## IONA SET FOR SHOWDOWN WITH SECOND-PLACE RIDER



The Iona College women's basketball team opens up a two-game, New Jersey road trip in Lawrenceville when they face the Broncs on Tuesday night. Rider is coming off of a home win versus Marist, completing the series sweep of the Red Foxes; Iona has lost 19 straight.

### SCOUTING THE GAELS

• Freshman guard **Shyan Mwai** made her return to the starting lineup against Siena, matching a career-best with 12 points.

• Rookie guard **Juana Camilion** racked up a career-high 22 points in the last matchup between the two teams, a 66-58 win for the Broncs in New Rochelle.

• Iona boasts eight newcomers to the roster; five freshmen and three transfers. It lost its top four scorers from last season.

• The Gaels were voted 10th in the MAAC Preseason Coaches' Poll.

### SCOUTING THE BRONCS

• Rider is out to the best start (9-2 MAAC) in program history. Its previous best start was in the 2016-17 campaign (8-3).

• Four different players scored in double-figures in the team's win over Marist on Saturday. Each of the Broncs' last three wins have featured four different scorers in double-figures.

• Rider takes exceptional care of the ball, committing the second least amount of turnovers in the MAAC. The Broncs are 11-0 on the season when they win the turnover battle.

• Junior **Stella Johnson** earned her sixth MAAC Player of the Week honor after averaging 23.5/7/6 in a two-win week.

# Billi CHAMBERS

## Head Coach

### Hofstra '03 - Sixth Season

Head coach Billi Chambers is entering her sixth season at the helm of the Iona College women's basketball program.

Iona announced the appointment of Chambers as the seventh head coach of the women's basketball program in May of 2013. Chambers spent the previous two seasons as an assistant at Virginia Tech prior to the move to New Rochelle.

Last year the Gaels sported one of the youngest teams in the country. Rookie Toyosi Abiola carried the torch as the unanimous MAAC Rookie of the Year. The MAAC All-Rookie Team honoree was a nine-time MAAC Rookie of the Week. Alexis Lewis was also named to the All-MAAC Third Team.

The Gaels finished the 2016-17 season with a 18-13, 12-8 MAAC record. They entered the conference tournament as the No. 5 seed and advanced to the semifinals by upsetting Siena in the first round.

Alexis Lewis and Marina Lizarazu were named to the 2017 All-MAAC First Team, and four student-athletes took home All-MAAC Academic Team honors.

In 2016 Chambers led the Gaels to their first ever Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference Tournament Championship, taking down the top seeded Quinnipiac Bobcats in the championship game to earn the Maroon & Gold's debut appearance in the NCAA Tournament.

Marina Lizarazu and Joy Adams were both named to the All-MAAC First Team. Lizarazu earned Most Outstanding Player honors for her domination in the MAAC Tournament.

In her first season with the Gaels, Chambers led Iona to a program record 26 wins and a share of its first MAAC Regular Season Championship. Her 26 wins are the most by a rookie head coach in conference history.

In 2013-14, Chambers led the Gaels to a historic 18-game winning streak, the longest in school history. She became the first rookie coach to win the MAAC Coach of the Year honor since 1991 and led all first-time head coaches in NCAA Division I with 26 overall wins and 18 victories in conference play.

For her efforts, Chambers was named the WBCA Spalding Maggie Dixon Division I Rookie Coach of the Year, given to the nation's top first year head coach, becoming the first mentor in MAAC history to claim the honor. Chambers was also named College Sports Madness Mid-Major Coach of the Year in 2014.

After finishing 15-15 in her second season with the Gaels, Chambers held a 41-21 overall record; the mark is the best of any coach in program history during their first two seasons.

In her third season with the Maroon & Gold, Chambers led Iona to its first ever Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference Championship. Using her catchphrase of a "Defensive Standard", the Gaels had their best defensive scoring season in program history, allowing just 56.6 points per game.

In their first ever NCAA Tournament appearance, Chambers led the No. 15 seed Gaels in a competitive 74-58 loss to the No. 2 seed Maryland Terrapins. The Maroon & Gold were within seven points with less than eight minutes to go.

Through her first five years leading the Iona program, Chambers holds a 84-74 (.532) overall record.

During her five years at the helm of the Maroon & Gold, four student-athletes have earned All-MAAC First Team honors; Damika Martinez (2014, 15), Joy Adams (2013, 14, 15), Lizarazu (2016, 17), and Alexis Lewis (2017). Martinez was named the MAAC Player of the Year in both her junior and senior year.

Aaliyah Robinson (2014) and Alexis Lewis (2016) each earned MAAC Sixth Player of the Year honors. Toyosi Abiola (2018) was the unanimous MAAC Rookie of the Year.

- The Maroon & Gold's bench scored in double-figures for the fourth straight contest. Barefield was responsible for every single bench point scored by the unit.

- Founded in 1940, Iona College is a private Catholic liberal arts college of approximately 3,800 undergraduate and graduate students, with professional and pre-professional programs in business as well as arts & sciences.
- Located in New Rochelle, N.Y., 20 minutes northwest of Midtown Manhattan, and also offers graduate programs in Rockland County, N.Y., and Manhattan.
- College President, Dr. Joseph Nyre (pronounced "Nire"), is first president who is not a member of the Congregation of Christian Brothers and began in July 2011.
- Iona courses are taught by talented faculty and attended by those who qualify, regardless of their economic standing. Iona held down tuition increases and increased scholarship aid this year, making the actual cost of attendance for those starting this year lower than the previous year.
- Tradition: Irish Pipe Band plays on campus on first day of school to greet the freshman class and on the last day of class in spring. The Pipers have regularly been among the top college bands in NYC's annual St. Patrick's Day Parade
- A "hot" school -- three of the largest freshman classes in the last decade started the last three years.

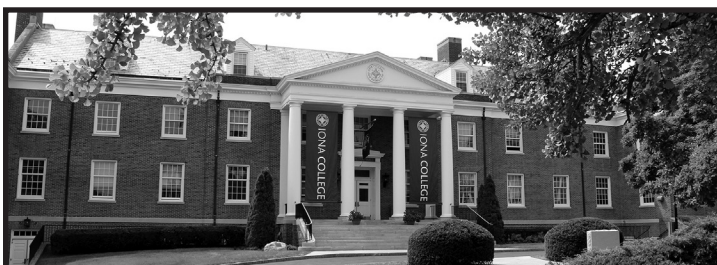


## President Joseph (Joe) Nyre, Ph.D.

- Substantially grew the College's endowment and annual fund raising.
- Developed and executed a residential housing strategy that included adding over 350 campus beds in less than 14 months.
- Grew campus land holdings by approximately 20 percent.

The symbol of Iona College's athletic teams is the popular Gael. A Gael is anyone of Irish-Gaelic ancestry, consistent with the Irish tradition of Iona. The College was founded in 1940 by the Congregation of Christian Brothers, commonly known as the Irish Christian Brothers.

The Gael, which is depicted as a spunky character, provides Iona with a nickname consistent with the school motto, *certa bonum certamen*, ("fight the good fight") and personifies strength..
