Deveaux also reached double figures with 11 points in the win.

◆ Leading 39-26 at the half, the Mount outscored the Lions, 23-to-4, over the first 13:23 of the second half to build a 32-point lead. From there, the Mount cruised to the victory.

◆ The Mount held PSU Brandywine to 28.0 percent shooting in the game while forcing 28 turnovers. The Mount held a 31-to-11 advantage in points off turnovers in the game.

◆ Arlandus Keyes leads four Mountaineers in double figures in scoring this season at 11.9 points per game. The others include Trey Deveaux (11.5), Xavier Lipscomb (10.8) and Luke McEldon (10.7). McEldon leads the team in rebounds (5.8) while Lipscomb leads the team in both assists (4.5) and steals (1.6).

◆ Mount St. Mary's is averaging 68.5 points per game while shooting 44.2 percent overall and 33.7 percent from three-point range. The Mount is allowing 76.0 points per game, 42.7 percent shooting from the field, and 35.2 percent shooting from beyond the arc.

► ABOUT IONA

◆ Iona improved to 9-4 on the season with an 83-78 win at Vermont on December 20. Toby Harris scored a season-high 26 points while Keshawn Williams matched his season high with 20 points in the win. Iona rallied from a 10-point second-half deficit to secure the victory.

◆ Iona opened the season with four consecutive wins (Hofstra, Kansas City, Fordham and Princeton), and has won three of its past four games. The Gaels are 1-1 in MAAC play with a road win over Sacred Heart (81-69) and a home loss to Quinnipiac (89-68).

◆ C.J. Anthony leads Iona in scoring at 16.3 points per game while dishing out a team-high 69 assists. Harris is averaging 12.8 points while shooting 45.0 percent (36-of-80) from three-point range. Lamin Sabally is averaging 12.2 points and a team-high 7.8 rebounds while Kosy Akametu is also in double figures at 10.3 points per game.

◆ Iona is averaging 80.5 points per game this season while shooting 45.7 percent from the field and 36.6 percent from three-point range. Iona allows 78.5 points per contests, 44.4 percent shooting from the field, and 31.0 percent shooting from three-point range.

► THE MOUNT VS. MAAC

◆ Mount St. Mary's joined the MAAC for the 2022-23 season, and has posted a 29-33 (.468) regular season record.

◆ The Mountaineers are the defending MAAC Champions having defeated Marist, Merrimack and Iona en route to the title. The Mount is 4-2 all-time in MAAC Tournament games.

◆ The Mount is 3-5 in December MAAC games, having split the pair of games in each of the first three seasons in the league and going 0-2 so far this year.

◆ The Mount has opened MAAC play with a home loss to Sacred Heart (87-80) and a road setback to Marist (64-56).

► NOTES FROM PSU BRANDYWINE

◆ The Mount improved to 12-0 against non-Division I opponents since moving to NCAA Division I in 1988-89. The average margin of victory in those games is 27.6 points.

◆ The Mount forced 28 turnovers in the game, leading to a 31-to-11 advantage in points off of turnovers.

◆ Arlandus Keyes dished out a career-high nine assists in the win as the Mount had a season-high 26 assists on 30 made field goals. The 26 assists are the most by a Mount team since recording 26 against Tulane in 1995.

◆ Trey Deveaux had 11 points and 11 rebounds for his first double-double as a Mountaineer.

► STARTING LINEUPS

◆ Mount St. Mary's used its eighth different starting lineup in 13 games against Penn State Brandywine. The Mountaineers have had a difference starting lineup in each of the past four games.

◆ Injuries have been the main factor, as the Mount has accumulated 56 man-games missed this season.

◆ Mason So has started all 13 games this year, and is the lone Mountaineer to appear in all 13 contests. Lipscomb (12), McEldon (11), Justin Amadi (nine), Arlandus Keyes (seven), Anastasios Rozakeas (seven) and Trey Deveaux (six) have also made starts this year.

► HELPING HANDS

◆ Mount St. Mary's recorded 26 assists on 30 field goals in the 73-42 victory over Penn State Brandywine. The 26 assists are the most by a Mount team since dishing out 26 in a 100-75 loss at Tulane on Dec. 30, 1995.

◆ It is just the ninth time since the Mount moved to NCAA Division I in 1988-89 that the Mountaineers have recorded 26 or more assists in a game.

◆ The Mount is 34th in the nation in the KenPom rankings in assist percentage, recording an assist on 60.8 percent of the team's baskets.

◆ Arlandus Keyes leads the team in scoring at 11.9 points per game, followed by Trey Deveaux (11.5), Xavier Lipscomb (10.8) and Luke McDoldon (10.7). Rounding out the group of players averaging six or more points are Justin Amadi (9.5), Anthony Arrington (8.3), Mason So (6.4), Anastasios Rozakeas (6.3) and Abdou Khadre Kebe (6.0).

◆ The Mount had five players score in double figures for the first time this season in the loss to Sacred Heart. The last time the Mount had five double-figure scorers was in an 85-79 victory over Siena on March 2, 2025.

► LIPSCOMB LEADS THE WAY

◆ Graduate student Xavier Lipscomb has scored 16 points in each of his past two games. He sat out the Penn State Brandywine matchup with an injury. Lipscomb had a 16-point, six-rebound effort in the Mount's loss at Drexel. Lipscomb needed just three shots to accumulate his 16 points at Loyola, going 3-for-3 from the field, 2-of-2 from three-point range and 8-of-9 at the foul line. He is one of five players this season in NCAA Division I to score 16 or more points on three or less shots.

◆ Lipscomb recorded 12 points, five rebounds, five steals and four assists at Marist, just the third time since 2007 that a Mountaineer has posted 12+ points, 5+ rebounds, 5+ steals and 4+ assists in a game. The last time was when Elijah Long had 14 points, seven rebounds, 12 assists and five steals in a 77-70 win over FDU on January 12, 2017. The other time was when Jeremy Goode had 22 points, five rebounds, nine assists and seven steals in the Mount's 70-58 victory against Loyola on December 1, 2007.

◆ Lipscomb is averaging 10.8 points, 5.1 rebounds, 4.5 assists and 1.6 steals for the Mount this season in a team-high 34.6 minutes per game. Lipscomb has scored in double figures seven times, and is shooting 48.7 percent from the field and 40.8 percent from three-point range.

◆ Lipscomb was named to the Preseason All-MAAC Third Team. A team leader, he has been instrumental in help head coach Donny Lind build the team culture. Lipscomb had 10 points while dishing out a career-high 13 assists for his first career double-double against Sacred Heart last season.

◆ Lipscomb began his career at Radford where he was recruited by head coach Donny Lind when he was assistant coach with the Highlanders.

► THREE-POINTERS

◆ Mount St. Mary's went 17-for-36 (.472) from three-point range in the 95-90 overtime loss at Maryland. The 17 three-point field goals made are tied for the second-most in program history. The school record is 18, set in a 104-84 win at Norfolk State on January 3, 2014.

◆ In the latest Kenpom date, 46.6 percent of the Mount's field goal attempts against Division I opponents have been from three-point range this season (306-of-657), the 50th-highest mark in the nation. In point distribution, 38.5 percent of the Mount's scoring this season has come from three-point range, the 33rd-highest mark in the nation.

◆ Mount St. Mary's made 10 or more three-pointers at Saint Francis, Cincinnati and Maryland. It was the first

time the Mount has made 10 or more three-pointers in three consecutive games since having a nine-game streak during the 2017-18 season.

◆ Mount St. Mary's connected on 17-of-45 (.378) from beyond the arc in an 85-70 exhibition win over Hood College on October 29. The 45 three-point attempts by the Mountaineers would be a school record, but exhibition game stats do not count in the record books.

► KEYES IN DOUBLE FIGURES

◆ Senior Arlandus Keyes is the Mount's top scorer at 11.9 points per game. He had his streak of double-figure games snapped at eight in the Mount's 73-42 win over Penn State Brandywine. Keyes did not score in that contest, but dished out a career-high nine assists while adding five rebounds.

◆ Keyes hit 7-of-11 (.636) from three-point range in the Maryland game, the most threes in a game since Dakota Leffew hit seven at Marist on February 2, 2024. He is 22-of-59 (.373) from three-point range this season.

◆ Keyes had 16 points, five rebounds, four assists and four made three-pointers in the Mount's victory at Loyola. Just six Mountaineers have posted those numbers in a game over the past 20 seasons, including teammate Xavier Lipscomb, who had 17 points, six rebounds, five assists and four three-pointers in the overtime loss at Maryland on November 19. The others Mountaineers on the list are Dakota Leffew (four times), Elijah Long, DeShayne Montgomery and Landy Thompson.

◆ Last season, Keyes was a key contributor in the Mount's postseason run, scoring in double figures in all five games. He was named to the MAAC All-Tournament team after averaging 12.7 points over the three games, including 14 points in the MAAC Championship game win over Iona. Keyes hit five three-pointers for 15 points in the Mount's loss to Duke in the NCAA First Round.

► NEWS AND NOTES

◆ Xavier Lipscomb has scored 32 points on just eight shots over his past two contests. Lipscomb was 3-for-3 from the field, 2-of-2 from three-point range and 8-of-9 at the line for 16 points in the win over Loyola. He followed by going 4-for-5 from the field, 1-of-2 from three-point range, and 7-of-7 at the line in the loss at Drexel. Lipscomb is averaging 16.0 points over the two games, shooting 87.5 percent (7-of-8) from the field, 75.0 percent from three-point range (3-of-4) and 93.8 percent (15-of-16) at the foul line.

◆ Arlandus Keyes had 16 points, five rebounds, four assists and four made three-pointers in the Mount's victory at Loyola. Just six Mountaineers have posted those numbers in a game over the past 20 seasons, in-

cluding teammate Xavier Lipscomb, who had 17 points, six rebounds, five assists and four three-pointers in the overtime loss at Maryland on November 19. The others Mountaineers on the list are Dakota Leffew (four times), Elijah Long, De'Shayne Montgomery and Landy Thompson.

♦The Mountaineers are averaging 17.1 turnovers per game while forcing 11.8 for a turnover margin of -5.3. The Mount is 364th out of 365 teams in turnover percentage, committing a turnover on 24.3 of the team's possessions against Division I opponents.

▶ **DEVEAUX WITH DOUBLE-DOUBLE**

♦Trey Deveaux finished with 11 points and 11 rebounds in the Mount's 73-42 win over Penn State Brandywine for his first double-double as a Mountaineer.

♦Deveaux has seven career double-doubles in NCAA action, five with Wayne State, one with Western Illinois and one at the Mount. His last double-double was a 17-point, 11-rebound game against Morehead State on February 15, 2025, for Western Illinois.

♦Deveaux has scored in double figures in three consecutive games, and in eight of his 10 games played this season. He is averaging 13.7 points and 5.7 rebounds over the past three games. For the season, Deveaux chips in 11.5 points and 4.8 rebounds per game for the Mountaineers.

▶ **AMADI FINDING RHYTHM**

♦Justin Amadi scored 12 points in the win over Penn State Brandywine, and is averaging 12.3 points and 6.7 rebounds over the past five games. He is averaging 9.5 points and 5.7 boards per game on the year. He is shooting 54.7 percent from the field on the season.

♦Amadi pulled down eight offensive rebounds in the Mount's 95-90 overtime loss at Maryland. He recorded all eight of the boards after halftime.

♦The eight offensive boards are the most by a Mount player since Nana Opoku had eight at Merrimack on January 9, 2020. It was the 15th time since the Mount moved to NCAA Division I in 1988-89 that a Mountaineer has recorded eight or more offensive rebounds in a game.

♦Malik Jefferson has the top spot on the list with 12 offensive rebounds at American on December 18, 2018.

▶ **KNOTT ARENA ENHANCEMENTS**

♦Mount St. Mary's added to the fan experience at Knott Arena this year with new state-of-the-art video boards, sideline tables and sound system.

♦Three new video boards feature on both sides on Knott Arena, made possible by Digital Scoreboards. On the far wall opposite the concourse will be a giant 50-by-21 foot screen running the length of the court. Across the way, two smaller 12-by-7 foot screens supplement the larger board. All three enhance the real-time stat update experience, provide additional windows for fan experiences, and increase utilization of advertising space.

♦Along with the video boards, Digital Scoreboards provided new courtside tables with digital signage. These boards will also house the scorer's table, DV Sport Replay, statisticians, and broadcasting.

♦Accompanying the video board is a brand new

- ◆ The Mount played before a sellout crowd of 2,821 at Knott Arena in the home opener against Bucknell. It was the Mount's sixth sellout since 2007, and first since 2023.
- ◆ The last sellout at Knott Arena was on February 24, 2023, when the Mount lost to Iona and head coach Rick Pitino, 80-68.
- ◆ The largest crowd in Knott Arena history came on December 8, 1987, when Maryland visited. The crowd that day was listed as 3,700.
- ◆ Seating capacity at Knott Arena is now 2,821 after removing the end bleachers two years ago.

NON-CONFERENCE HISTORY

- ◆ Mount St. Mary's finished the non-conference season with a 4-7 record. Last year, the Mountaineers finished with a 7-4 record in non-conference play, the most non-conference wins in program history since moving to NCAA Division I in 1988-89. The Mount had six non-conference wins in 2017-18 (6-7) and 1989-90 (6-6).
- ◆ Since joining NCAA Division I, the Mount is 120-267 (.310) in non-conference action, going 68-52 (.567) at home, 43-199 on (.178) on the road and 9-18 (.333) at a neutral site.
- ◆ The Mount is 2-6 on the road in non-conference play this season, and is 6-9 (.400) in road non-conference games under head coach Donny Lind. The Mount posted a 38-191 (.166) road record in non-conference games since moving to NCAA Division I prior to Lind taking the helm of the program last year. The Mount's four road non-conference wins last season were the most in a season in the team's Division I era.
- ◆ Last year marked just the second time that Mount St. Mary's had a winning season in non-conference play at the Division I level. The 2002-03 team went 5-4 in non-conference action before finishing the year with an 11-16 record.

BUILDING THE 2025-26 ROSTER

- ◆ Head coach Donny Lind has a roster of 16 players for the 2025-26 season. It is comprised of six returnees, six transfers, two true freshmen and two new walk-ons.
- ◆ Guards grad student Xavier Lipscomb (36 GP, 6.8 ppg) and senior Arlandus Keyes (32 GP, 6.8 ppg) are the

top returnees for the Mount in 2025-26. Junior Patrick Haigh averaged 1.8 points in 19 games as a walk-on last year, earning a scholarship for this season. Sophomore Abdou Khadre Kébé averaged 2.6 points in 29 games last year. The other two returnees are redshirt freshman Elijah Espinosa and walk-on Jaxon Hartman.

- ◆ Six transfers were added to the fold for the 2025-26 season as well. Trey Deveaux (Gr., Western Illinois), Justin Amadi (R-Sr., Tulsa), Luke McEldon (R-Jr., Santa Clara), Anthony Arrington (R-Jr., Wofford), Mason So (Jr., UNC Greensboro) and Anastasios Rozakeas (So., Florida State) comprise the group of transfers.
- ◆ True freshmen Justin May and Yakhya Diop along with walk-ons Noah Rogers (So.) and John Miller IV (Gr.) round out the roster. Miller IV joins the basketball team after playing for the Mount's men's lacrosse team the previous four seasons.

A LOOK BACK AT 2024-25

- ◆ Mount St. Mary's won the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAAC) title last season to earn the school's seven appearance in the NCAA Division I tournament.
- ◆ The Mount finished the season with a 23-13 record, the most wins by a Mount team since the school moved to NCAA Division I in 1988-89. The only other 20-win seasons in the Mount's D1 era came in 1995-96 (21-8) and 2016-17 (20-16).
- ◆ The Mountaineers earned wins over Marist (62-58), Merrimack (57-55) and Iona (63-49) to capture the MAAC title, the first by the team since moving to the MAAC for the 2022-23 season.
- ◆ The Mount earned a trip to Dayton, Ohio, and a match-up with American in the First Four. The Mount rolled to an 83-72 victory over American to advance to an NCAA First Round matchup with top-seeded Duke. The win over American was the school's third NCAA Division I tournament victory. The Mount fell to Duke, 93-49, in Raleigh, N.C. to end the season.
- ◆ Head coach Donny Lind led the Mount to 23 wins in his first season in Emmitsburg, the most wins in program history by a Mount coach in their debut season. The previous mark was set by Jim Phelan, who led the Mount to a 22-3 record in his first season in 1954-55.
- ◆ The Mount defeated Miami (Fla.), 78-74 in overtime, on December 21 last season. The win was the Mount's first over an Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) team since a 71-69 win over #21 Georgia Tech on December 18, 1995.

MAAC PRESEASON POLL

- ◆ Mount St. Mary's was picked to finish in ninth place in the annual Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference Preseason Coaches Poll.
- ◆ The Mount's Xavier Lipscomb was named to the Preseason All-MAAC Third Team. HEAD COACH DONNY LIND

2nd Season at Mount St. Mary's; 2nd Season Overall ♦ Career Record: 27-22 ♦ Loyola (Md.) (2010)

Donny Lind, hired as the 23rd head coach in the Mount's men's basketball history, made an immediate mark on the program as the 2024-25 team captured the university's first Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAAC) championship with a victory over Iona in the conference title game. They would notch a NCAA Tournament victory - the program's third - by defeating American in the First Four. The 23 wins by the team set a Division I record and were the most by any Mount St. Mary's squad since 1986-87.

Lind was hired as the 23rd head coach in men's basketball program history in April of 2024. An assistant coach at University of North Carolina Greensboro the previous several years, Lind brings tremendous energy along with an up-tempo offense and defense to Emmitsburg.

The 2024-25 season was a magical one for the Mountaineers, posting a 23-13 record, the most wins by a Mount team since the school moved to NCAA Division I in 1988-89. The Mountaineers knocked off Marist and Merrimack to advance to the MAAC Championship game against Iona. The Mount came through with a 63-49 victory for the school's first MAAC title, securing the Mount's seventh trip to the NCAA Division I Tournament.

The Mount faced American in the First Four in the NCAA Tournament, and earned a scintillating 83-72 win to advance to play top-seeded Duke in the First Round. Despite the loss to the Blue Devils, the Mountaineers season will go down as one of the best in program history.

Lind served on coaching staffs at both Radford and UNCG under head coach Mike Jones. Radford won back-to-back Big South regular season titles in 2018-19 and 2019-20 during his tenure in Virginia. He also helped the Highlanders win the 2017-18 Big South Tournament, leading to a First Four win over LIU Brooklyn for the program's first NCAA Tournament win. Earning high marks at UNCG as well, the Spartans earned the No. 2 seed in the SoCon last year after earning a 21-11 record. Electric from long range, UNCG ranked fourth in the country for three-point percentage, making 39.7 percent of all shots and drilling over 10 shots per game from beyond-the-arc.

Serving as assistant coach and recruiting coordinator for the Mount from 2013 to 2016, Lind was on staff for the 2014 Northeast Conference Championship and helped put many of the pieces together for the team's 2017 run. He worked on both sides of the ball, improving the Mountaineers offense before transitioning to directing the "Mayhem" full court pressure defense. Using a background in basketball analytics, he improved both sides of the ball, producing the top offense in the NEC for the 2013-14 season.

Following the 2019-20 season after Radford went 21-11 with a 15-3 Big South record, Lind was recognized as a Top 50 Impactful Low Major Coach in D1 by Silver Waves Media and a top five assistant coach for the Big South by Jeff Goodman.

Former Mount Head Coach Jamion Christian brought Lind along from Virginia Commonwealth University where he worked as a graduate manager before being elevated to video coordinator. He was part of the Rams' storied run as the team won 84 games, including seven NCAA Tournament games and the team's run to the 2011 Final Four.

Originally hailing from New Knoxville, Ohio, he graduated with an economics degree from Loyola in Baltimore in 2010. He went on to earn his M.Ed in Sports Leadership from VCU while employed there.

Lind lives in Frederick with his wife, Ciara, and his two children, Magnolia and Silas.

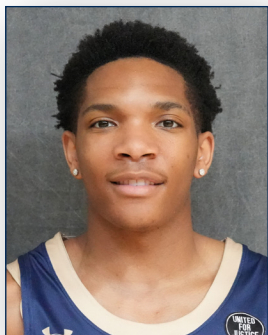

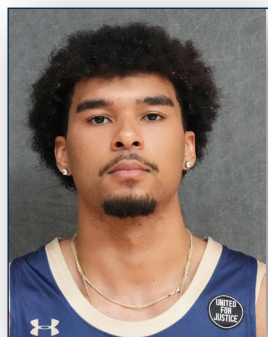
